DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a firearm charging handle comprising a top surface of the firearm charging handle; FIG. 2 is a top view of the firearm charging handle shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a second side view of the firearm charging handle shown in FIG. 1;

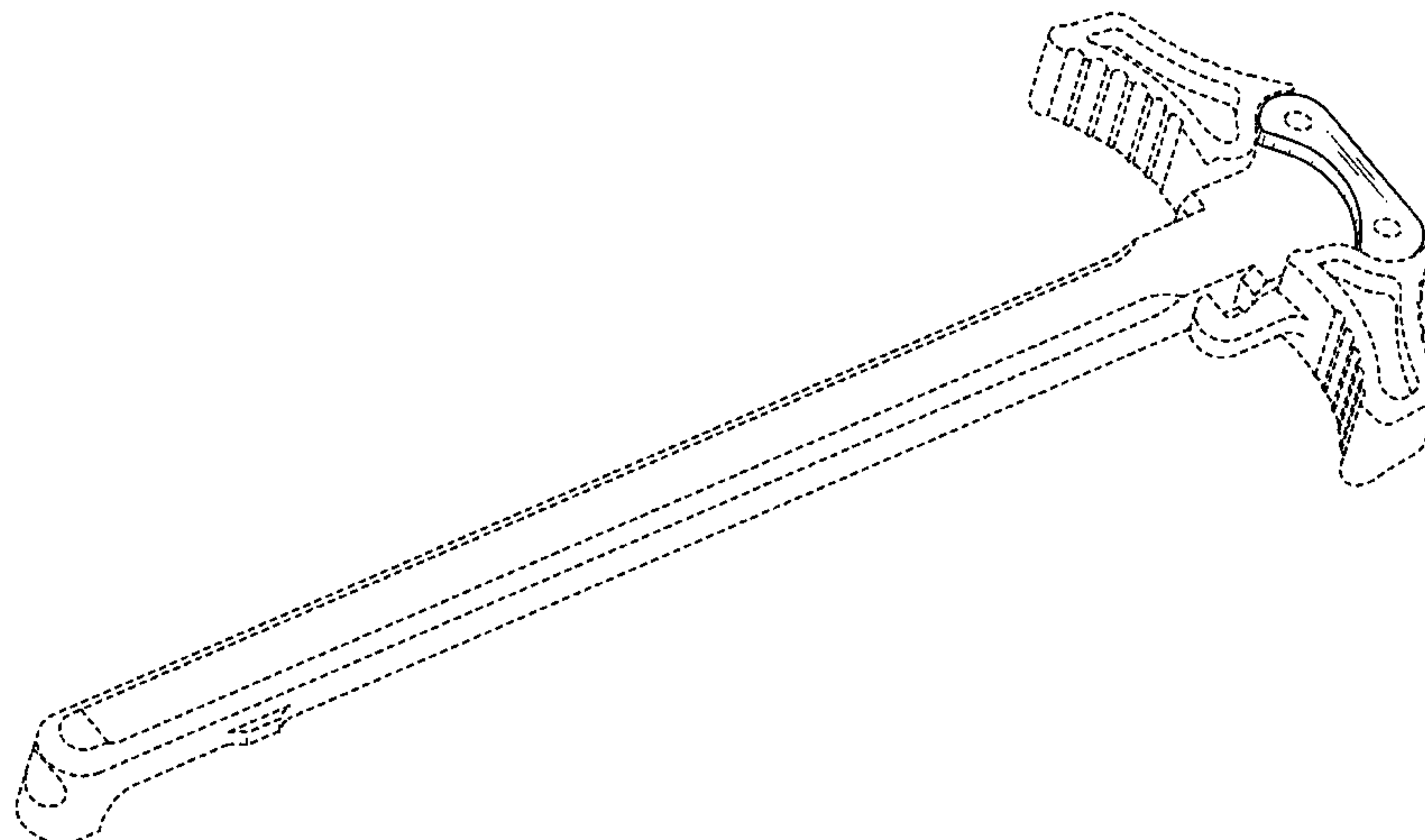
FIG. 6 is a front view of the firearm charging handle shown in FIG. 1; and,

