(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a hooded endless body
scarf, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a head cover with
attached endless scarf, showing my new design with tie
strings of the design in a tied position and with a user's arms
shown traversing arm apertures of the design;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof, illustrated with the
tie strings untied and with the user's arms not traversing the
arm apertures;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view thereof, showing the
endless scarf portion thereof in a double-wrapped configu-
ration;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof as it would appear
when not being worn;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 10 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment
thereof, showing the tie strings in the tied position and with
the user's arms shown traversing the arm apertures of the
design;

FIG. 11 is a front perspective view of the second embodi-
ment, illustrated with the tie strings untied and with the
user's arms not traversing the arm apertures;

FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of FIG. 10 as it would
appear when not being worn;

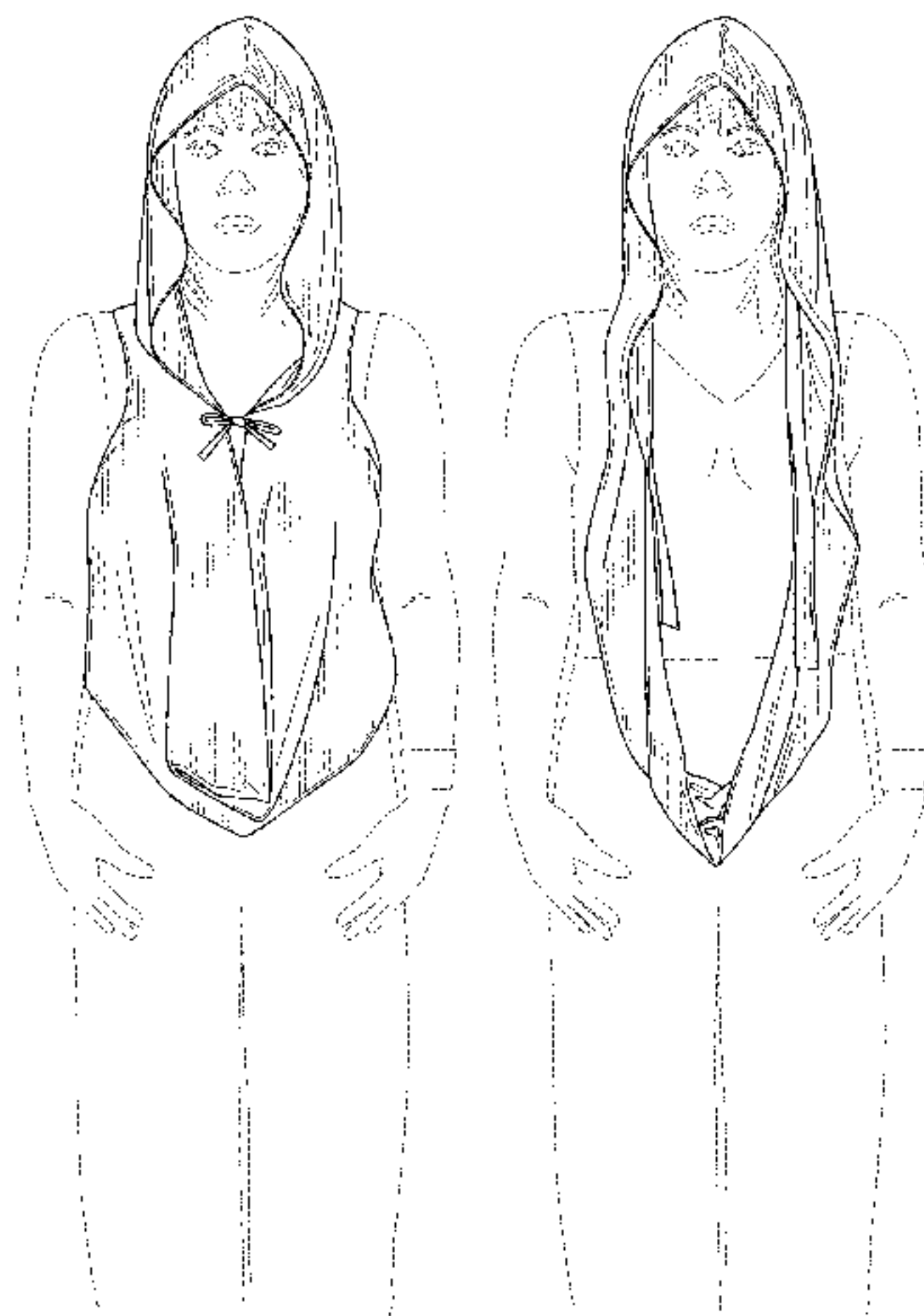
FIG. 13 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 10;

