FIG. 4 is a side view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

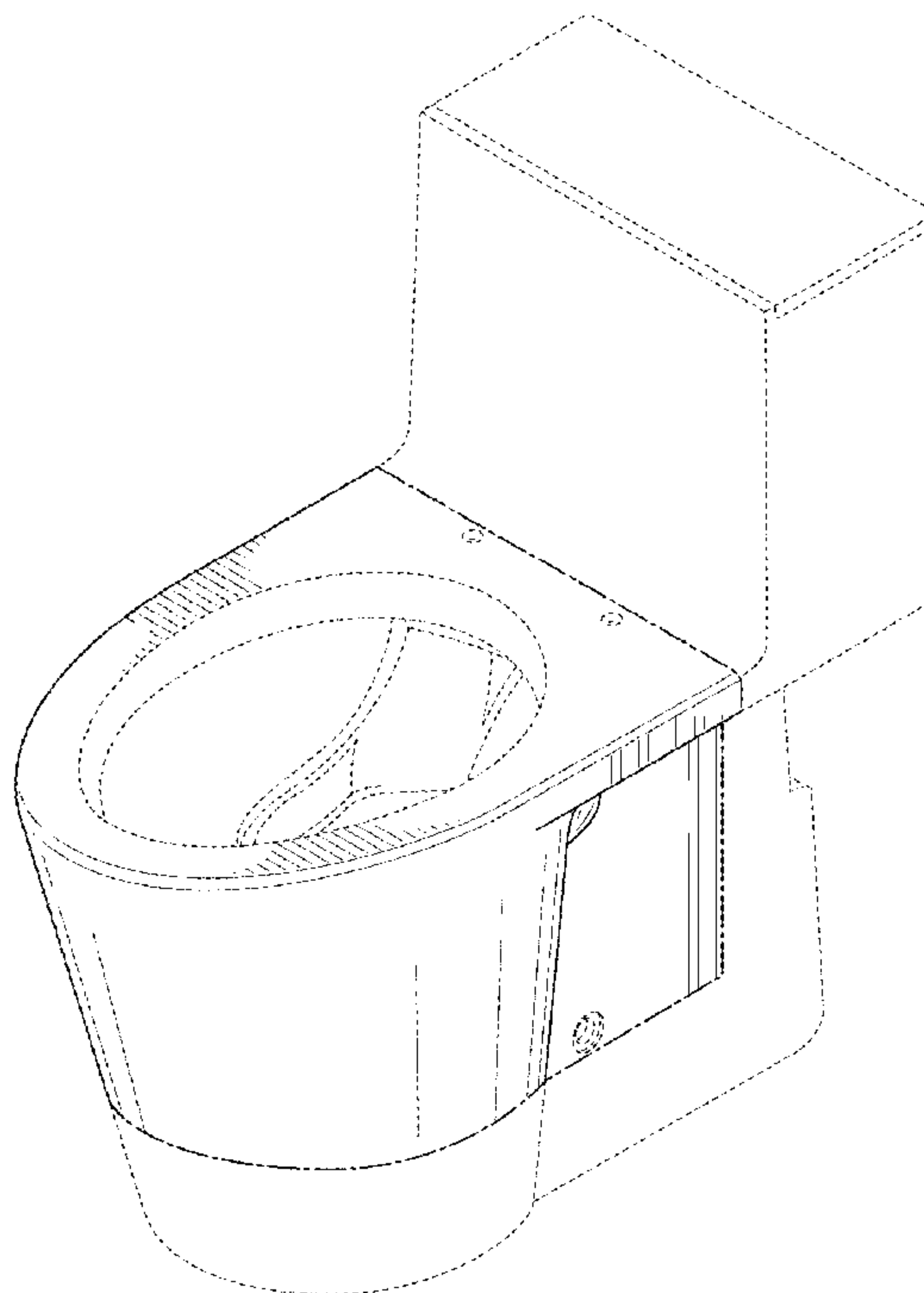
