The ornamental design for bumper guard for a portable light, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the bumper guard.

FIG. 2 is a front plan elevational view of the bumper guard of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a top side plan elevational view of the bumper guard of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a left side plan elevational view of the bumper guard of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a right plan elevational view of the bumper guard of FIG. 1.

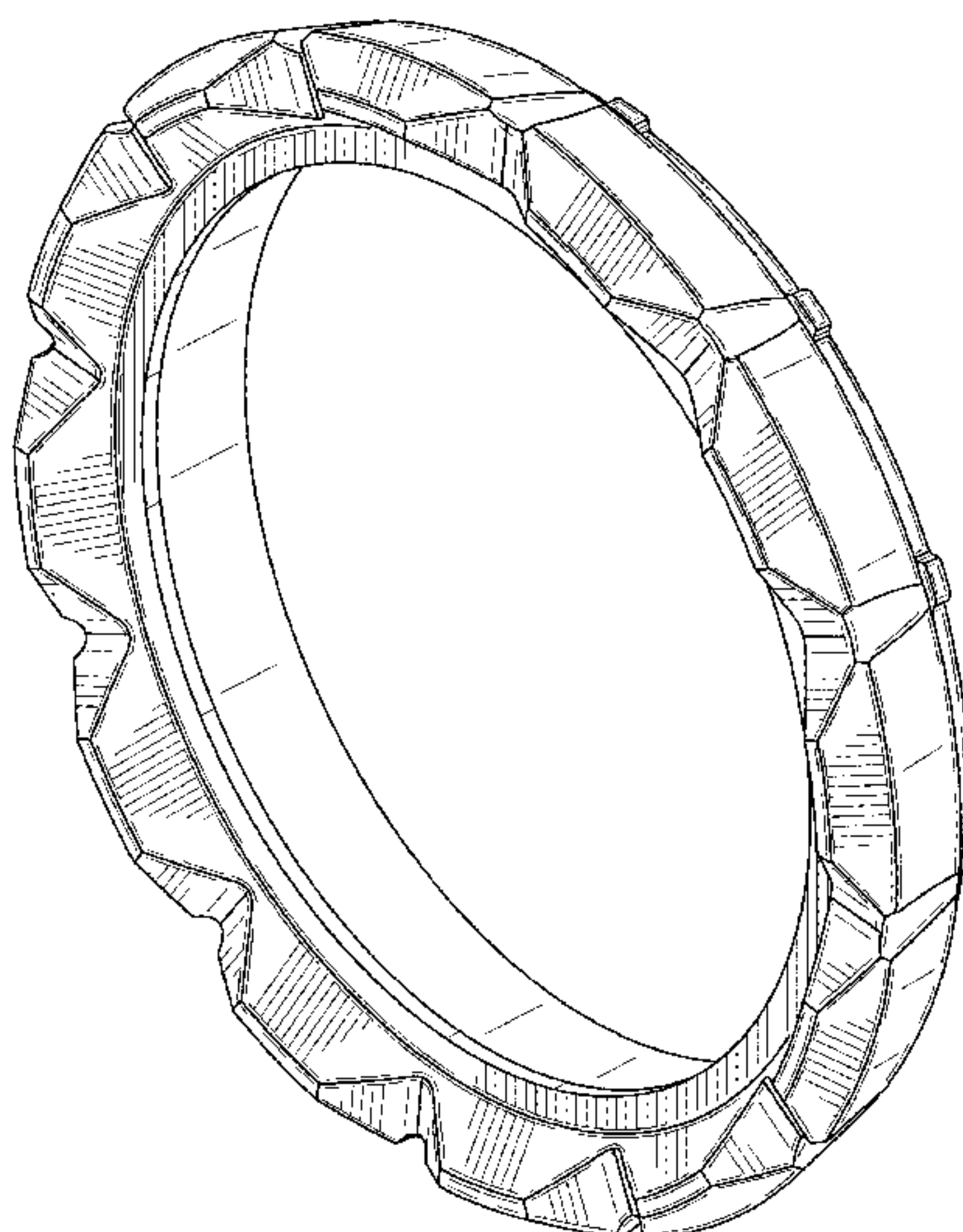
FIG. 6 is a rear plan elevational view of the bumper guard of FIG. 1.

