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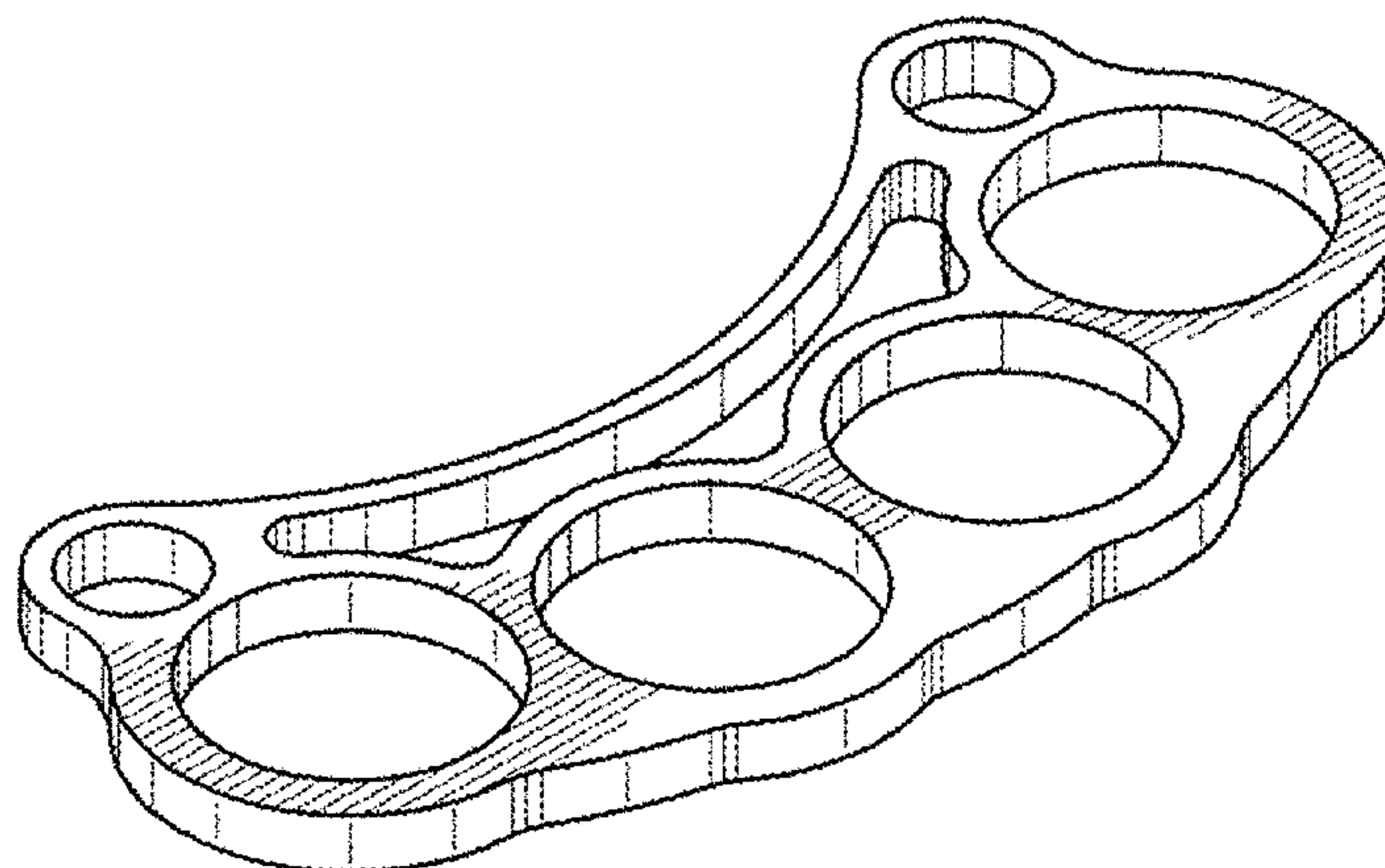
