DESCRIPTION

bar showing our new design.

FIG. 16 is a bottom view thereof.

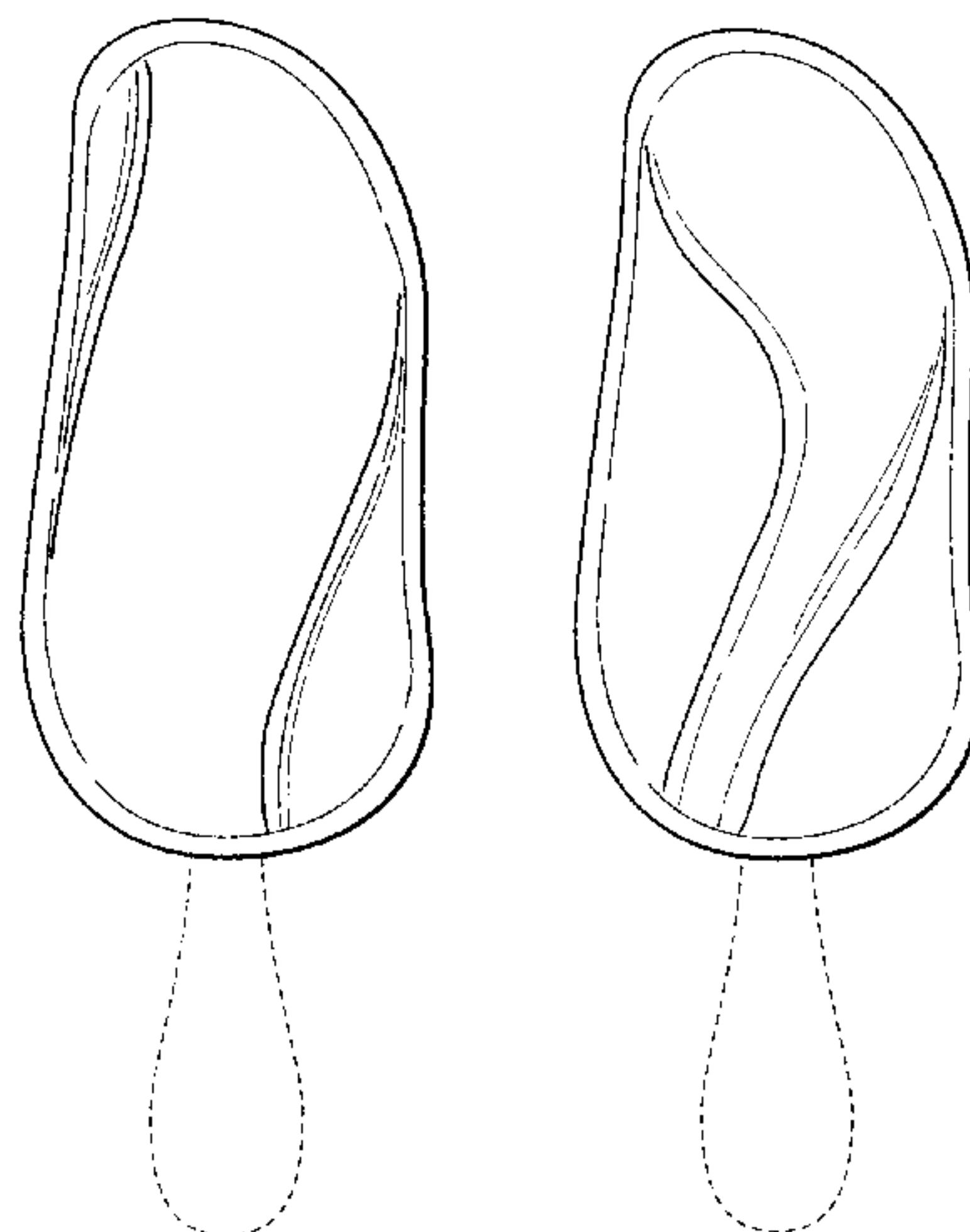
The food bar is not limited to the scale shown herein.

The broken lines in FIGS. 1-6, 8-14 and 16 illustrate
portions of the food bar that form no part of the claimed
design.

The light weight lines in the figures show surface contour
and not surface ornamentation.

In accordance with two embodiments, the food bar is a
frozen confection, such as, for example, a popsicle, a frozen
fruit bar, a frozen yogurt bar, an ice cream bar, a frozen
pudding bar, a gelato bar, or a frozen custard bar.

