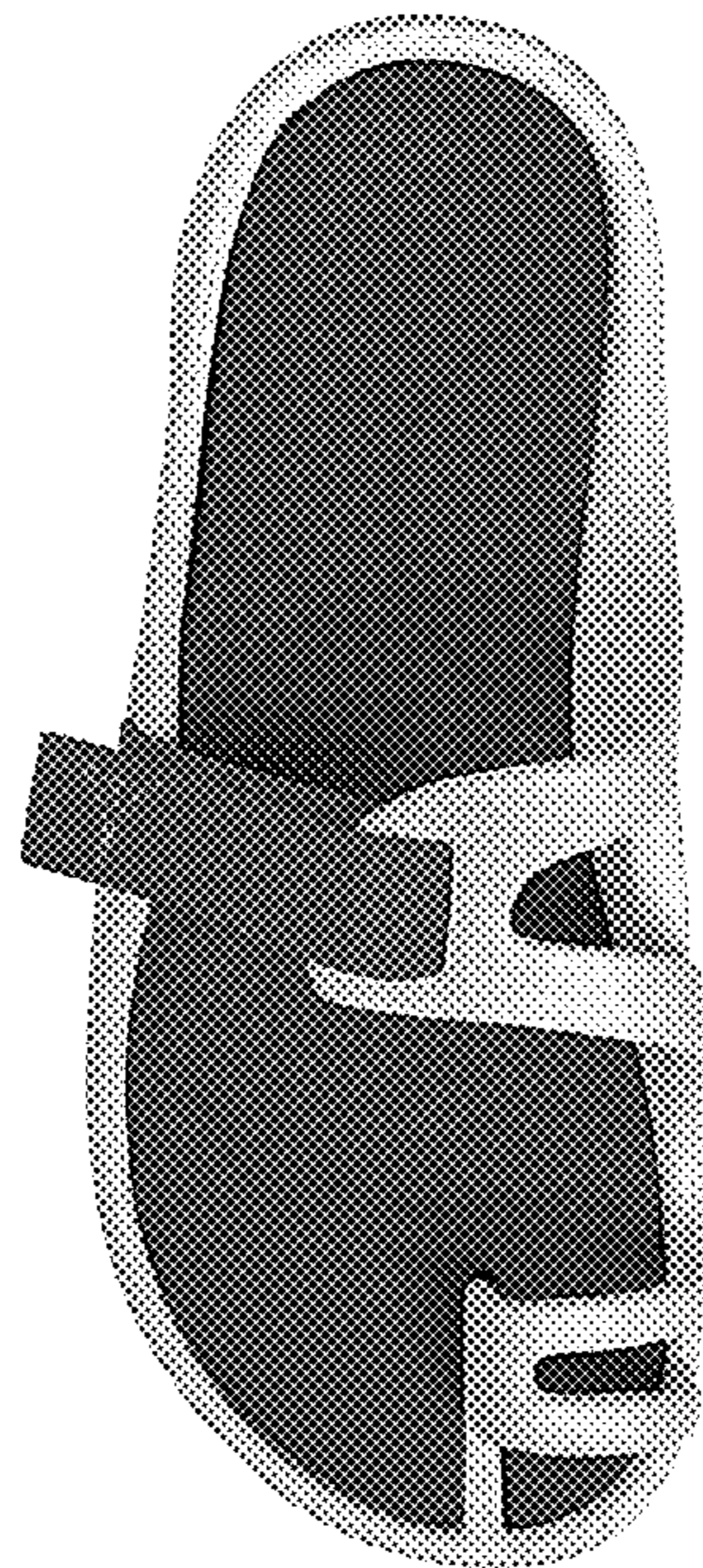
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an orthopedic sandal, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an orthopedic sandal showing my new design.
FIG. 2 is a top, left side view of the orthopedic sandal.
FIG. 3 is a top, right side view of the orthopedic sandal.
FIG. 4 is an enlarged rear view of the orthopedic sandal.
FIG. 5 is a top, plan view of a second embodiment of the orthopedic sandal.
FIG. 6 is a top, left side view of the orthopedic sandal.
FIG. 7 is a top, right side view of the orthopedic sandal.
FIG. 8 is an enlarged rear view of the orthopedic sandal.
FIG. 9 is a bottom view for the first embodiment of the orthopedic sandal; and,
FIG. 10 is a bottom view for the second embodiment of the orthopedic sandal.
