(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen or portion thereof with an animated computer generated falling dialog, as shown and described.

FIG. 10 is the tenth image thereof;

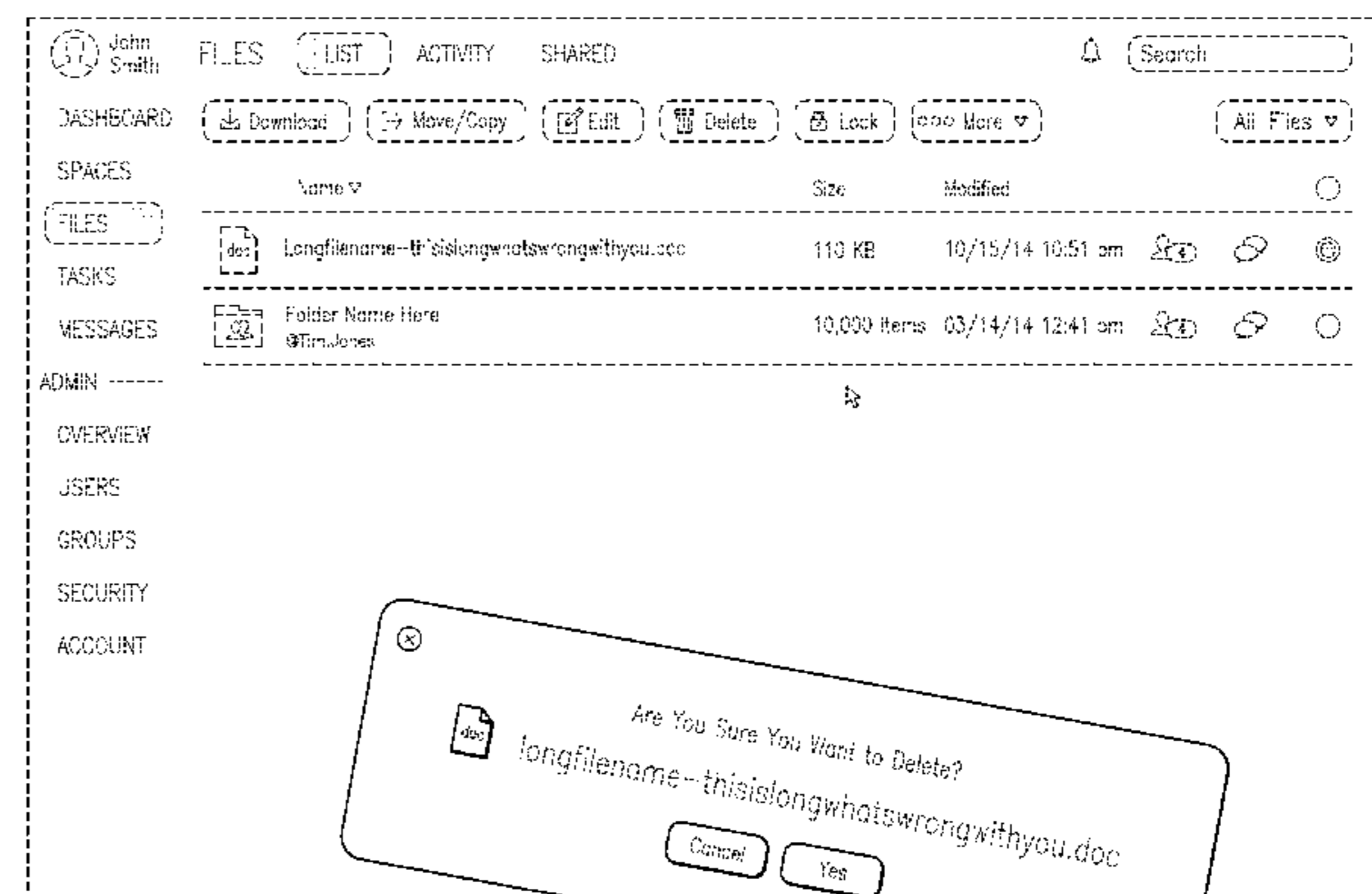
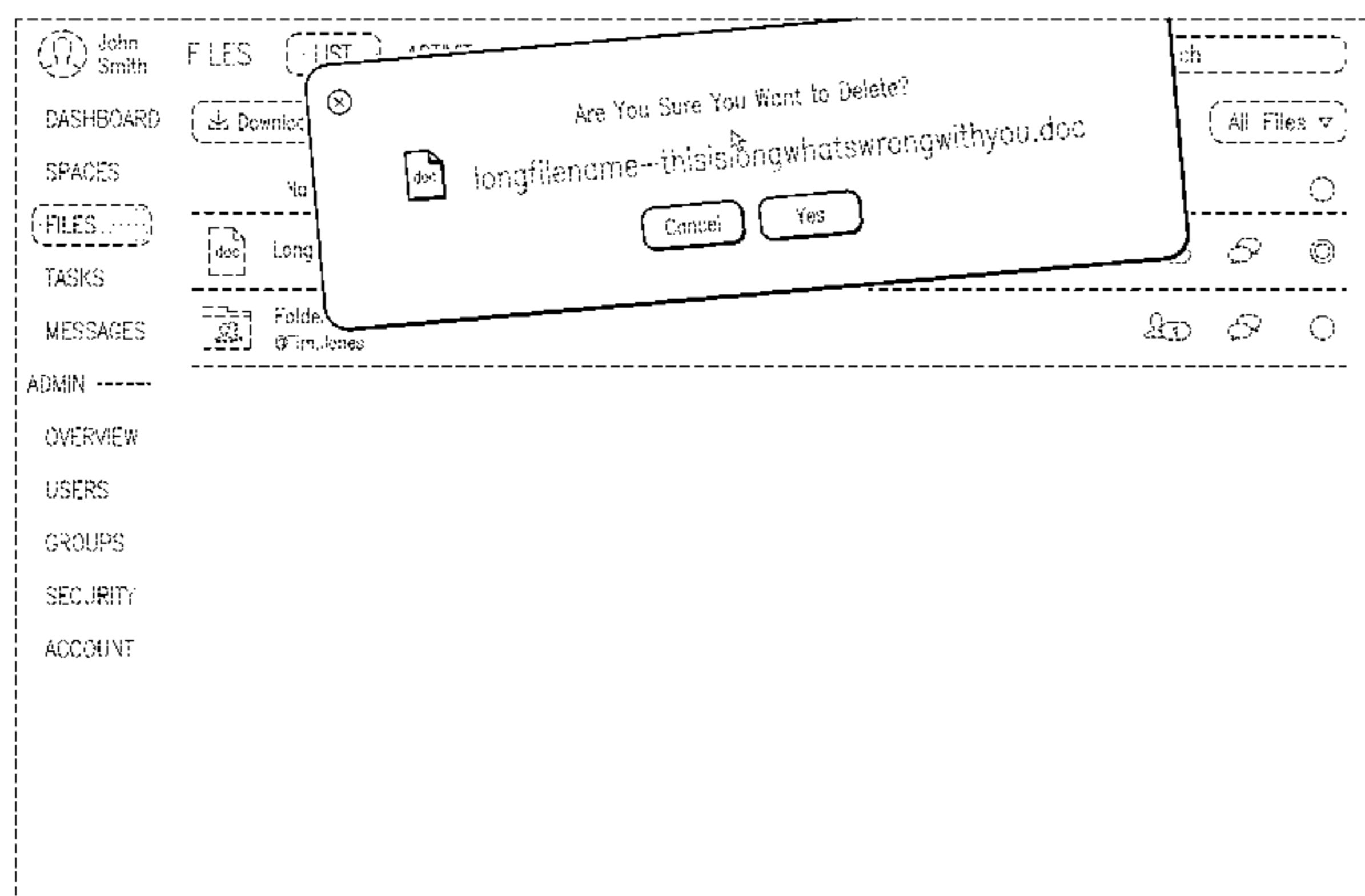
FIG. 11 is the eleventh