1.

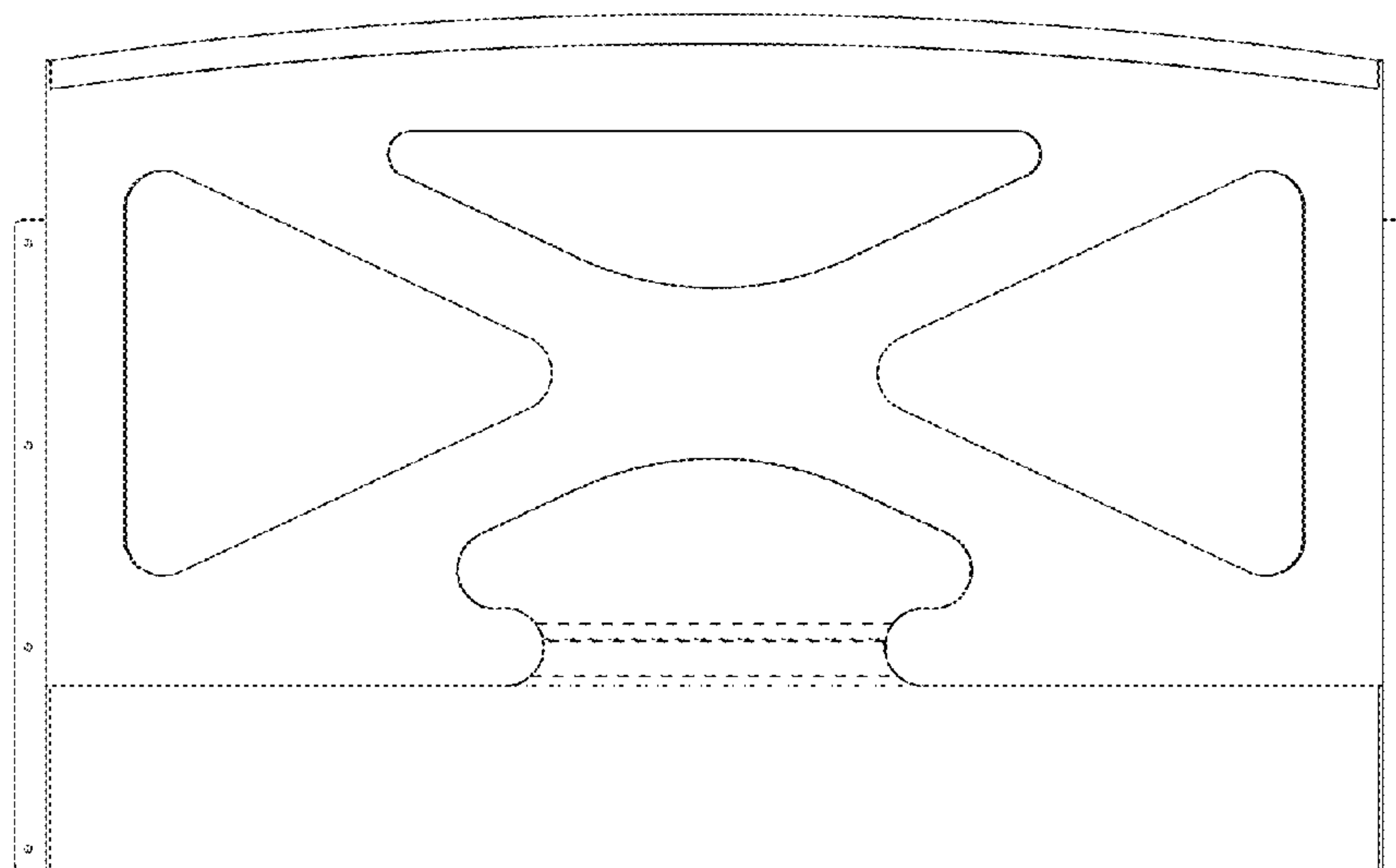