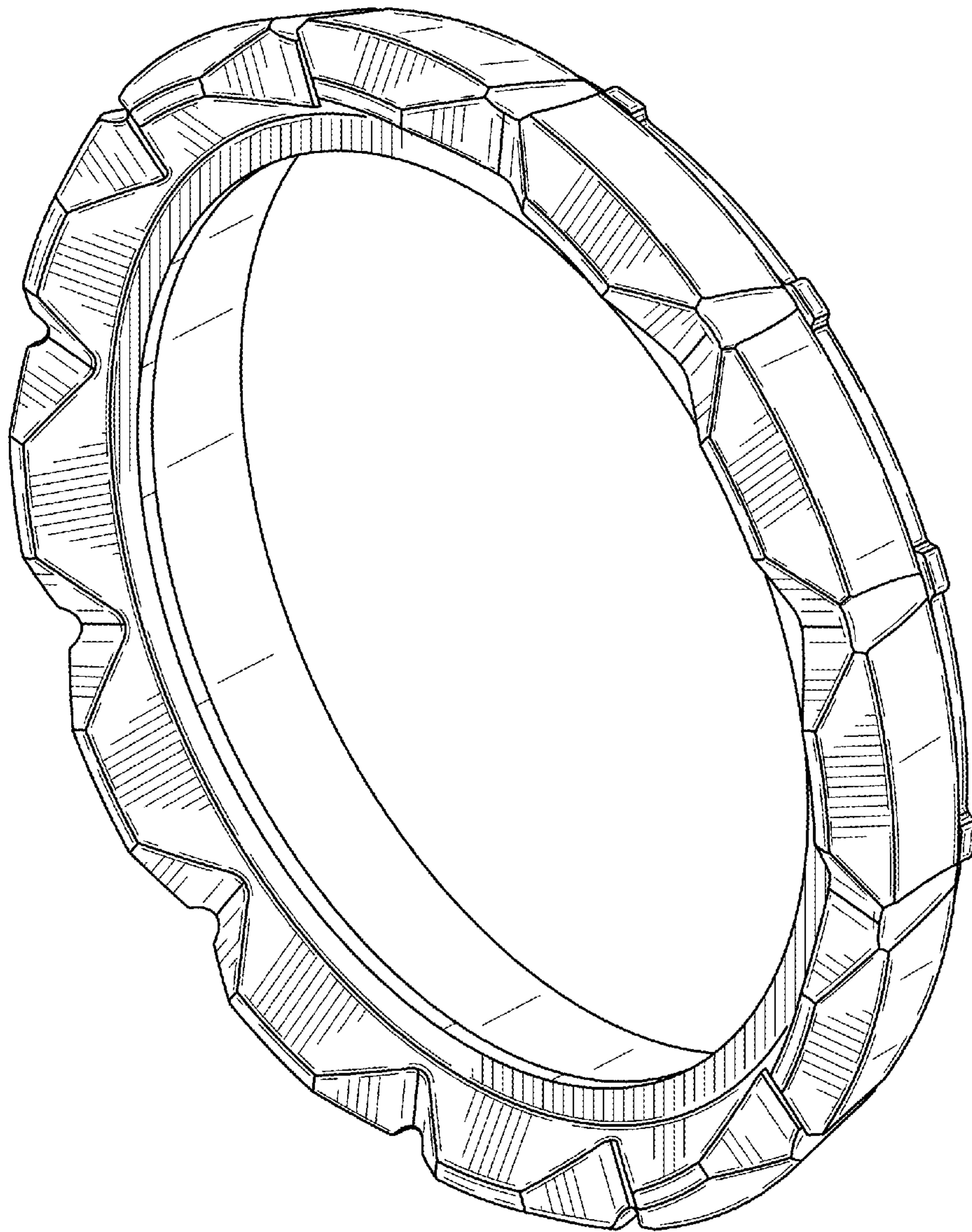

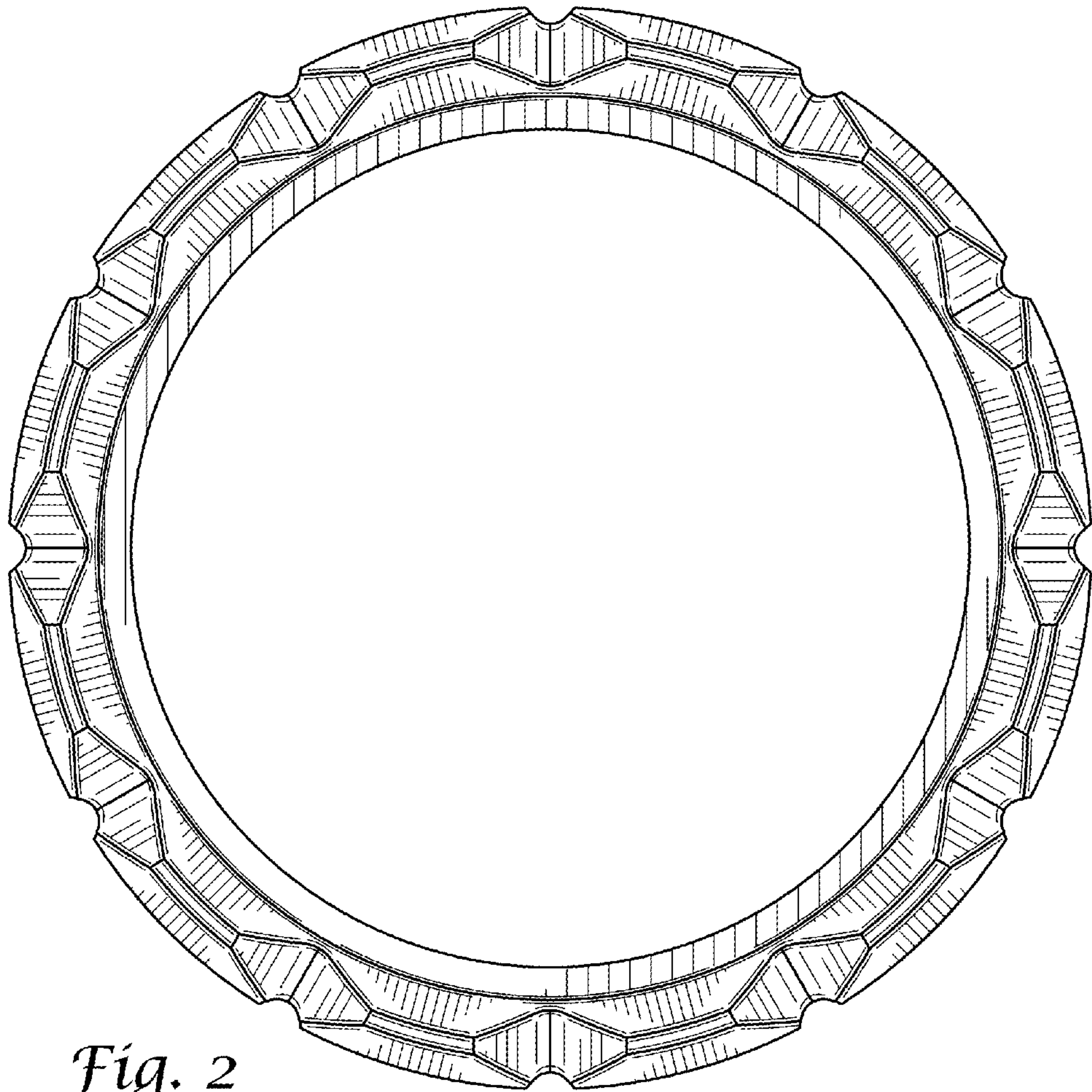