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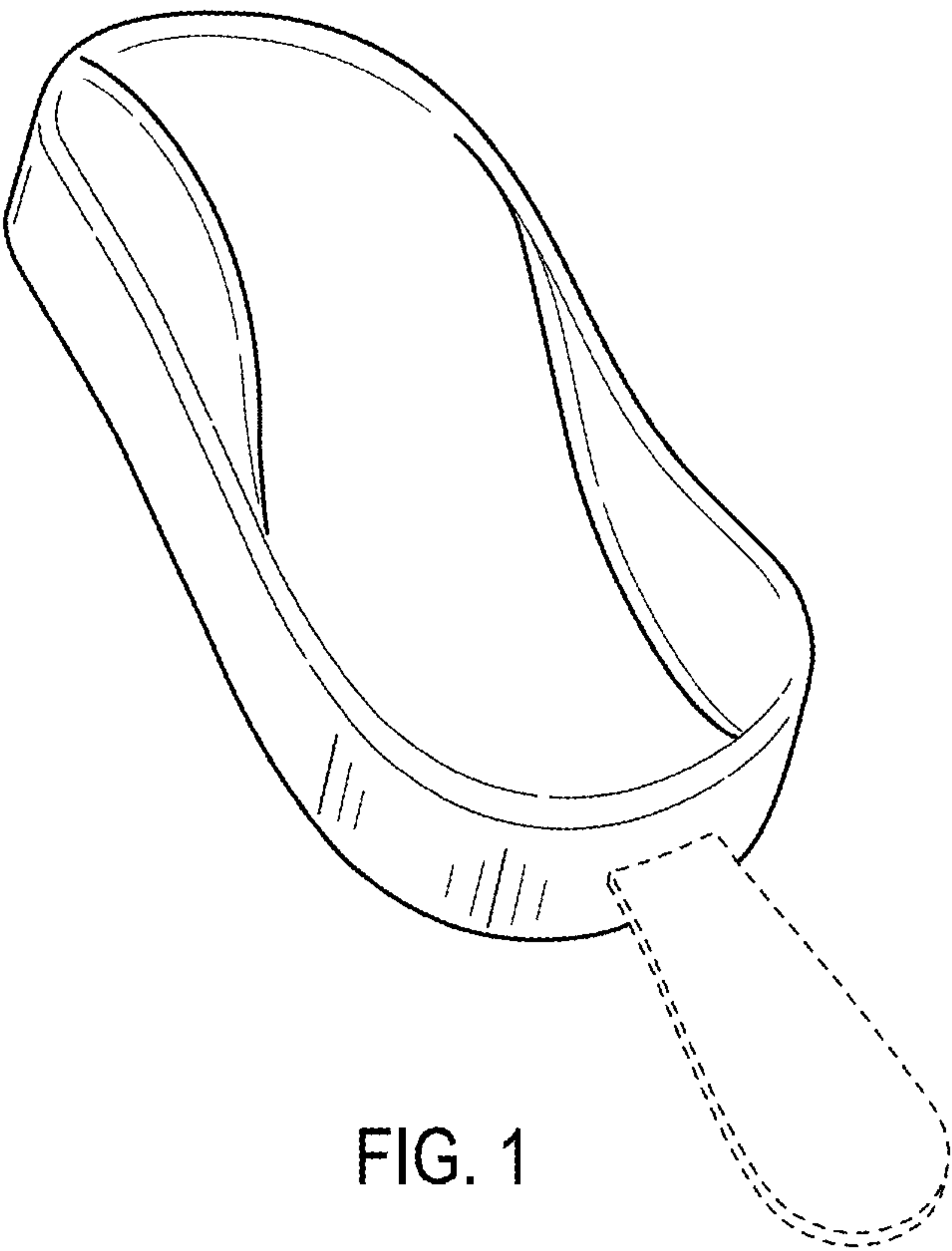

