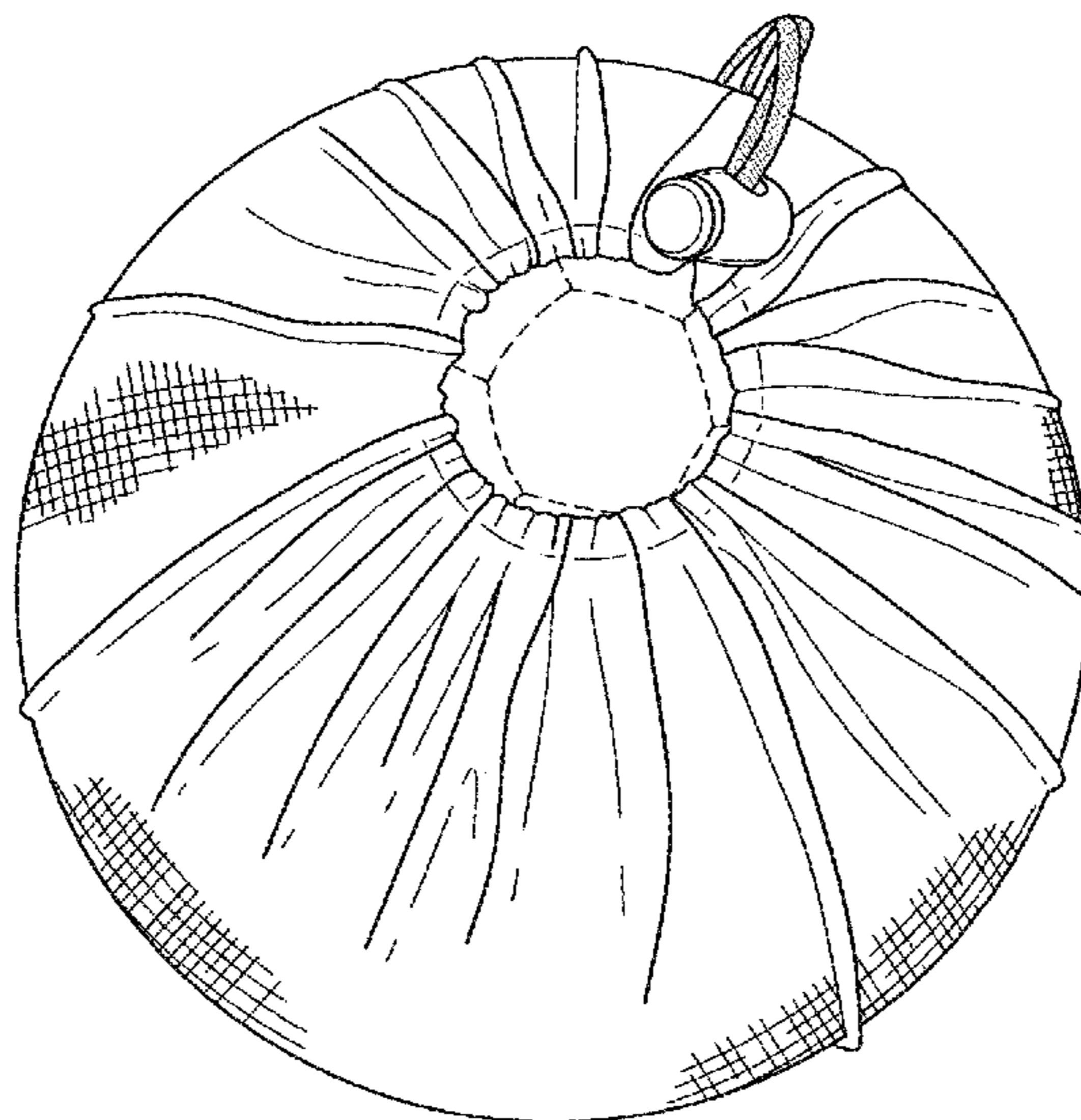

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a ball