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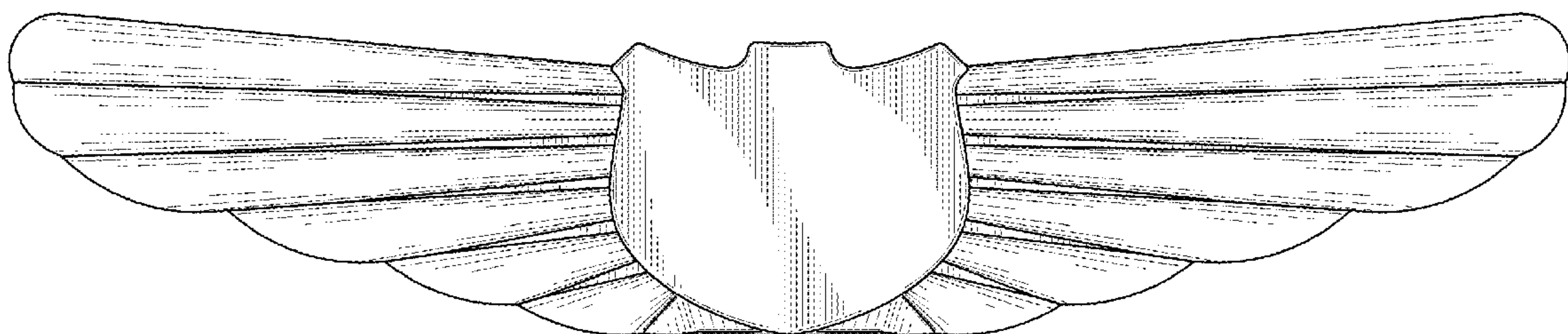
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the fuel gauge holder;

