our new design;

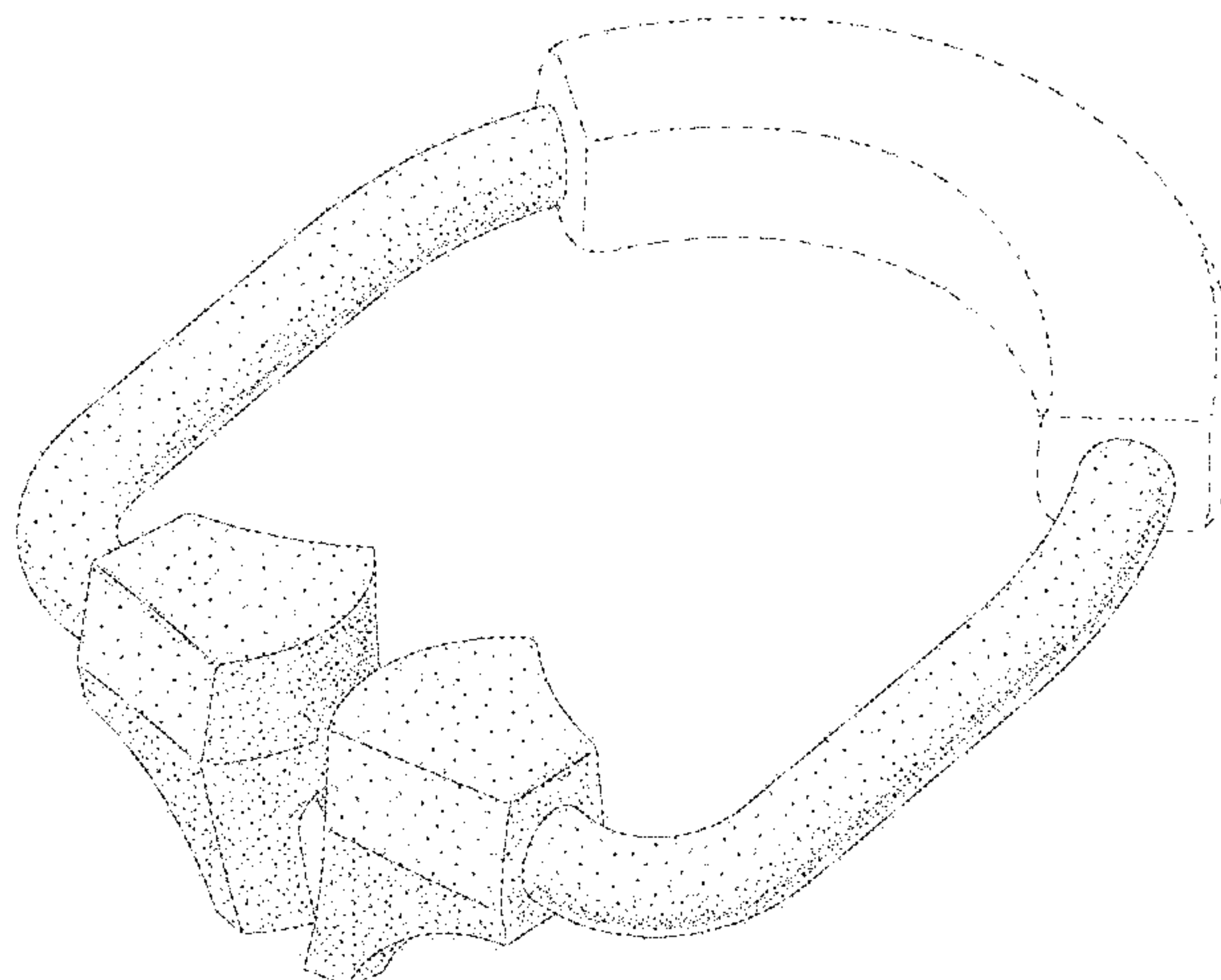
FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof which is a mirror image to

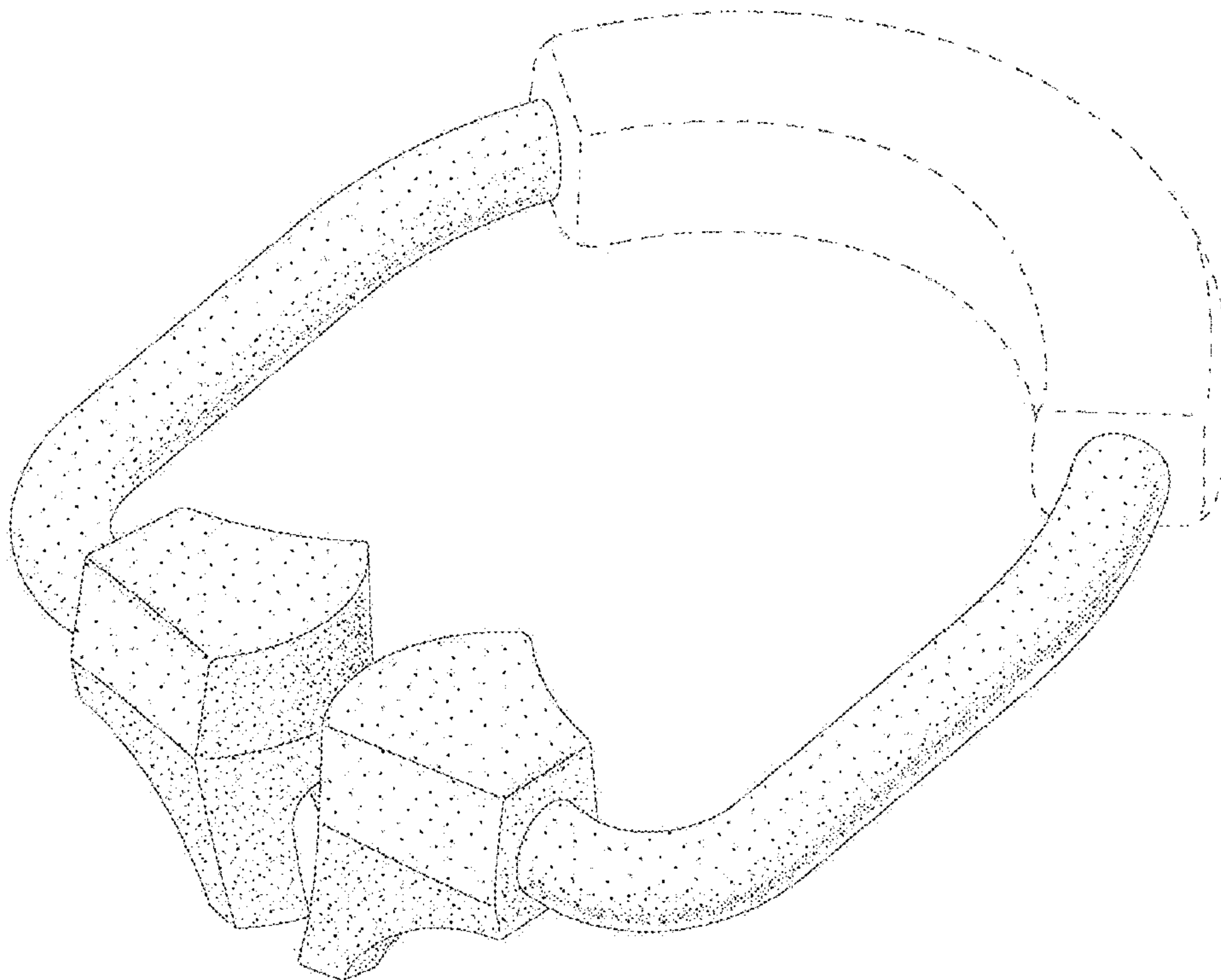

