(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a sleep aide headband with
restraining straps for stabilizing a passenger's head to permit
sleep, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a passenger wearing the sleep
aide headband and showing the restraining straps fastened
around the headrest of a passenger seat;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the sleep aide headband;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the sleep aide headband
showing the ends of the restraining straps fastened together;
FIG. 4 is left side elevation view of the sleep aide headband
showing the ends of the restraining straps fastened together;
FIG. 5 is a side elevation view of the sleep aide headband
showing the ends of the restraining straps fastened together;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the sleep aide headband showing
the ends of the restraining straps fastened together;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the sleep aide headband
showing the ends of the restraining straps fastened together;
and,
FIG. 8 is a front elevation view of the sleep aide headband
showing the ends of the restraining strap unfastened and
further showing the eye-covering portions of the headband
flipped up to a raised position.

The broken lines shown in FIG. 1 are for illustrative
purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

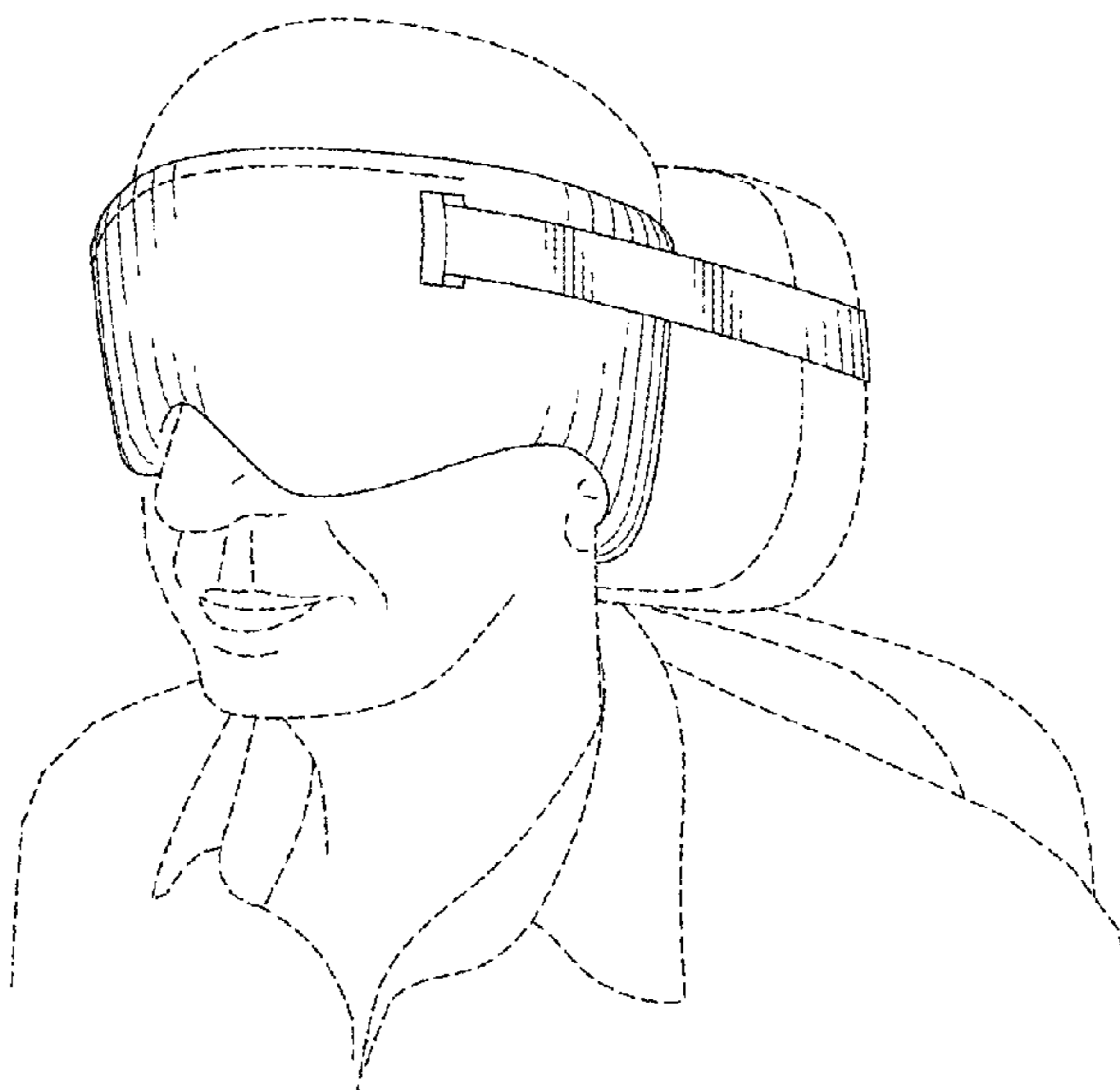

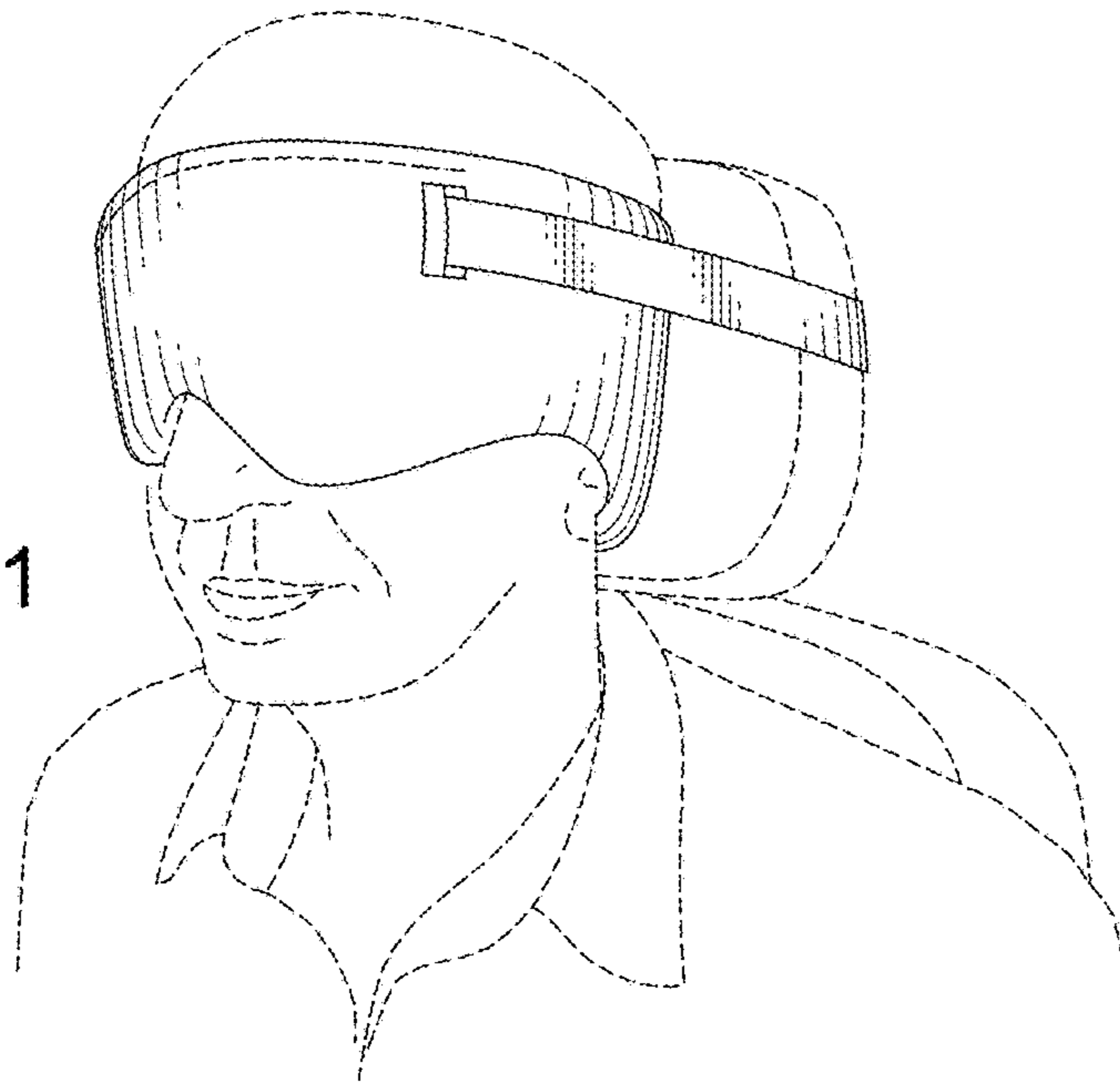

