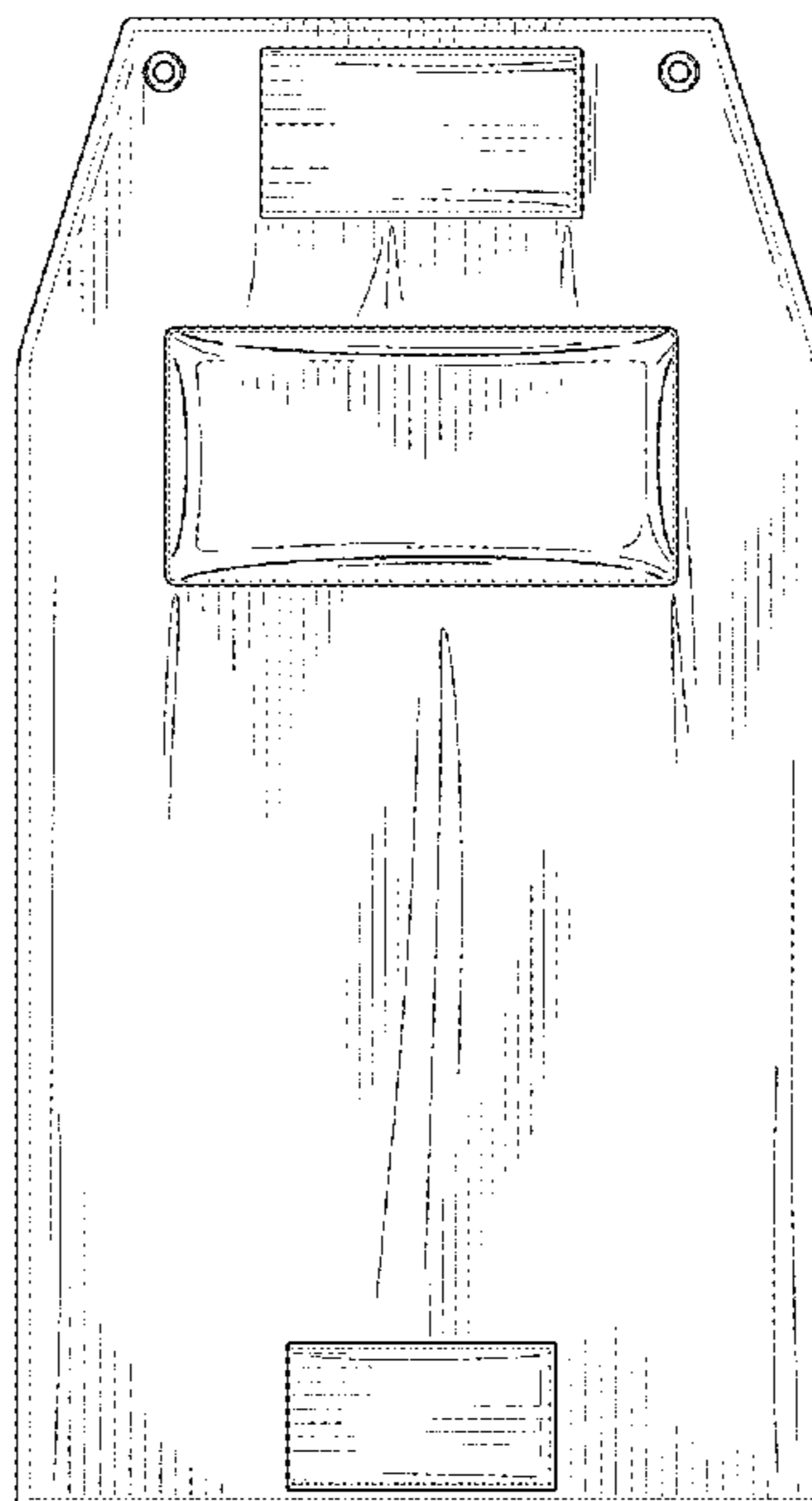

The ornamental design for a bench towel, as shown and described herein.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front and side perspective view of a bench towel showing my new design; with the upper portions shown in a folded, draped position;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a back view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top side view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom side view thereof.
