FIG. 4 is a back side view thereof;

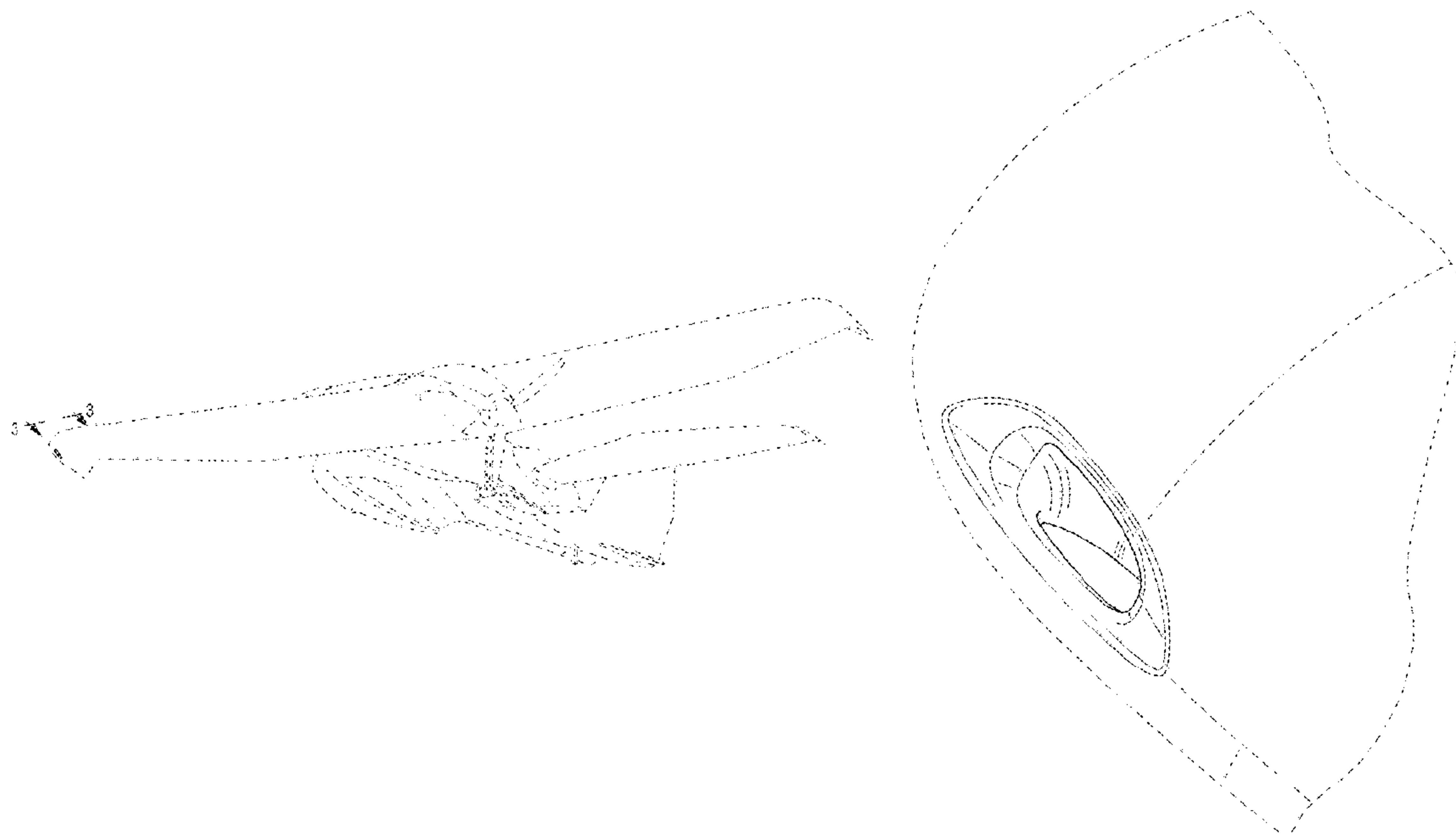
FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

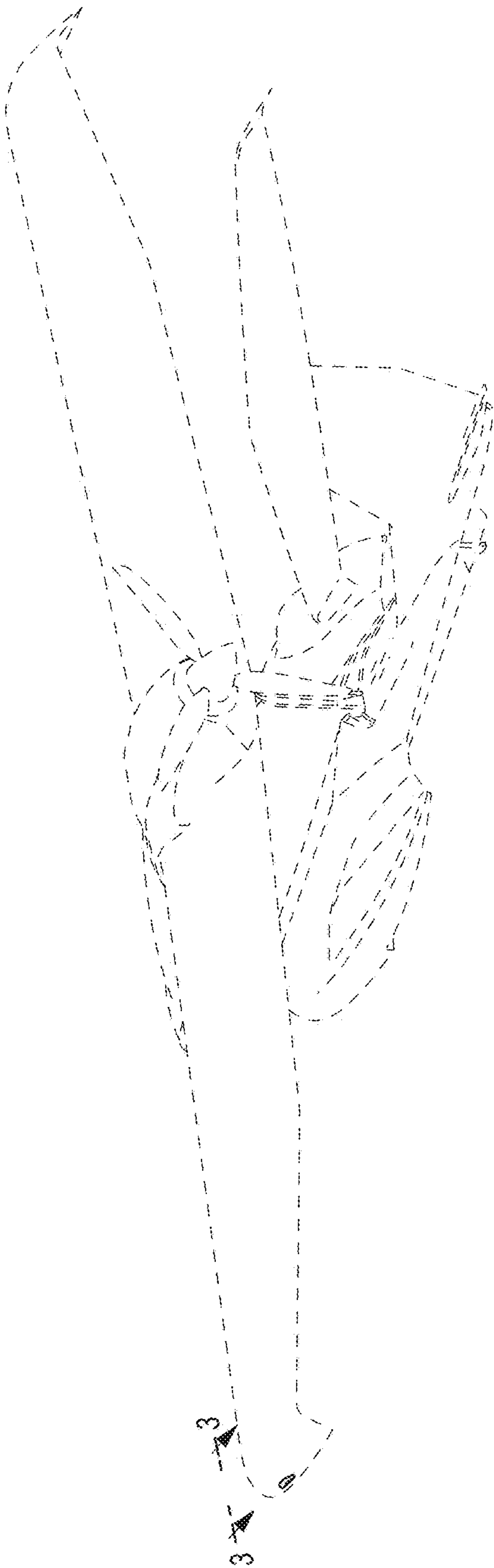

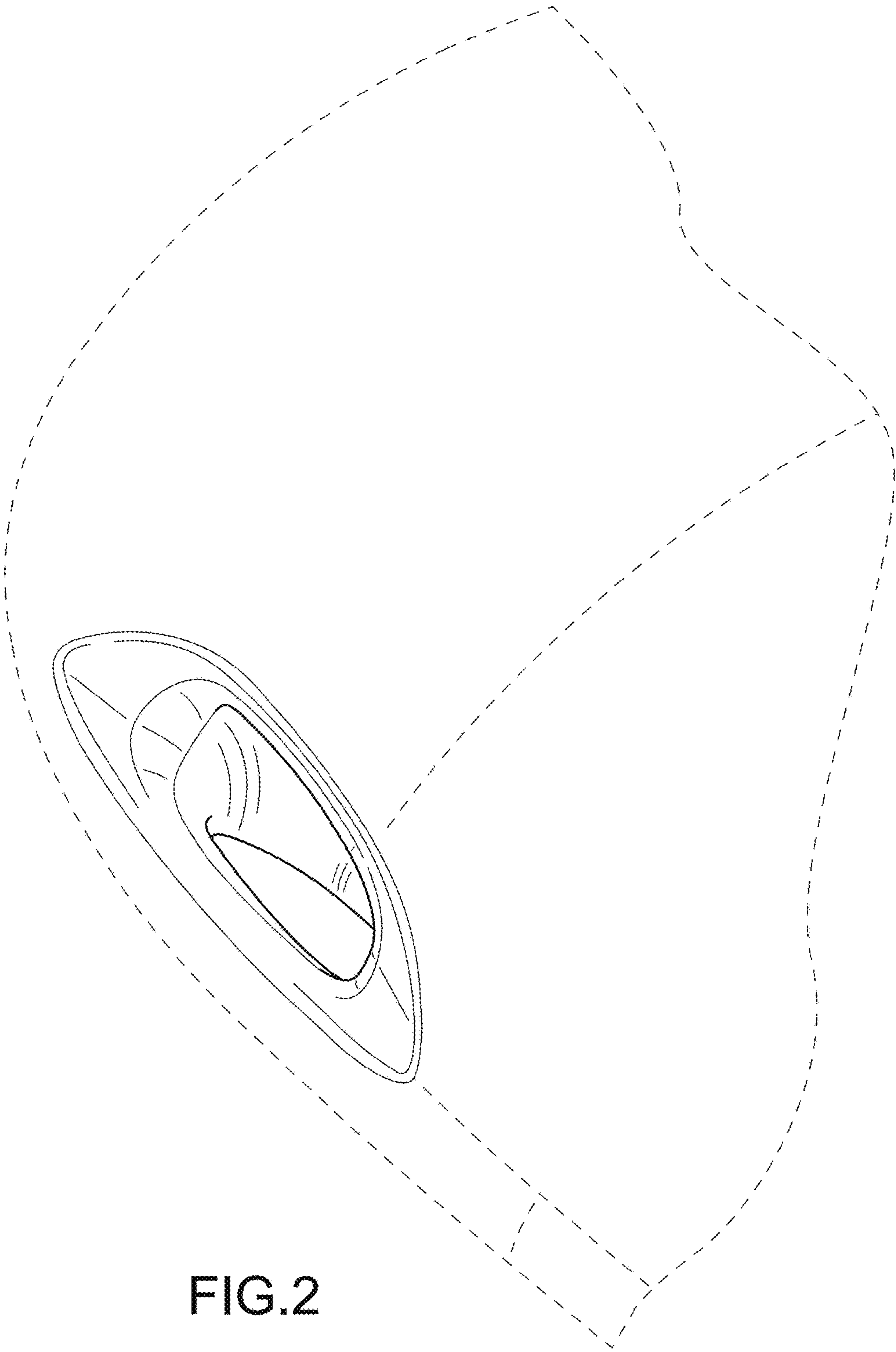