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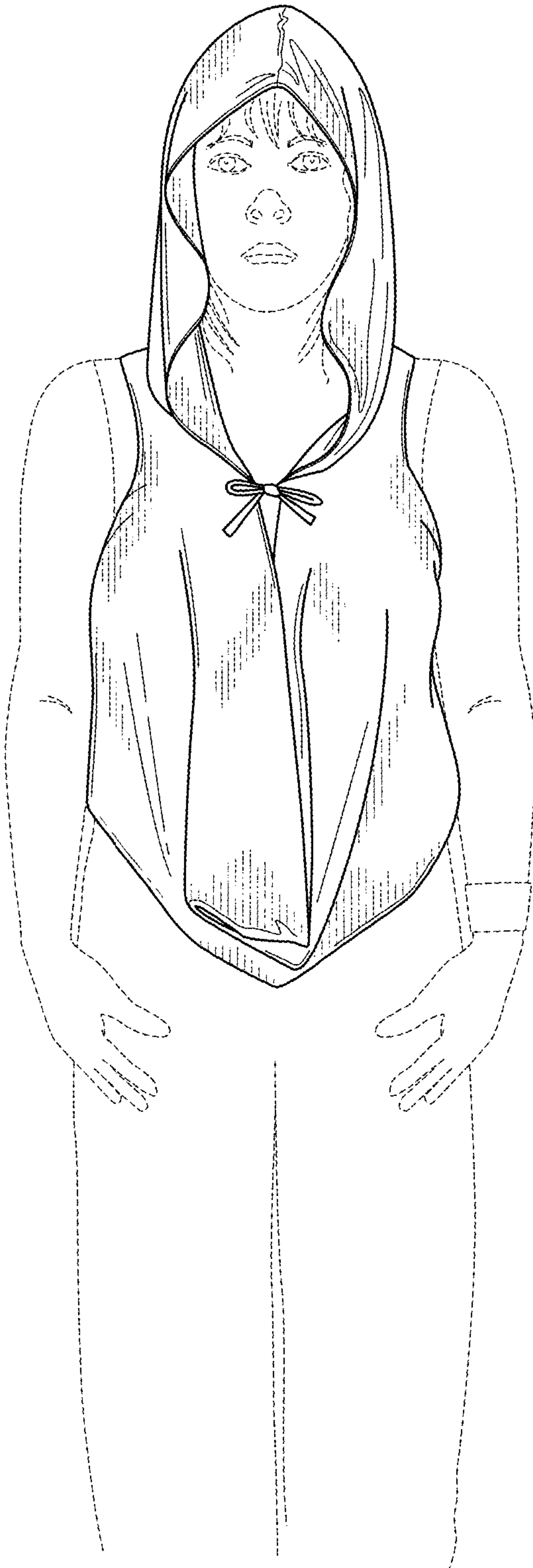

