(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a display screen or portion thereof with a graphical user interface, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a display screen or portion thereof, oriented in portrait, with a graphical user interface, showing our new design, according to a first embodiment thereof.

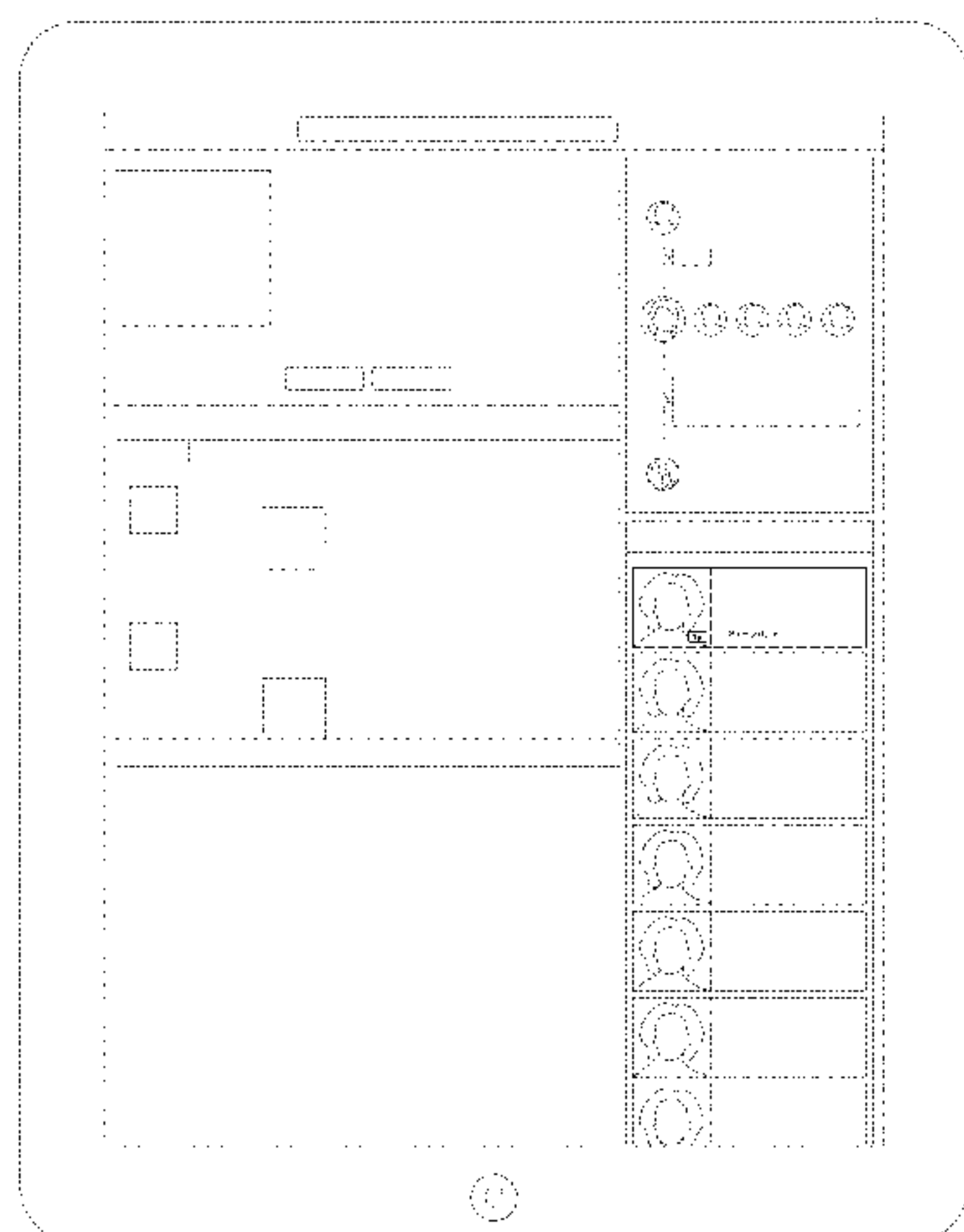


FIG. 2 is an annotated front view of the design of FIG. 1, according to the first embodiment.

FIG. 3 is an enlarged detail view of the design of FIG. 1, shown as indicated by “A” in FIG. 2, according to the first embodiment.

FIG. 4 is a front view of the display screen or portion thereof, oriented in landscape, with the graphical user interface in an alternate environment, according to the first embodiment.

FIG. 5 is a front view of a display screen or portion thereof, oriented in portrait, with a graphical user interface, showing our new design, according to a second embodiment thereof.

FIG. 6 is an annotated front view of the design of FIG. 5, according to the second embodiment.

FIG. 7 is an enlarged detail view of the design of FIG. 5, shown as indicated by “B” in FIG. 6, according to the second embodiment.

FIG. 8 is a front view of the display screen or portion thereof oriented in landscape, with the graphical user interface in an alternate environment, according to the second embodiment.

FIG. 9 is a front view of a display screen or portion thereof, oriented in portrait, with a graphical user interface, showing our new design, according to a third embodiment thereof.

FIG. 10 is an annotated front view of the design of FIG. 9, according to the third embodiment.

FIG. 11 is an enlarged detail view of the design of FIG. 9, shown as indicated by “C” in FIG. 10, according to the third embodiment.

FIG. 12 is a front view of the display screen or portion thereof, oriented in landscape, with the graphical user interface in an alternate environment, according to the third embodiment.

FIG. 13 is a front view of a display screen or portion thereof, oriented in portrait, with a graphical user interface, showing our new design, according to a fourth embodiment thereof.

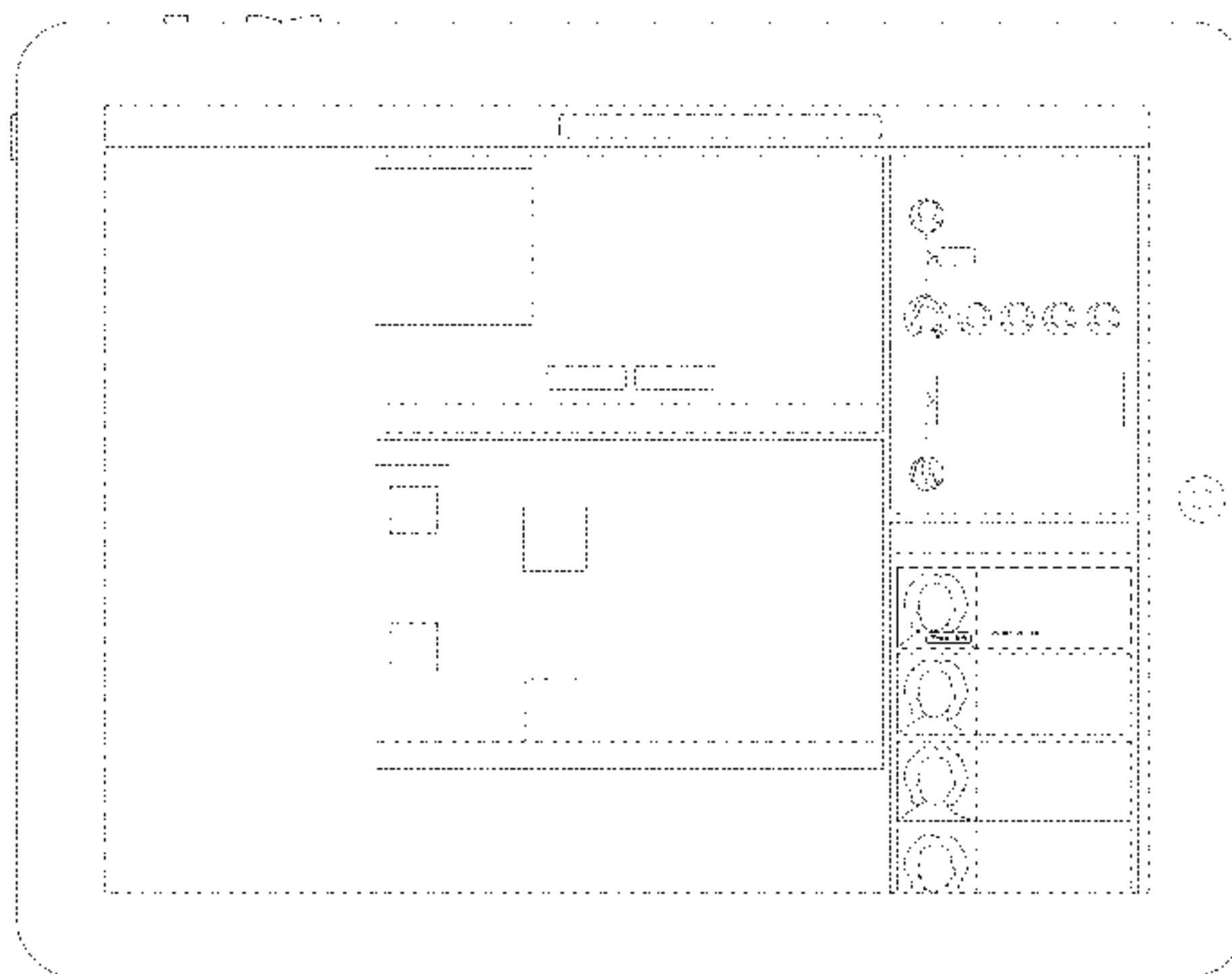
FIG. 14 is an annotated front view of the design of FIG. 13, according to the fourth embodiment.