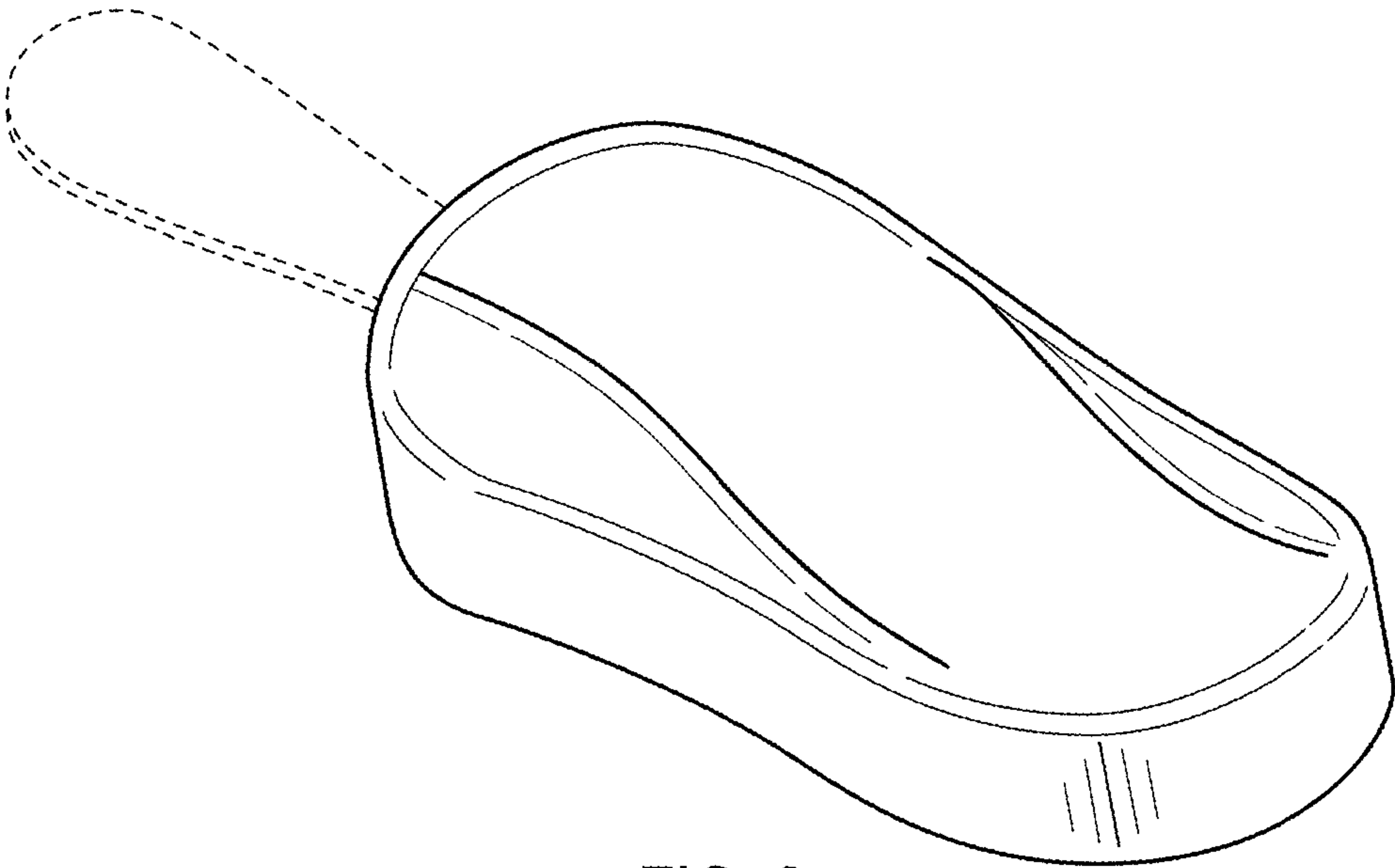

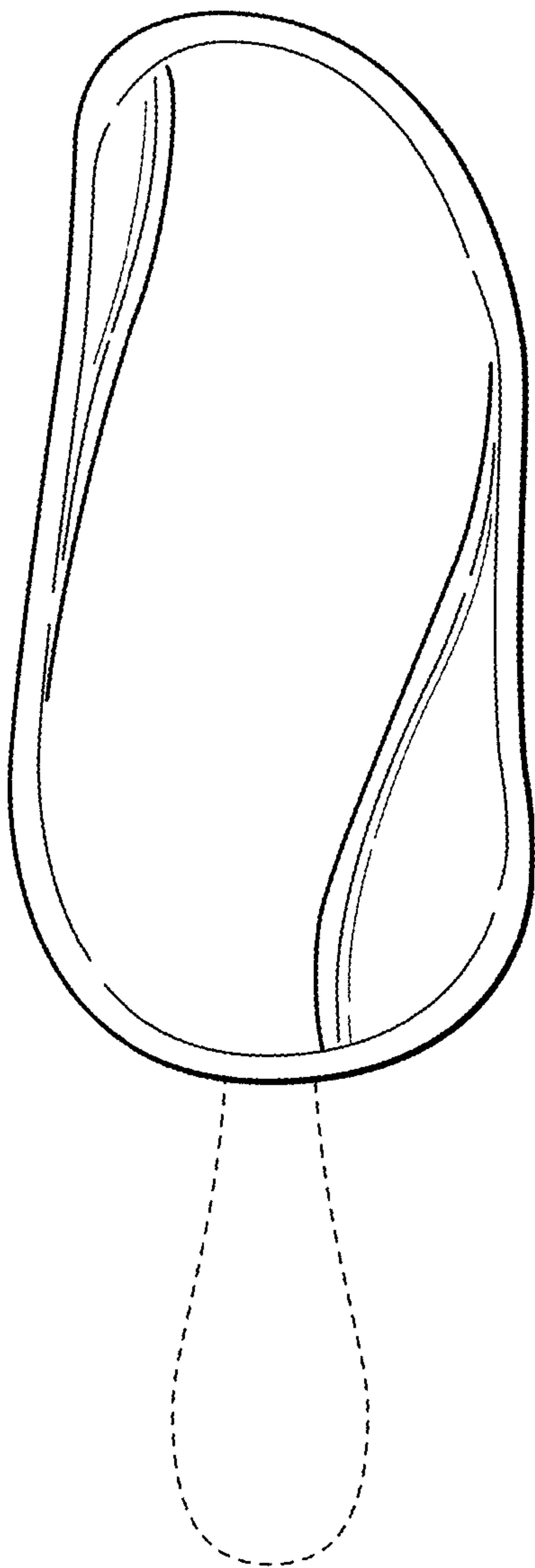

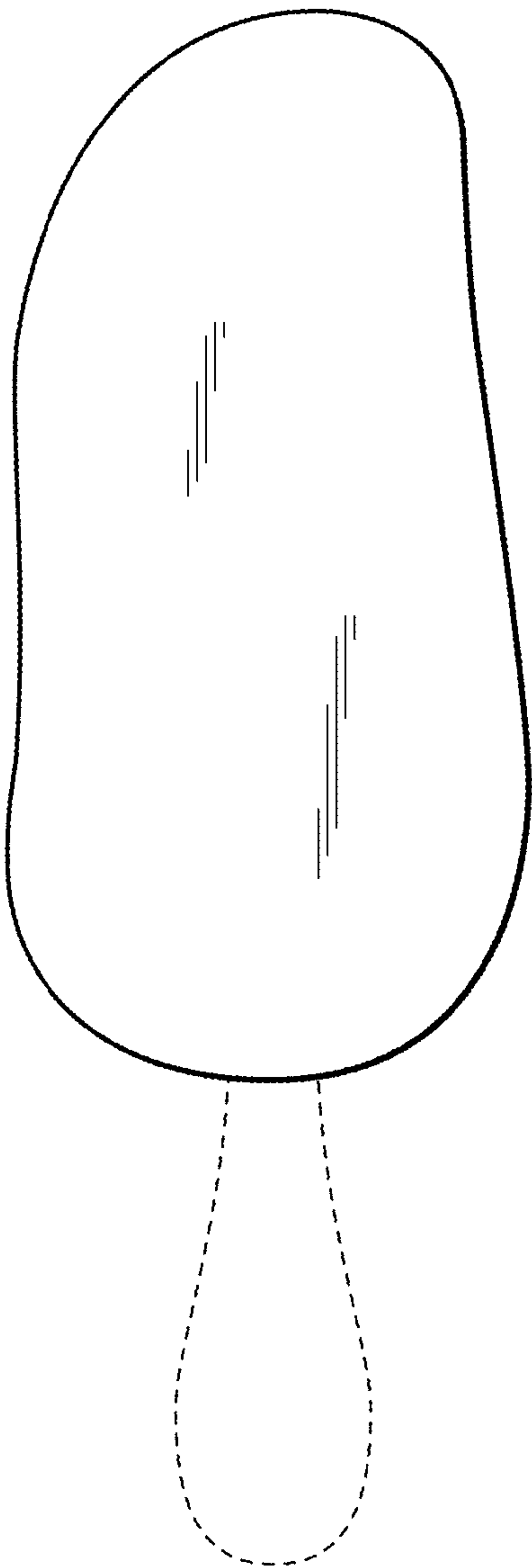

