DESCRIPTION

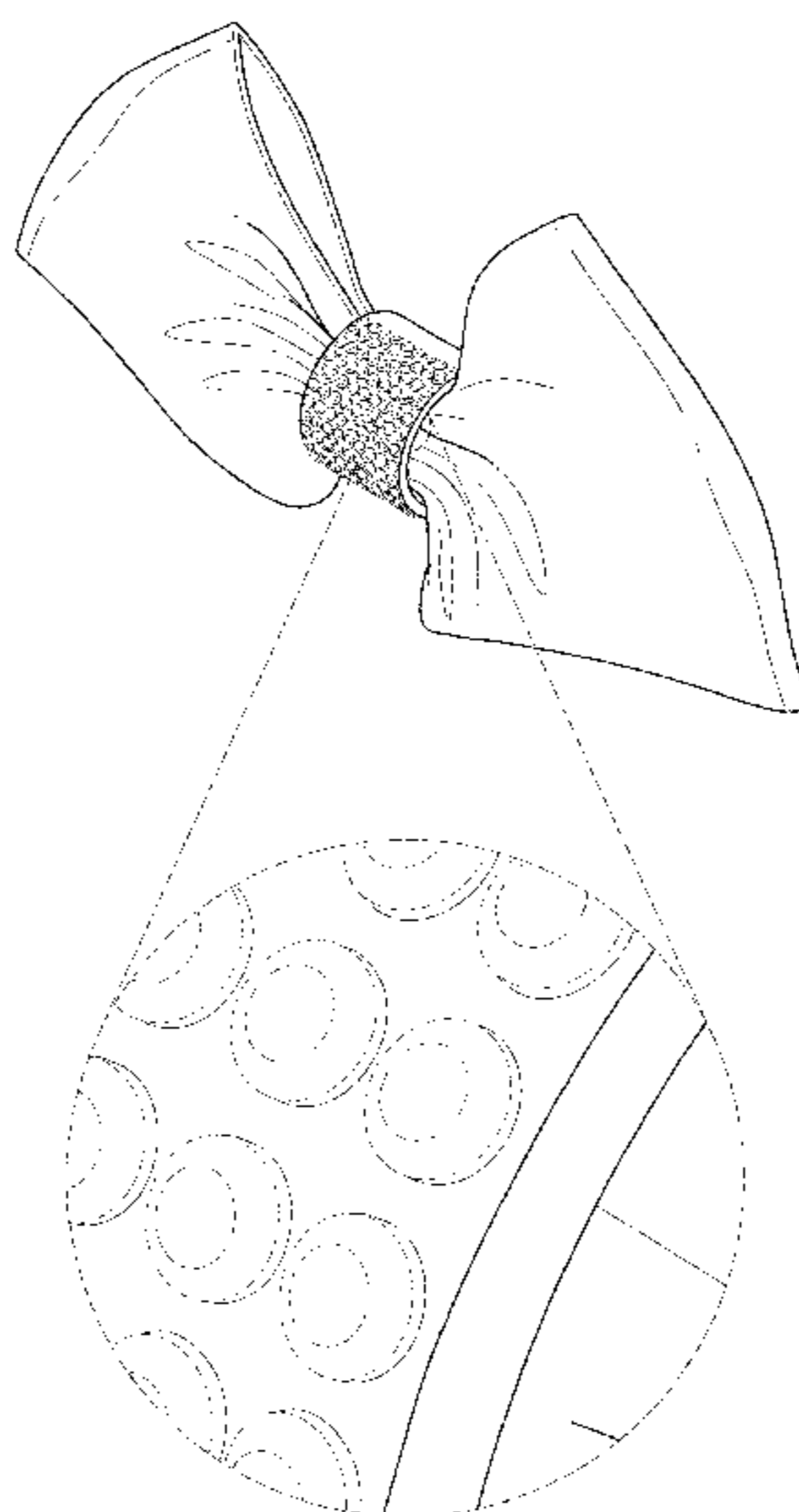
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a