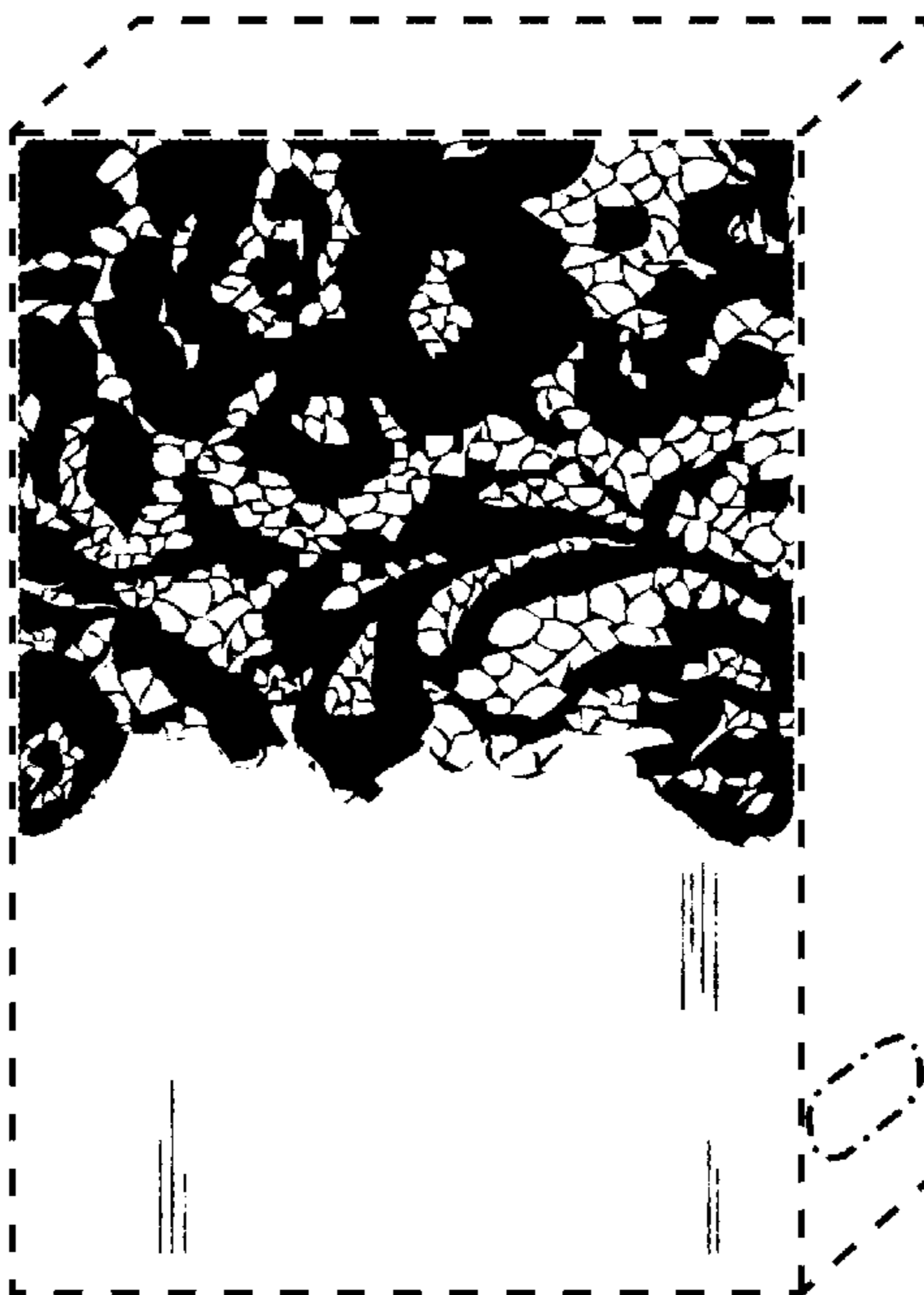
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a package for a feminine hygiene product, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a package for a feminine hygiene product having surface ornamentation showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The evenly spaced broken lines represent unclaimed environments and forms no part of the claimed design. The dash-dot line represents a perforation and is included in the claim.
The front and rear surfaces are part of the claimed design. Top, bottom and sides are not part of the claim.