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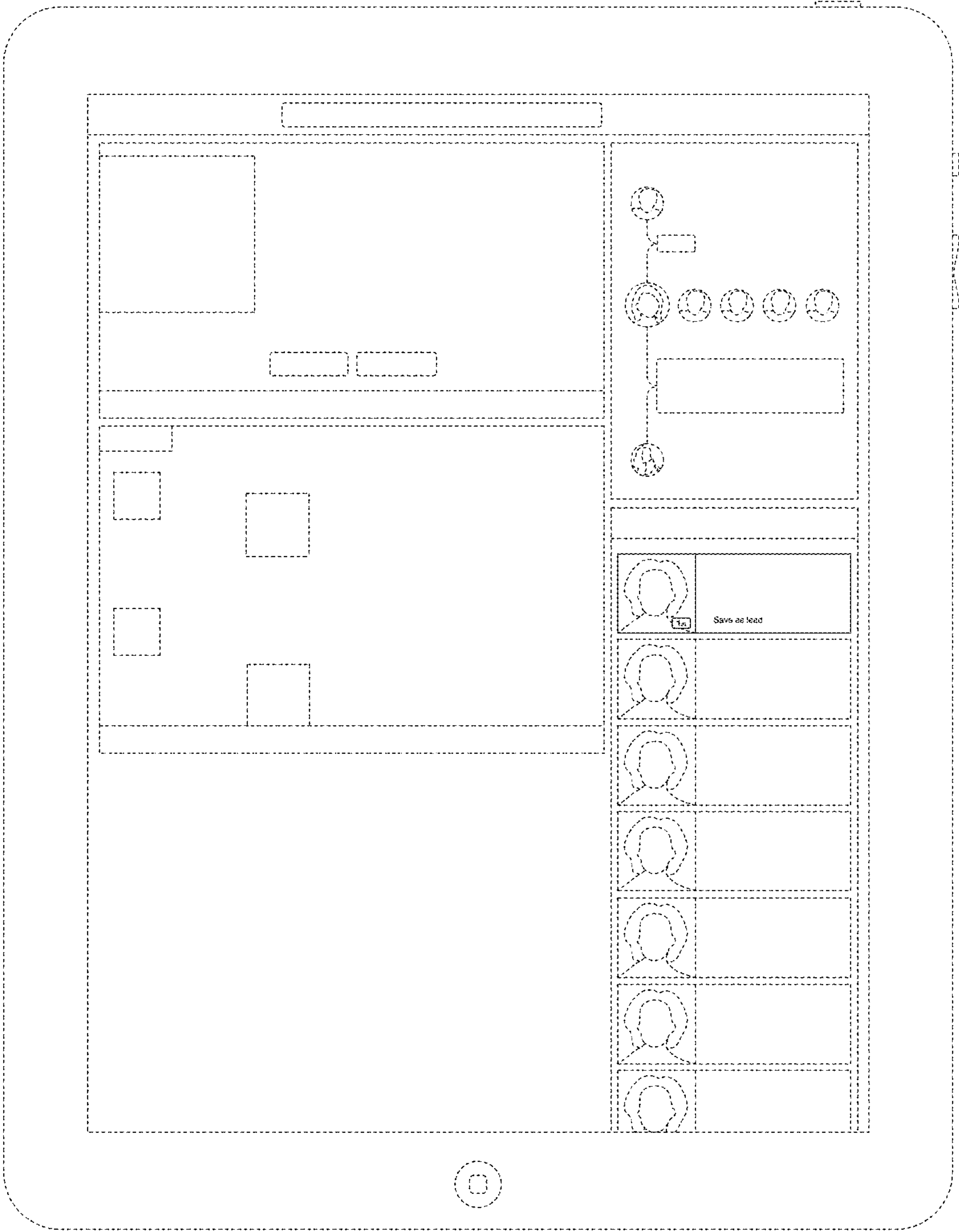

