DESCRIPTION

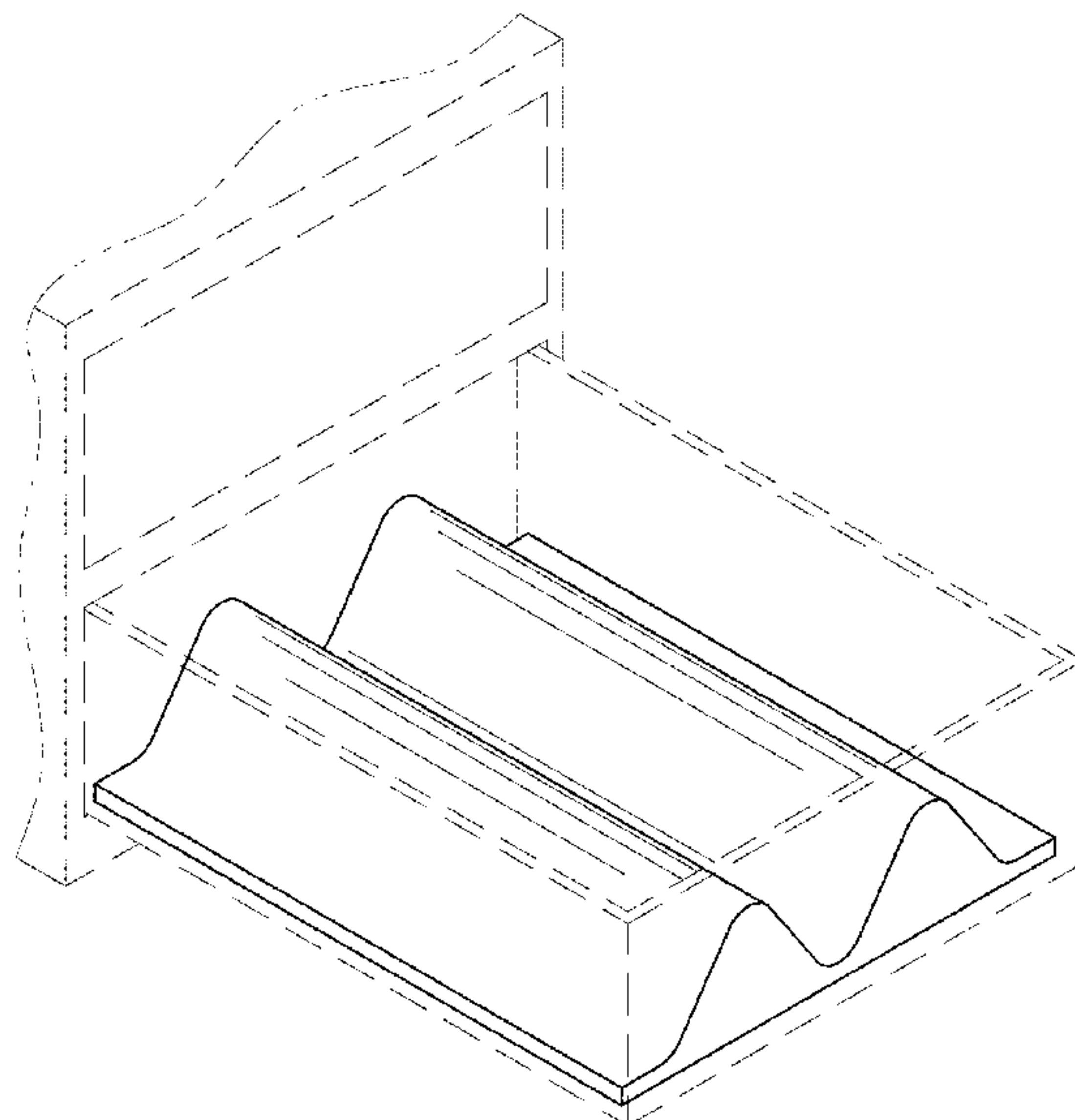
FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the jewelry drawer insert

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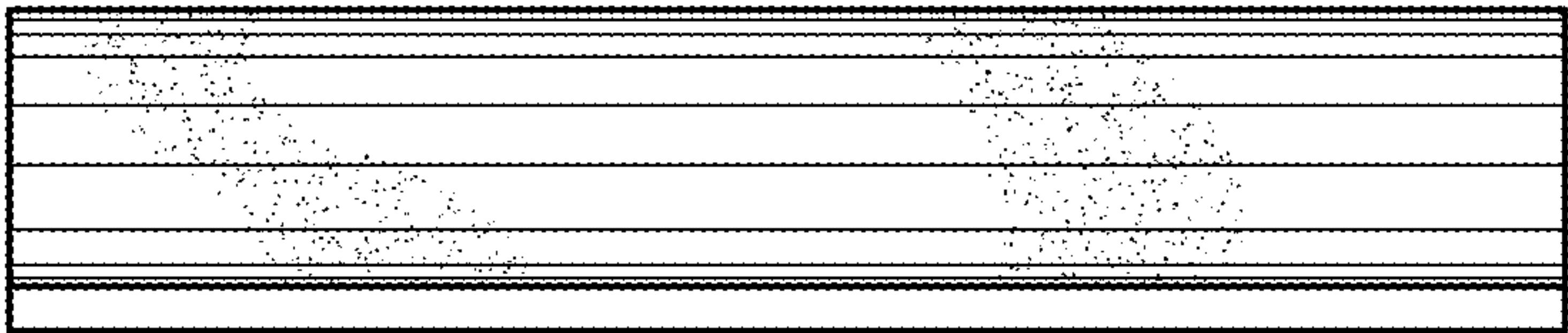