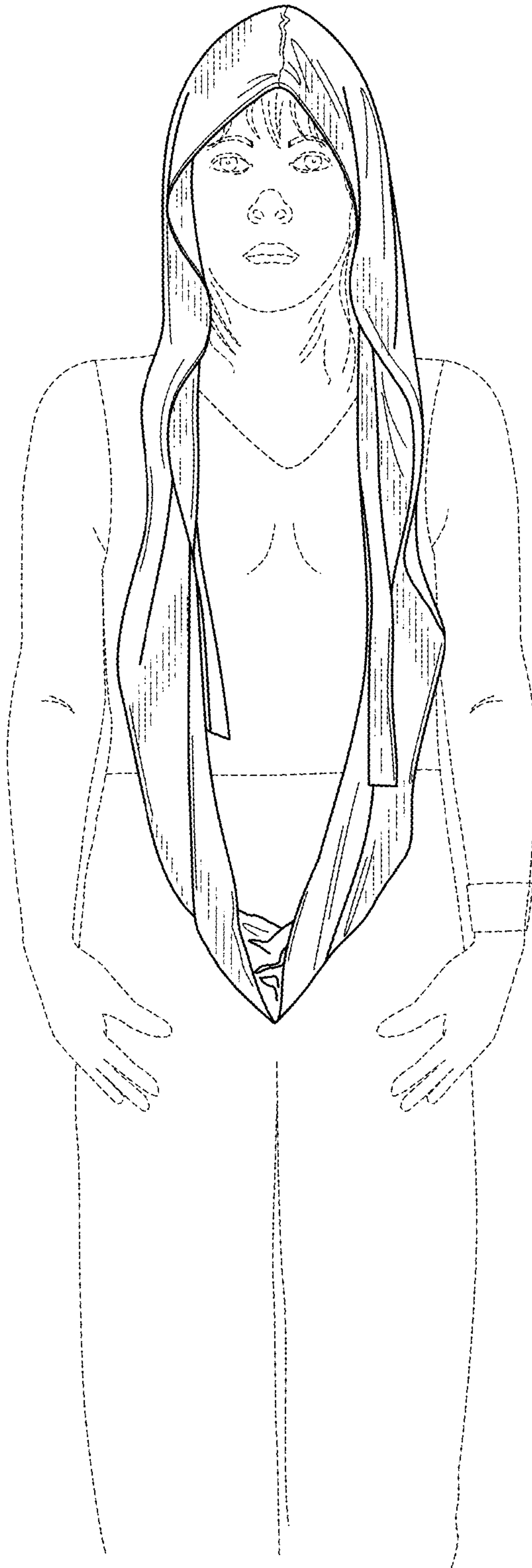

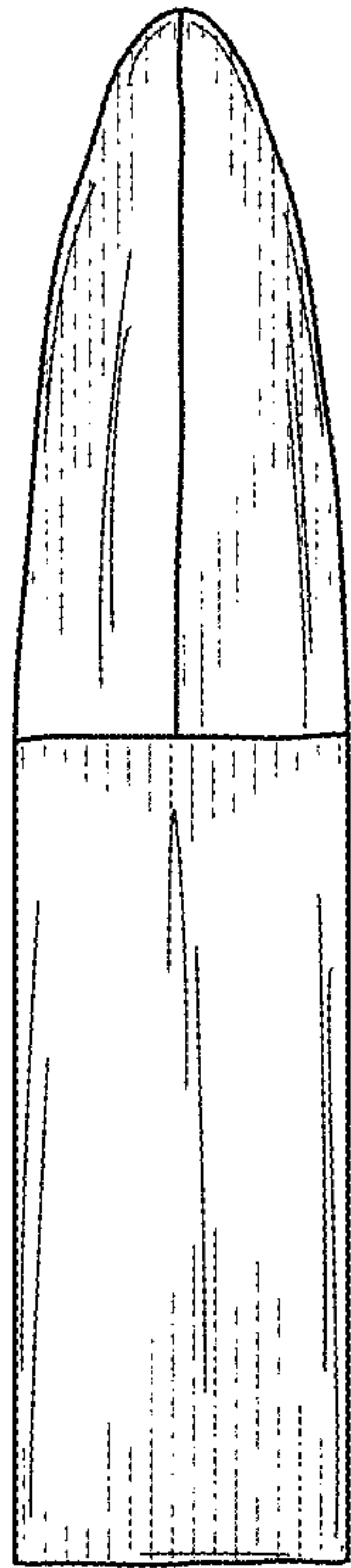