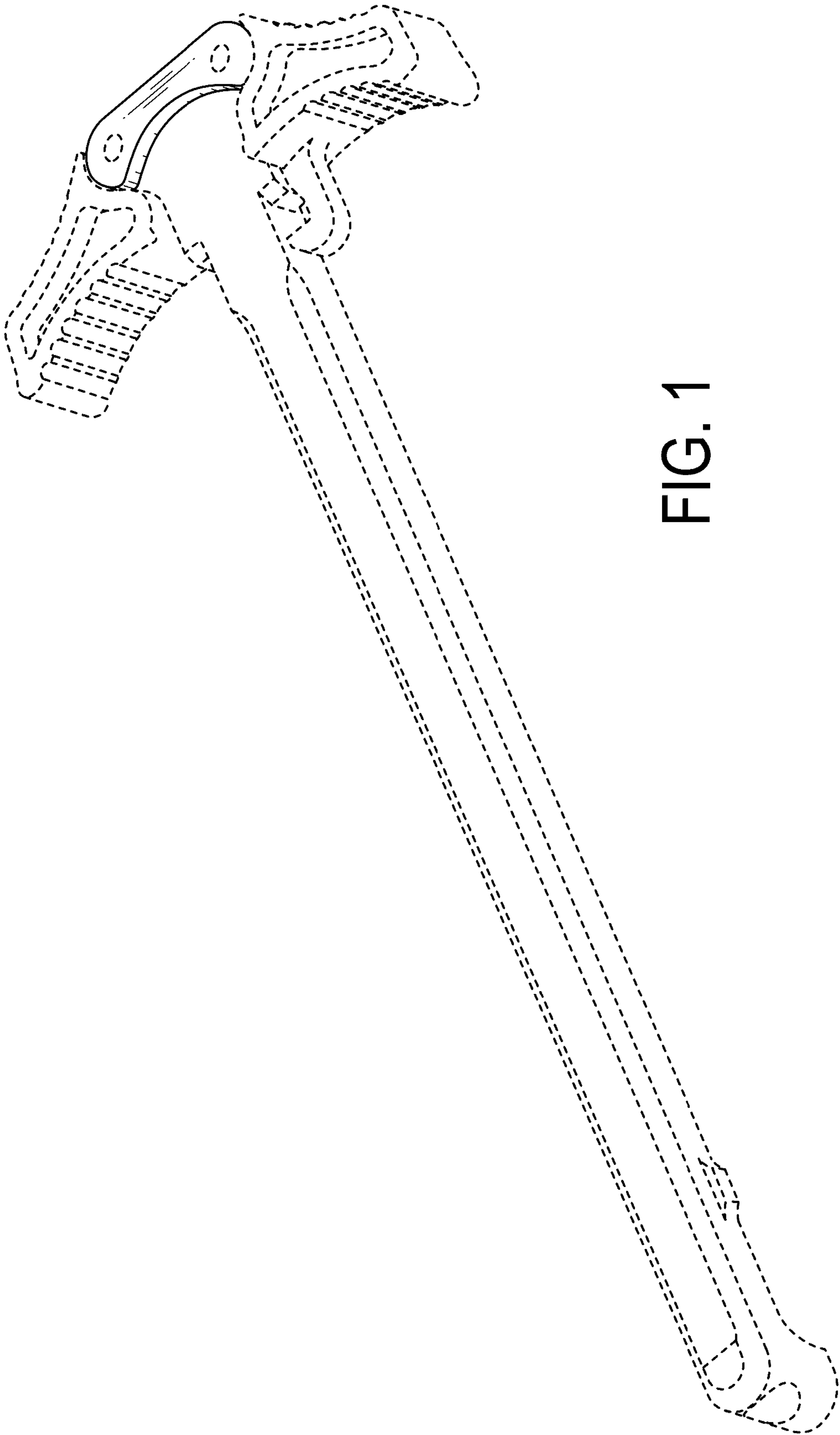

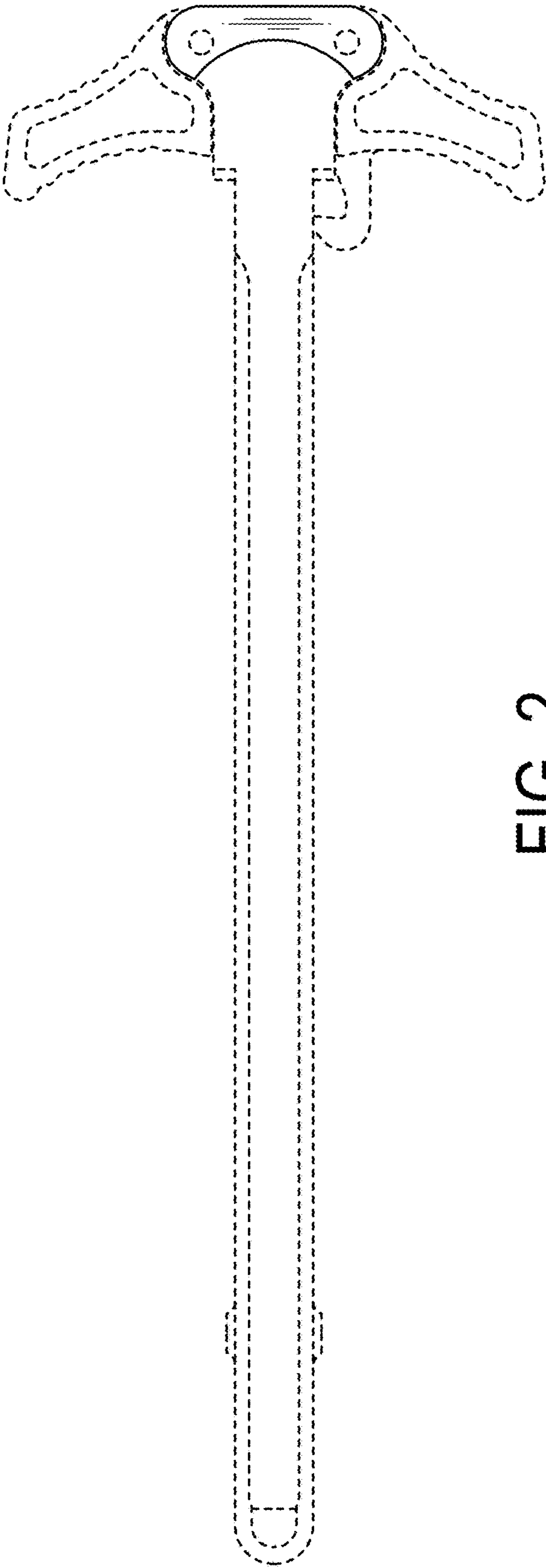

