(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bicycle wheel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bicycle wheel showing the front, right side and top views, and depicting my new design; FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof showing rear, left side and top views;

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a top view thereof, it being understood that the right side, left side and bottom views are identical.

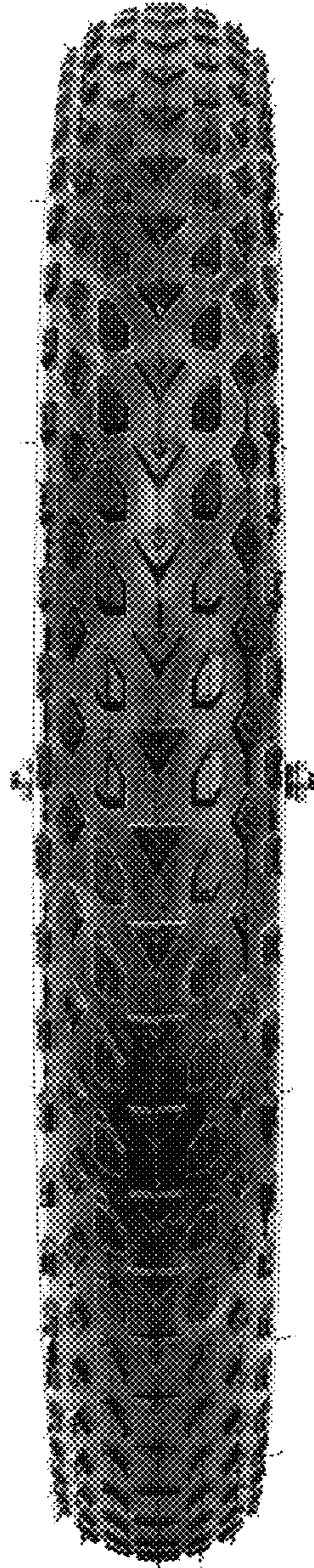