first of a bow showing my new design.

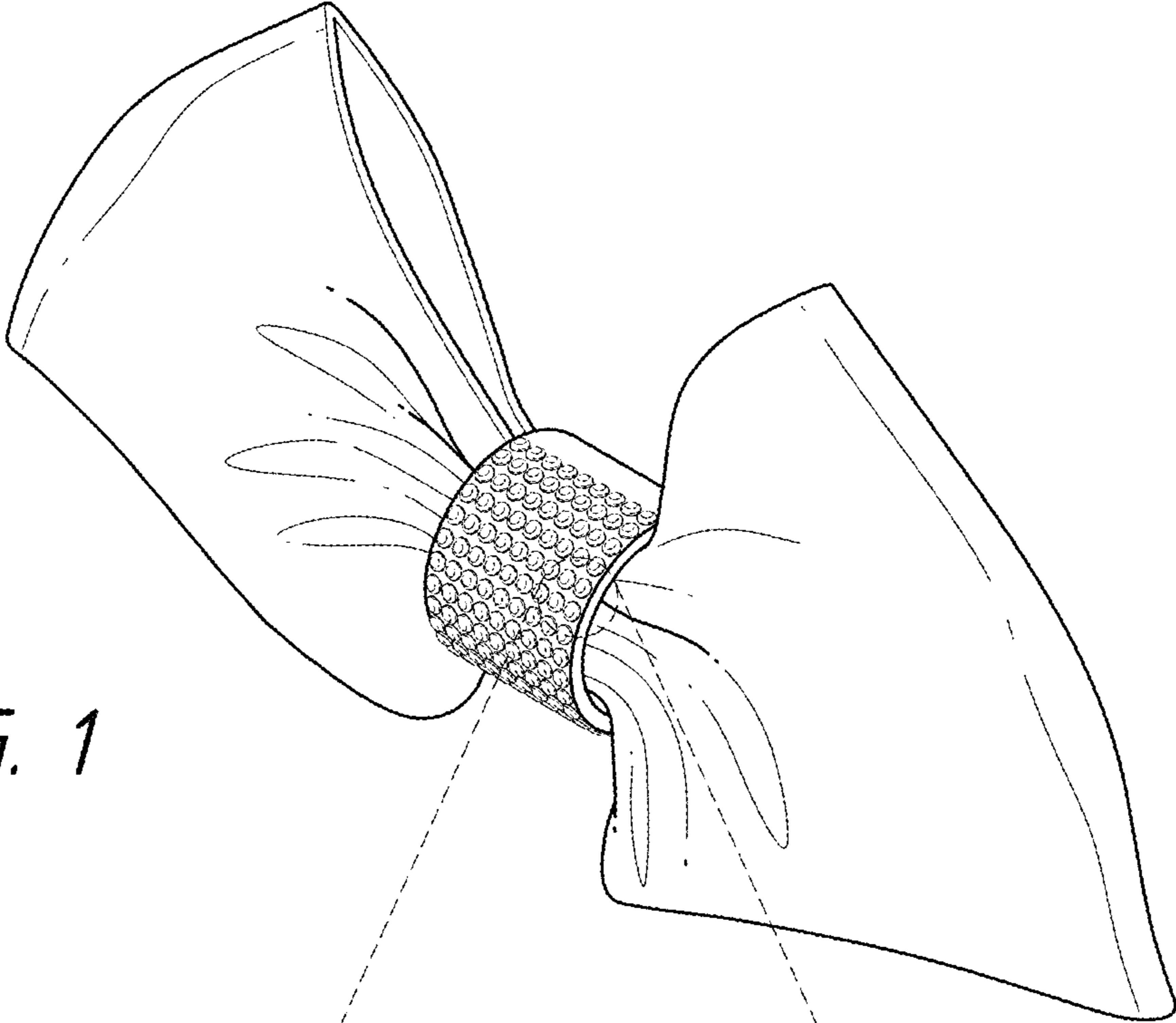