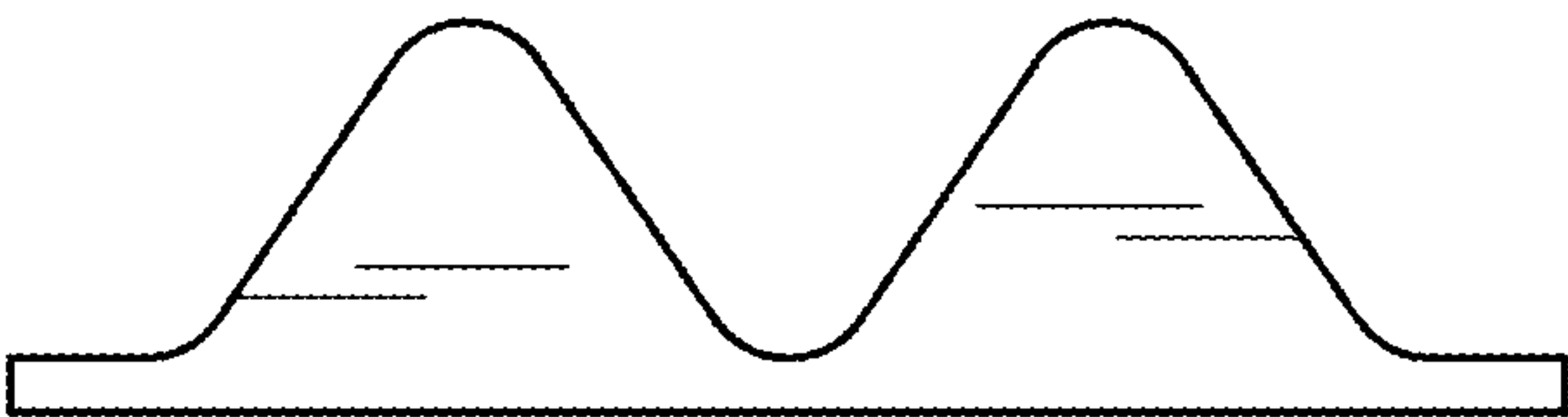

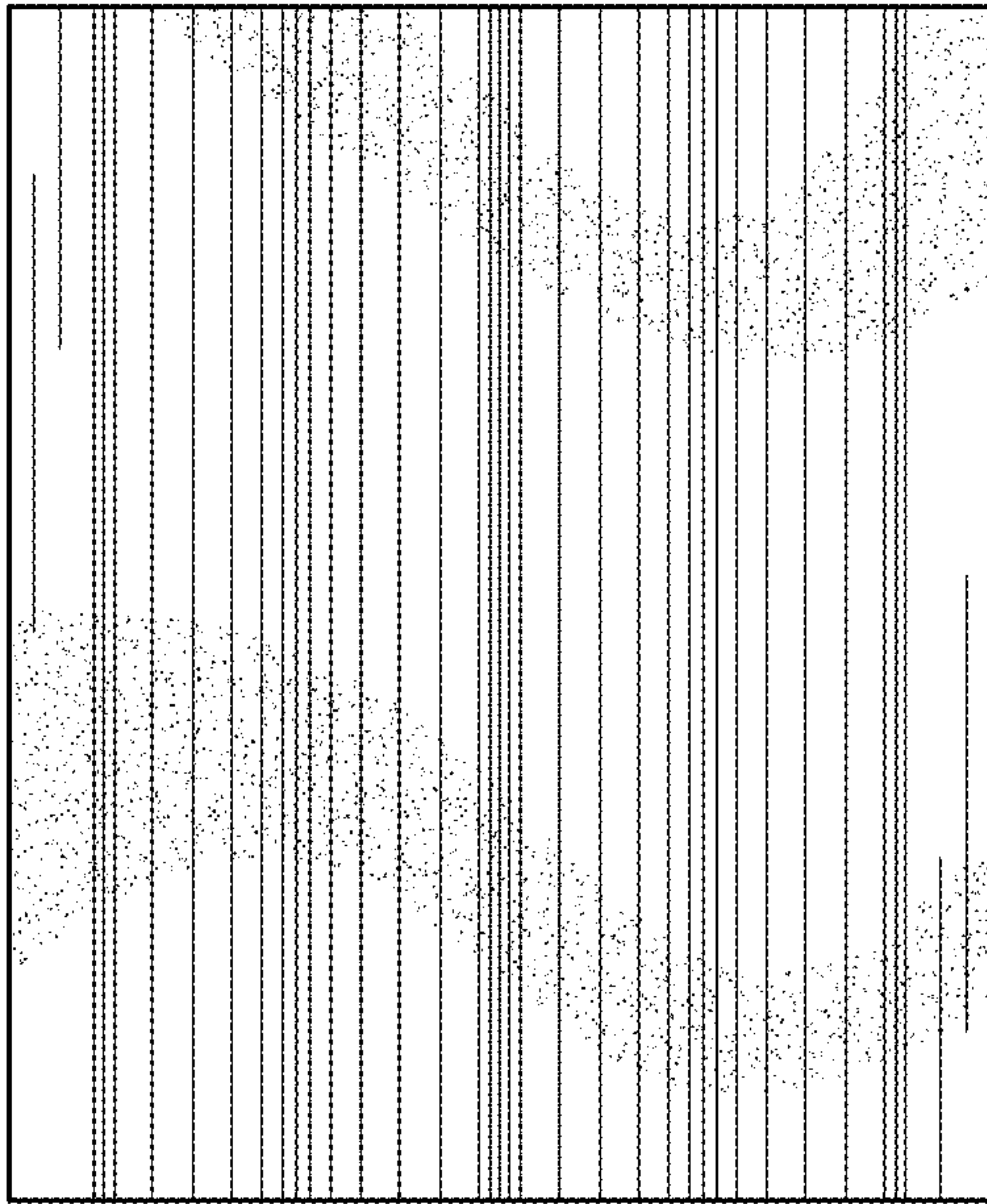