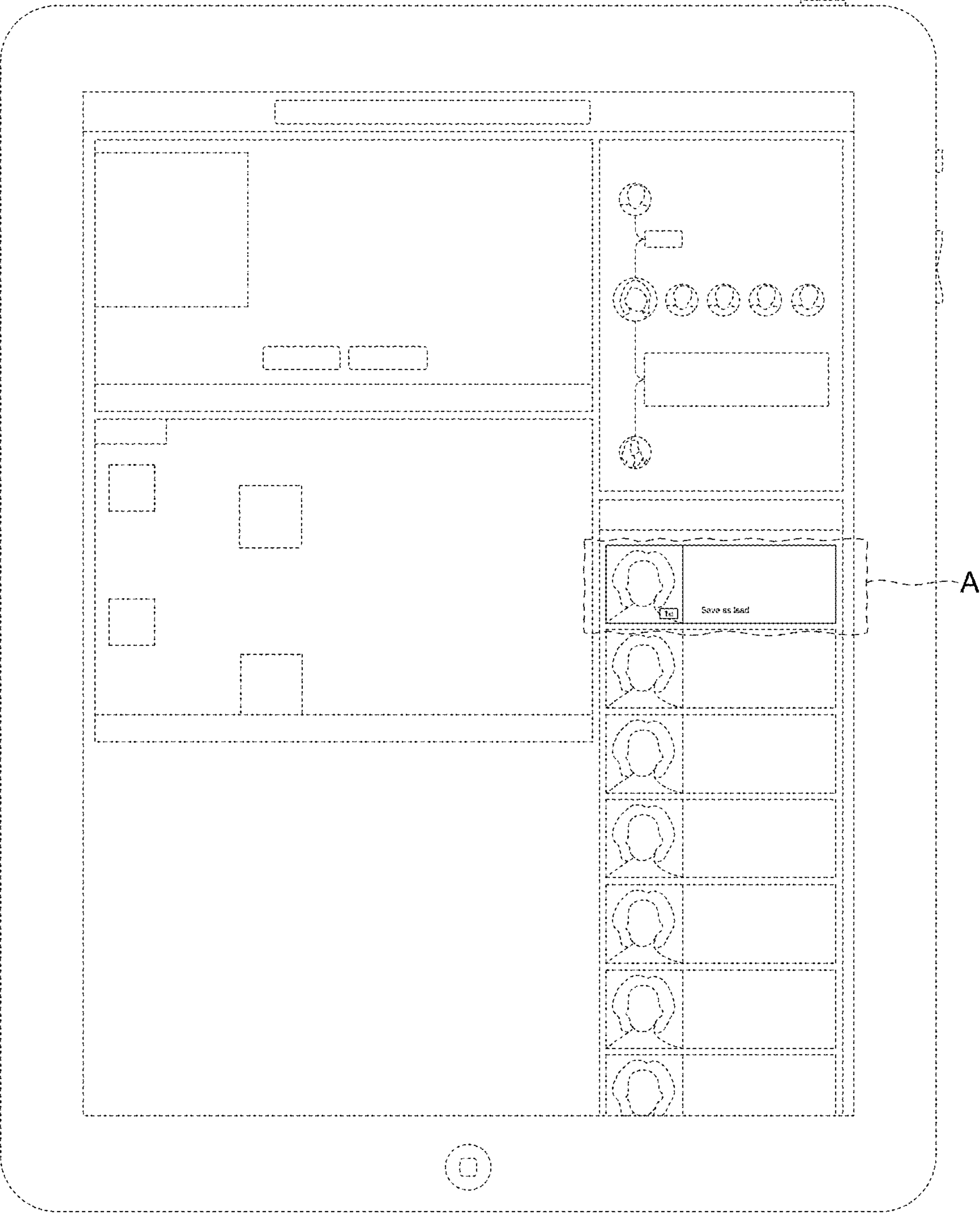

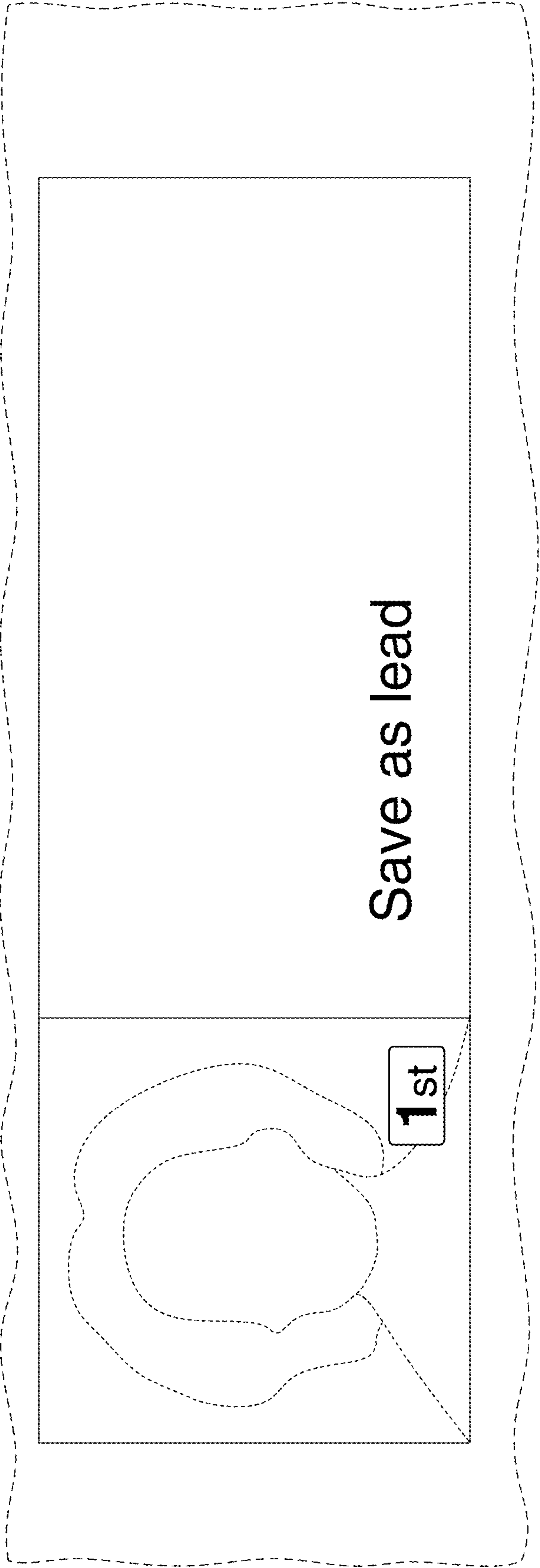

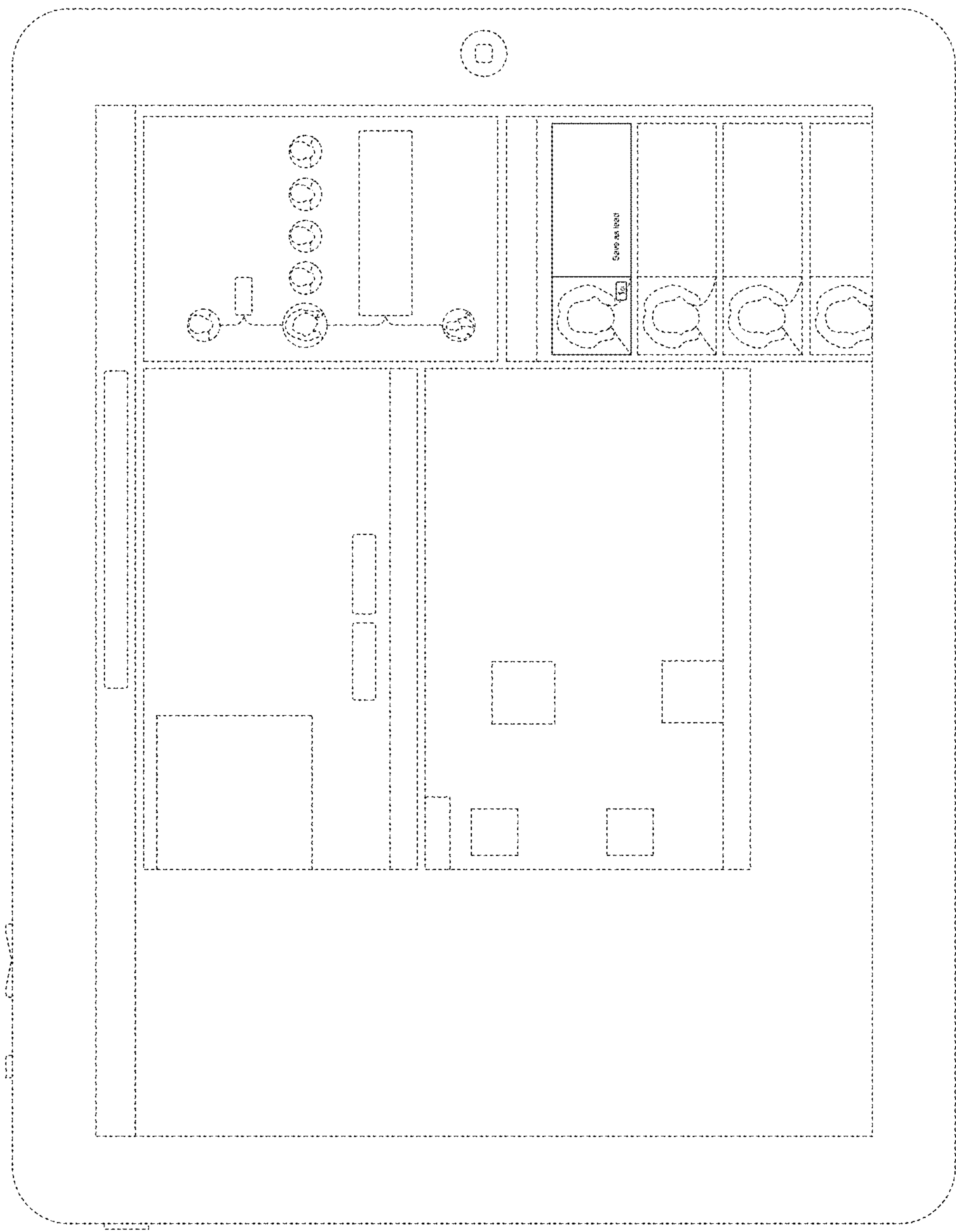

