DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top left isometric view of a needle support device illustrating a belt in dashed lines for environment.

FIG. 2 is a top left isometric view of the needle support device of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a bottom isometric view of the needle support device of FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a left-side elevation view of the needle support device of FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a right-side elevation view of the needle support device of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the needle support device of FIG. 1.

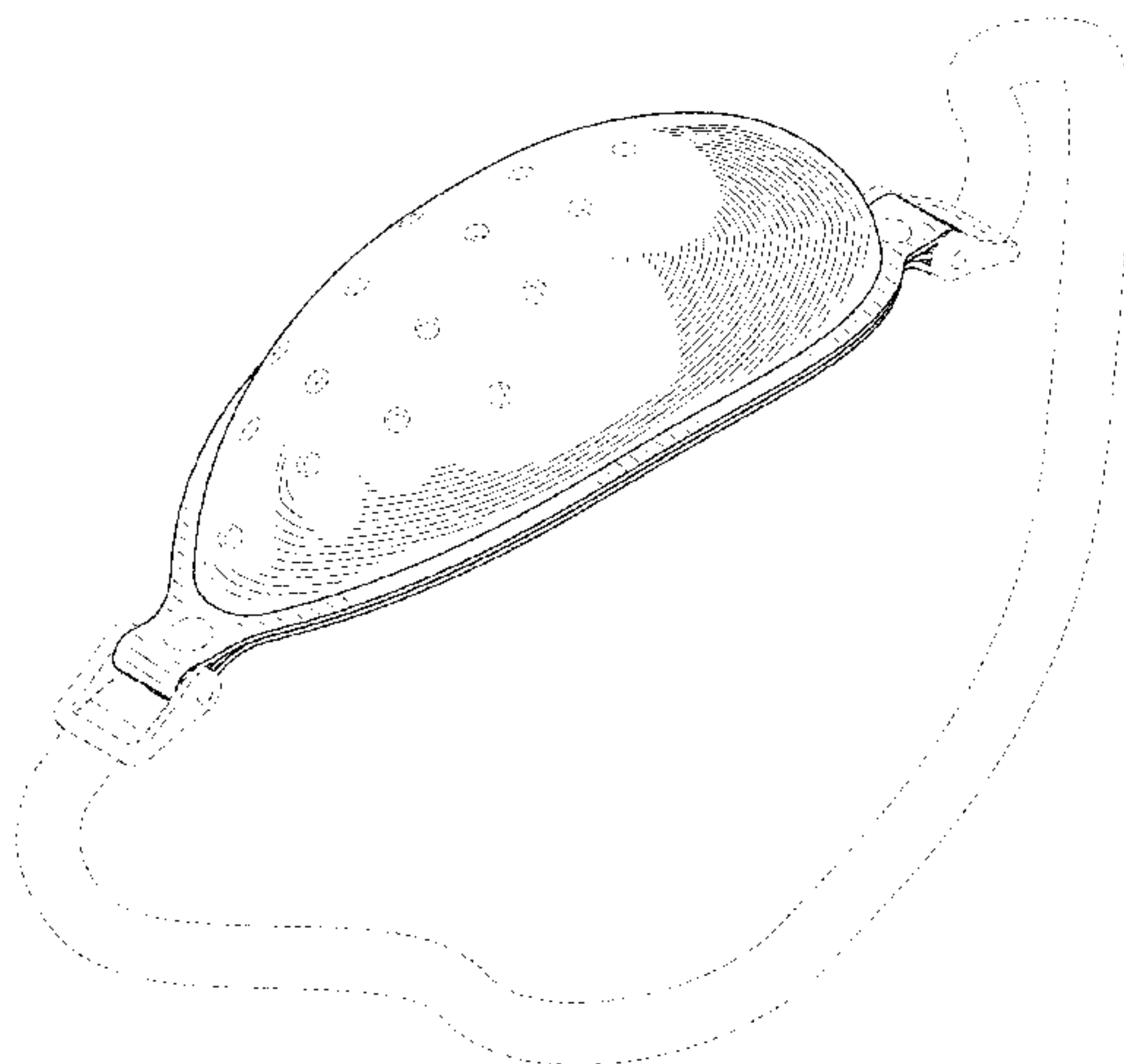
FIG. 7 is a front elevation view of the needle support device of FIG. 1.