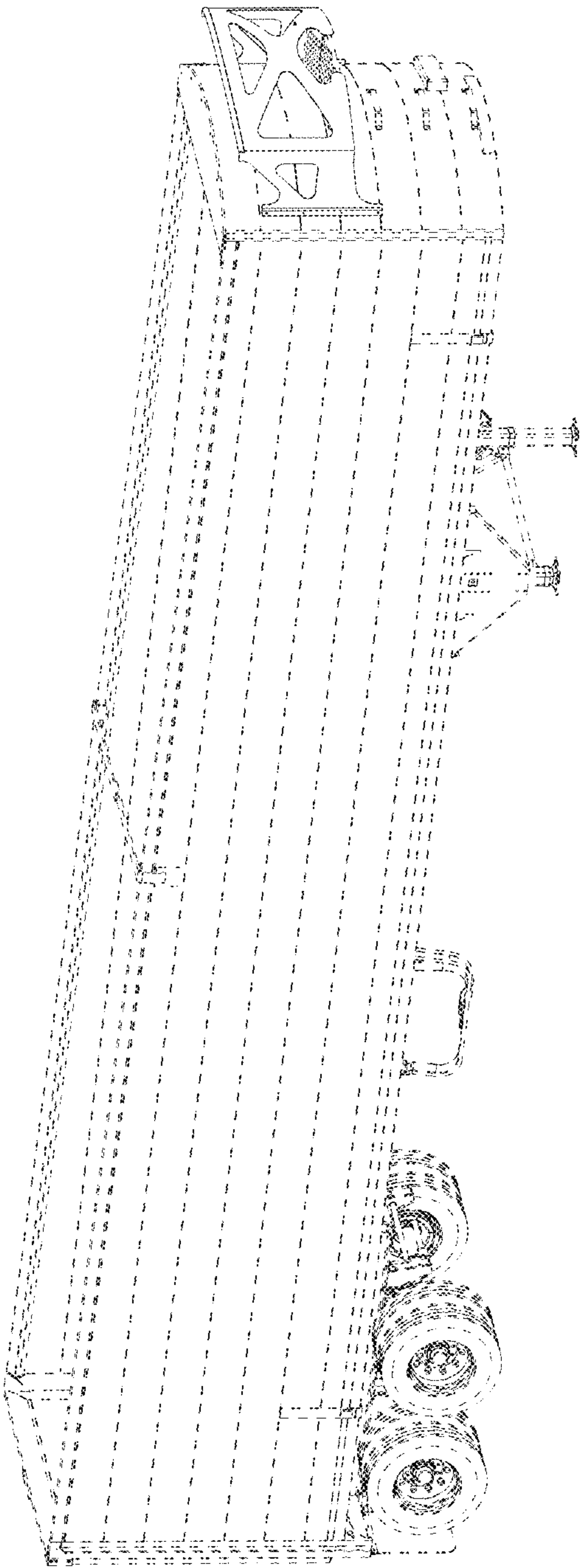

