FIG. 5 is an enlarged rear elevational view of the platform shuttle;

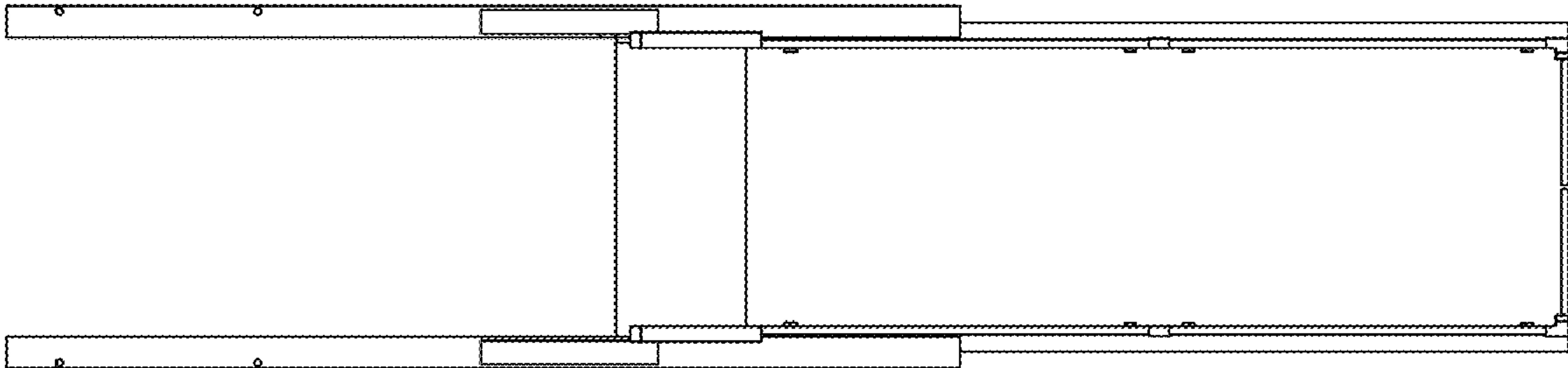
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the platform shuttle;