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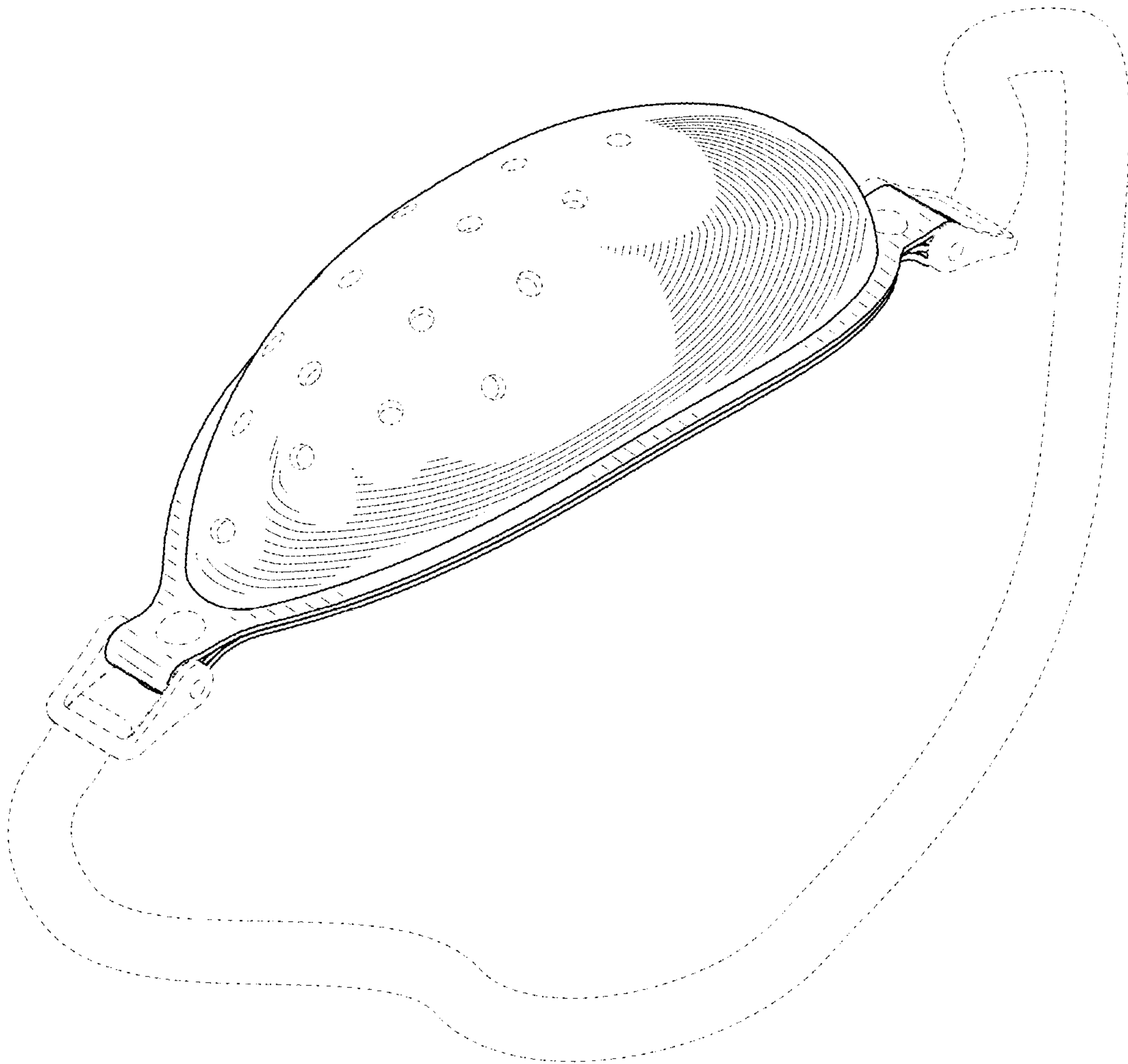

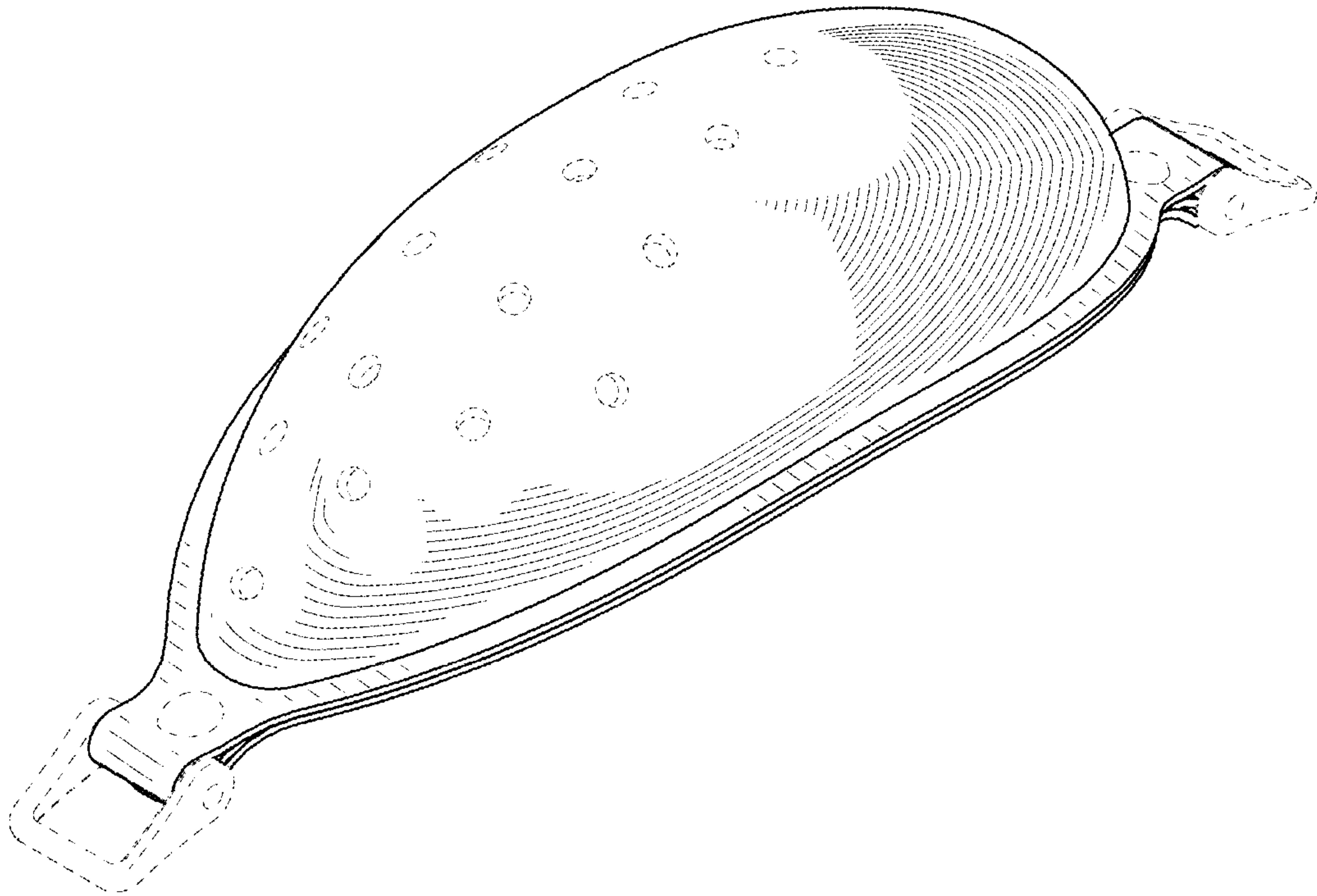

