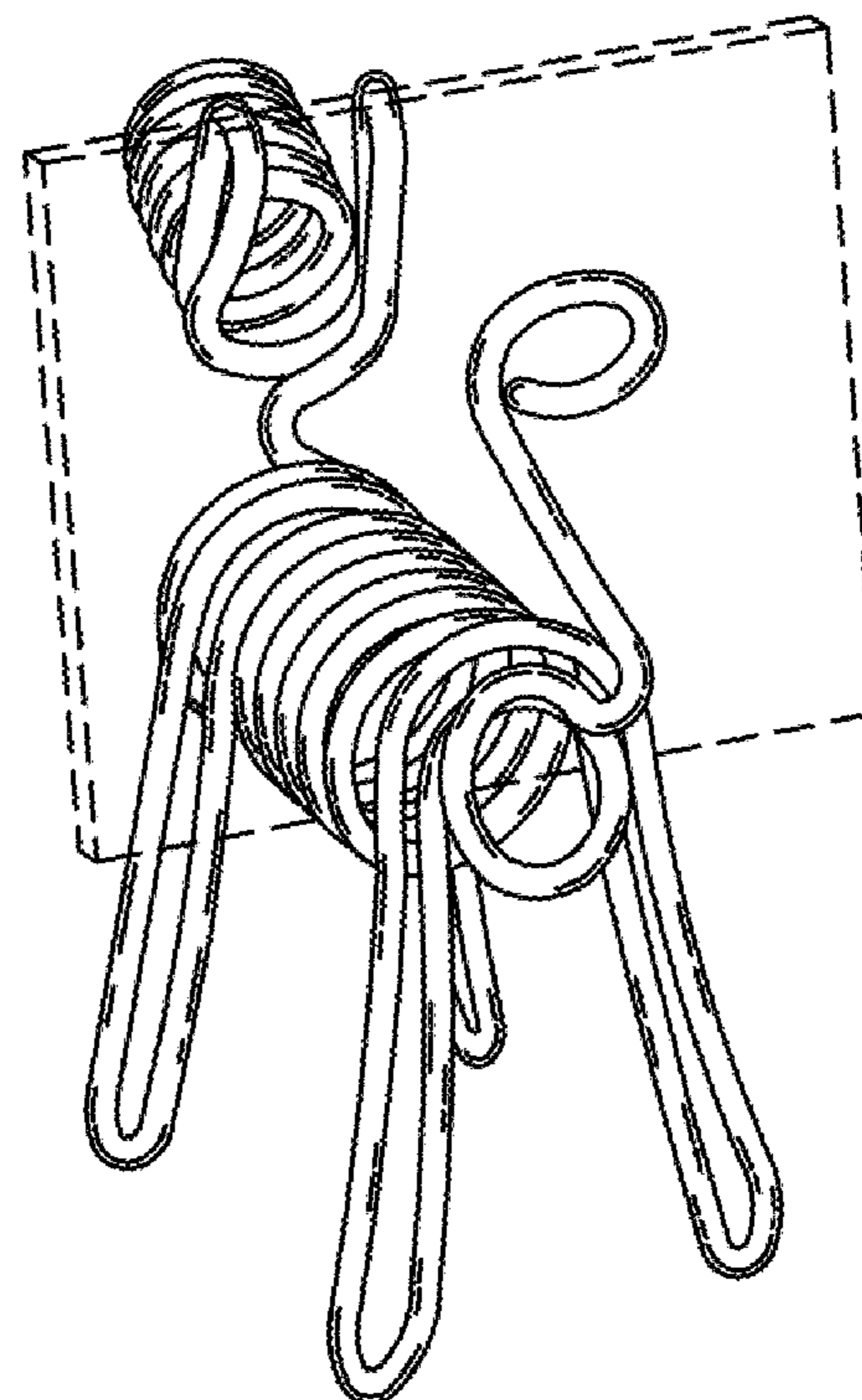