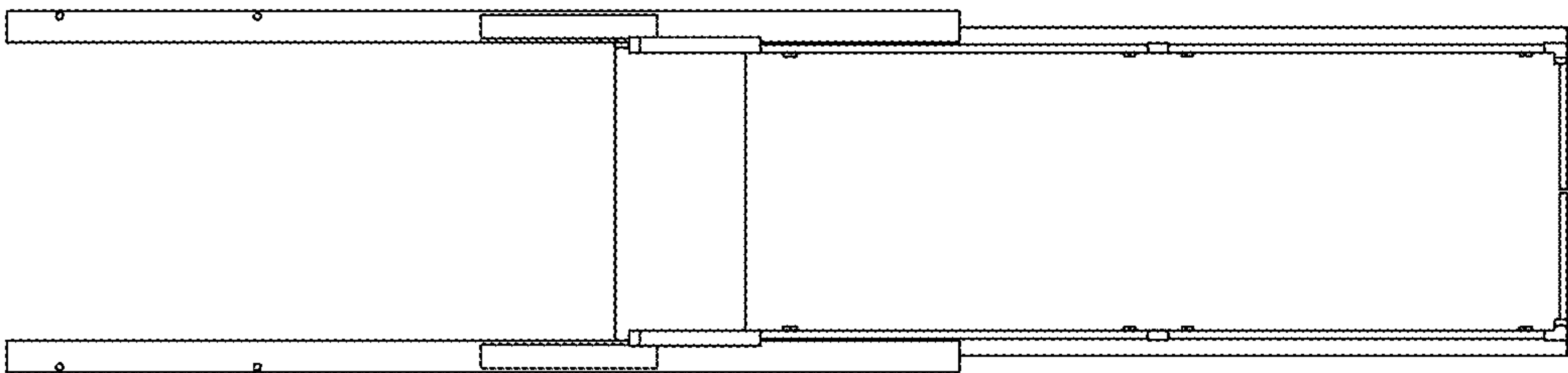

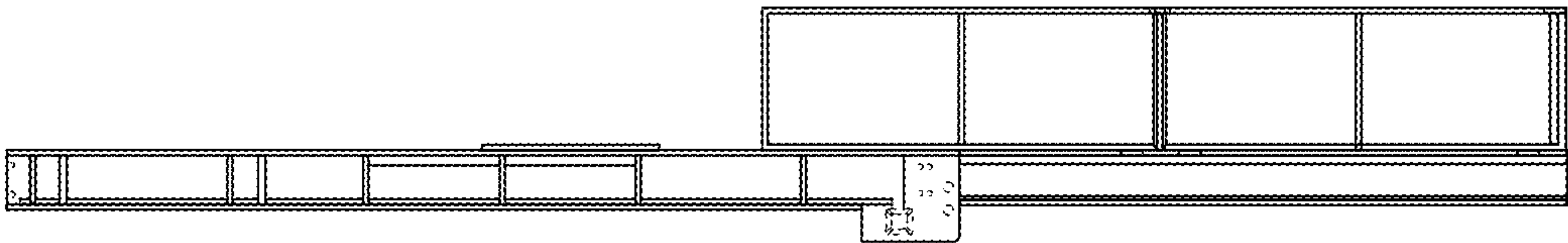