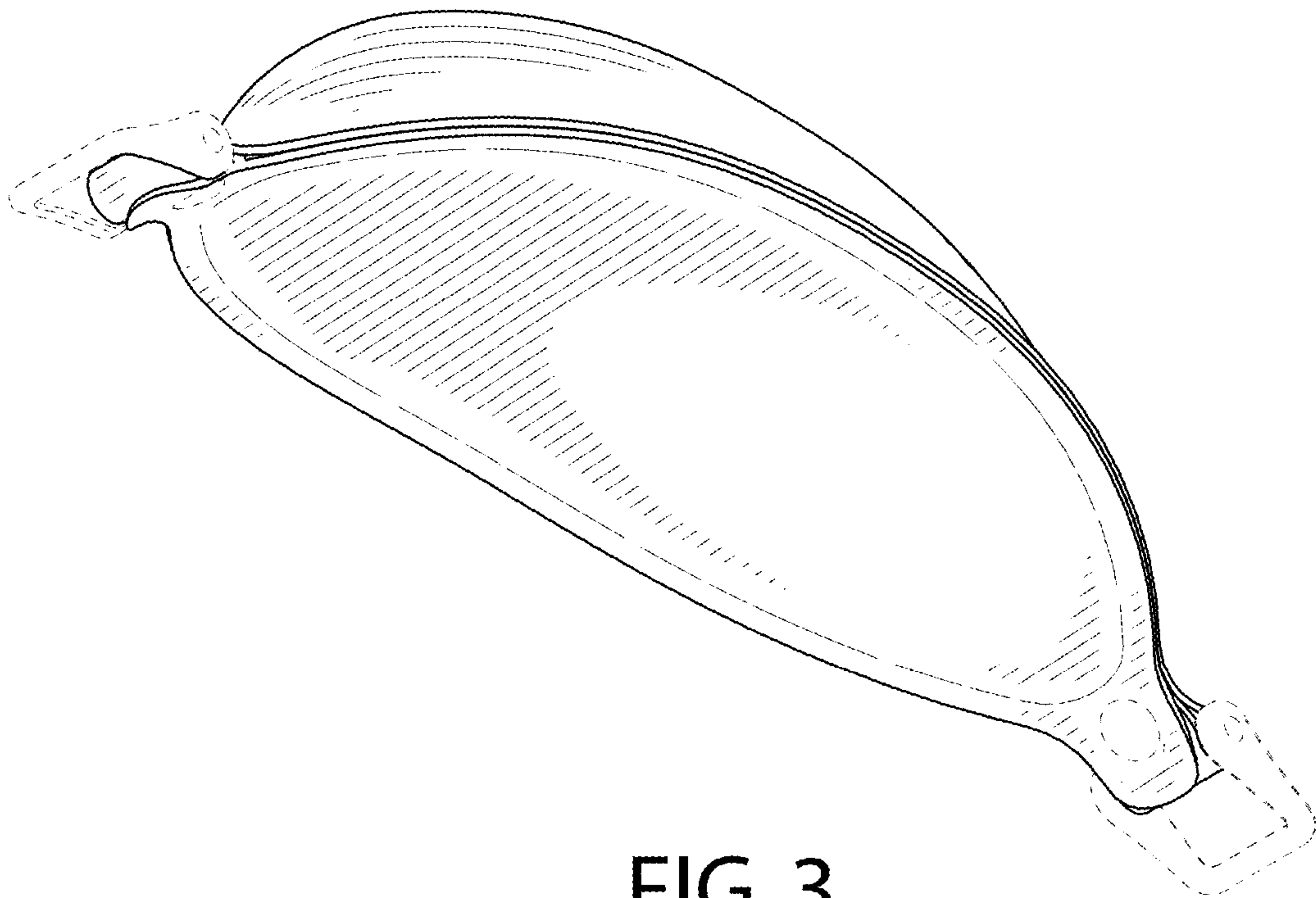