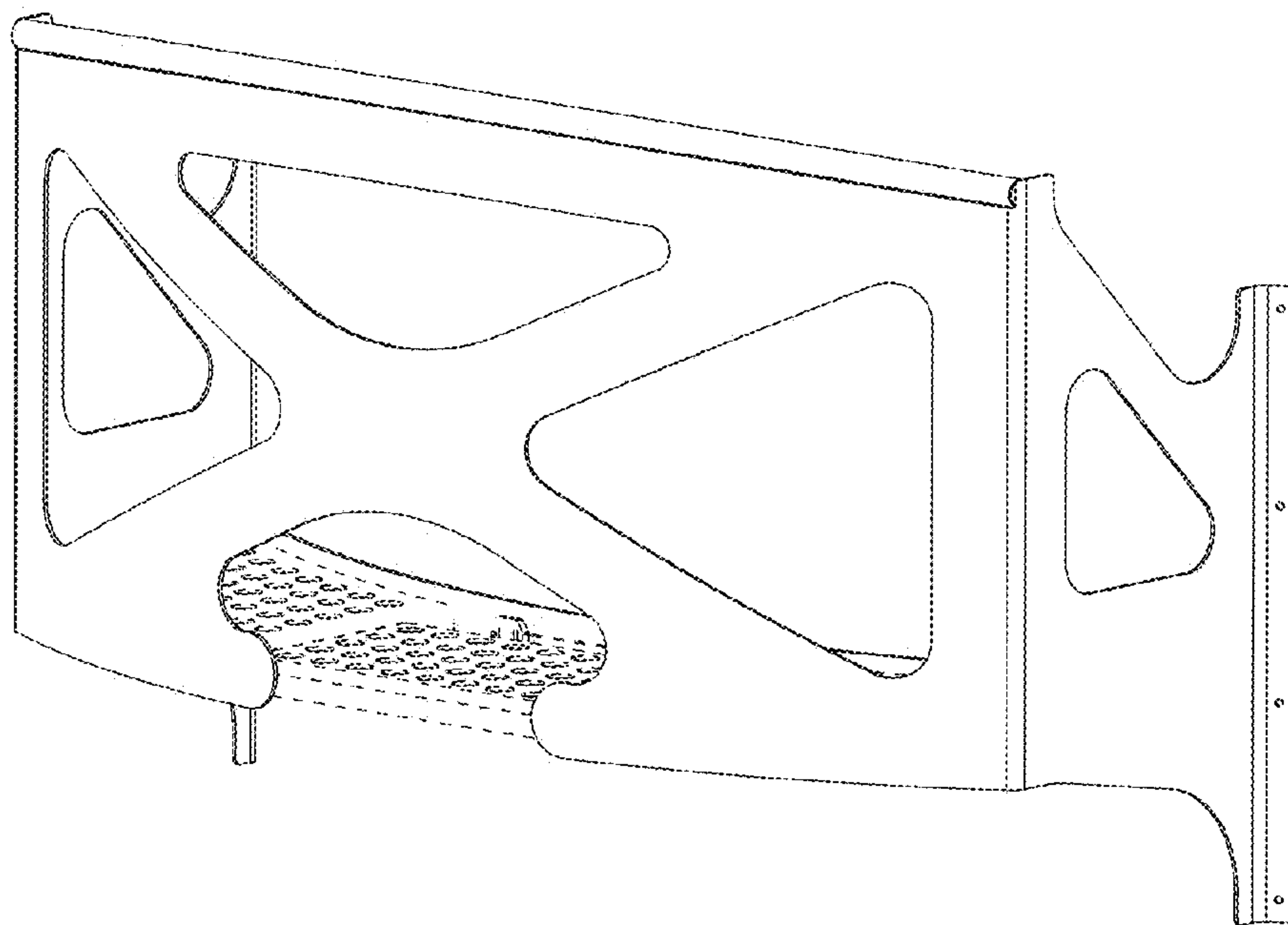

