FIG. 9 is a front view thereof;

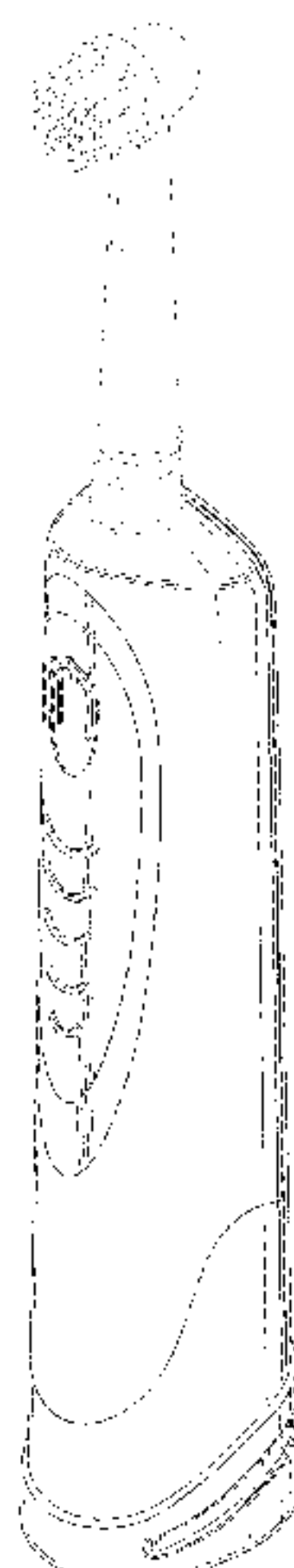
FIG. 10 is a rear view thereof;

The broken lines showing a brush head in FIGS. 1-5 and
7-11, and the broken lines shown on the rear of the handle
in FIGS. 4 and 10 and on the bottom of the handle in FIGS.
6 and 12 illustrate portions of the electric toothbrush that
form no part of the claimed design with the broken lines that
are immediately adjacent the surface shading in FIGS. 4, 6-9
and 11-12 representing the bounds of the claim and forming
no part thereof. The oval shaped broken line on the front of
the handle in FIGS. 7-9 and 11 illustrates an unclaimed line
on the surface of the handle and forms no part of the claimed
design.

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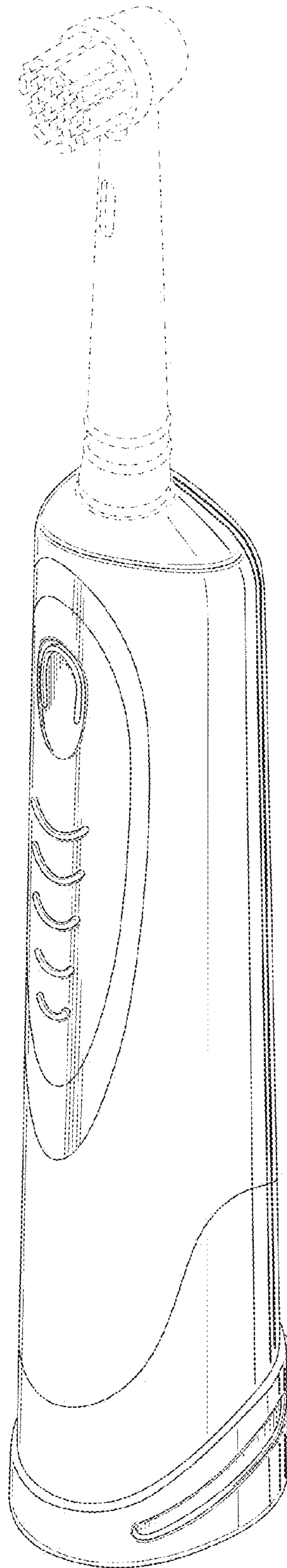