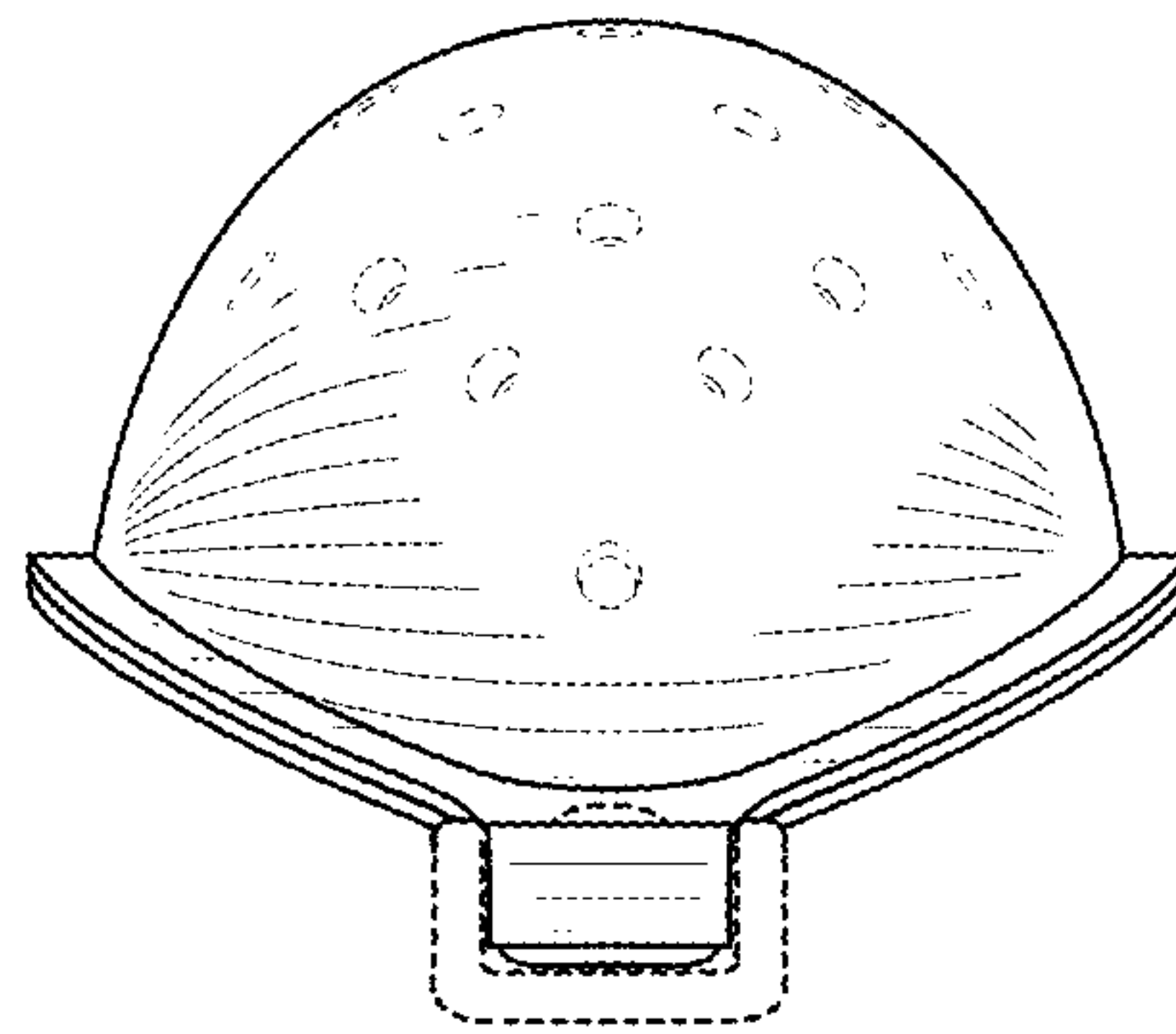

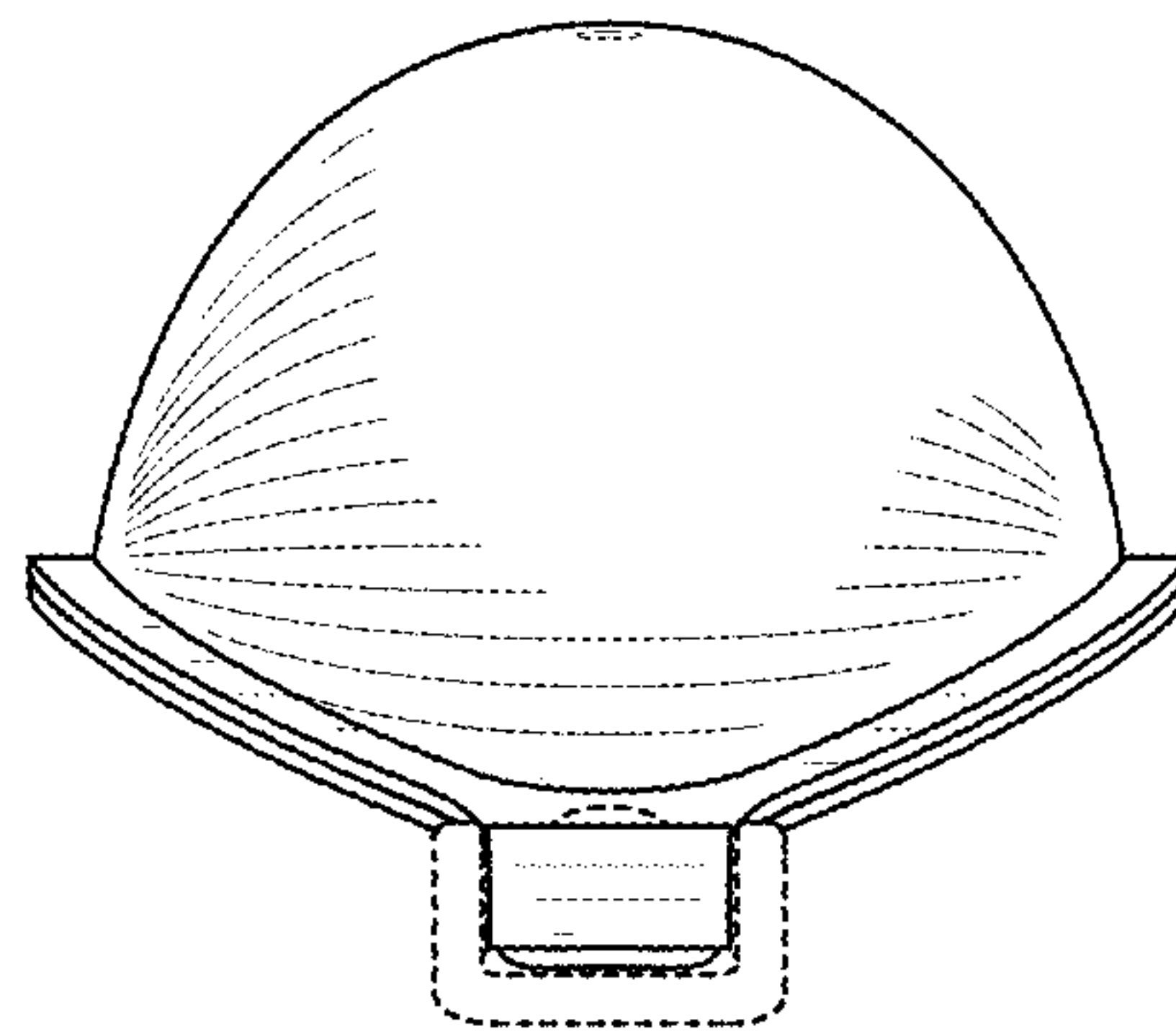