image thereof; and,

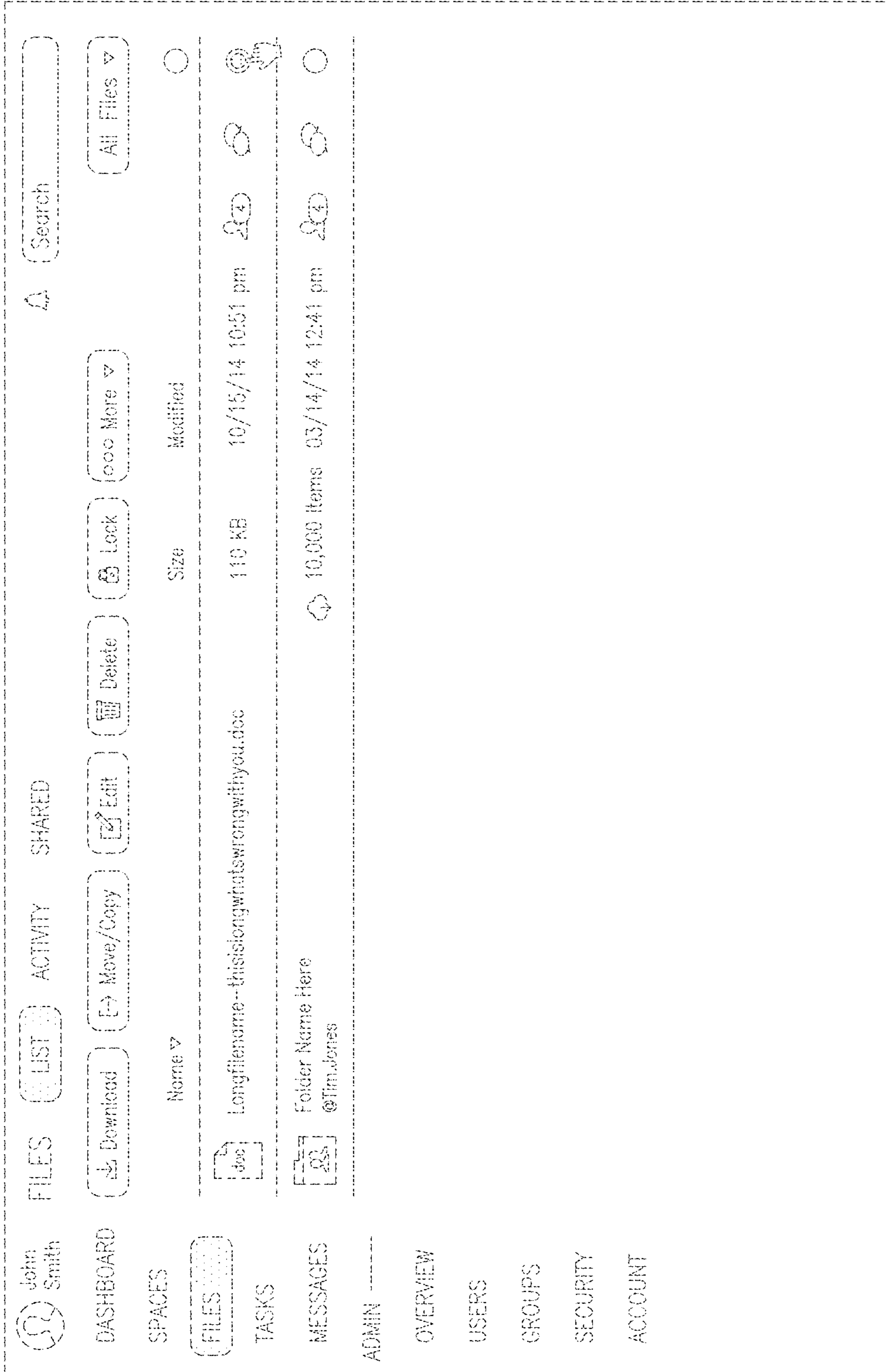

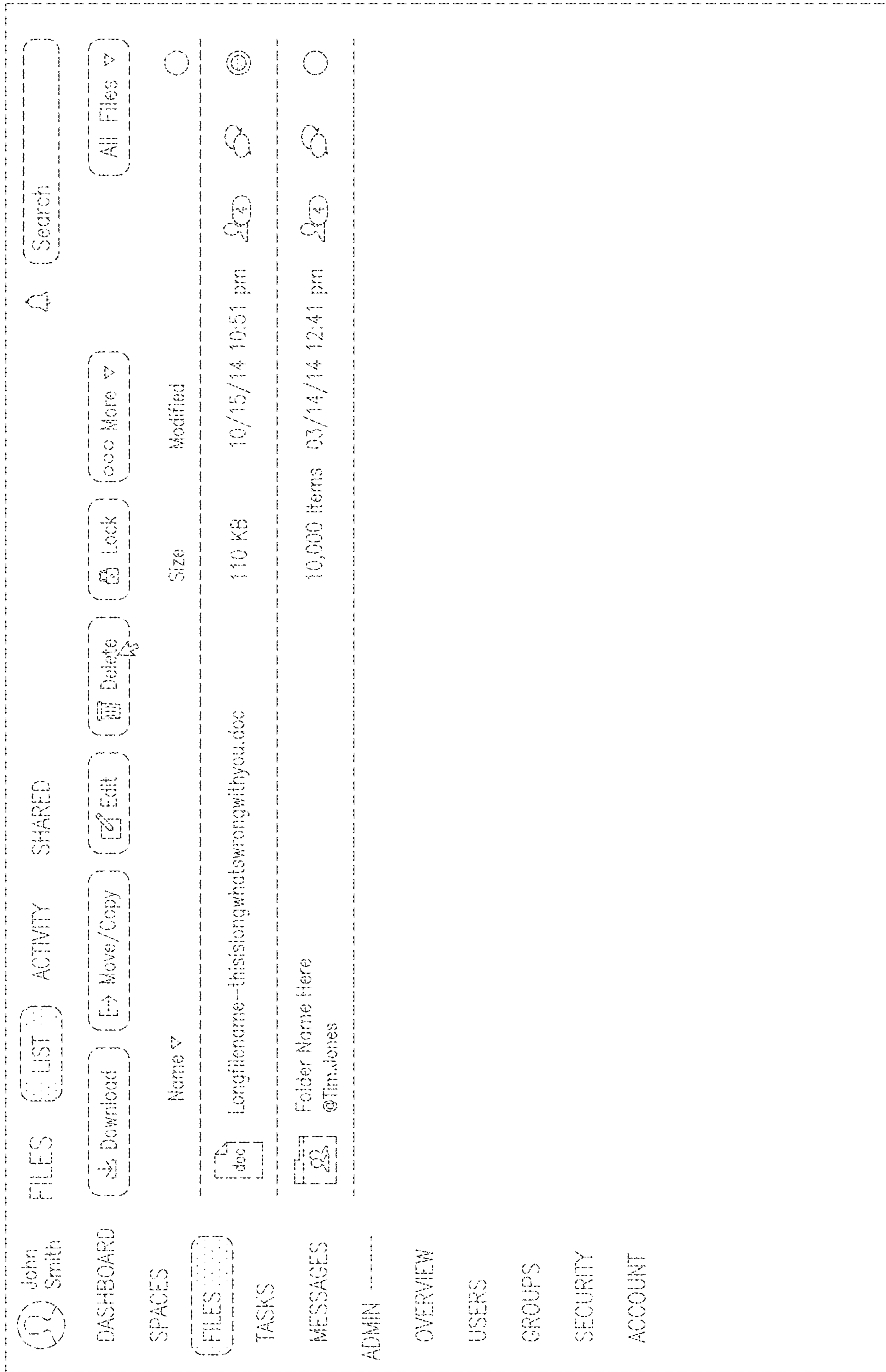

