DESCRIPTION

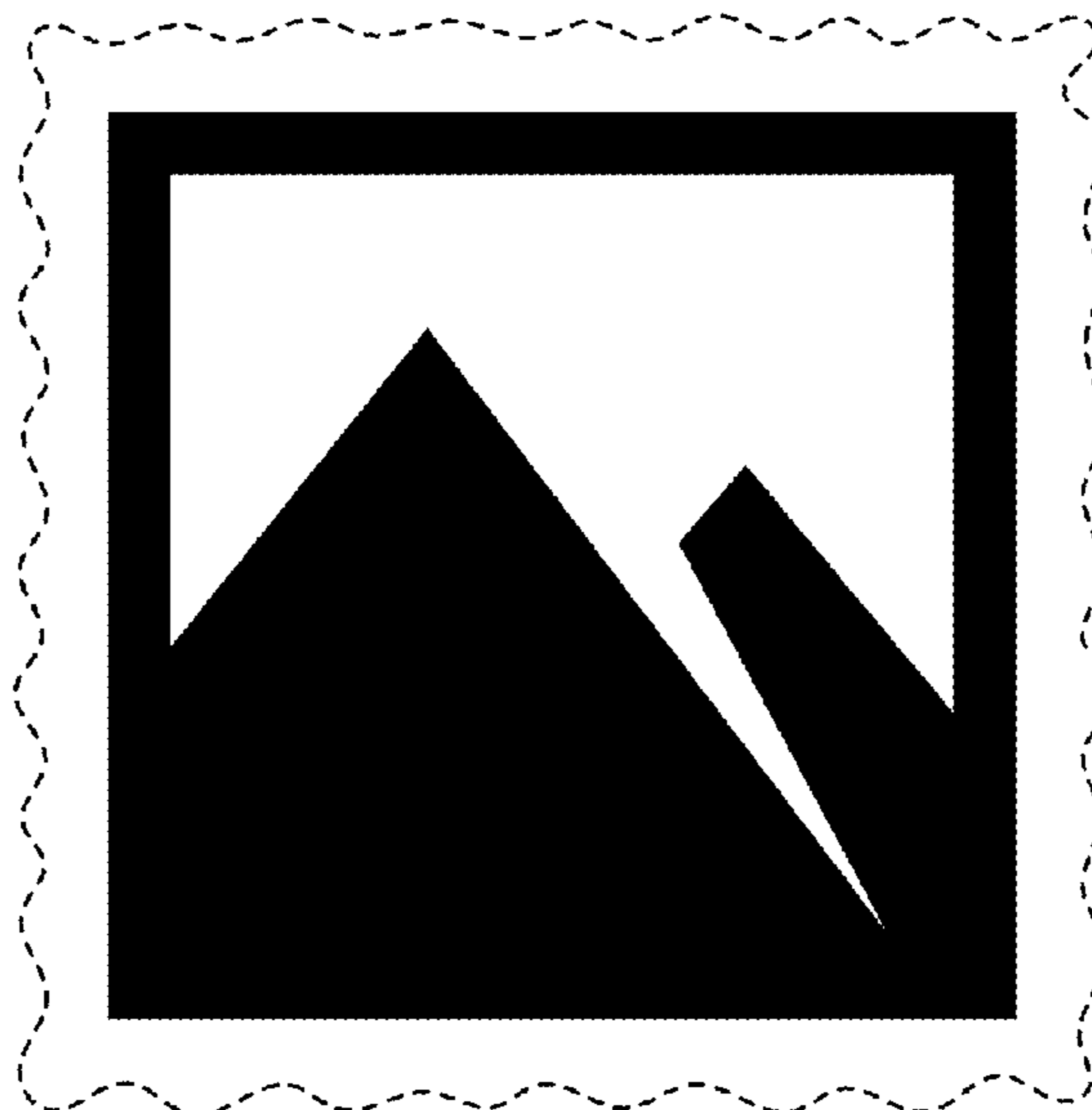
FIG. 1 is