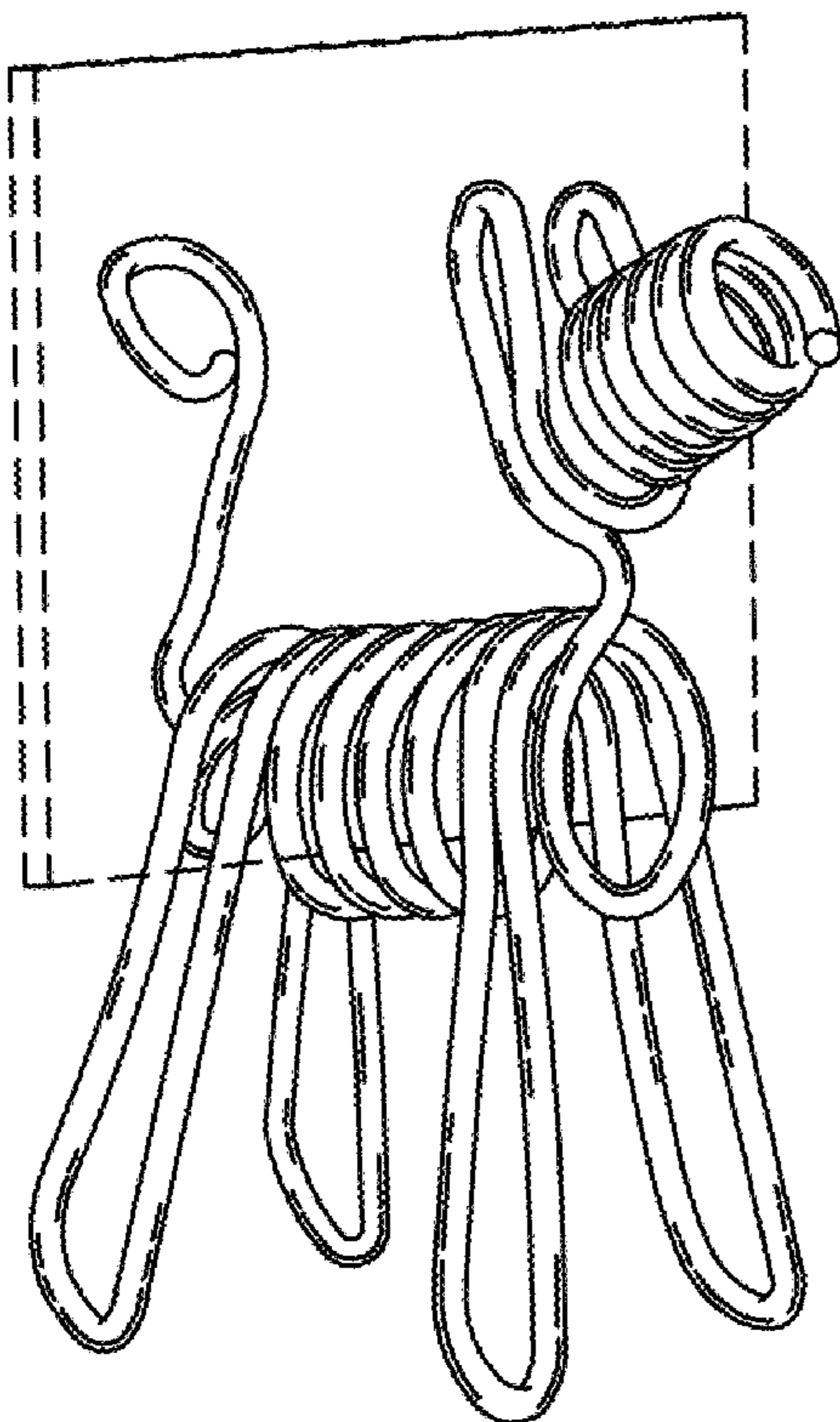
(57) **