The short dot-dot broken lines represent stitching.

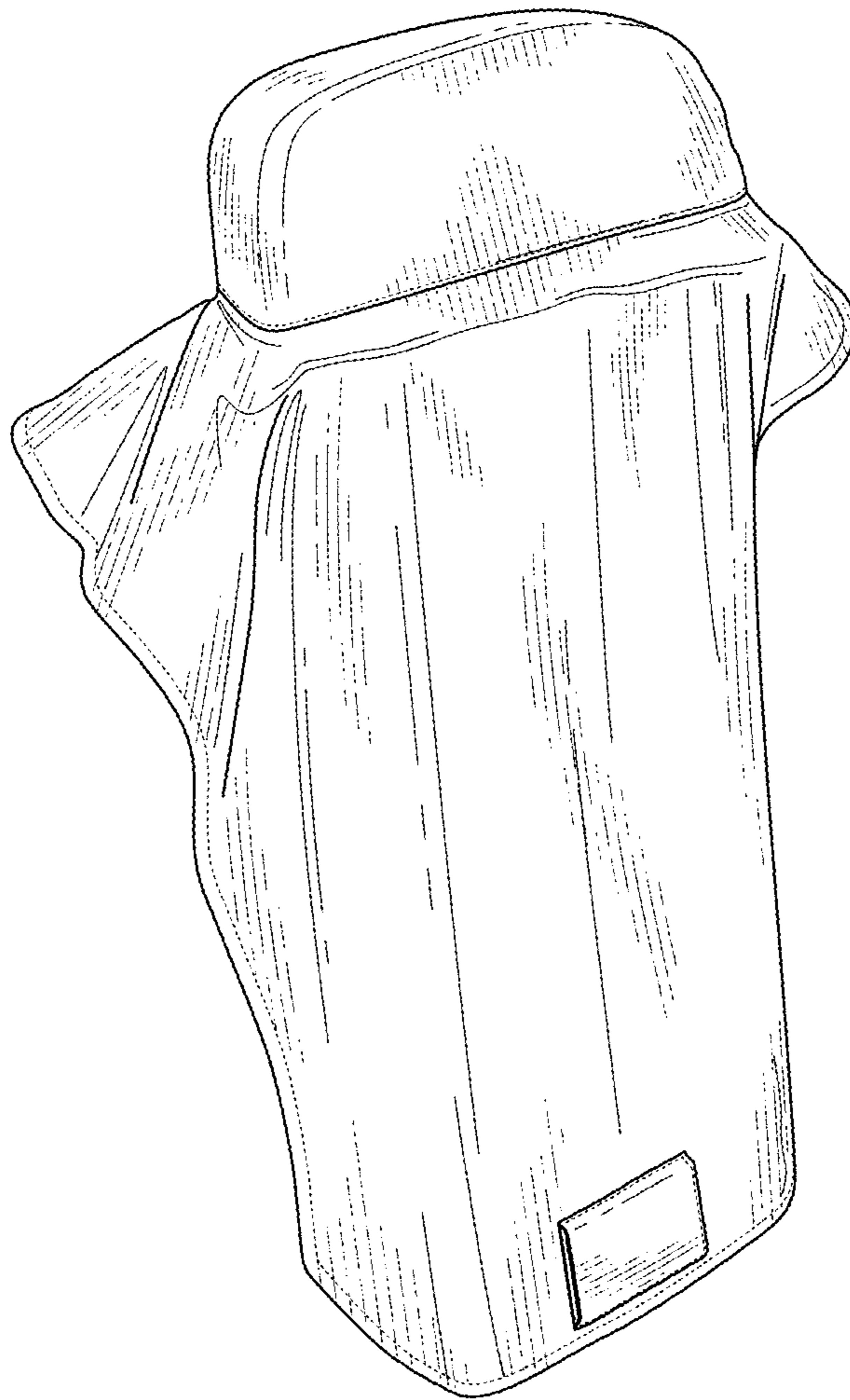

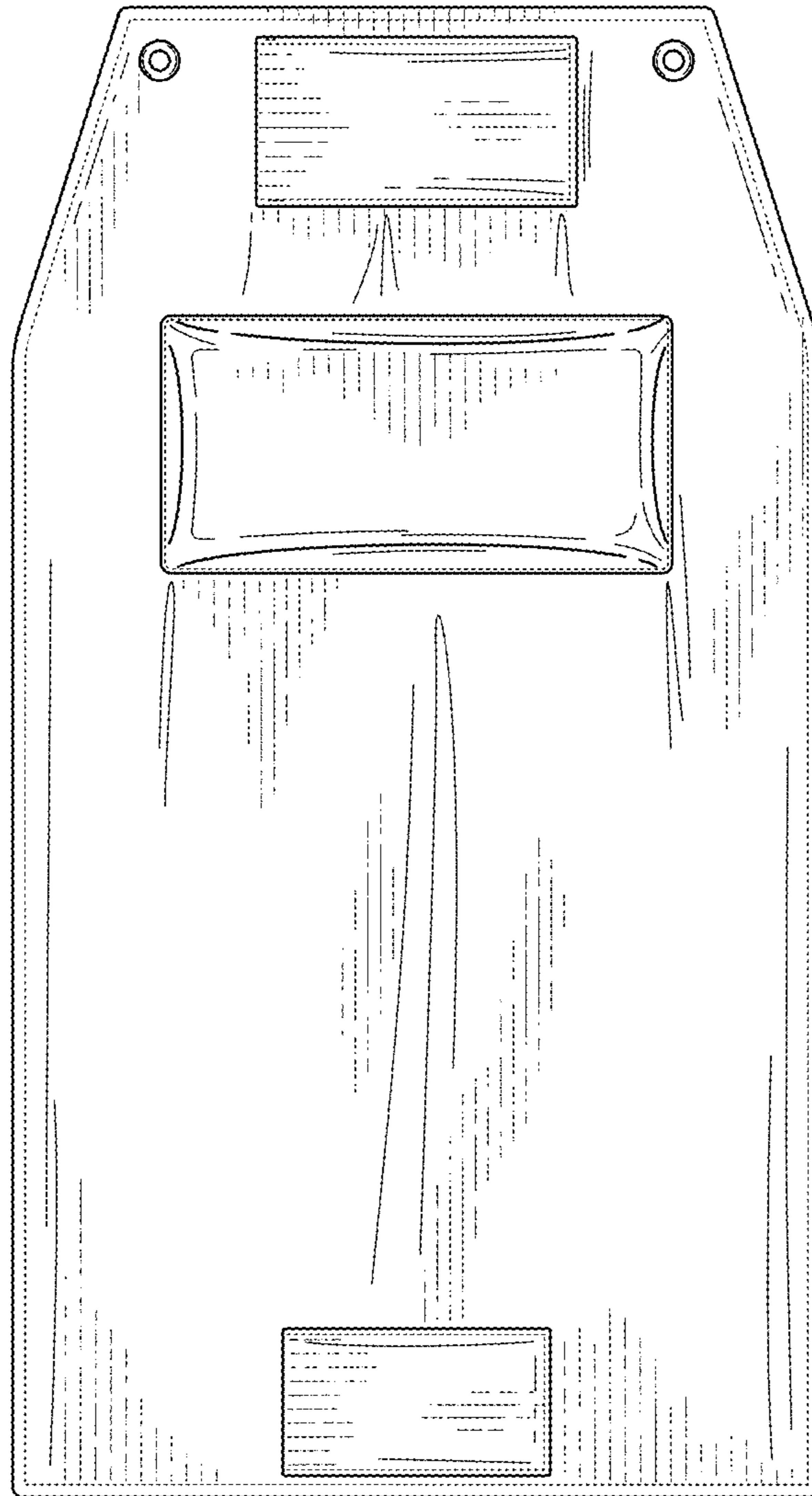

