The ornamental design for headwear, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of headwear, showing our new design, in a first condition of use, the first condition of use having a transparent visor.

FIG. 2 is a left elevation view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.

FIG. 3 is a right elevation view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.

FIG. 7 is a front-right-top perspective view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.

FIG. 8 is a front-left-top perspective view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.

FIG. 9 is a front-right-bottom perspective view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.

FIG. 10 is a front-left-bottom perspective view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.

FIG. 11 is a front elevation view of headwear, showing our new design, in a second condition of use, the second condition of use having no visor.

FIG. 12 is a left elevation view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.

FIG. 13 is a right elevation view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.

FIG. 14 is a top plan view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.

FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.

FIG. 16 is a rear elevation view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.

FIG. 17 is a front-right-top perspective view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.

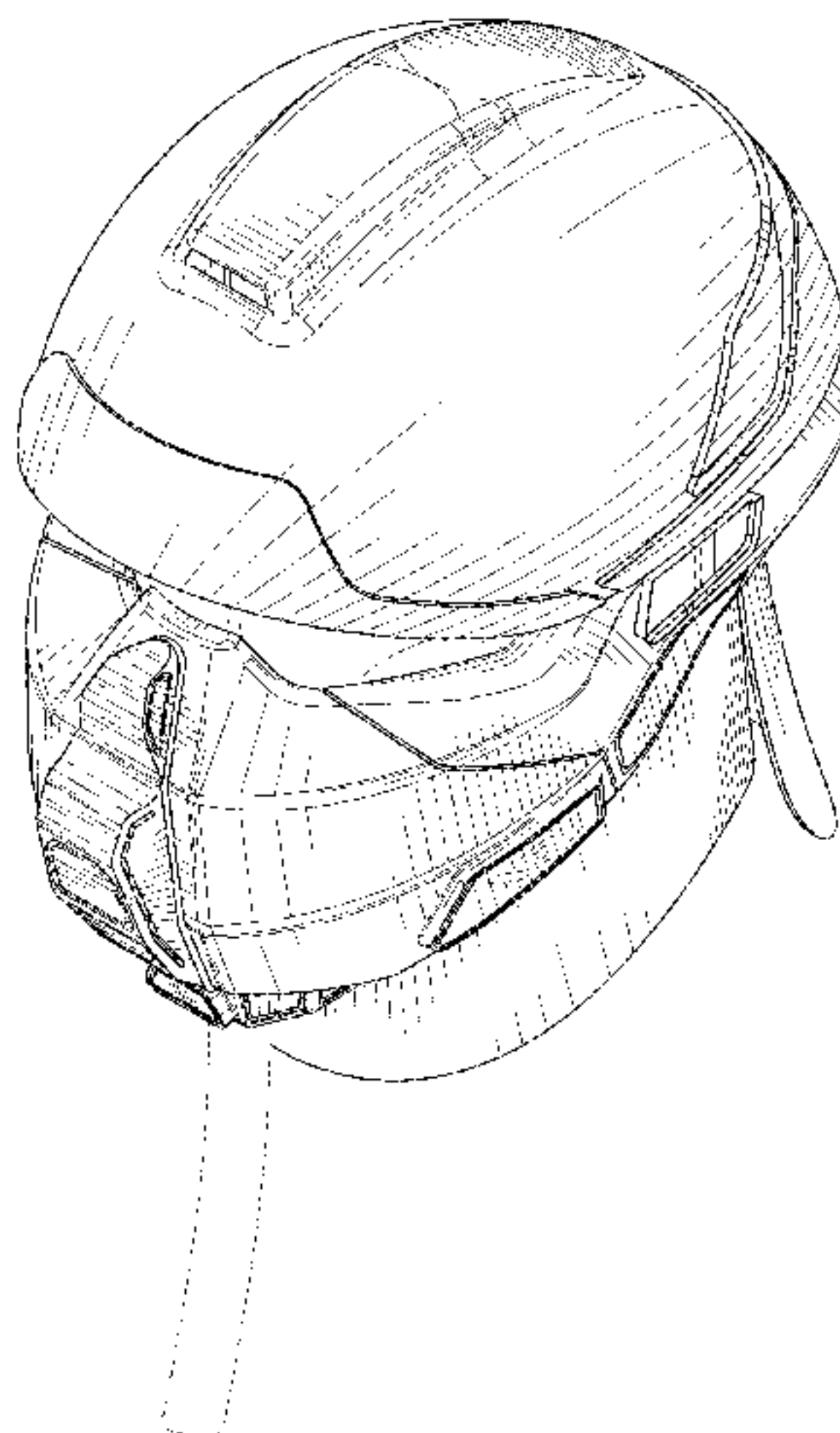
FIG. 18 is a front-left-top perspective view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.