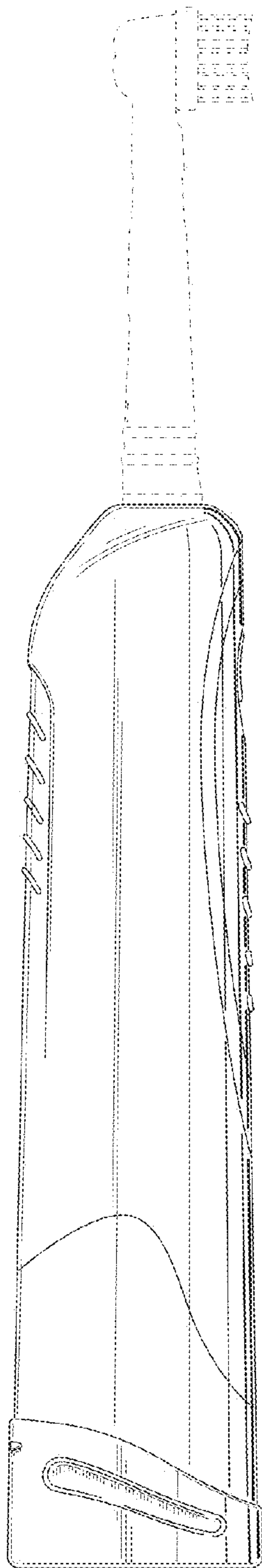

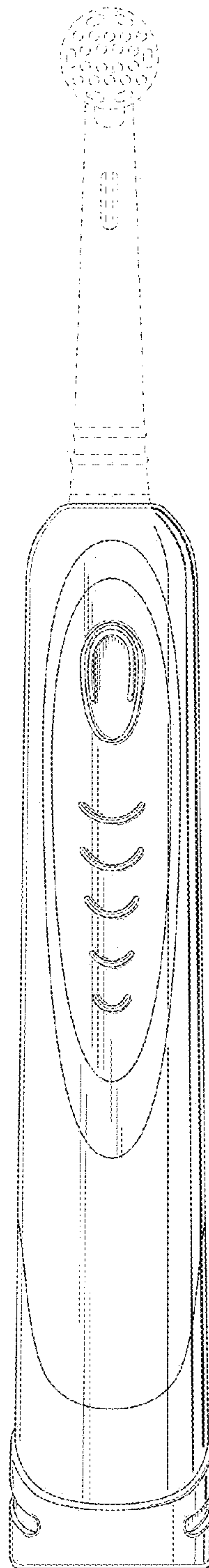

