DESCRIPTION

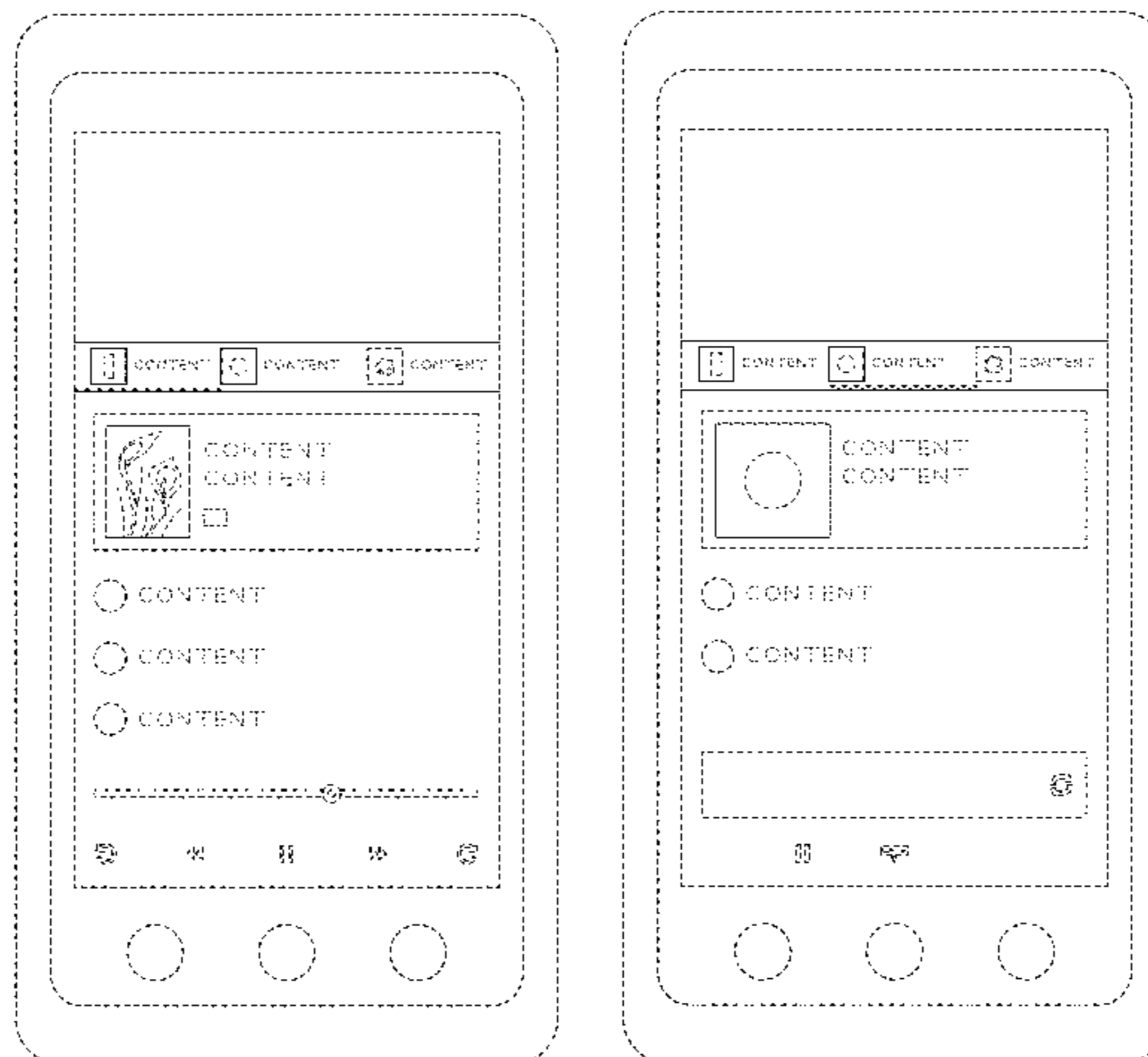
FIG. 1 is a front view of the first image in a sequence for a display screen with animated graphical user interface showing our new design in a first embodiment, on a device; FIG. 2 is the second image thereof; FIG. 3 is a front view of the first image in a sequence for a display screen with animated graphical user interface showing our new design in a second embodiment, on a tablet; and, FIG. 4 is the second image thereof. The appearance of the animated graphical user interface sequentially transitions between the images shown in FIGS. 1-2 and FIGS. 3-4 respectively. The process or period in which one image transitions to another forms no part of the claimed design. The broken line showing of a device in FIGS. 1 and 2 and a tablet in FIGS. 3 and 4 illustrates environment. The remainder of the broken lines illustrate portions of the display screen with animated graphical user interface. The broken lines form no part of the claimed design.