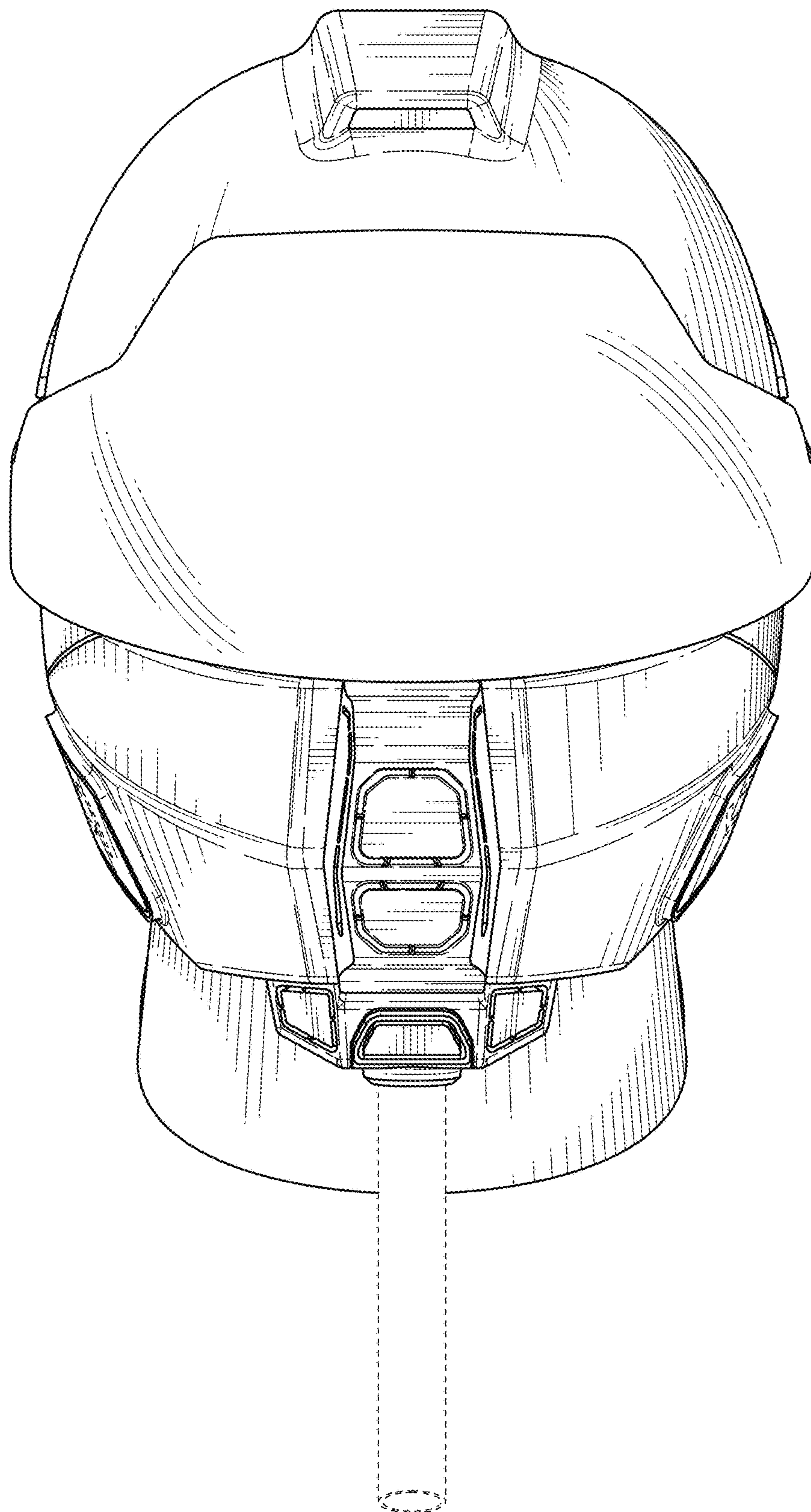