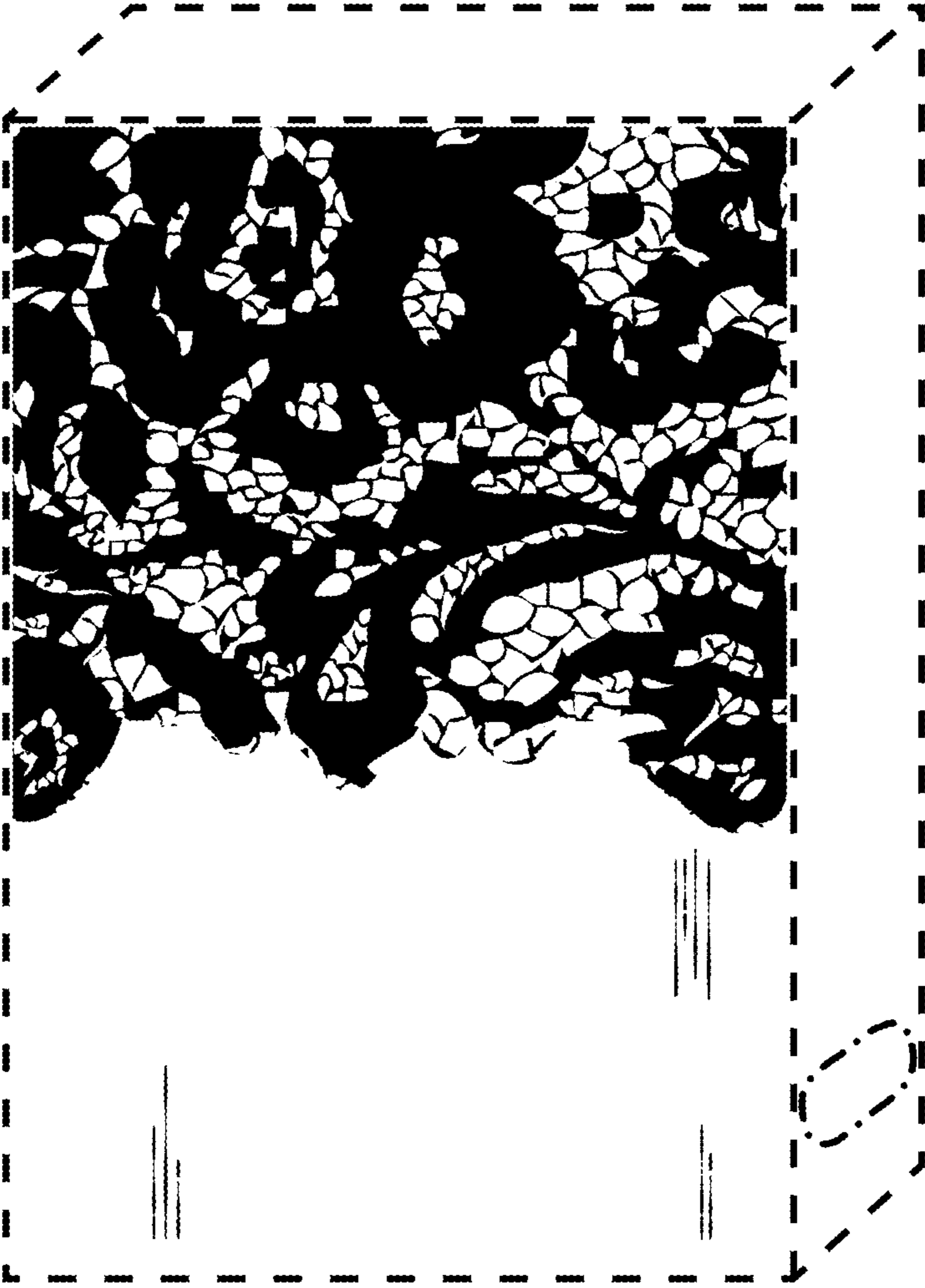