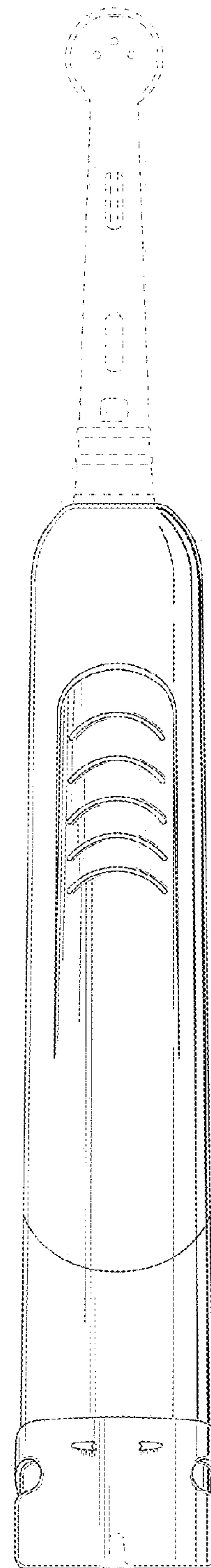

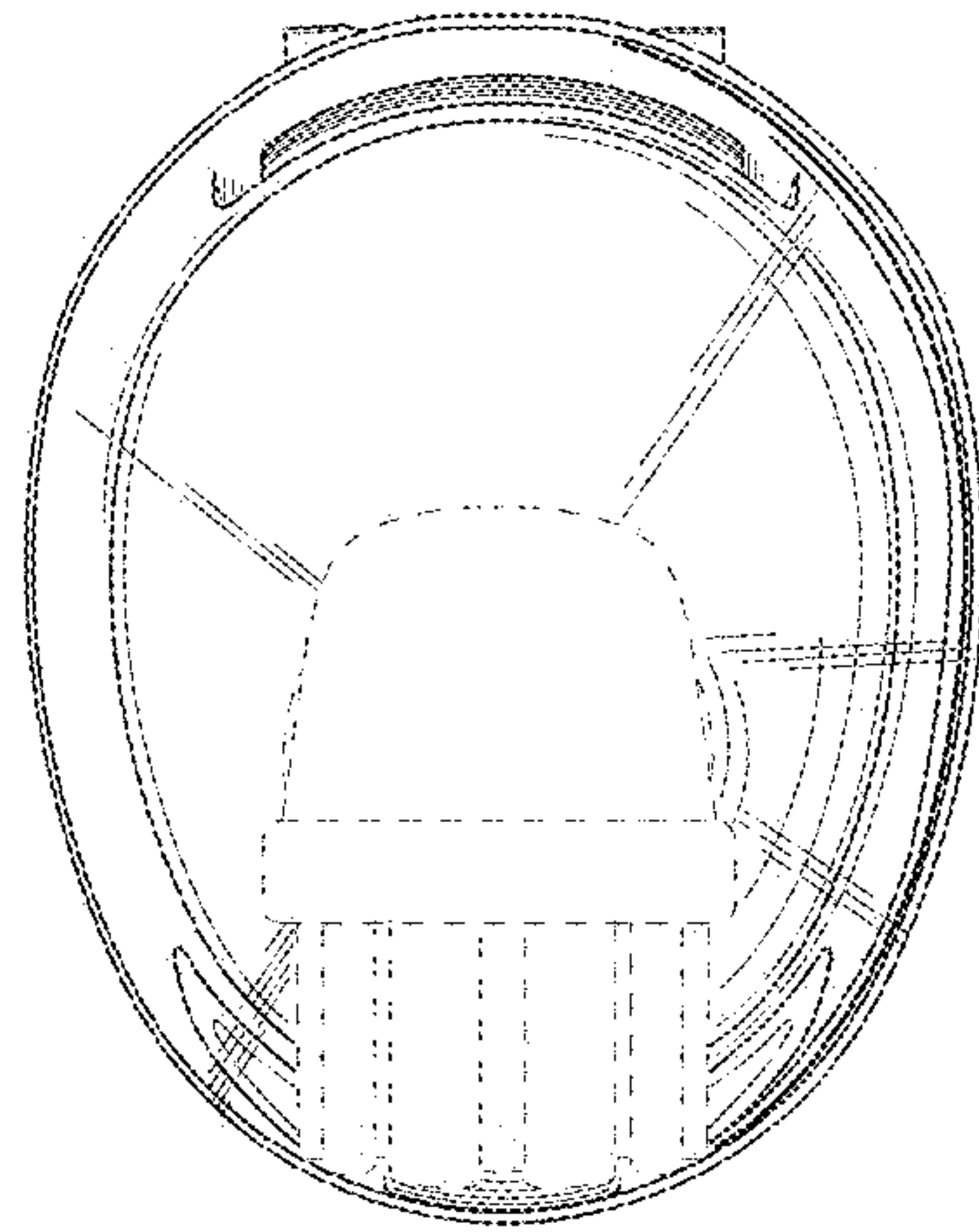