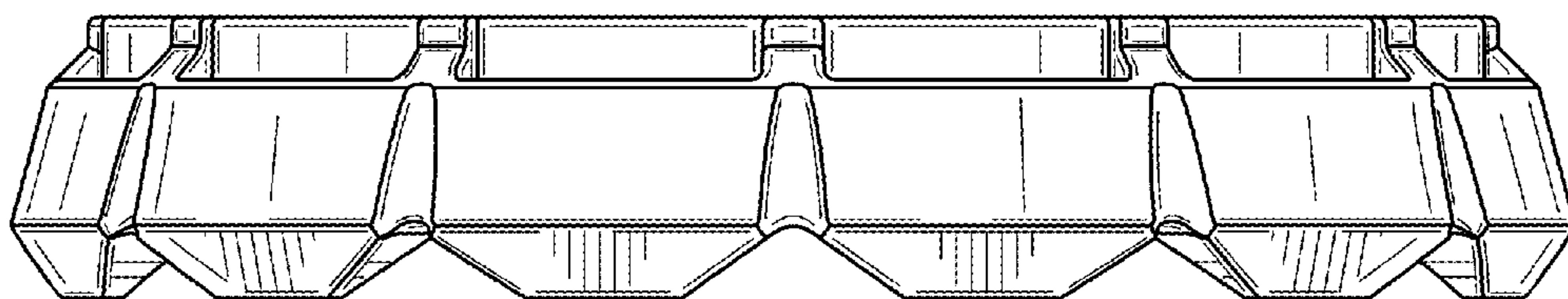