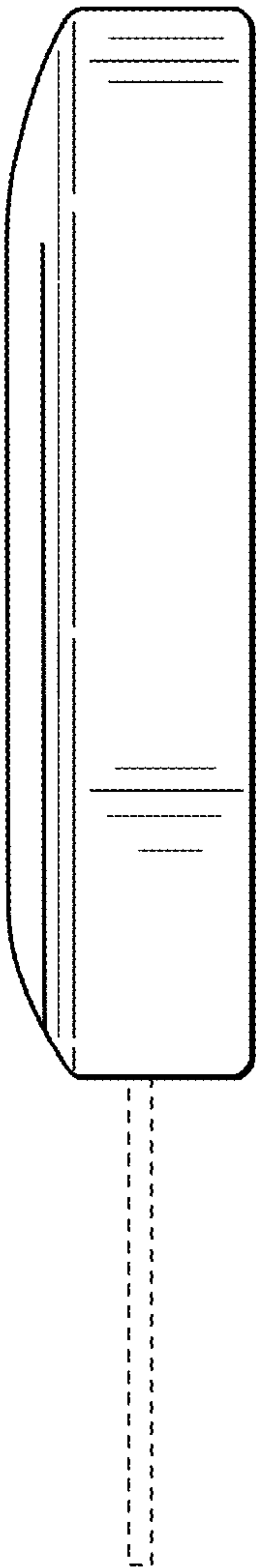

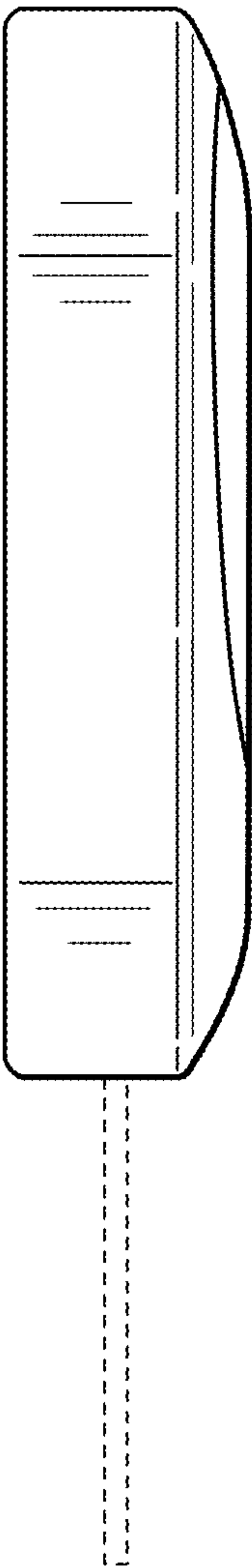