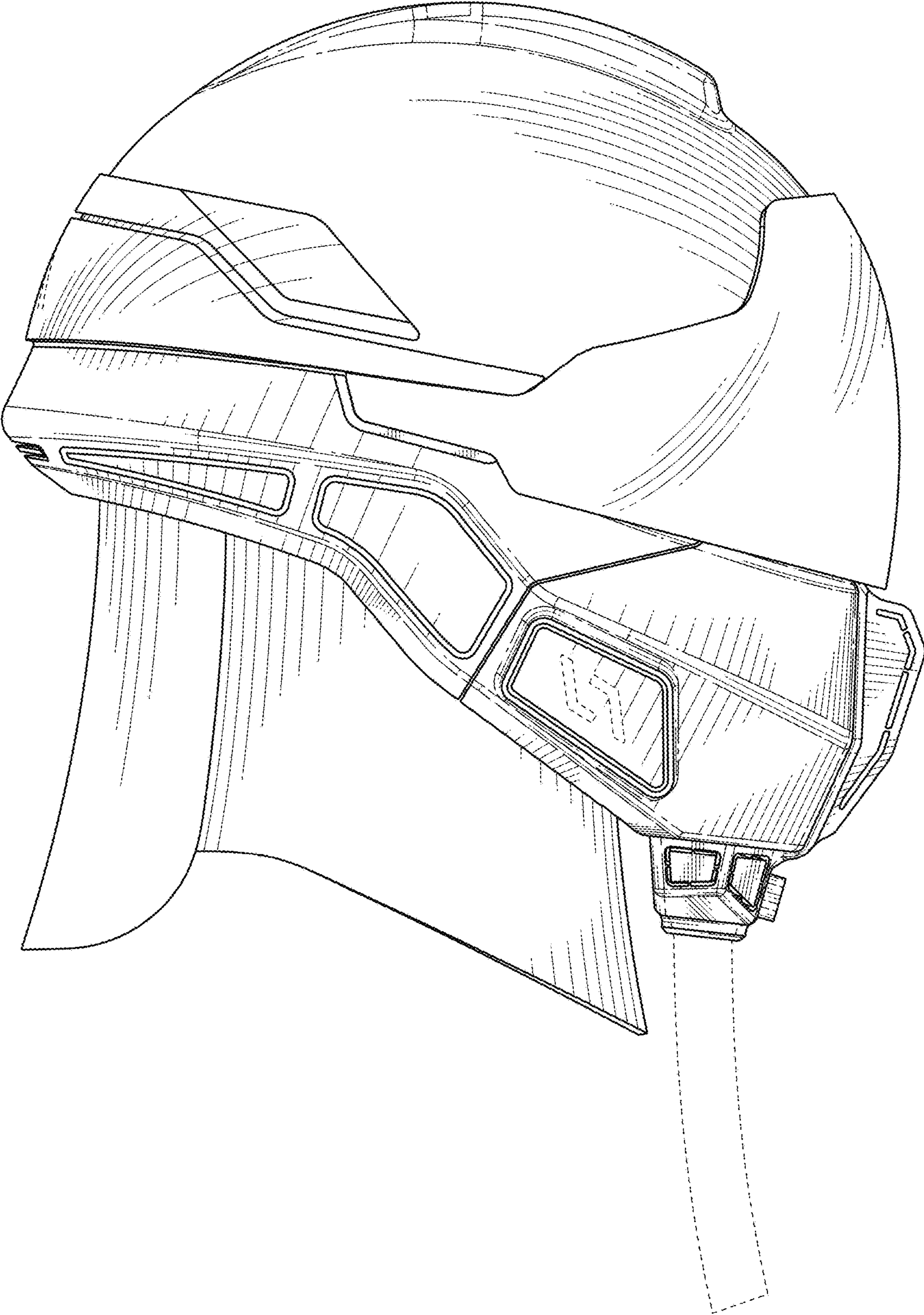

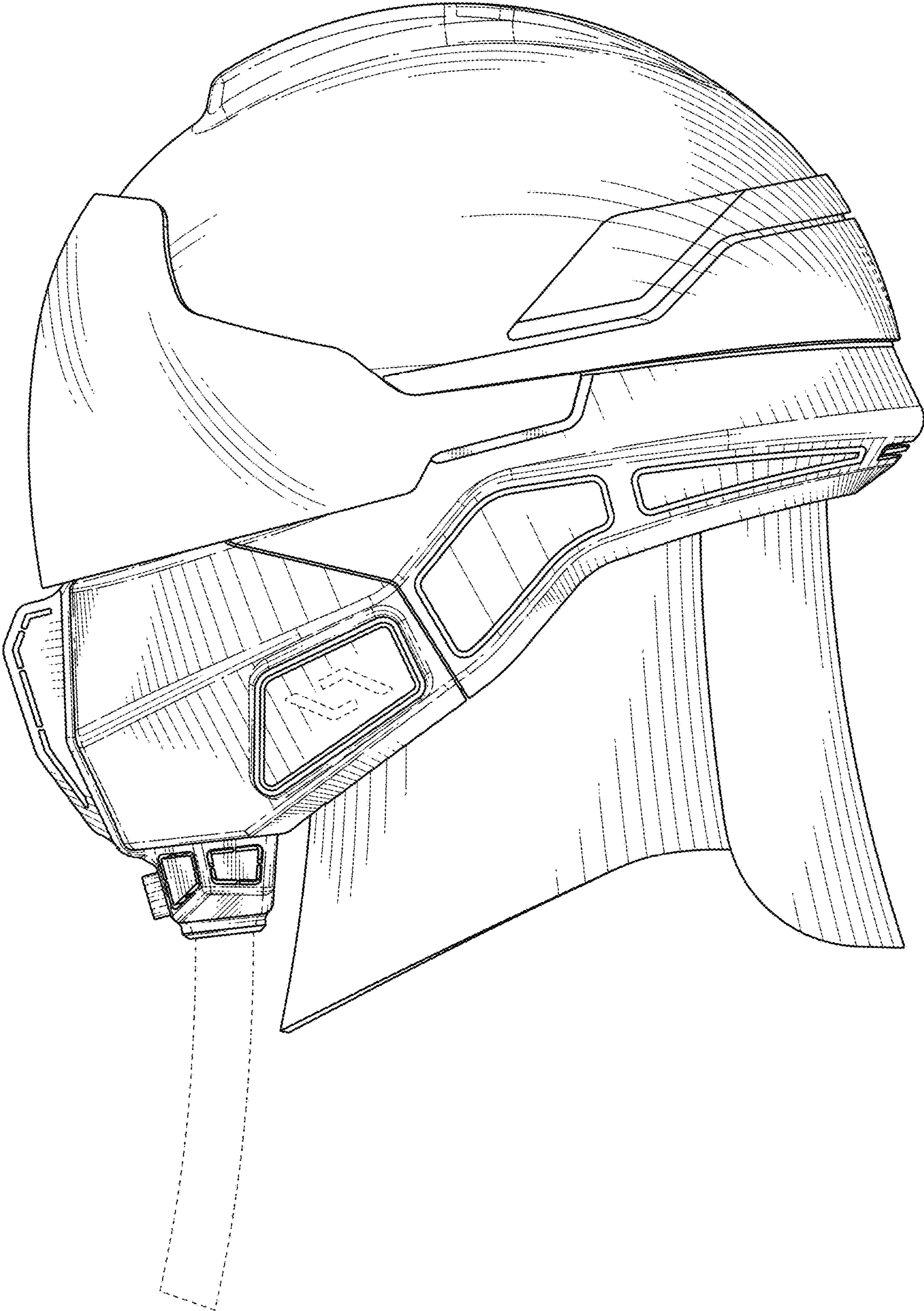