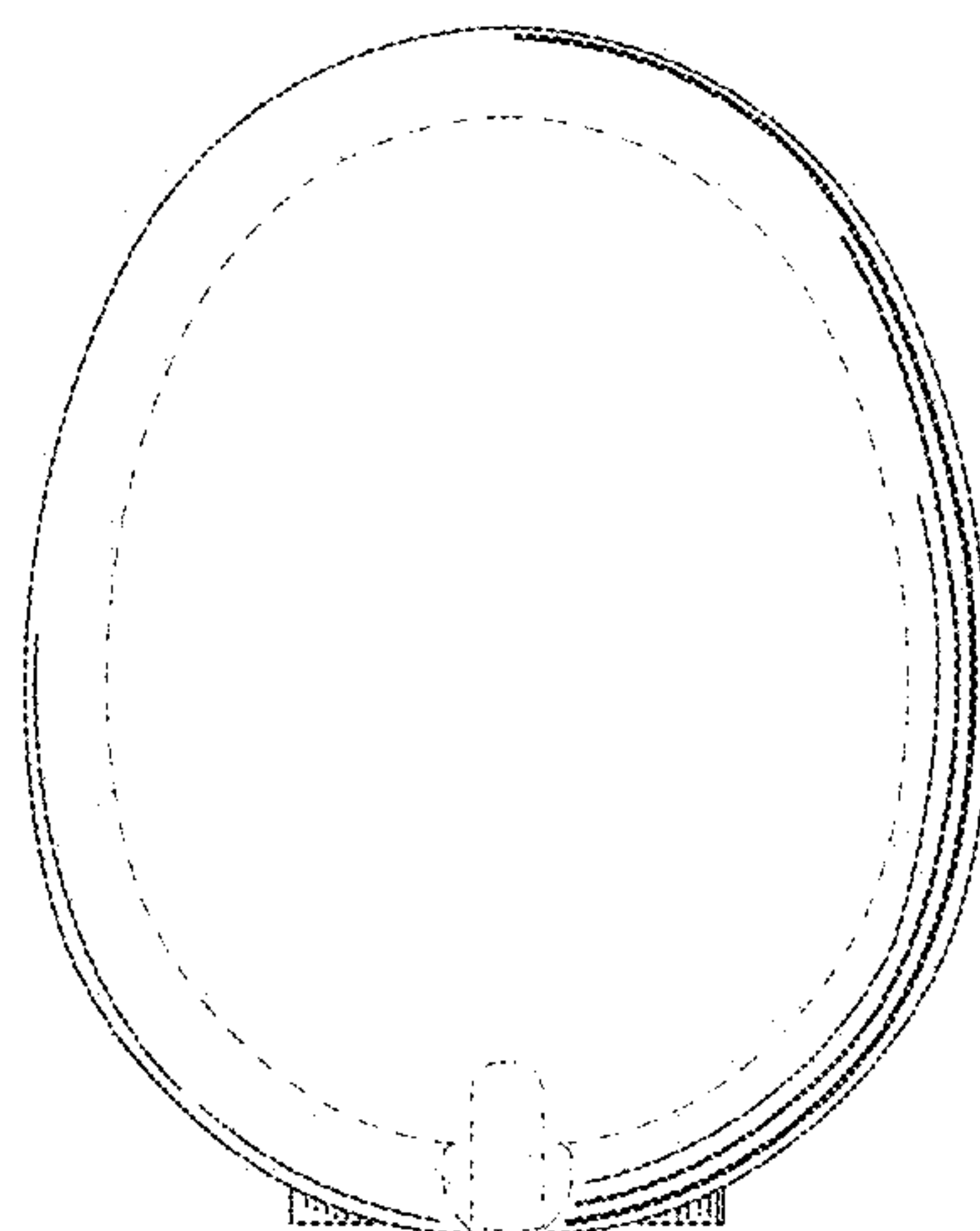