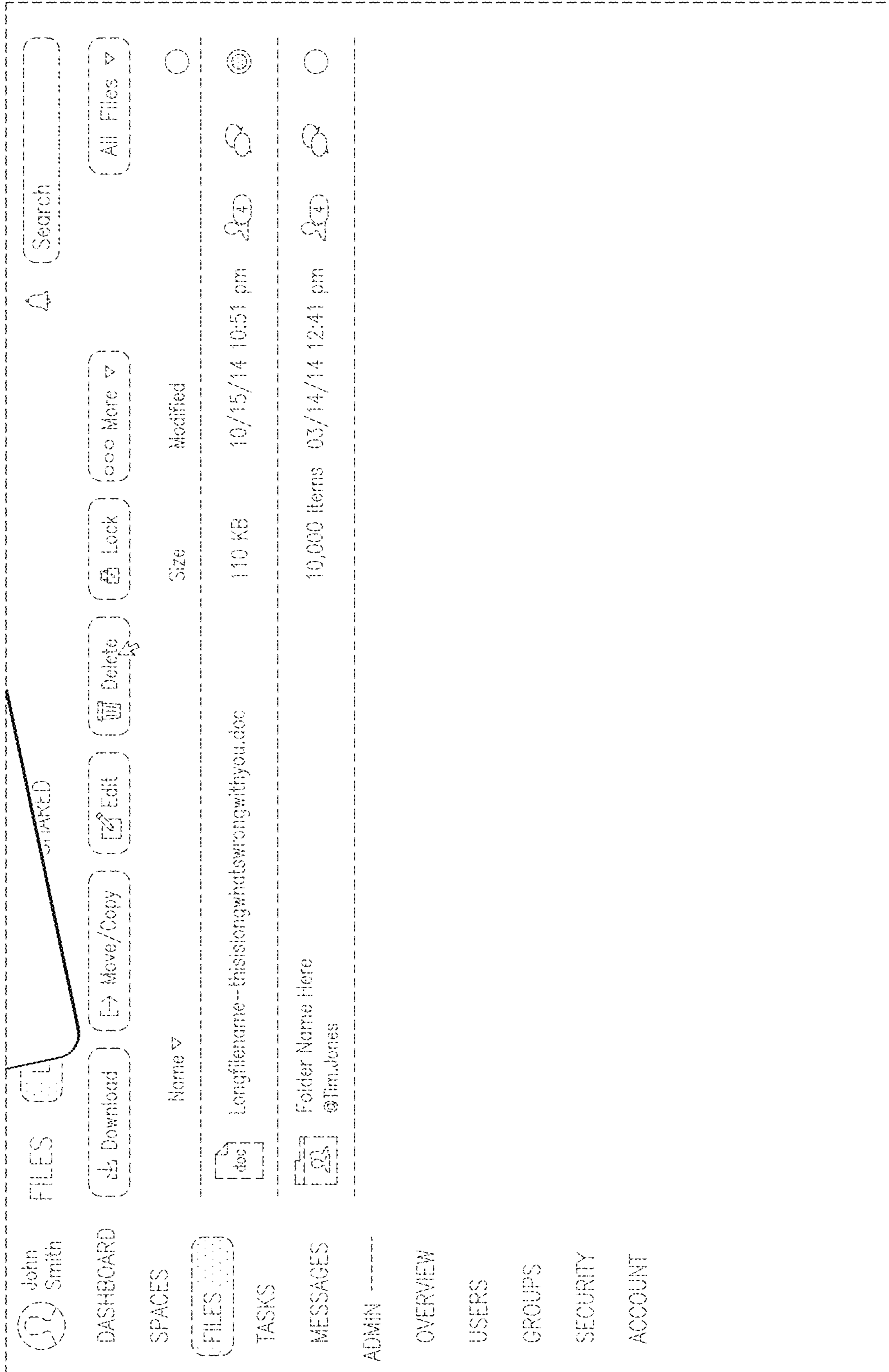

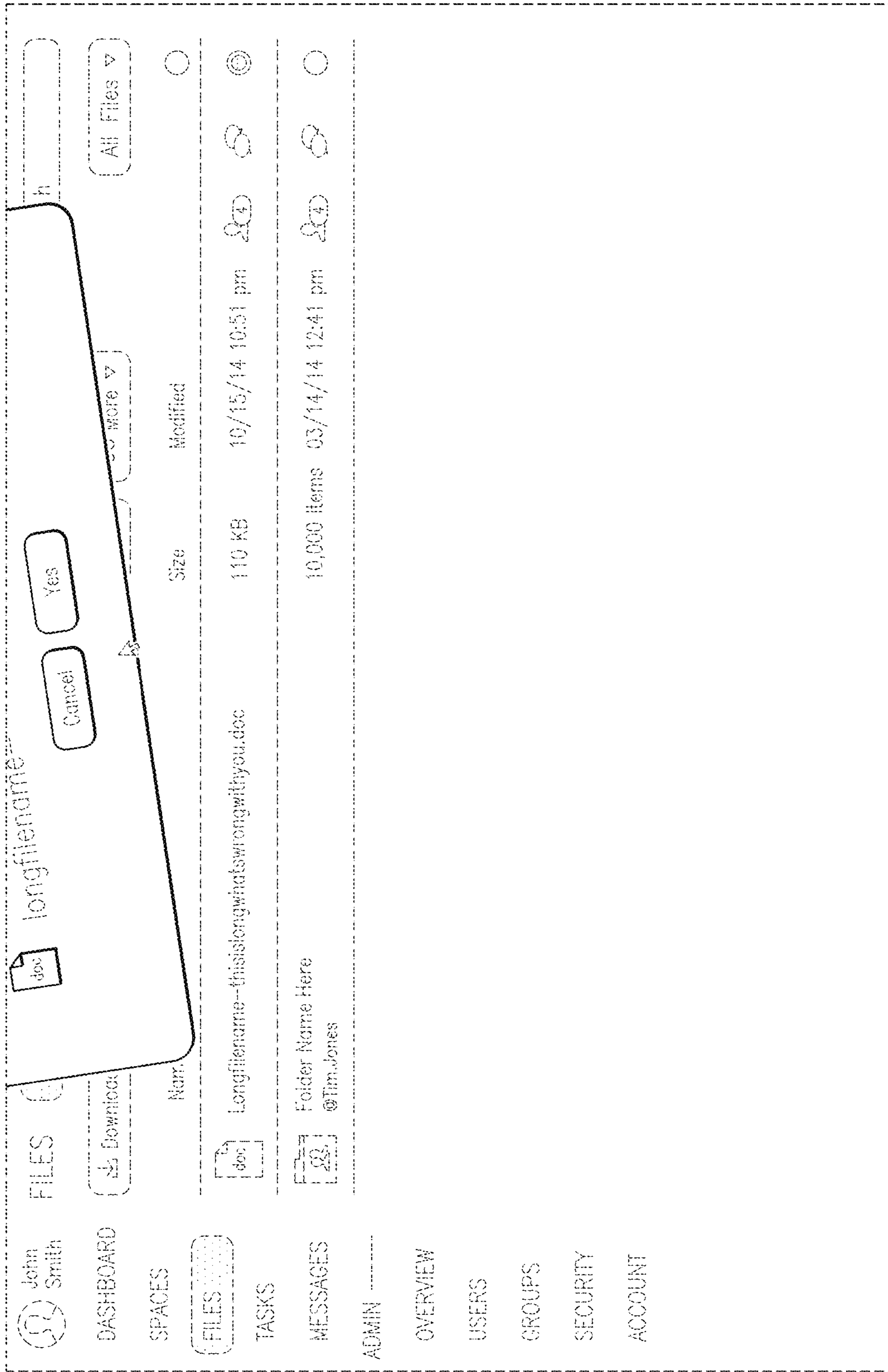