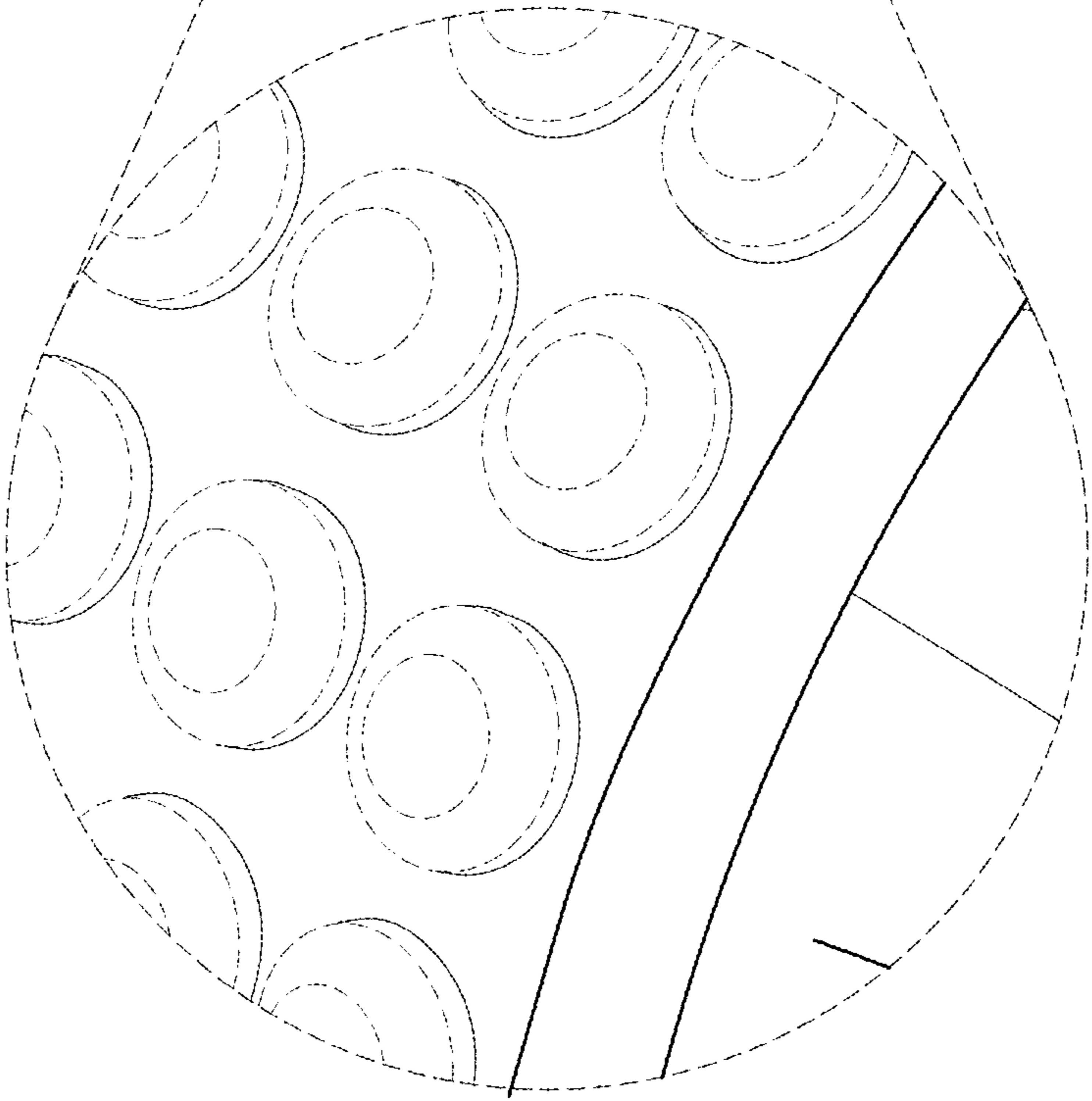

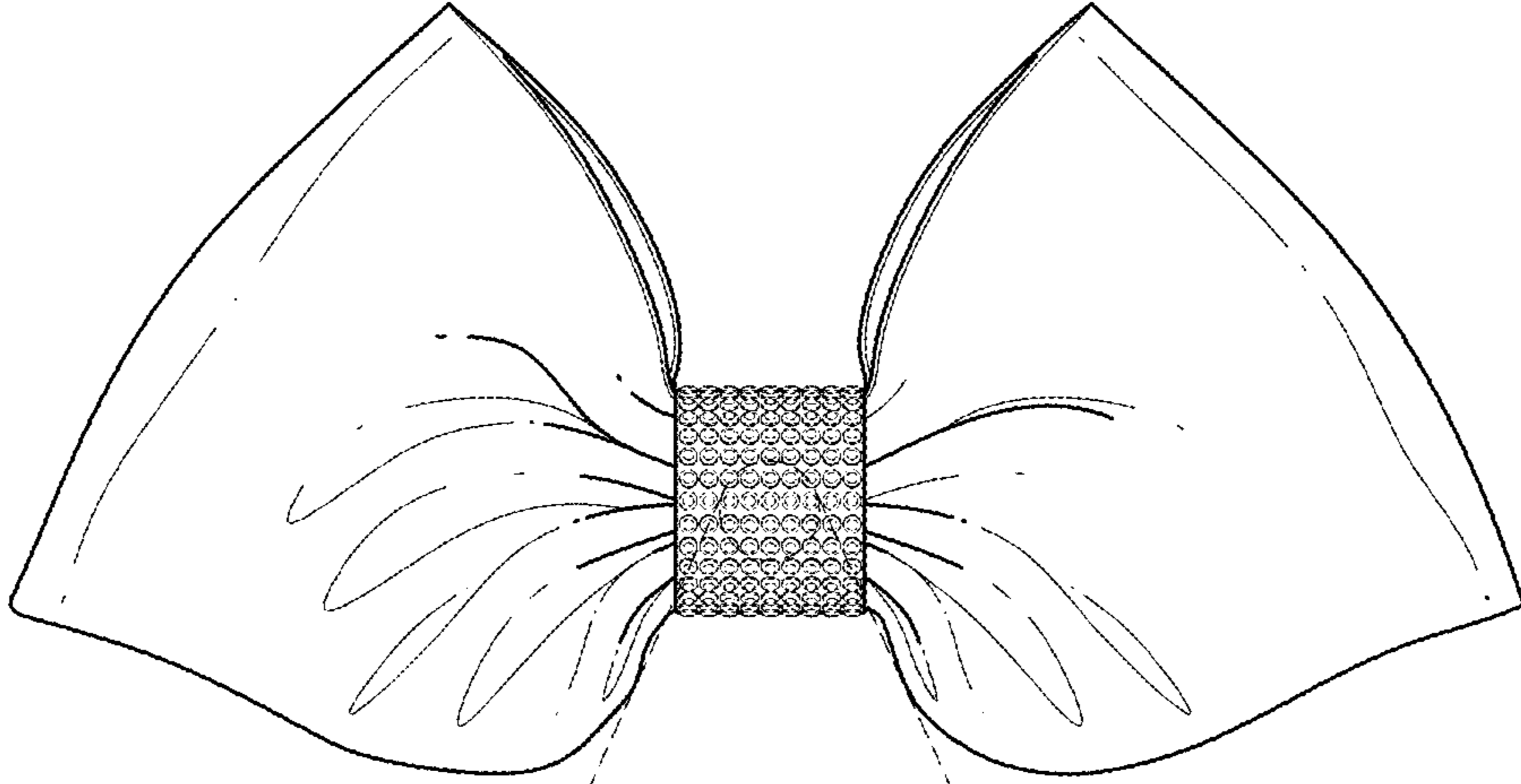