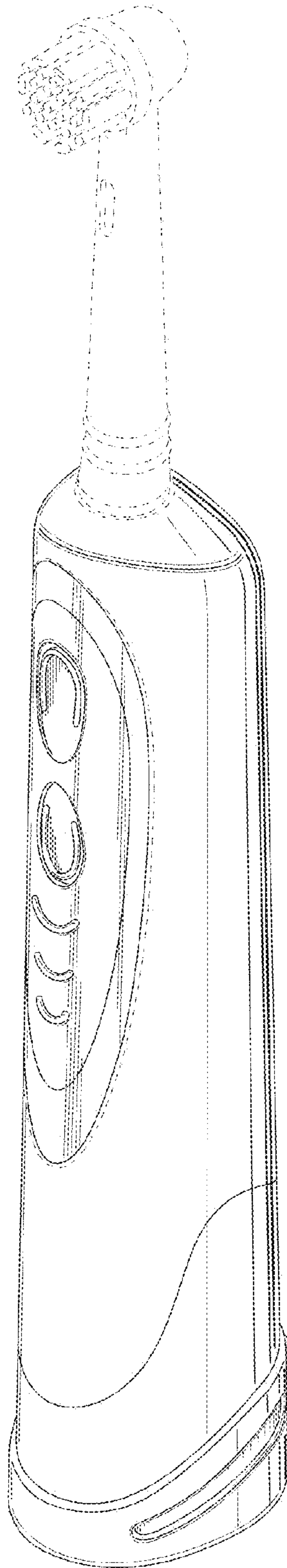

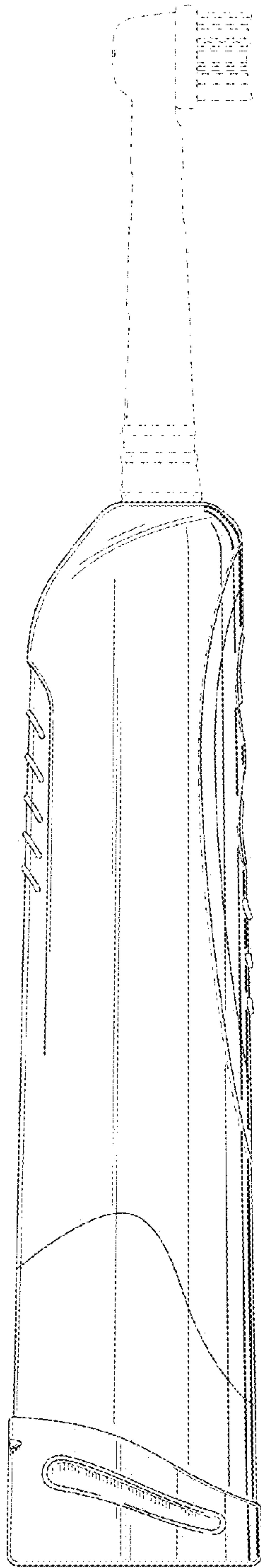