a front view of a display screen with icon showing the new design;

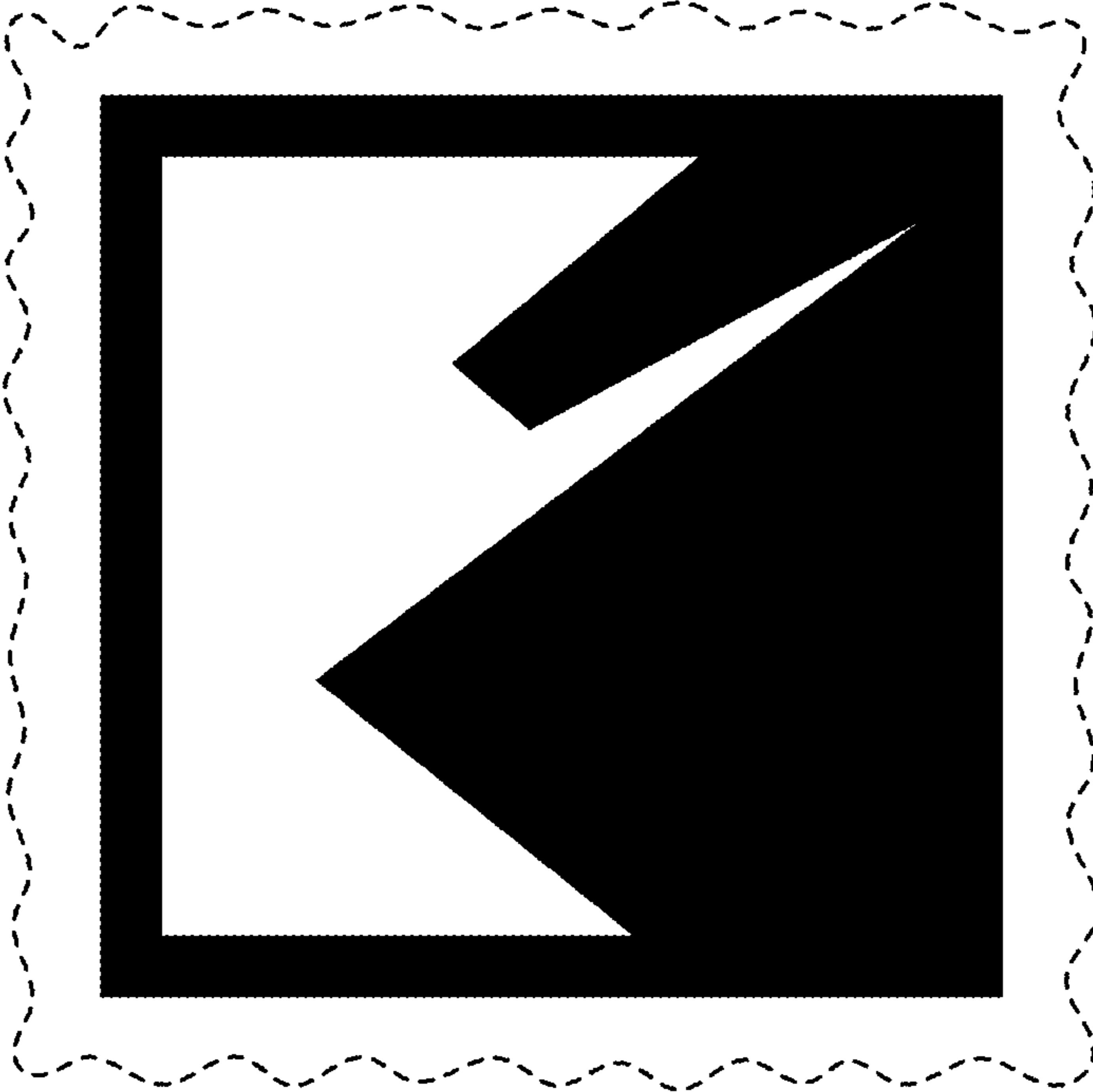