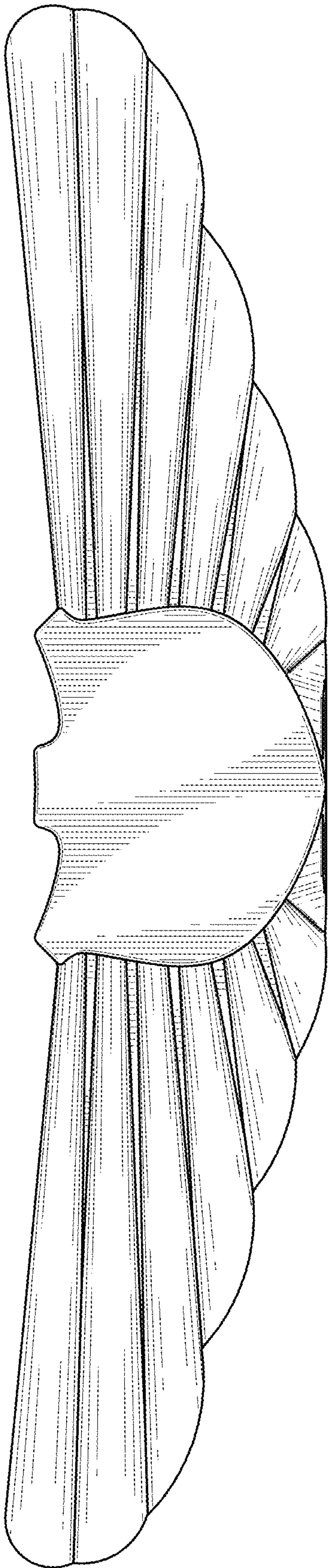

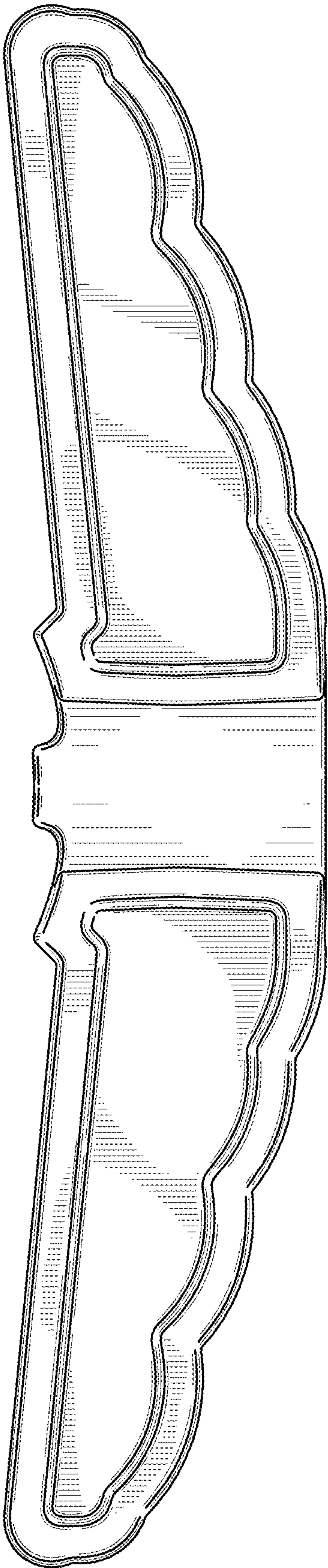

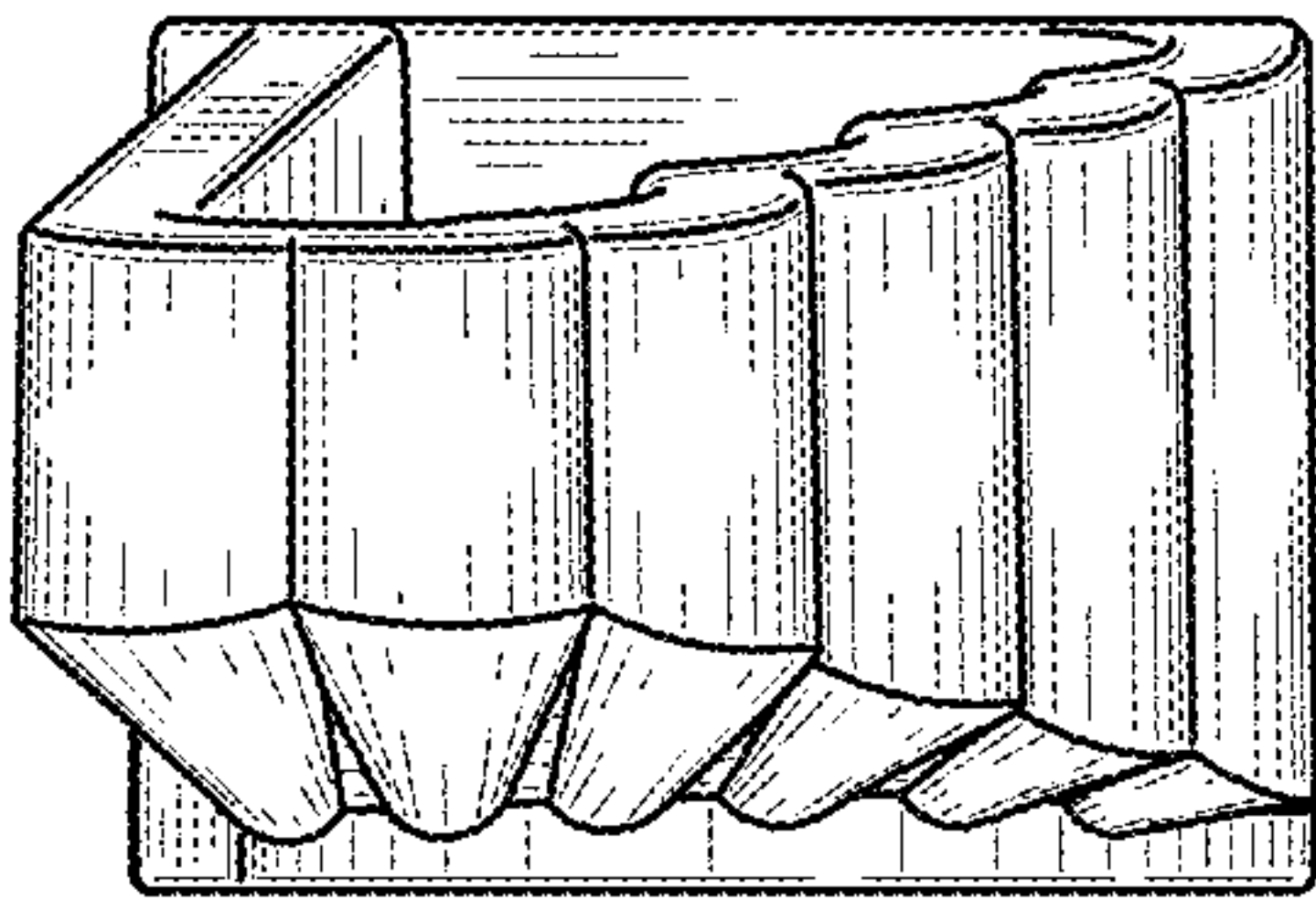

