FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view, the left side elevation view being a mirror image thereof;

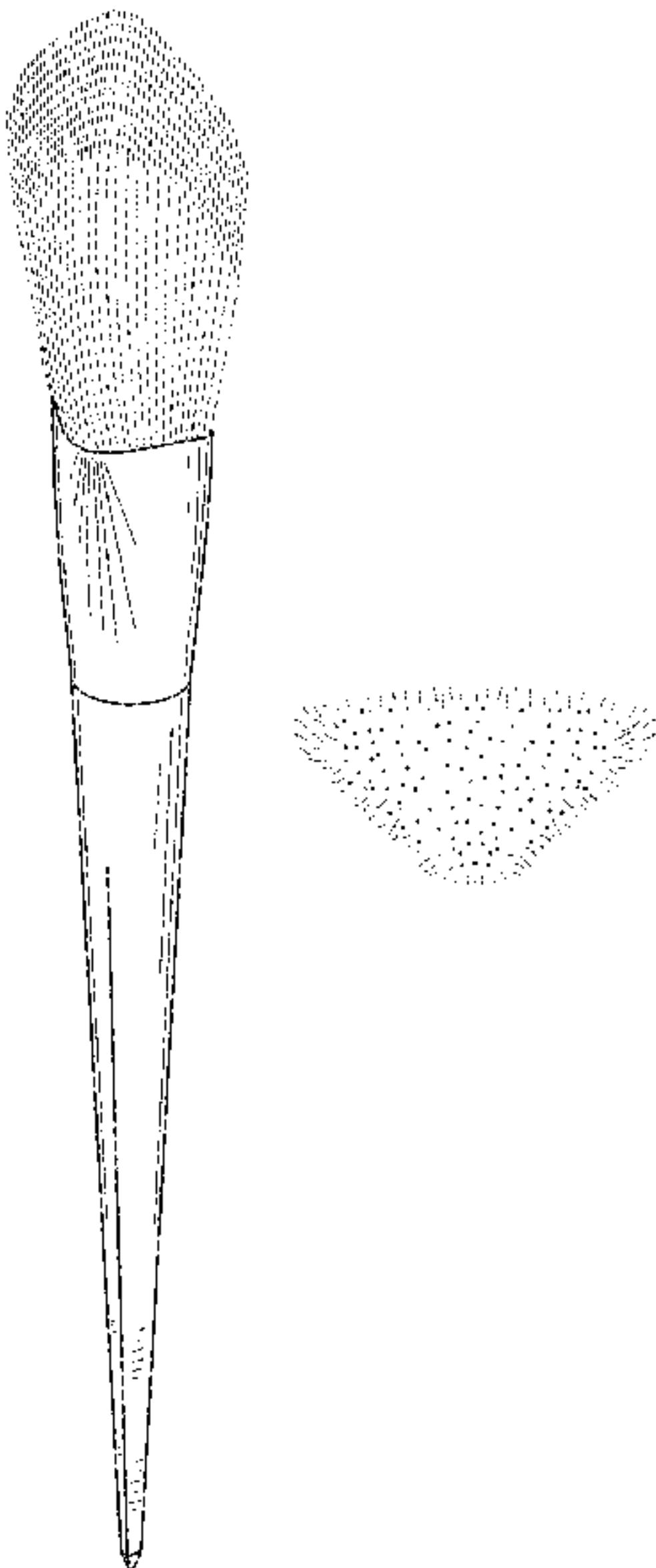
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;