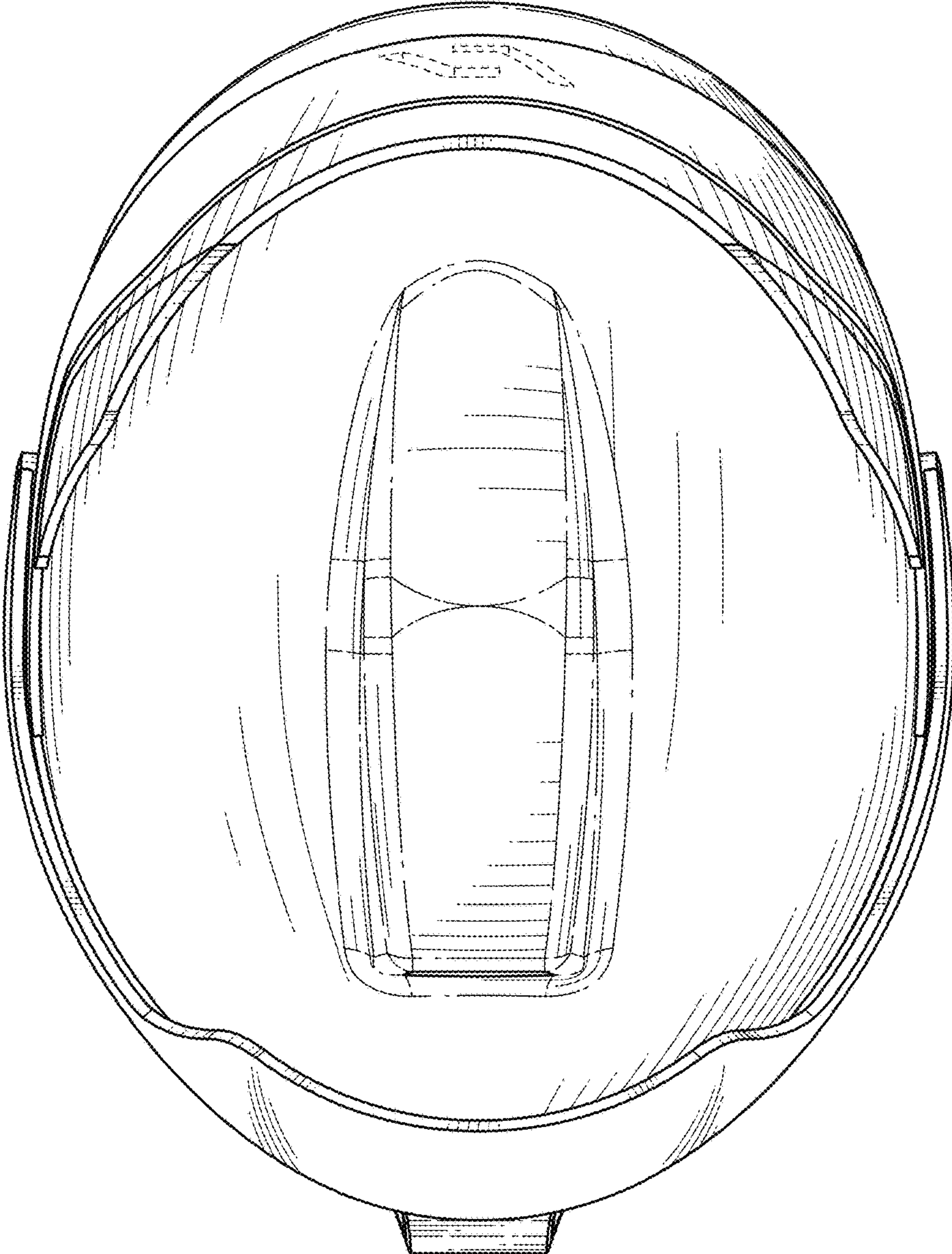