The broken lines seen on the strap in FIGS. 1, 3-5, 7, and 8 represent a corporate trademark that is owned by the applicant and is not part of the claimed design.

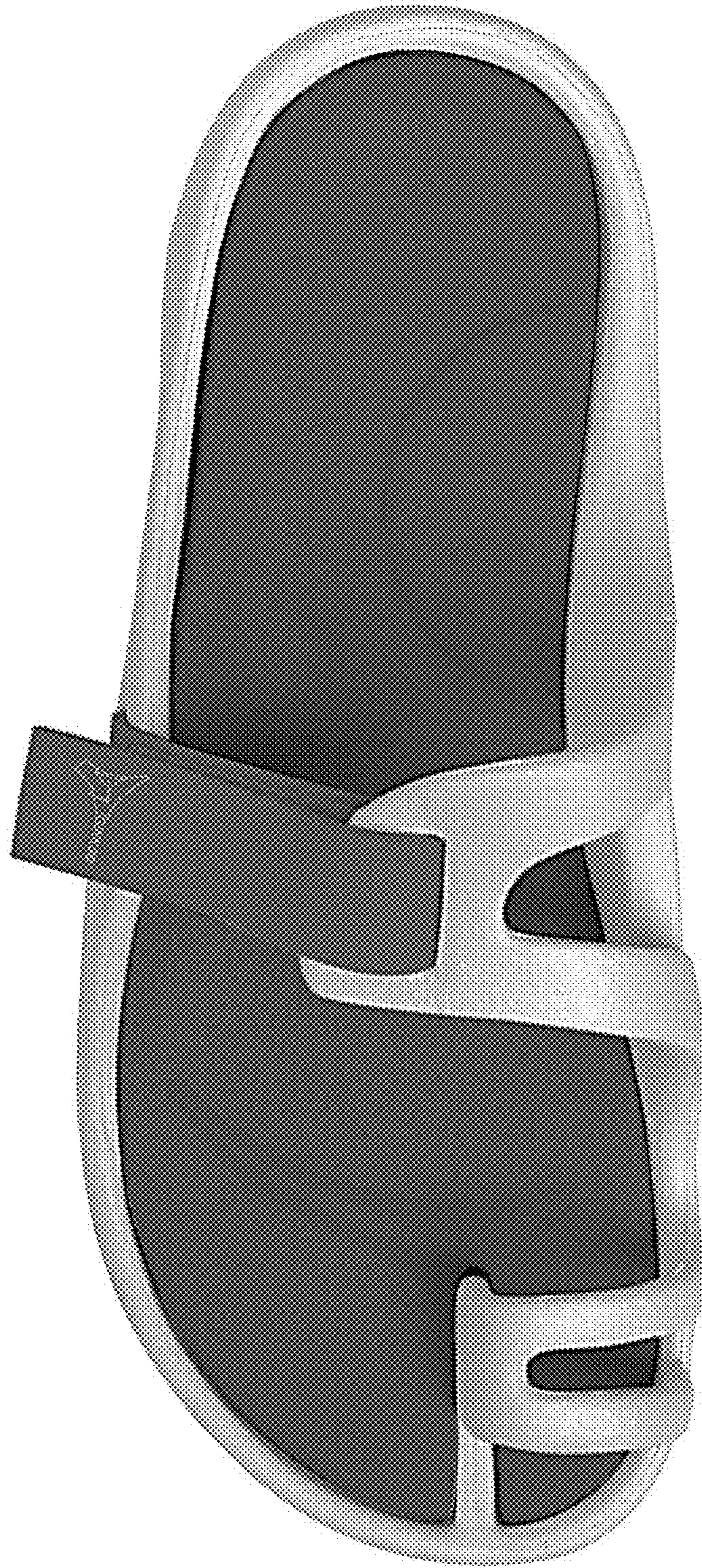

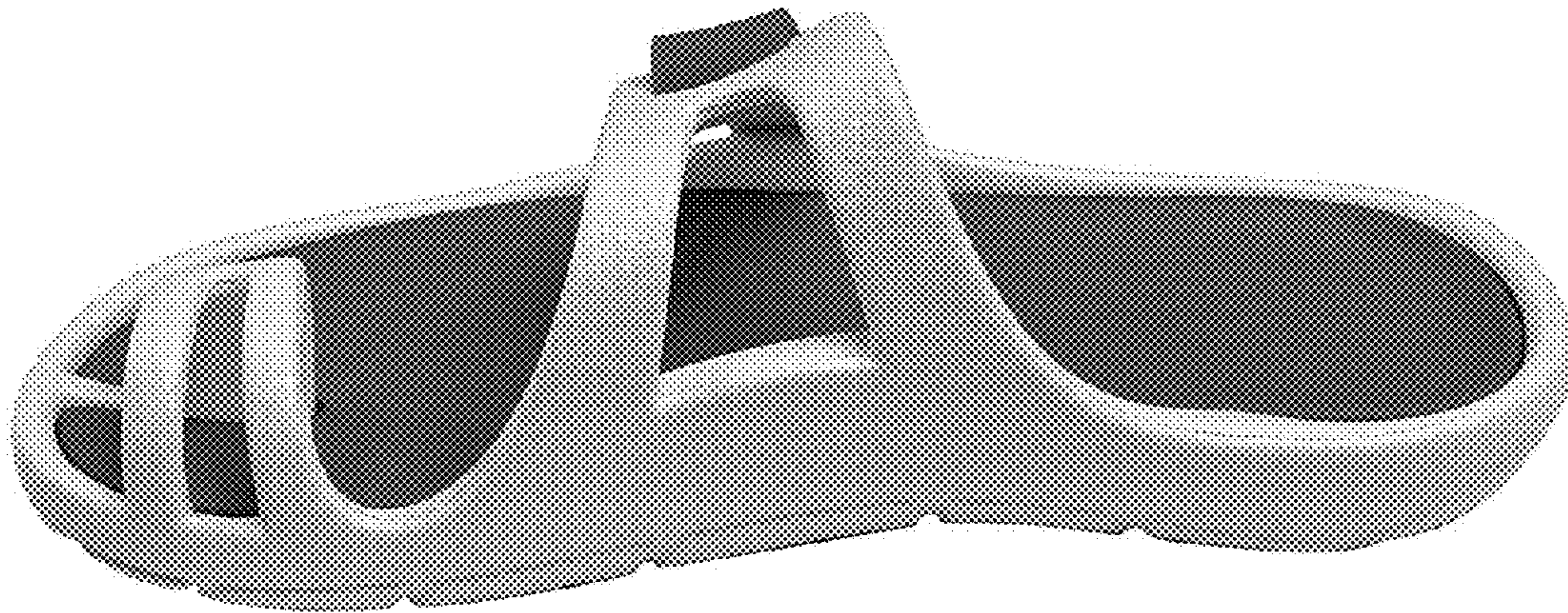