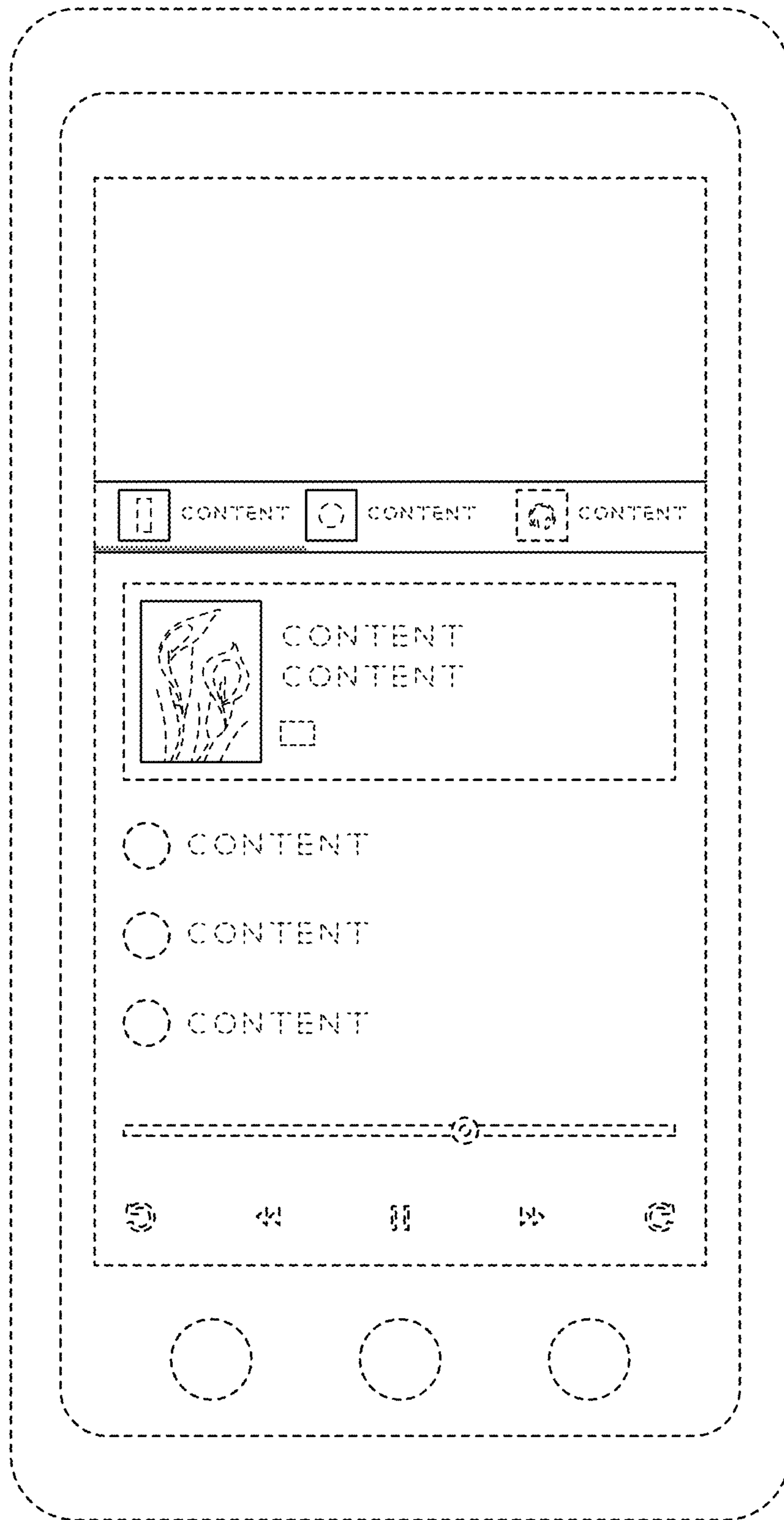