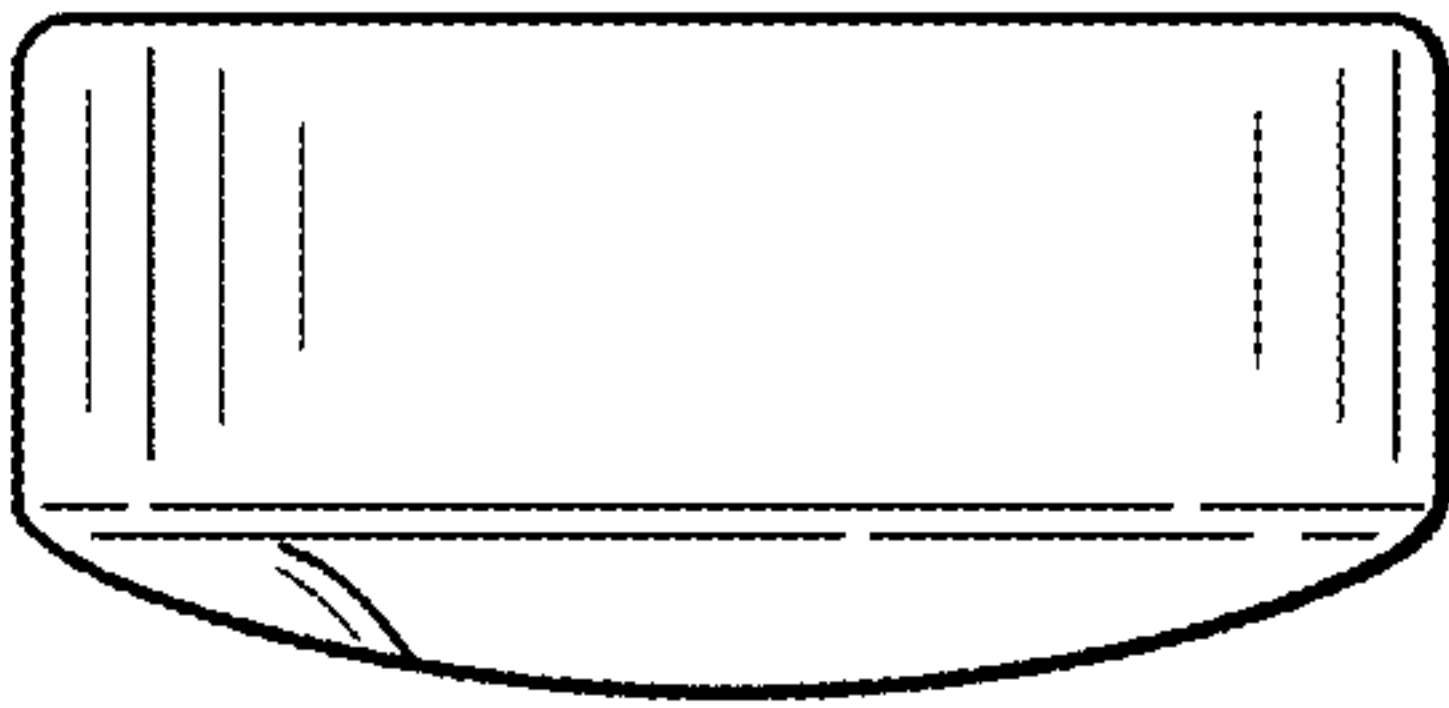

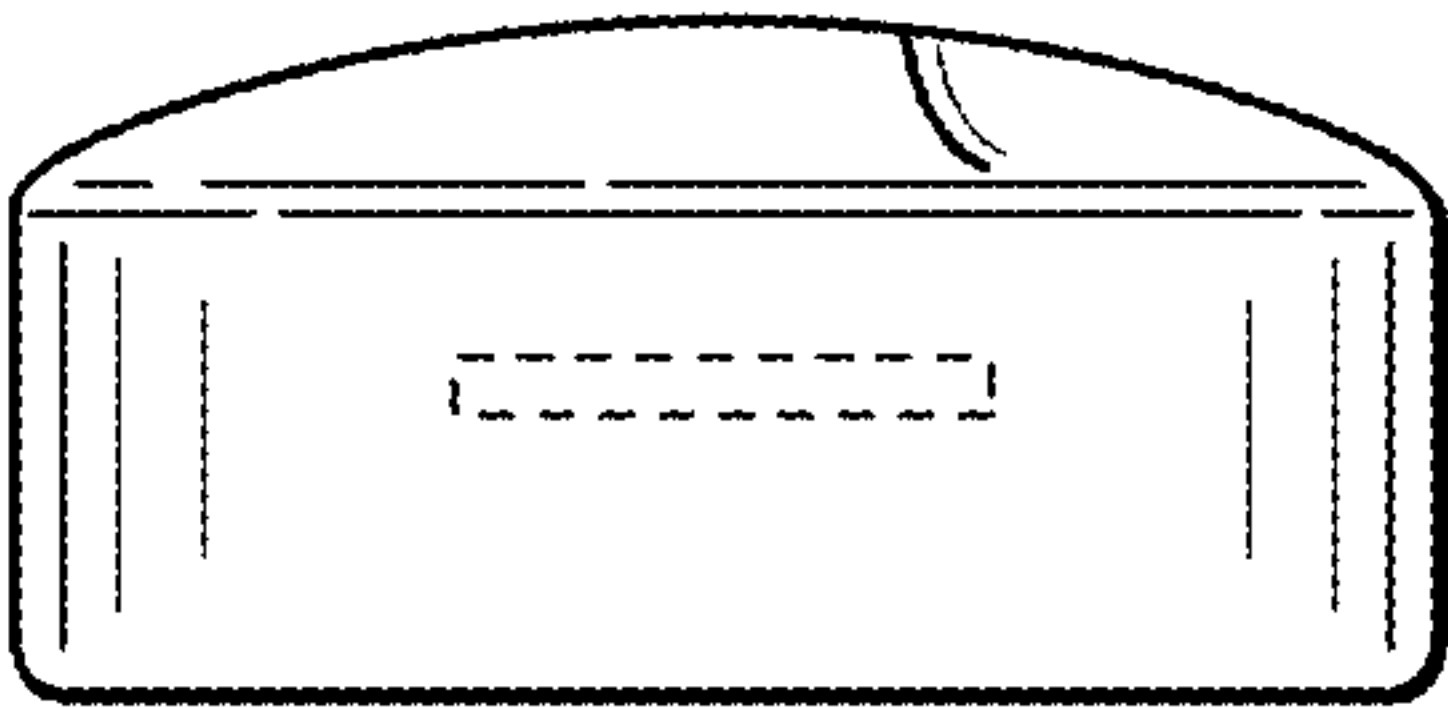