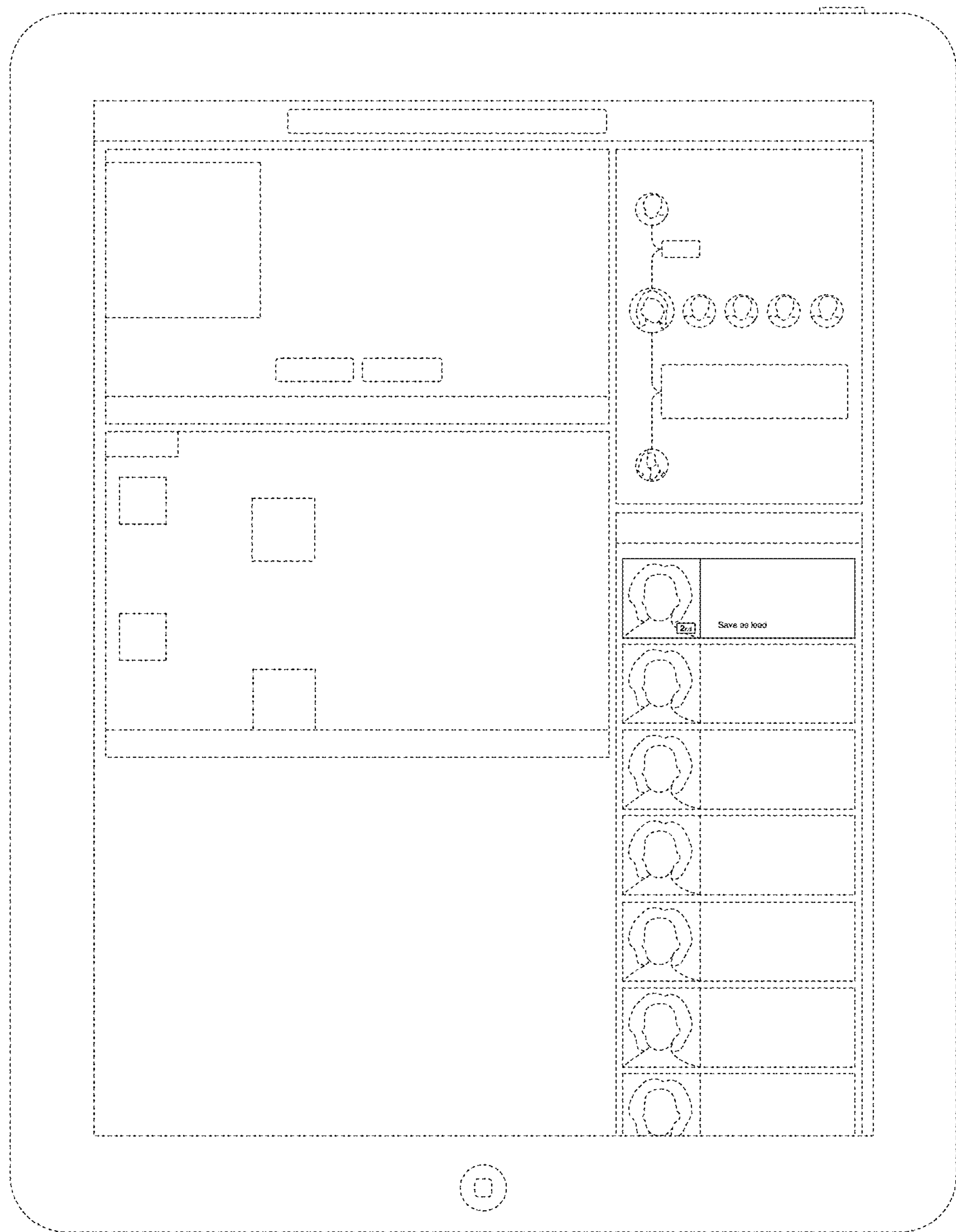

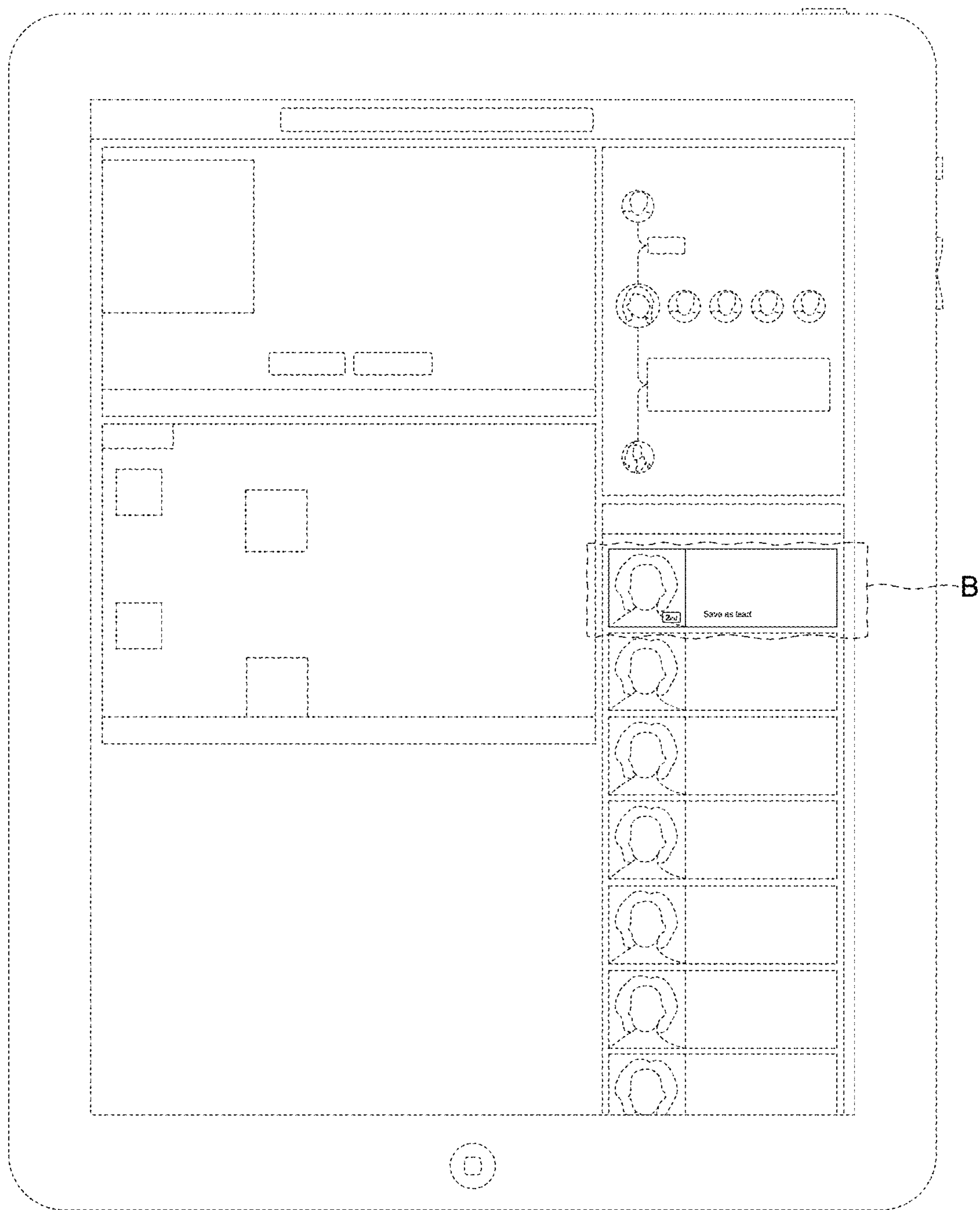