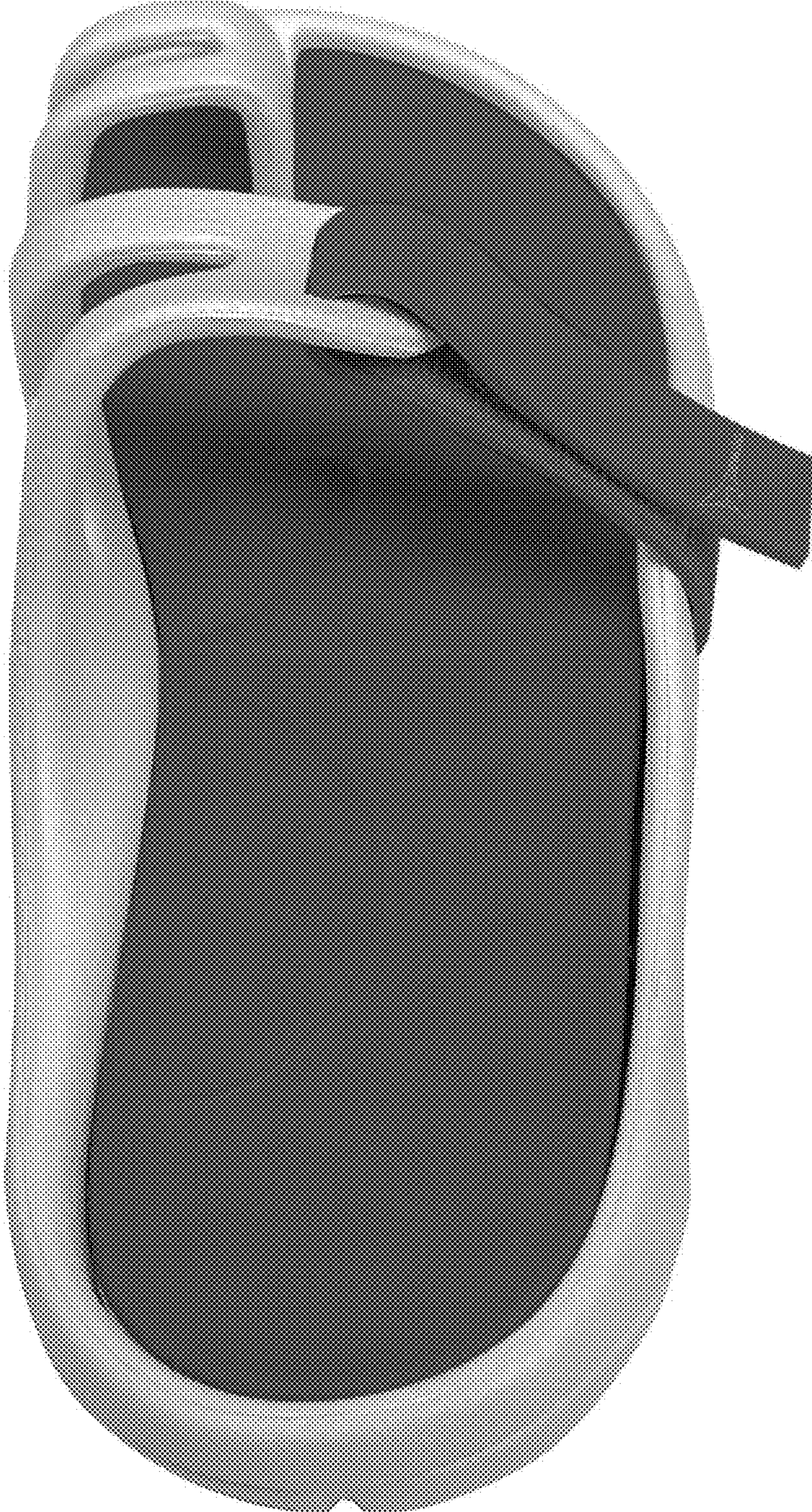

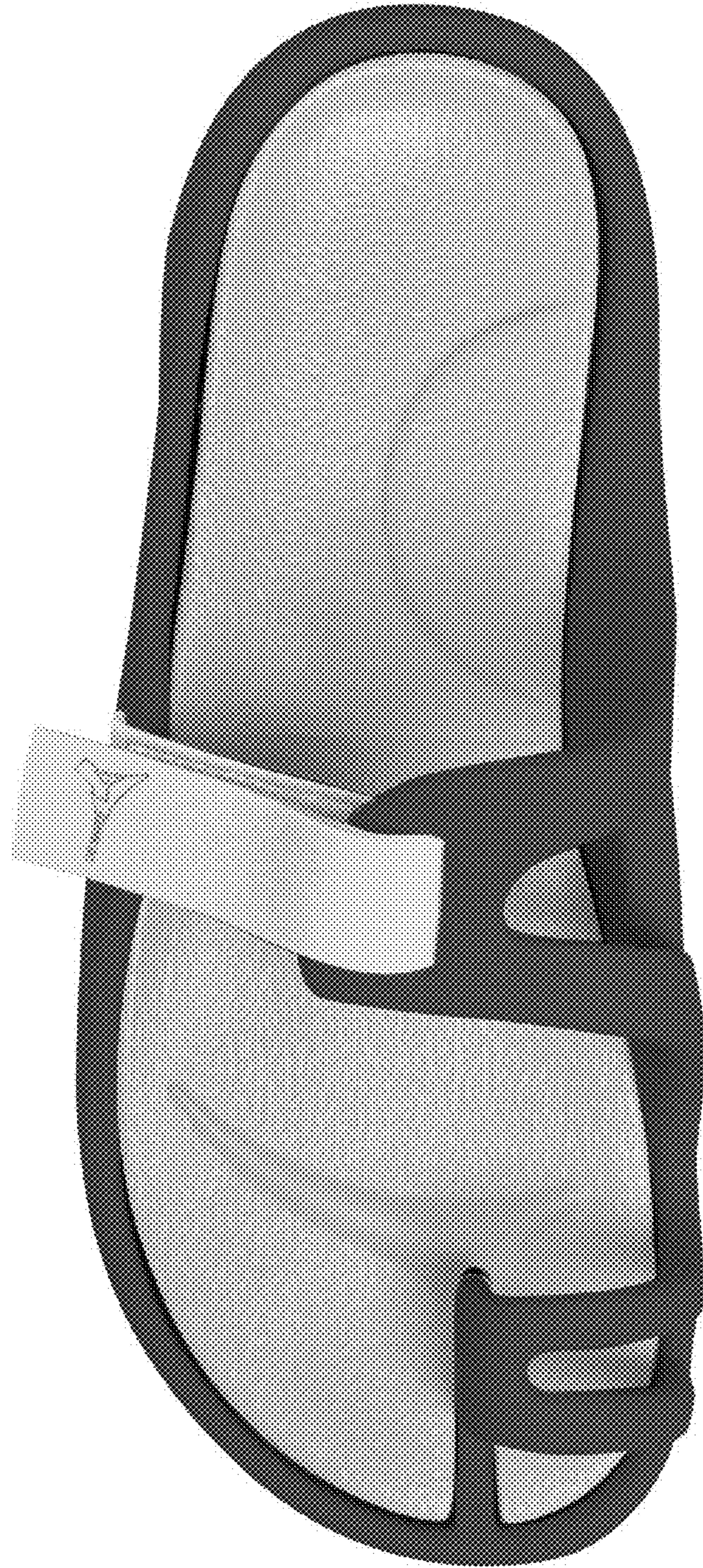