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chain ring bash guard showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

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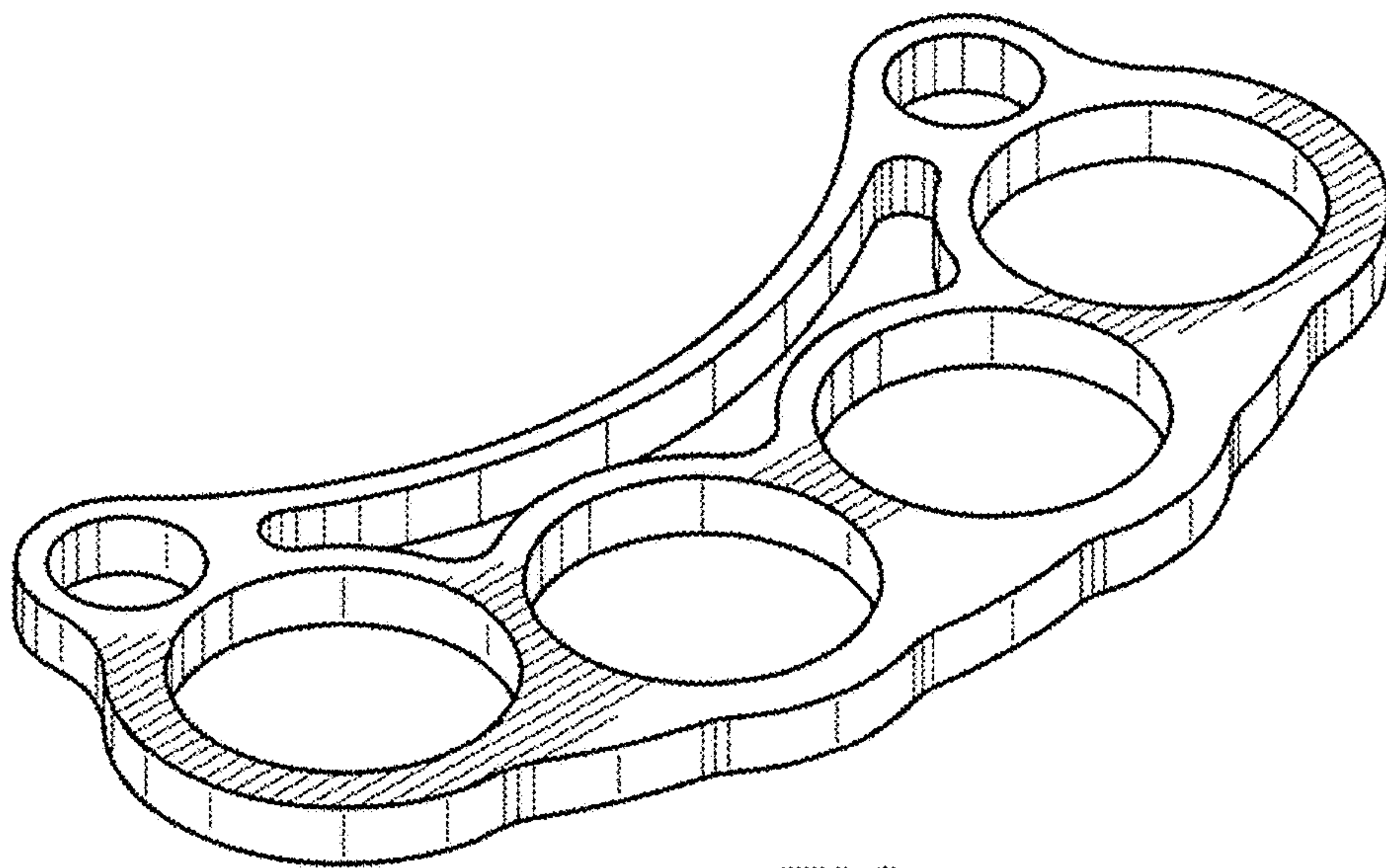