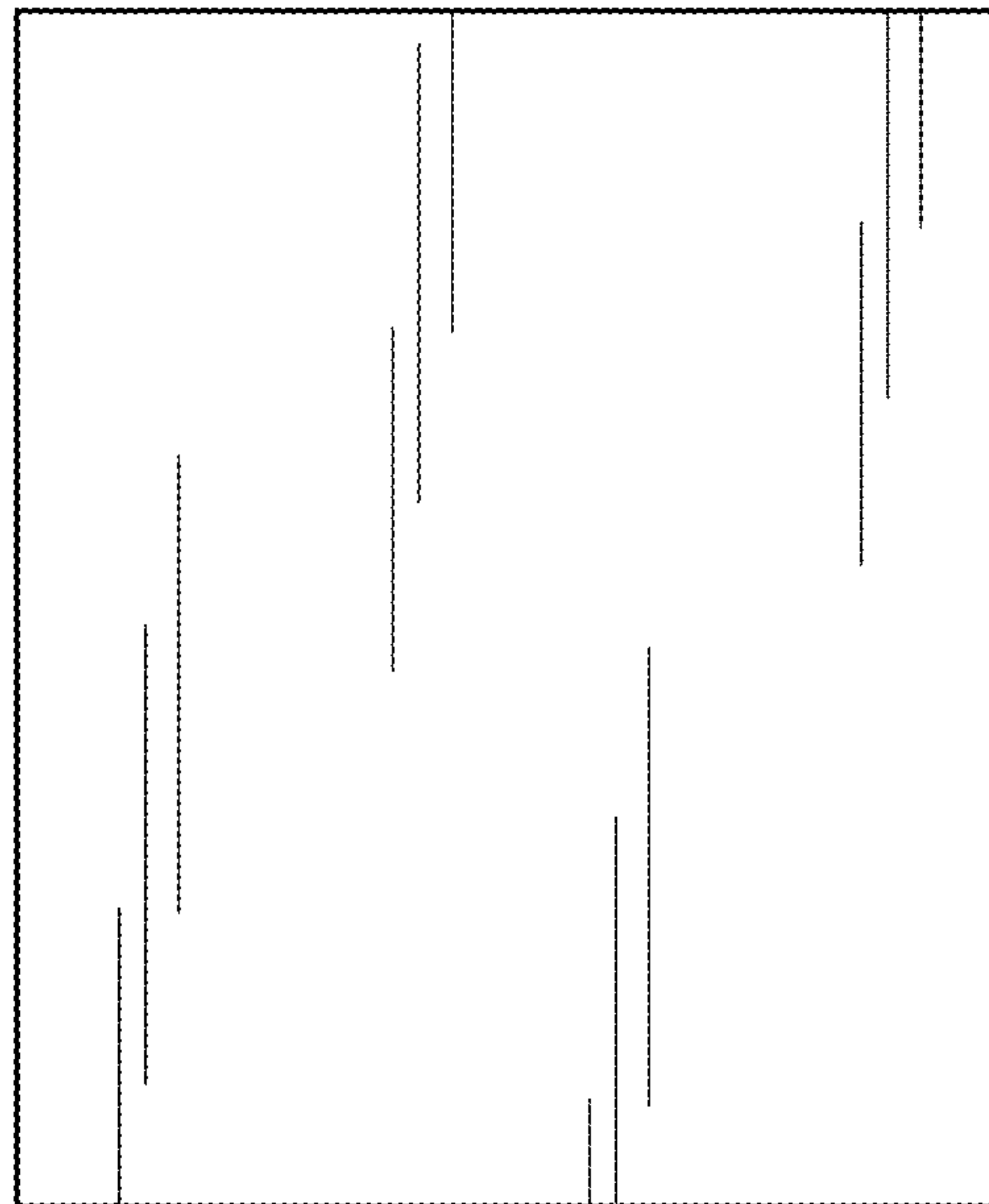