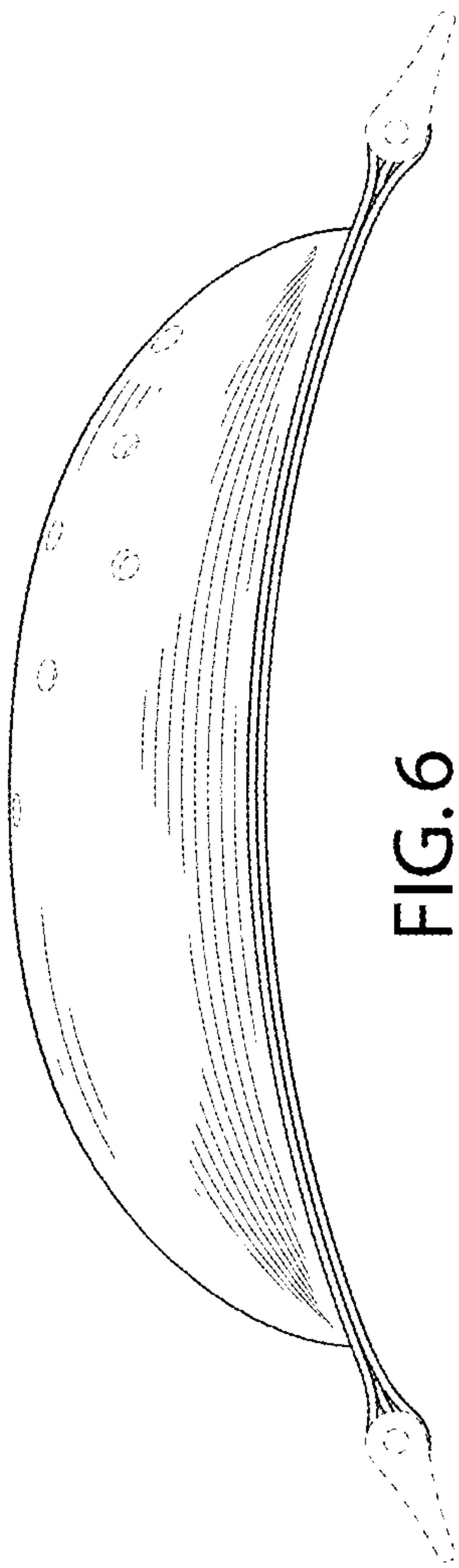