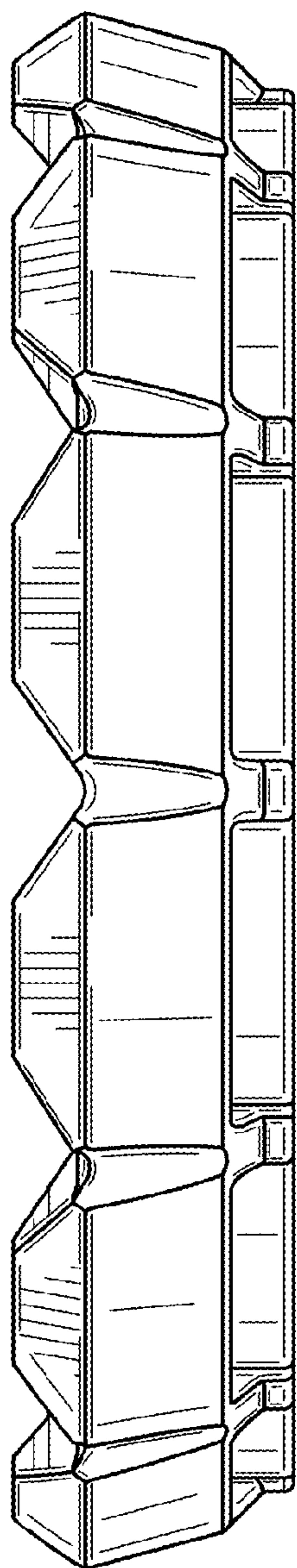

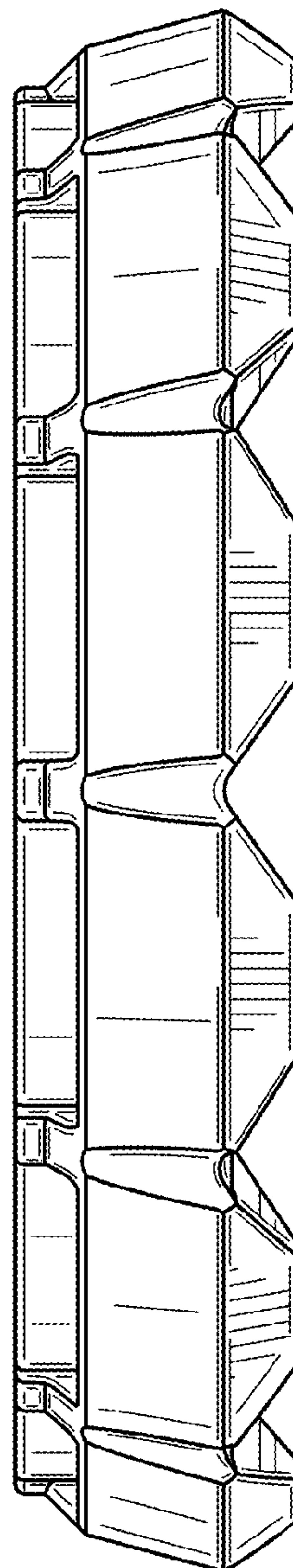