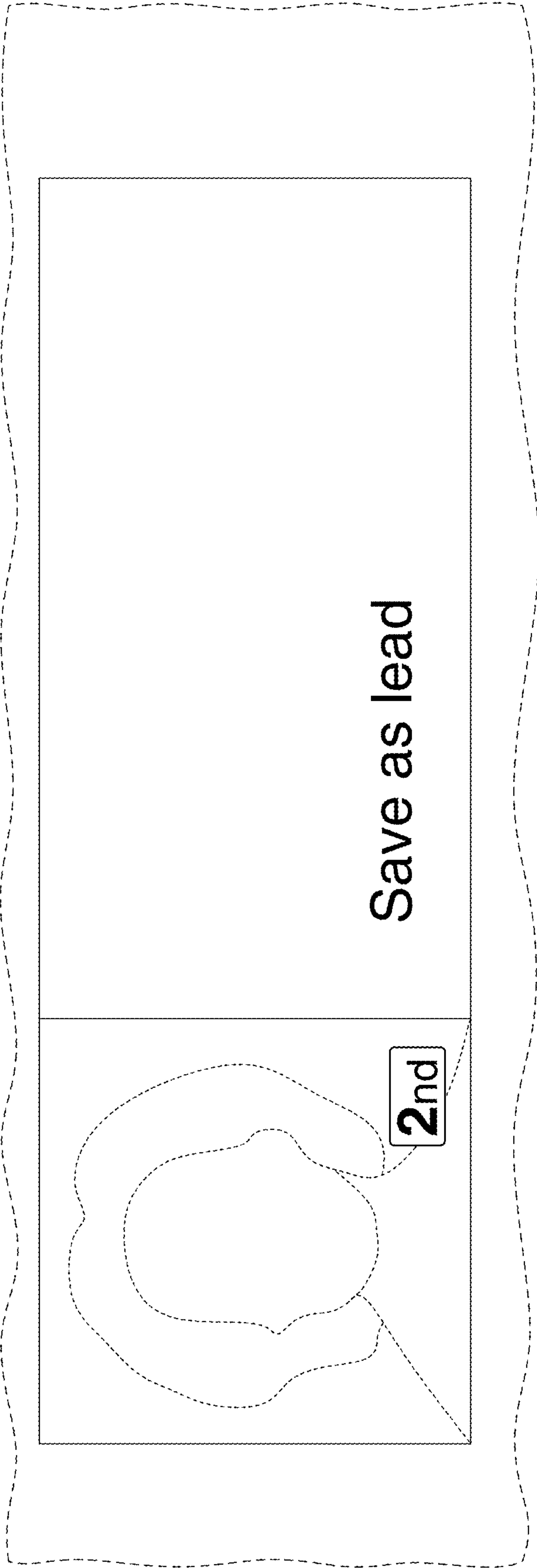

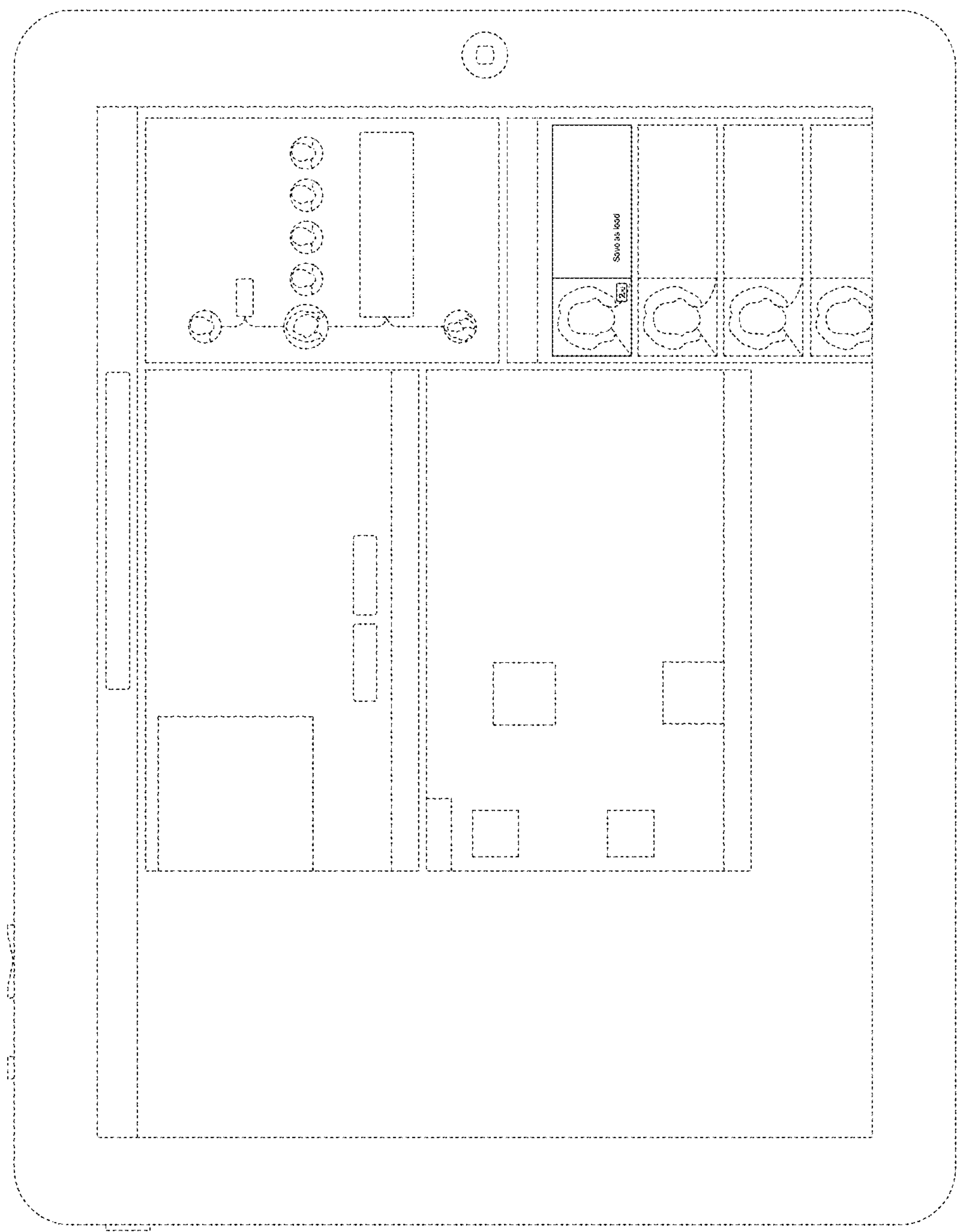