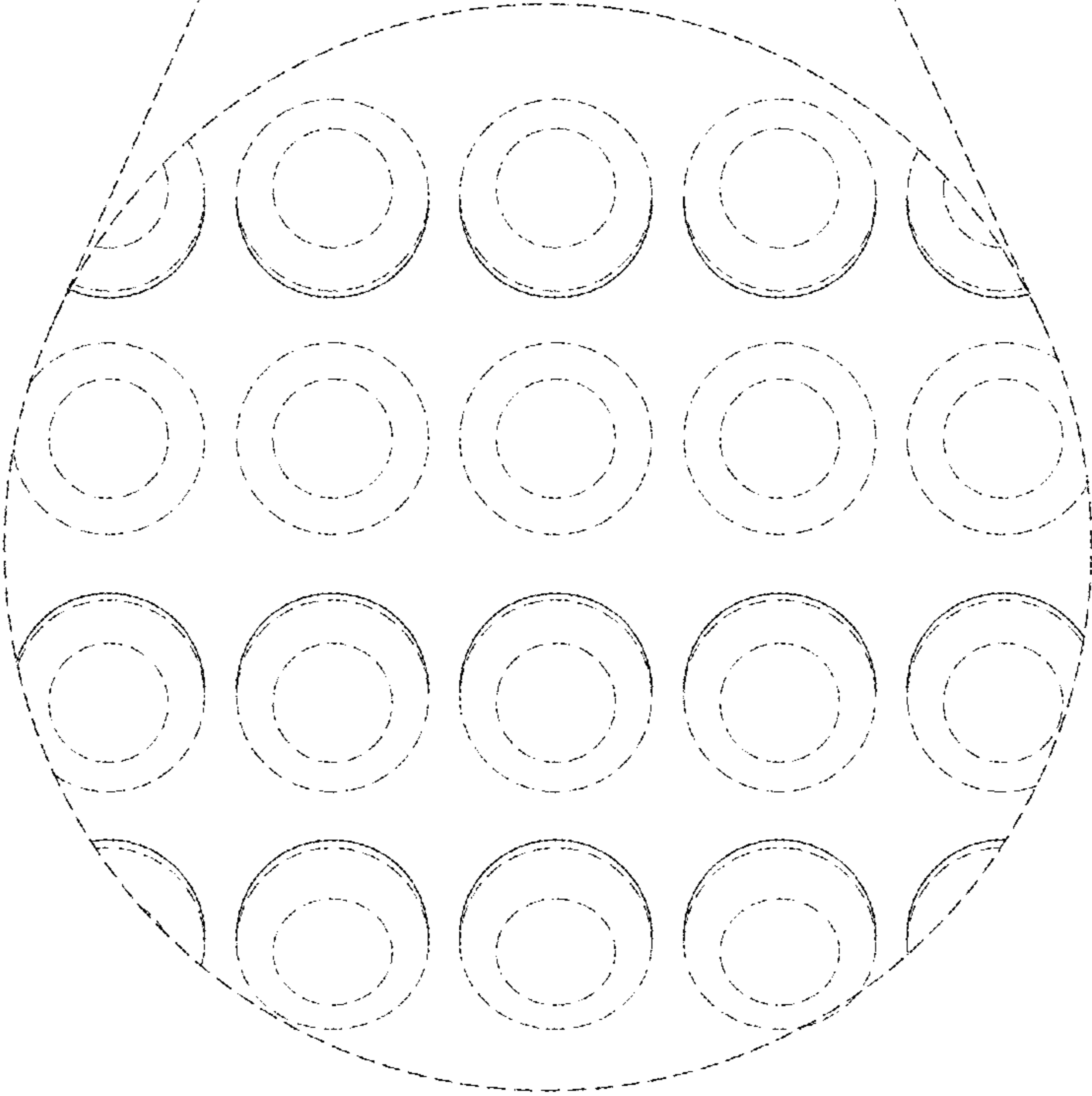

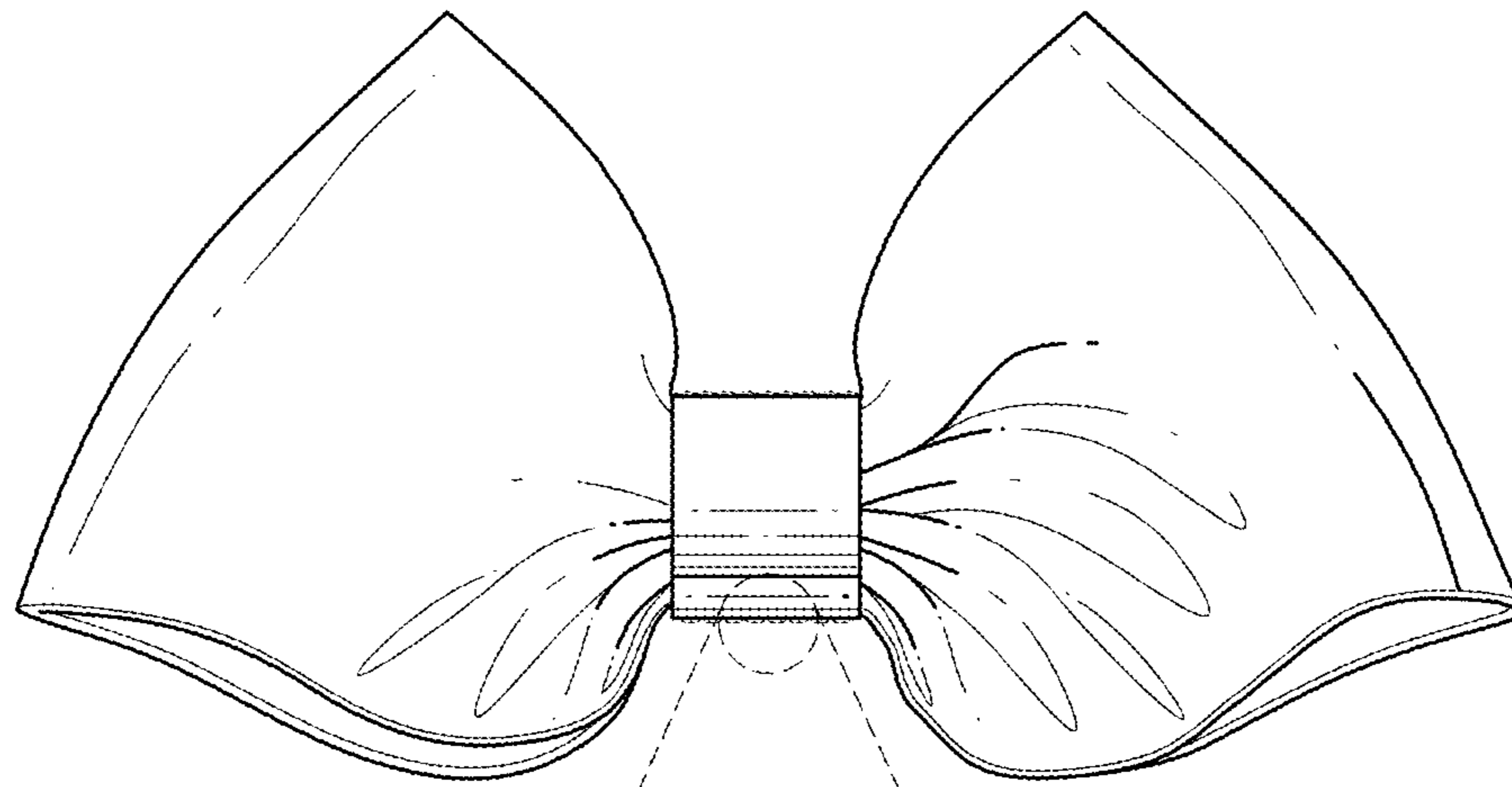
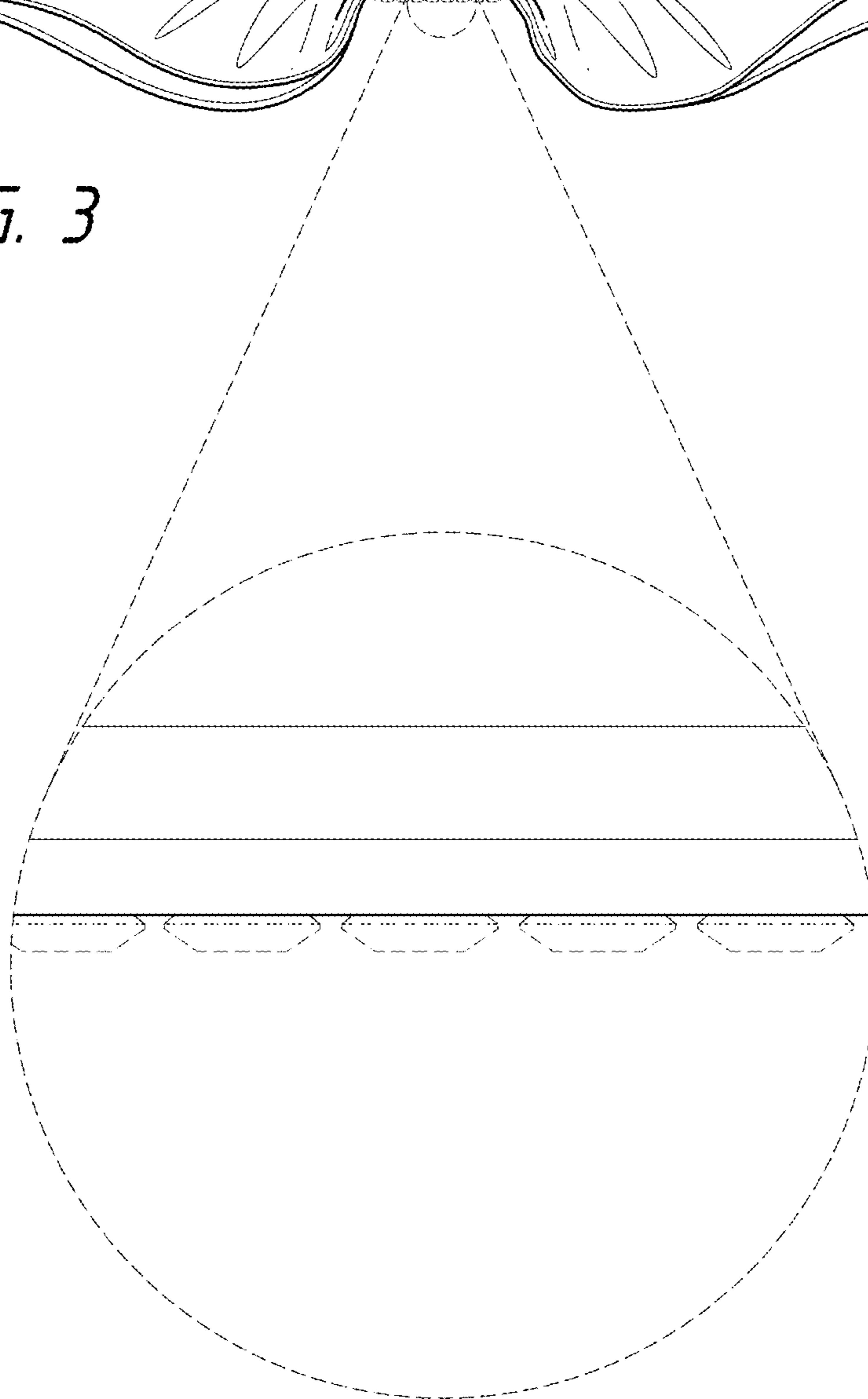