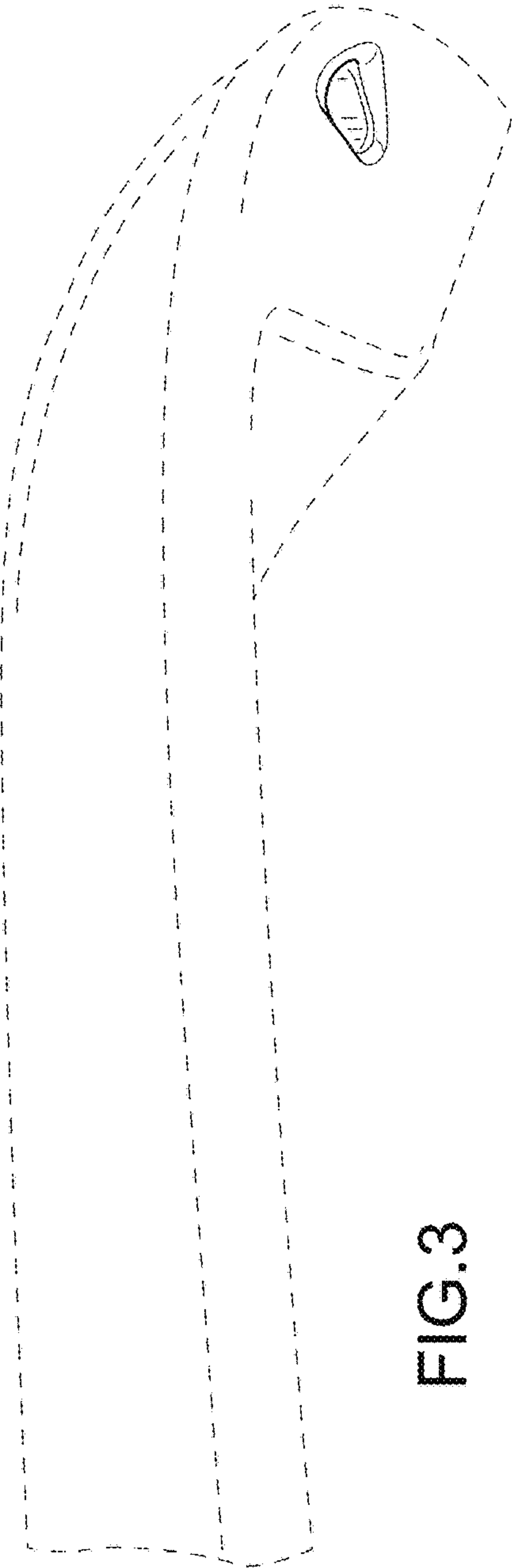

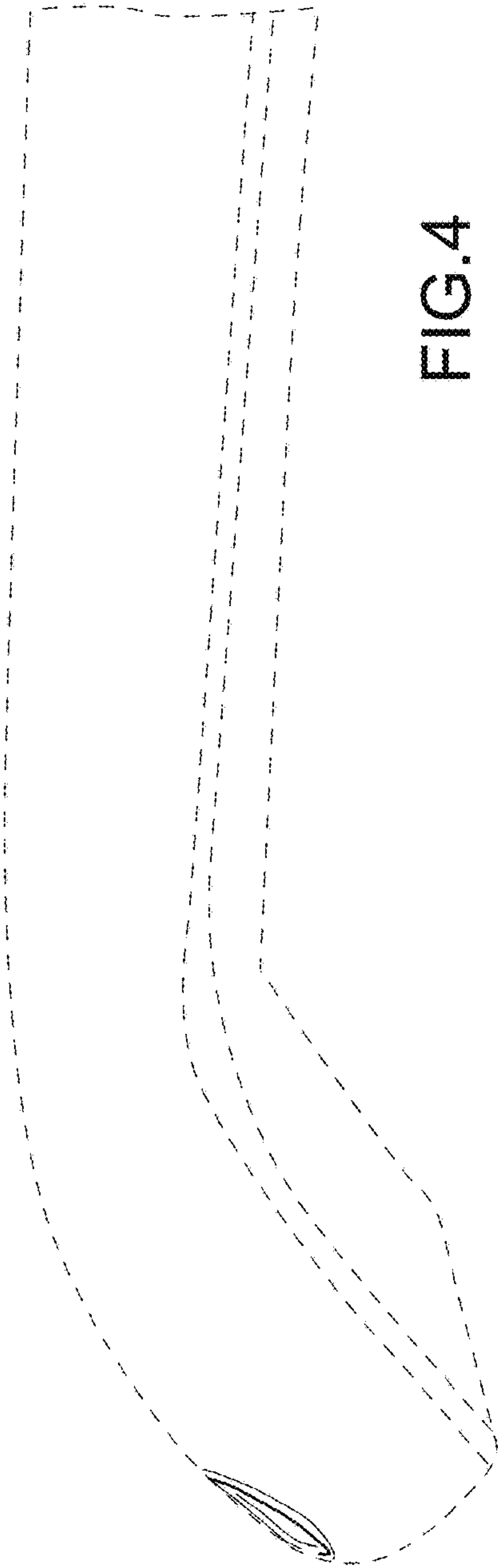

