FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof in a closed position;


FIG. 8 is a full left front perspective view of the new design in an open position; and,


FIG. 9 is a top left perspective view thereof showing the new design in an open position.


The elements shown in broken lines form no part of the claimed design.


The article is shown with a symbolic break in its length. The appearance of any portion of the article shown below the break lines forms no part of the claimed design.