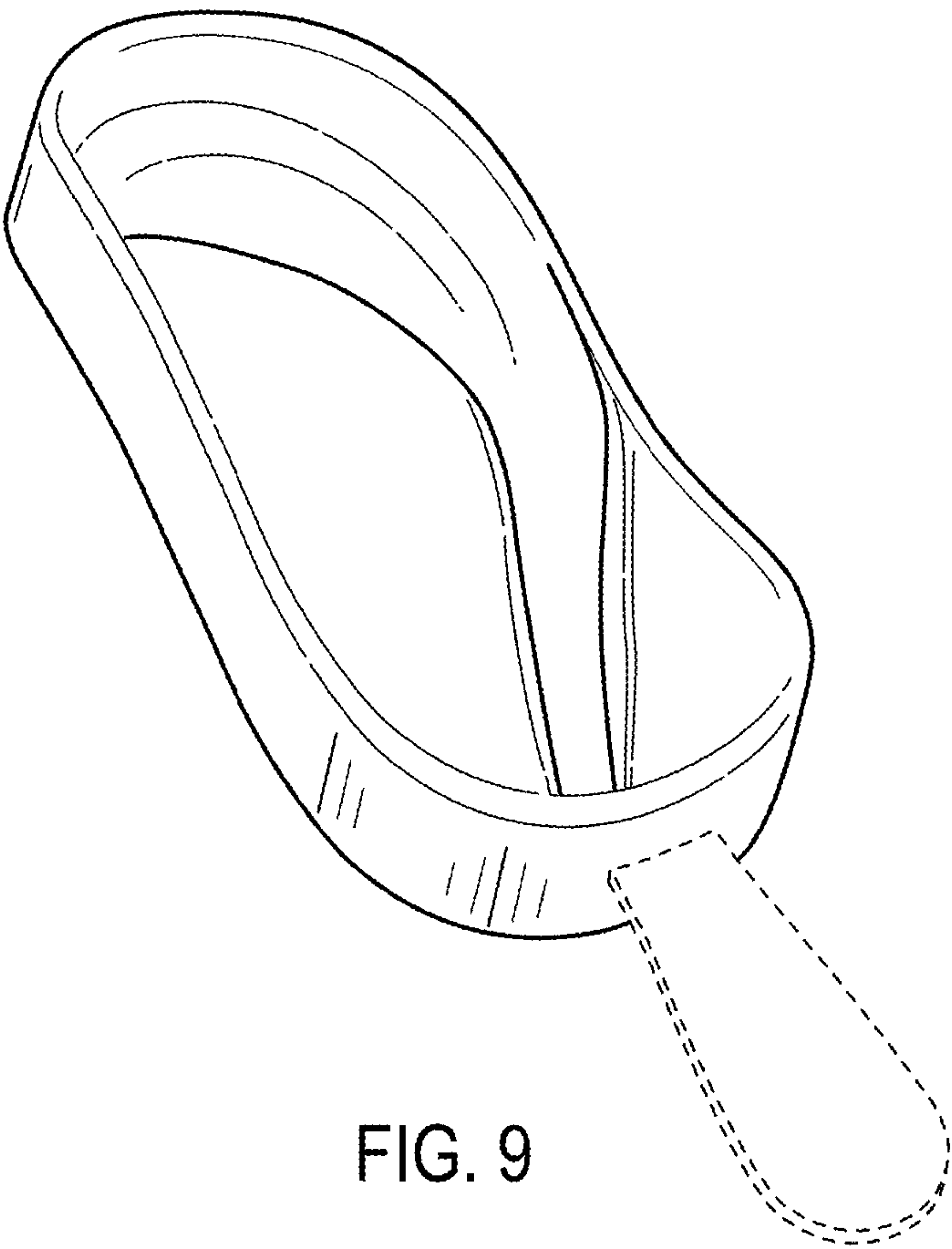

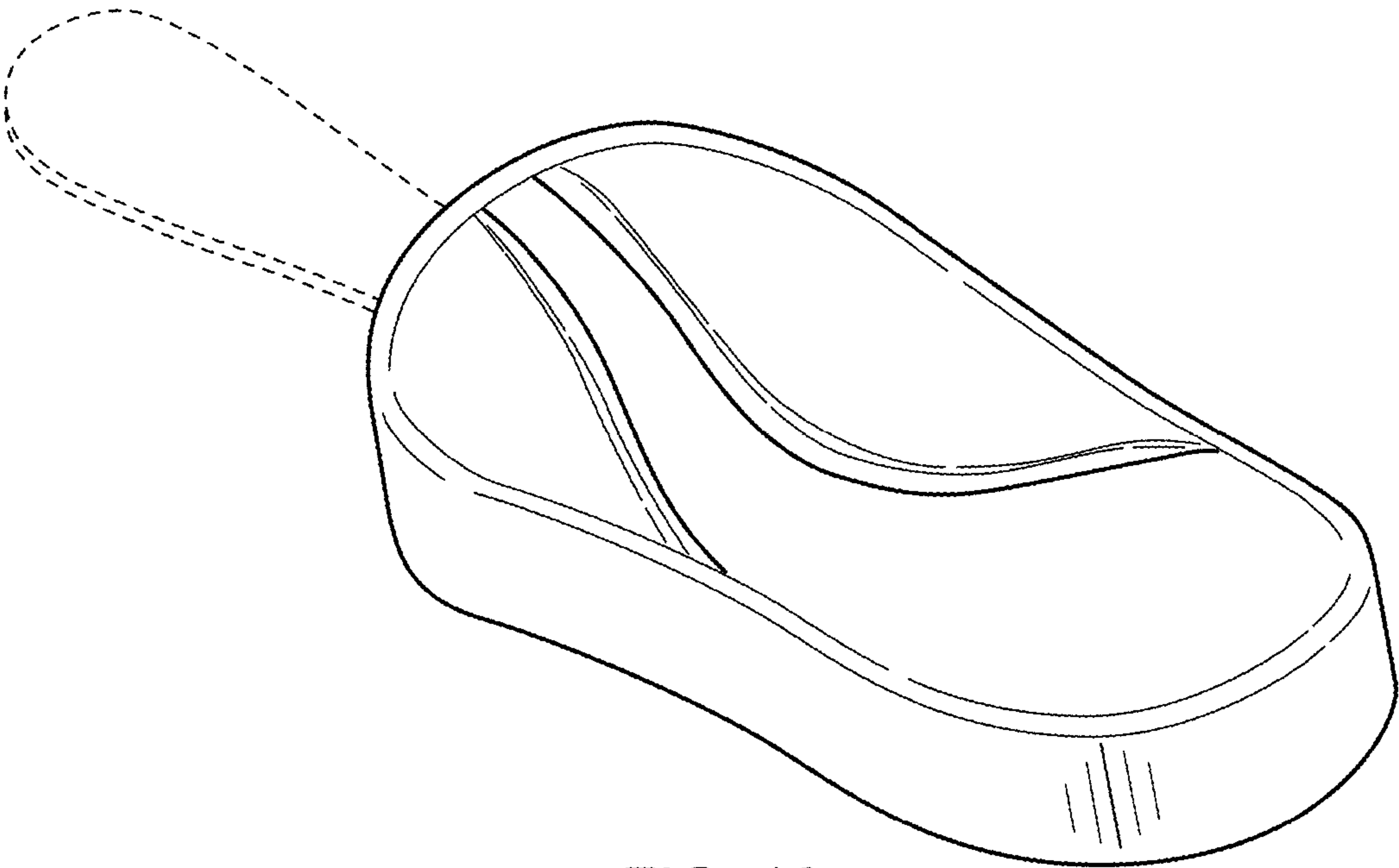

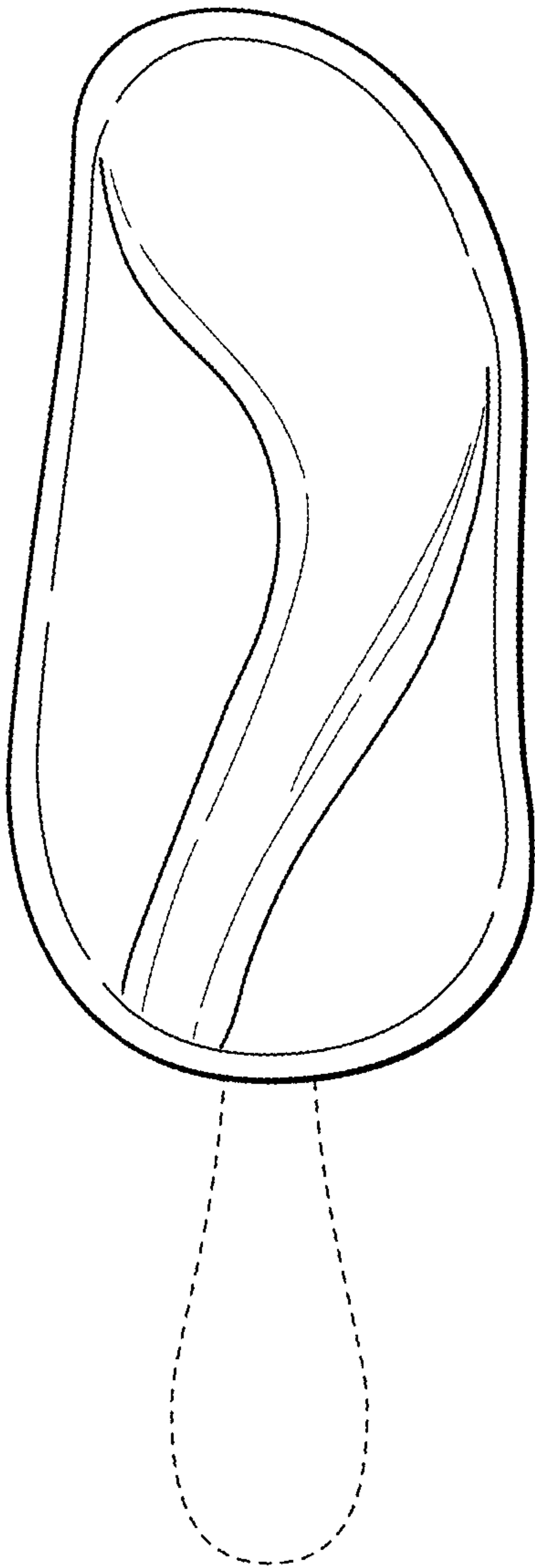

