I claim the ornamental design for a product merchandiser, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

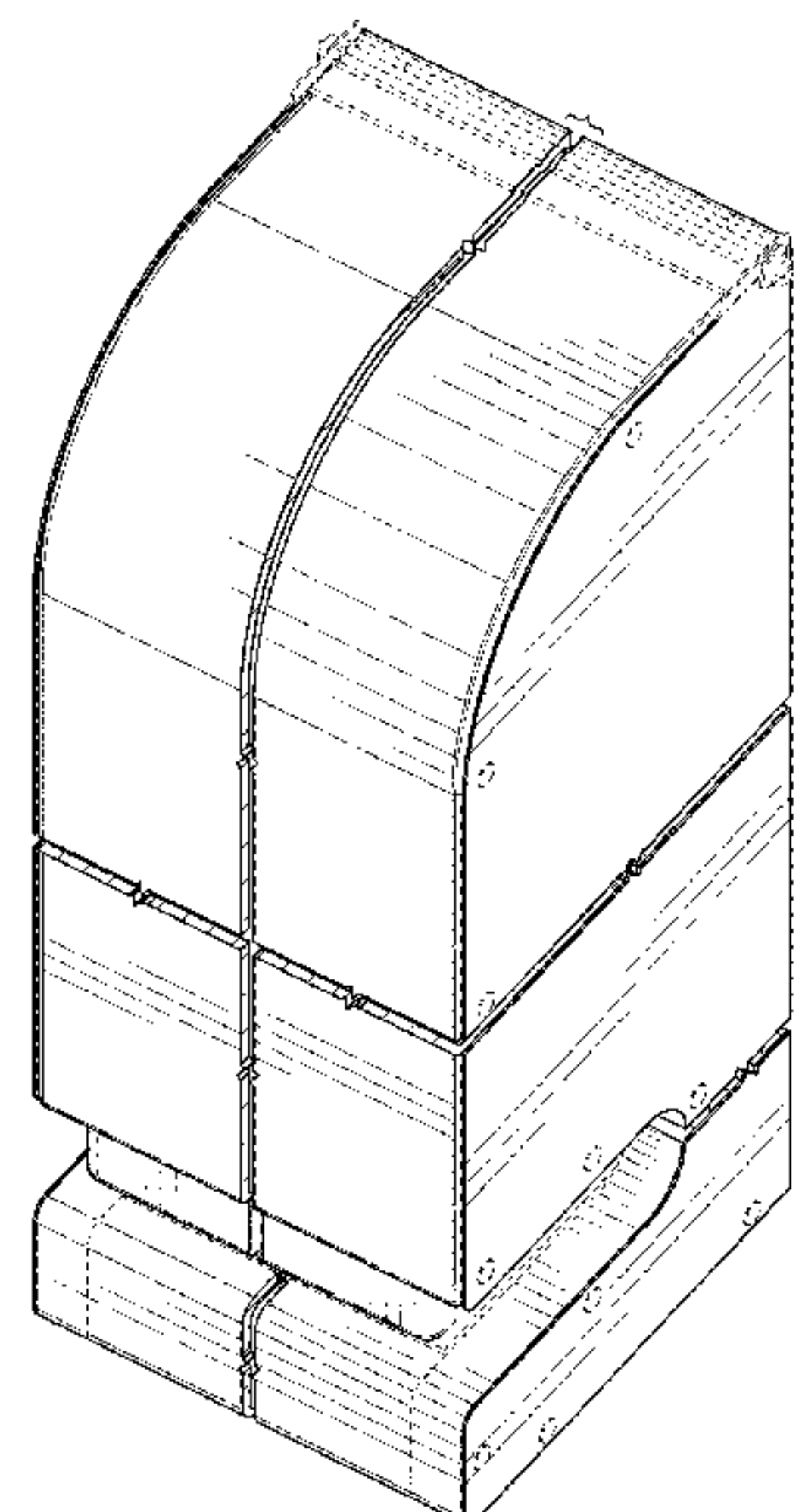