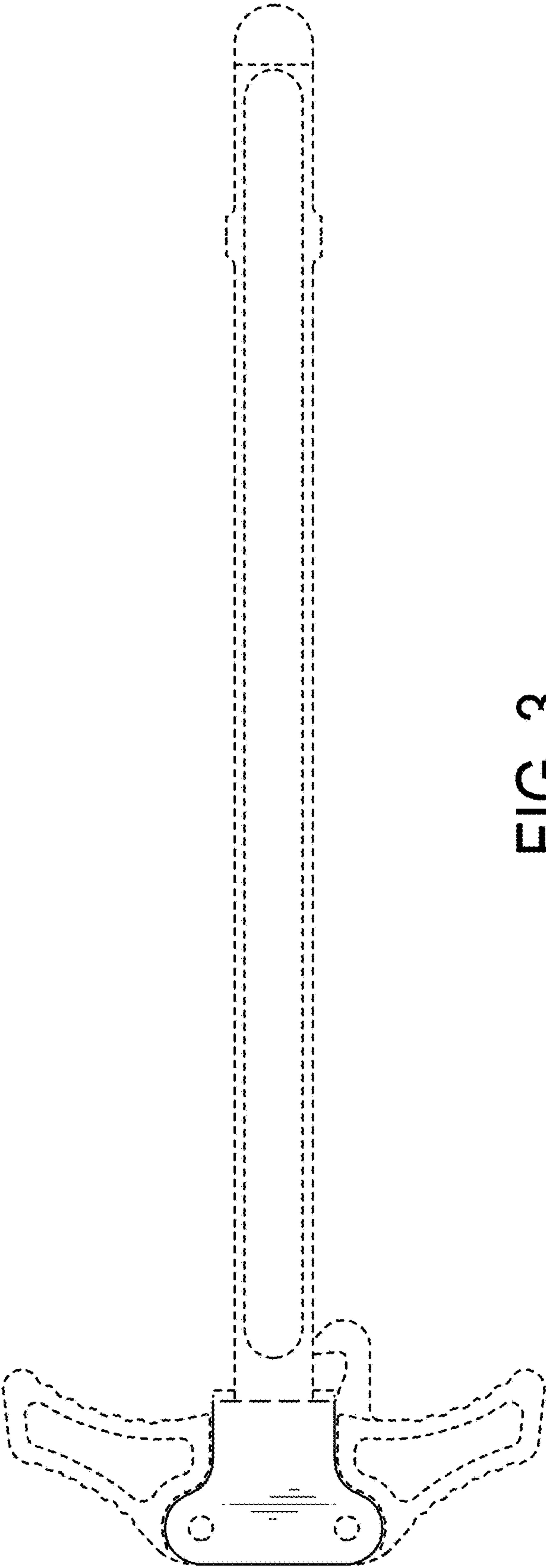

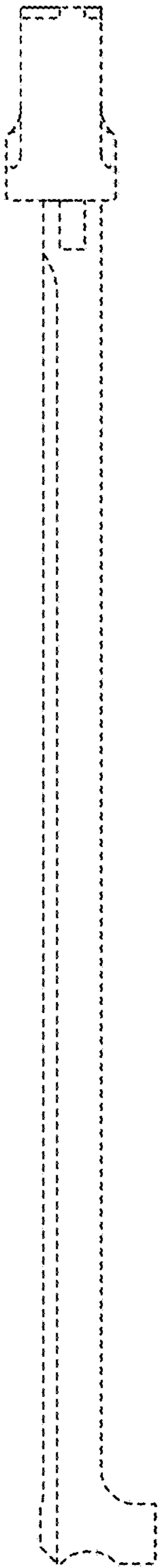