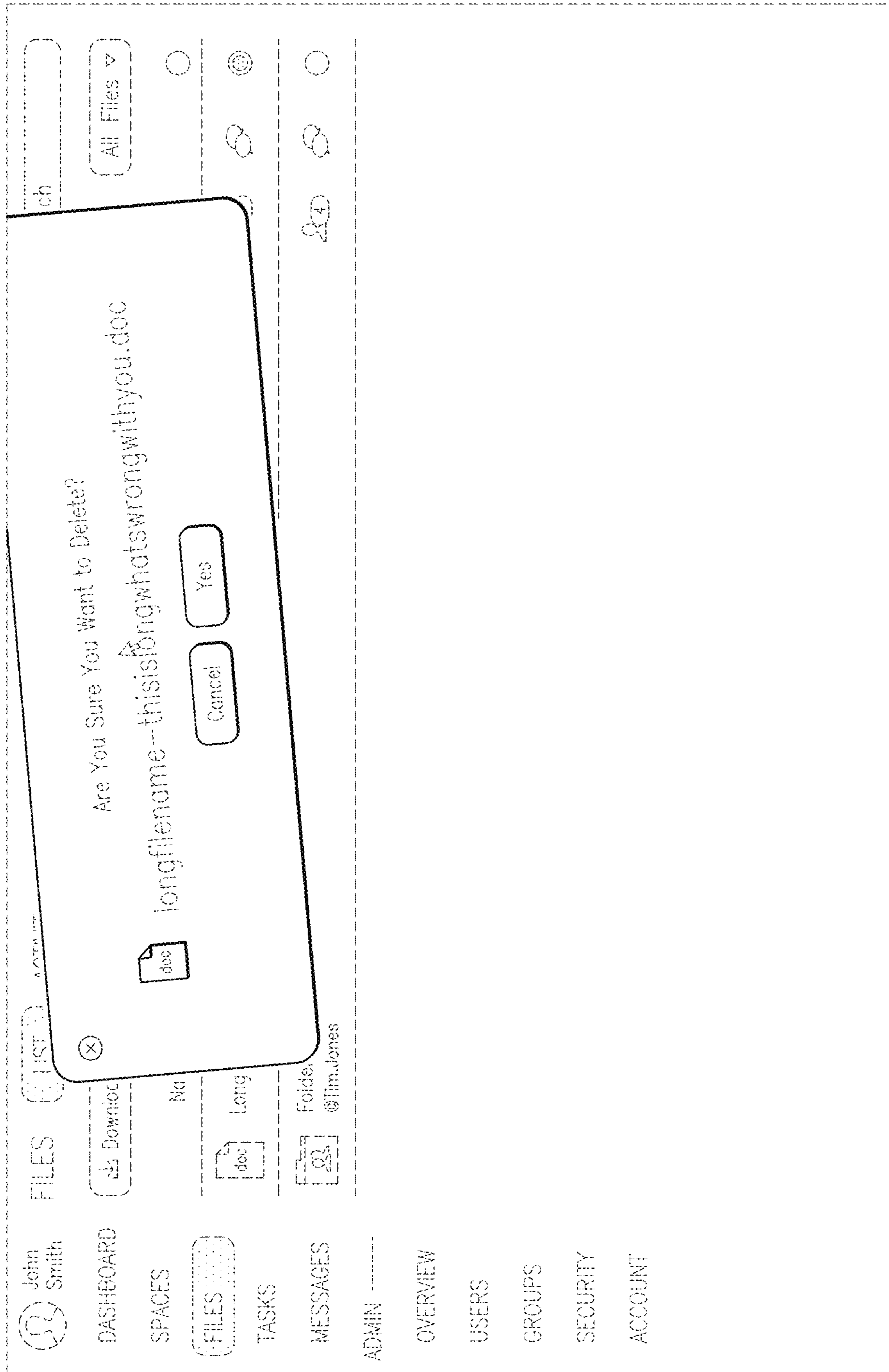

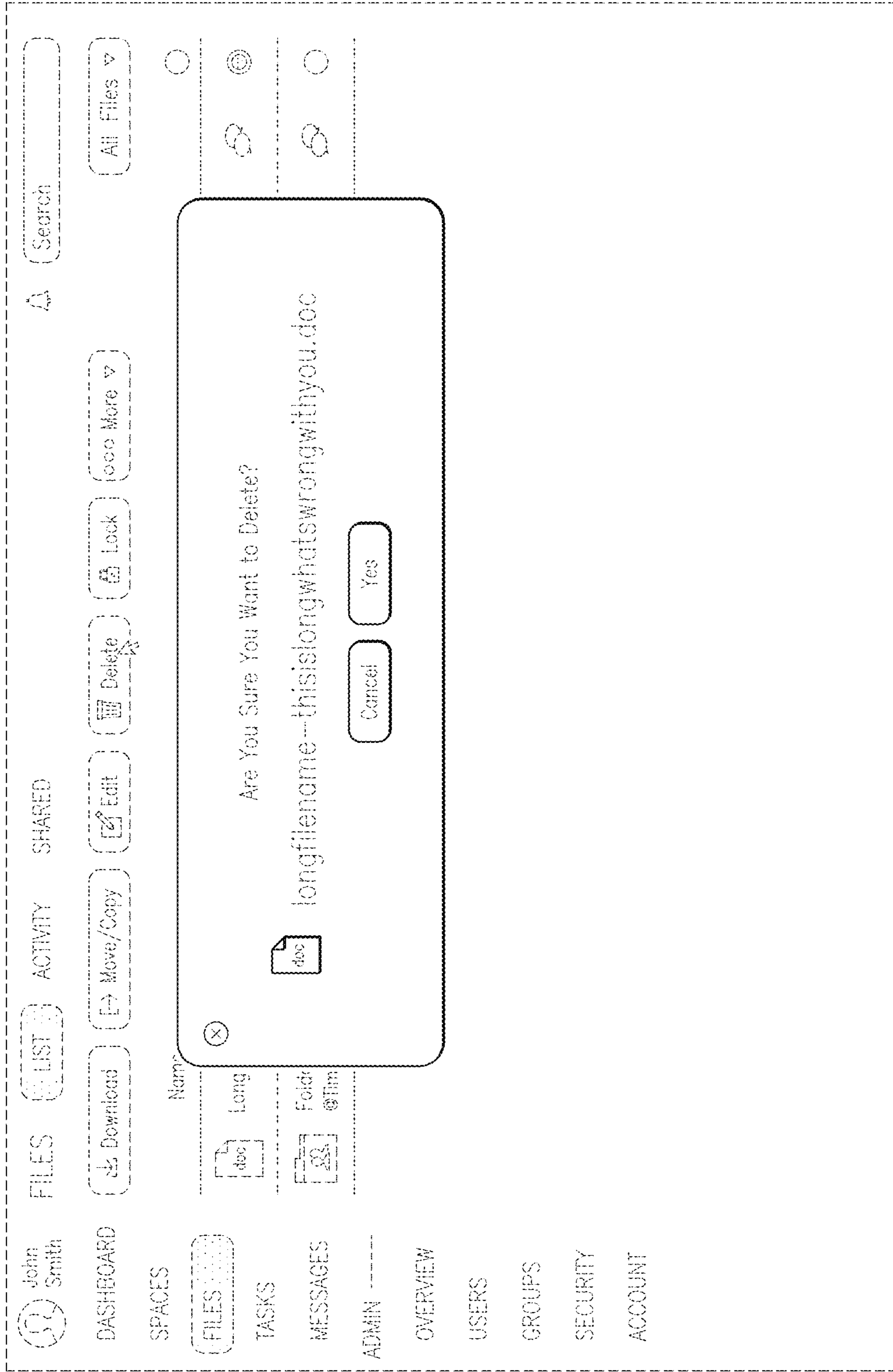