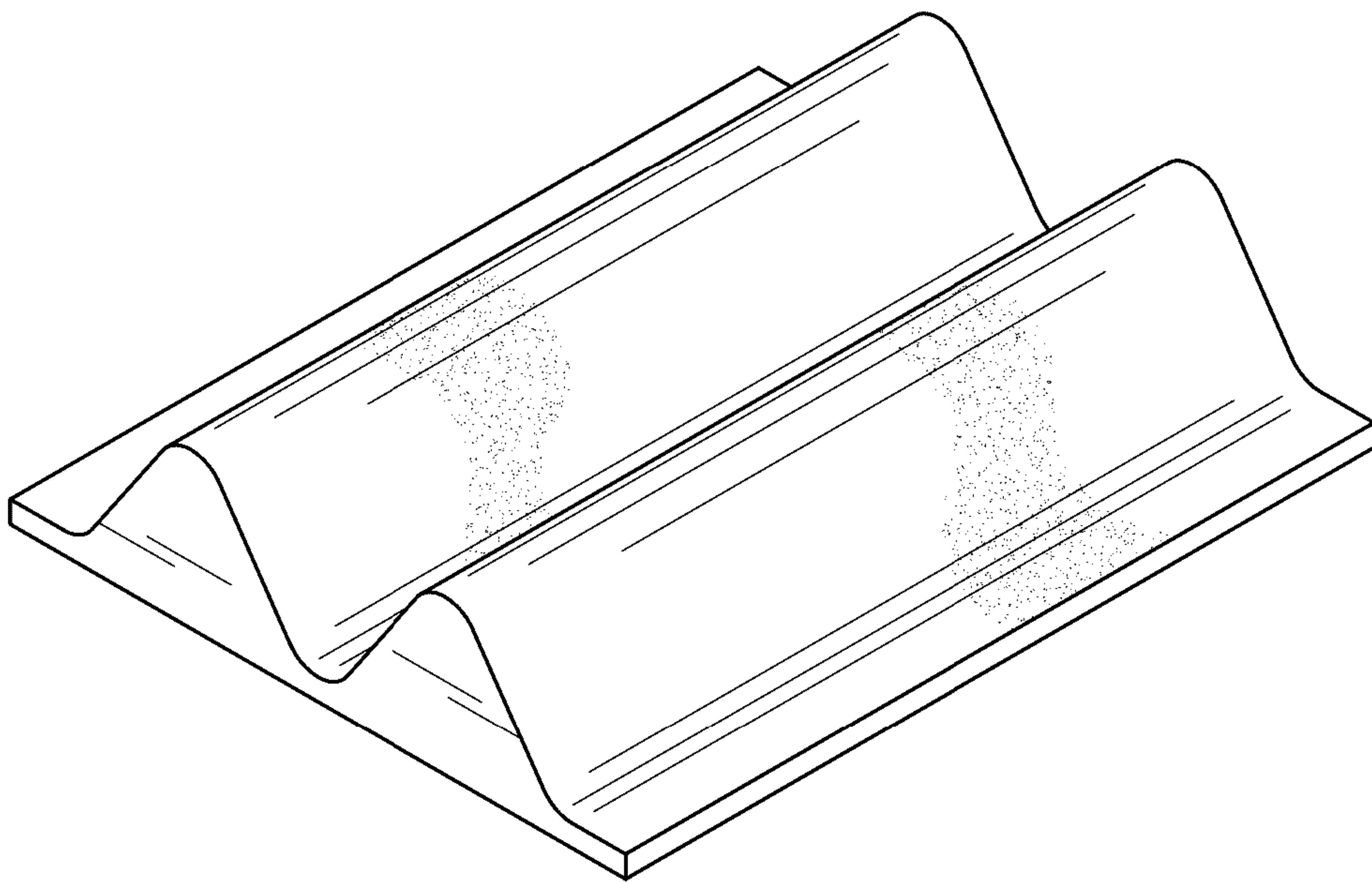

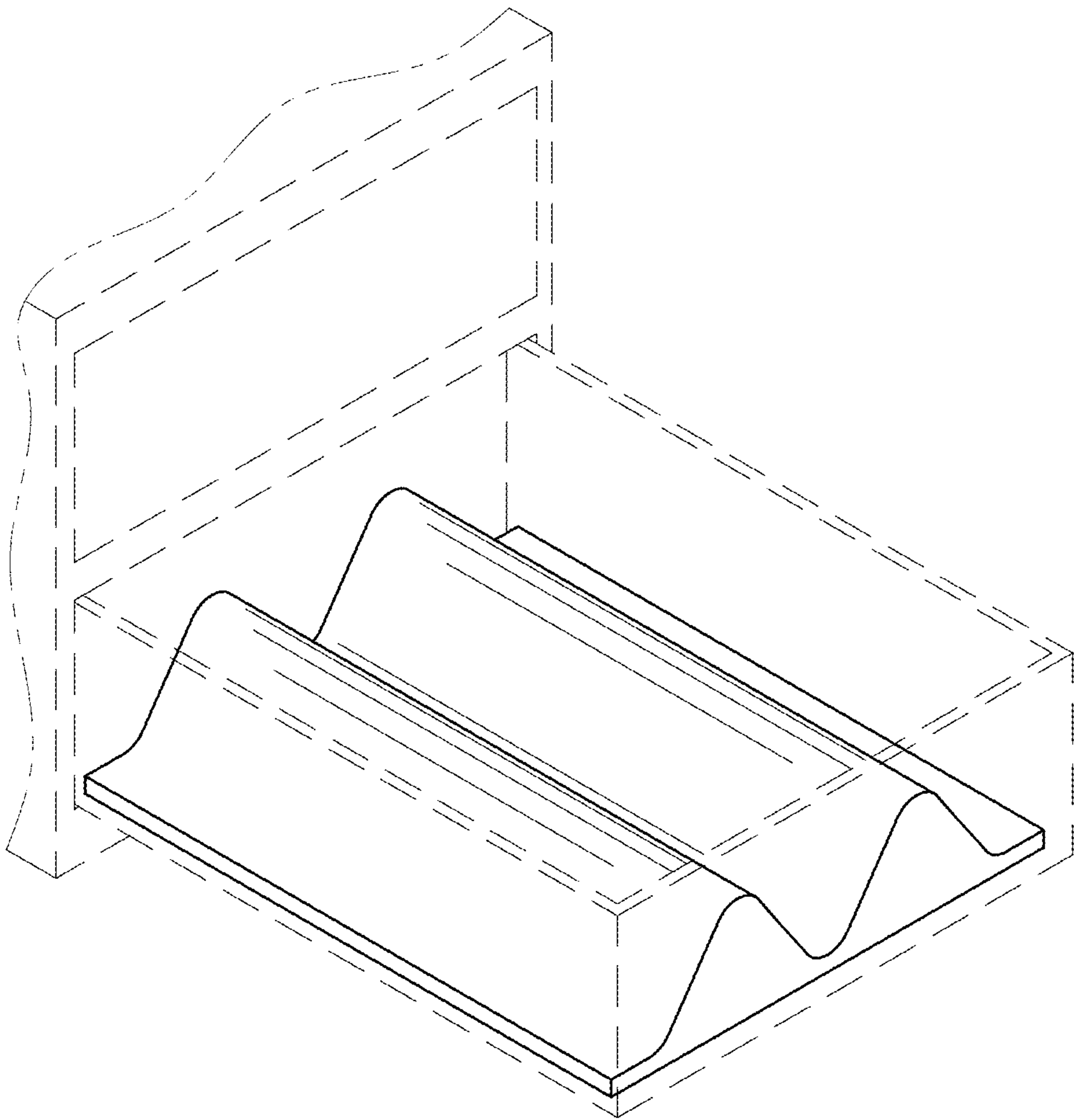