FIG. 5 is another side view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

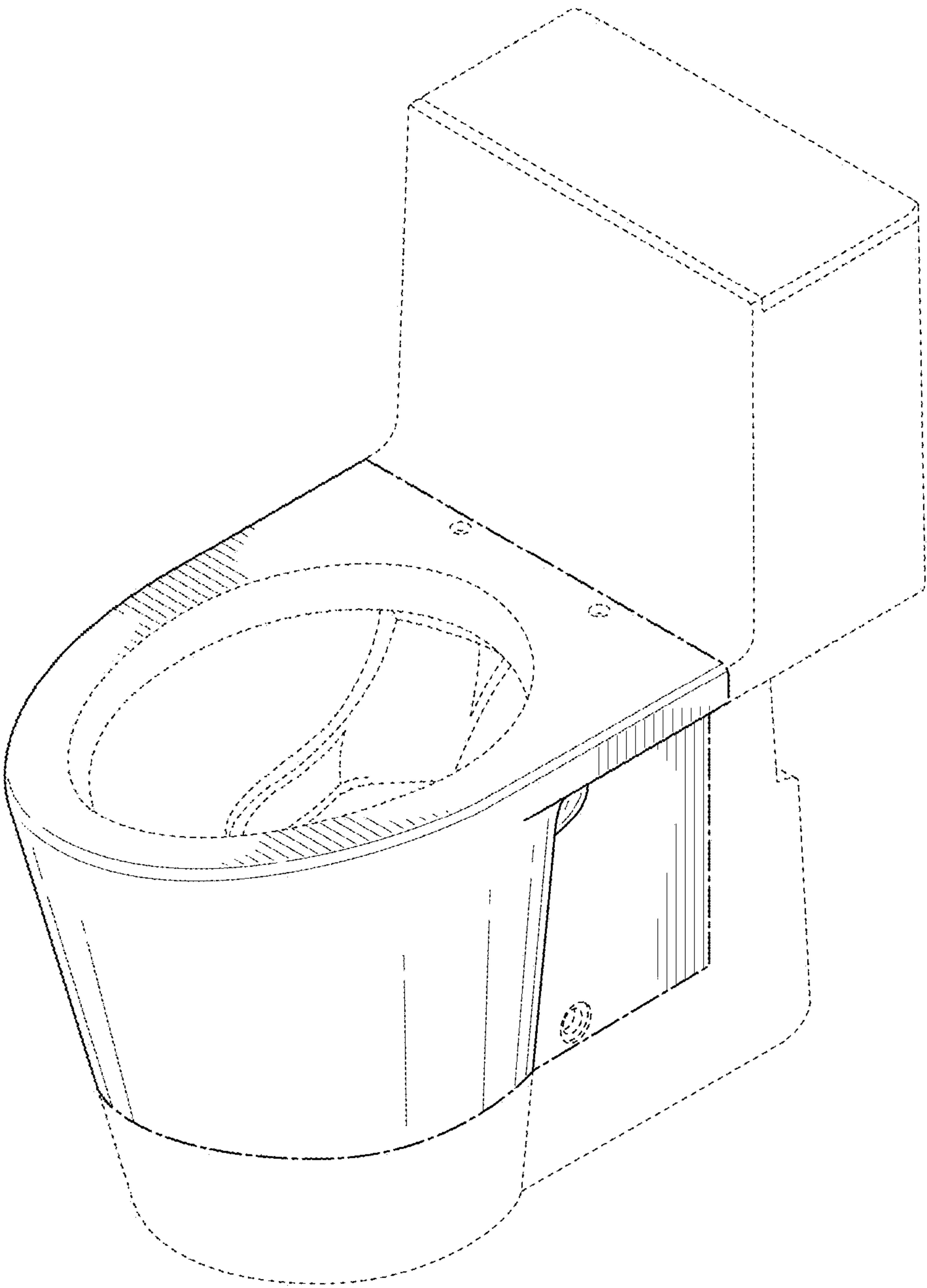