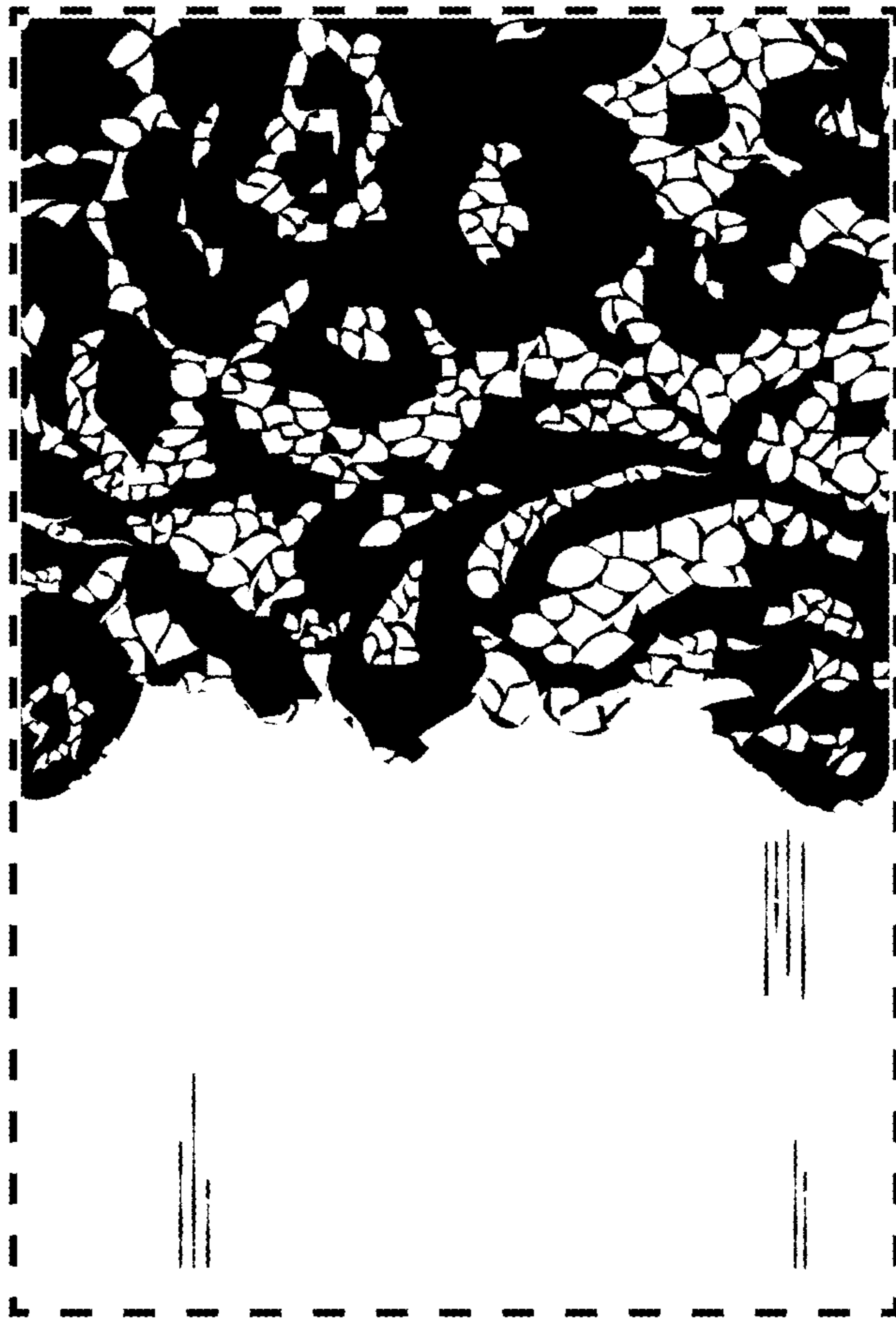