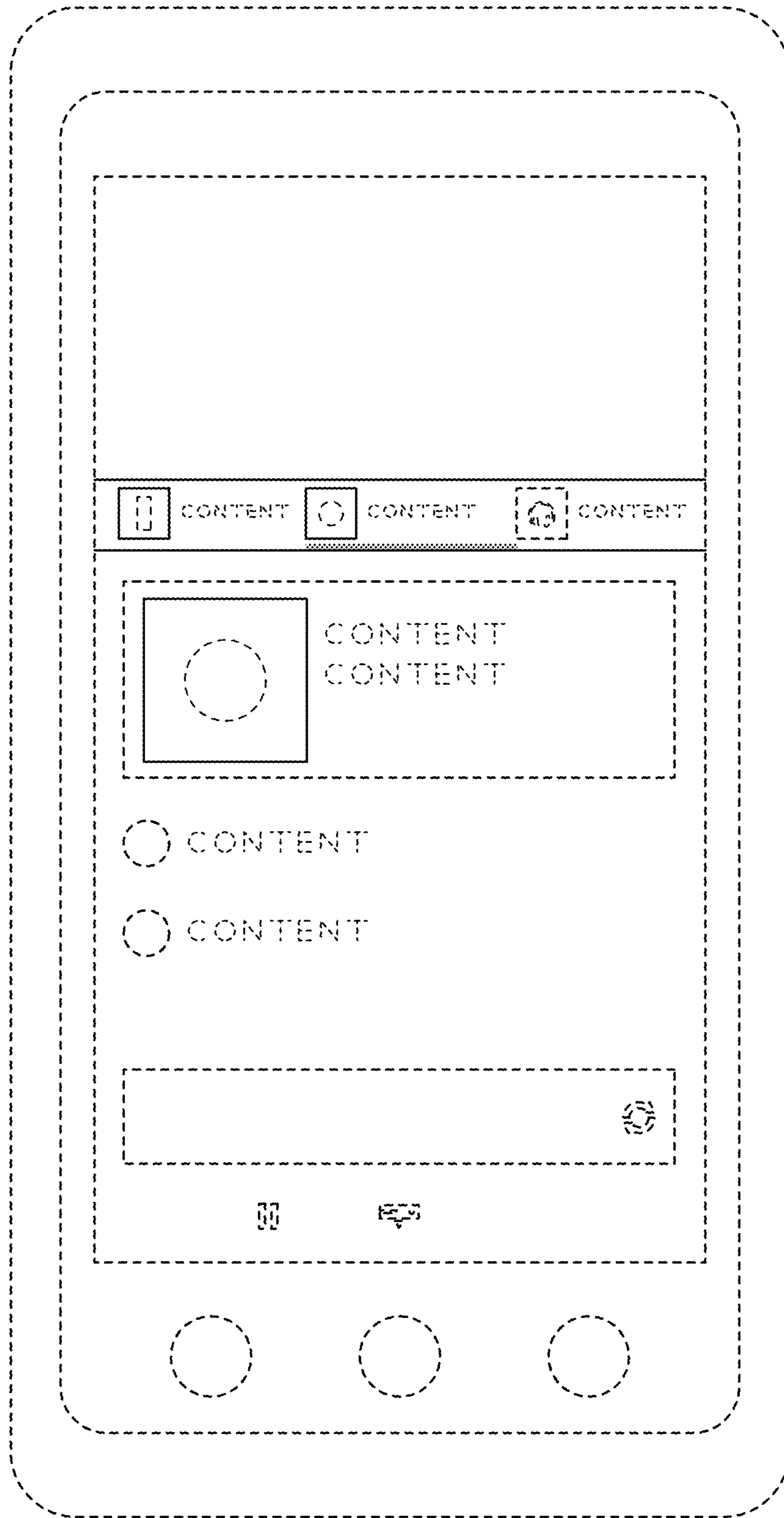

