(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a strap pad, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of the strap pad of the present invention, showing the unclaimed strap going through the middle of the claimed pad.

FIG. 2 is a side perspective view of FIG. 1, with the bottom side up.

FIG. 3 is a bottom view, showing the unclaimed strap going through the middle of the claimed pad.

FIG. 4 is a top view, showing the unclaimed strap going through the middle of the claimed pad.

FIG. 5 is an end view of the strap pad of the present invention, showing the unclaimed strap going through the middle of the claimed pad.

FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view of the strap pad of the present invention, showing the unclaimed strap going through slots at the ends of the claimed pad.

FIG. 7 is a side perspective view of FIG. 6, with the bottom side up.

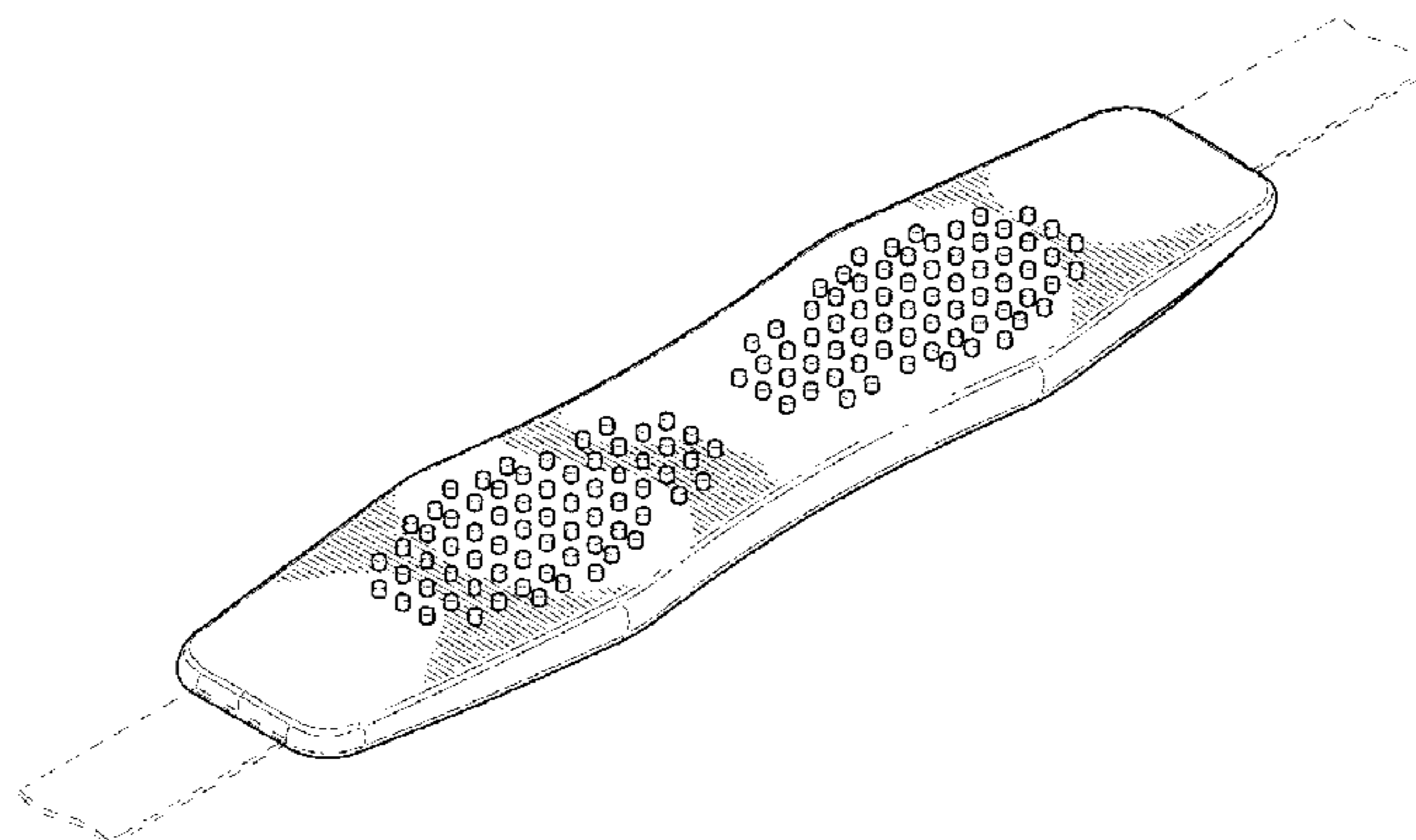
FIG. 8 is a bottom view of the strap pad of the present invention, showing the unclaimed strap going through slots at the ends of the claimed pad.