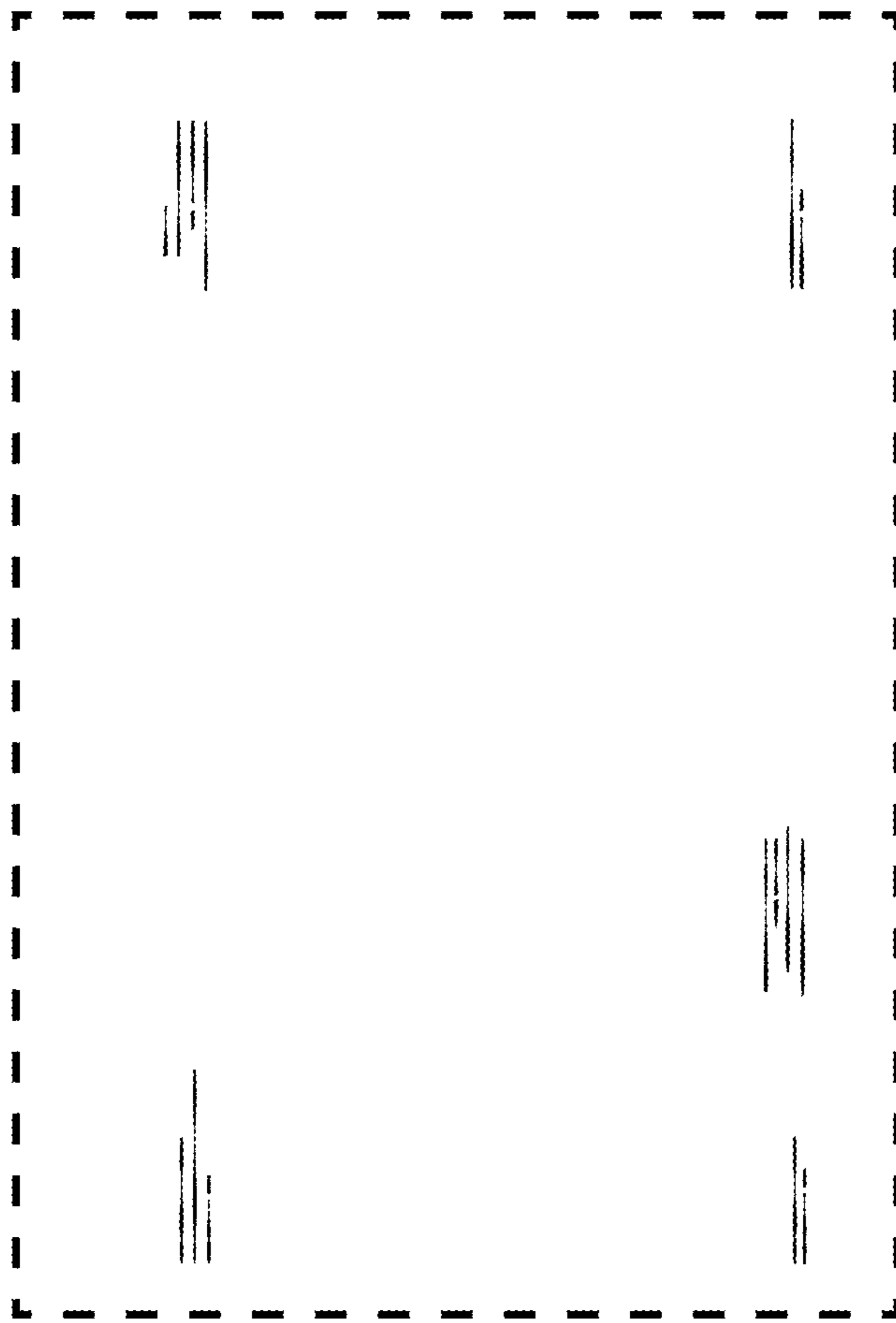

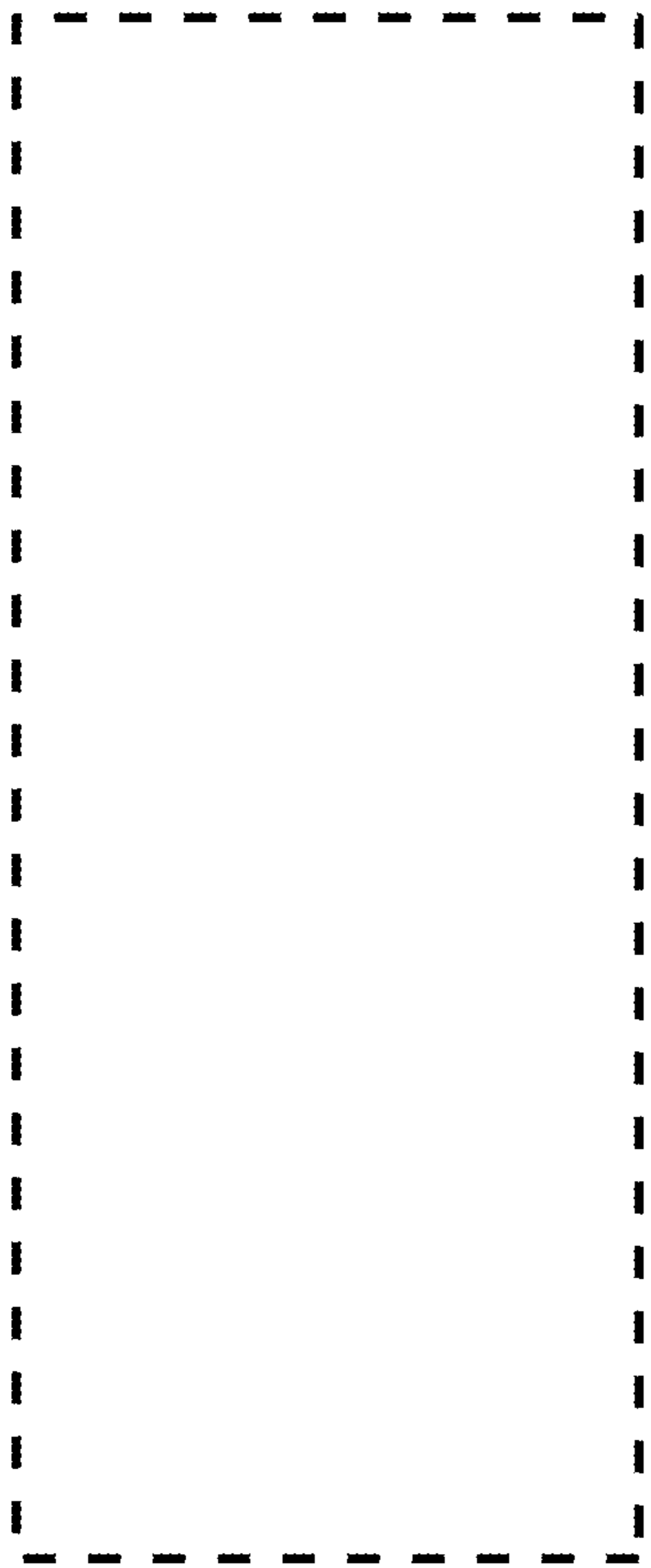