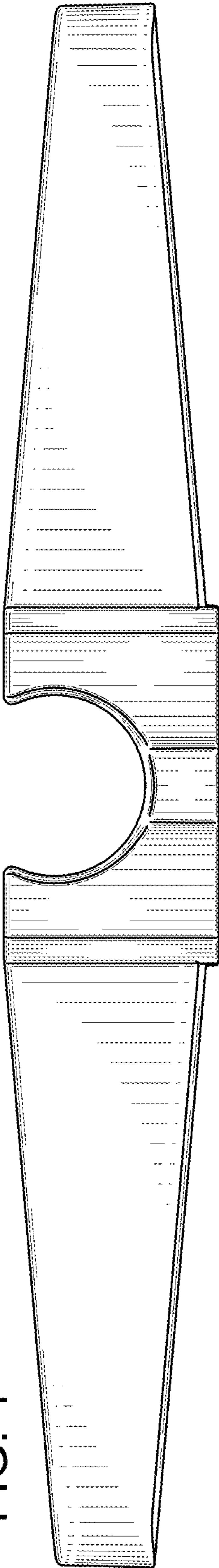
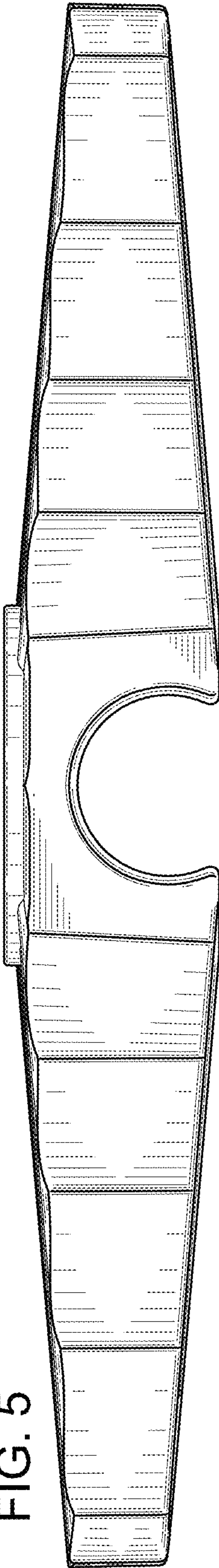

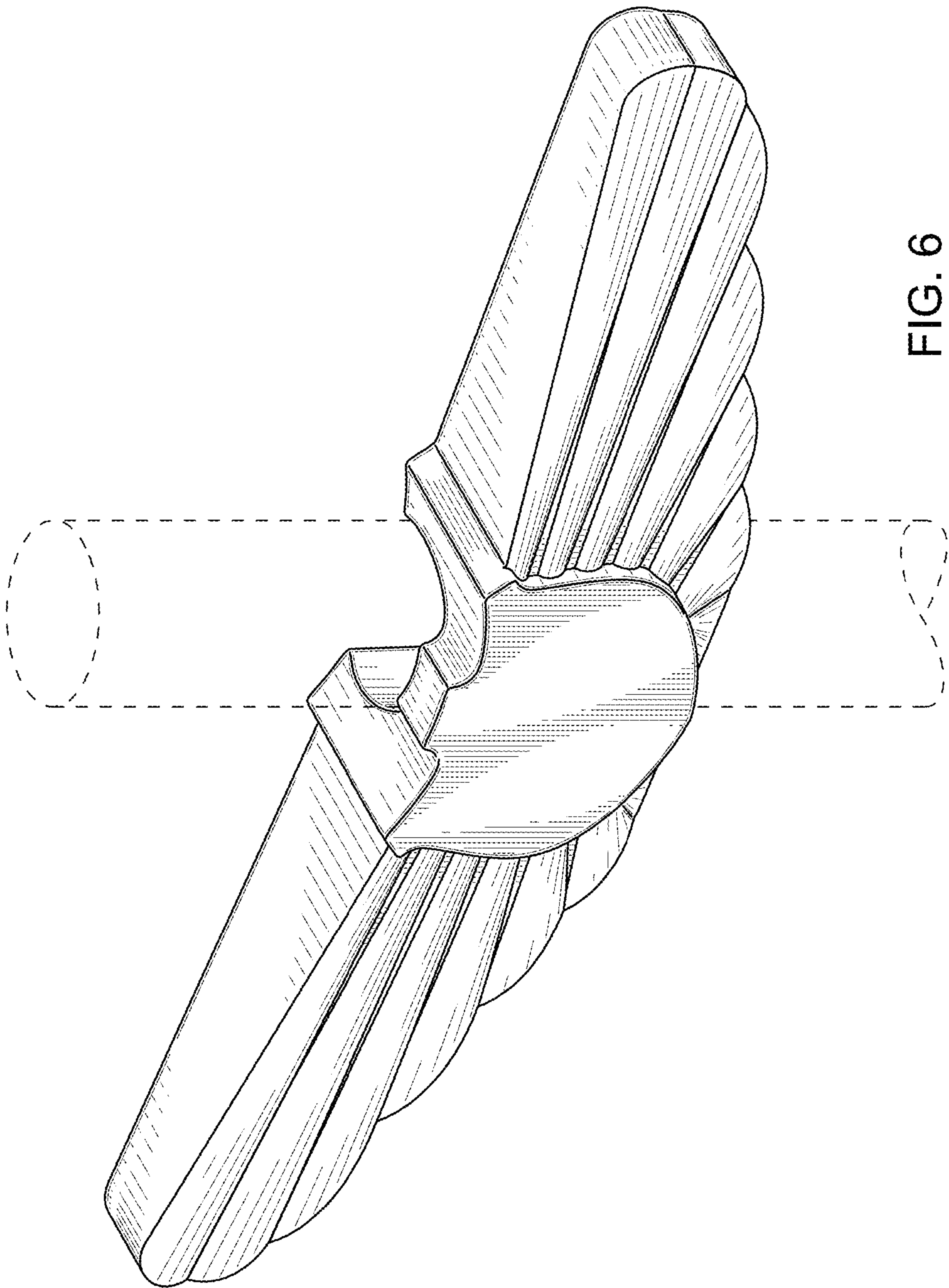