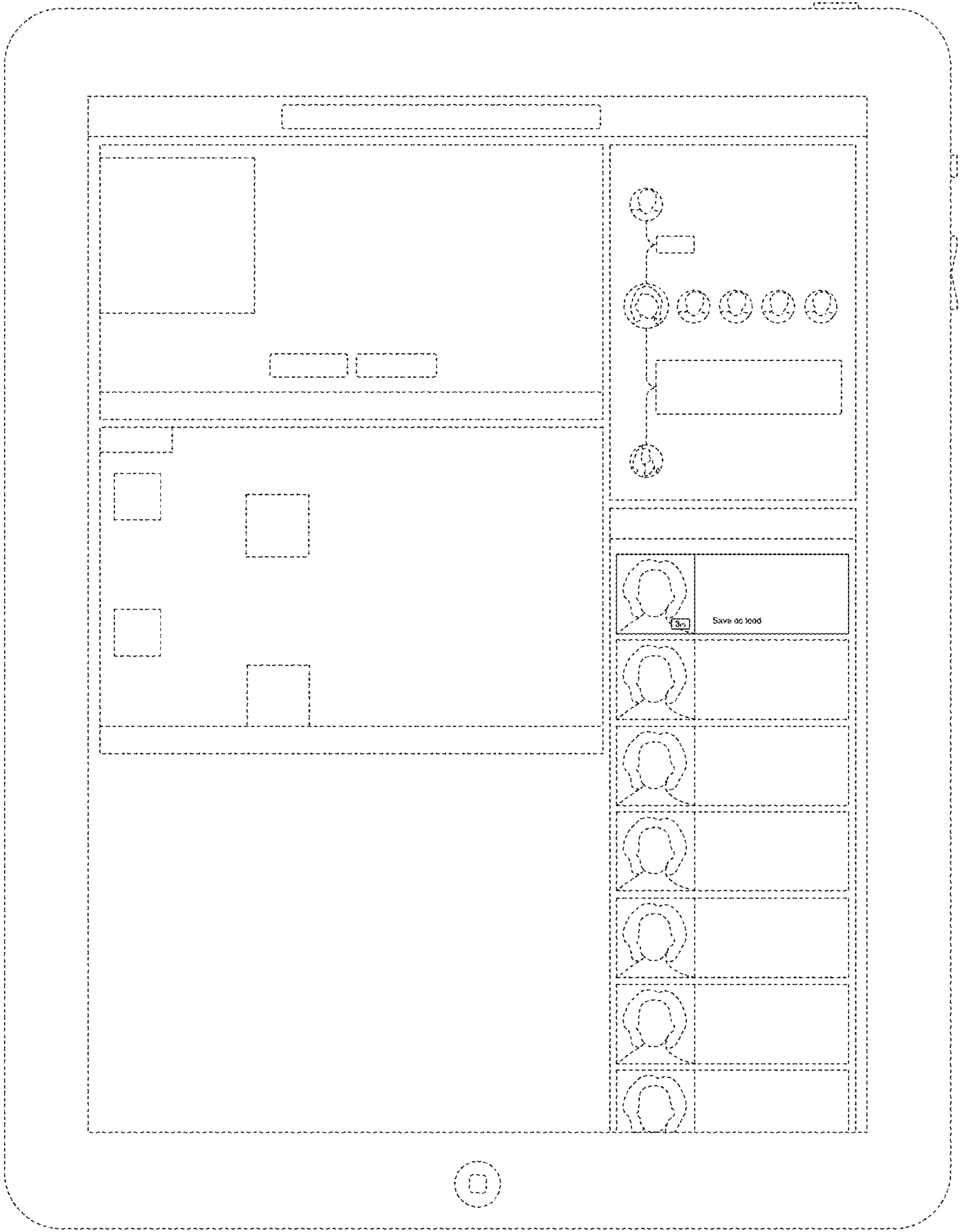

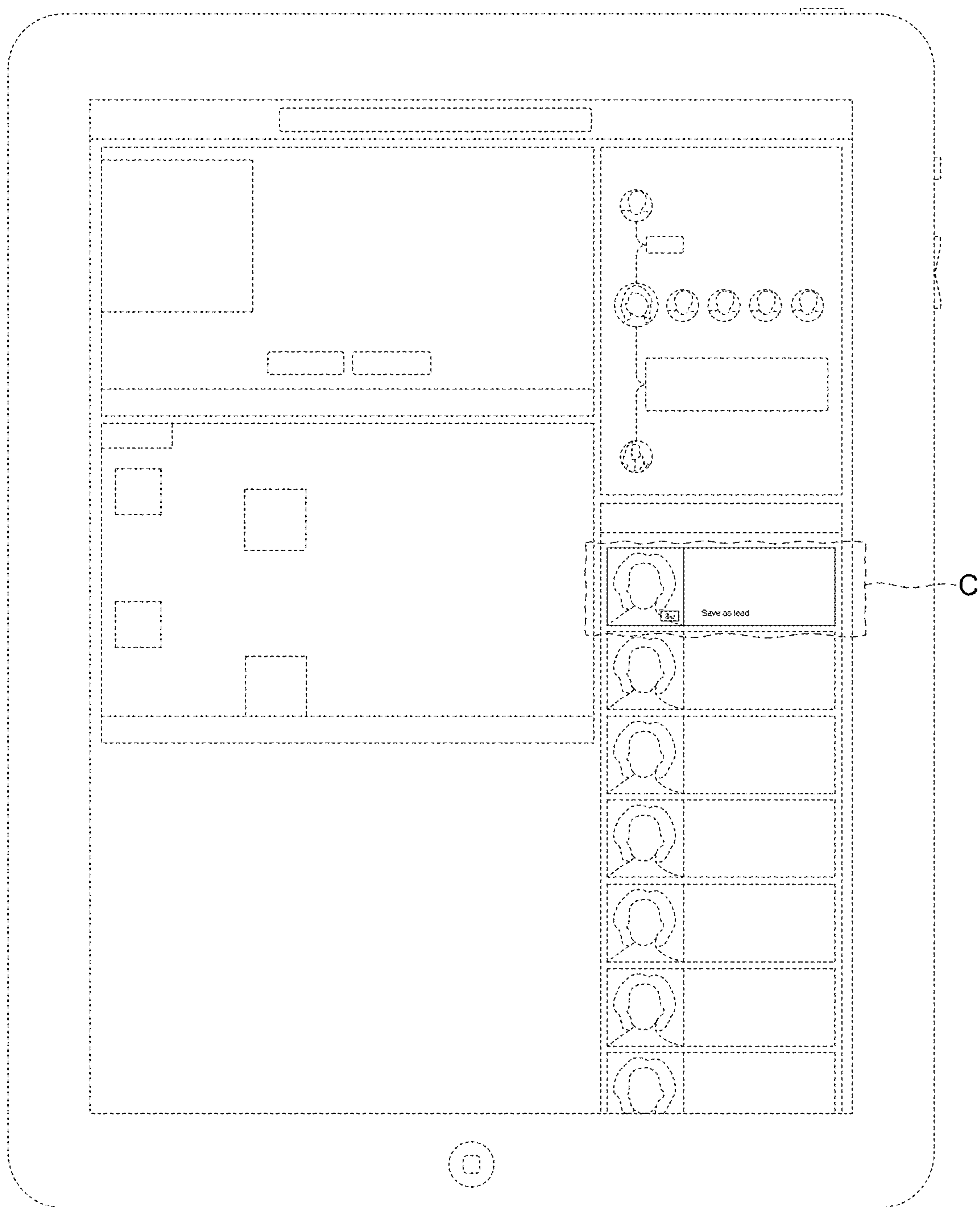

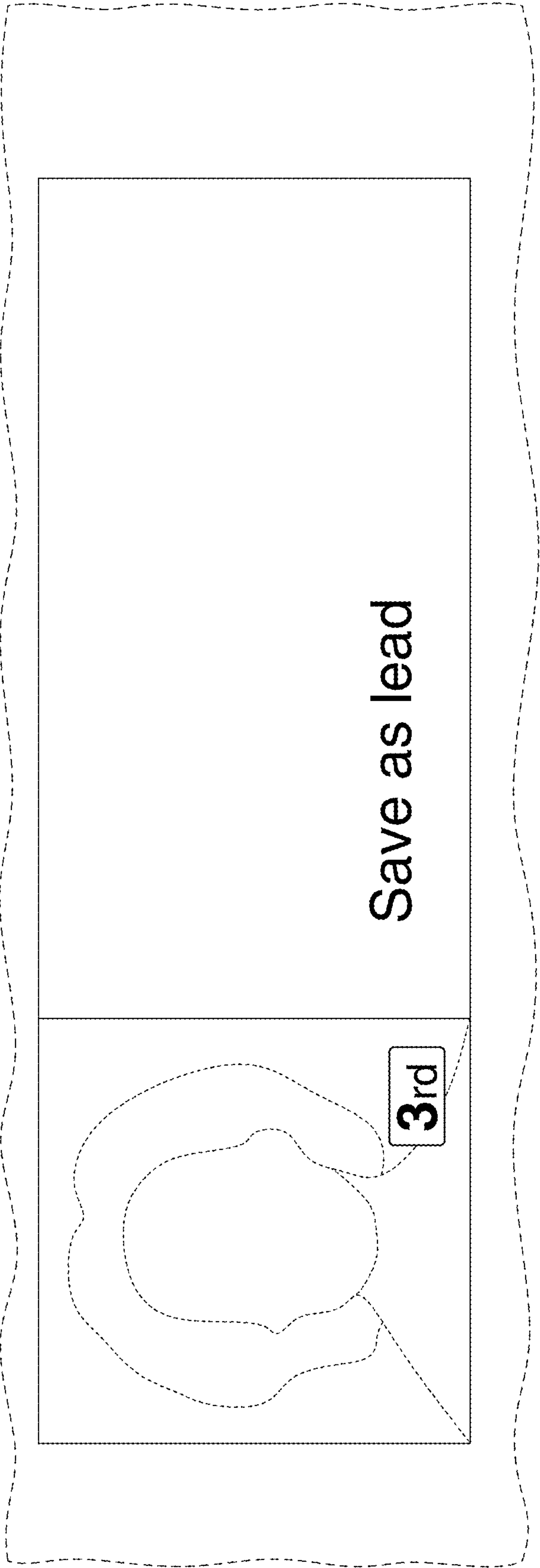