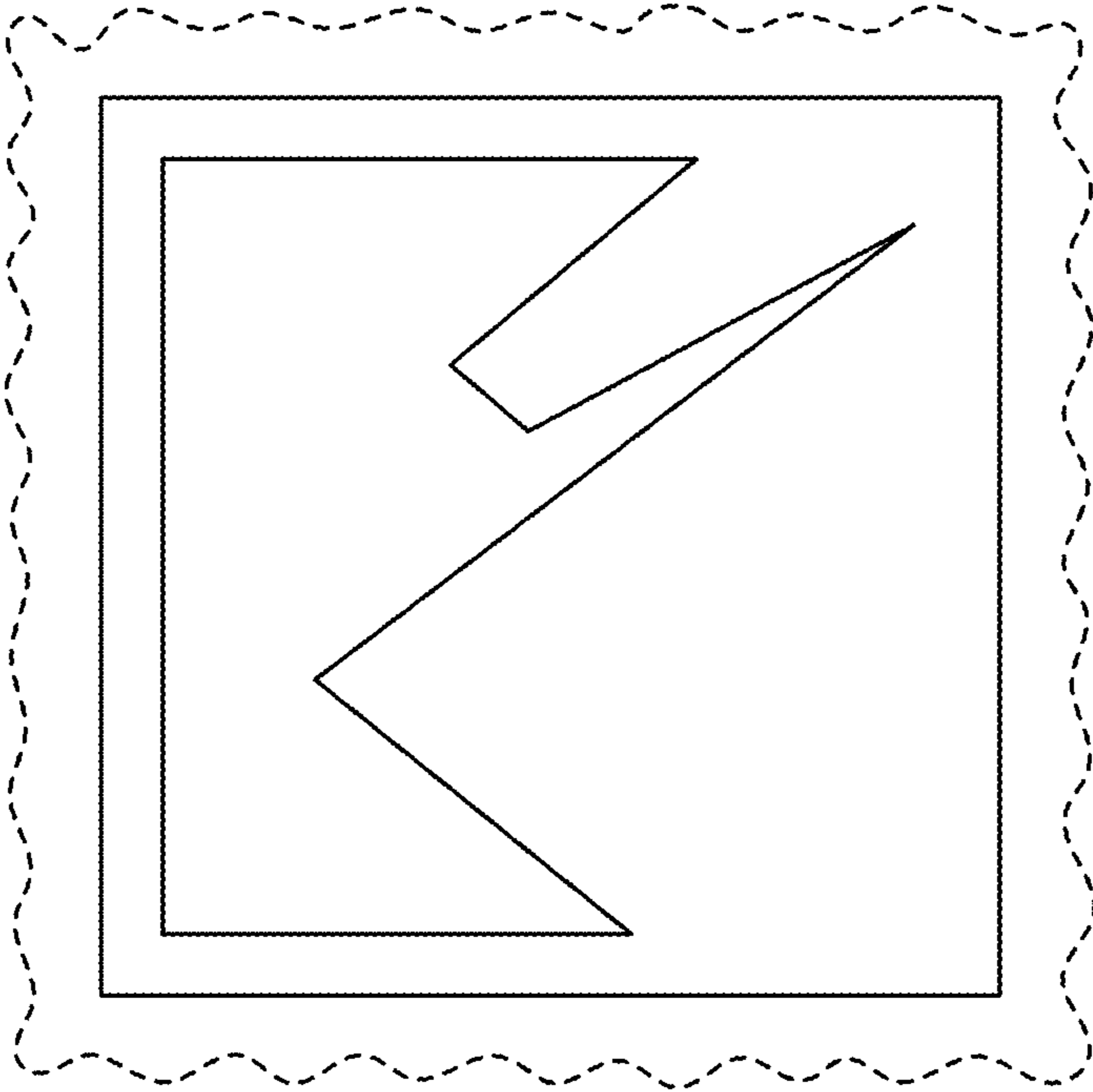

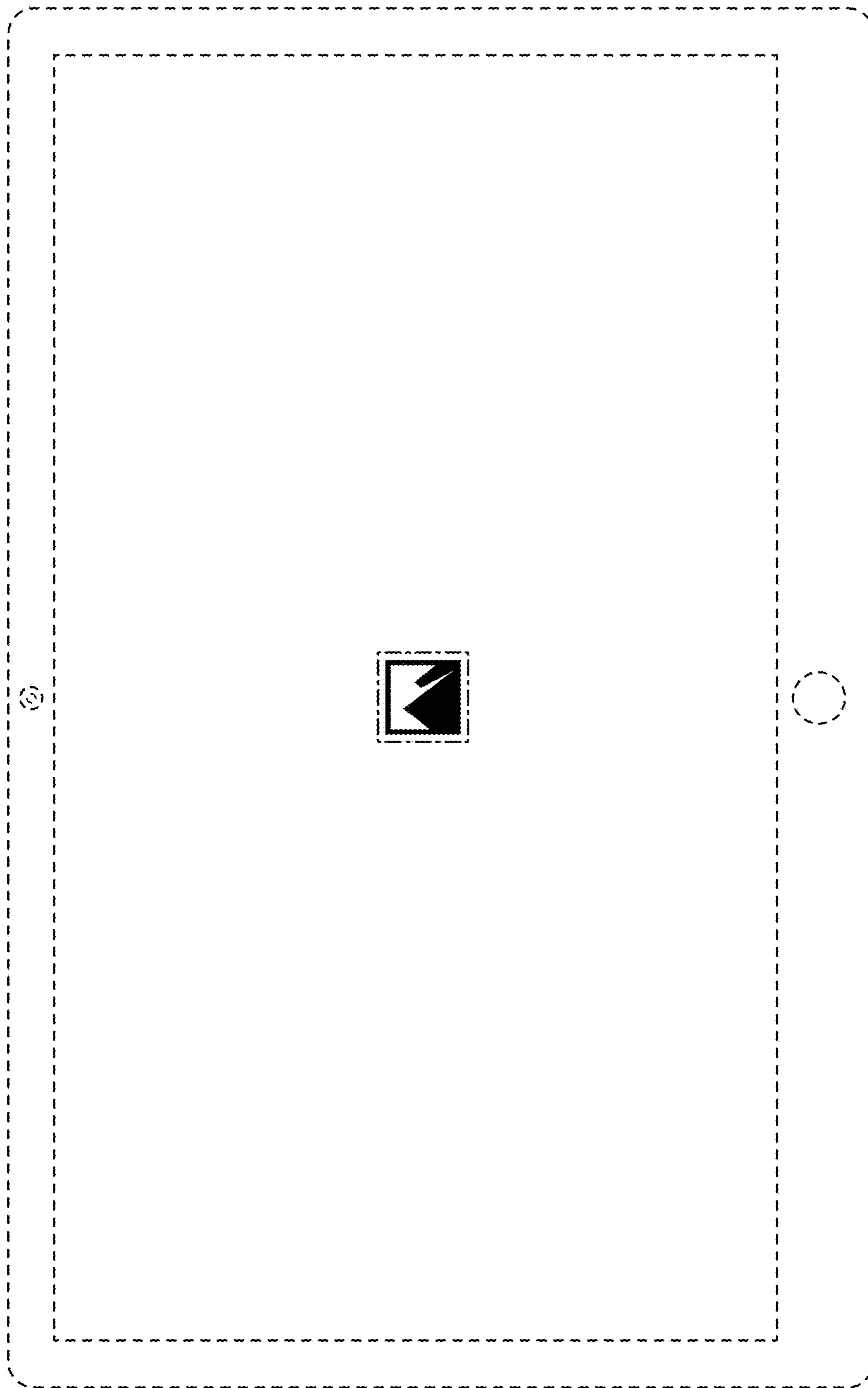