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

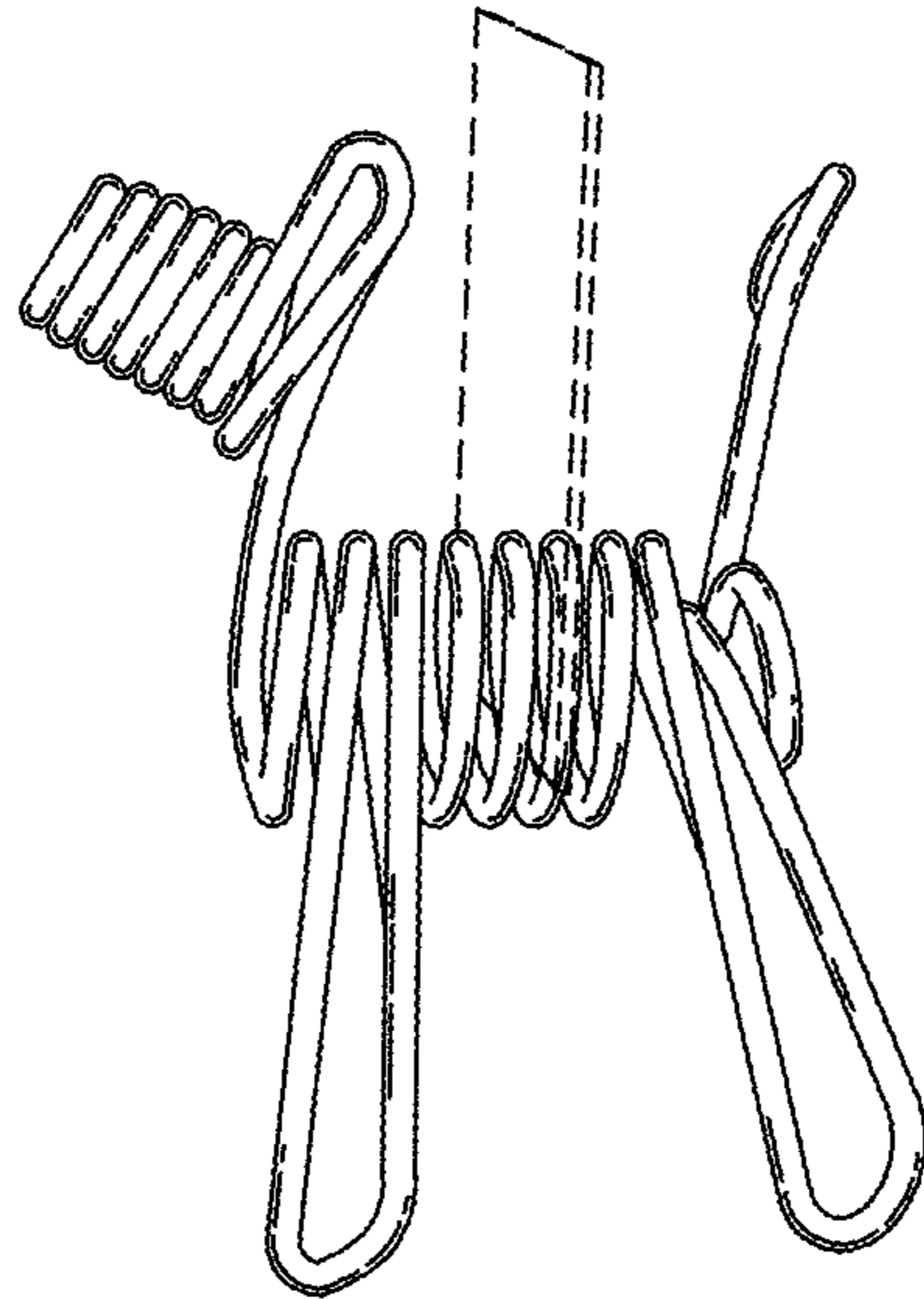

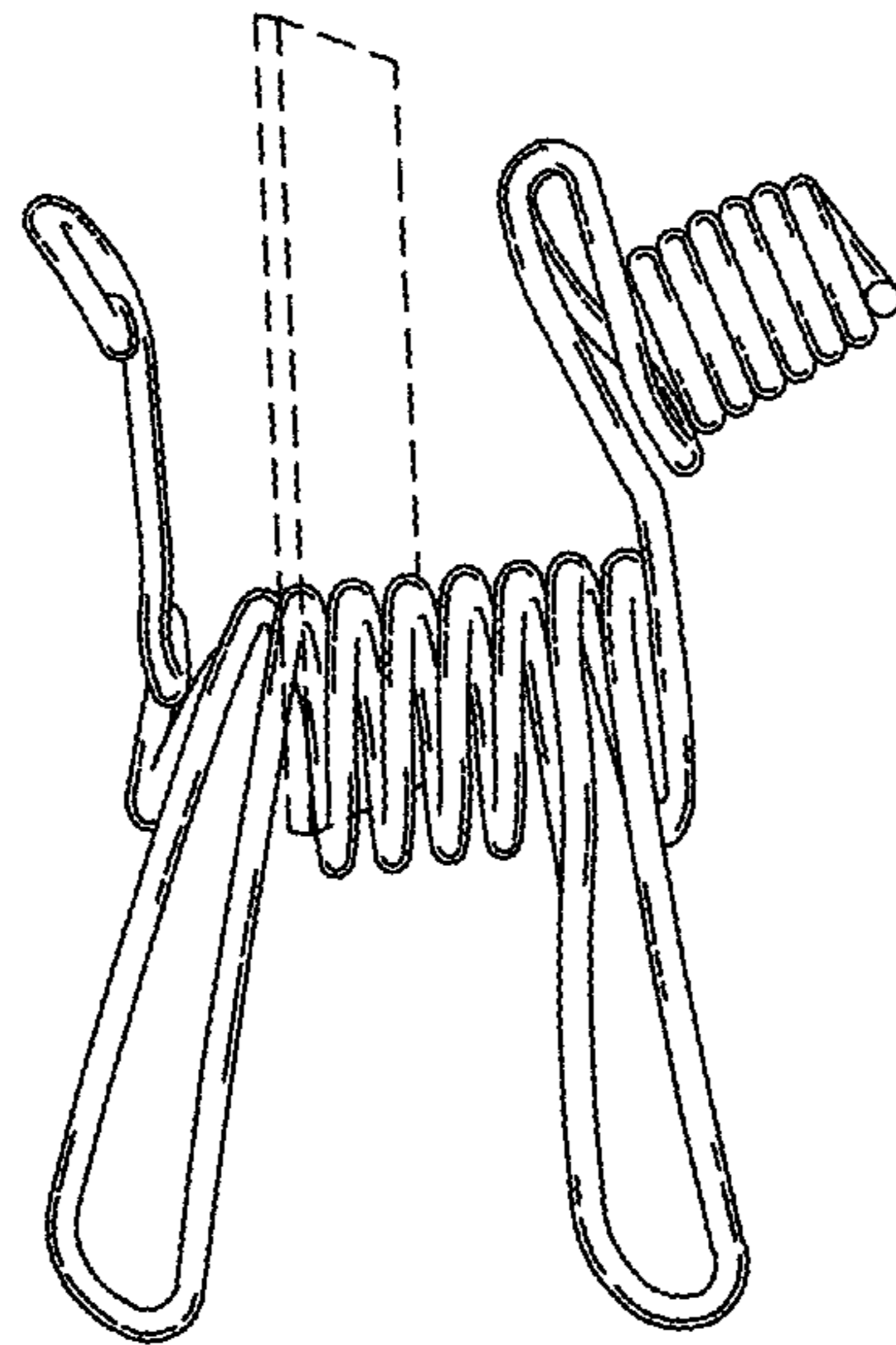