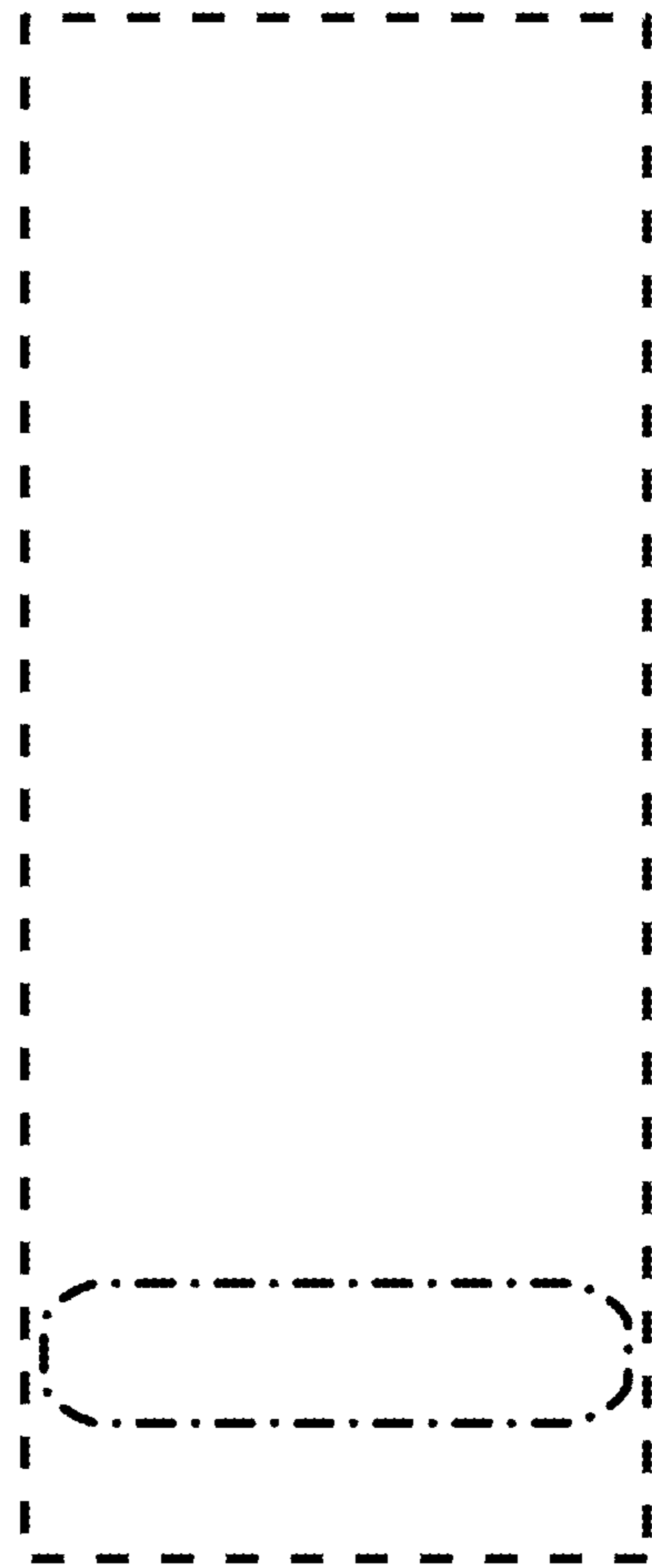