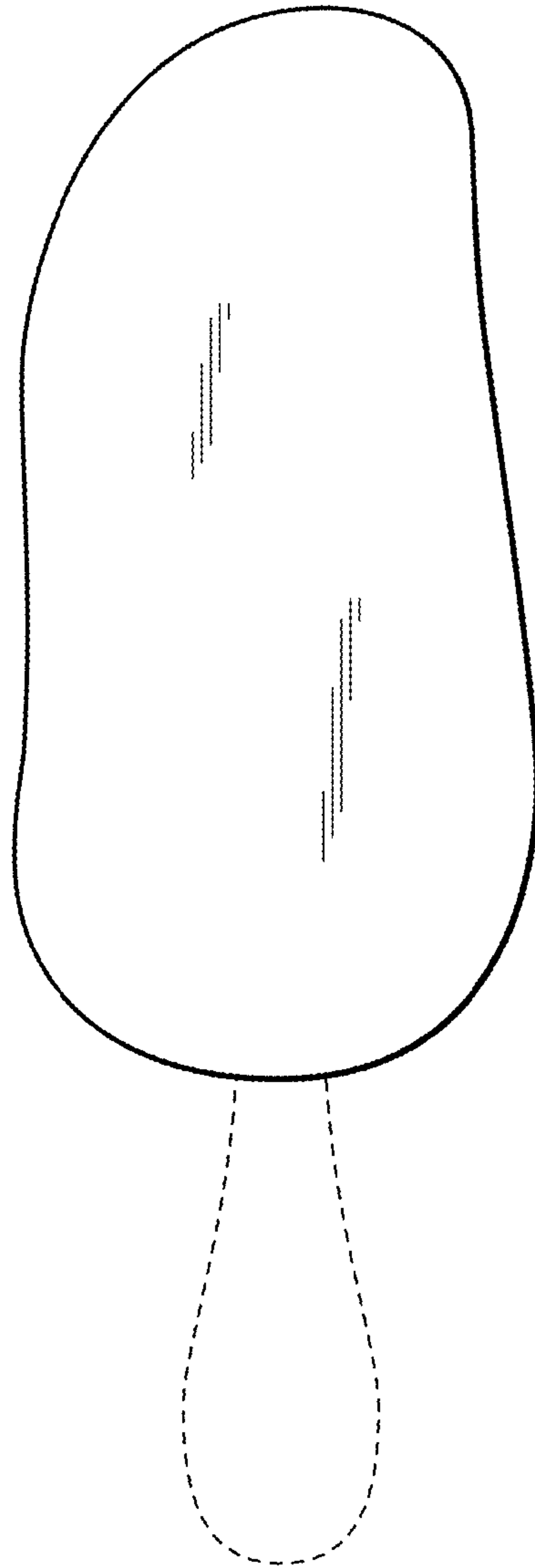

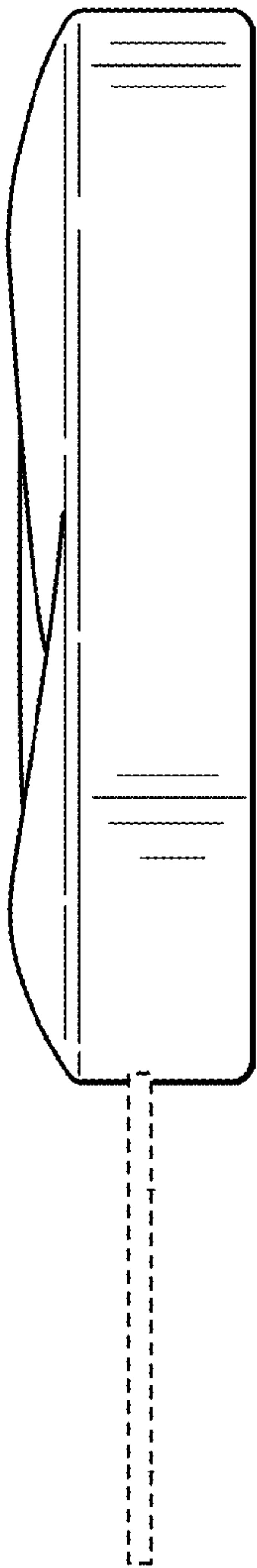