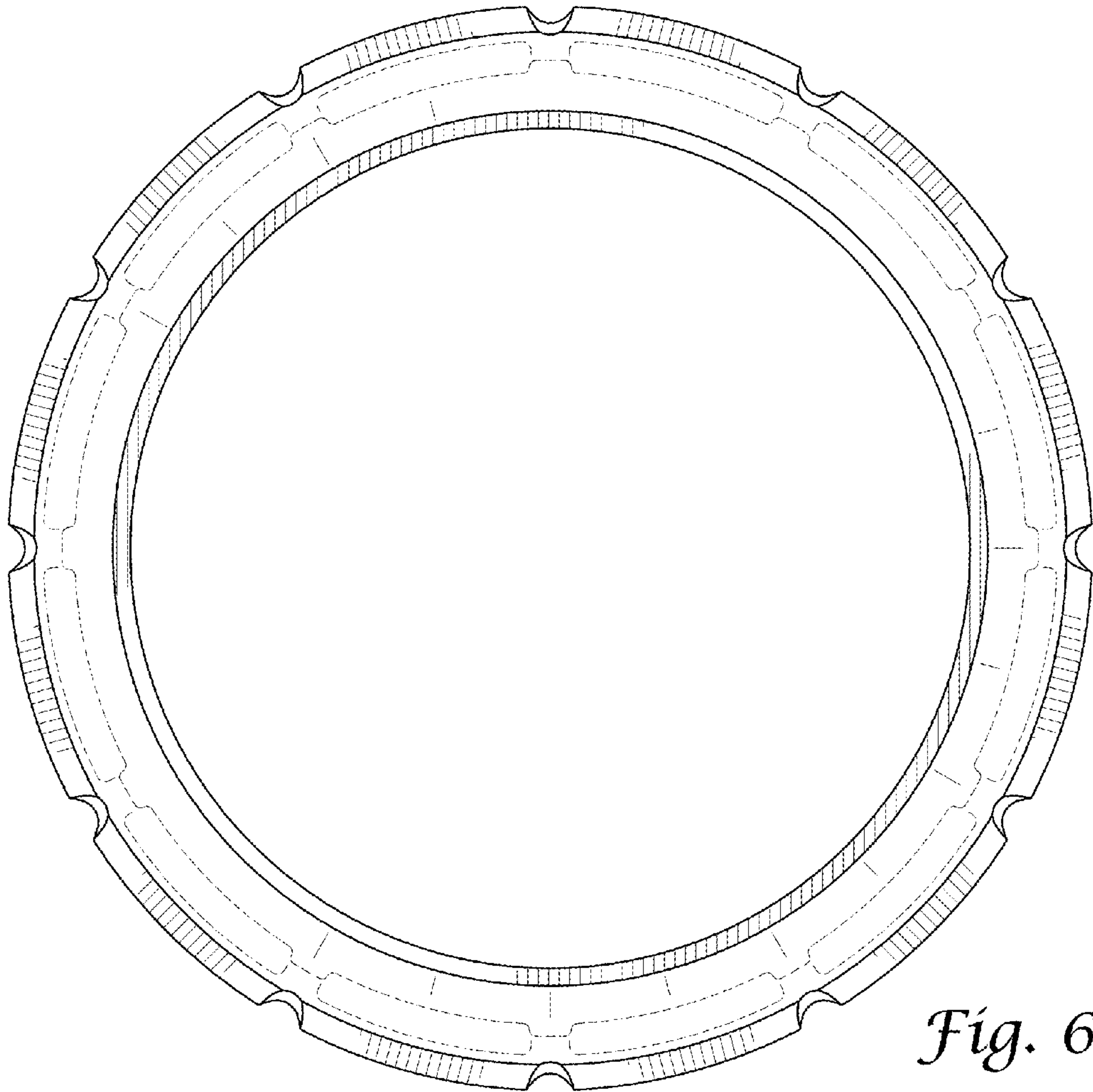