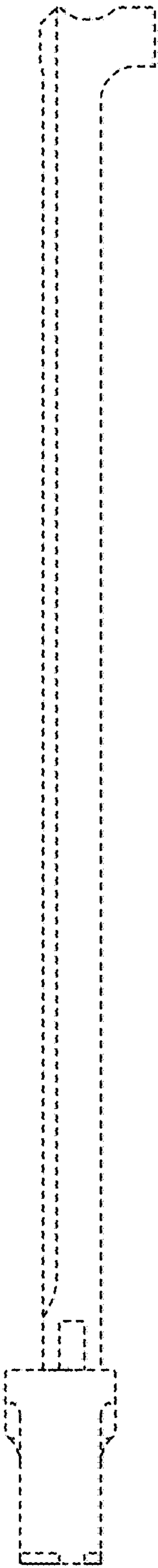

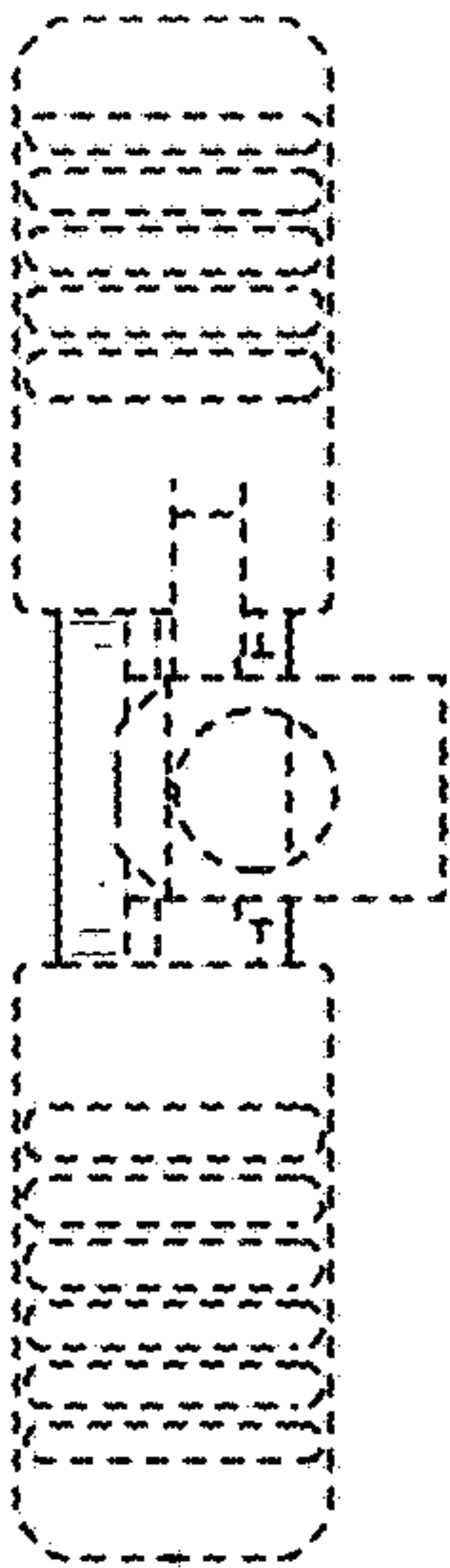