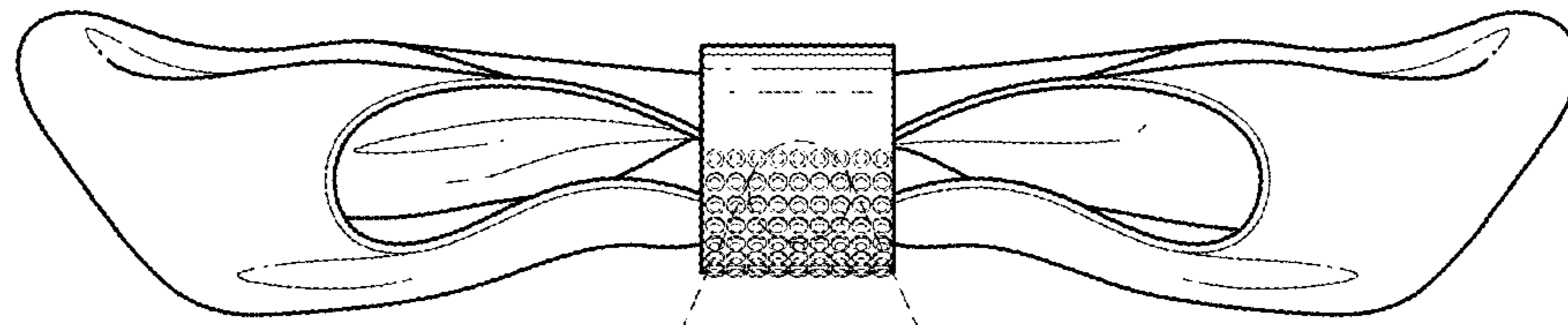
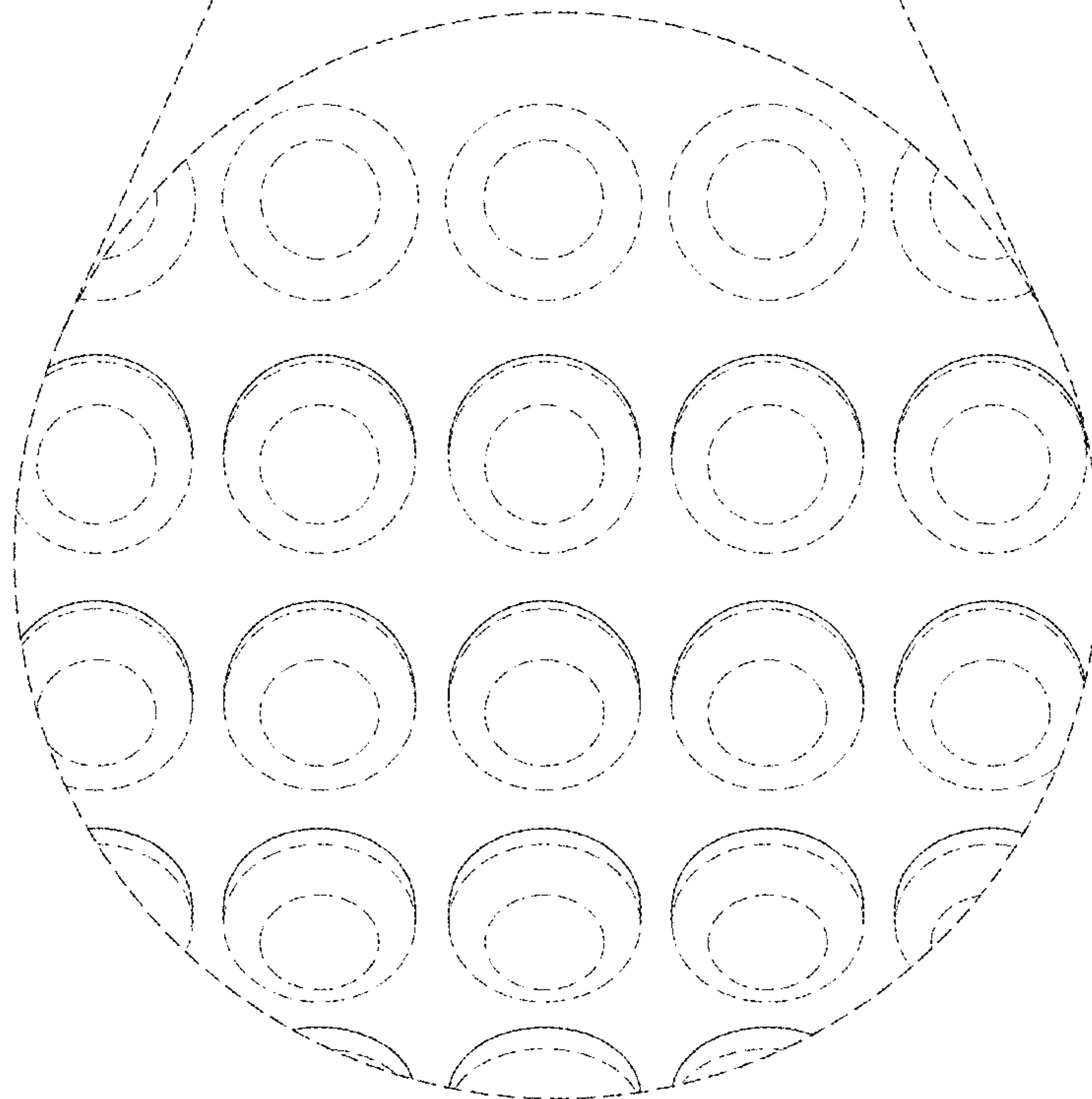