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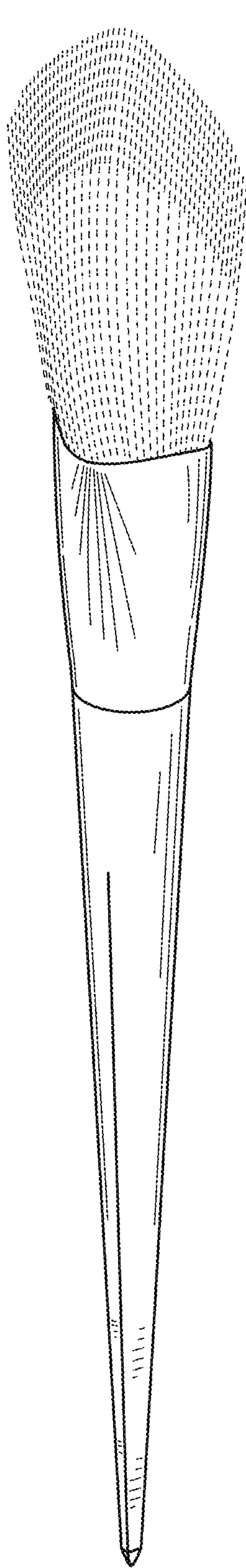

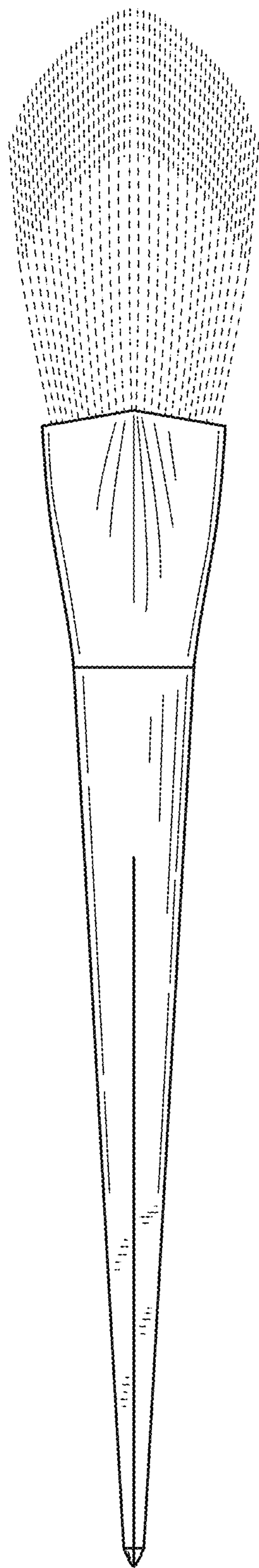

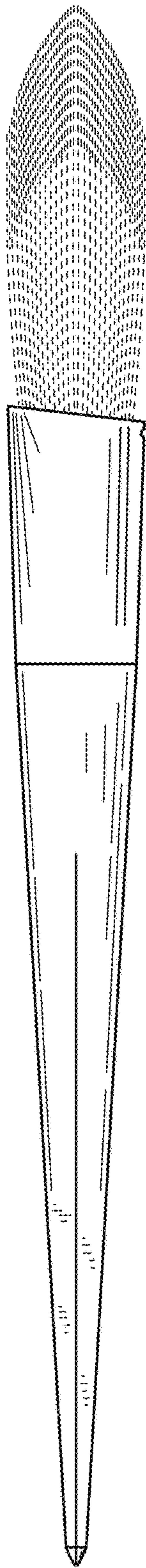

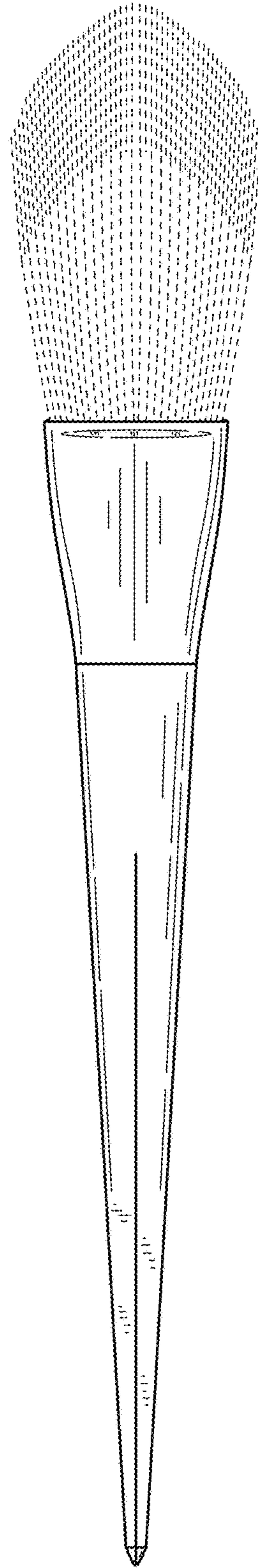