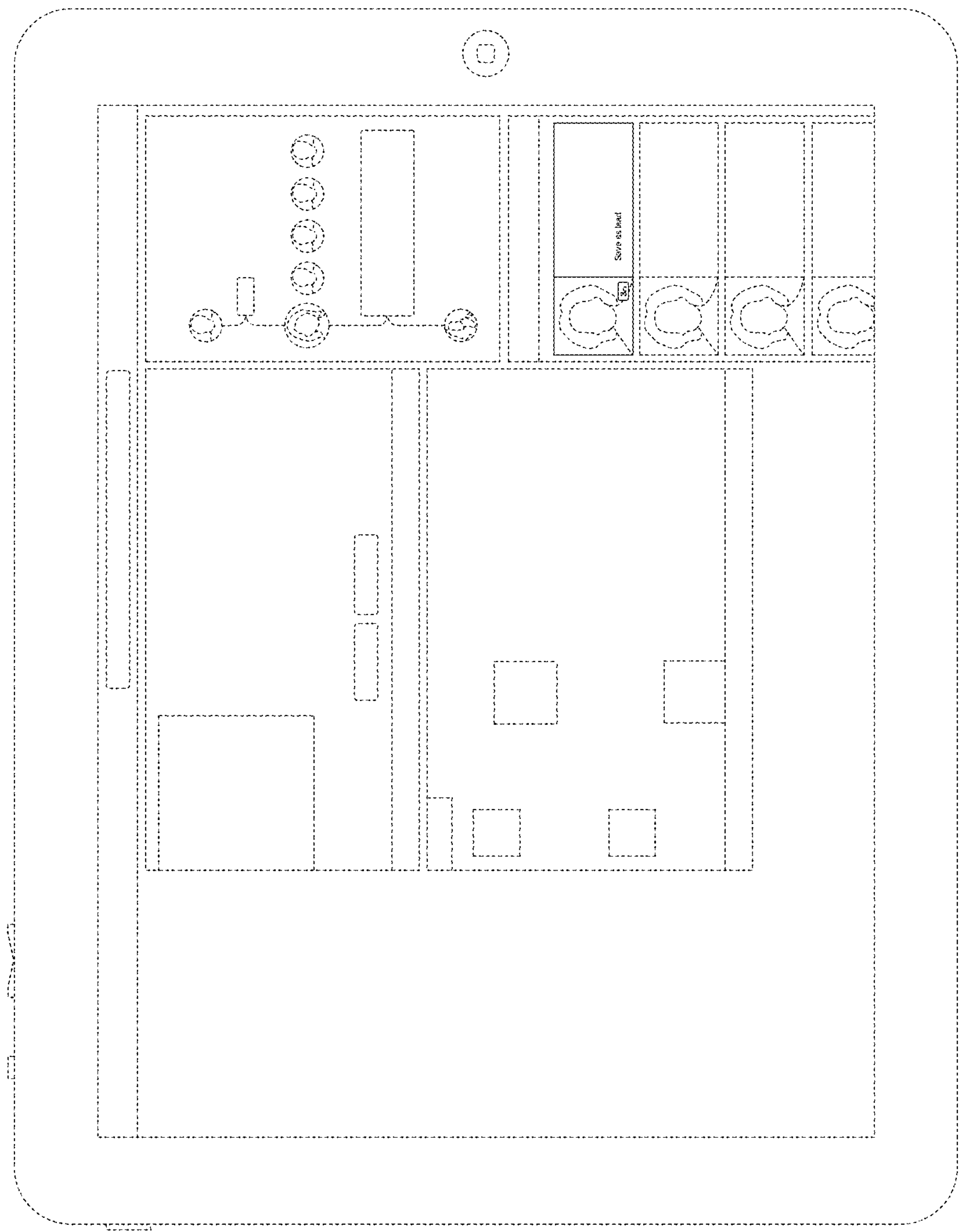

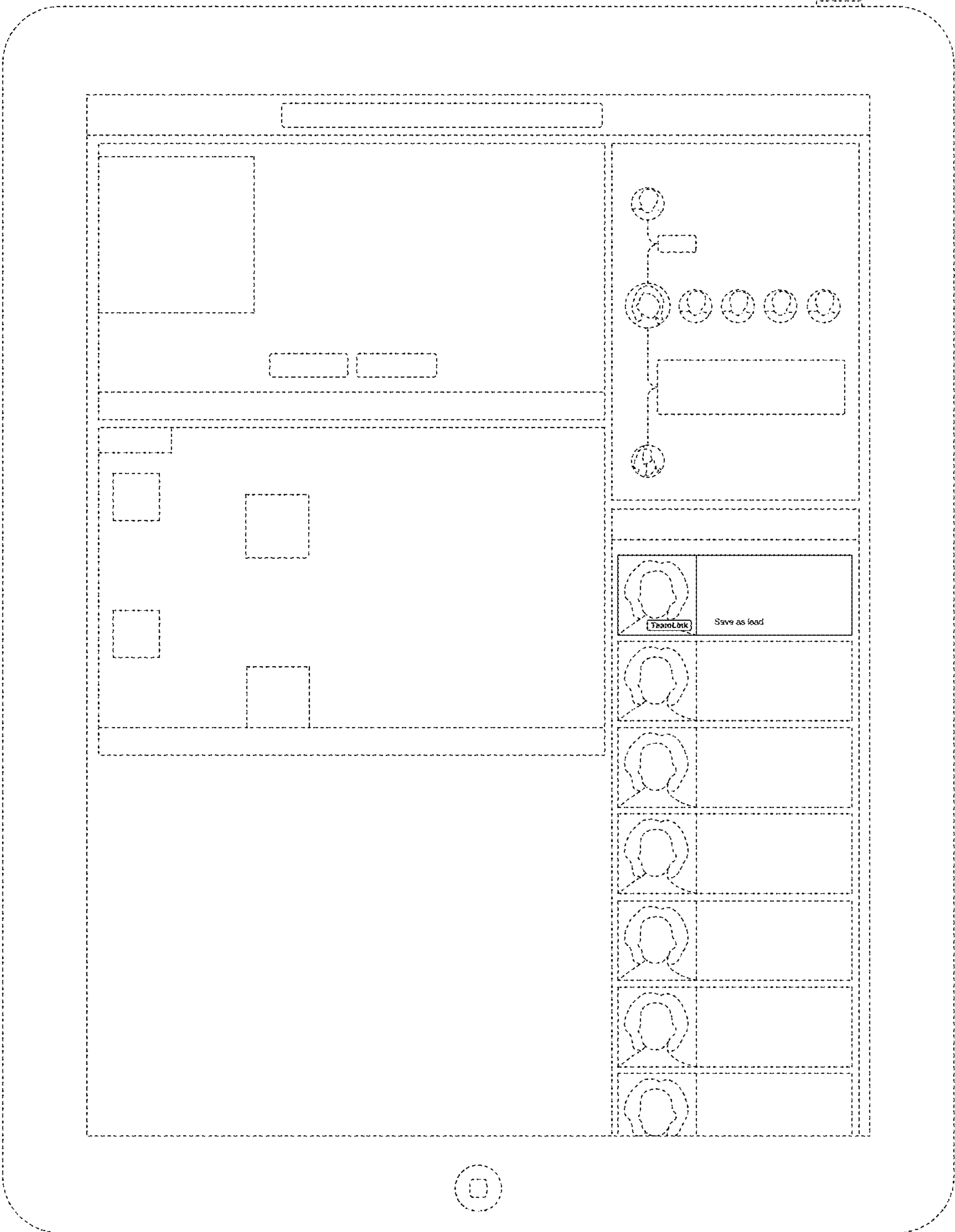