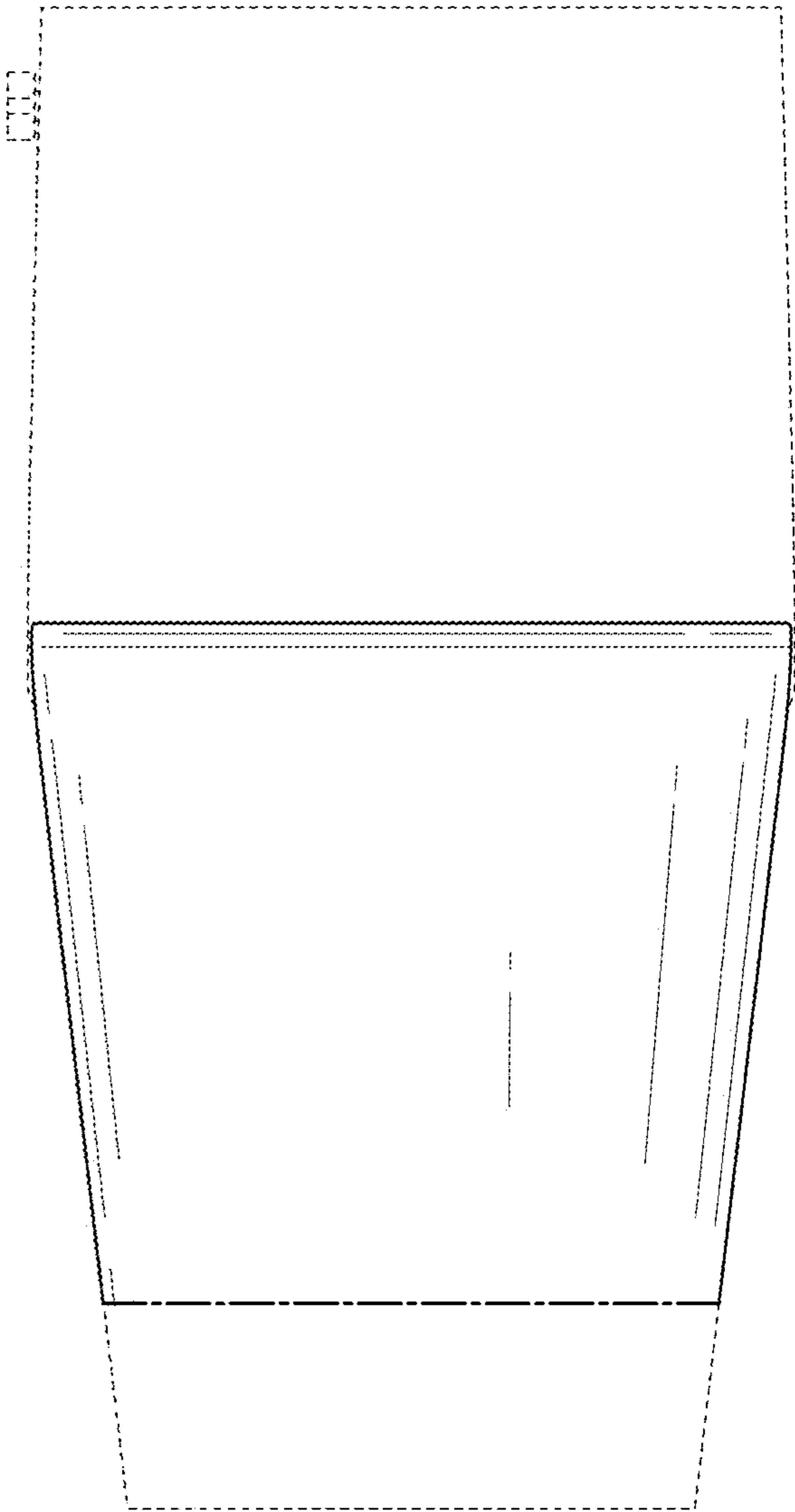

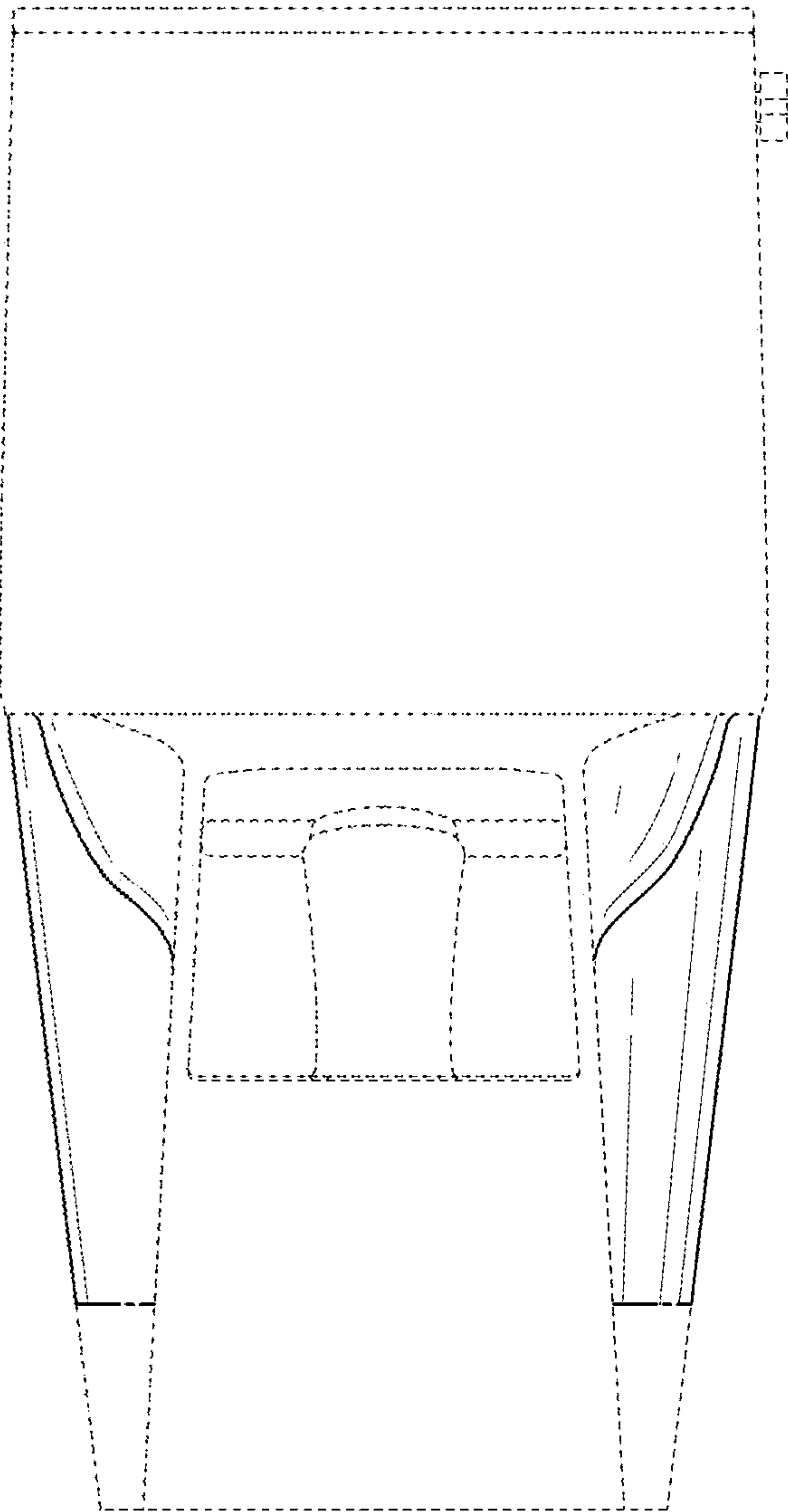