sleeve, shown with an unclaimed ball, in a closed position, showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof; shown with an unclaimed ball in an open position;
FIG. 3 is a top perspective view; shown in an open position;
FIG. 4 is a perspective right side view of FIG. 1; and,

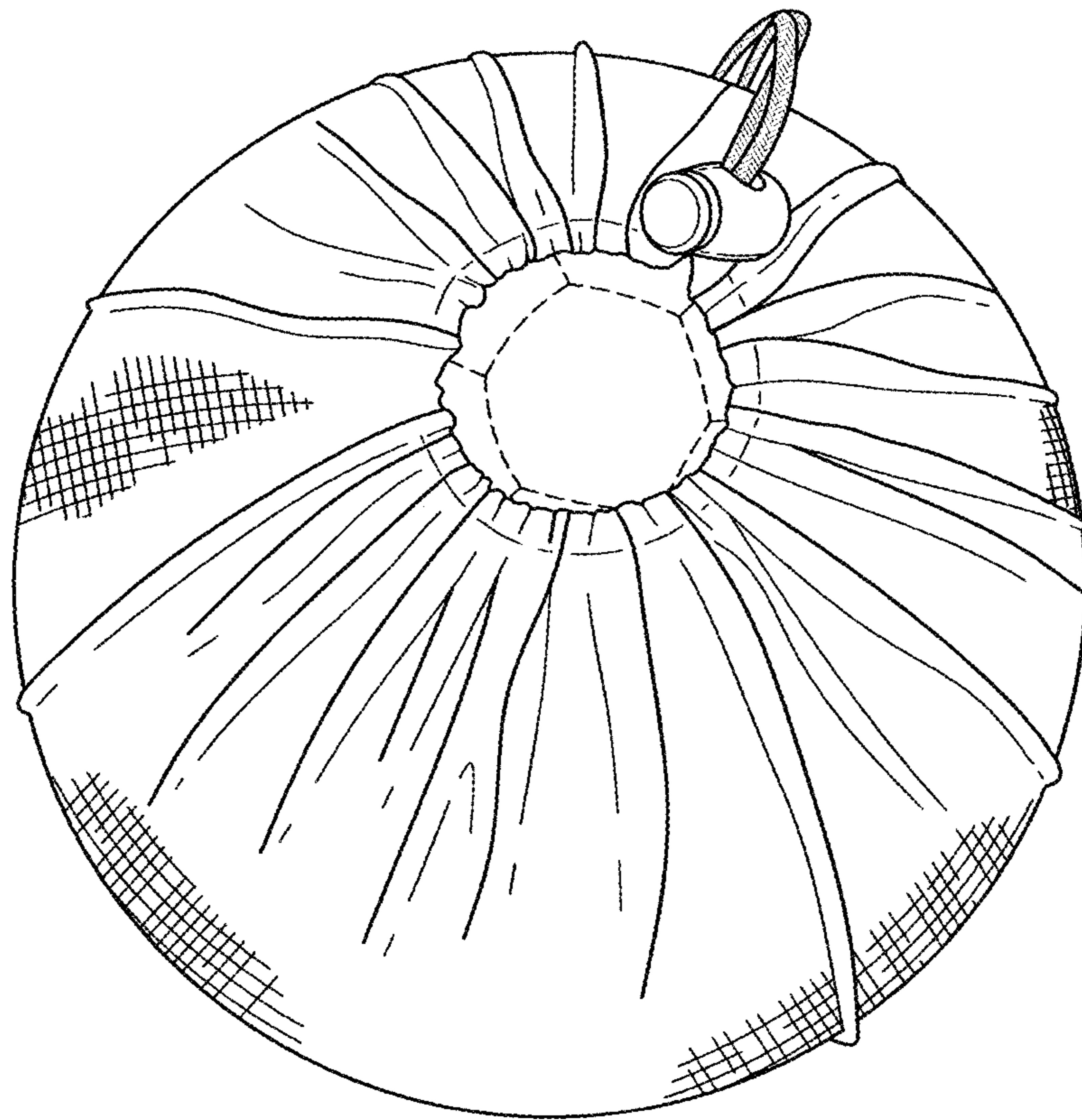

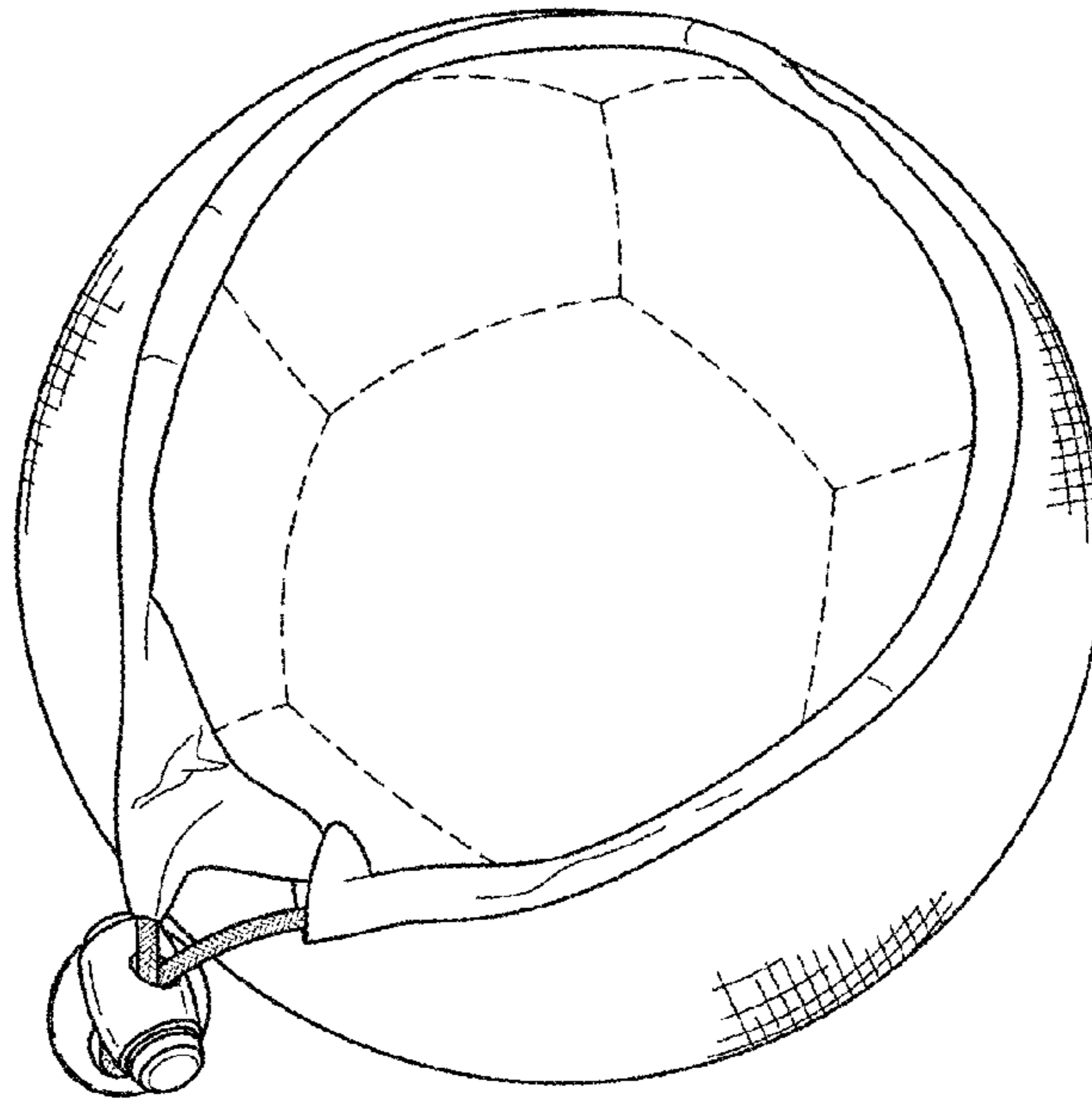

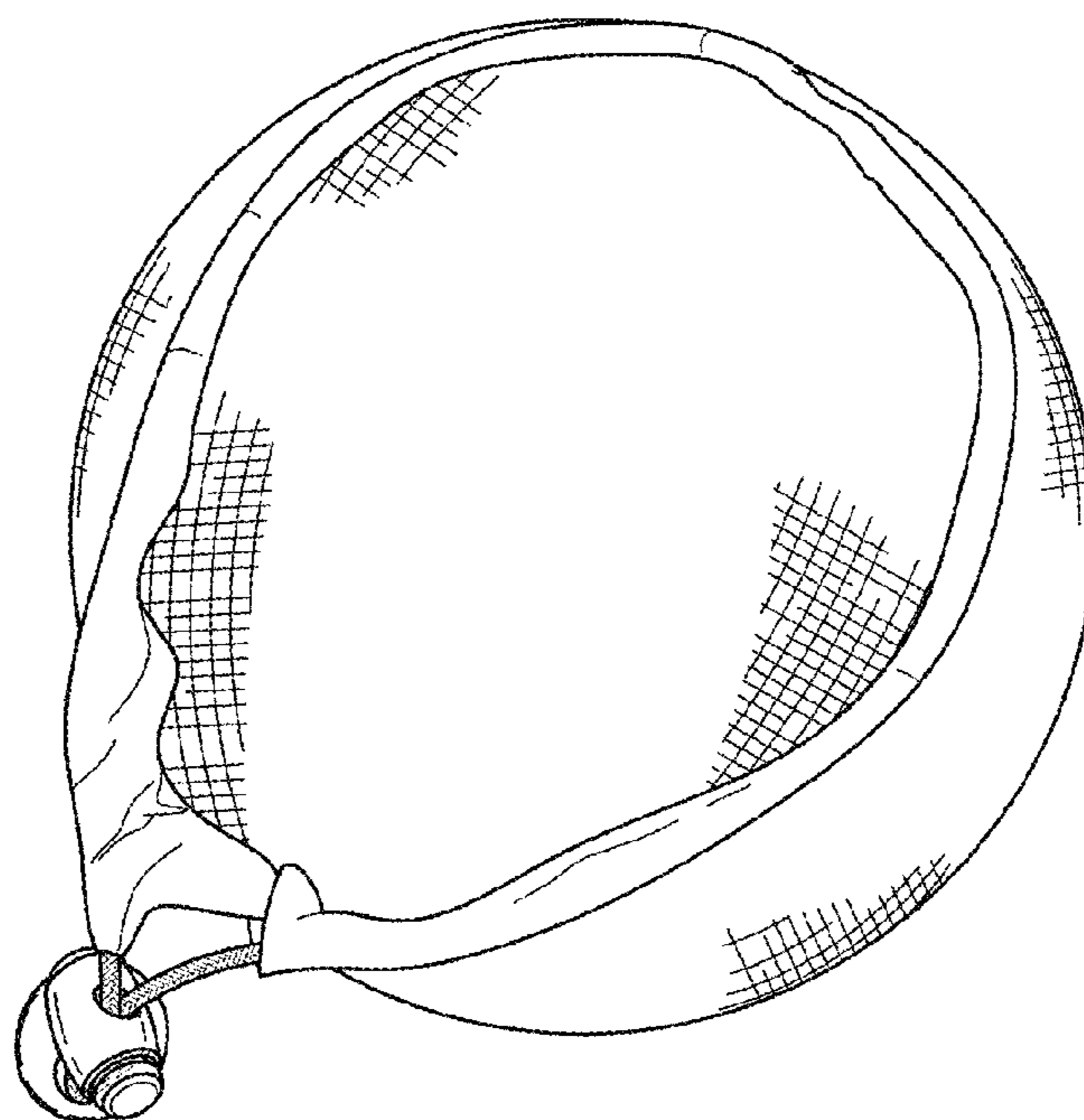