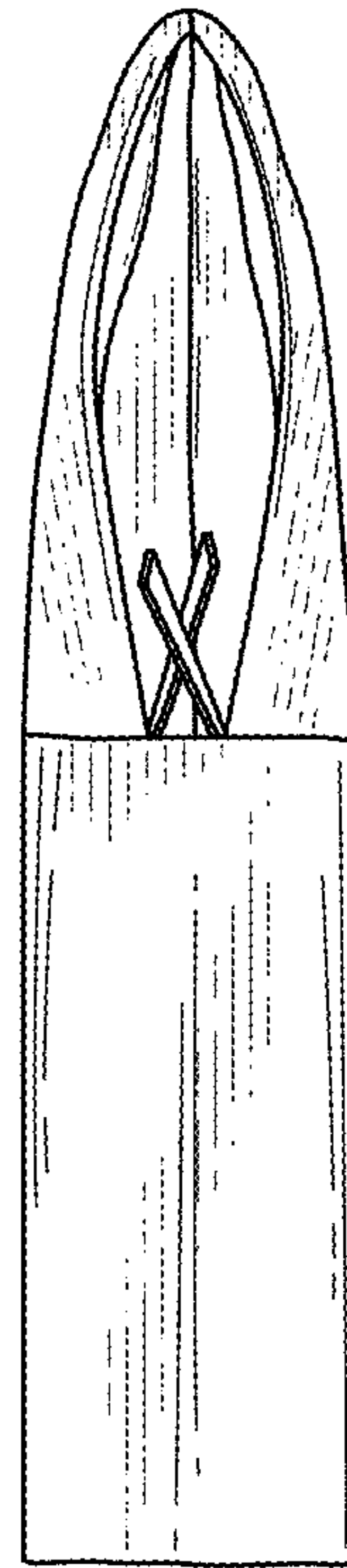

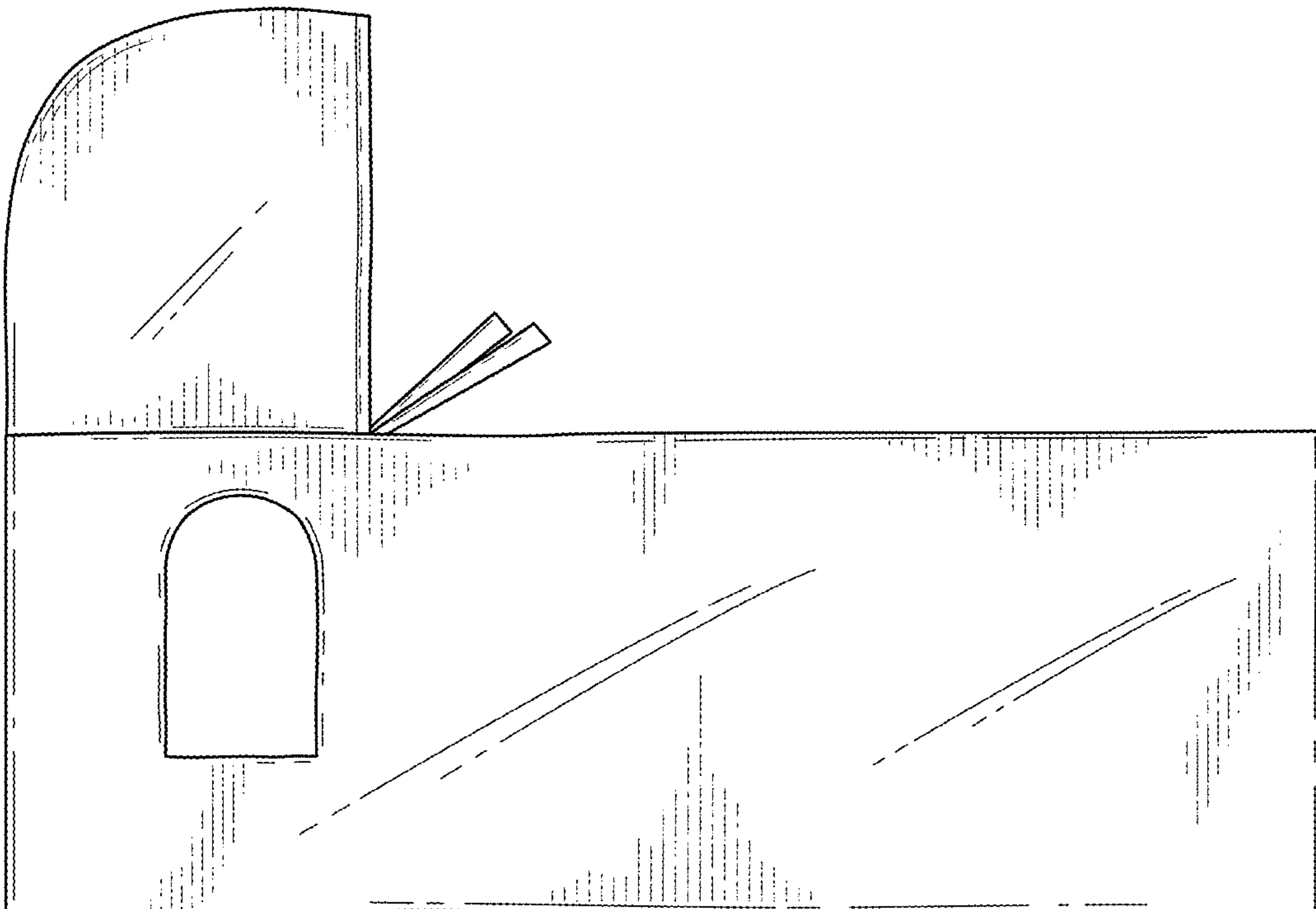