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a product merchandiser, showing my new design;

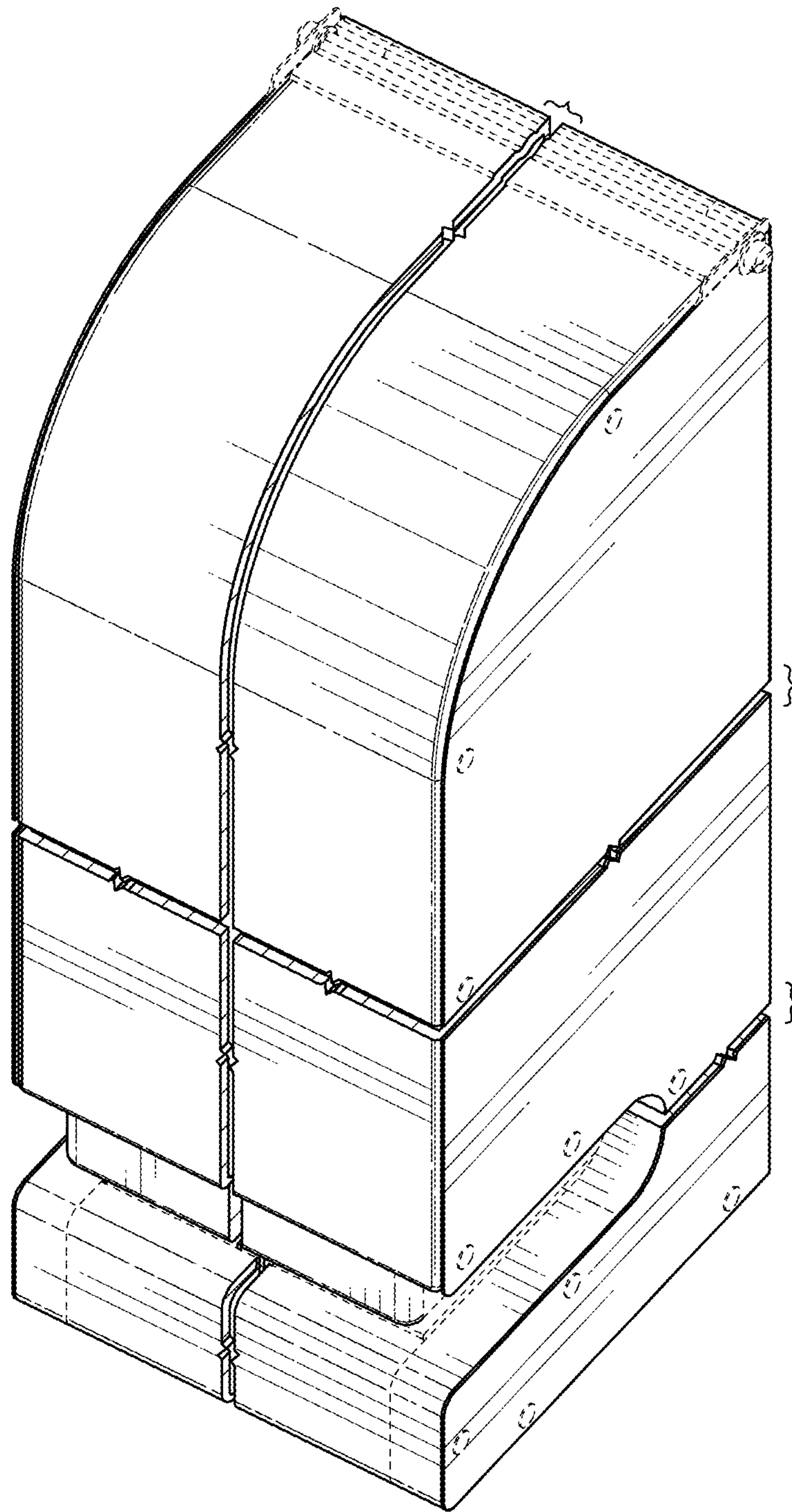

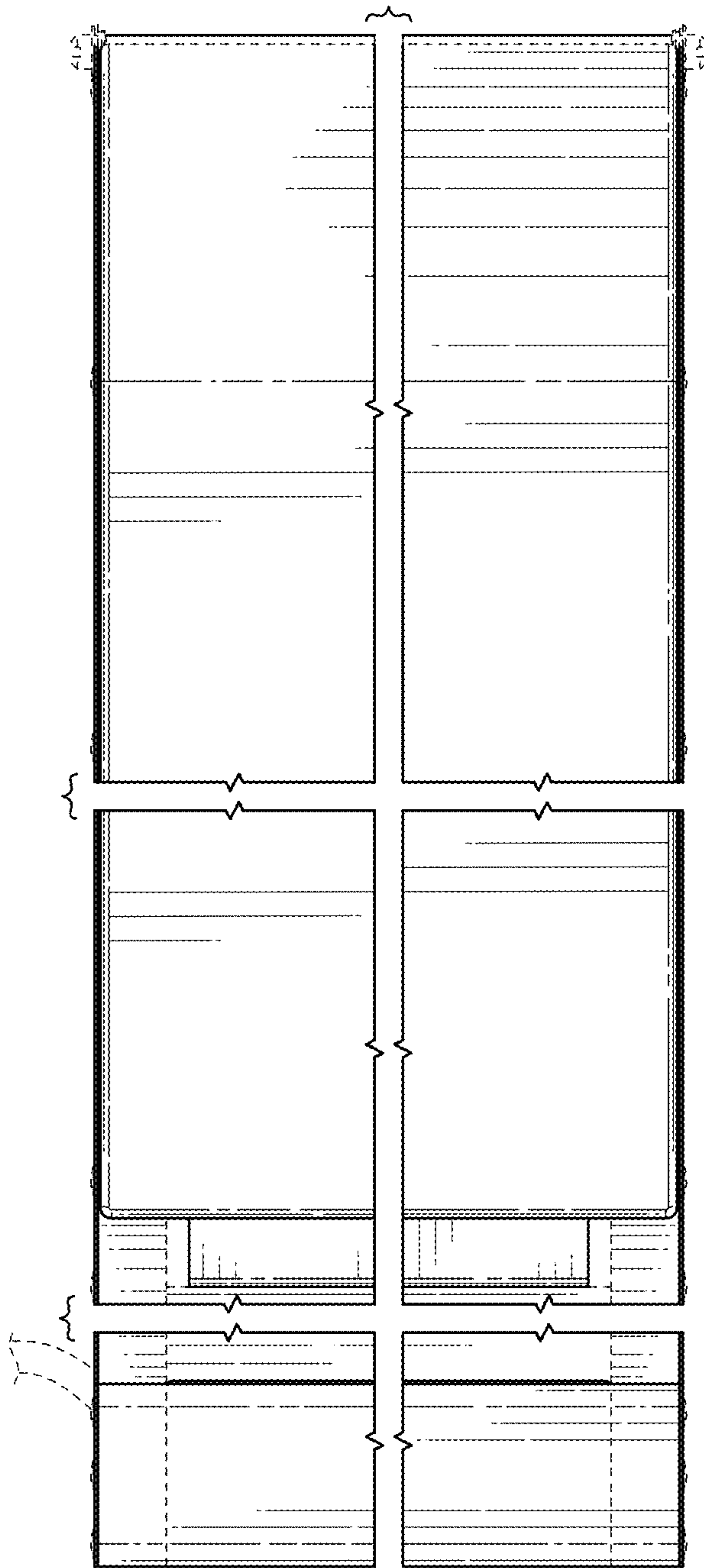

