(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for an absorbent paper towel with embossing pattern, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The sole FIGURE provided herein is a front view of an absorbent paper towel with embossing pattern.

The broken line surrounding the absorbent paper towel with embossing pattern depicts the boundaries of the claim and forms no part thereof. The dotted lines within the surrounding broken line are features of the claimed design.