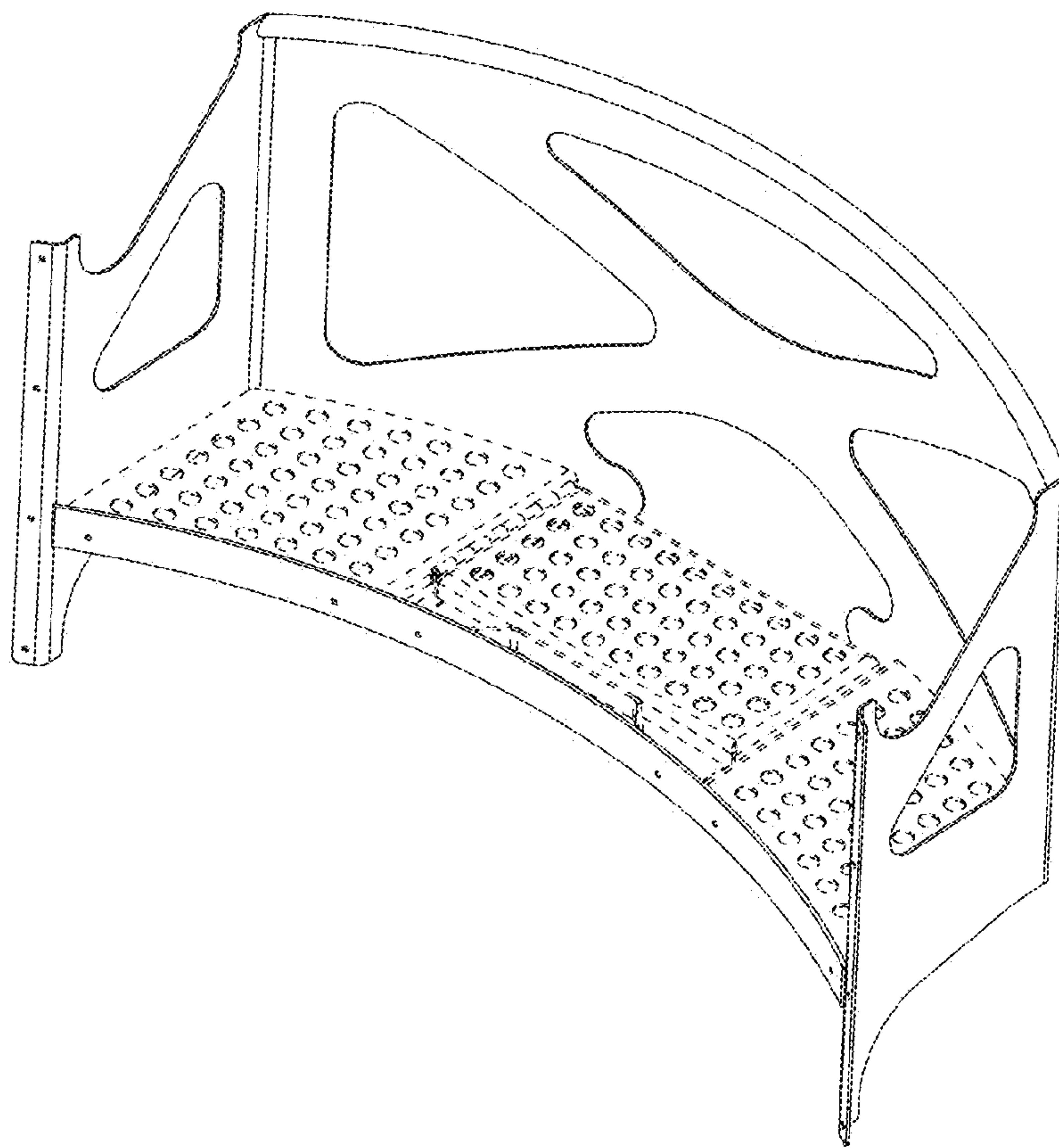

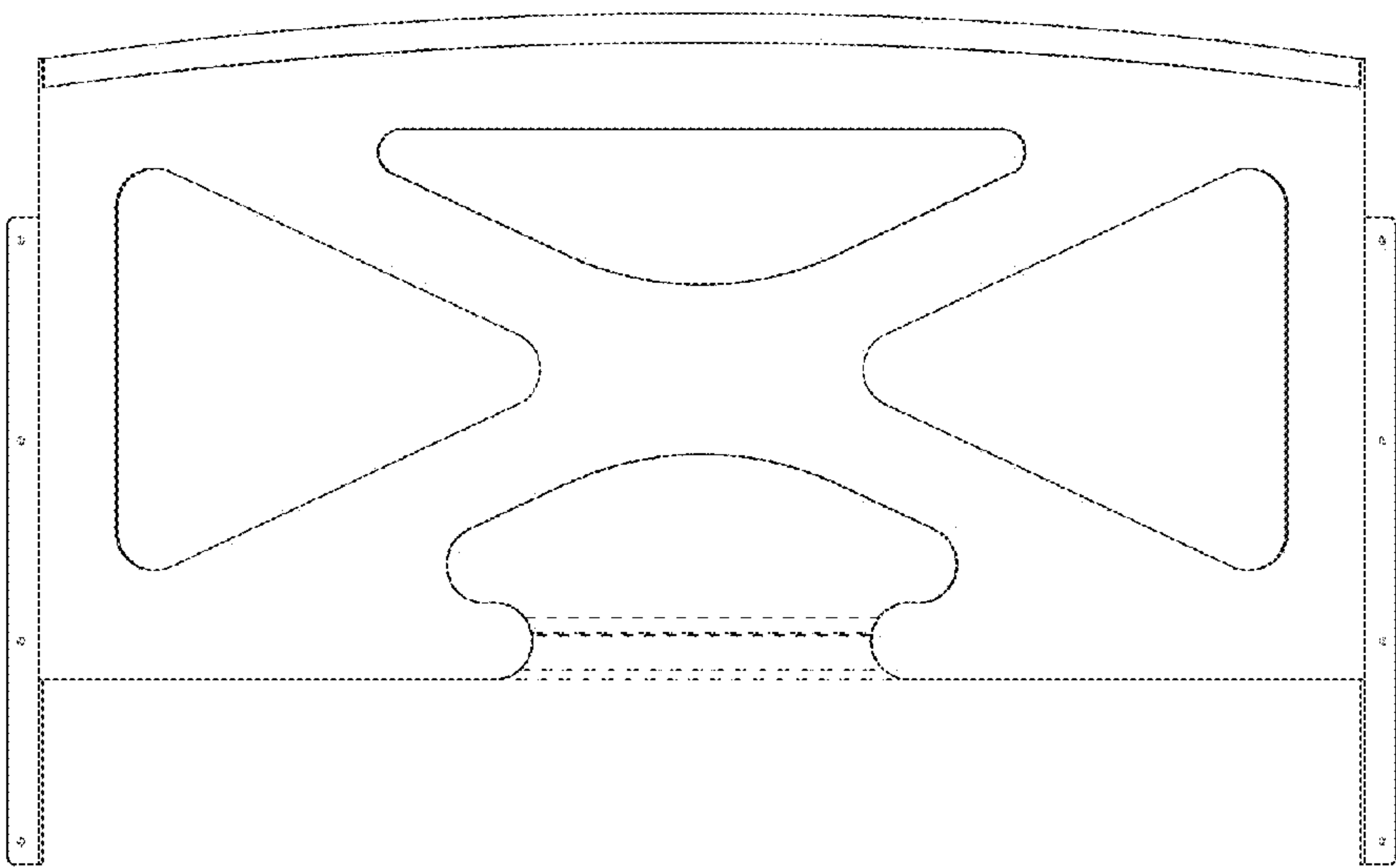