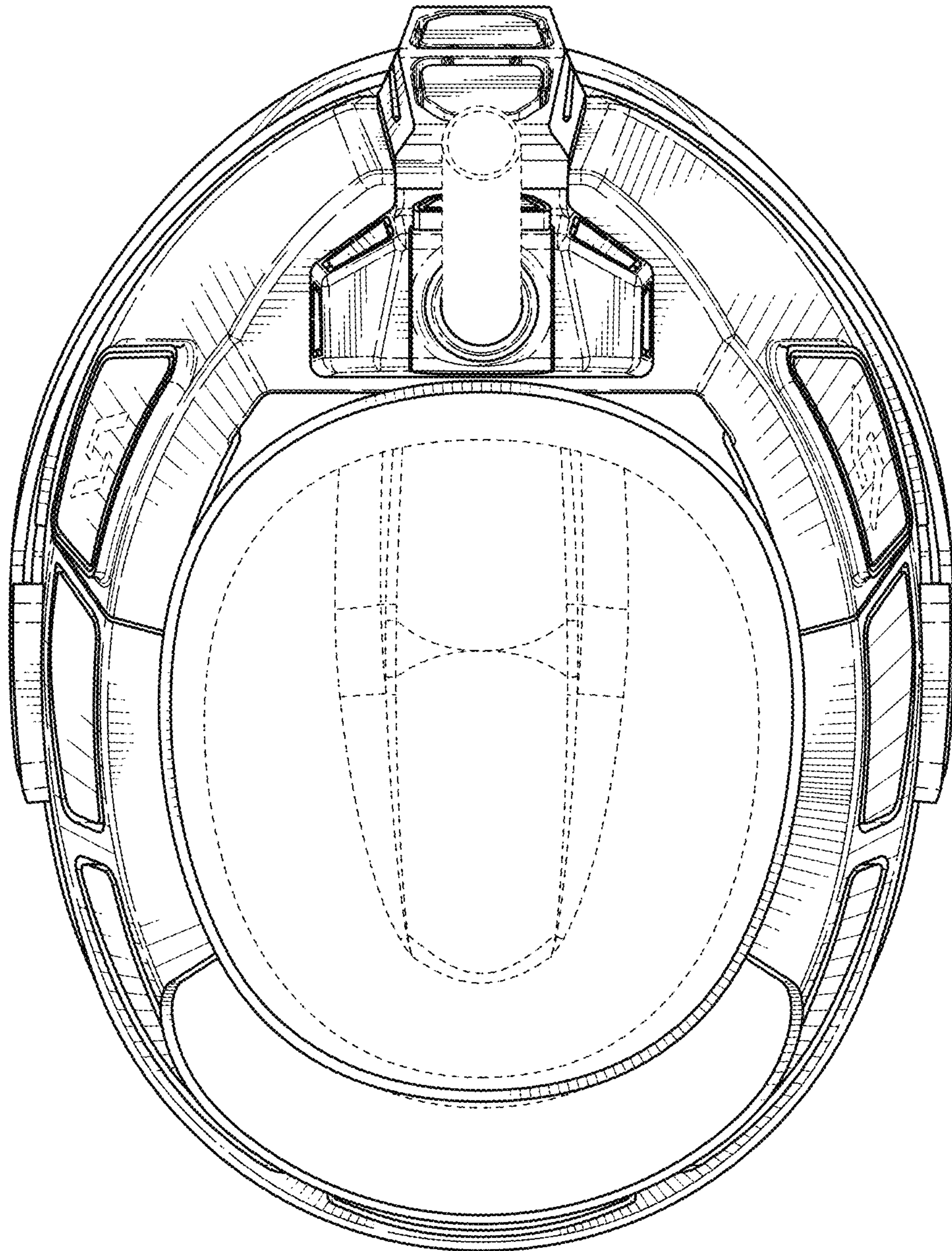