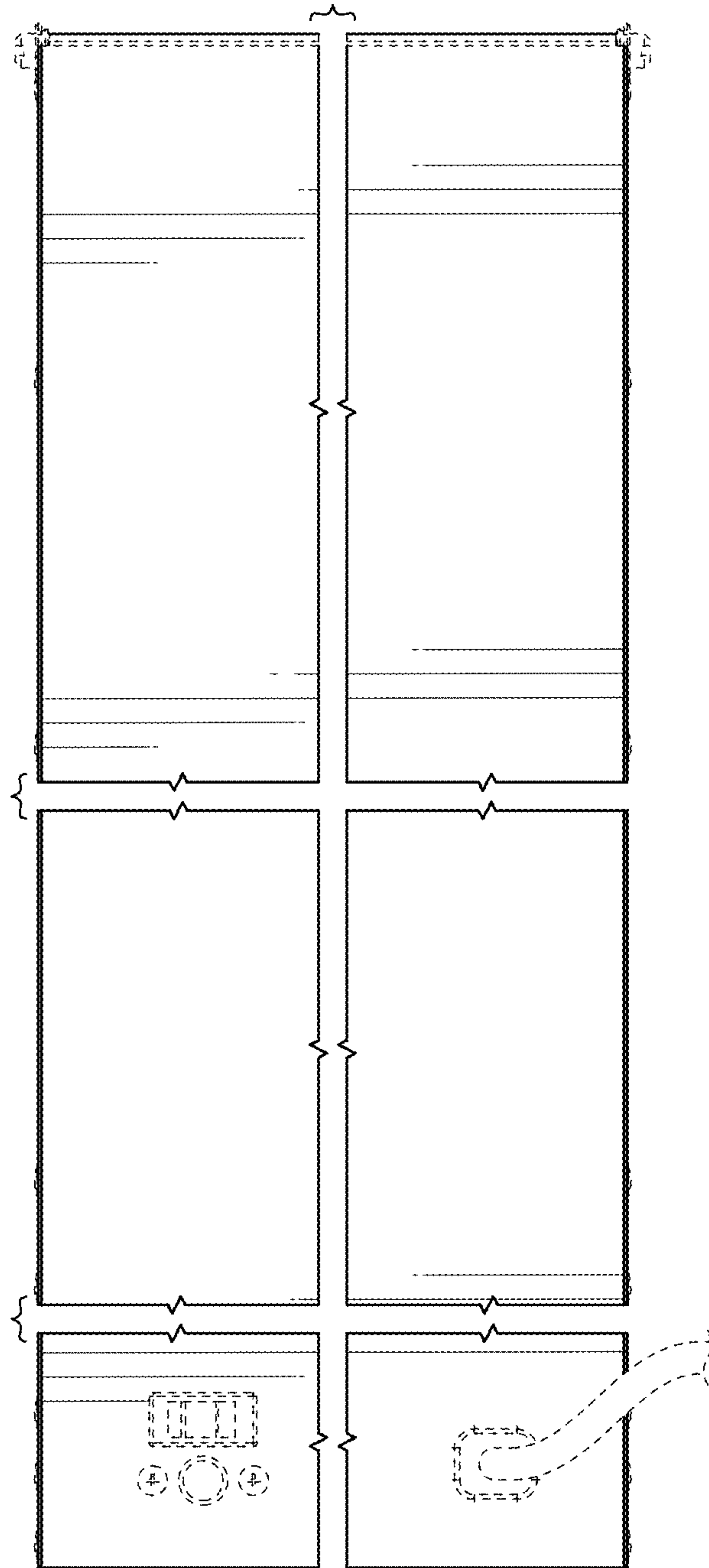

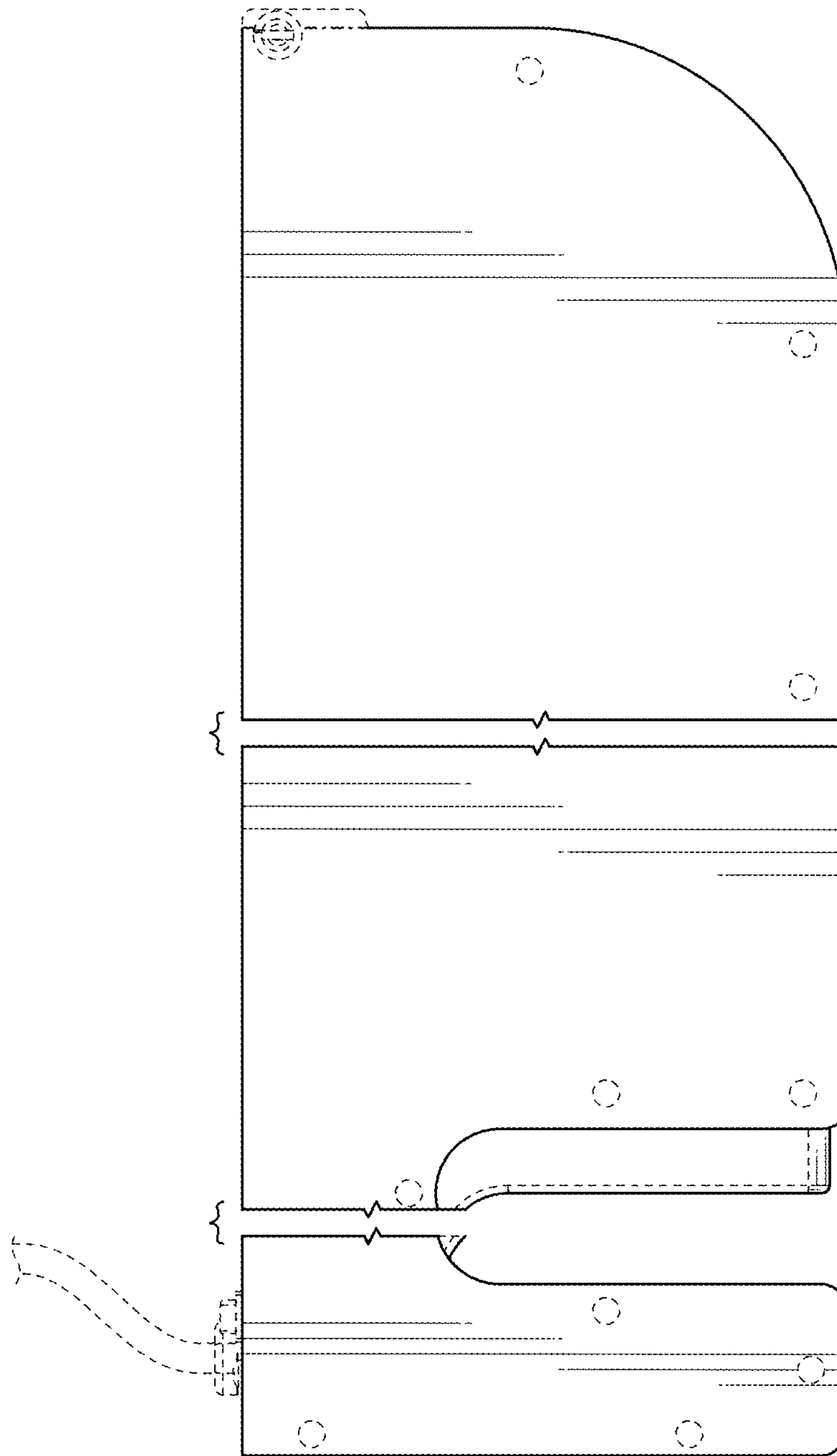