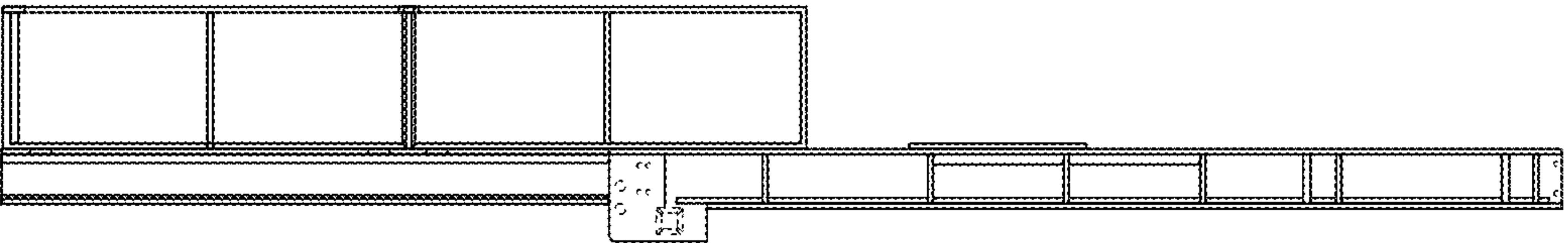

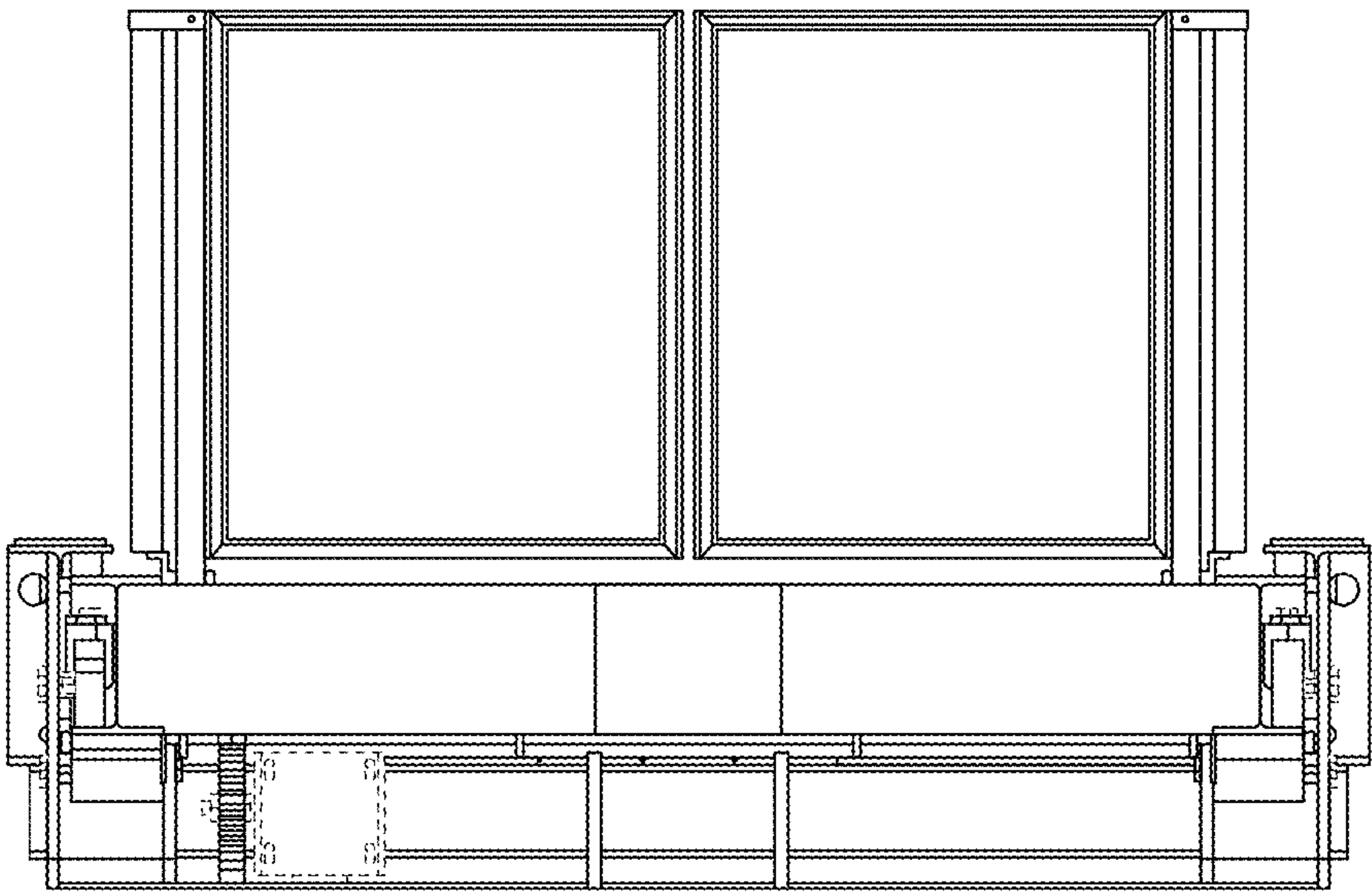