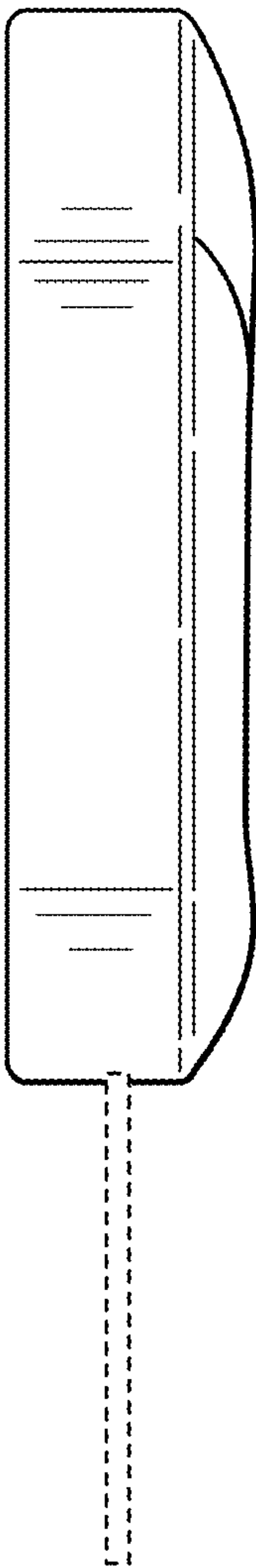

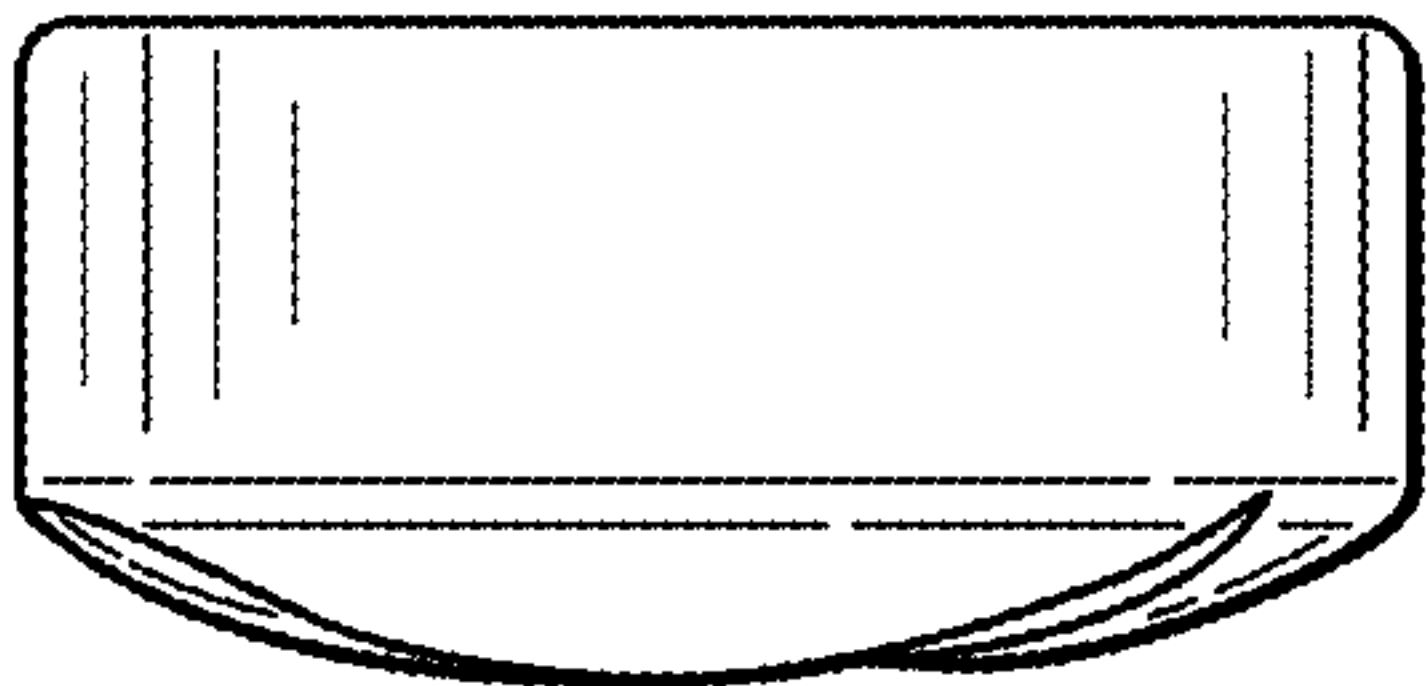

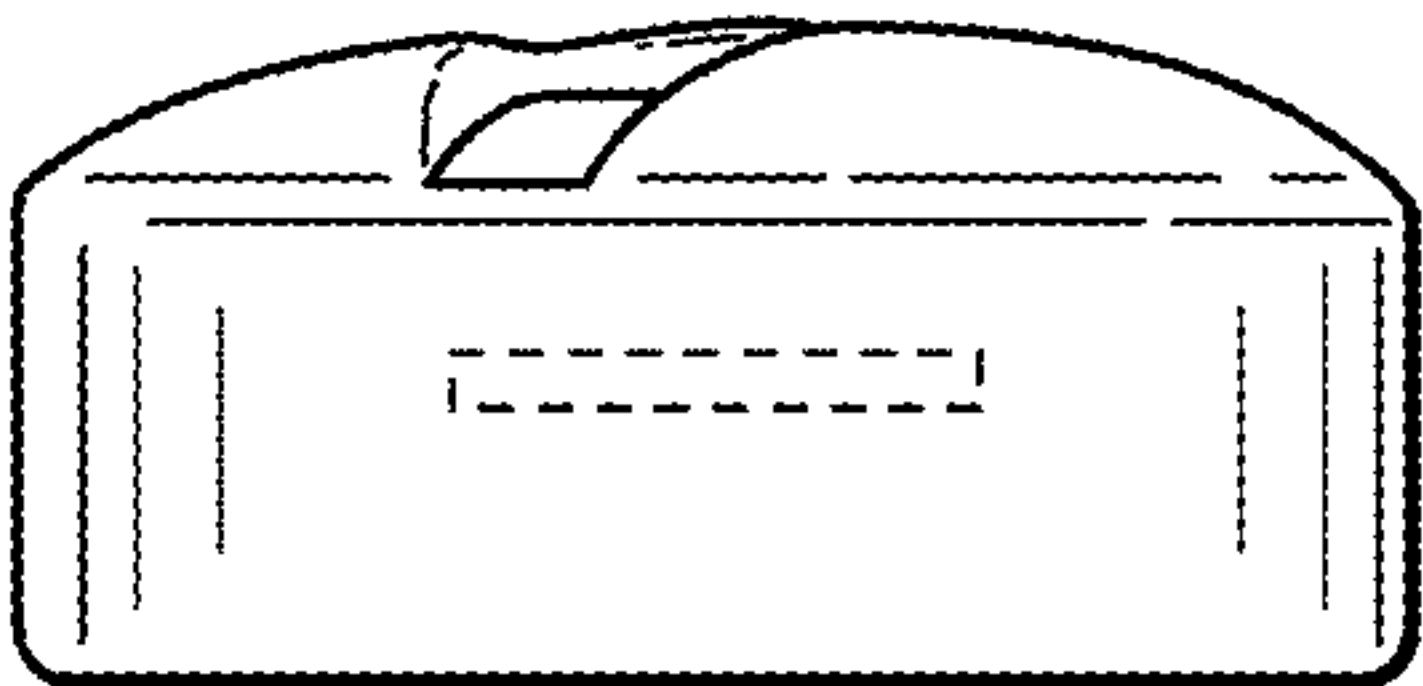