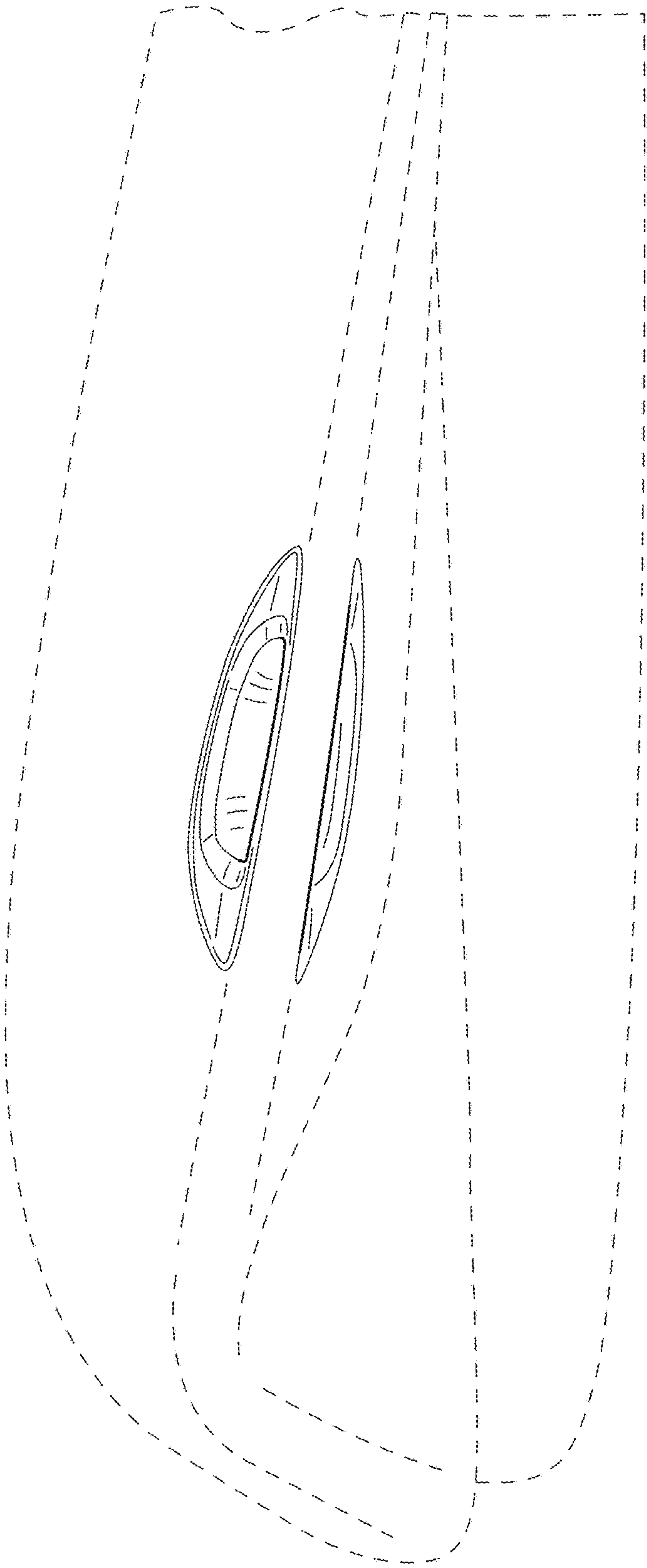