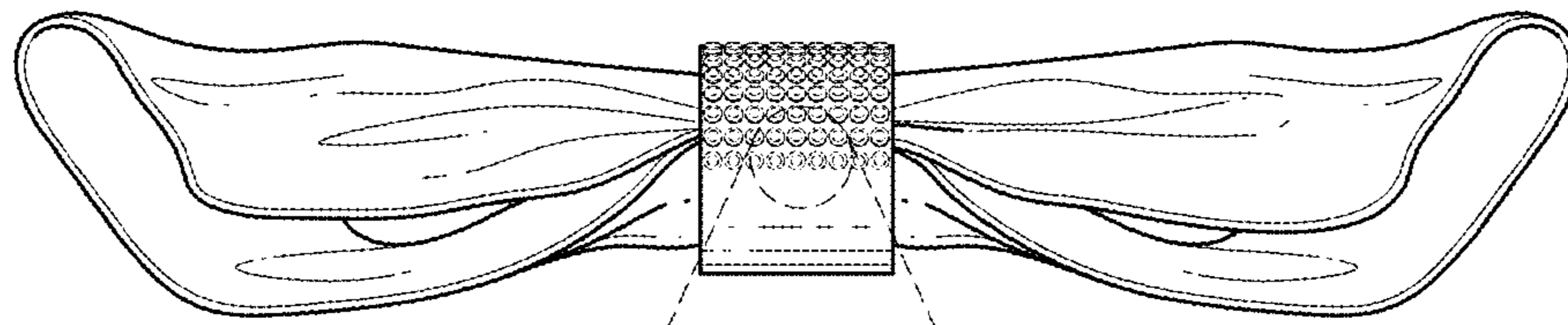
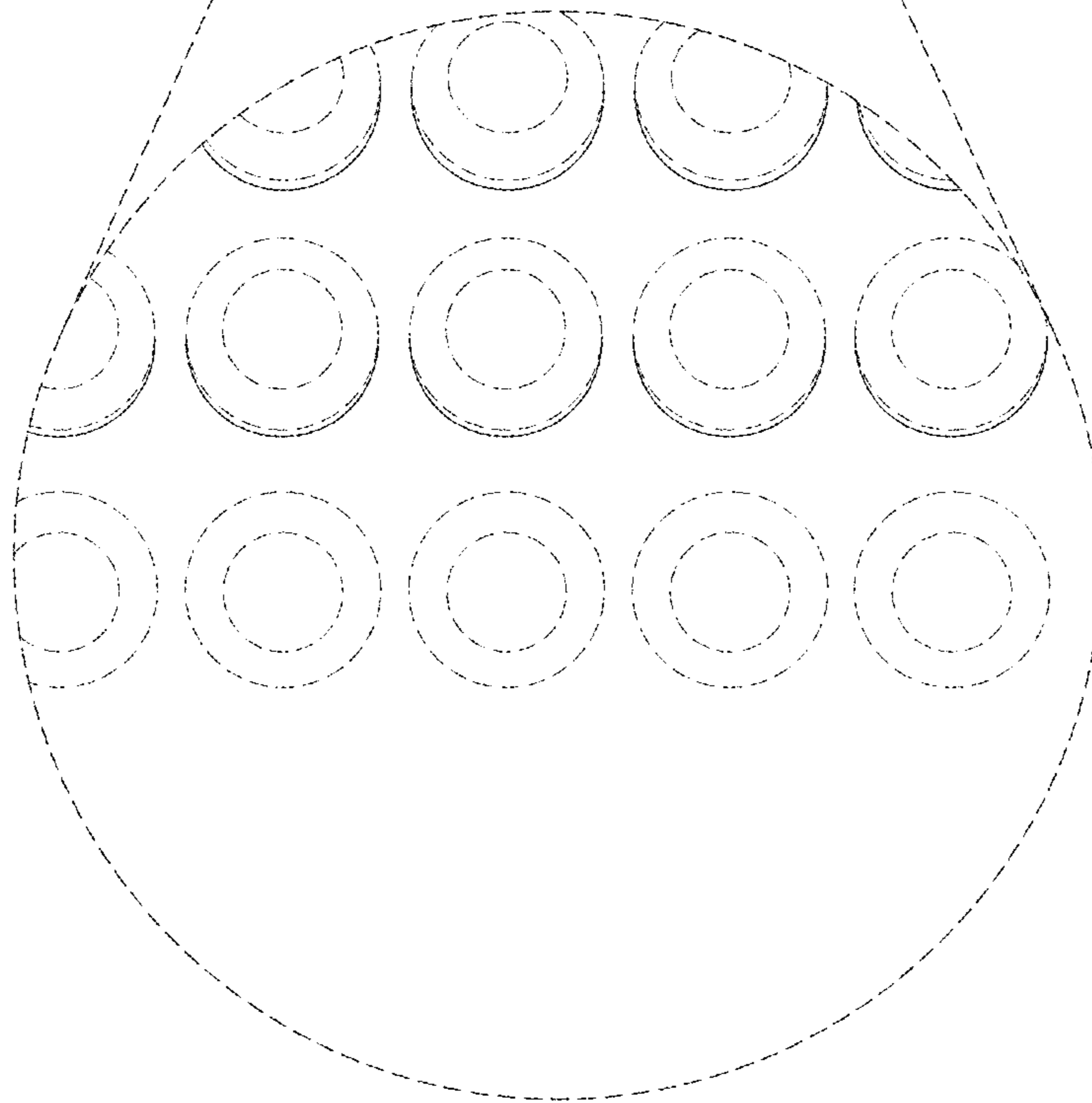
