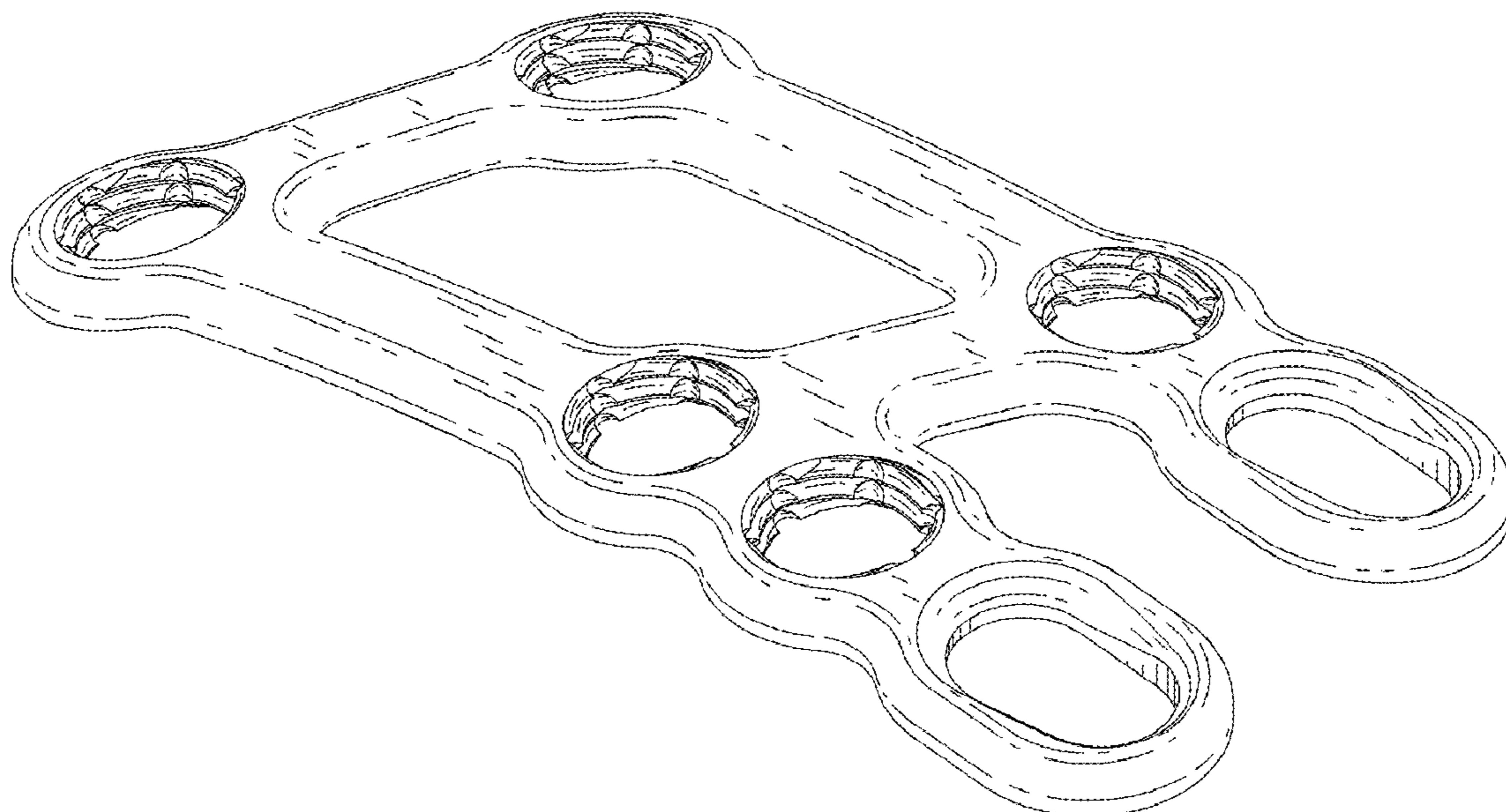
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bone plate, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a bone plate comprising the new design;  
FIG. 2 is a right elevational view of the design of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a top view of the design of FIG. 1;

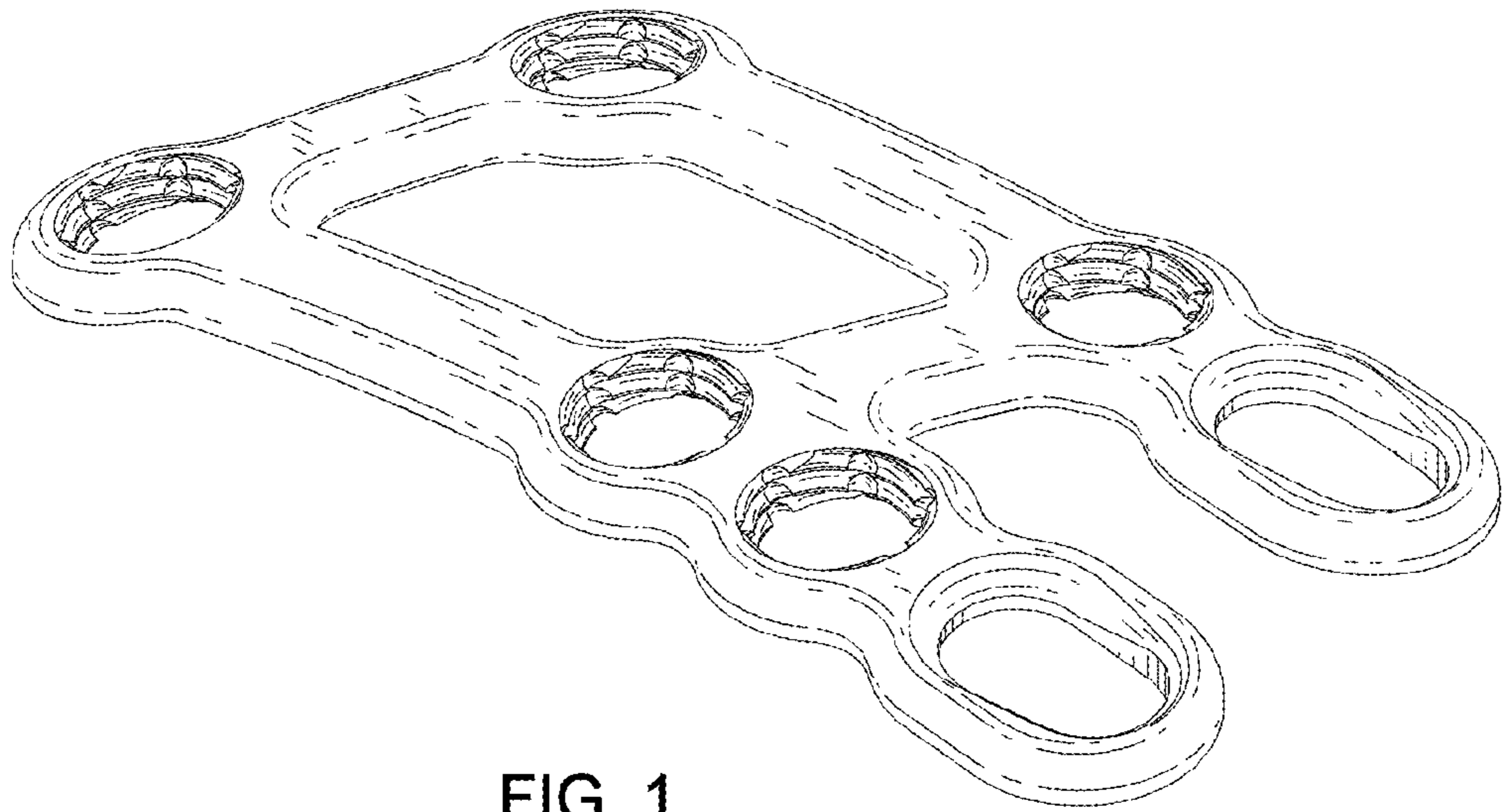