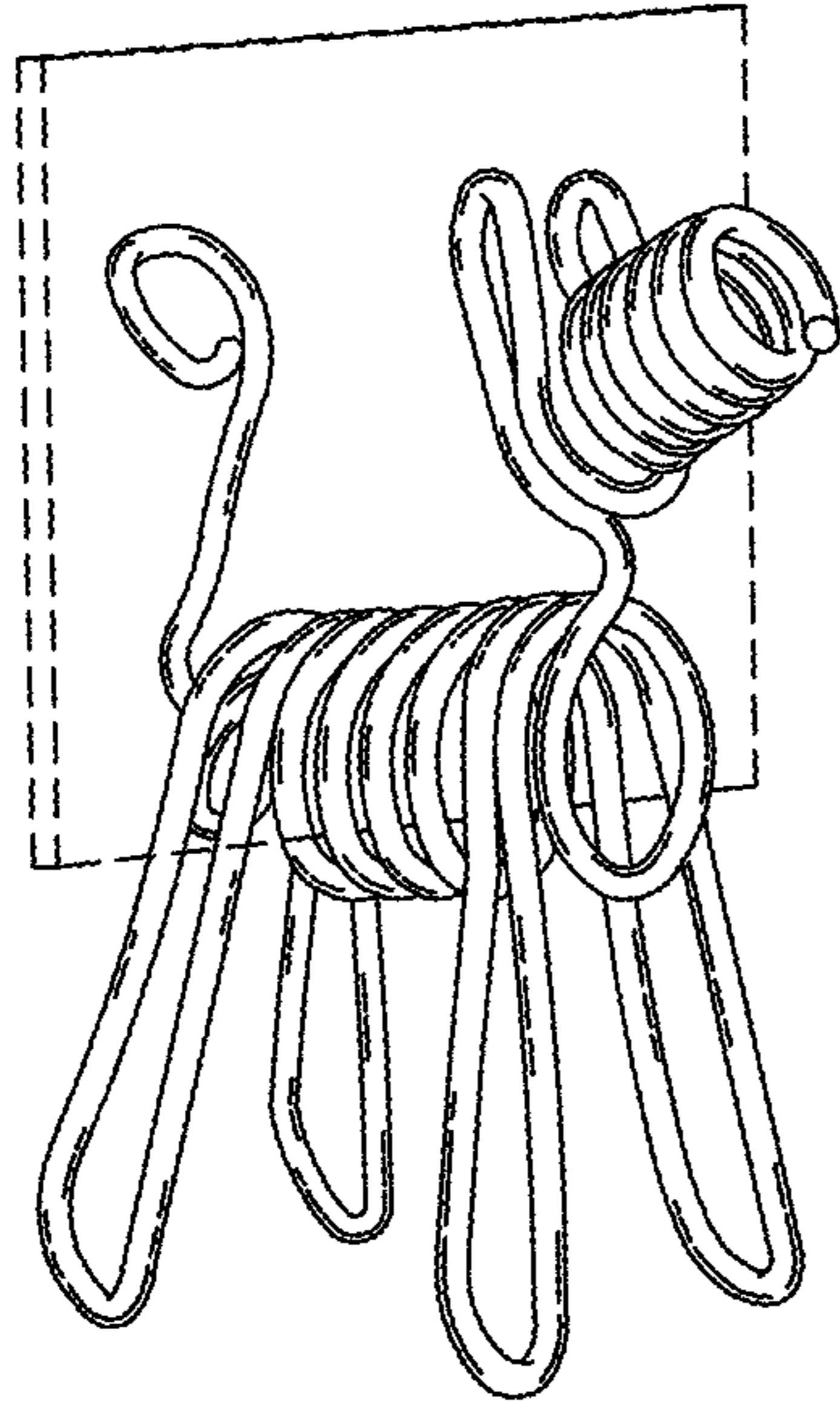