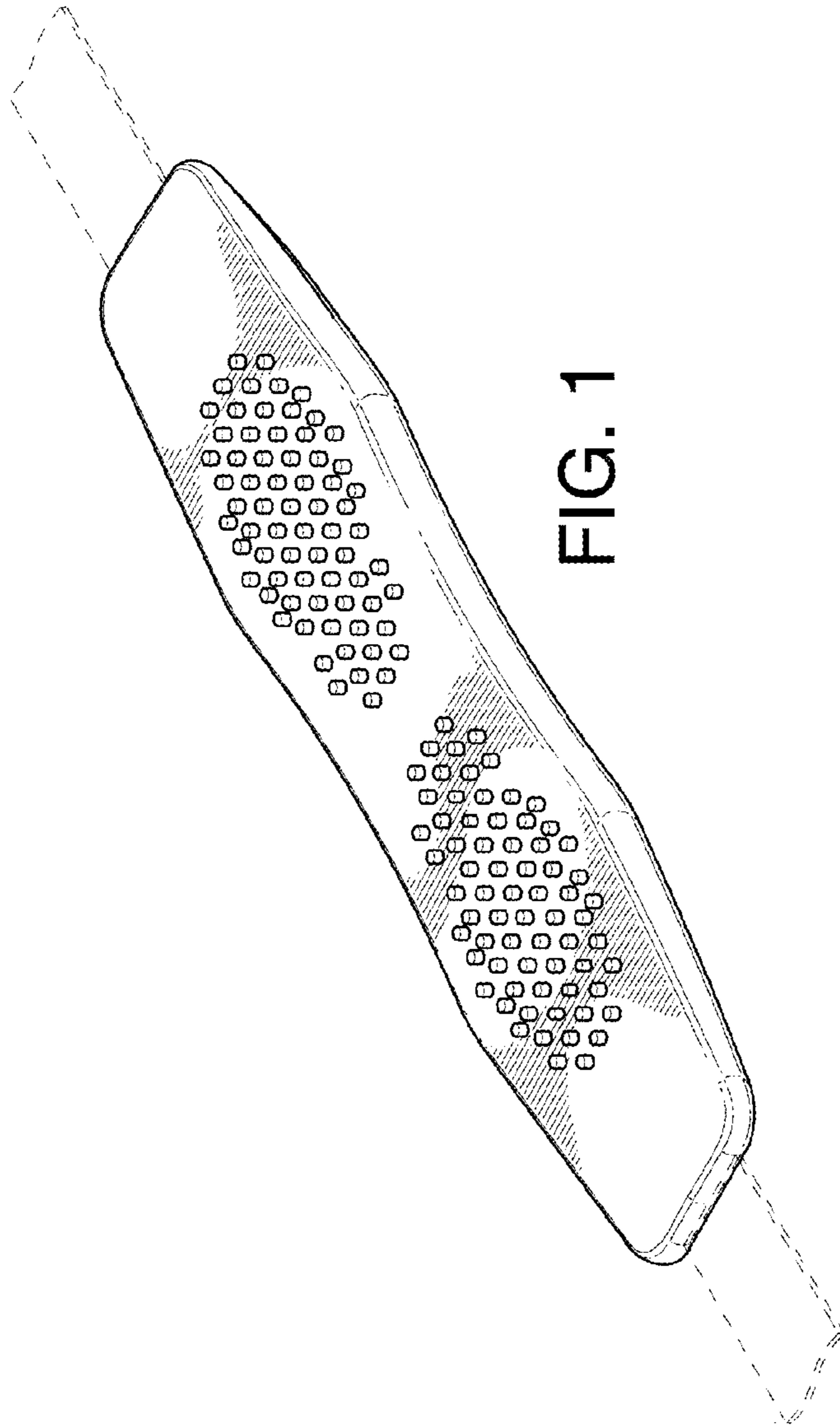

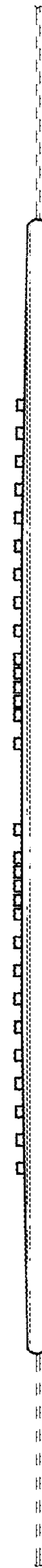

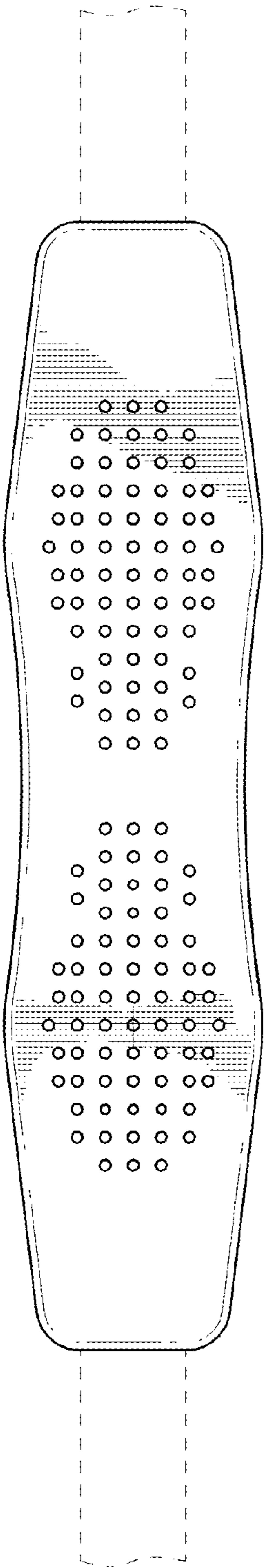