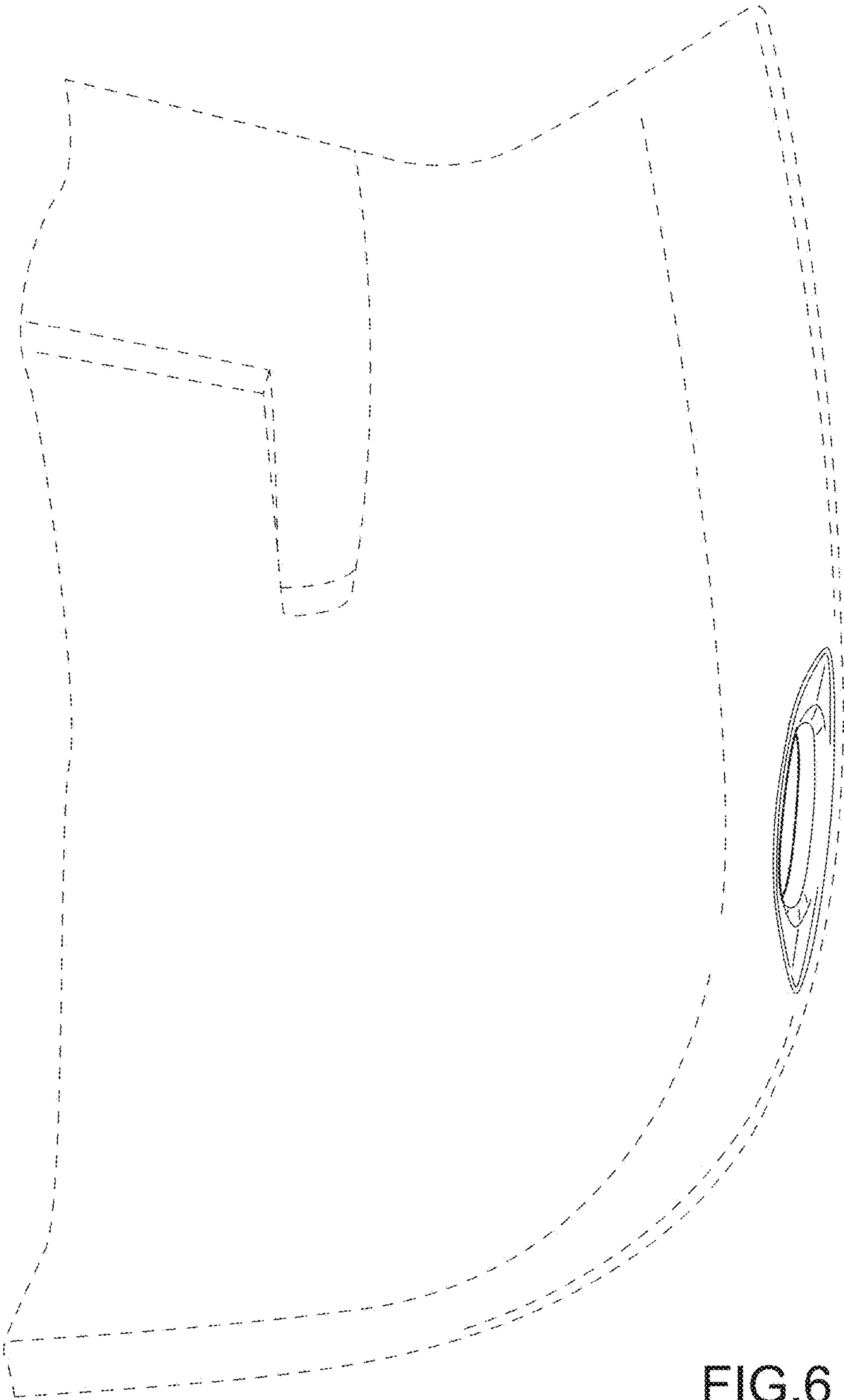

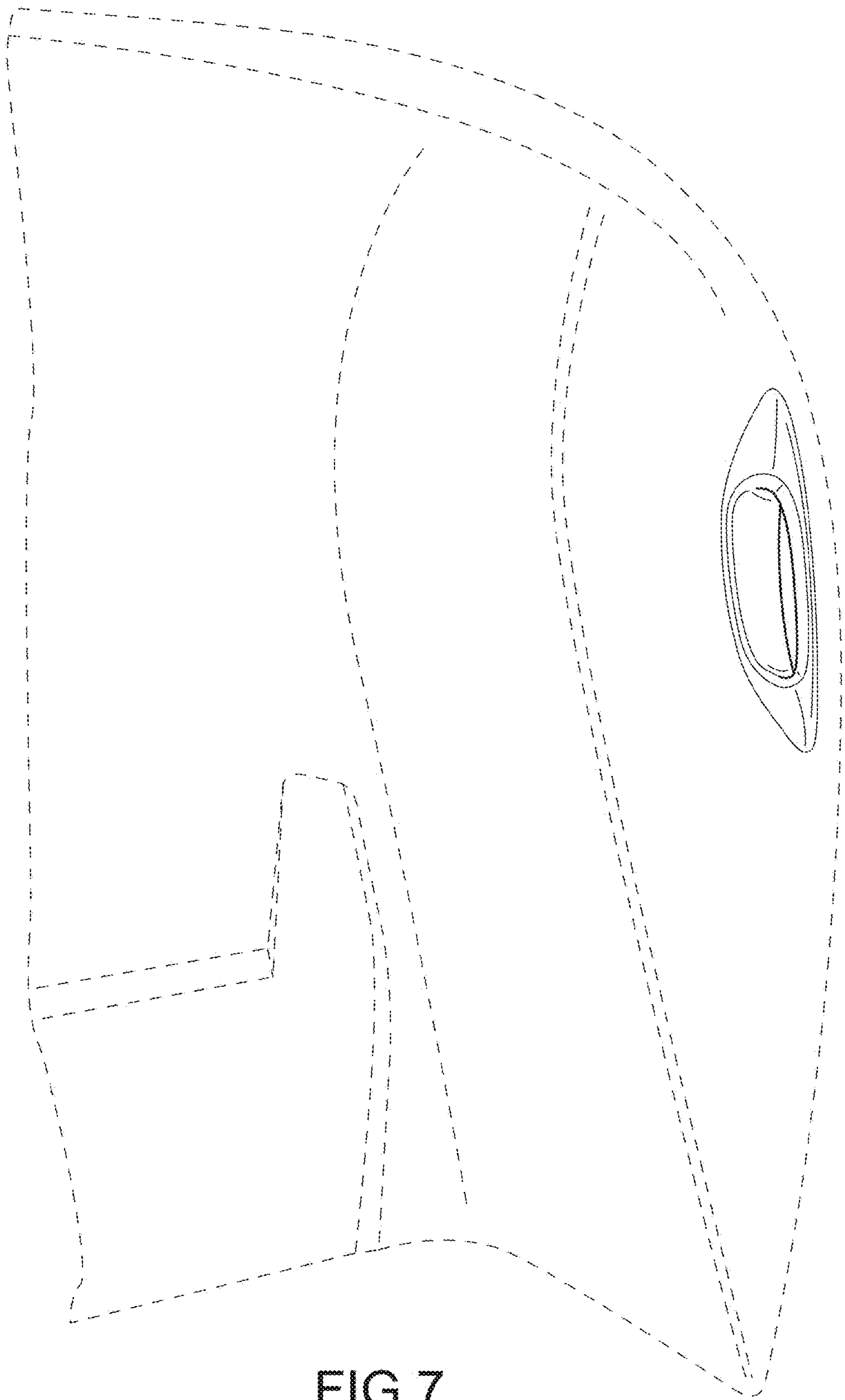