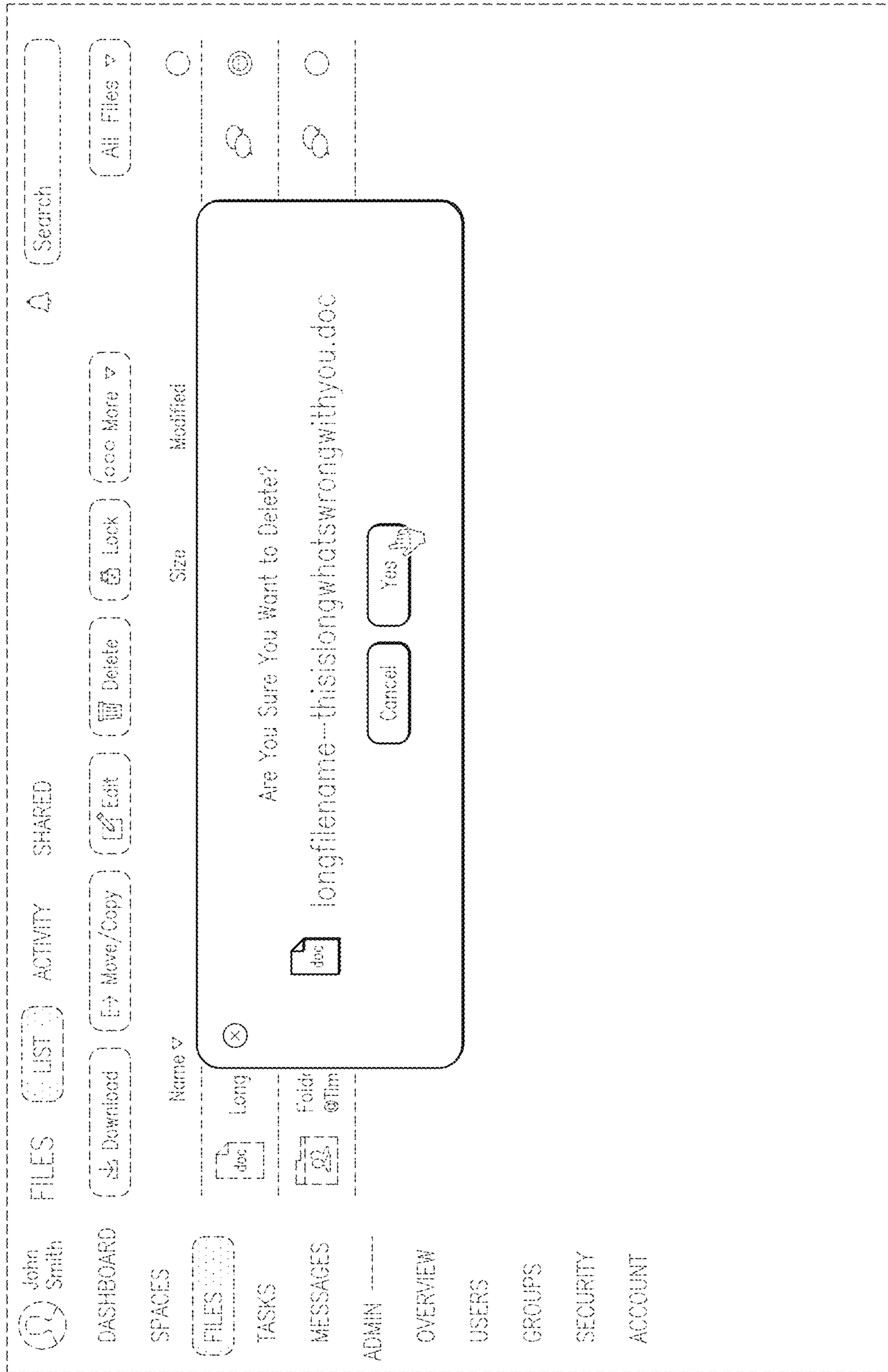

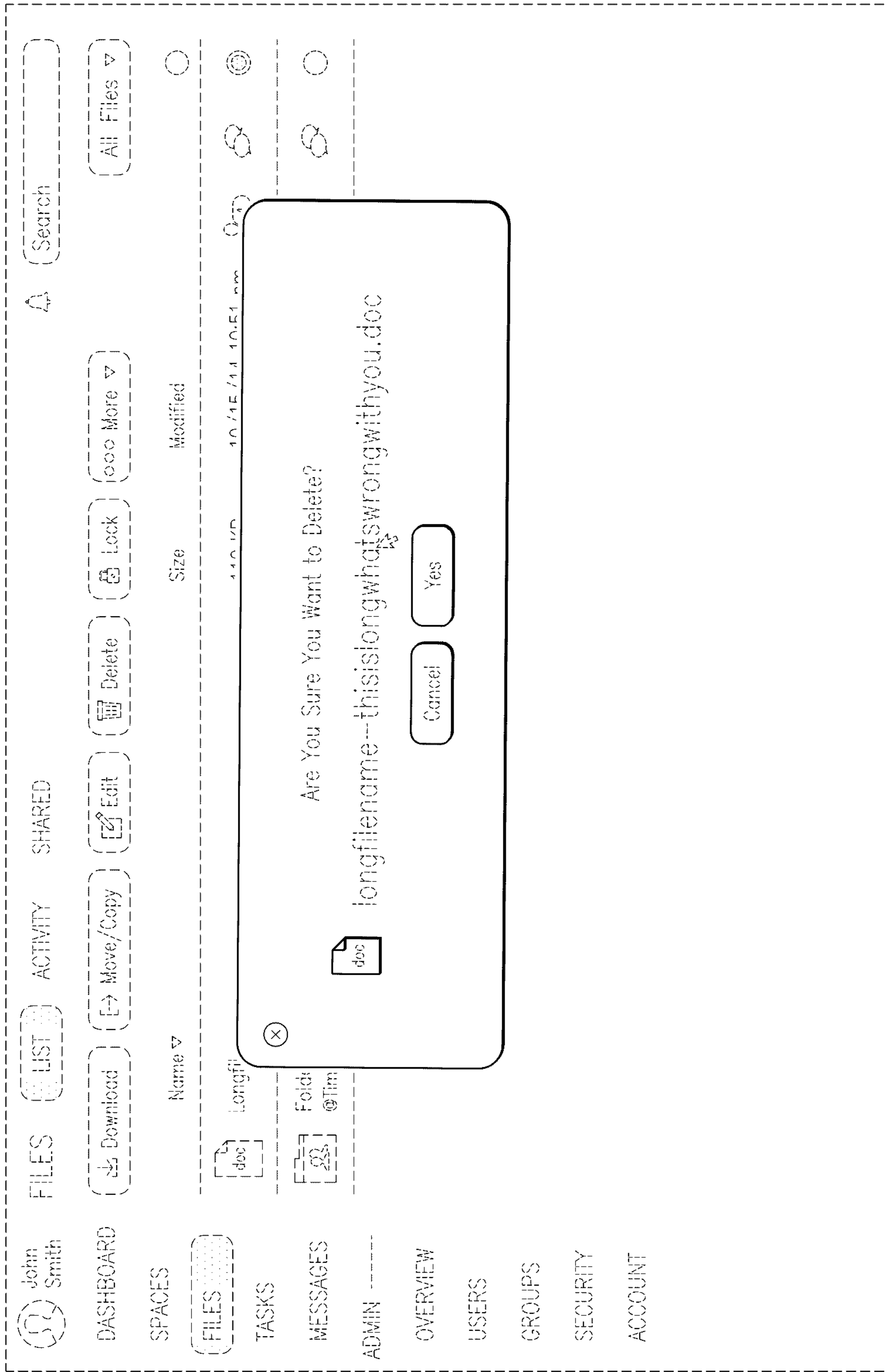

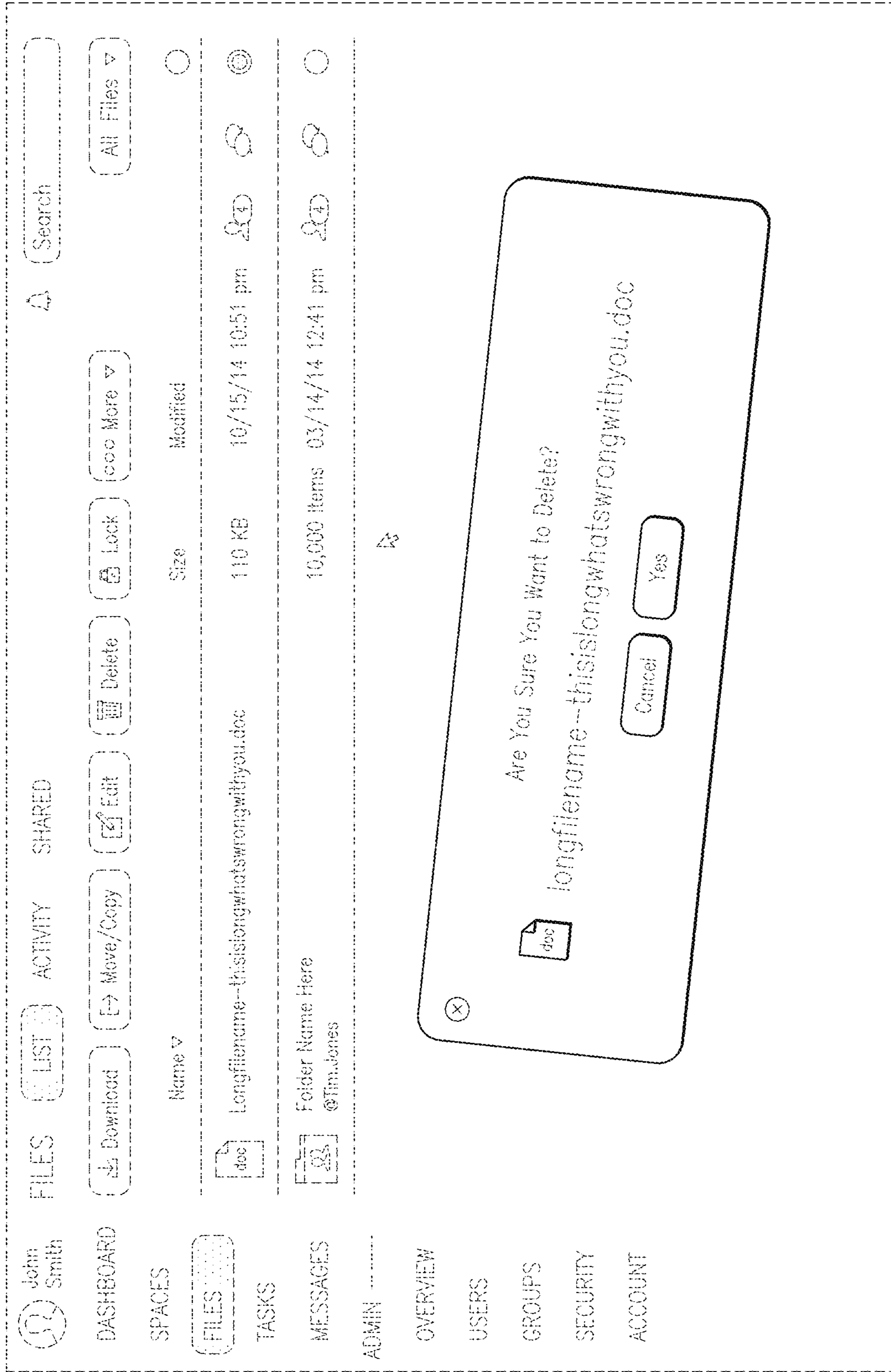