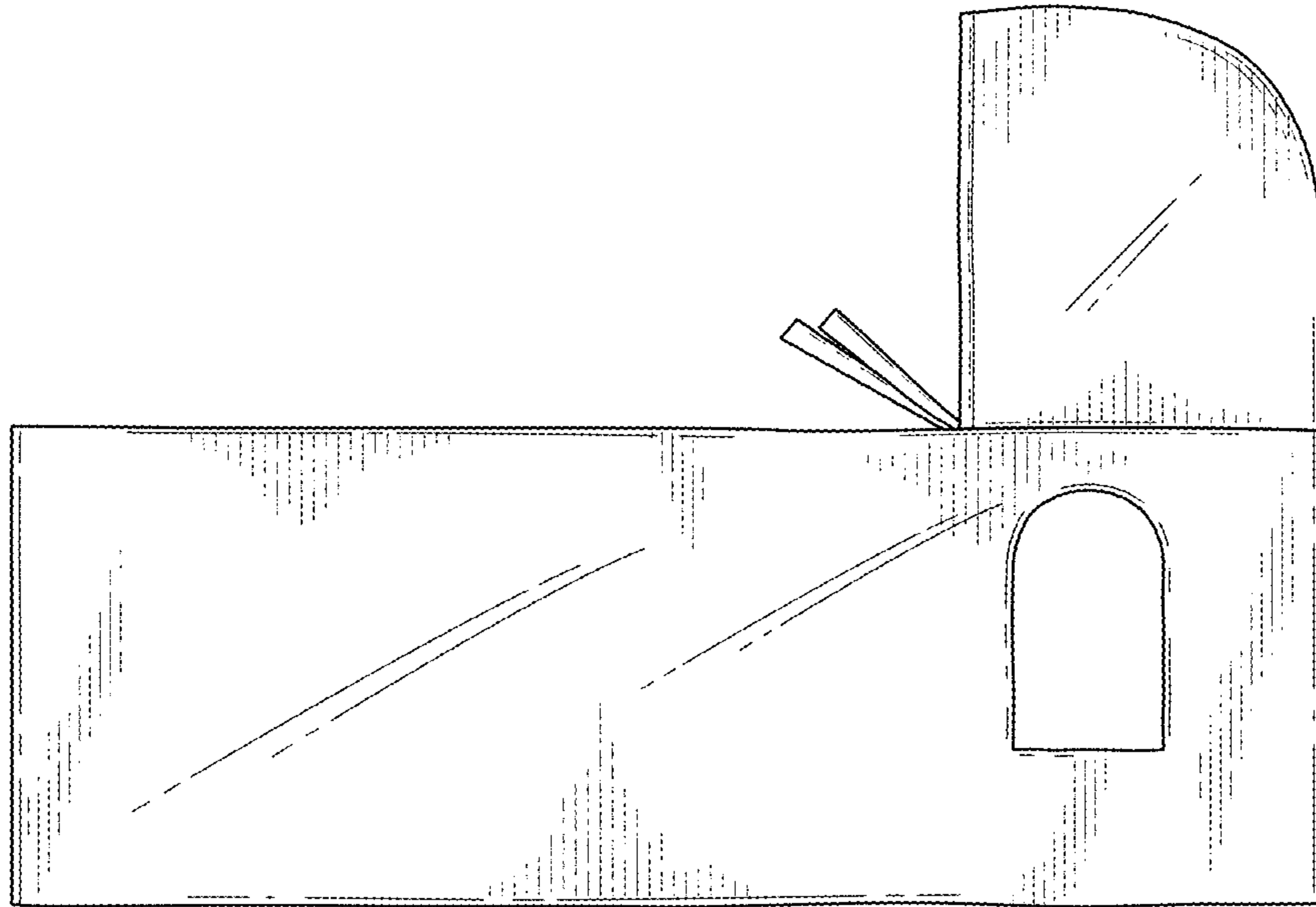

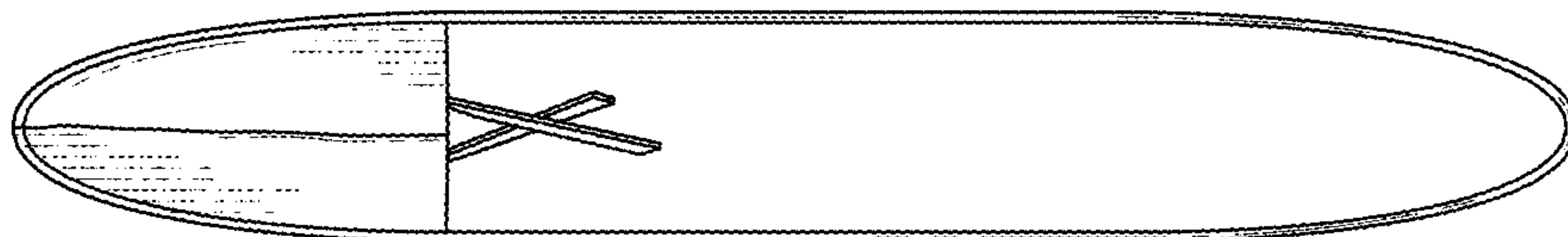