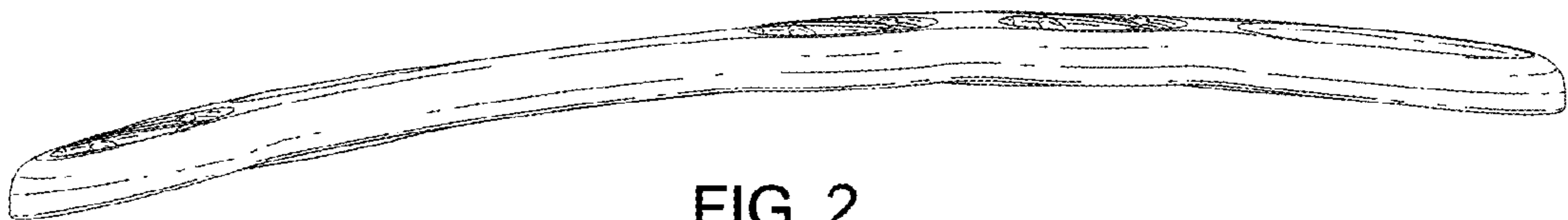

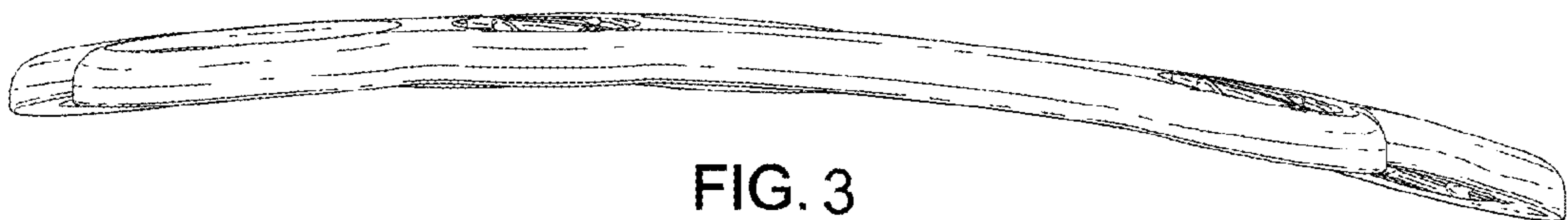

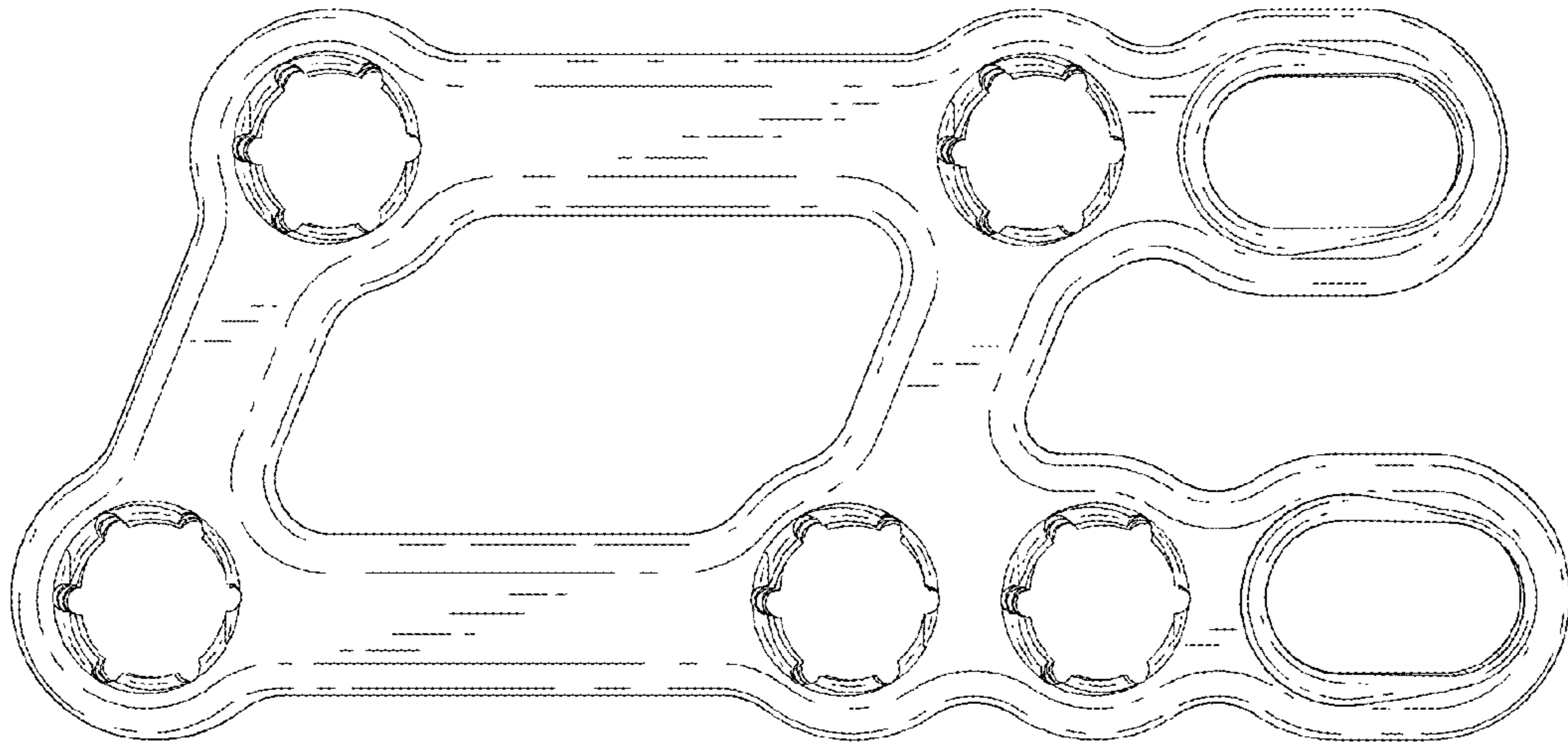