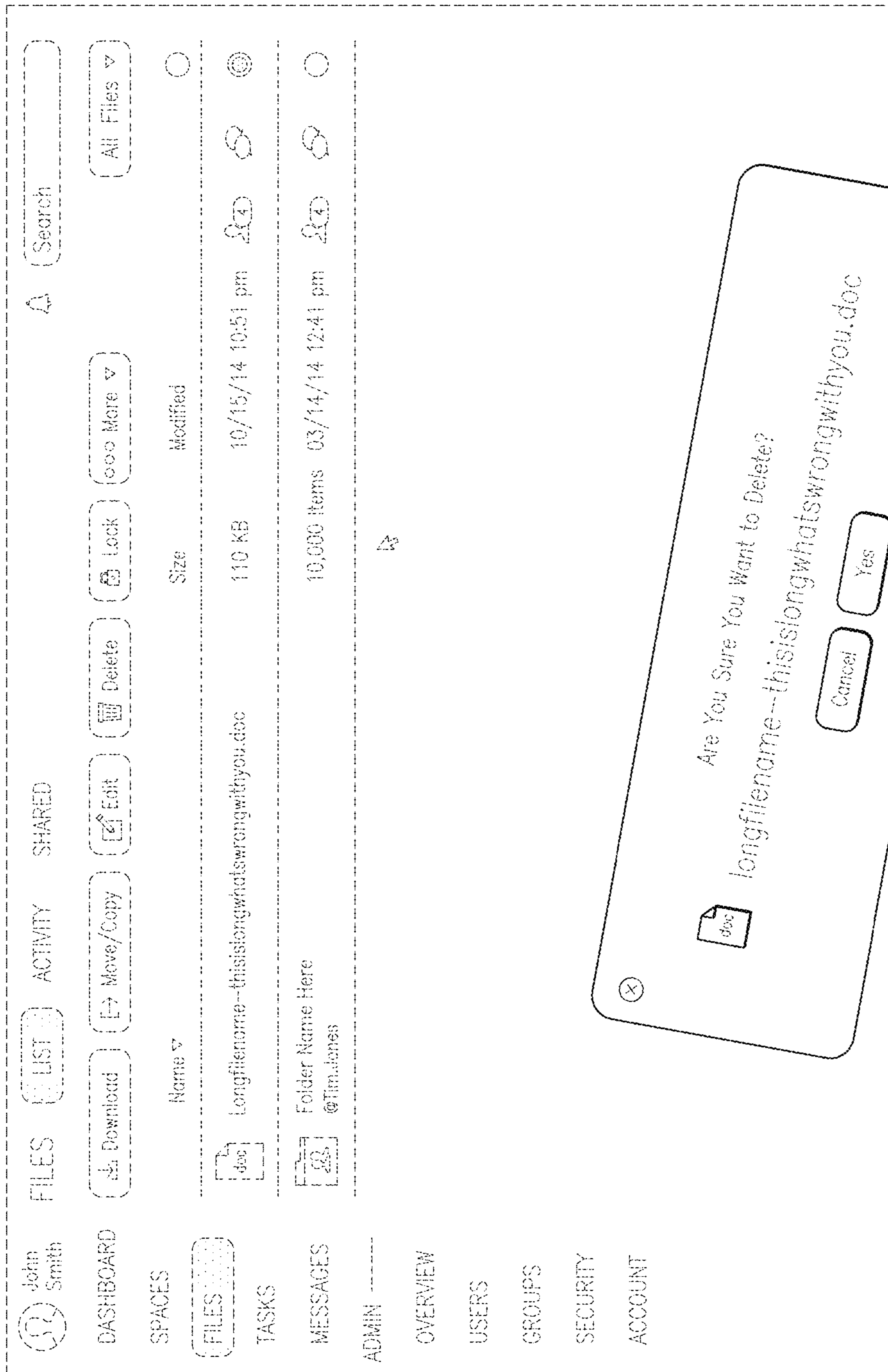

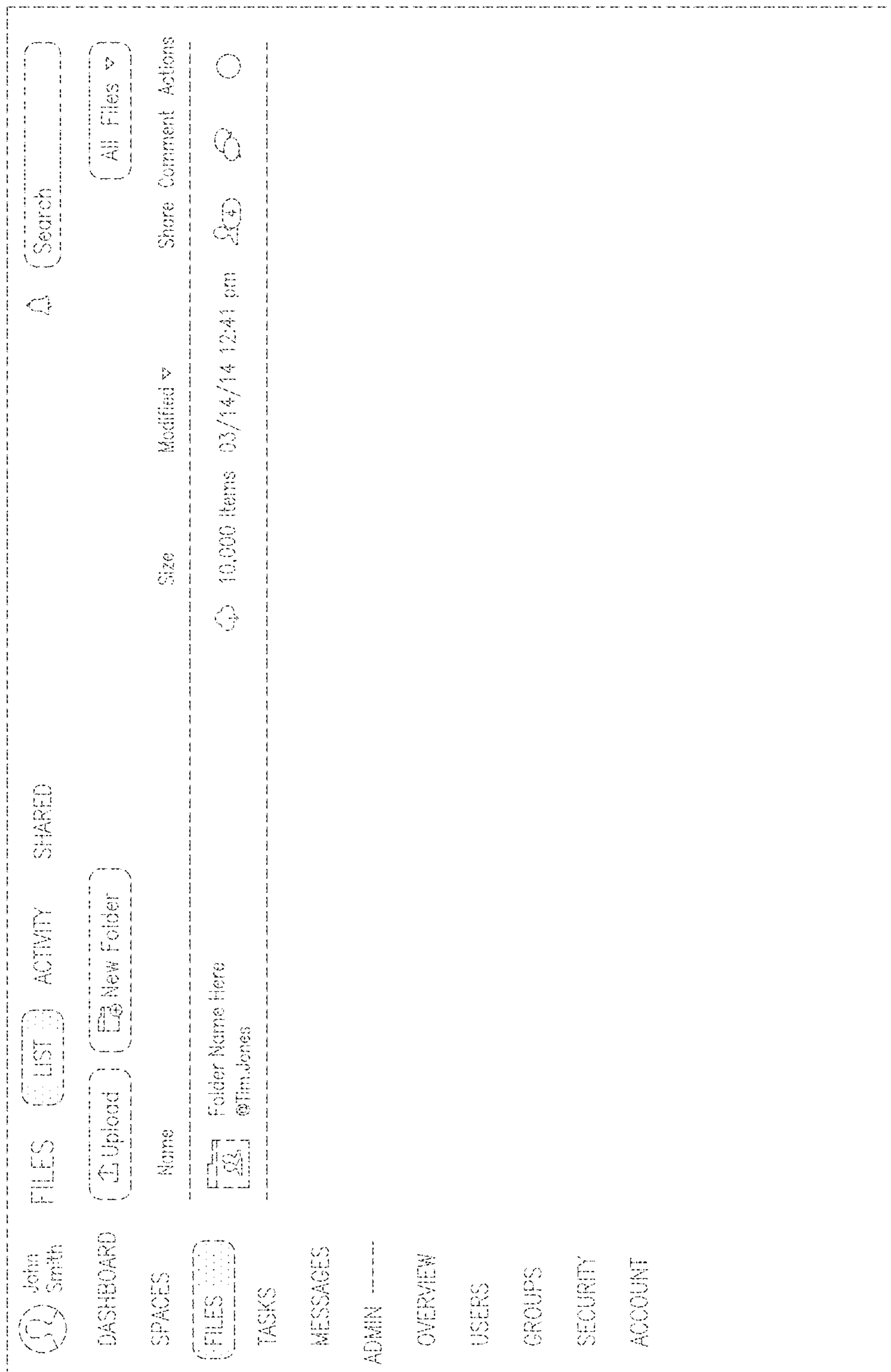