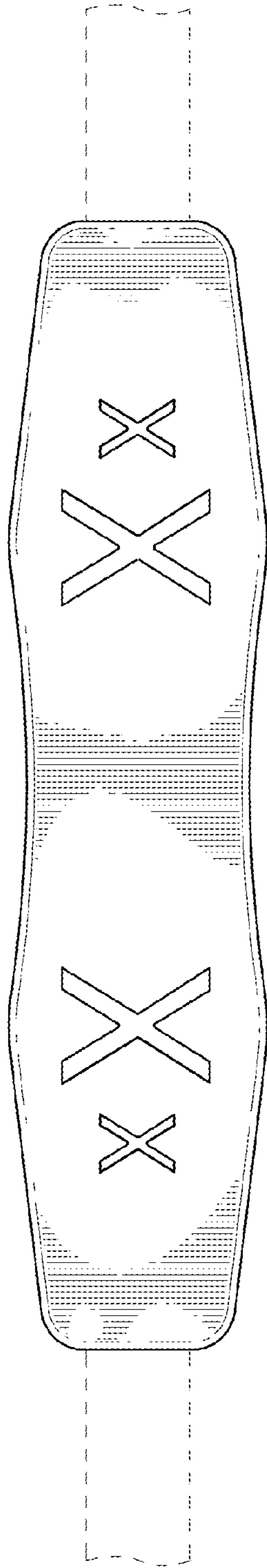

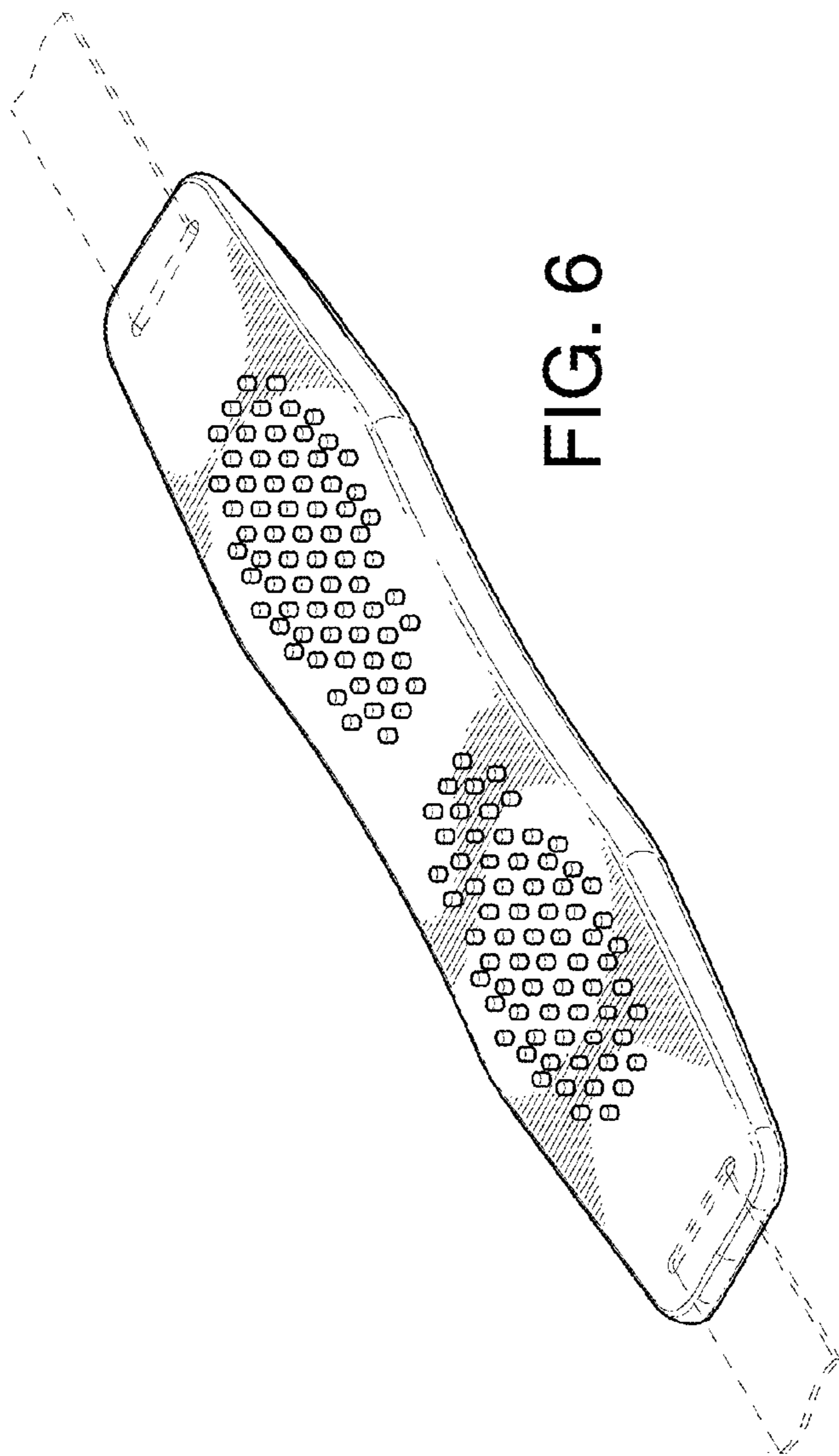