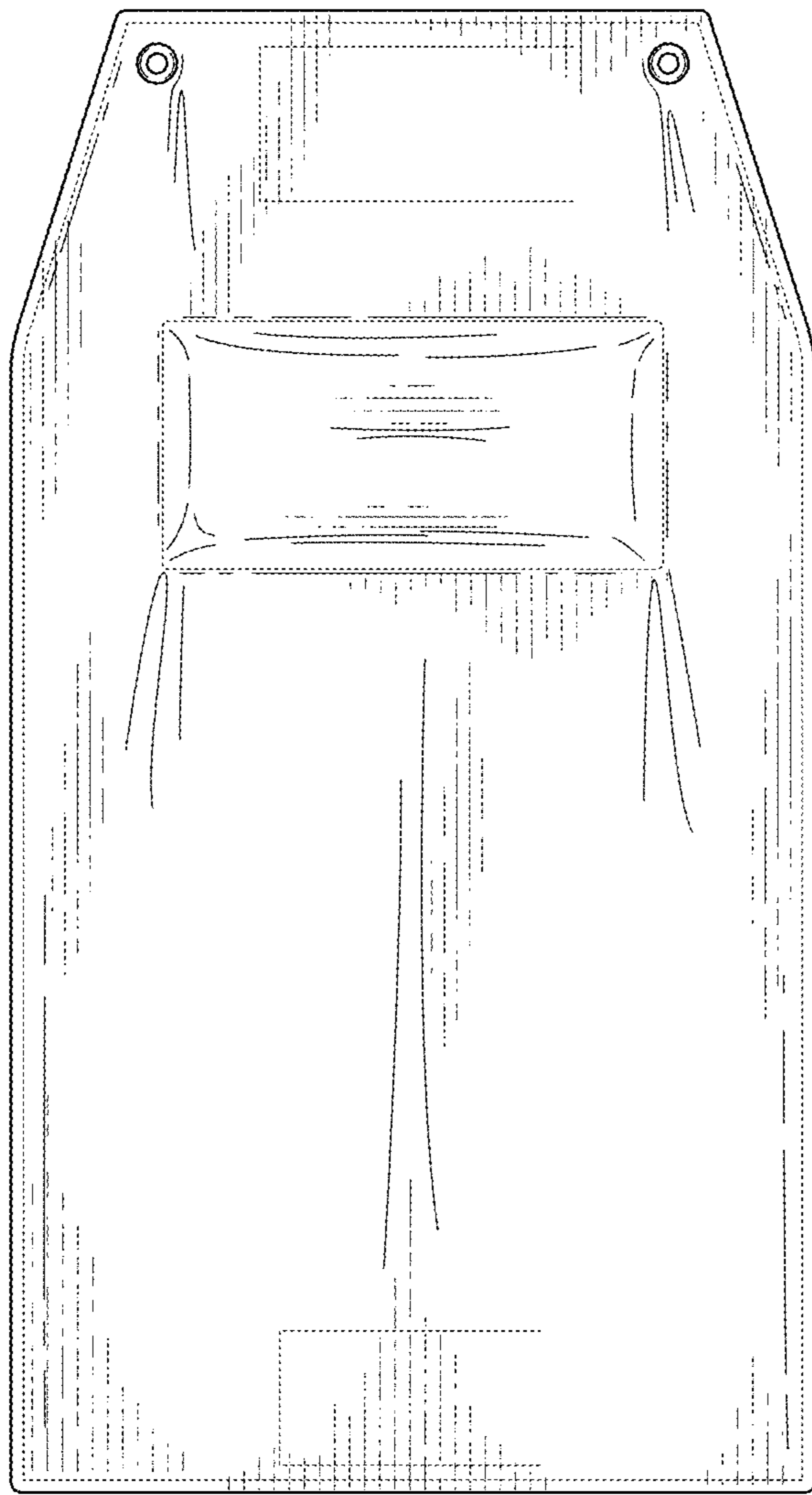