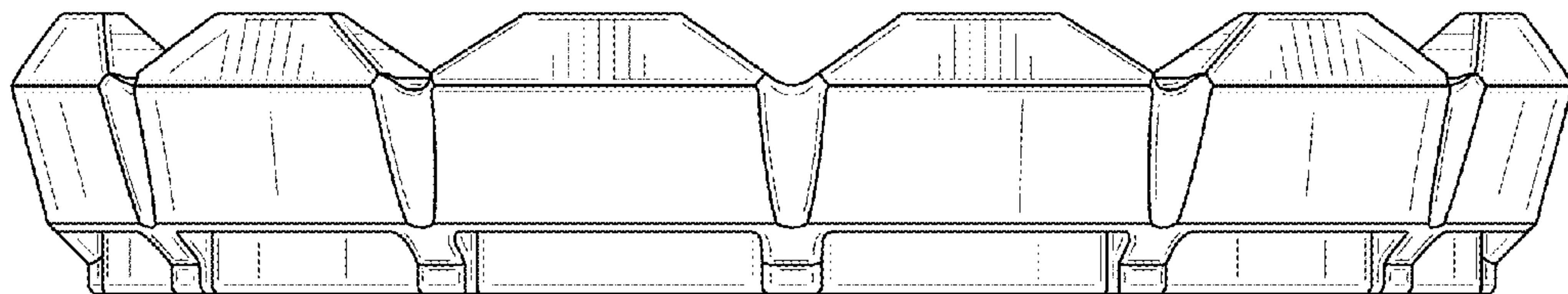

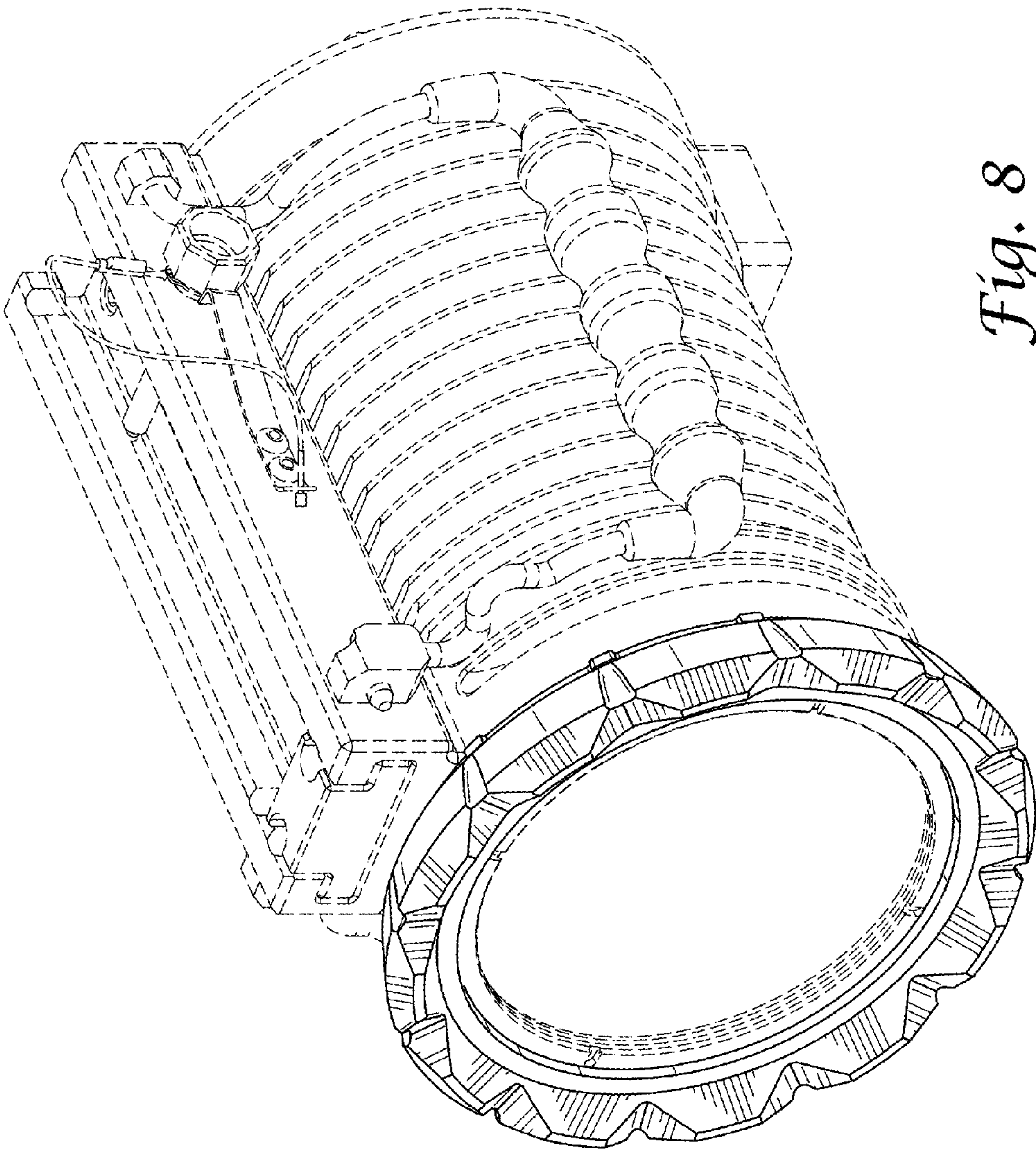
