(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a TV receiver, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a TV receiver showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 5 is another side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The evenly spaced broken line is included for illustrating portions of the TV receiver which form no part of the claimed design.

The dot-dash broken lines which define the bounds of the claimed design form no part of thereof.

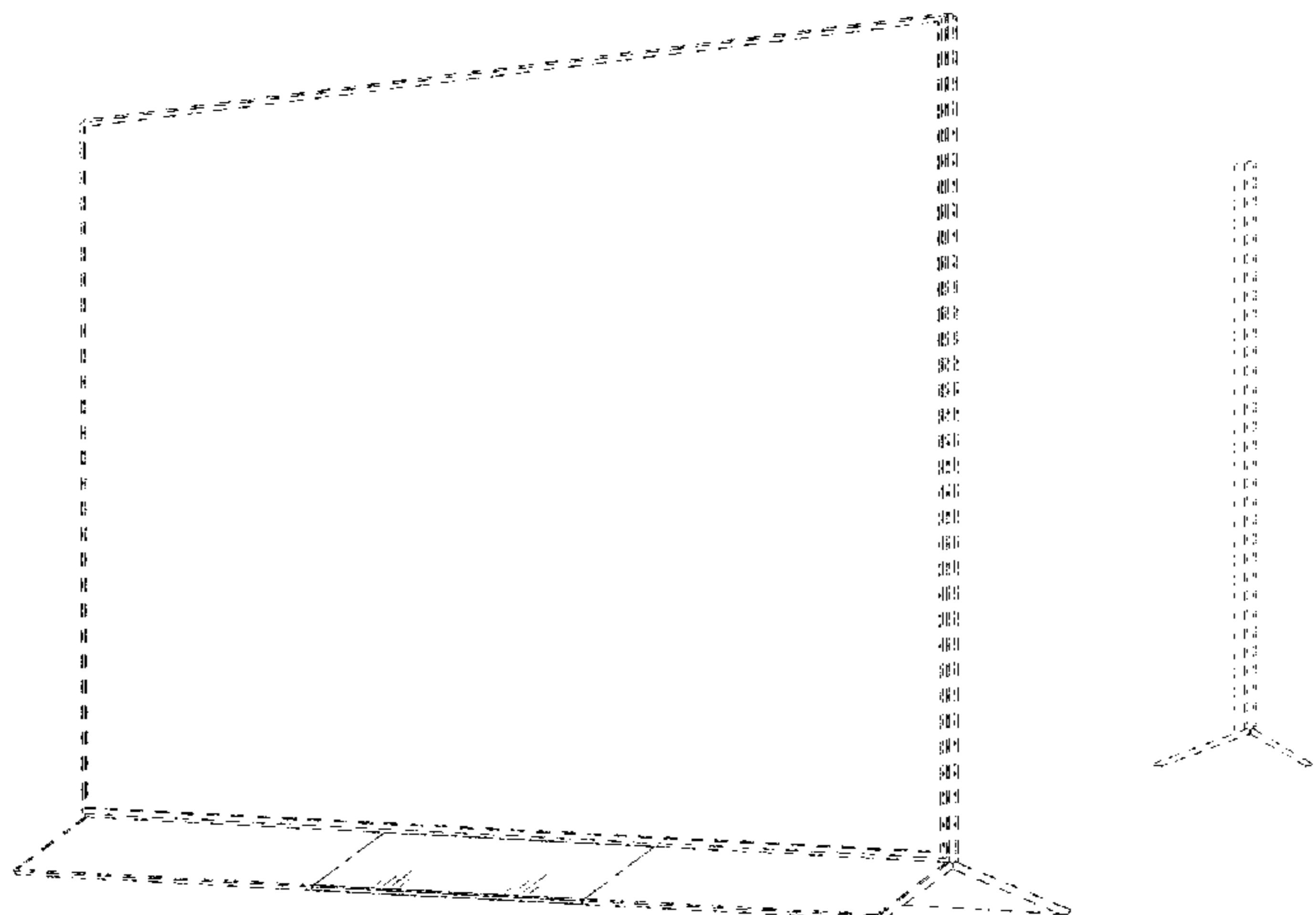

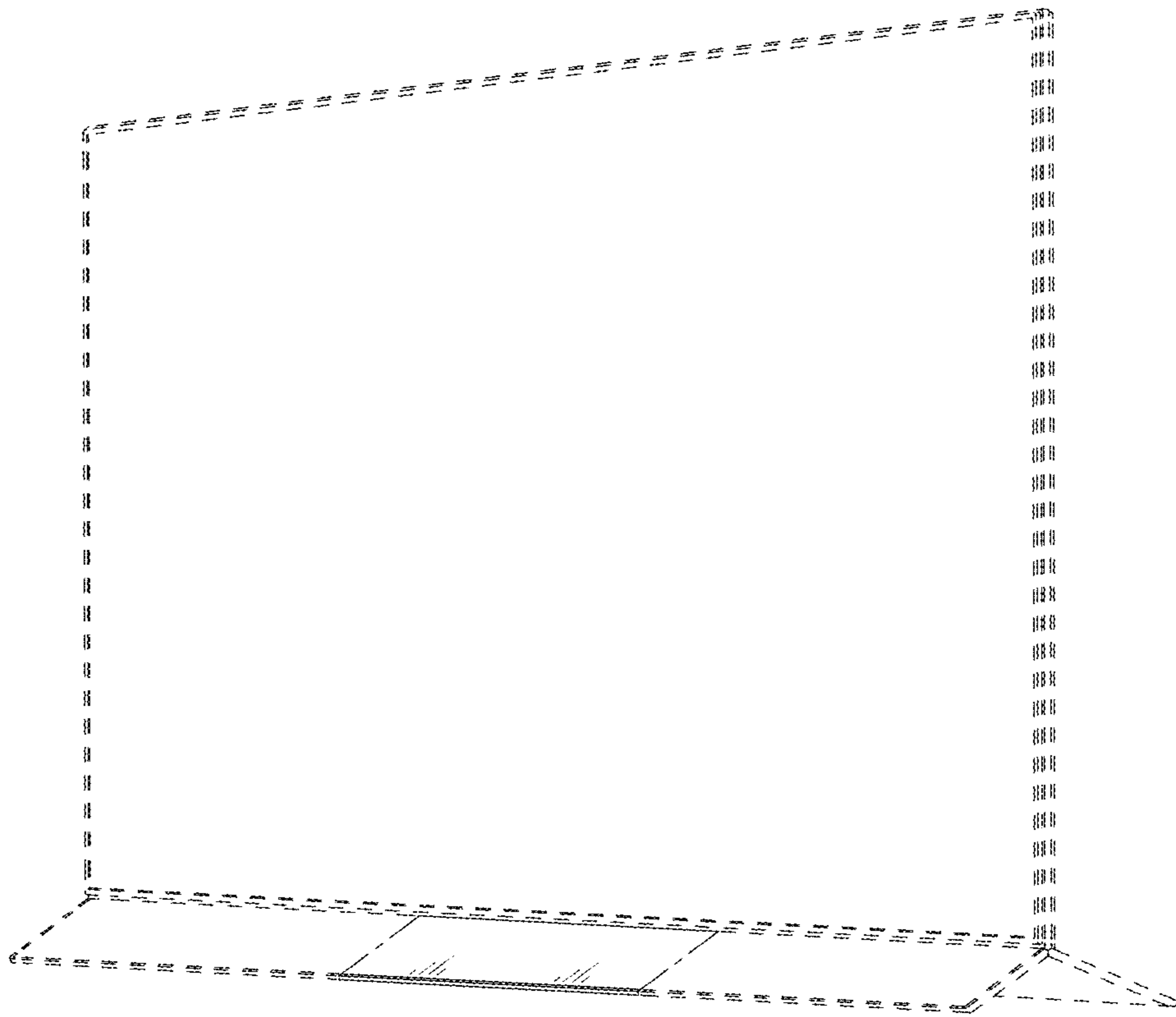

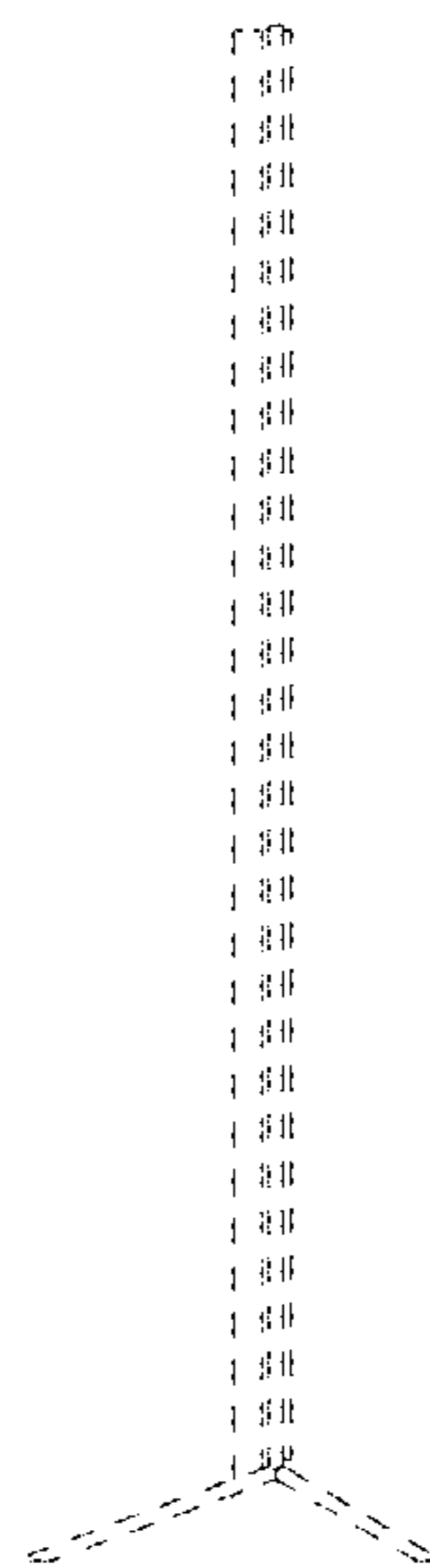

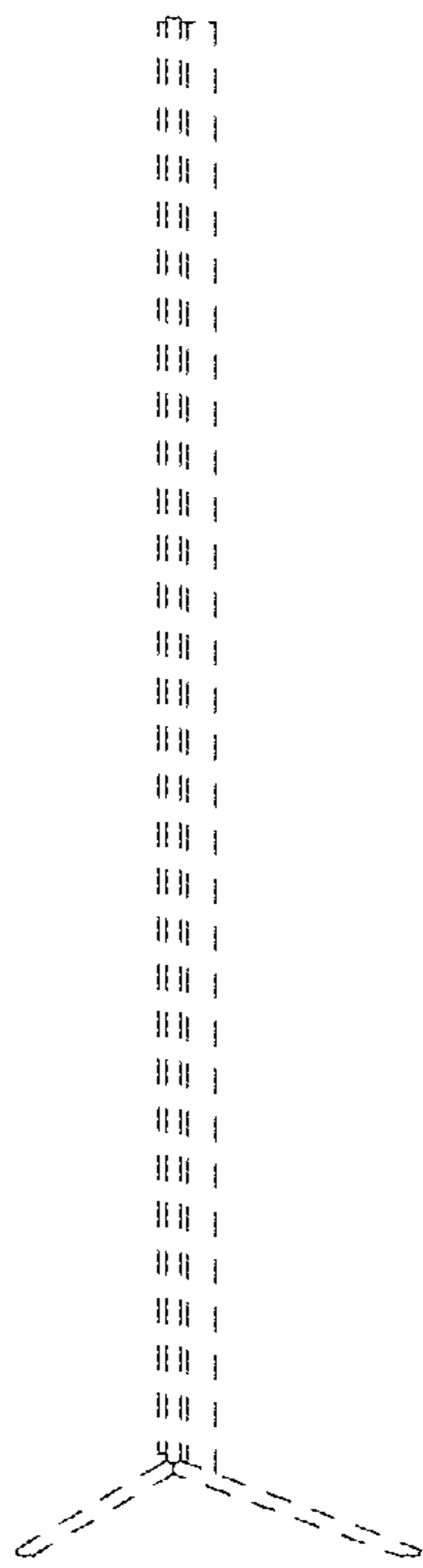

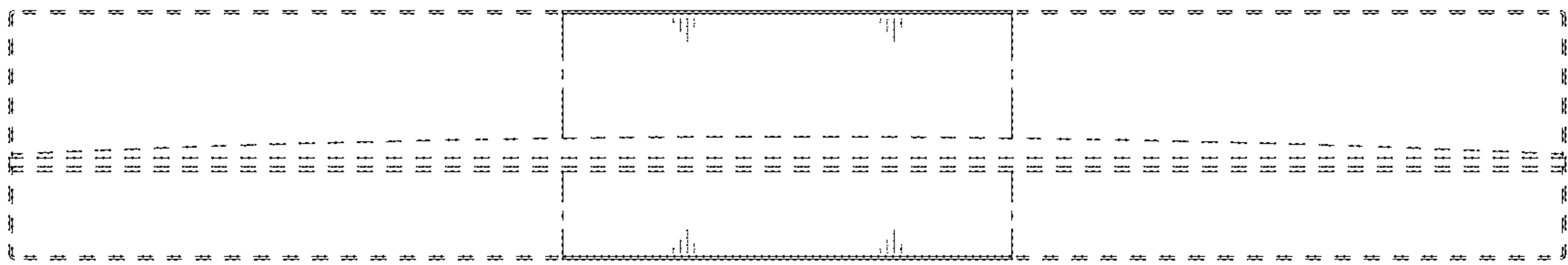