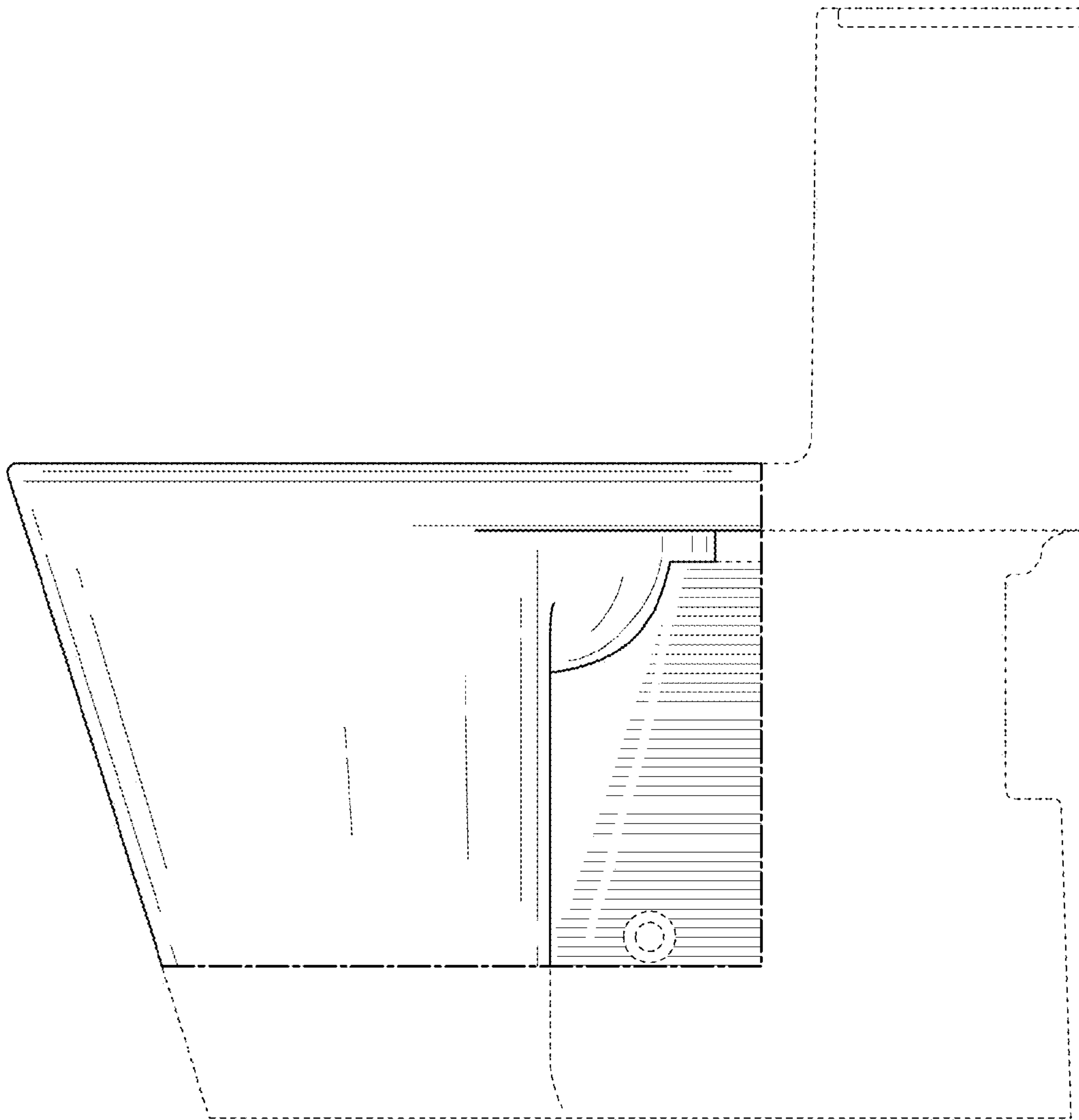