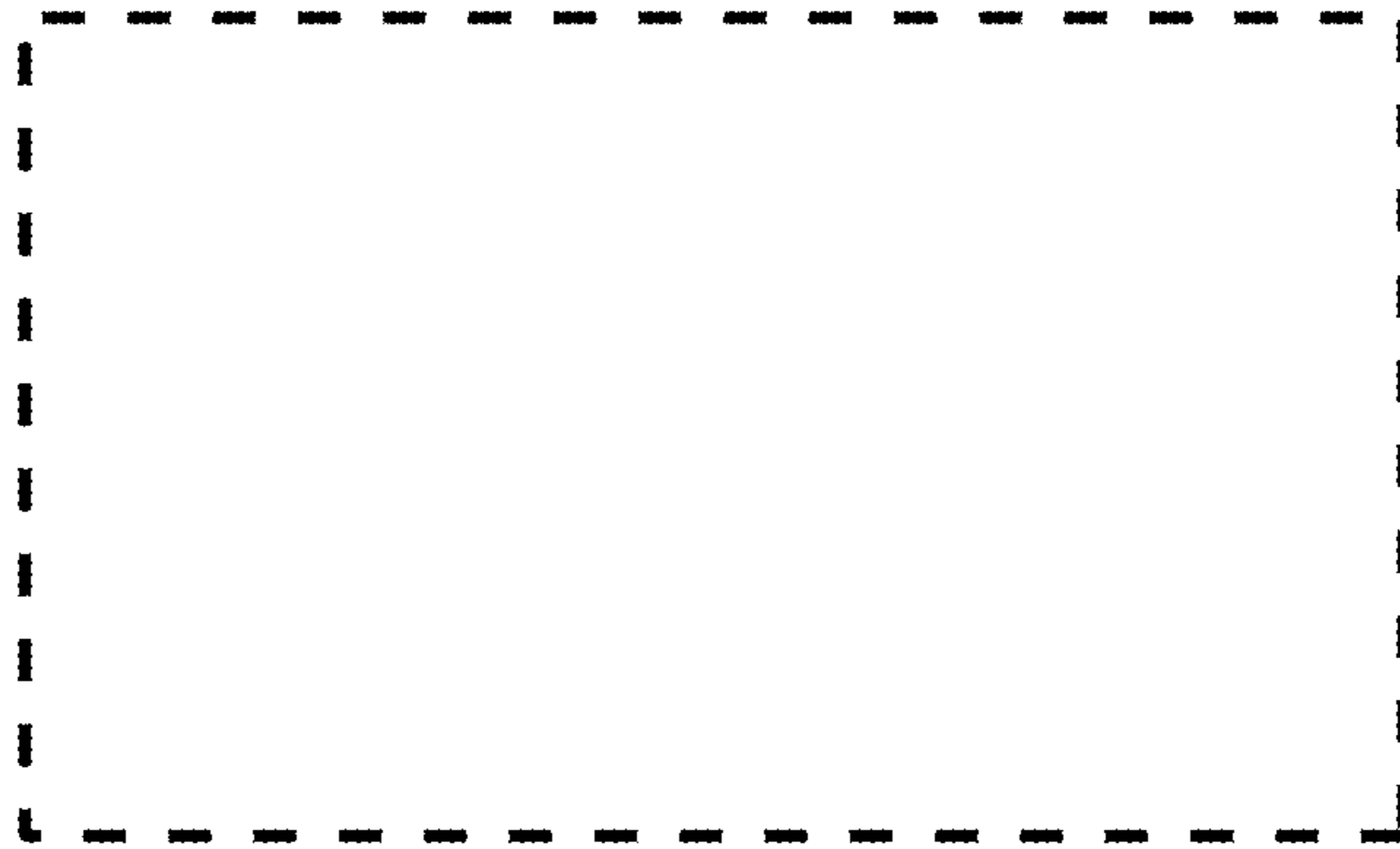