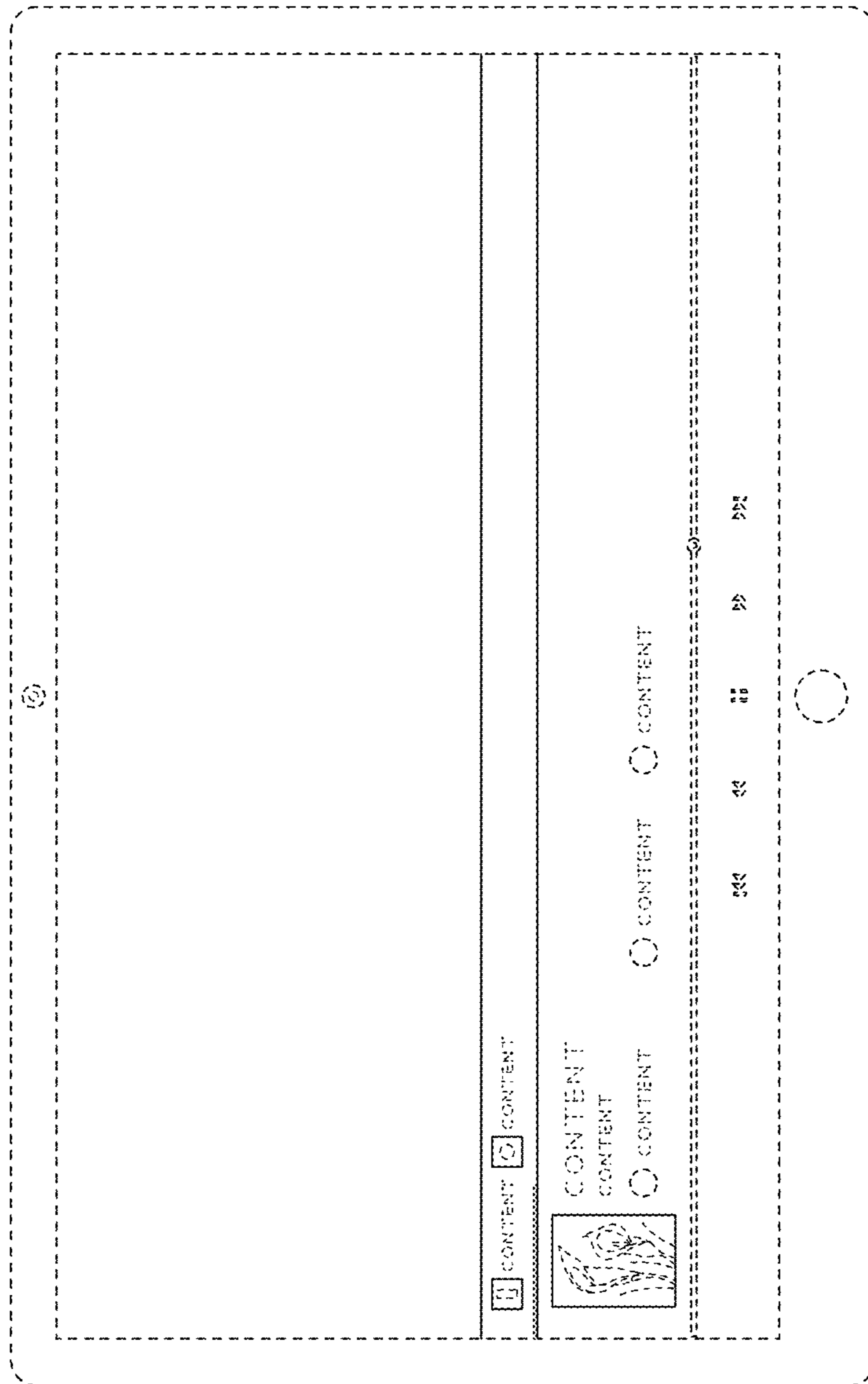