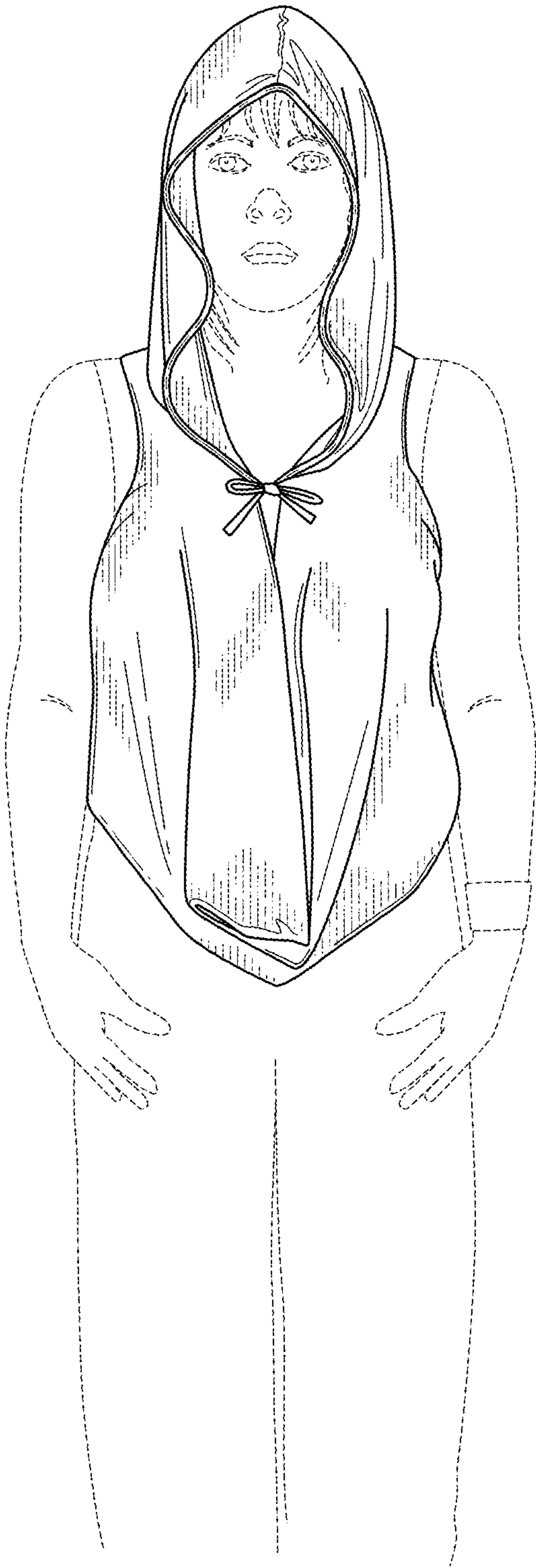

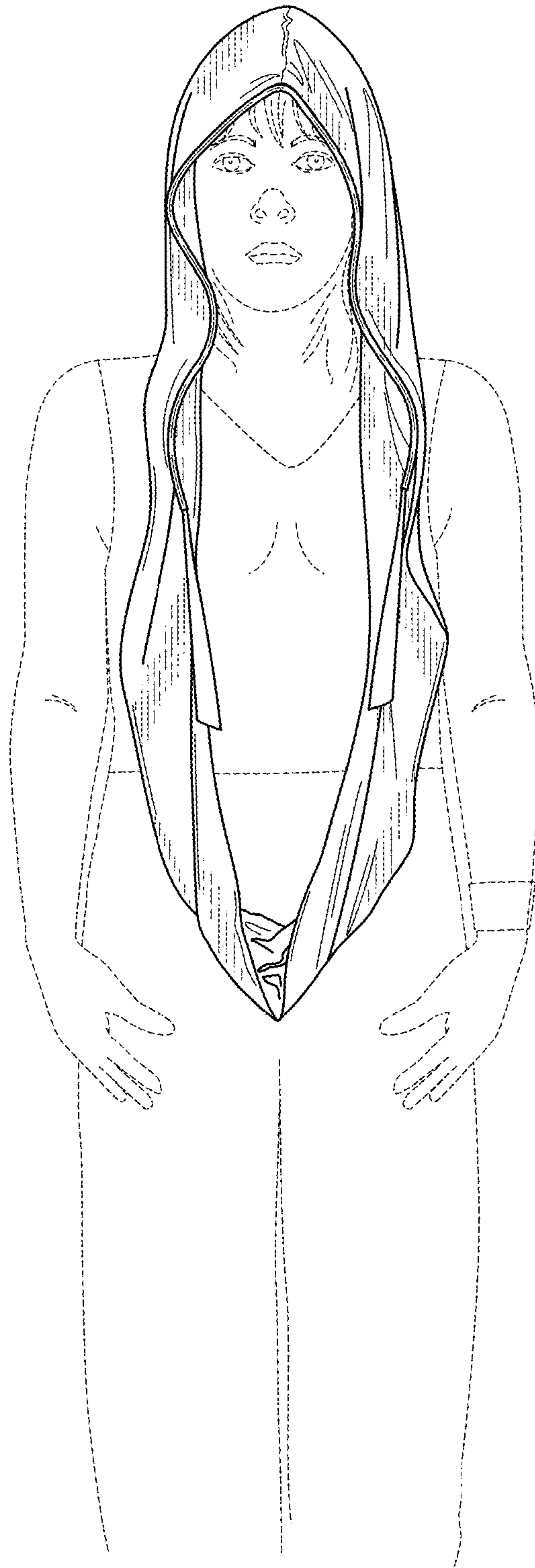