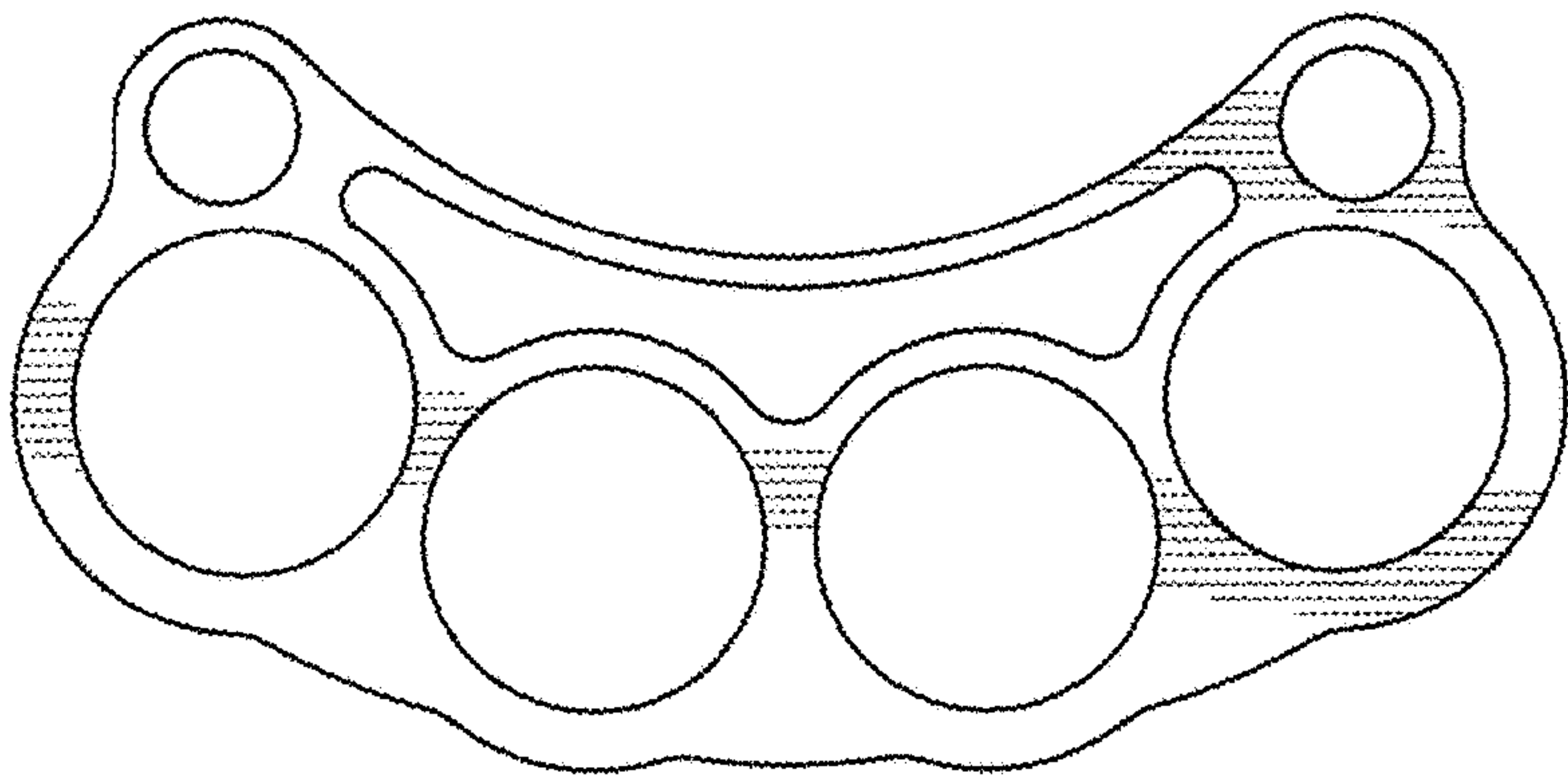

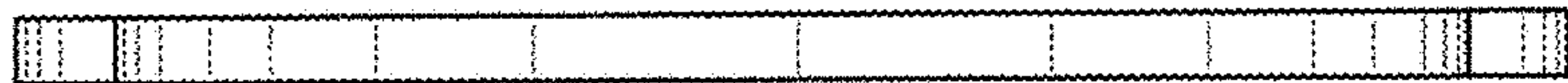

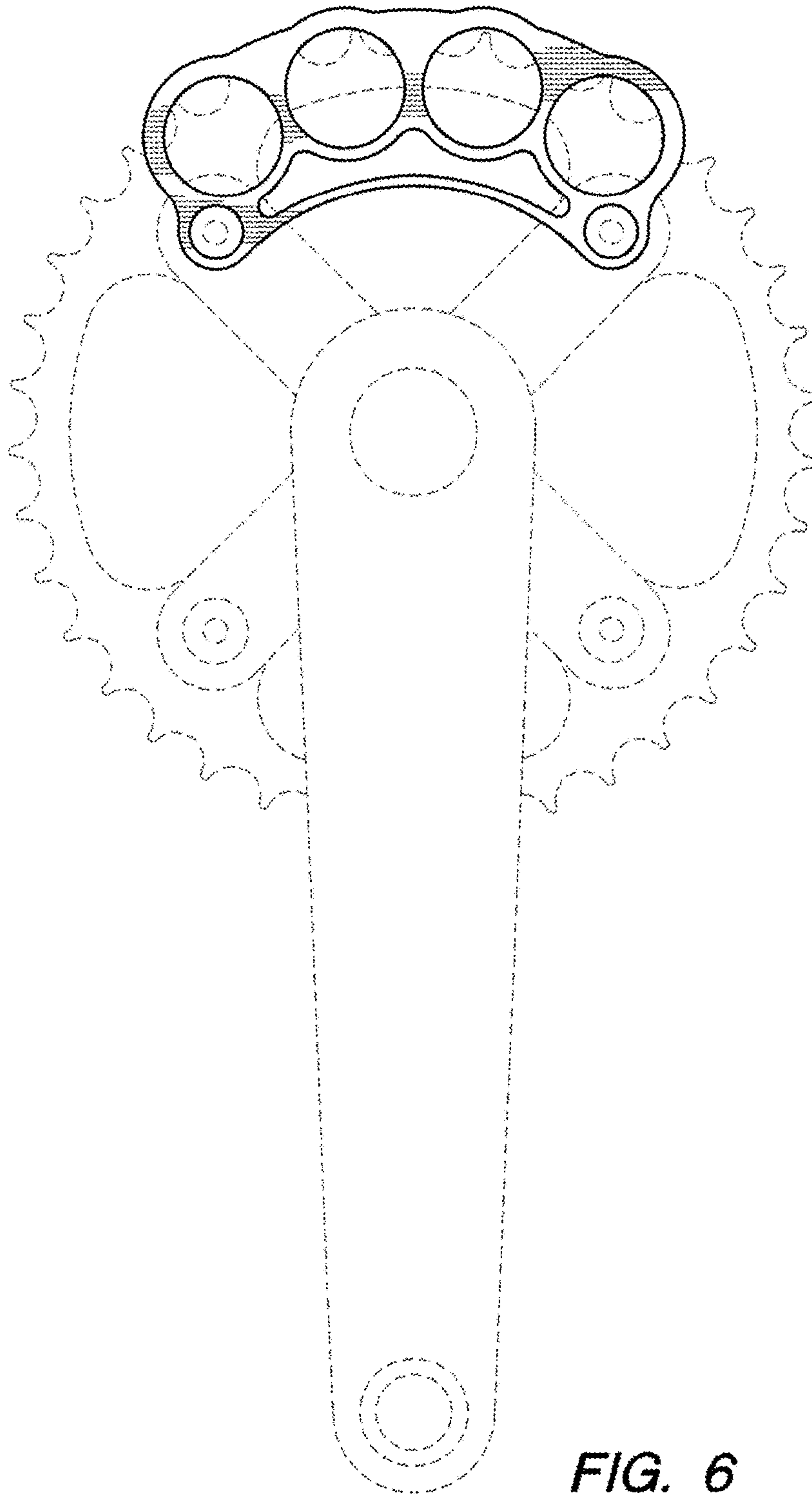