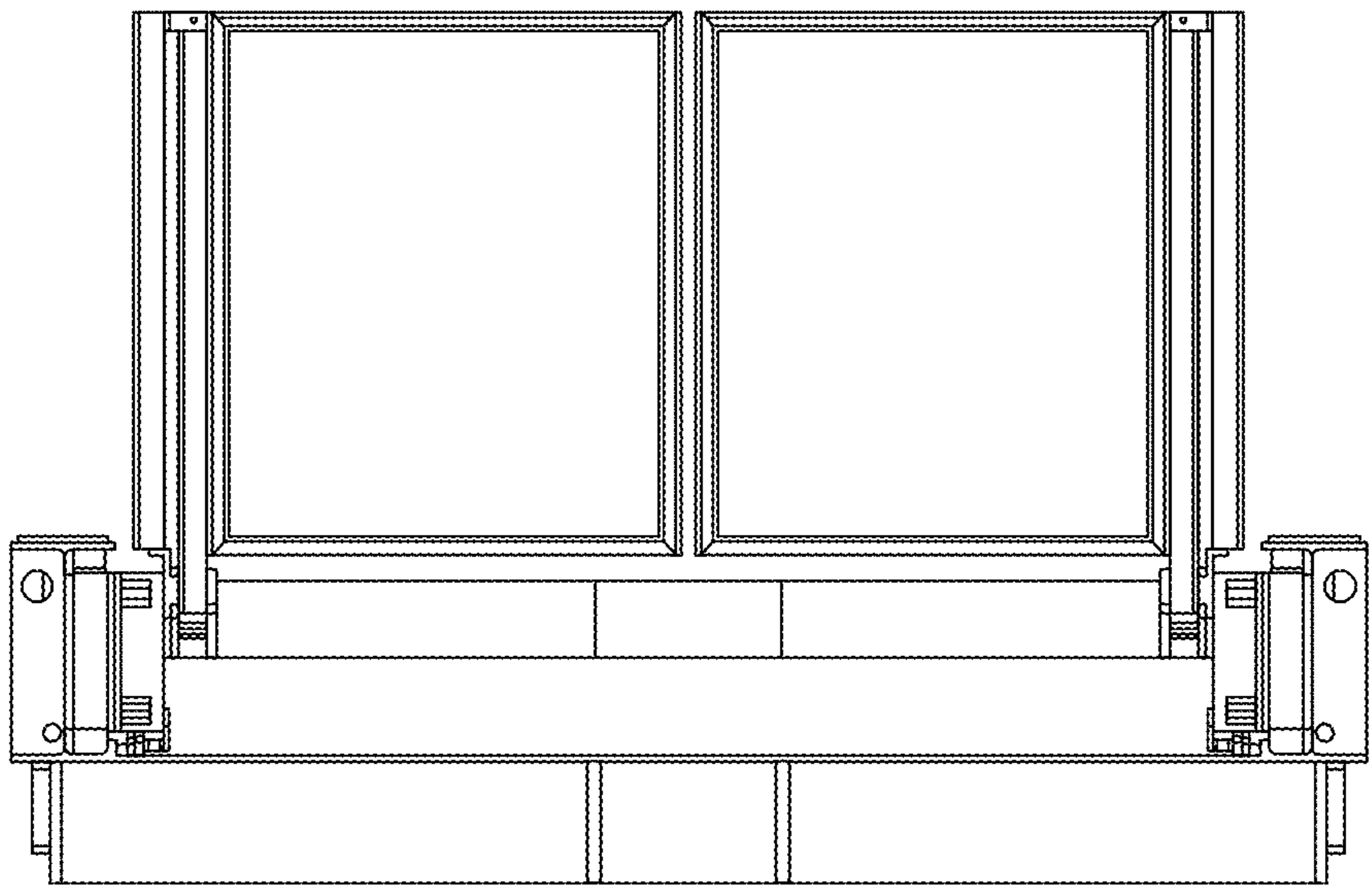

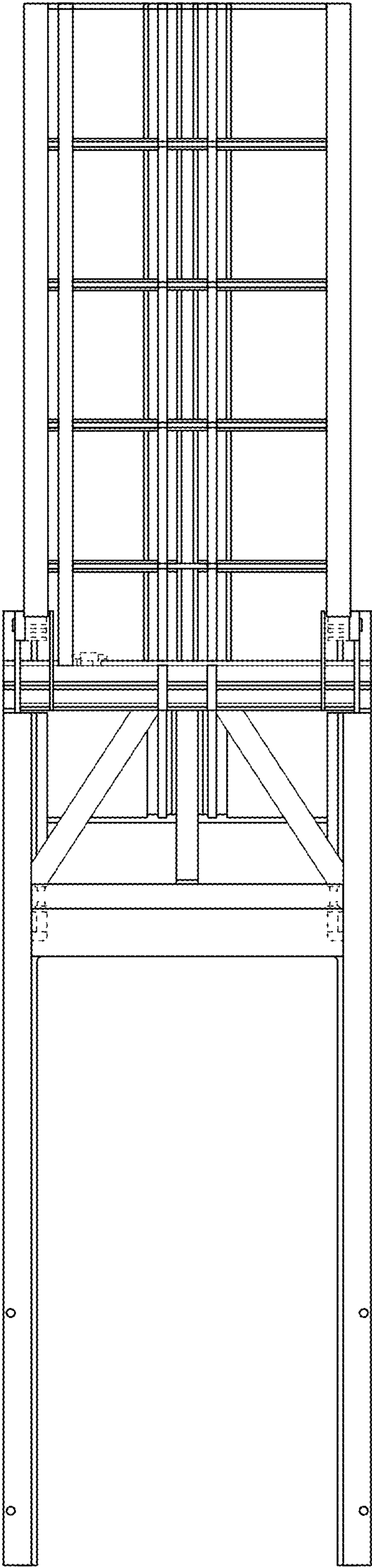