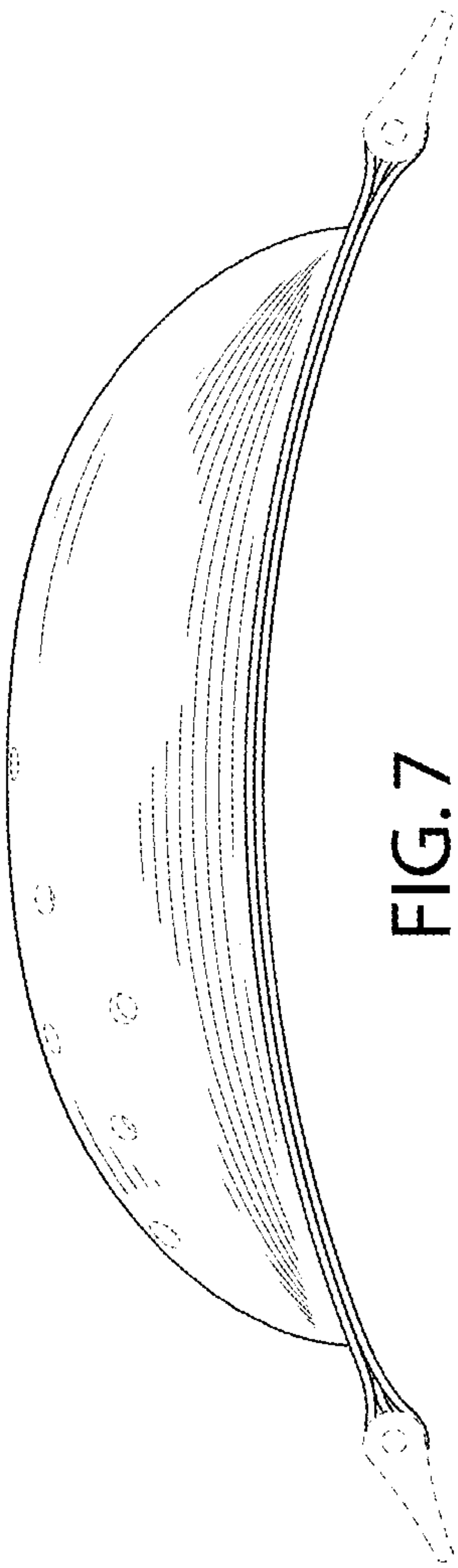

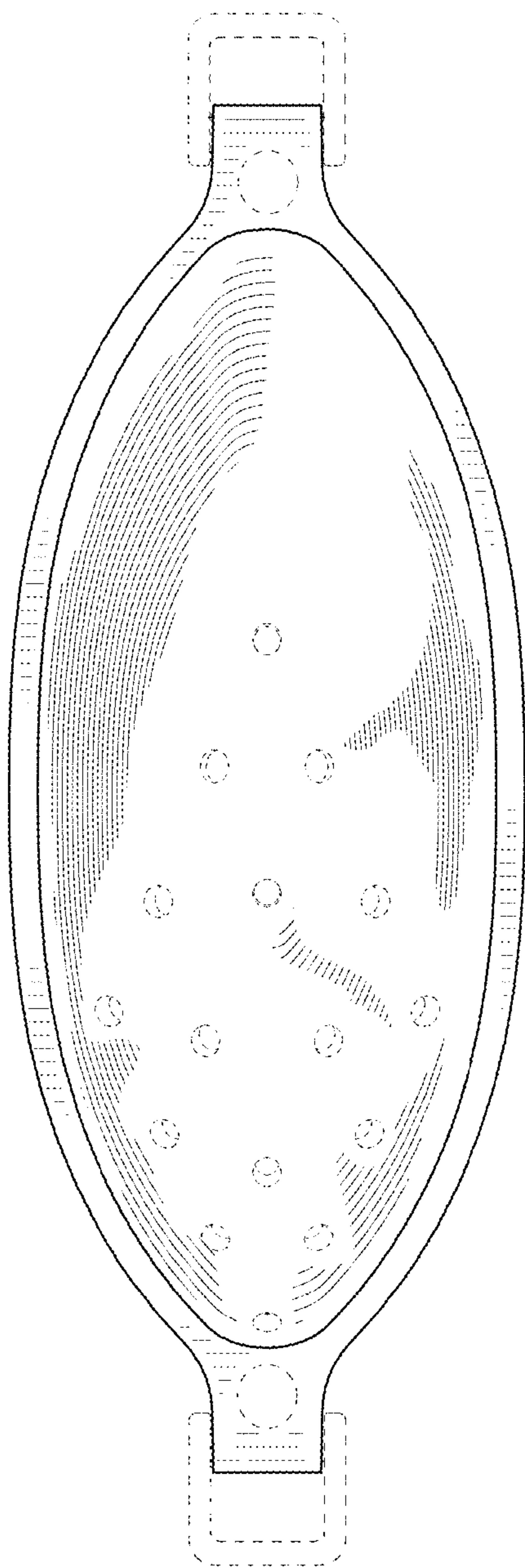