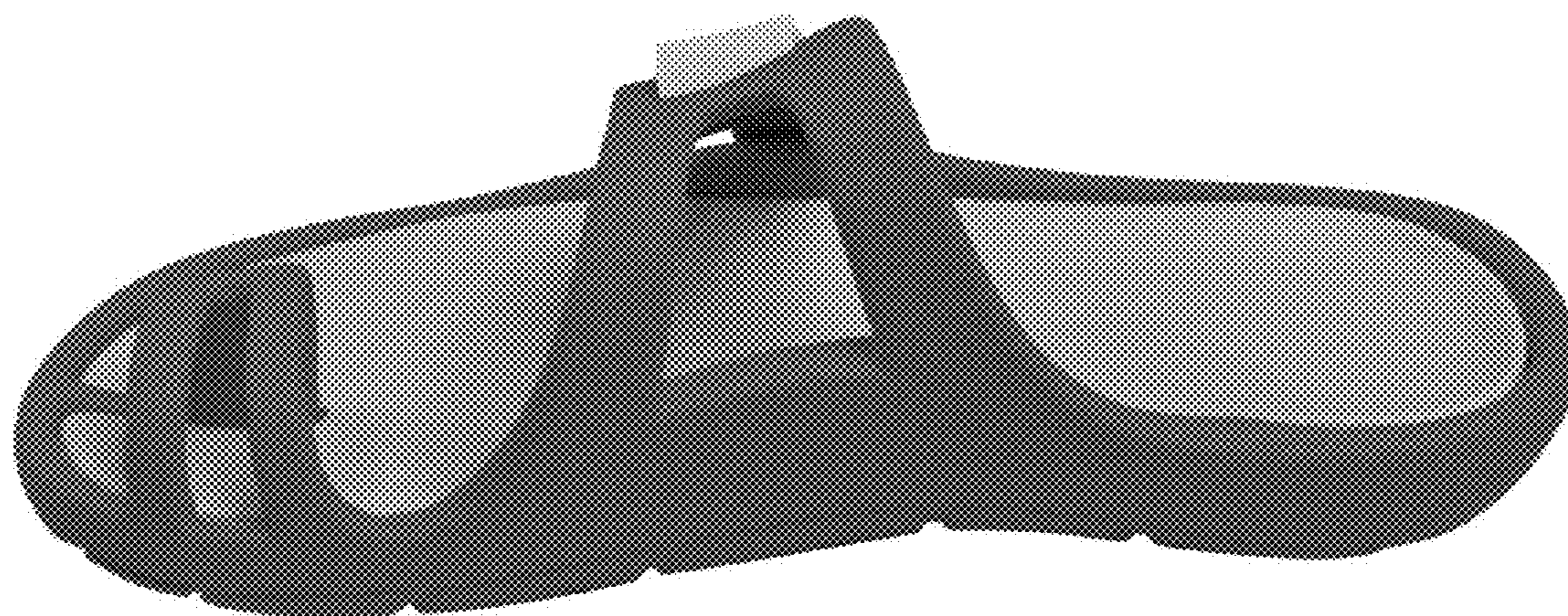

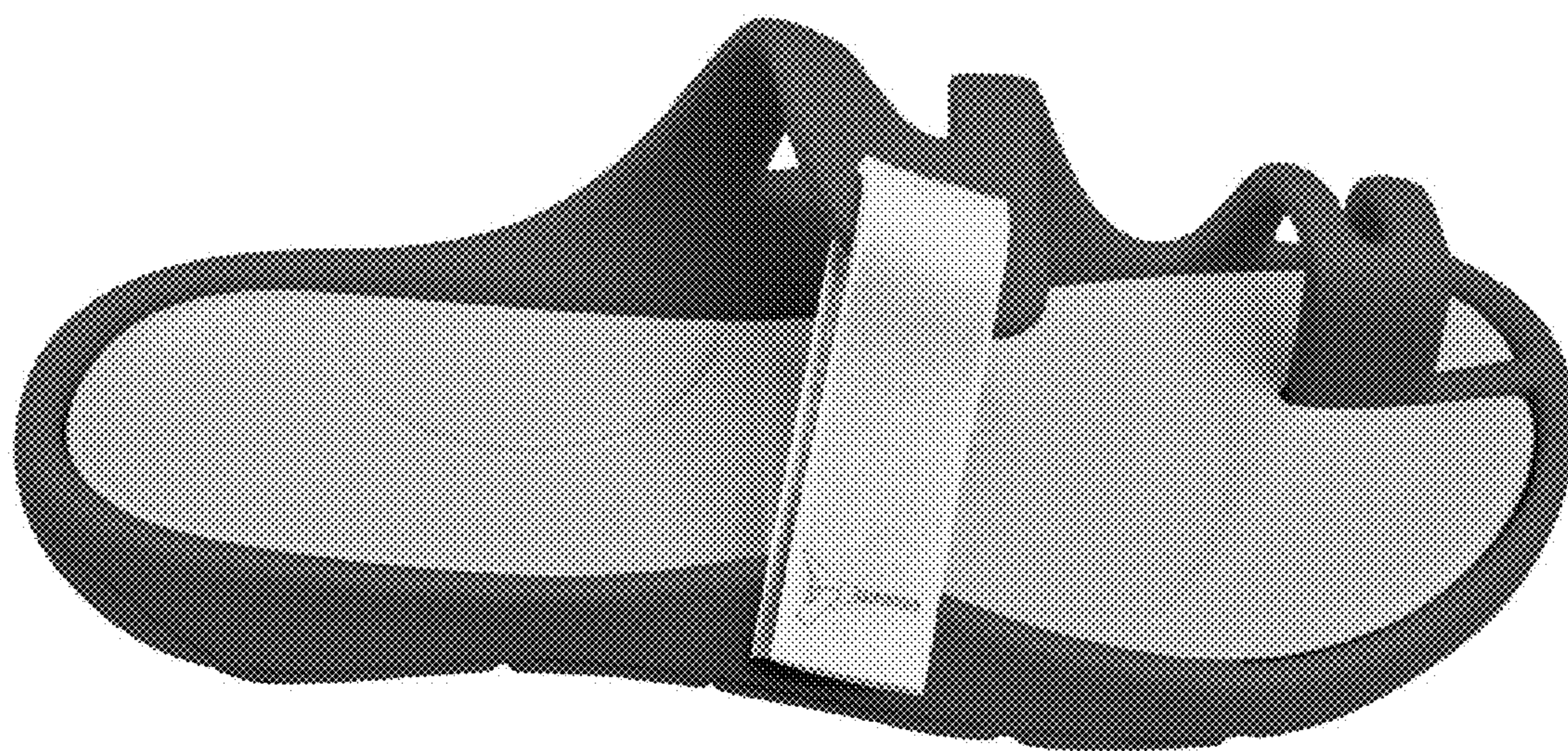