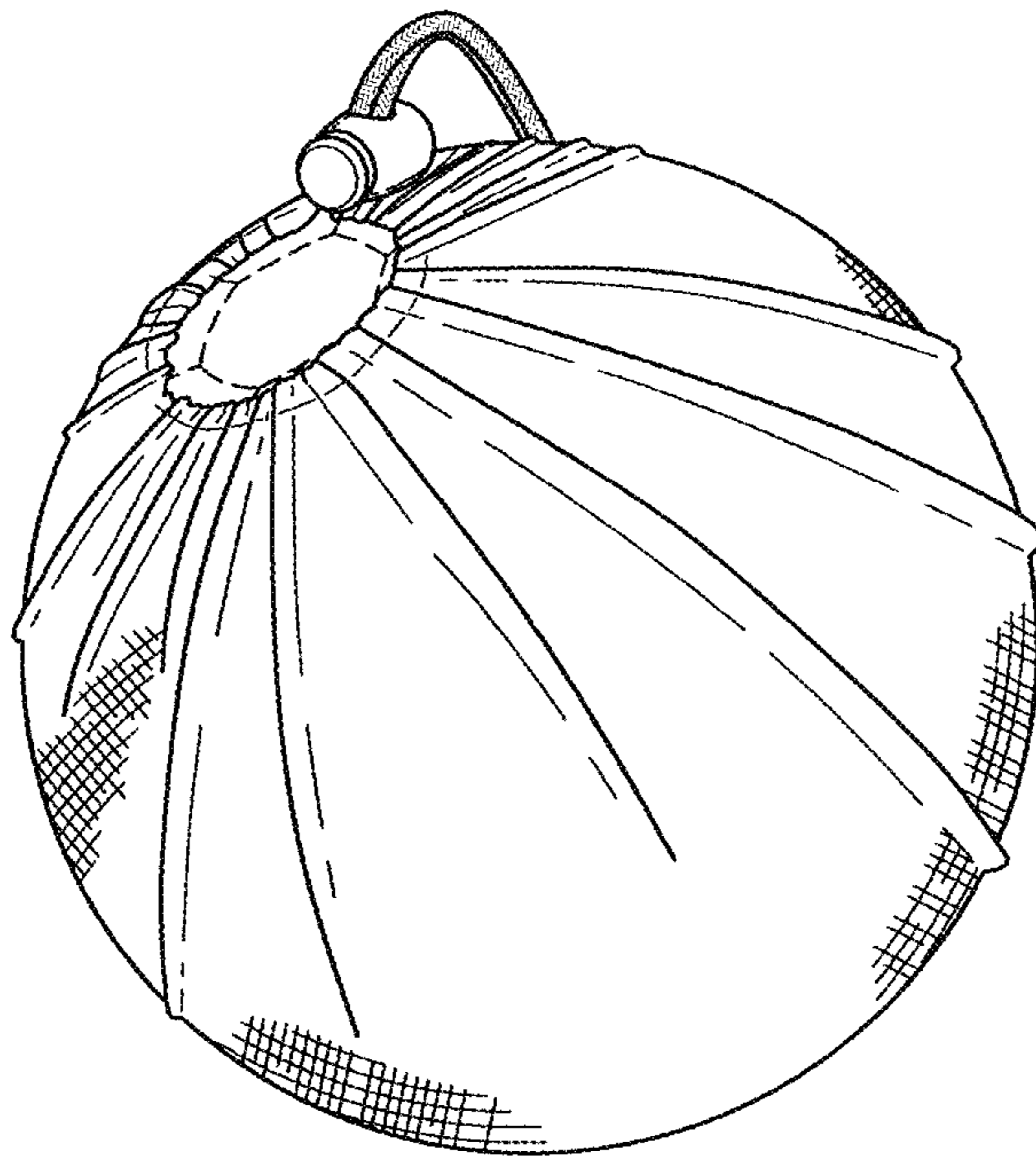

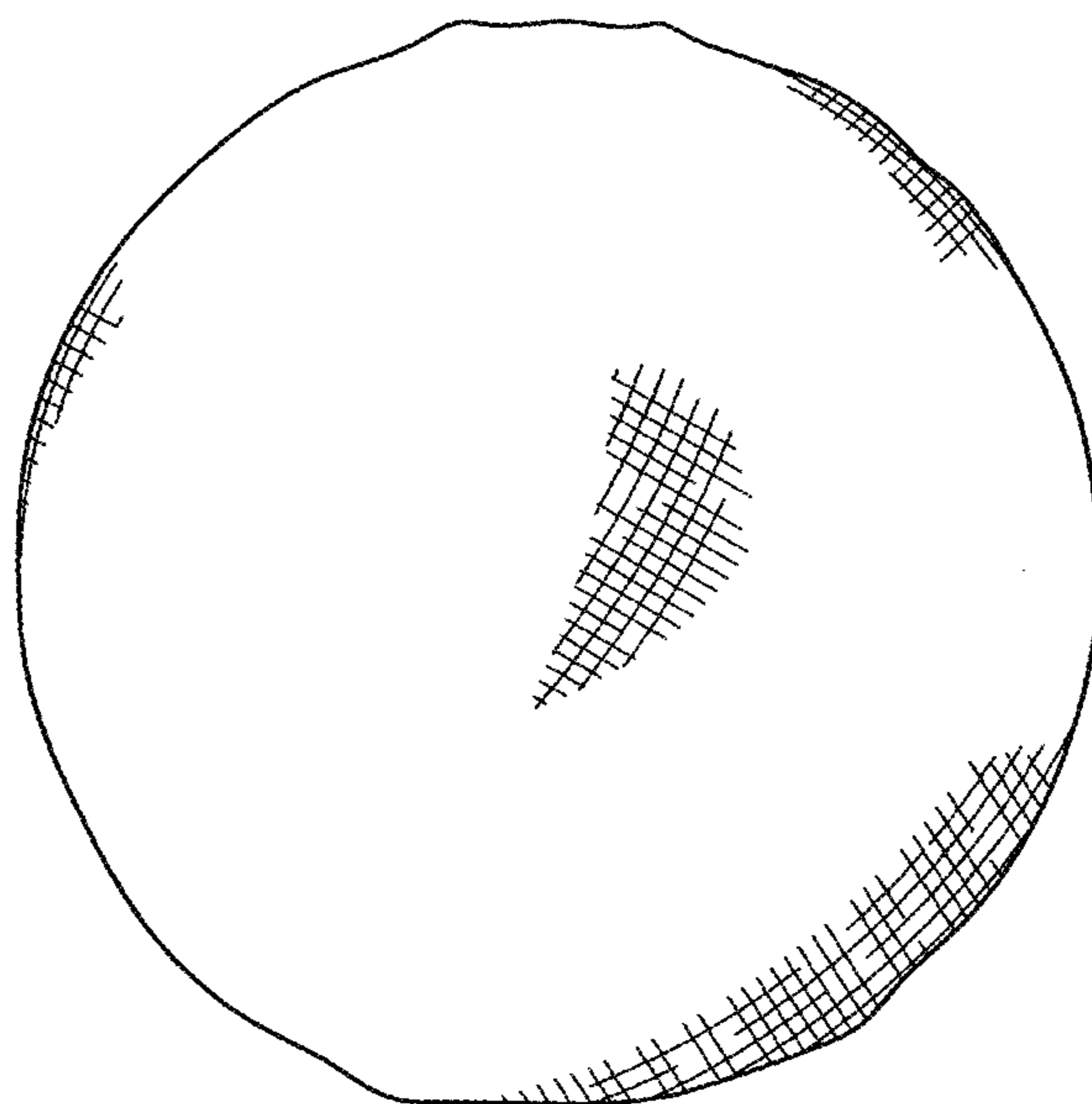