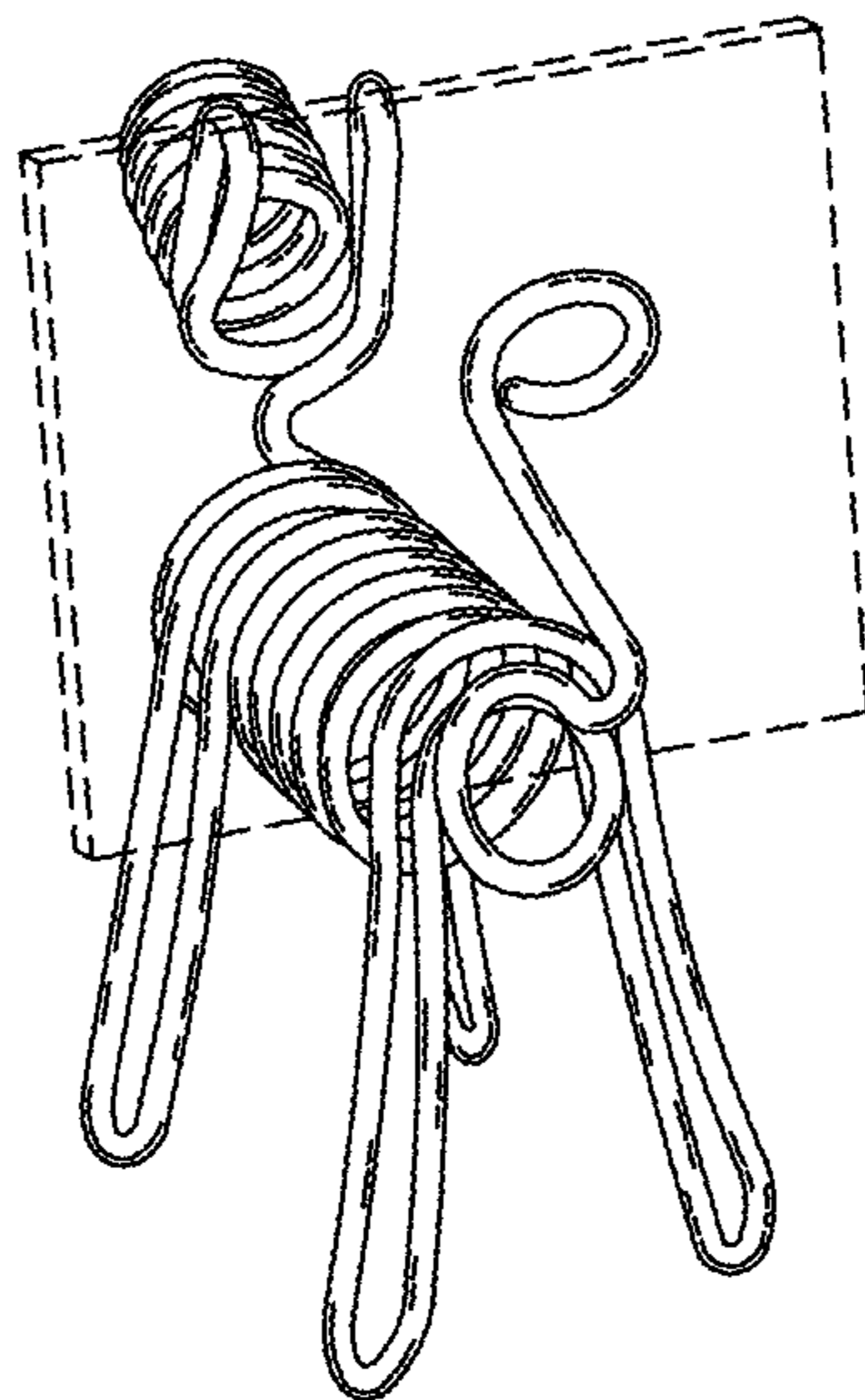