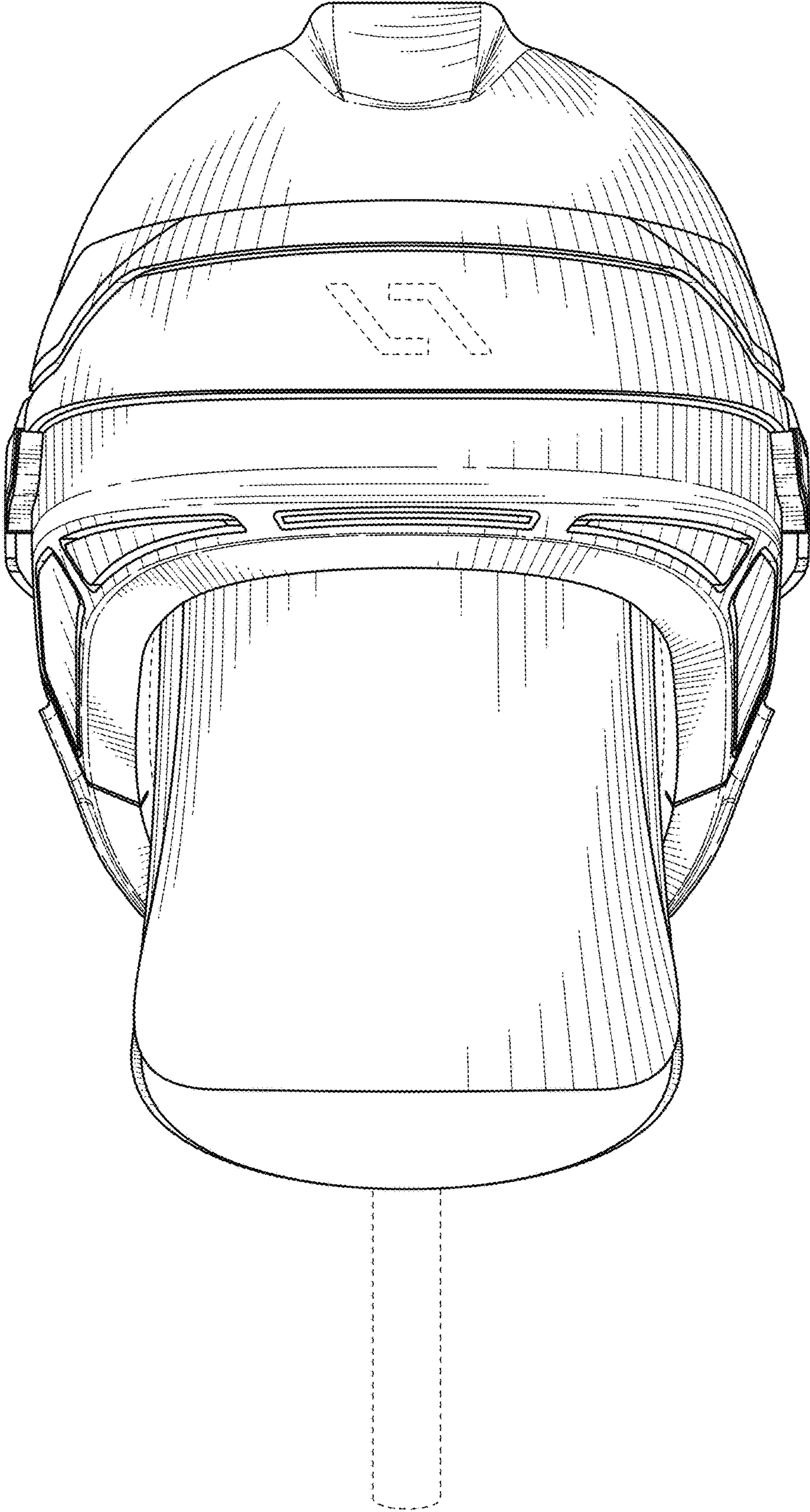