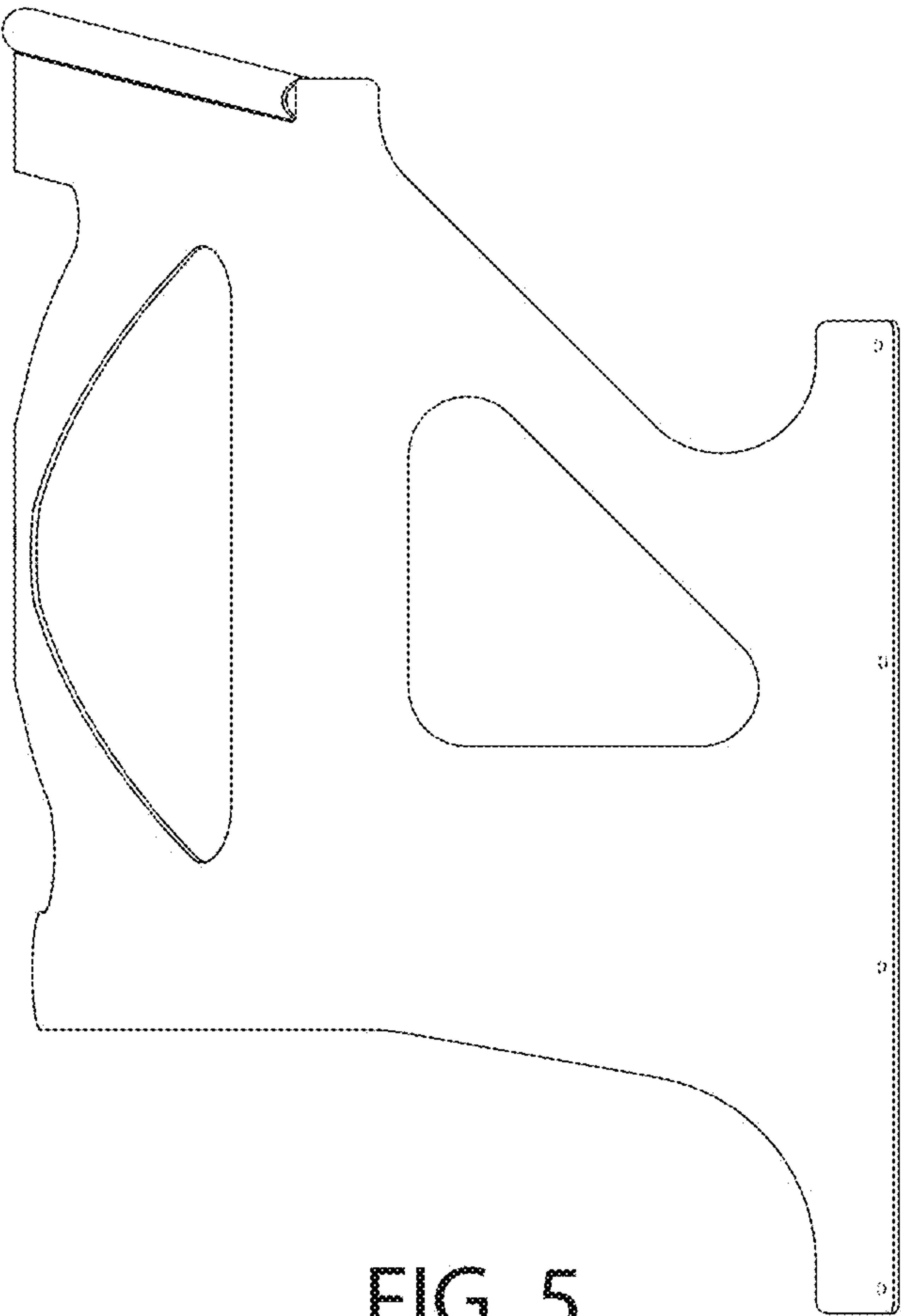