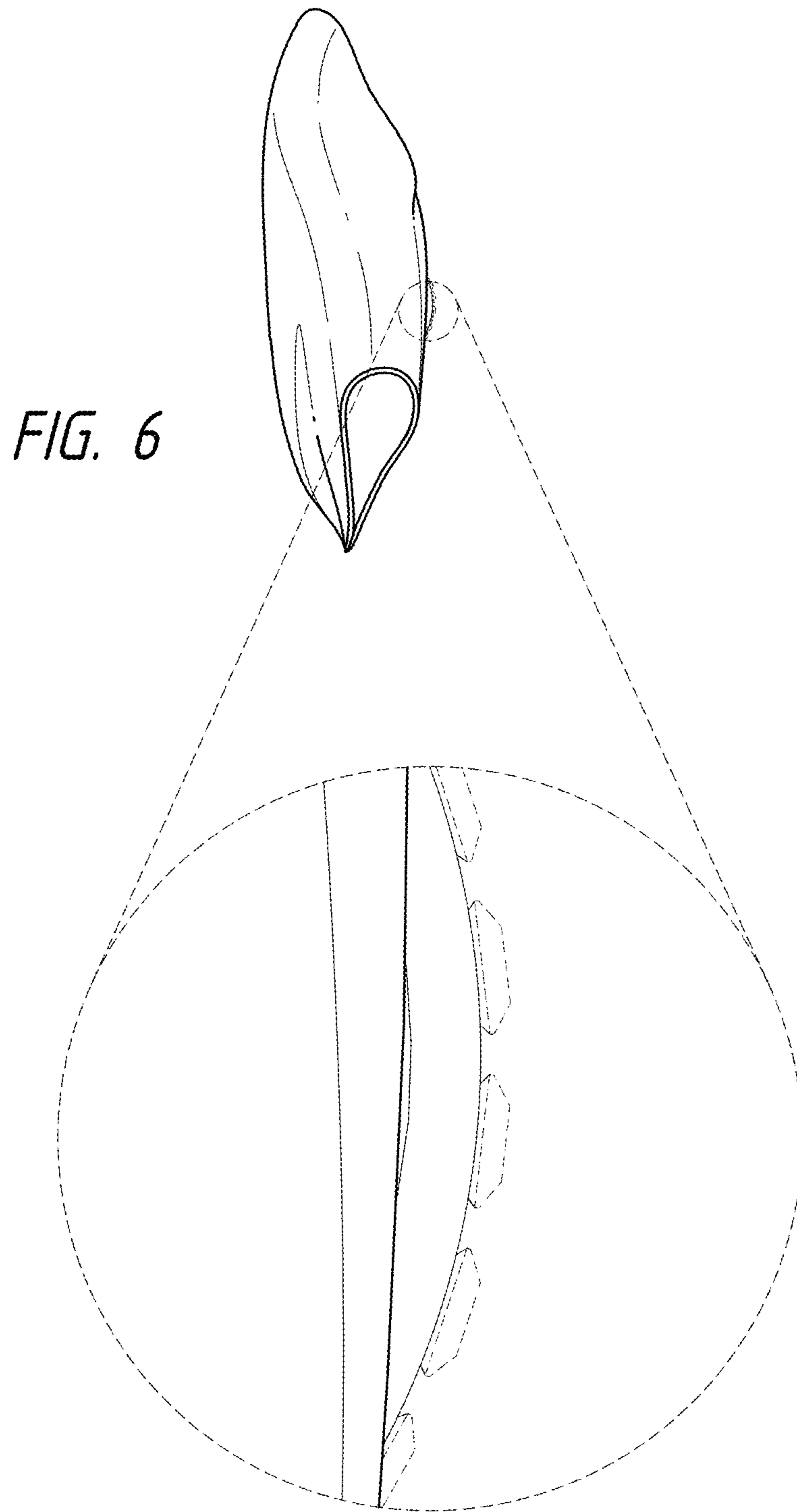

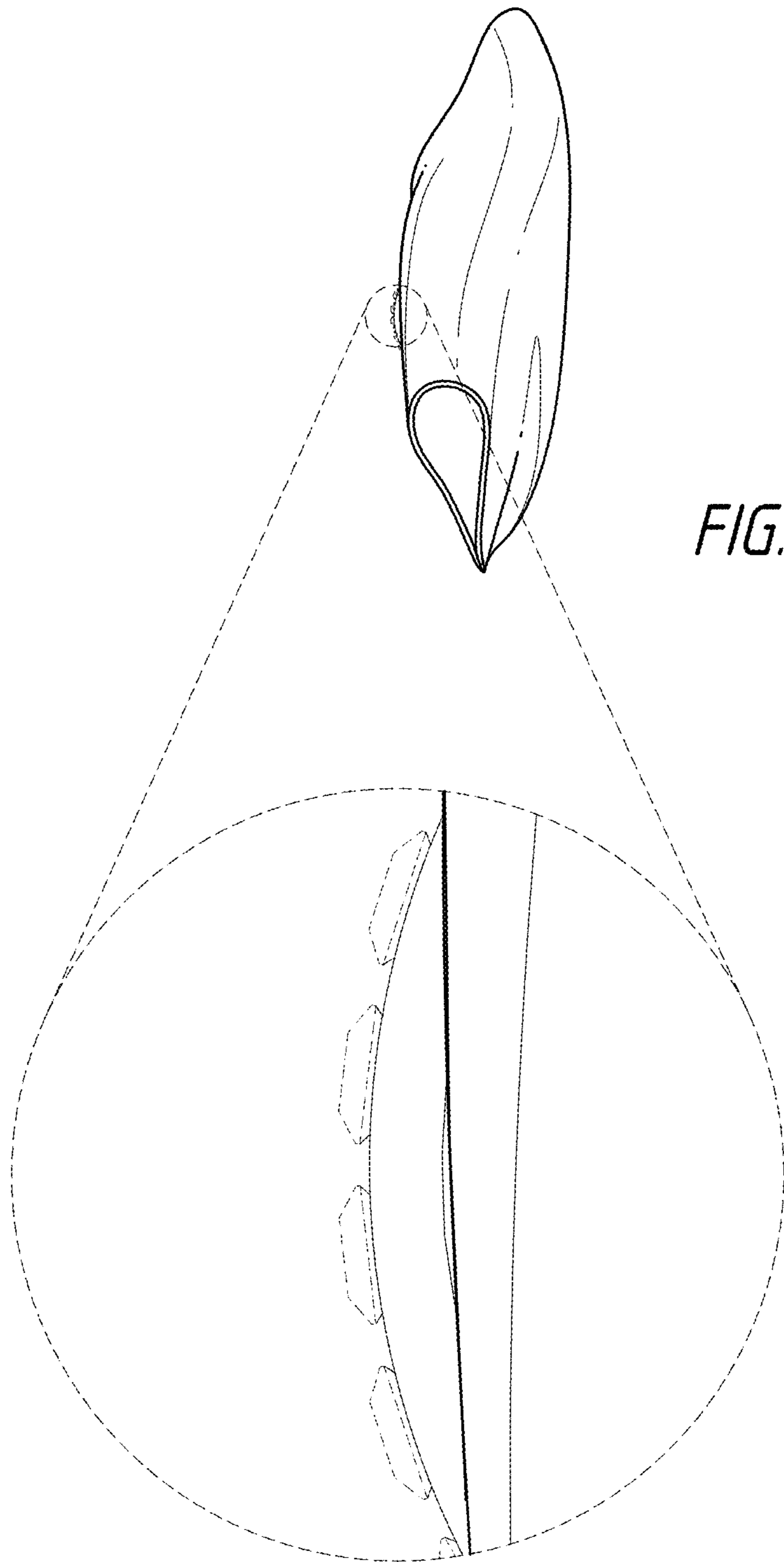

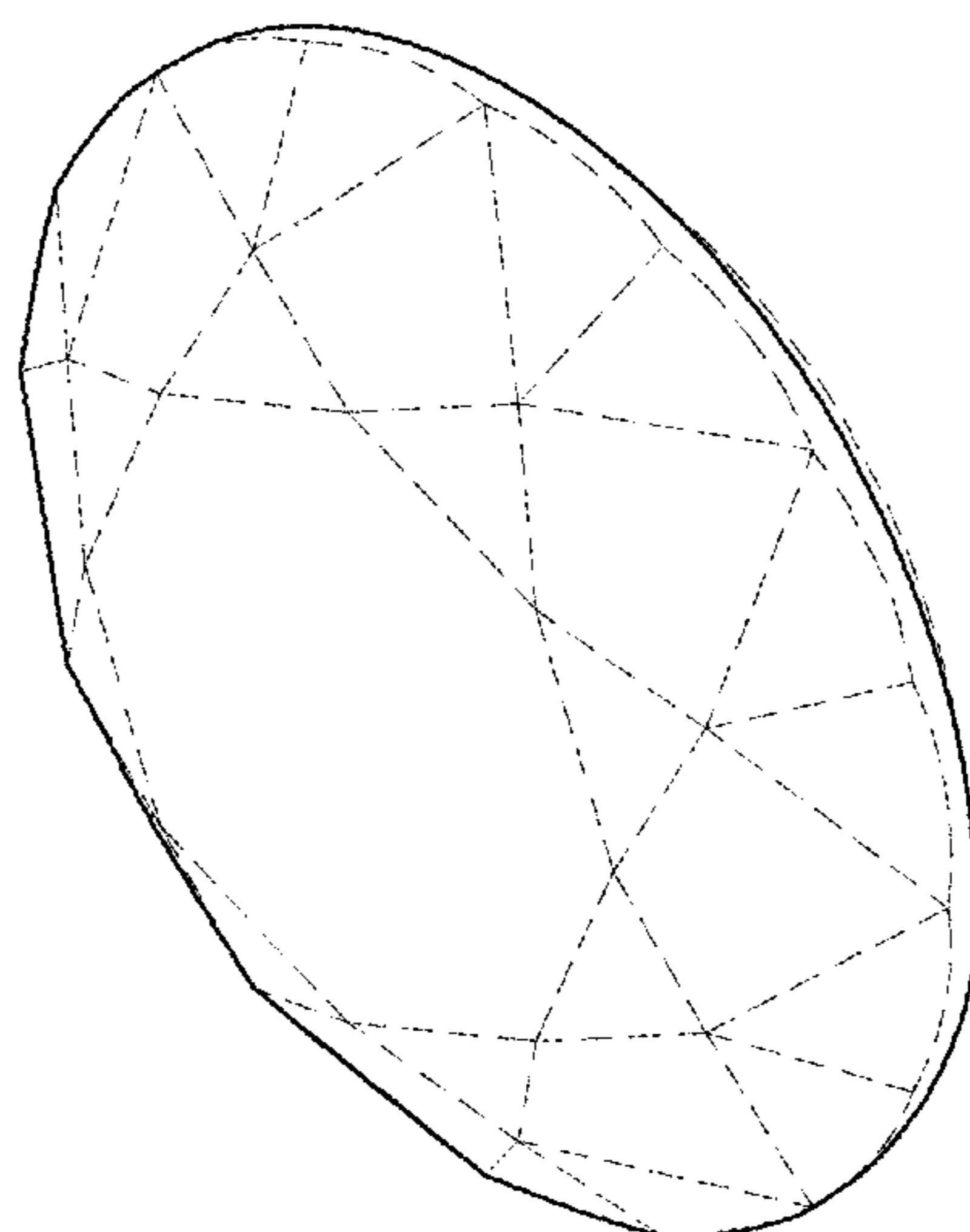