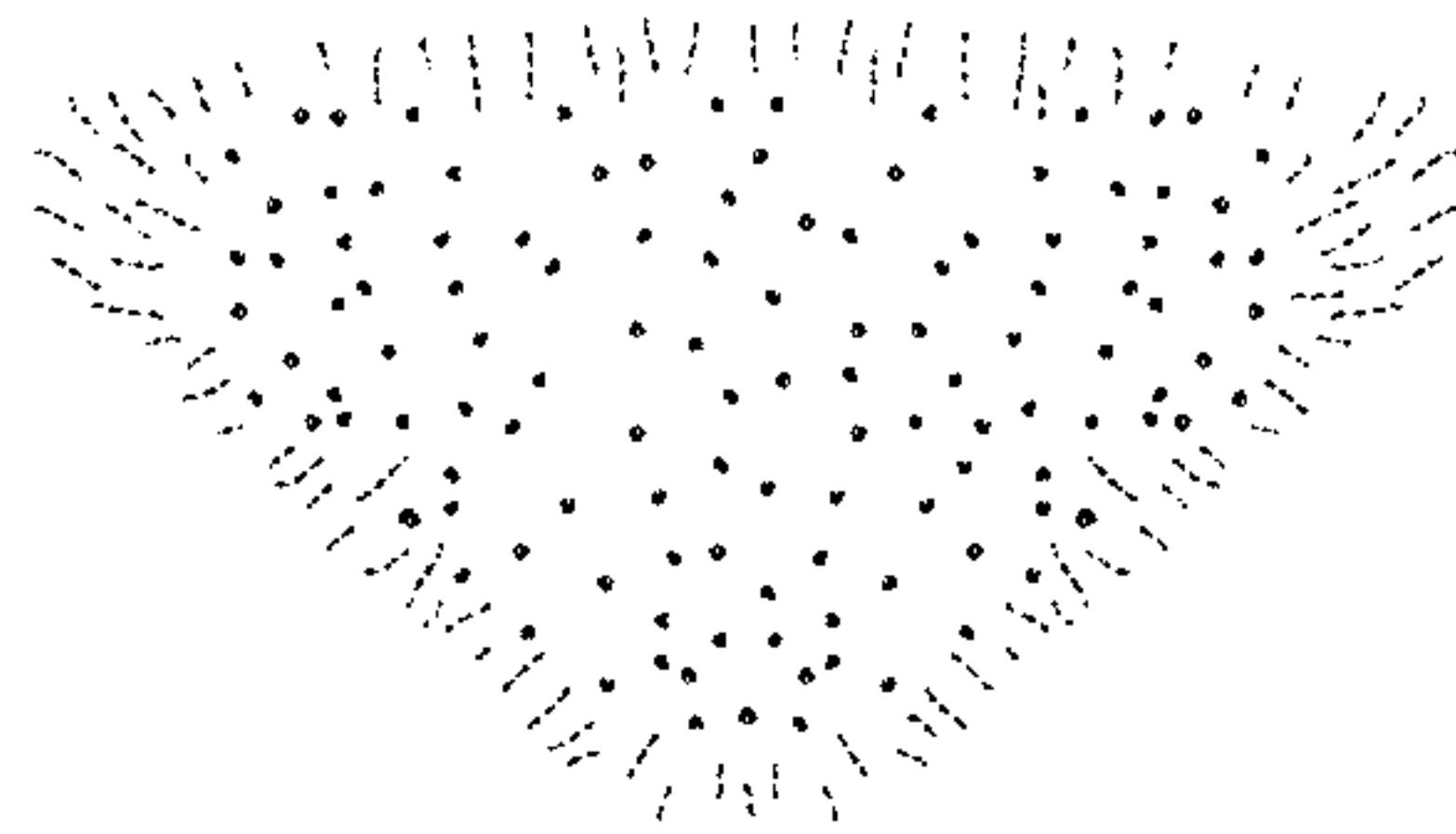

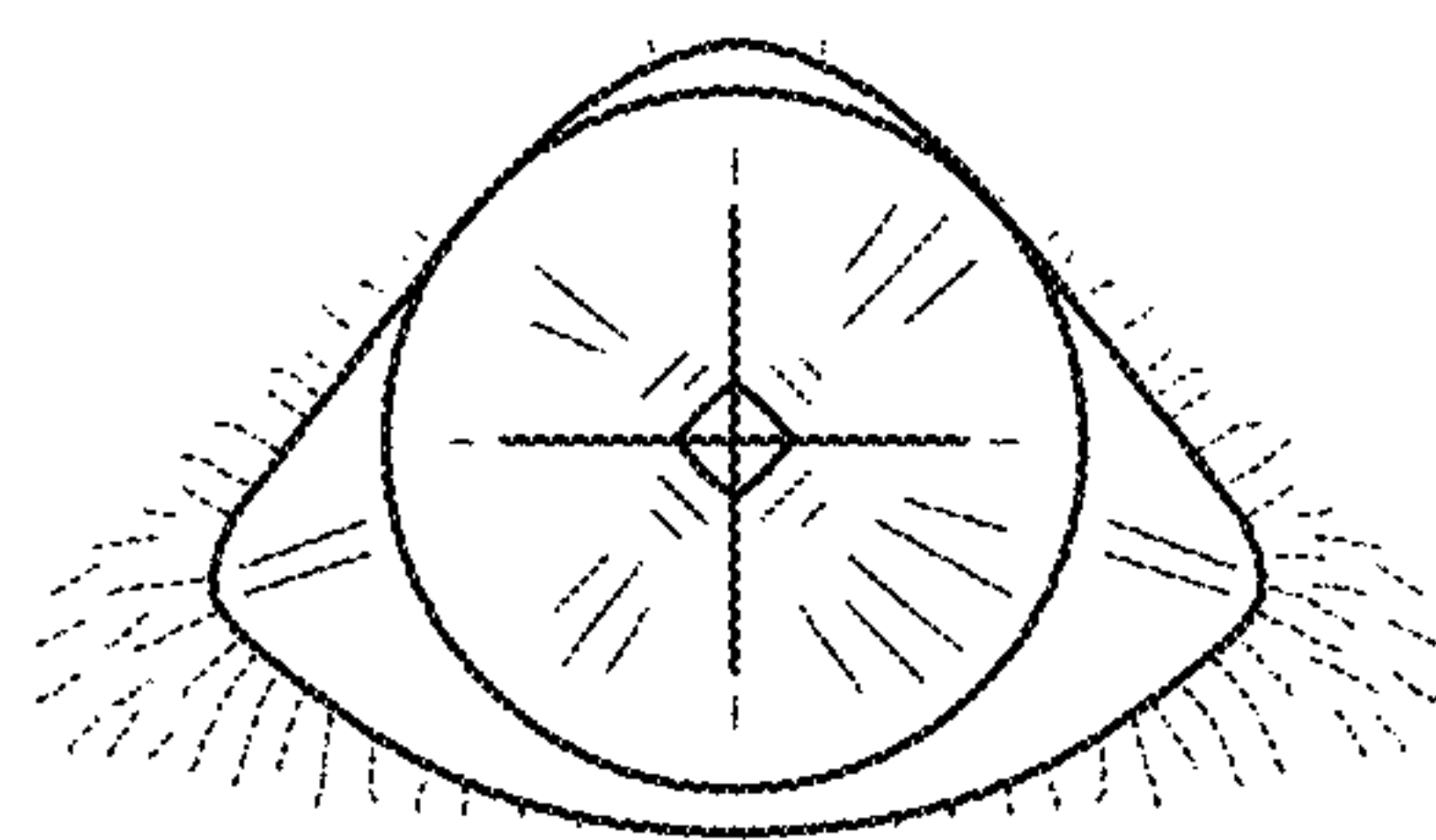