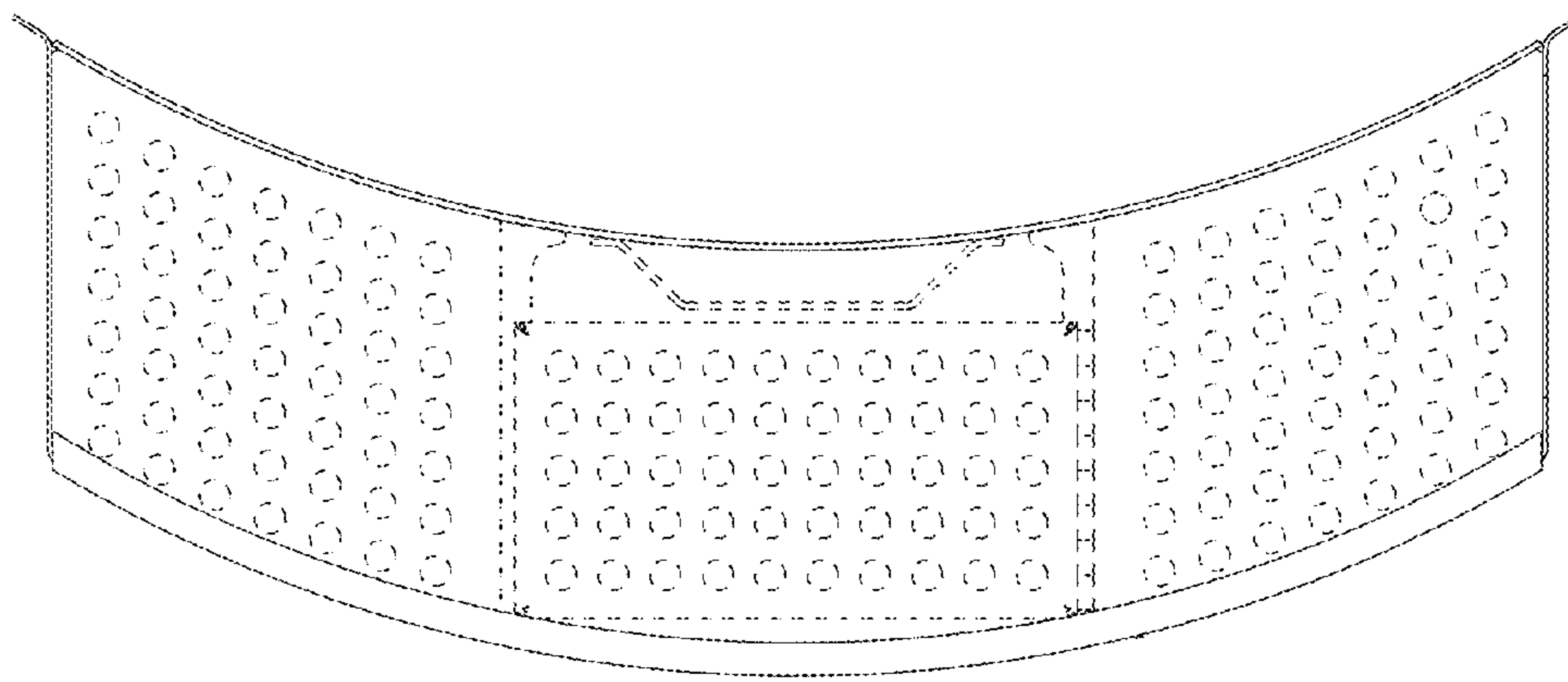