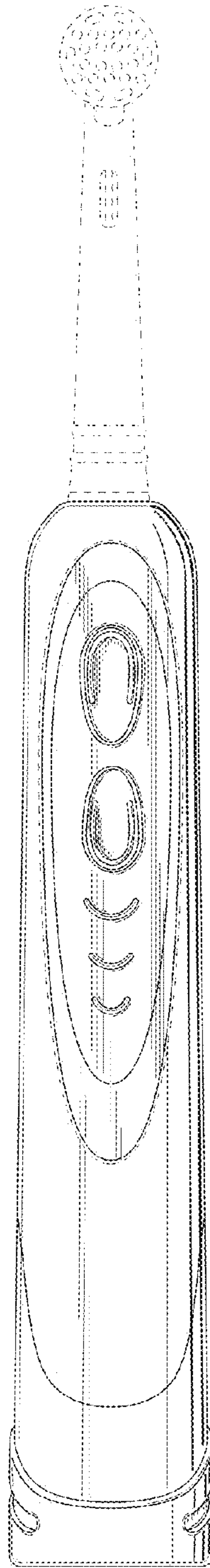

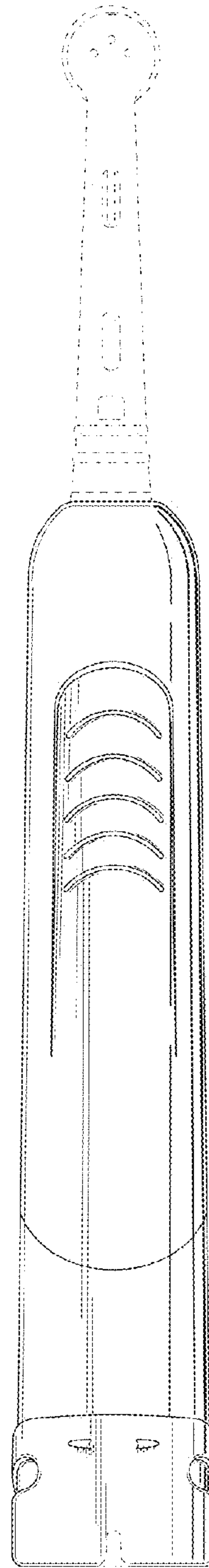