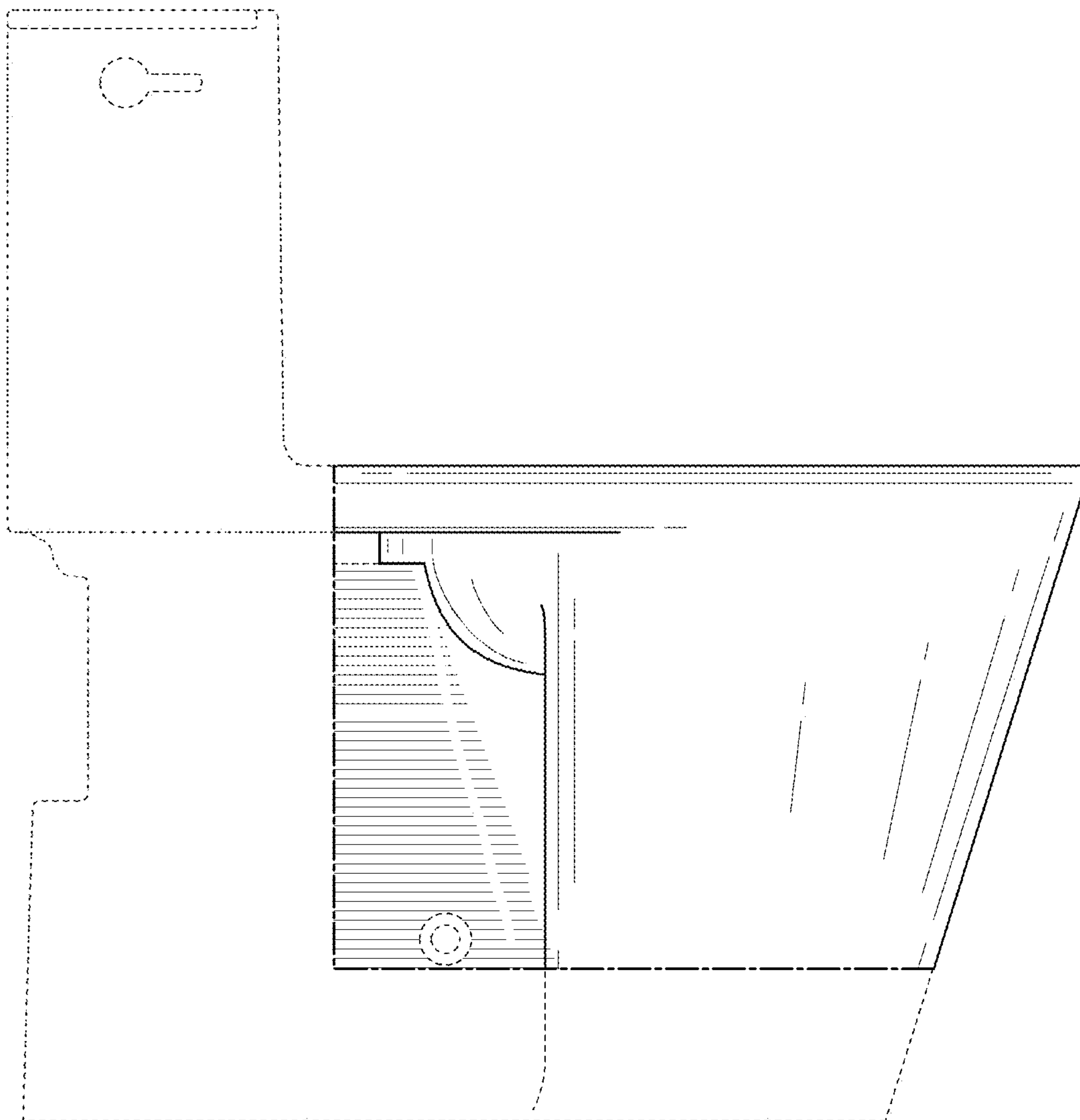

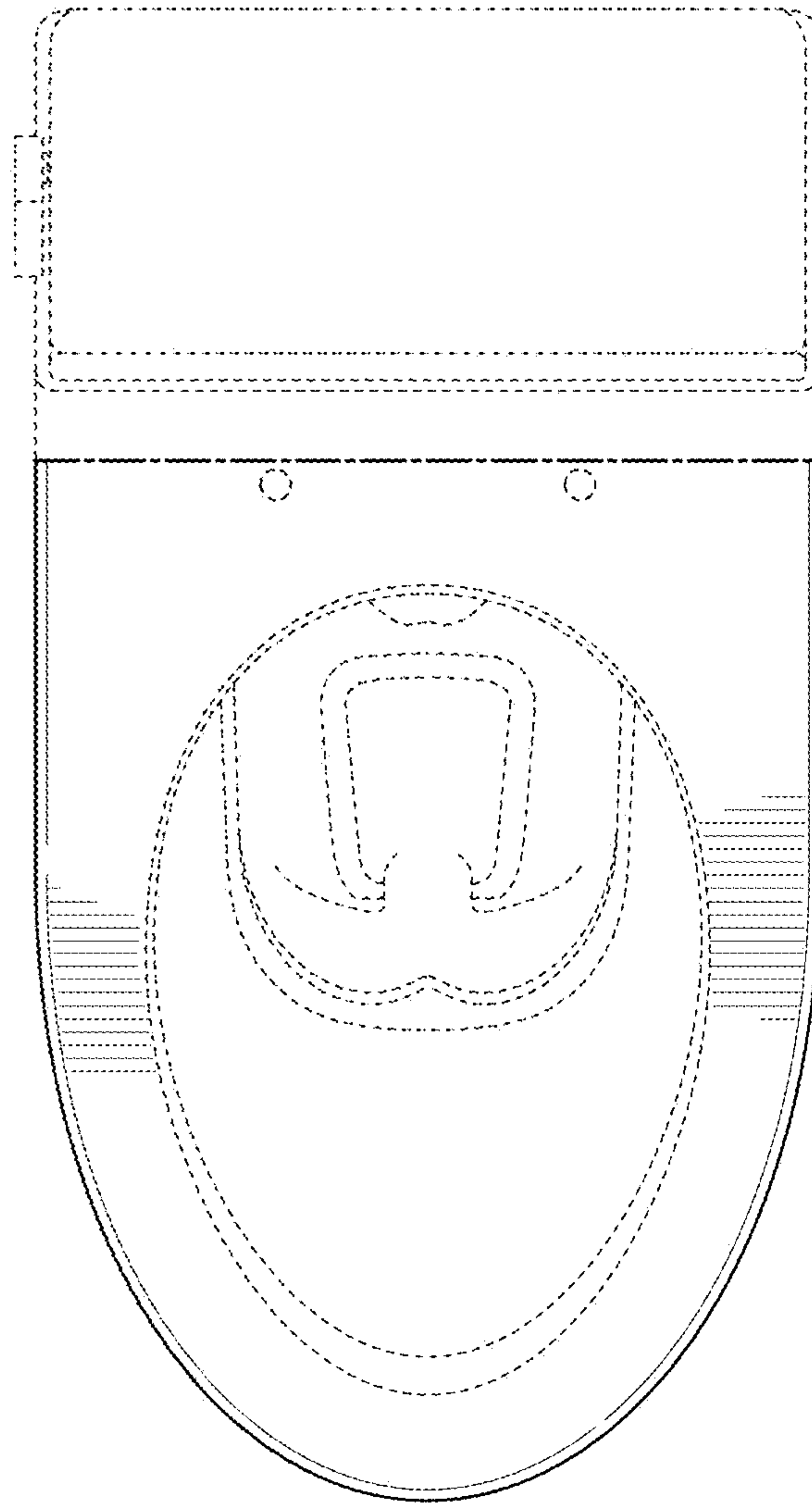