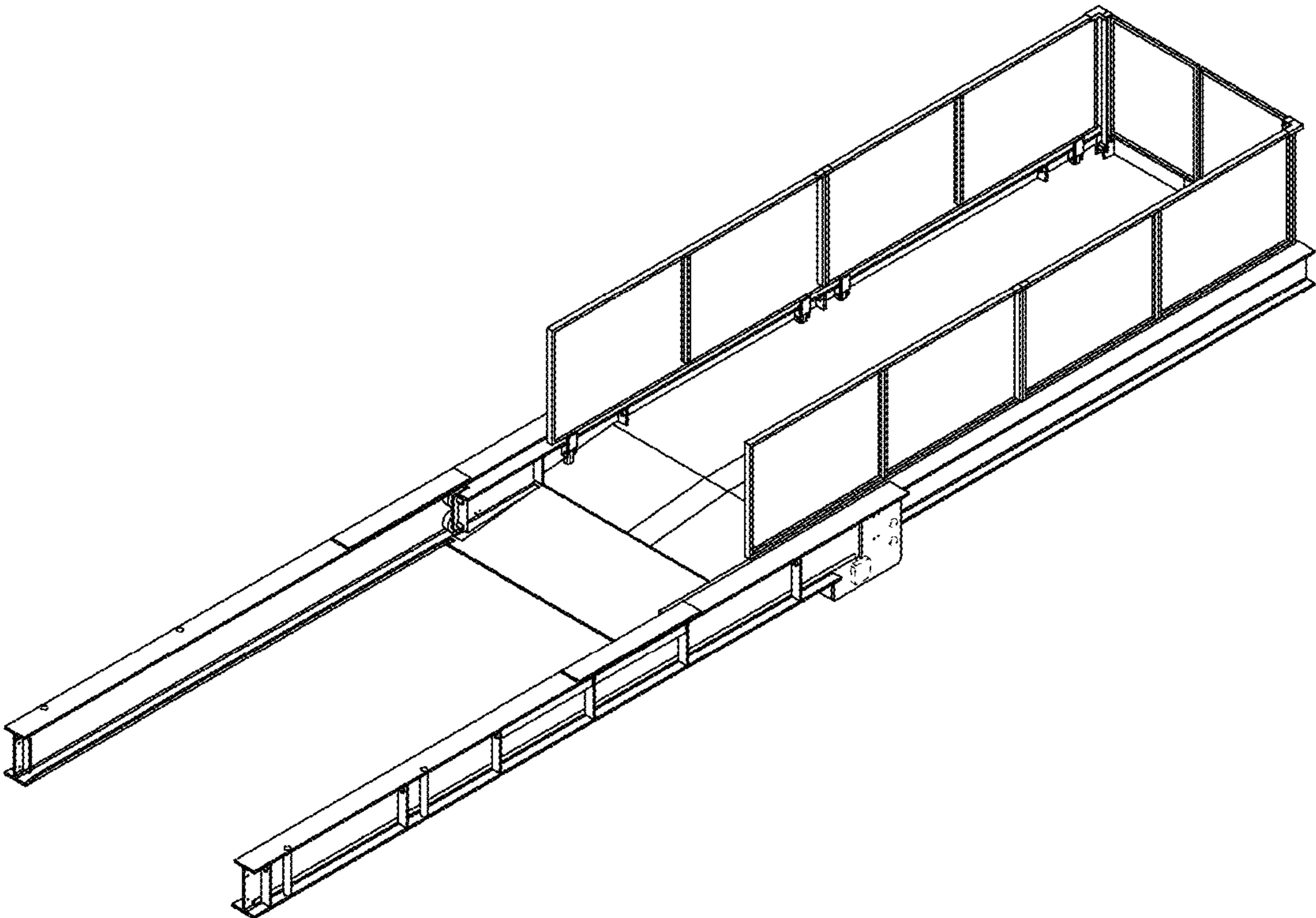

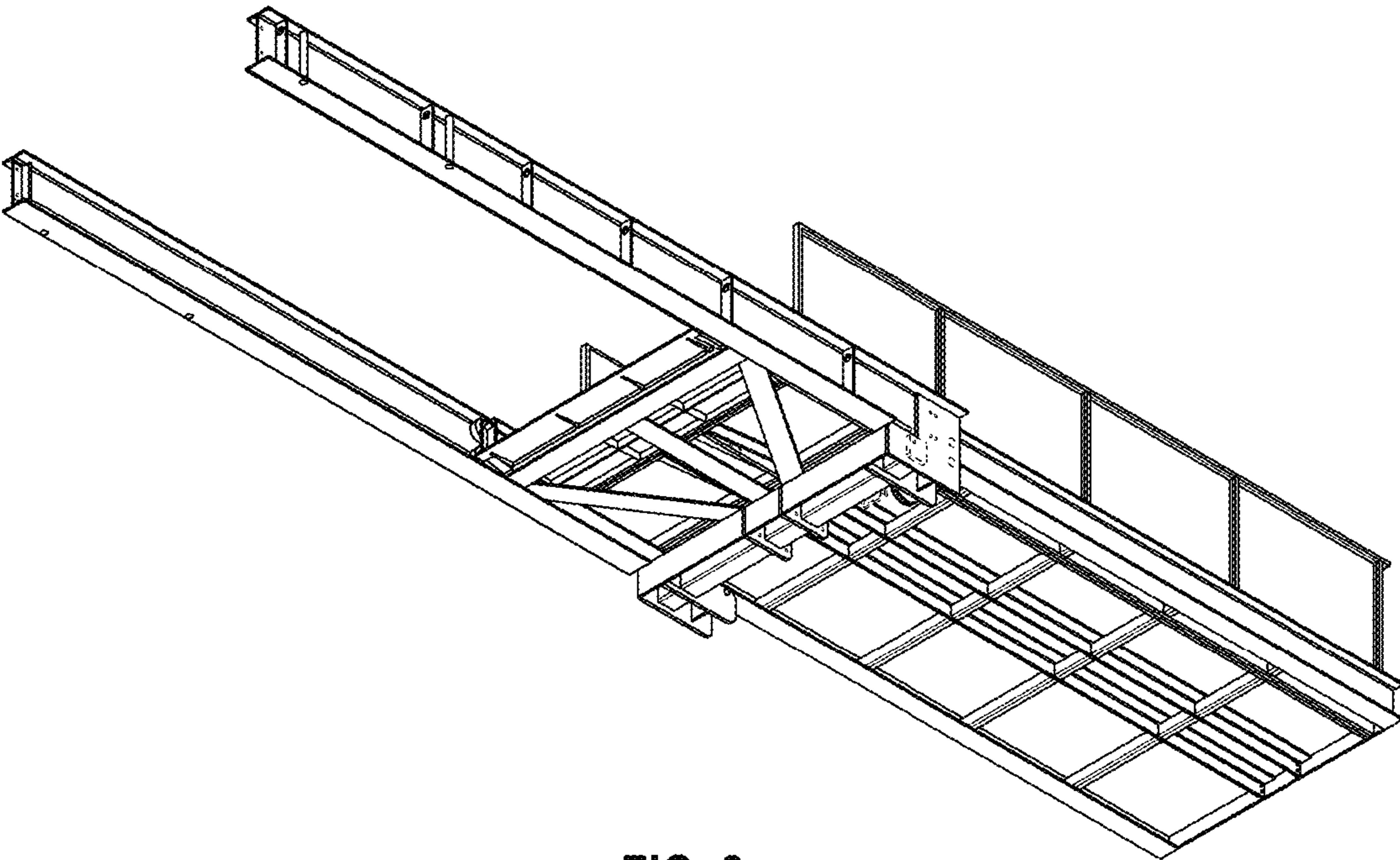