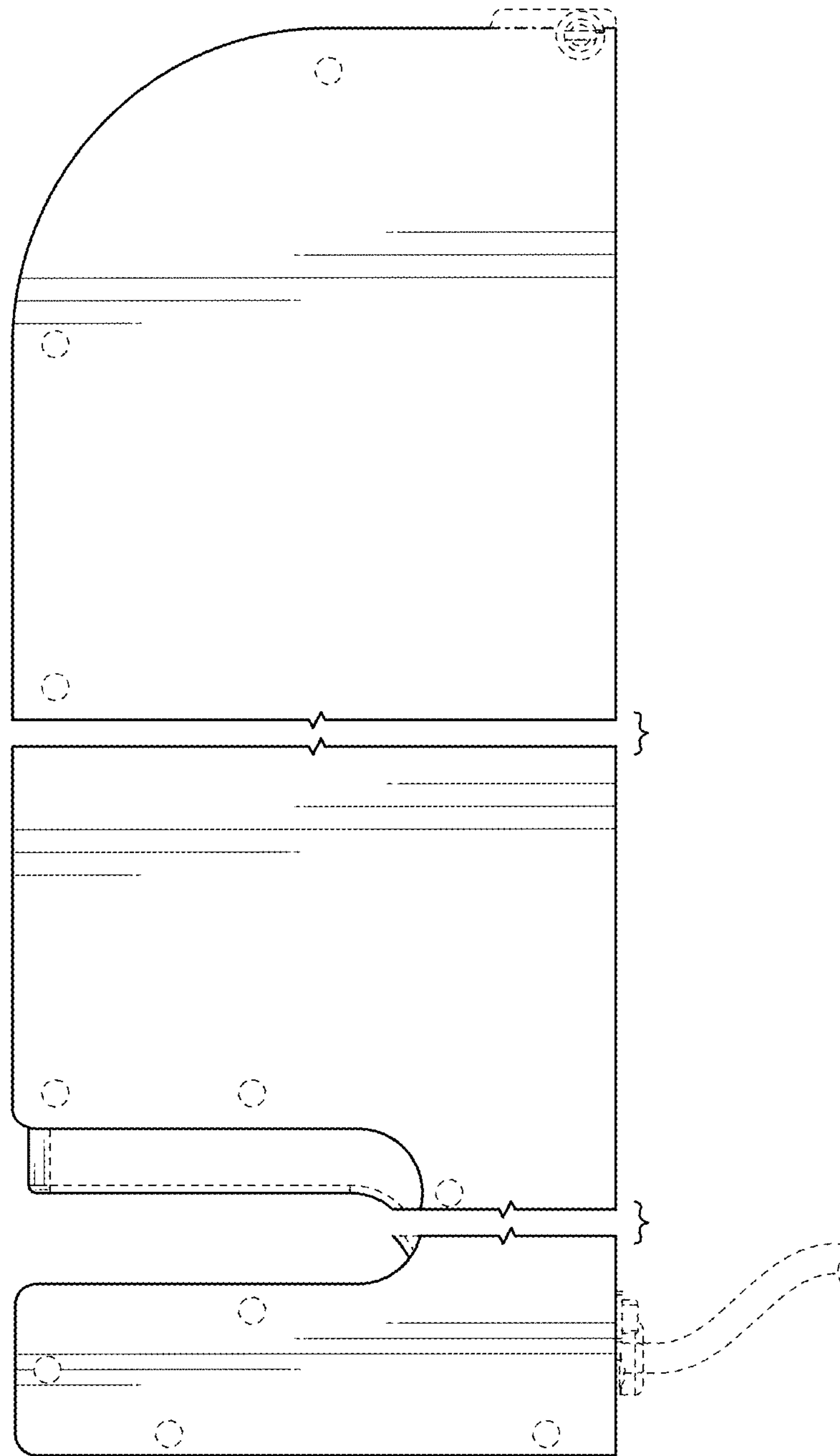