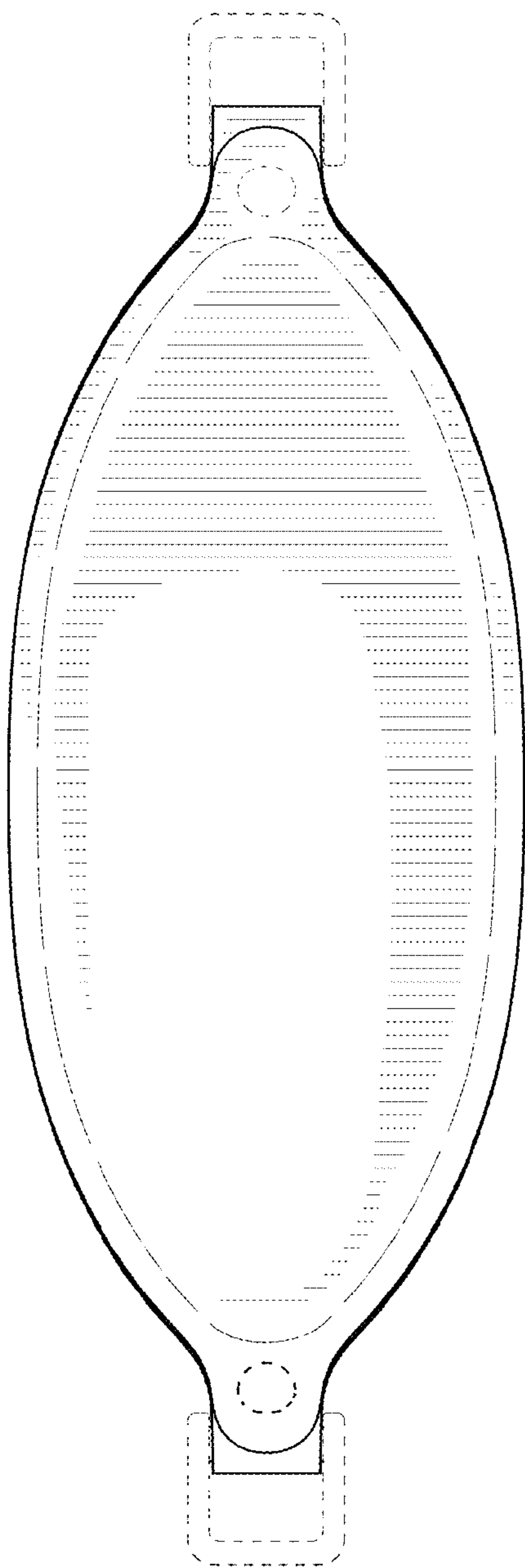