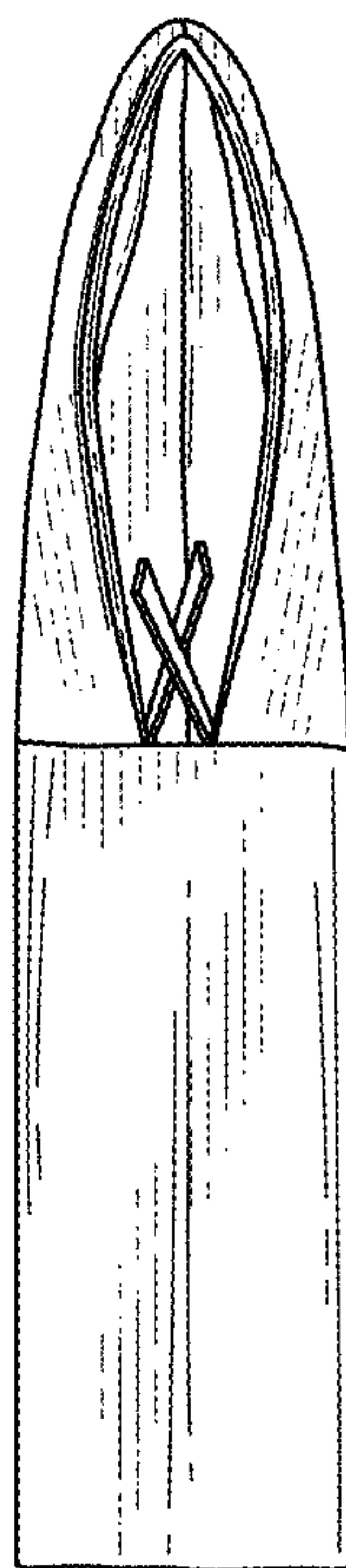

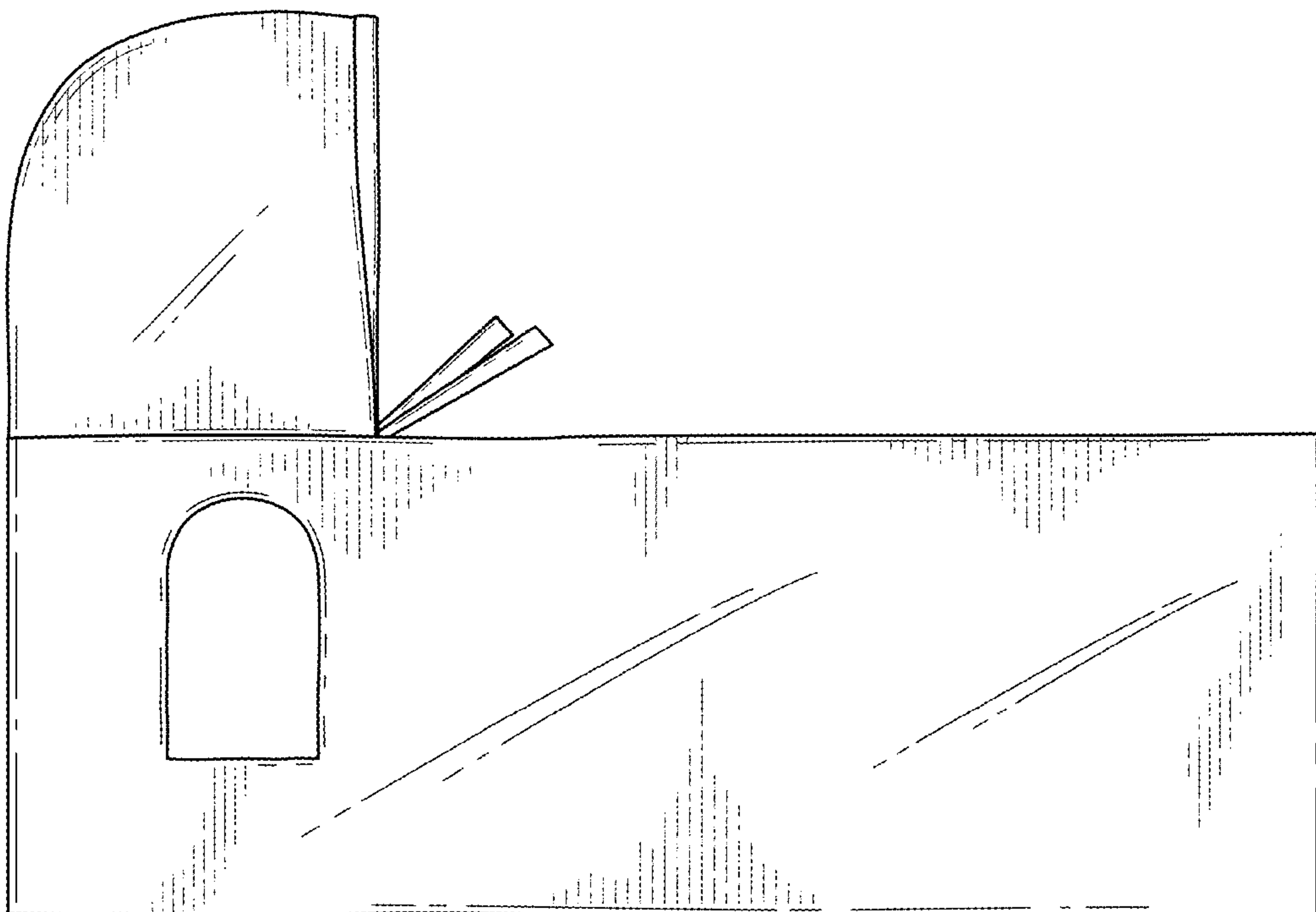