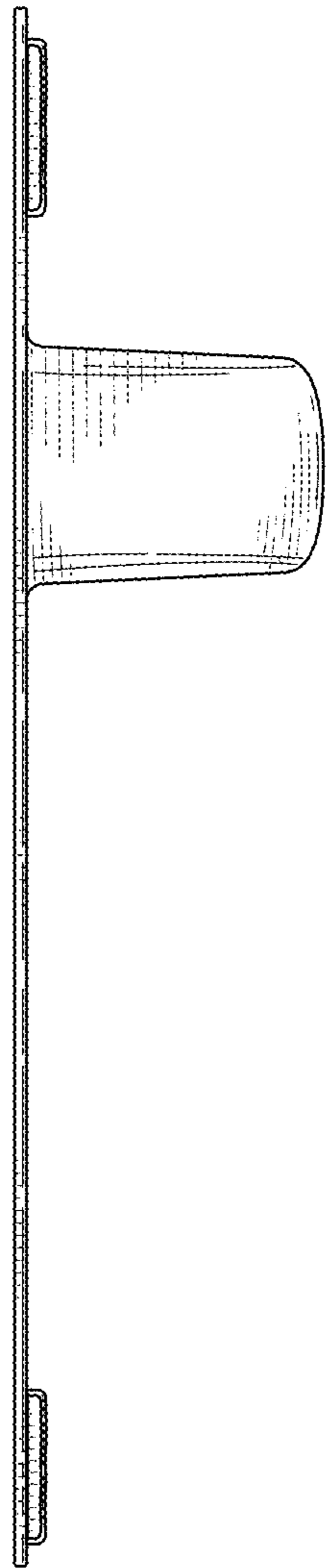

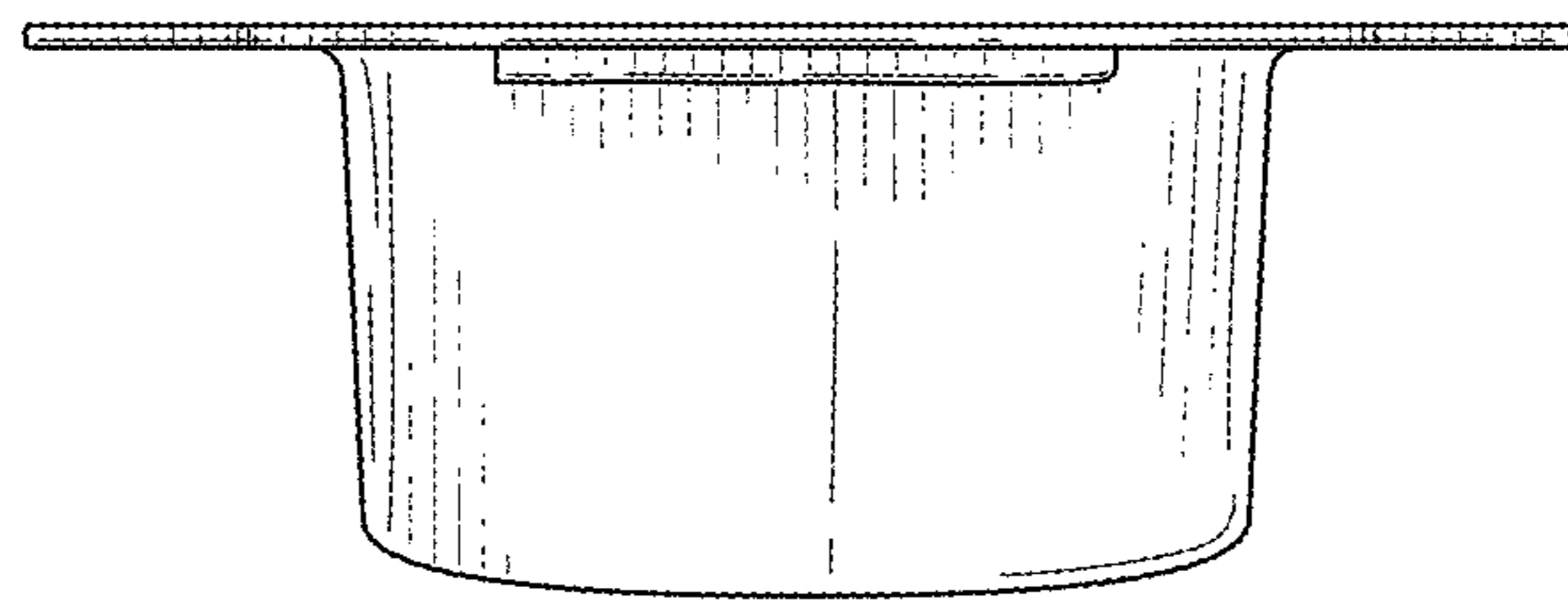