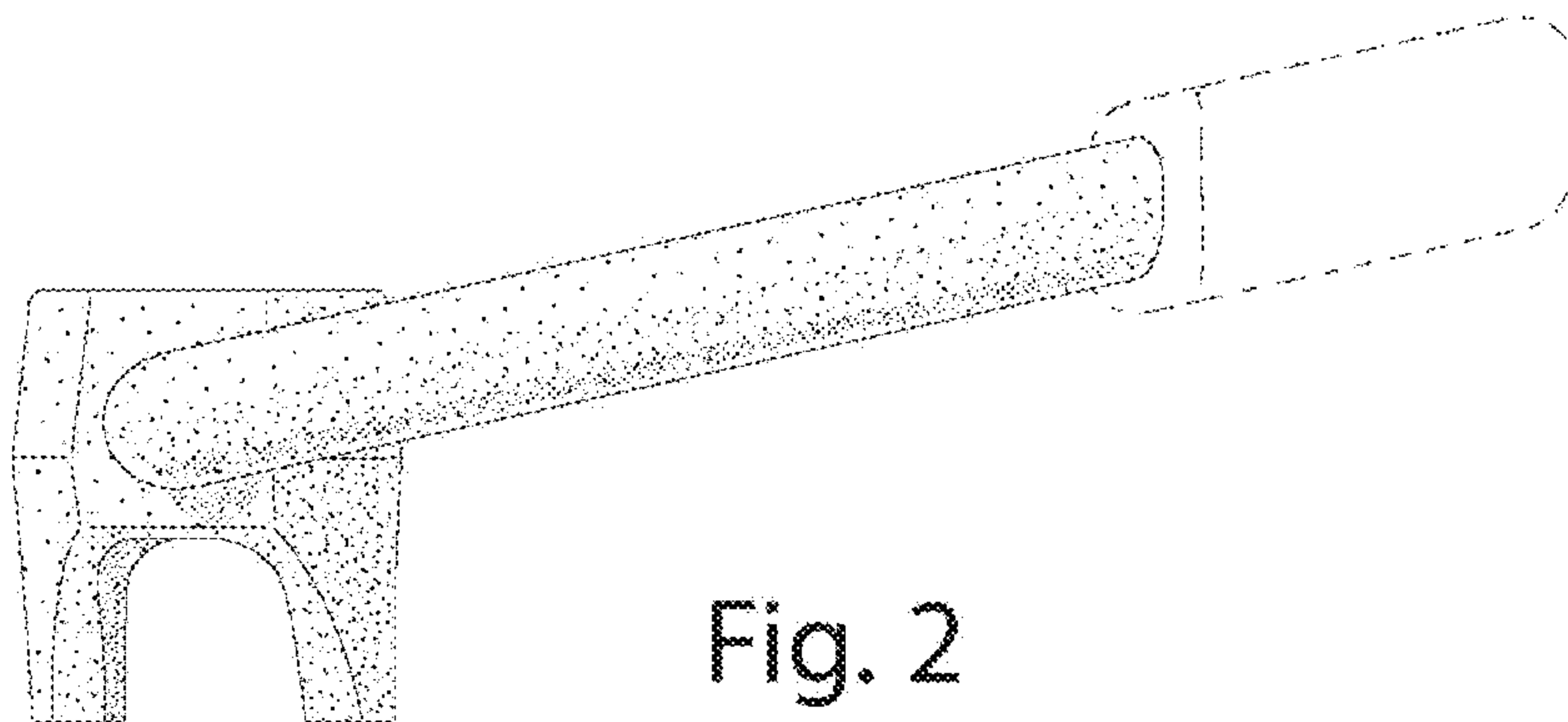

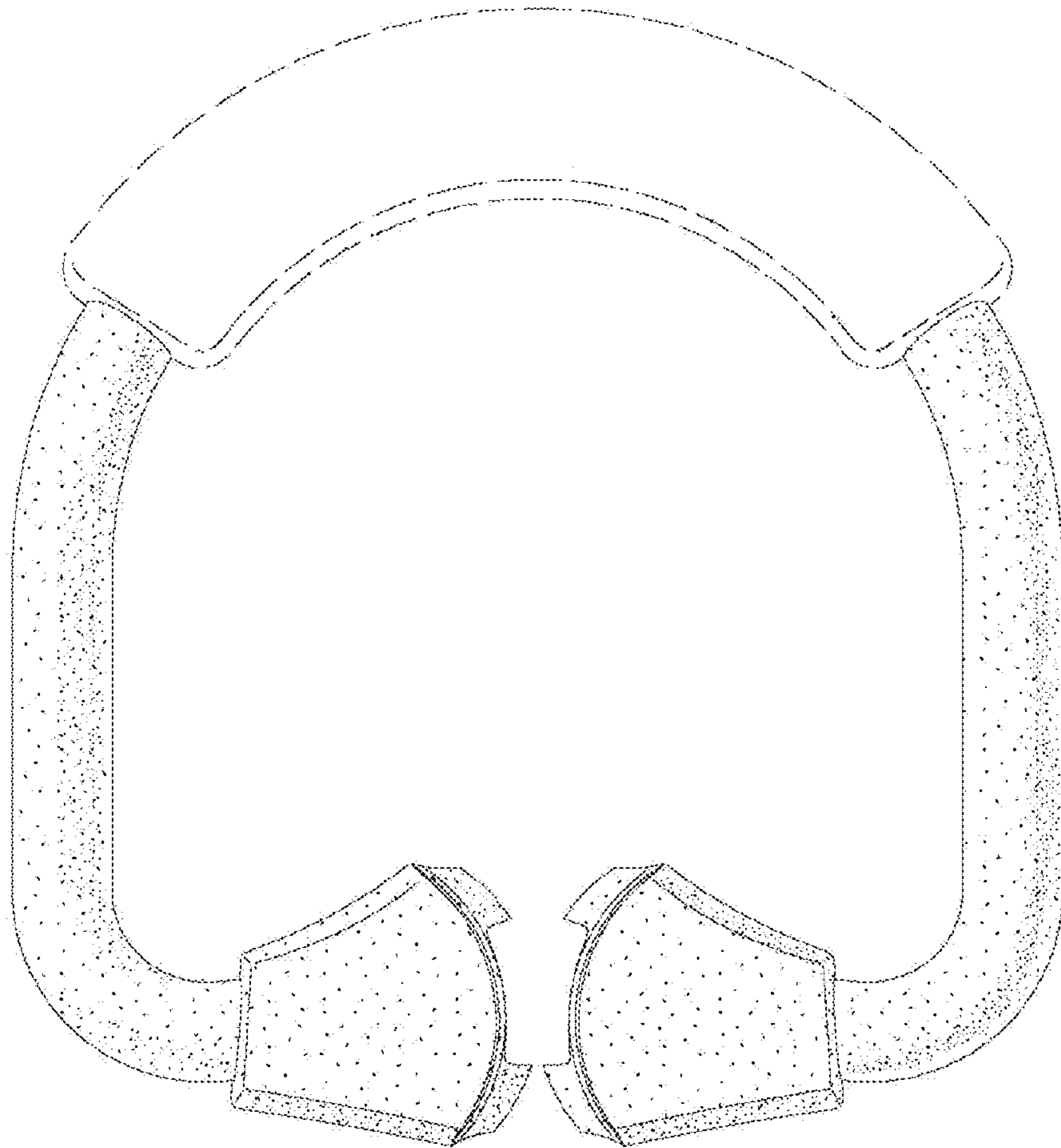