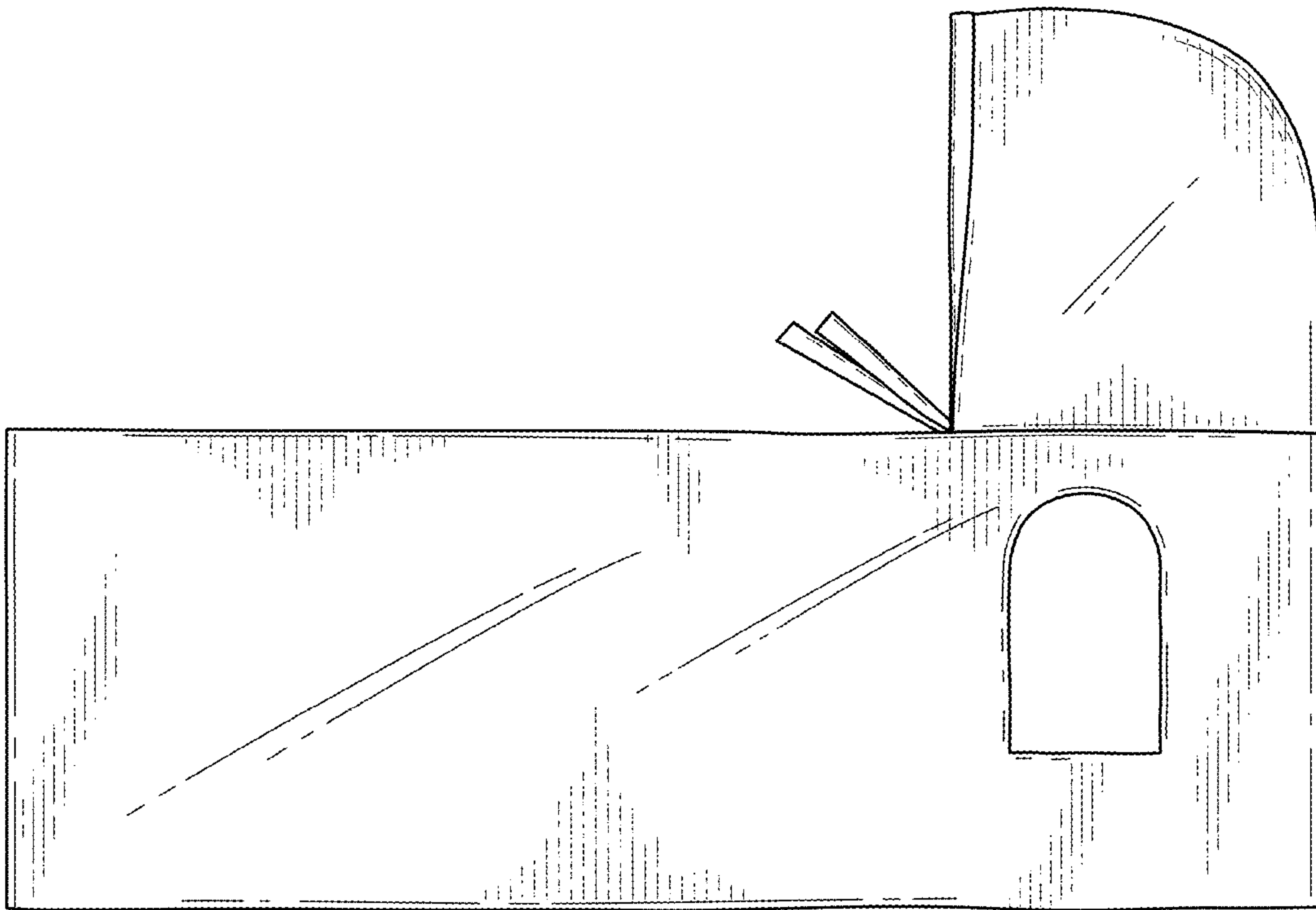

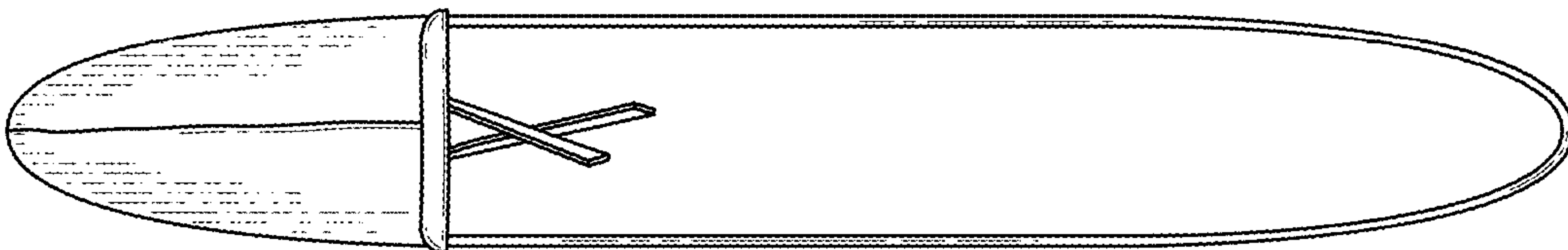