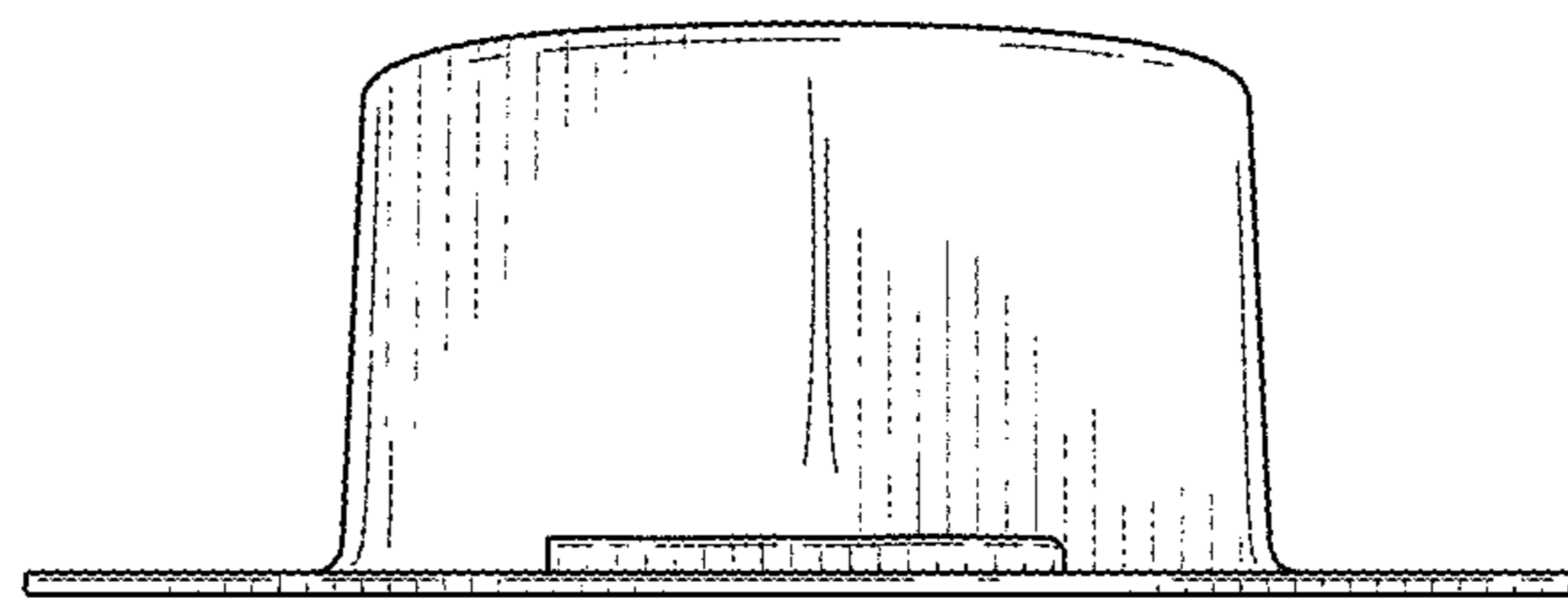