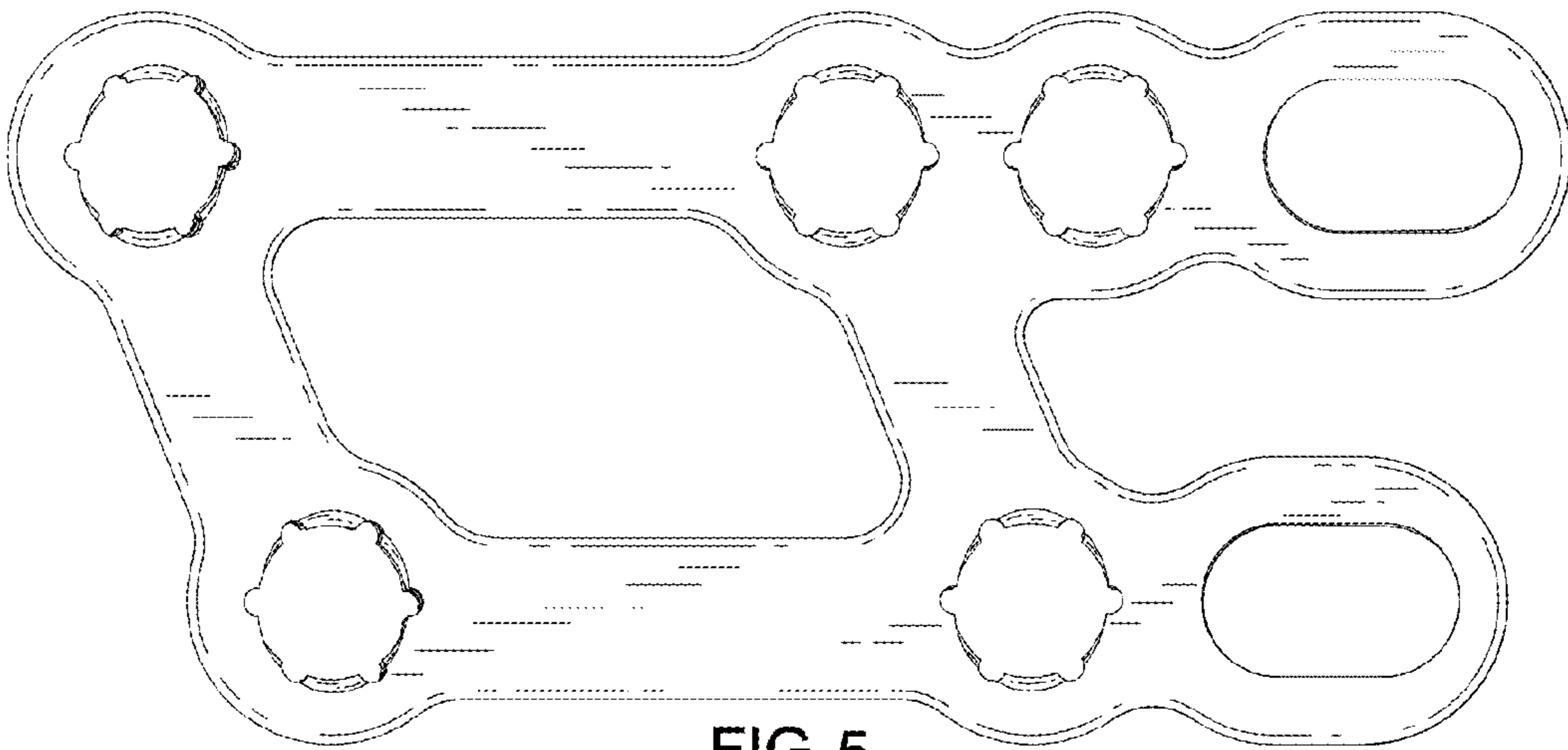

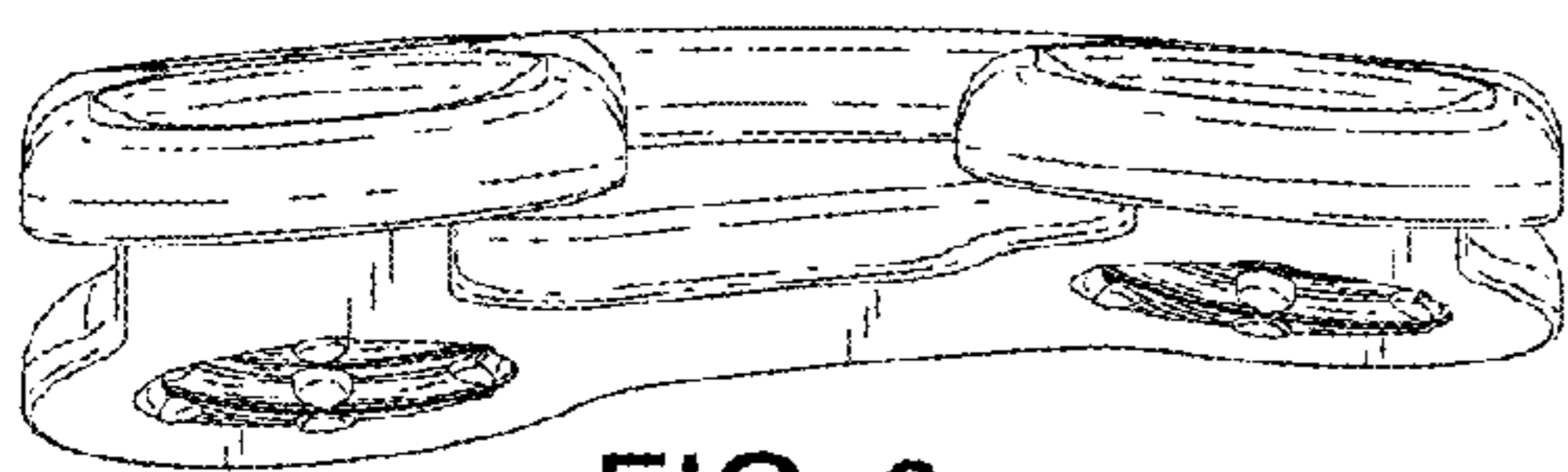

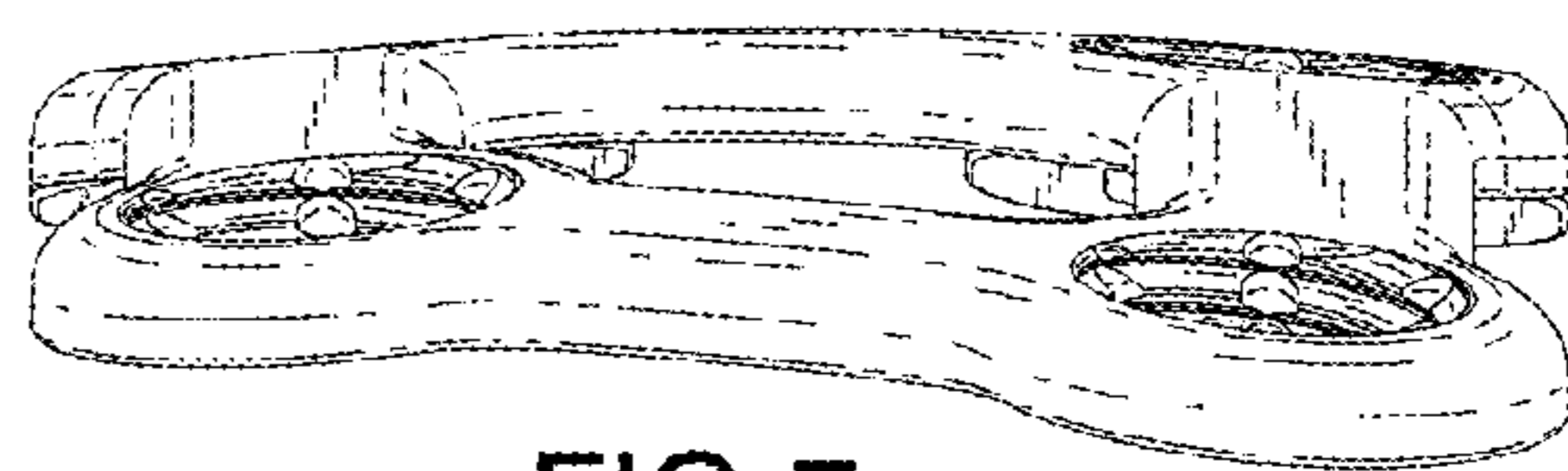