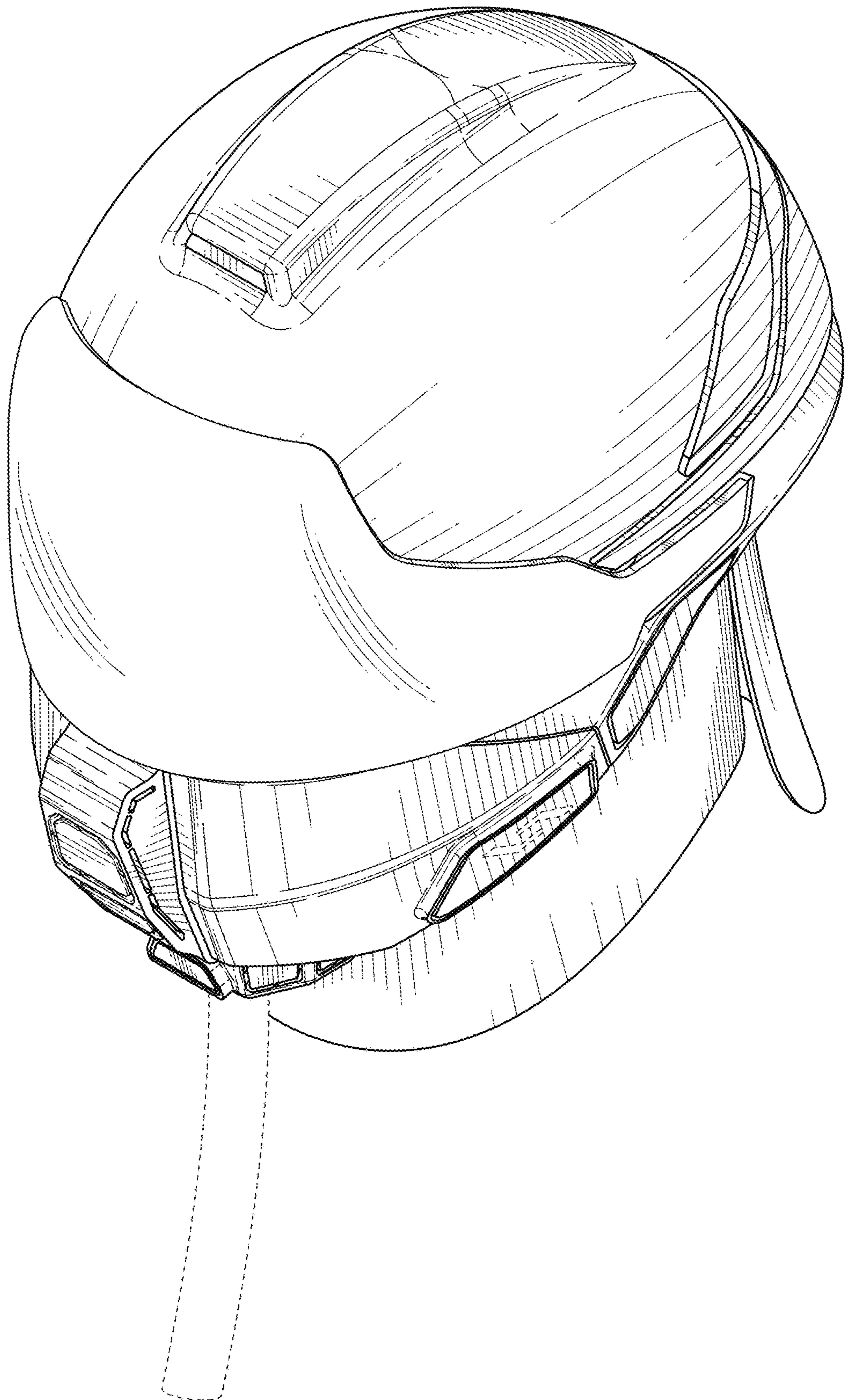

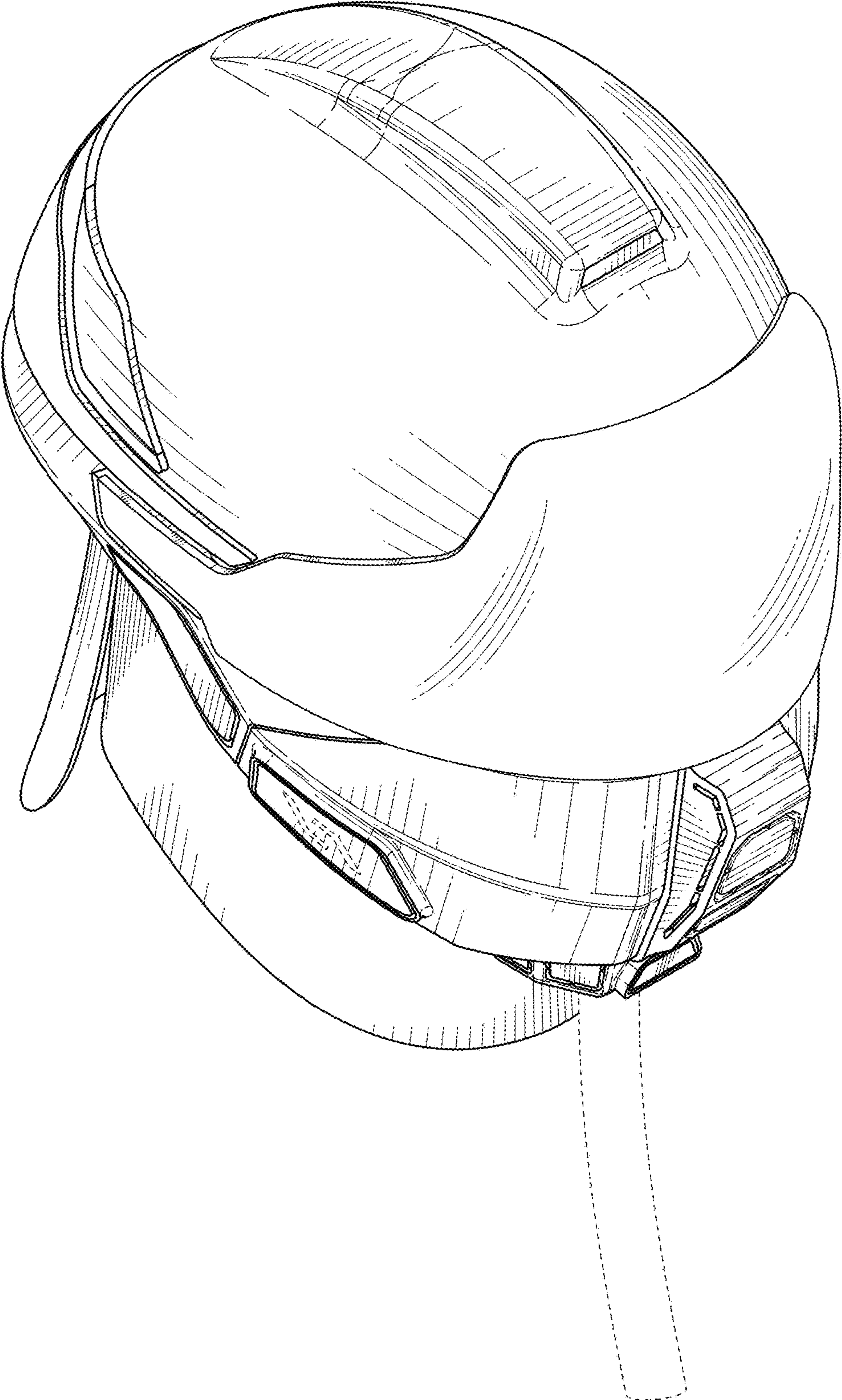