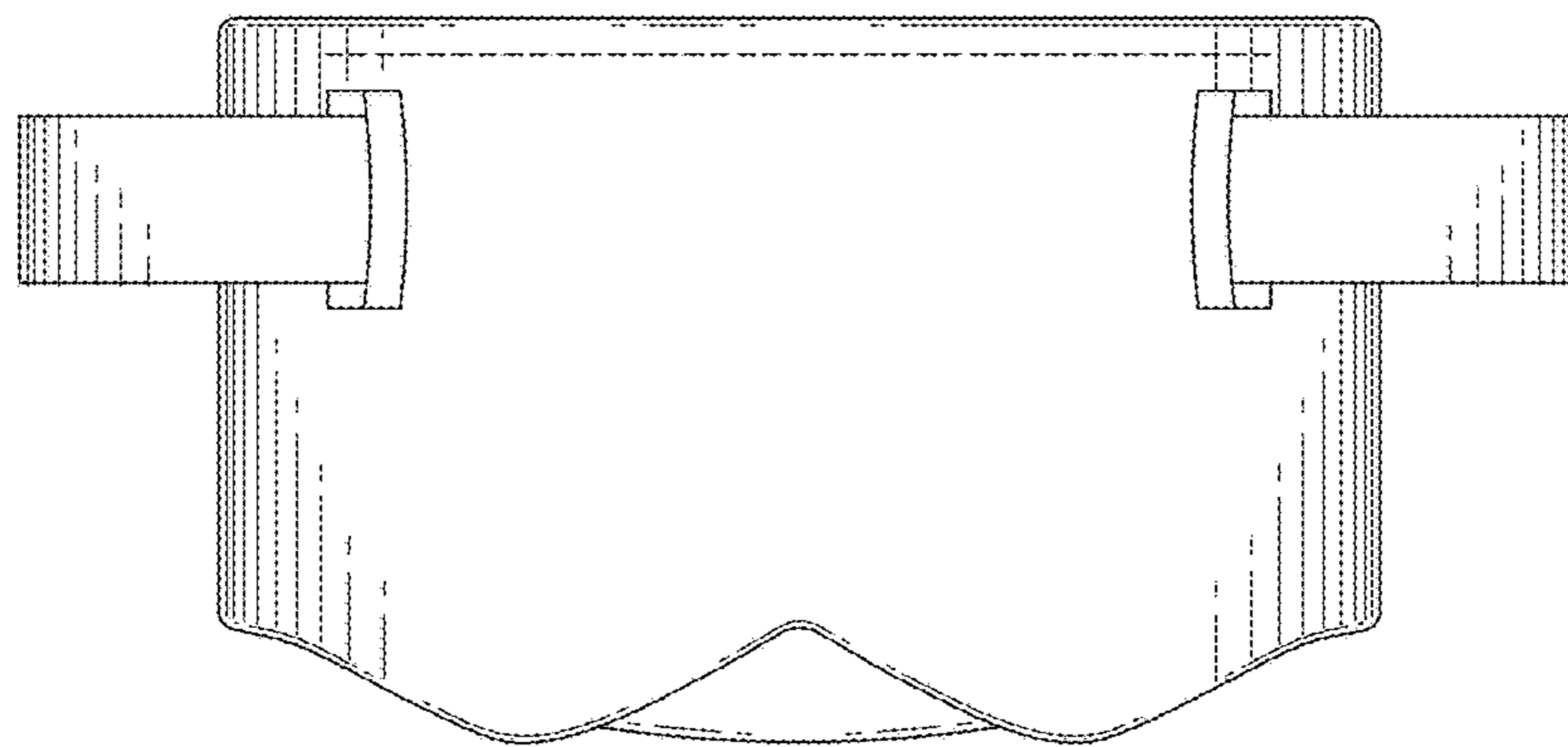

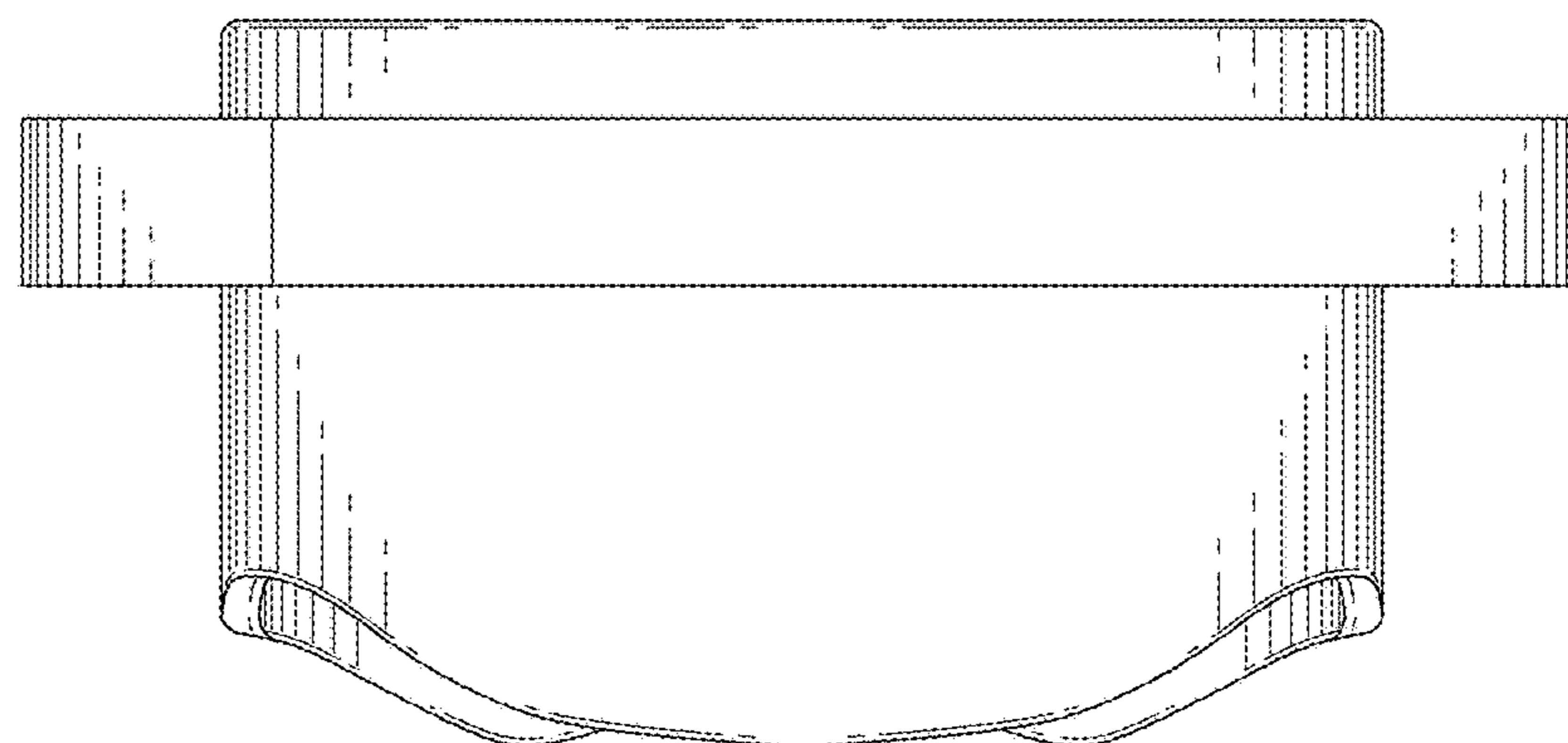

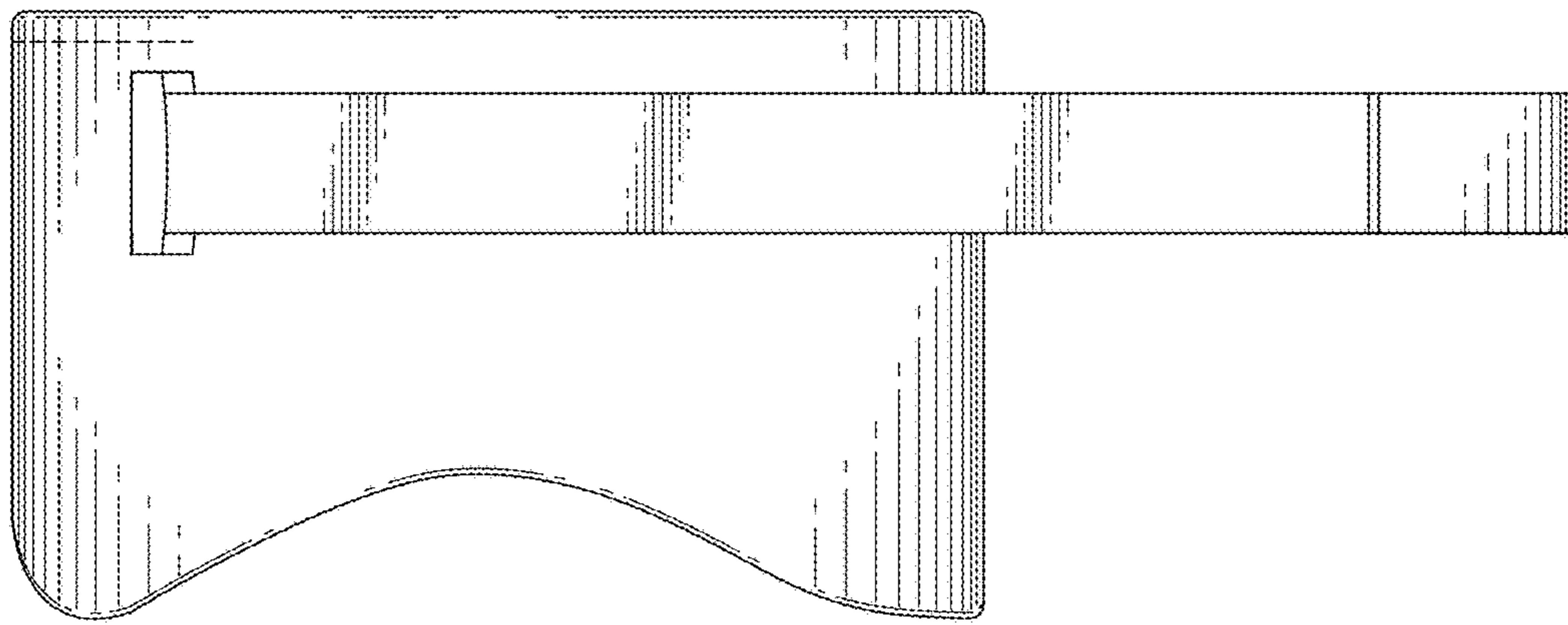

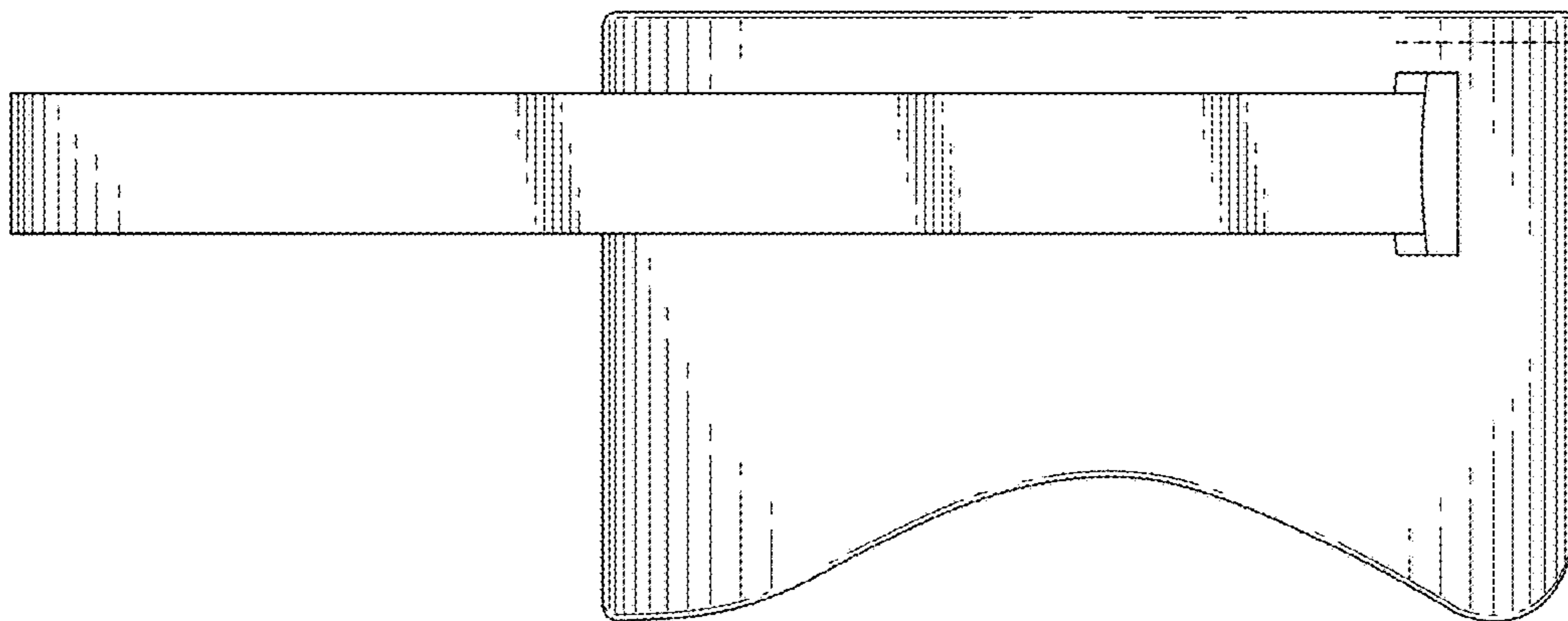

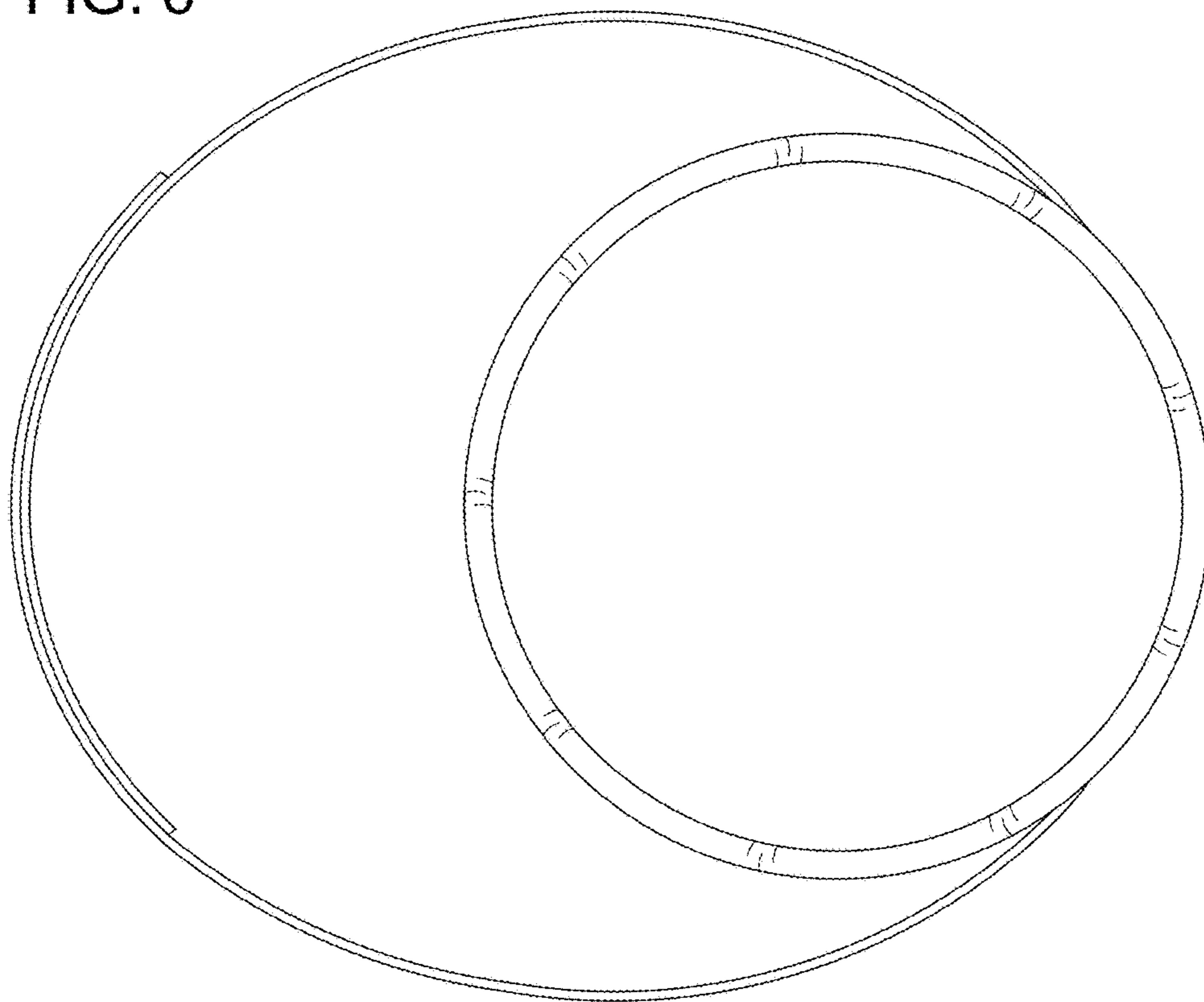

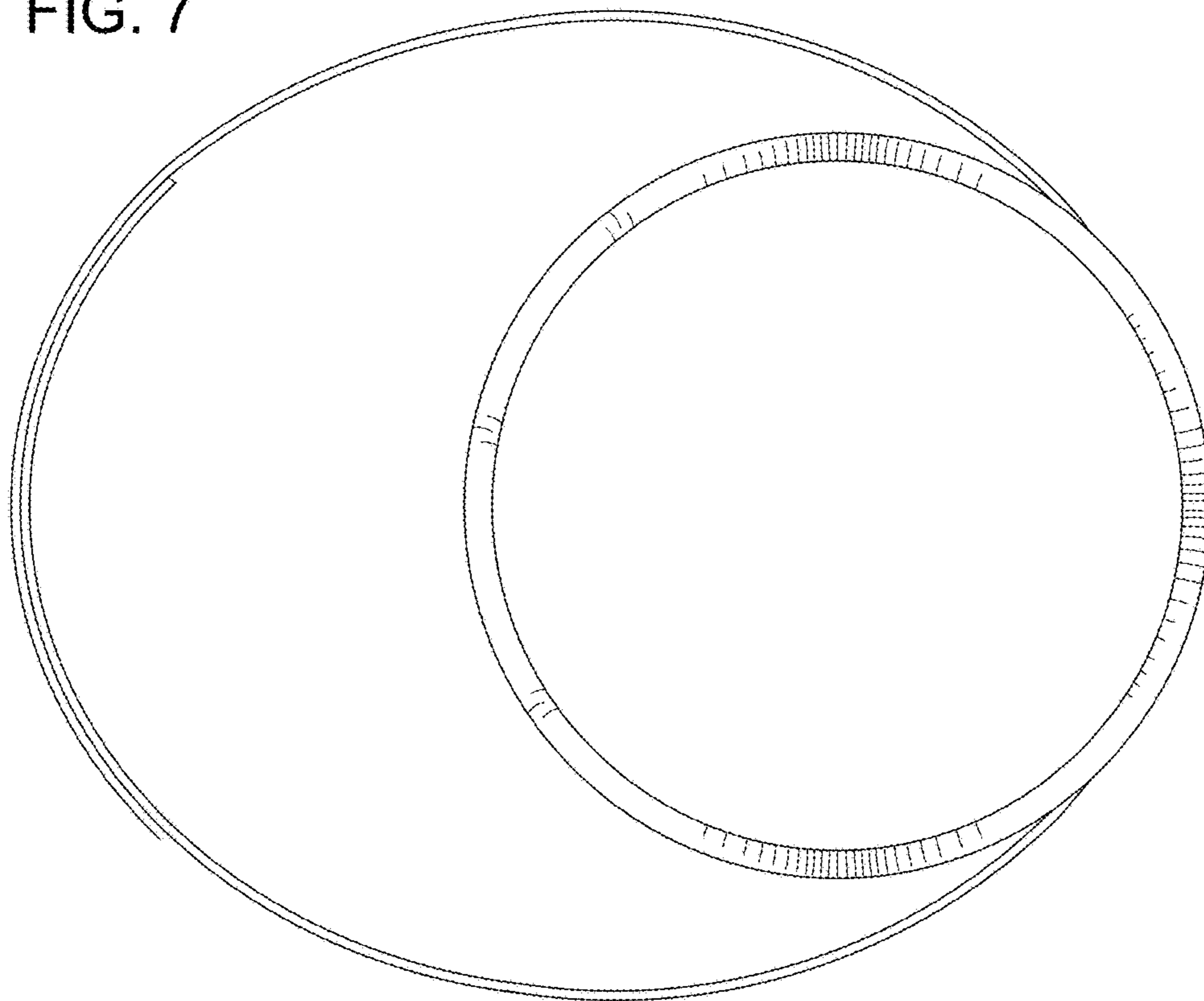