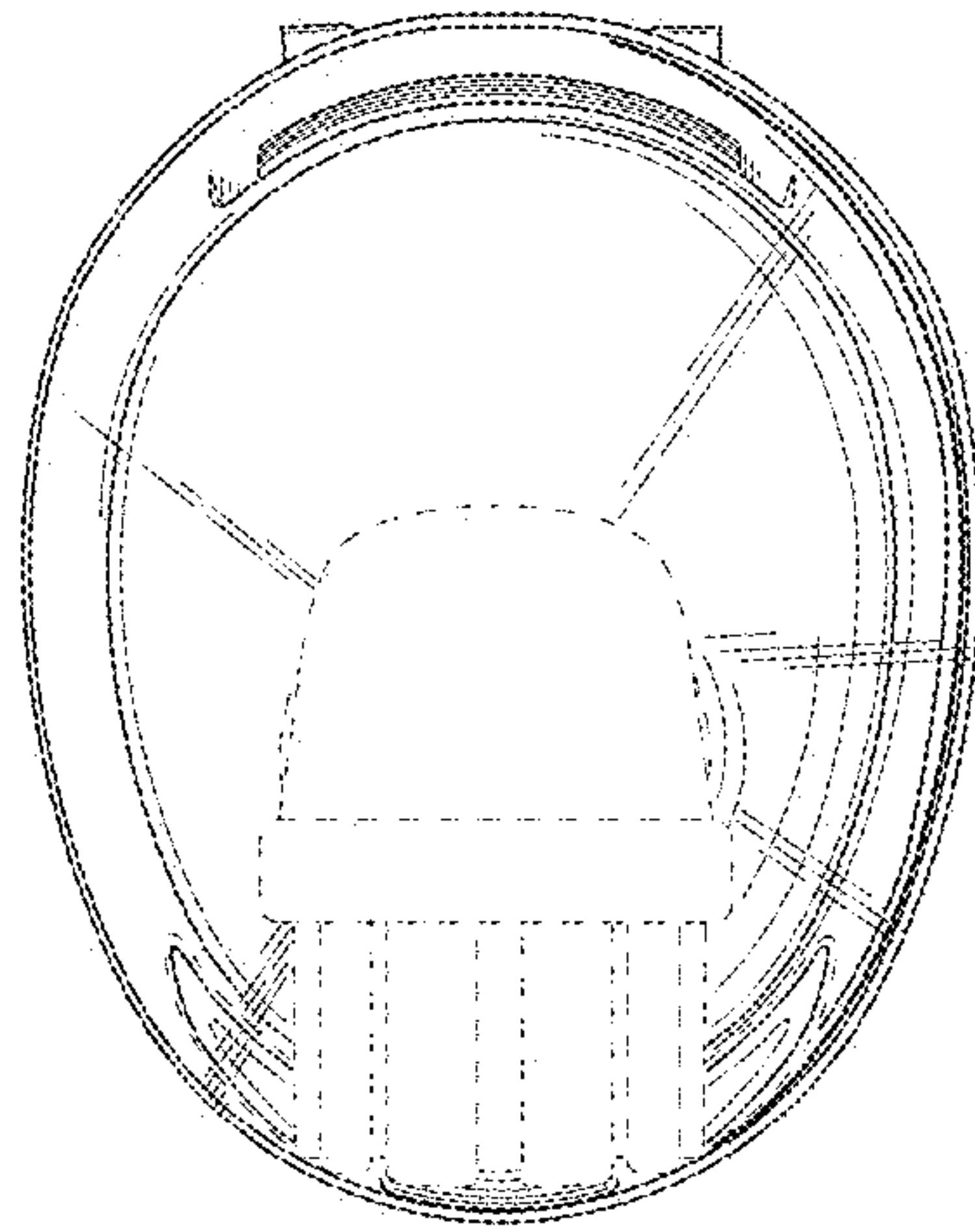

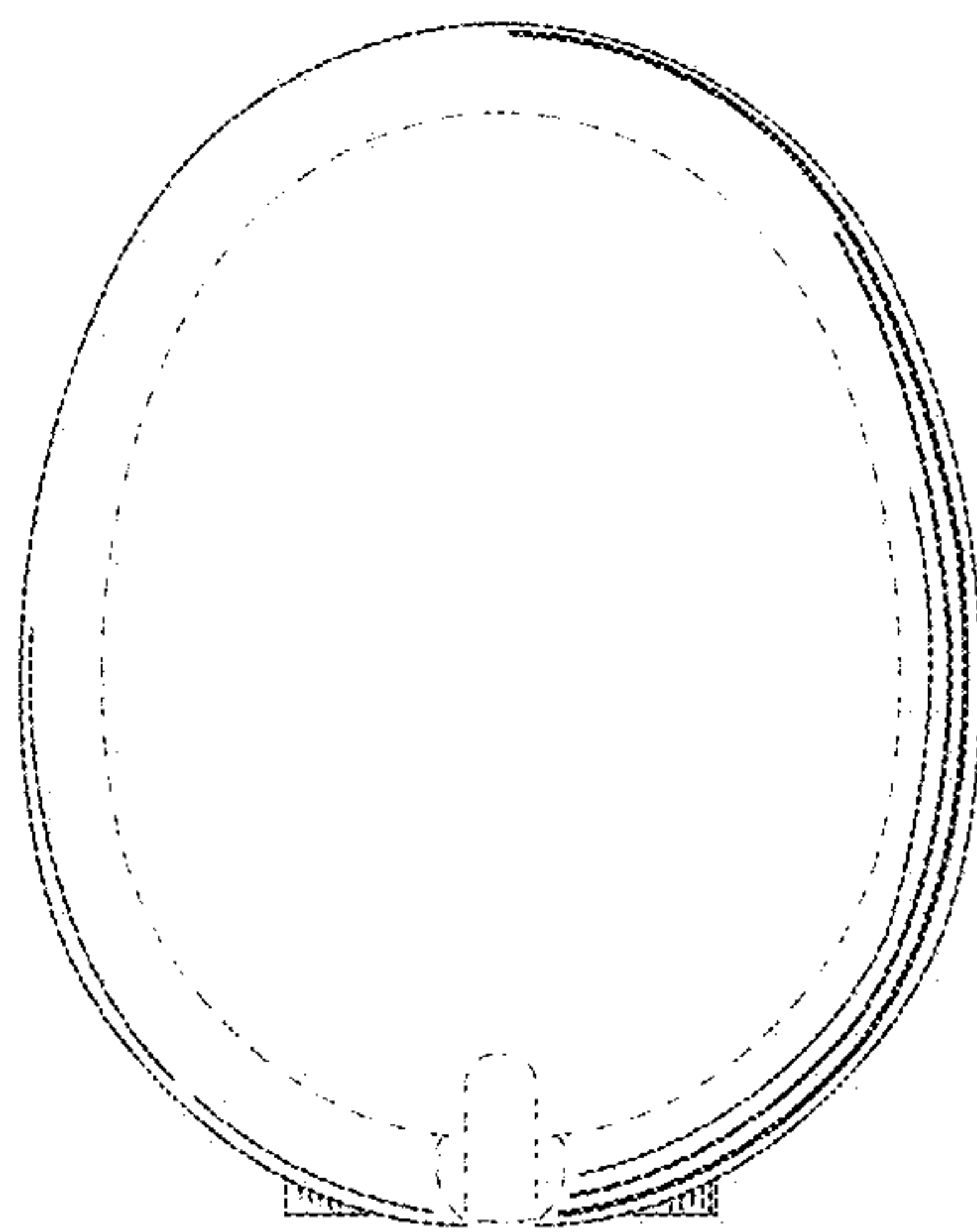