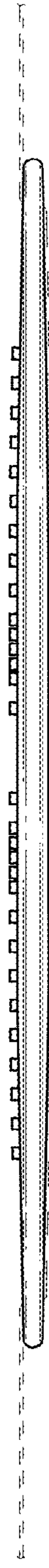

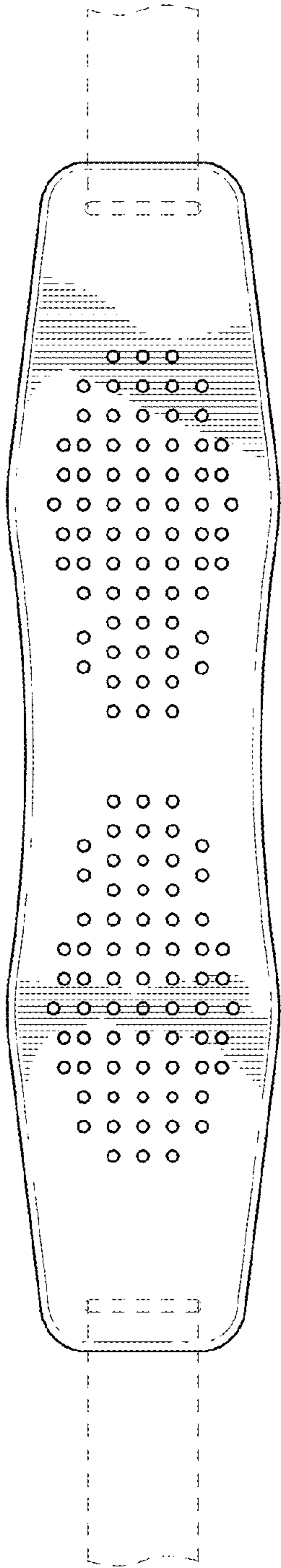

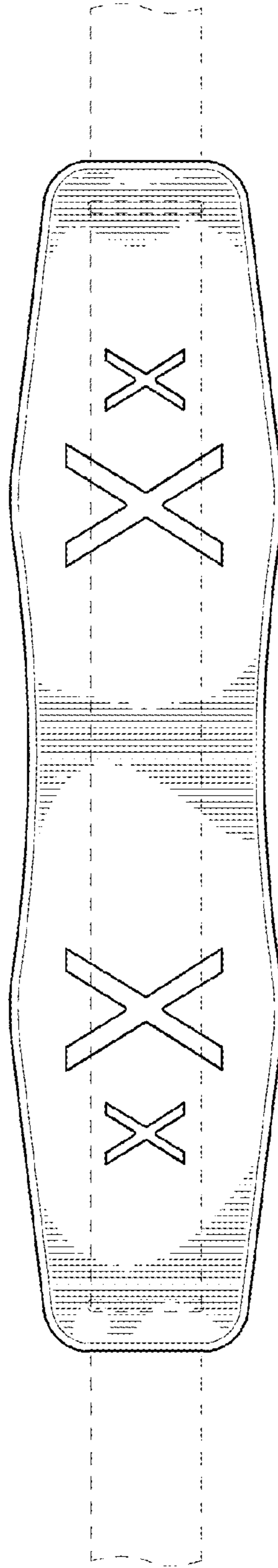