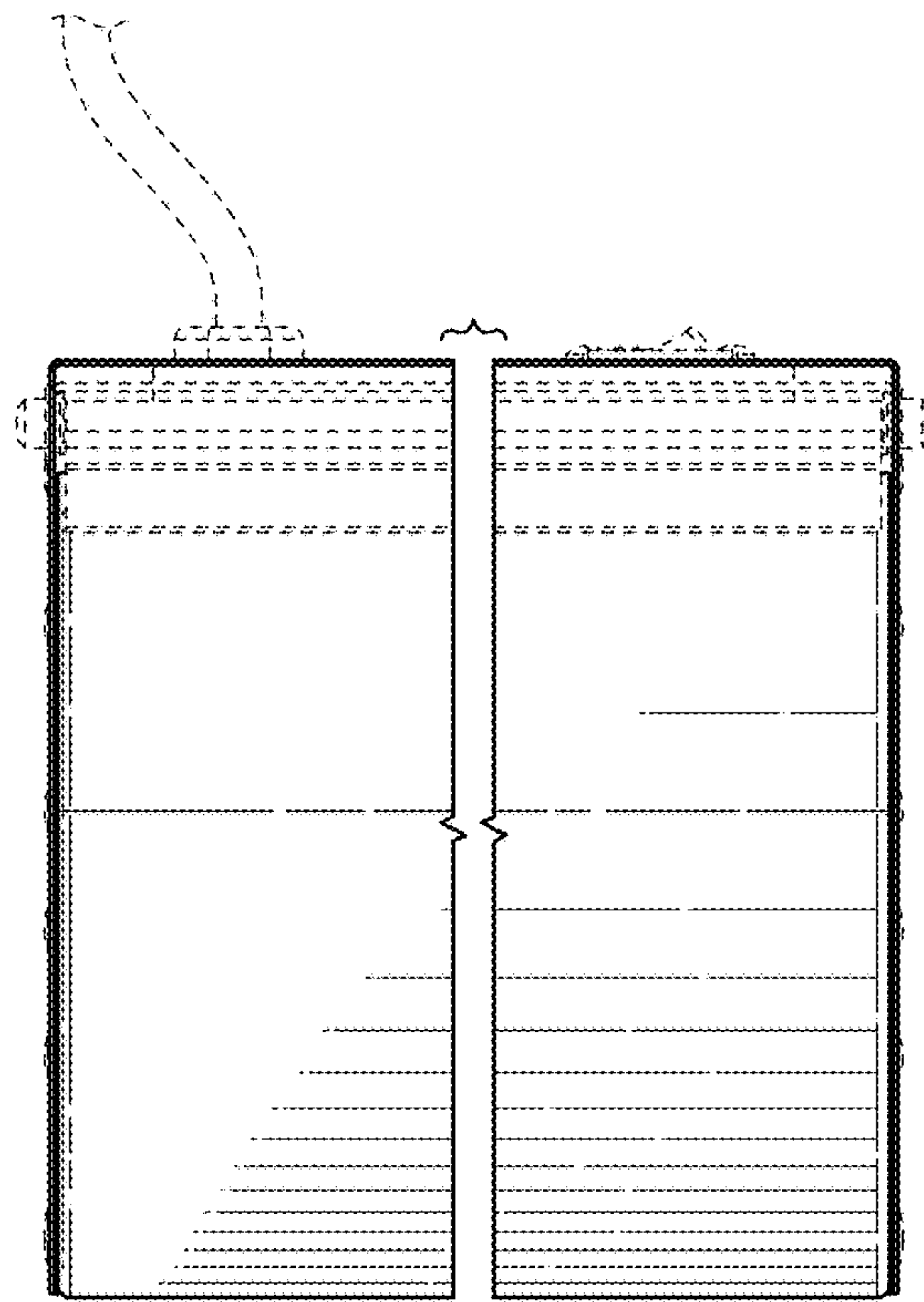

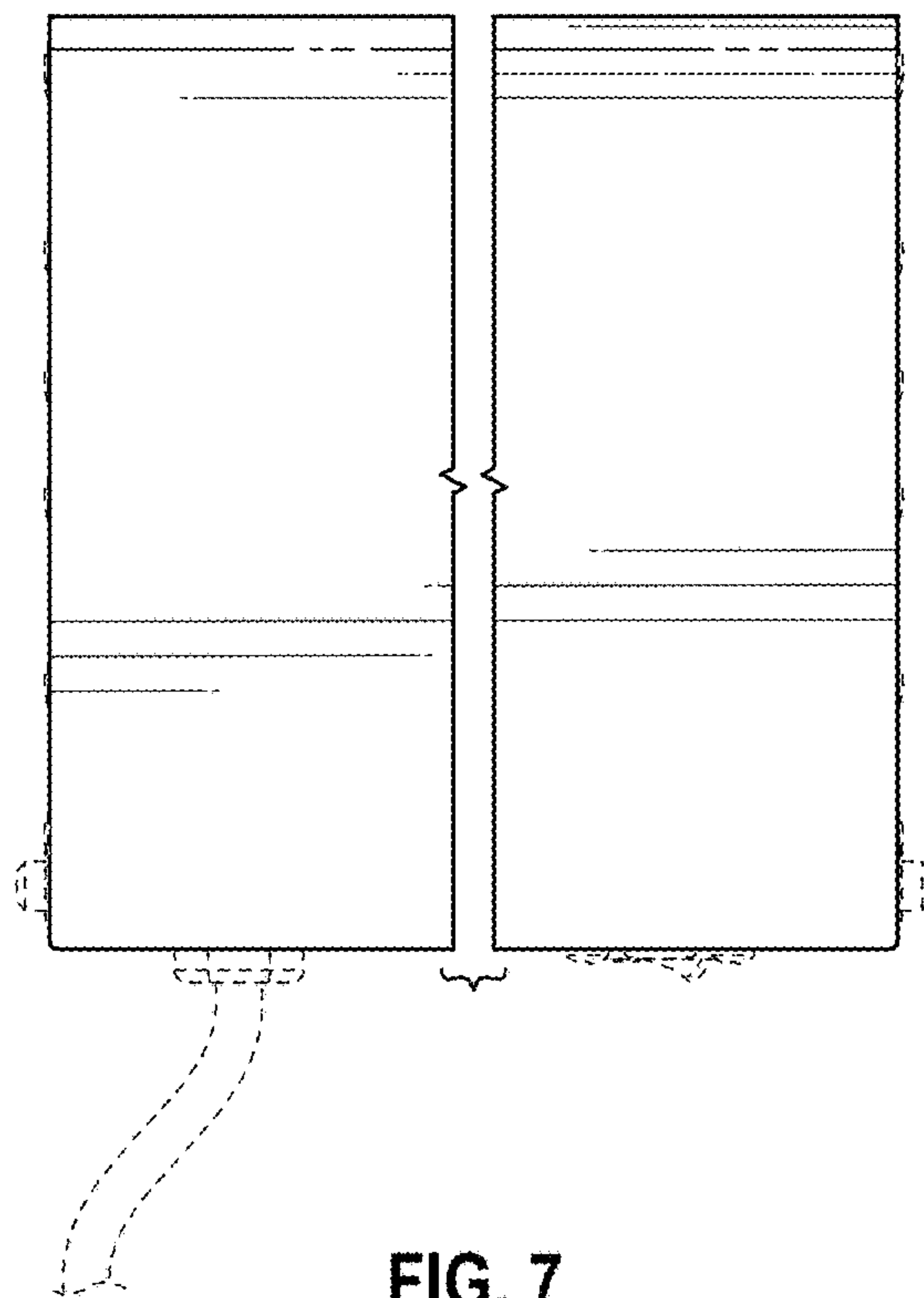