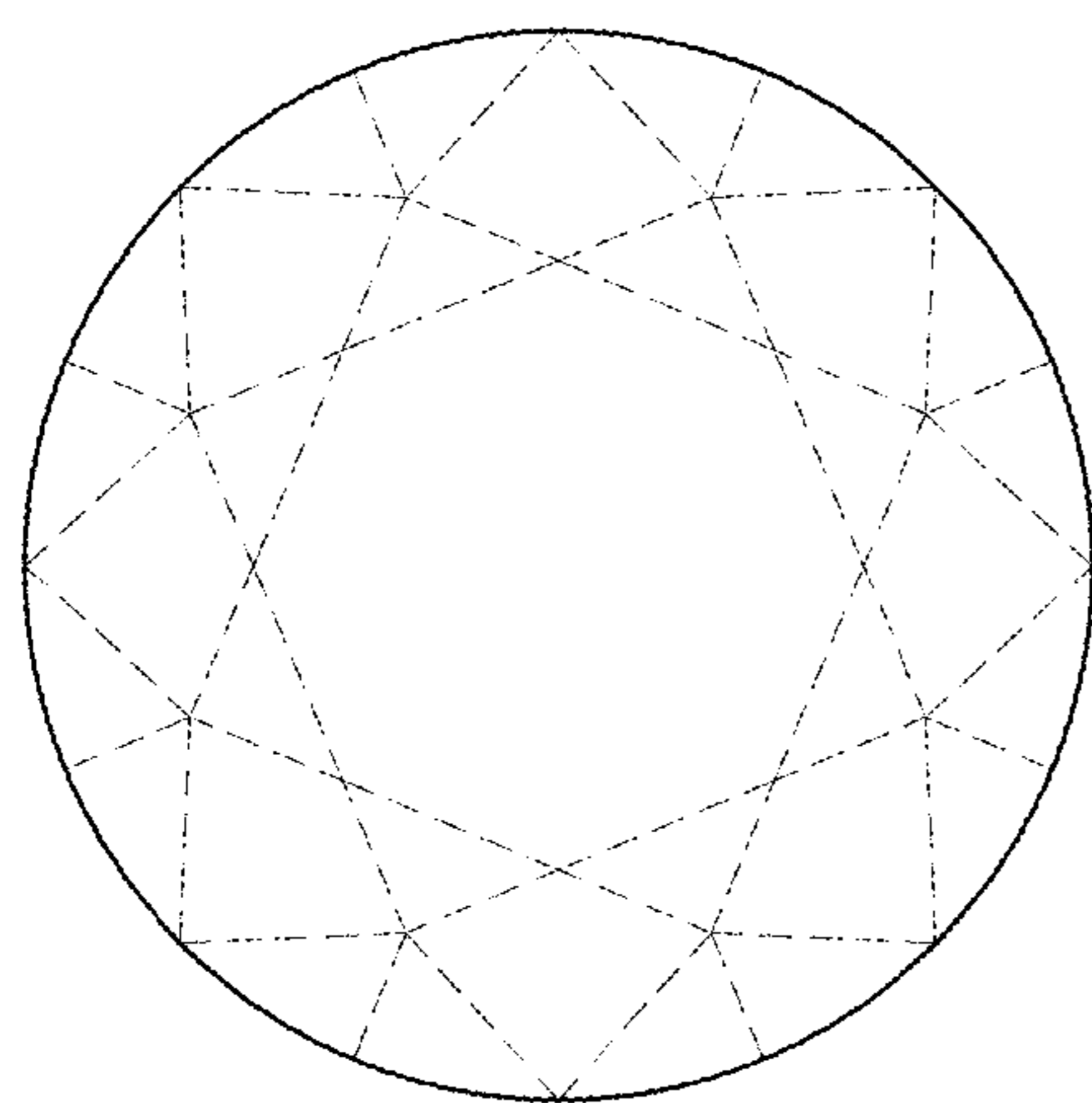

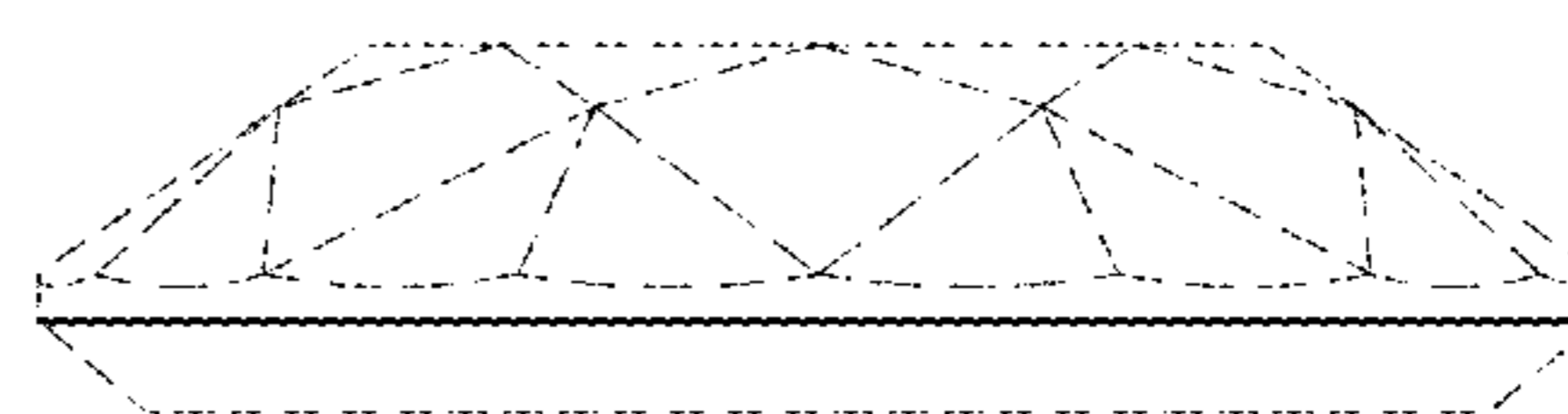