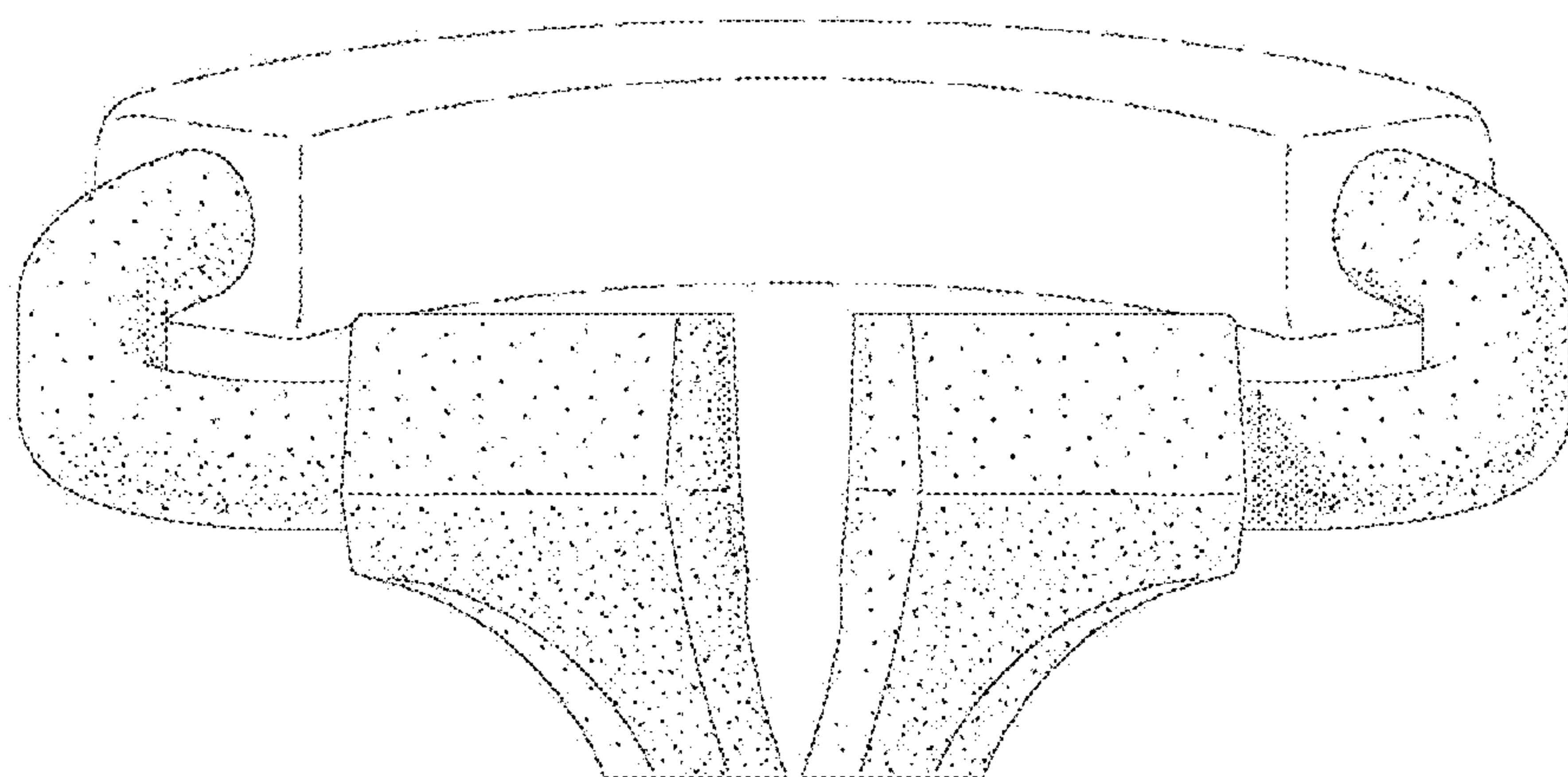