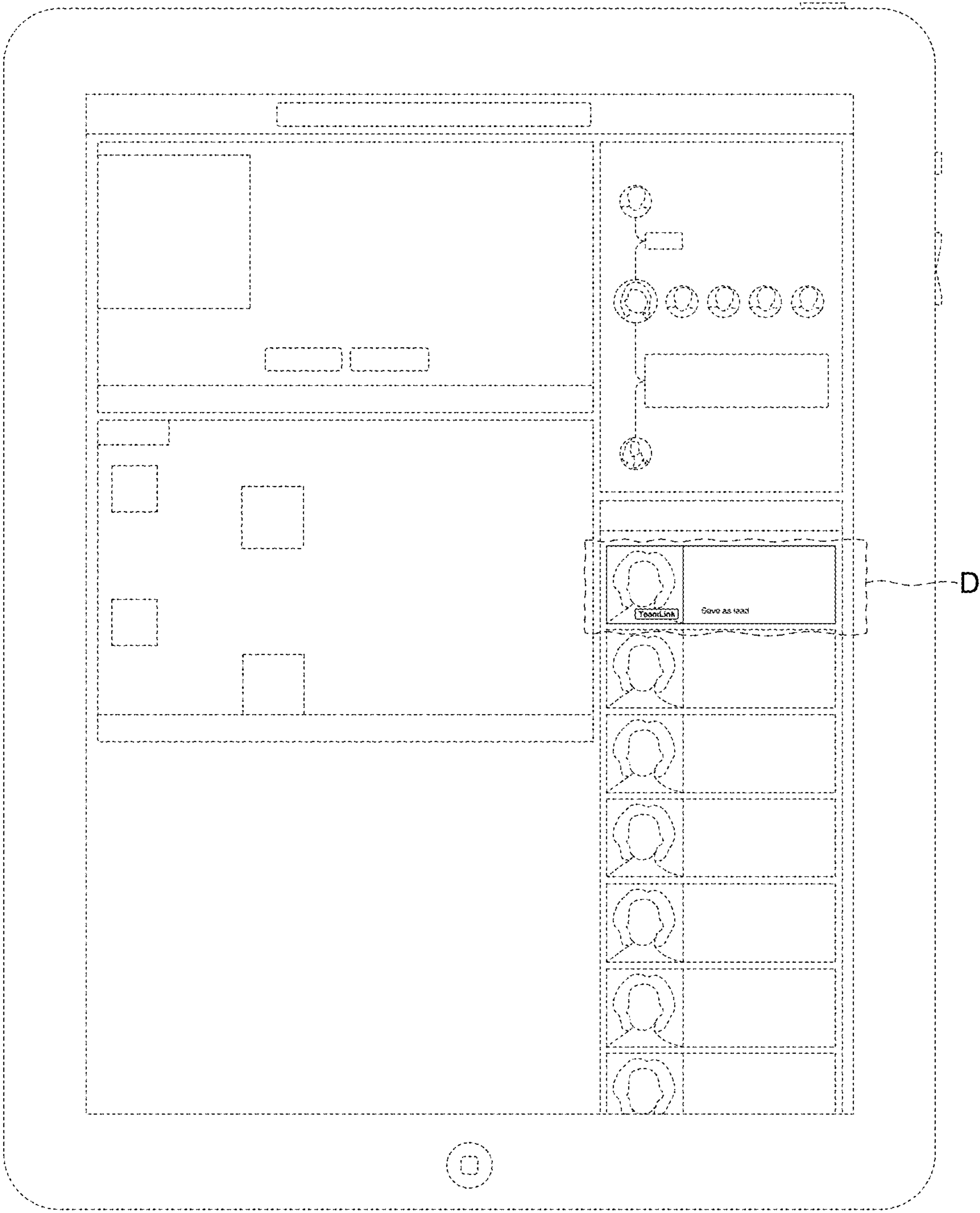

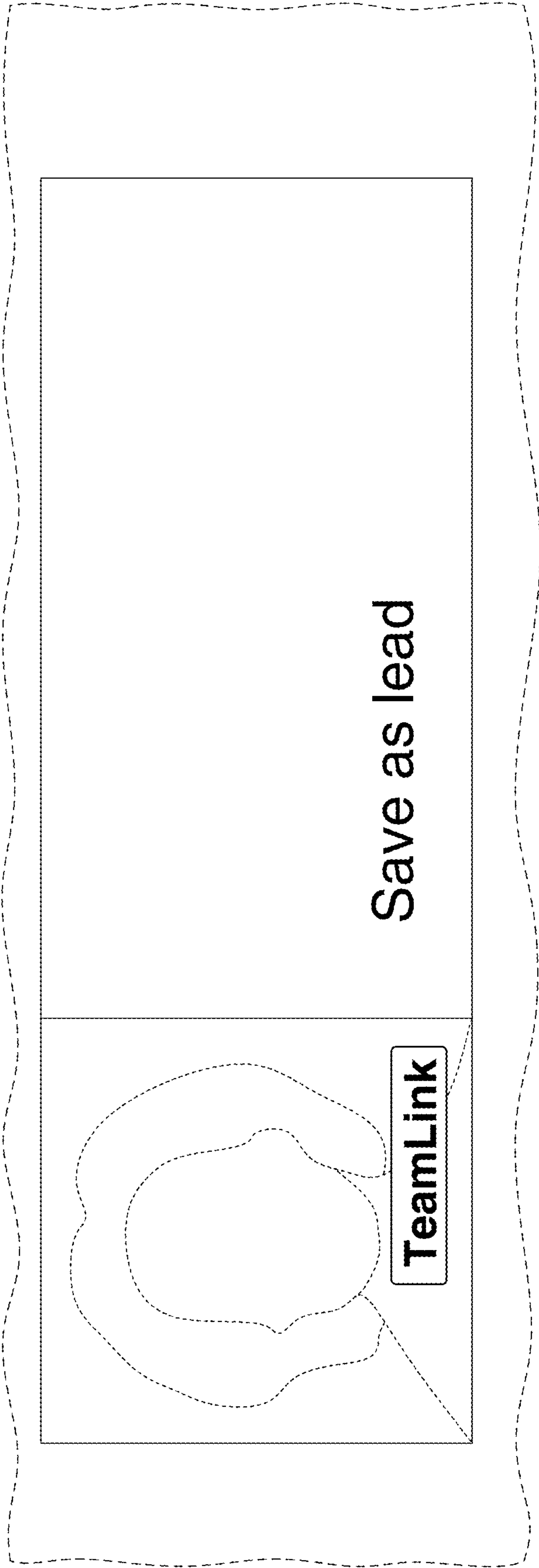

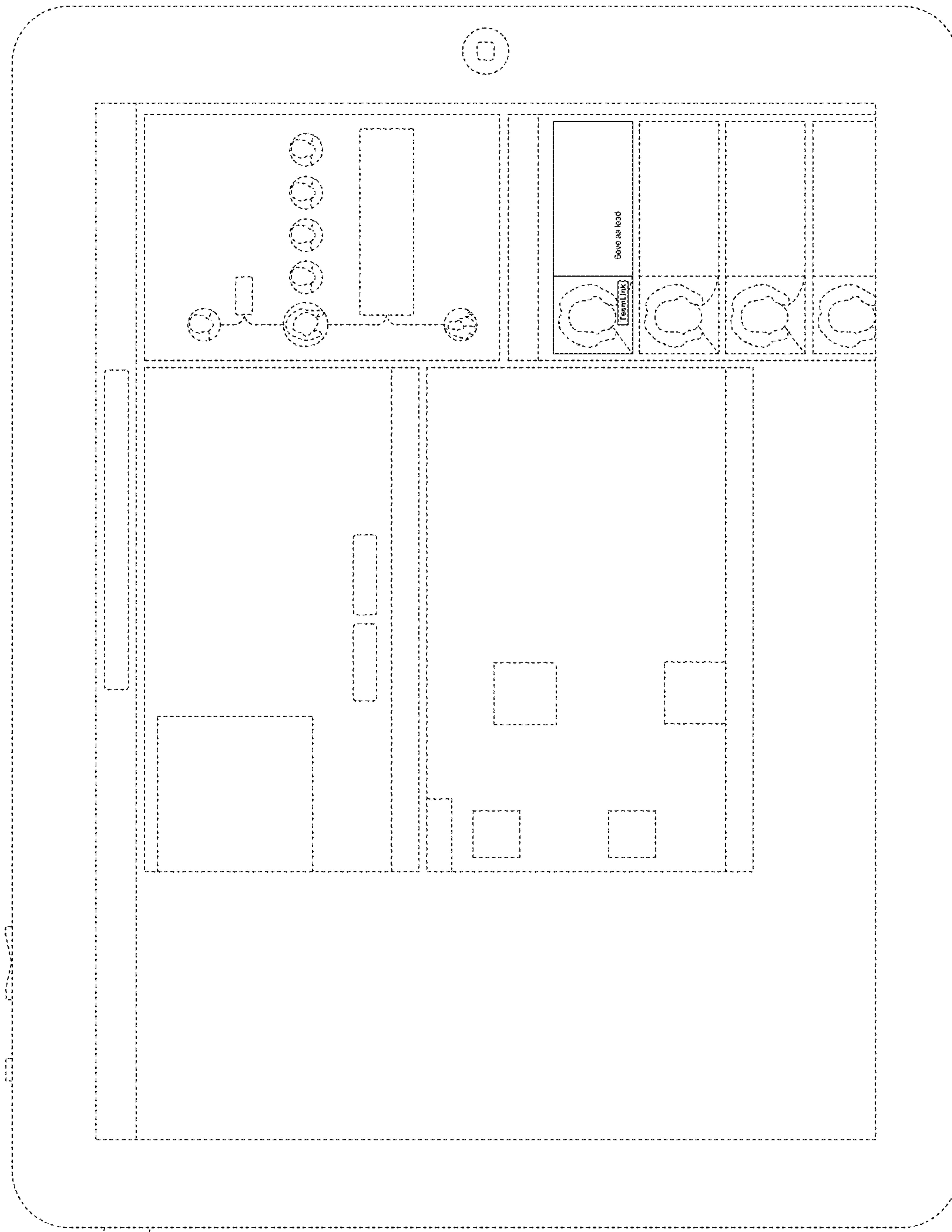