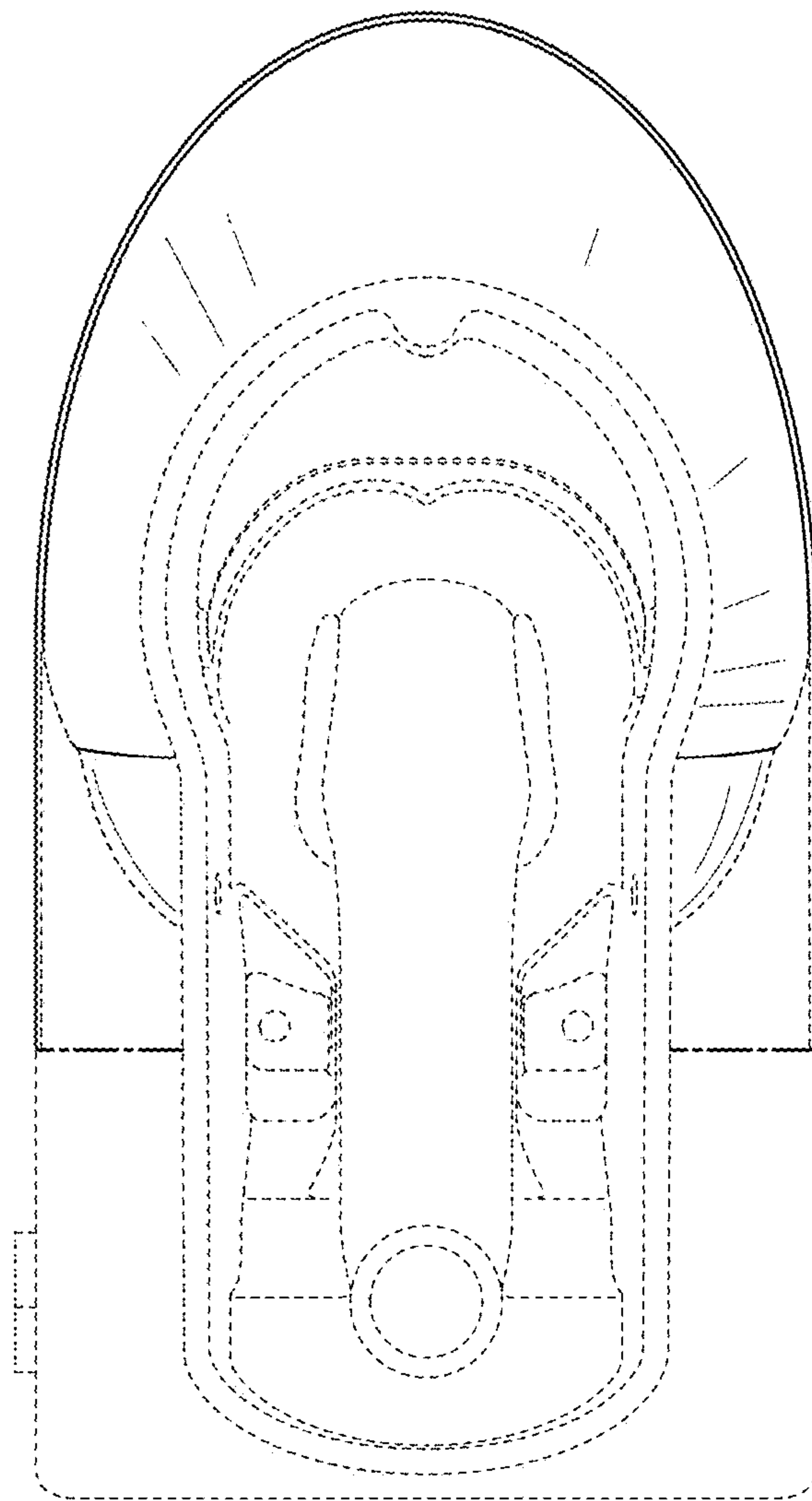