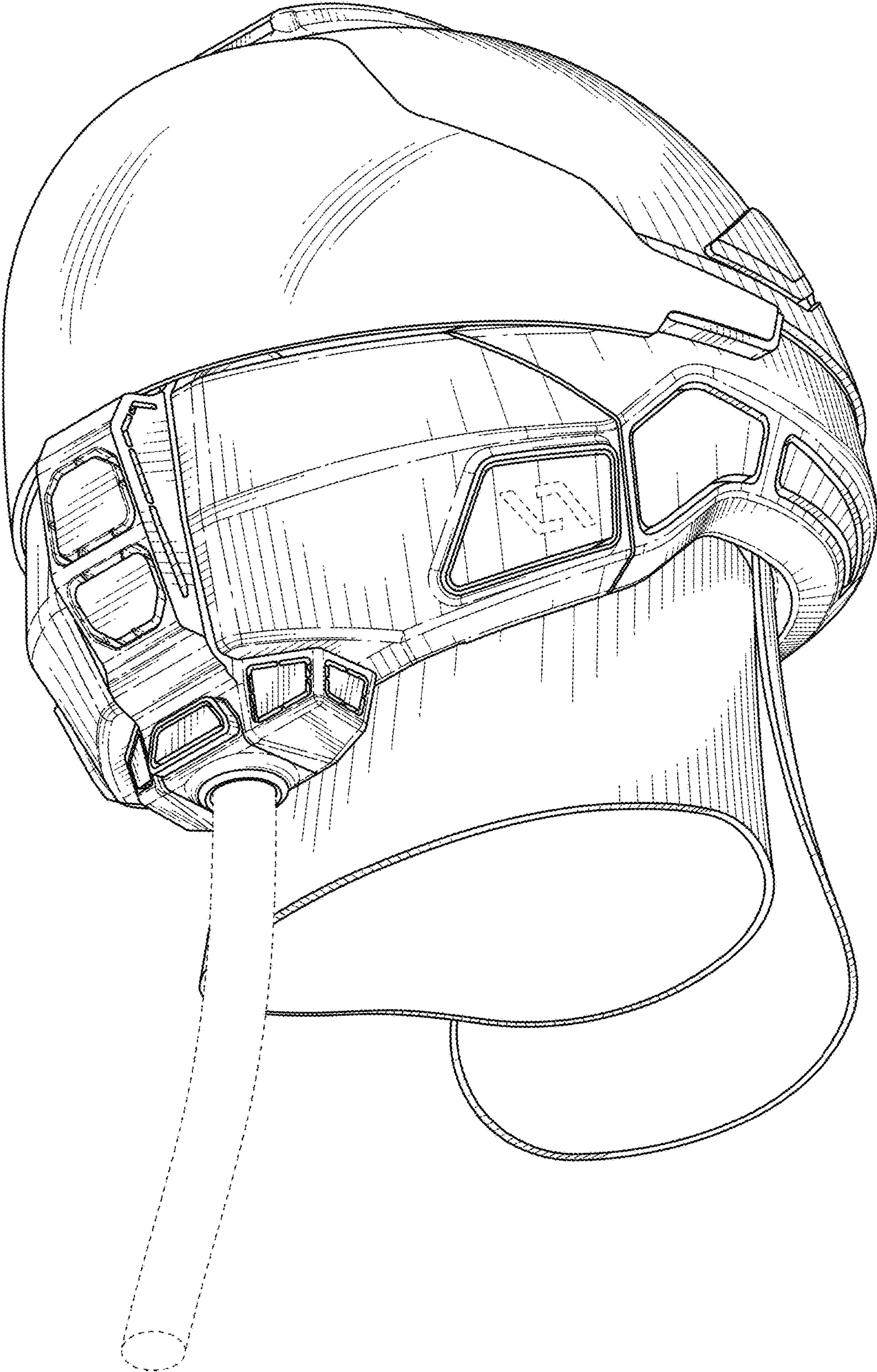

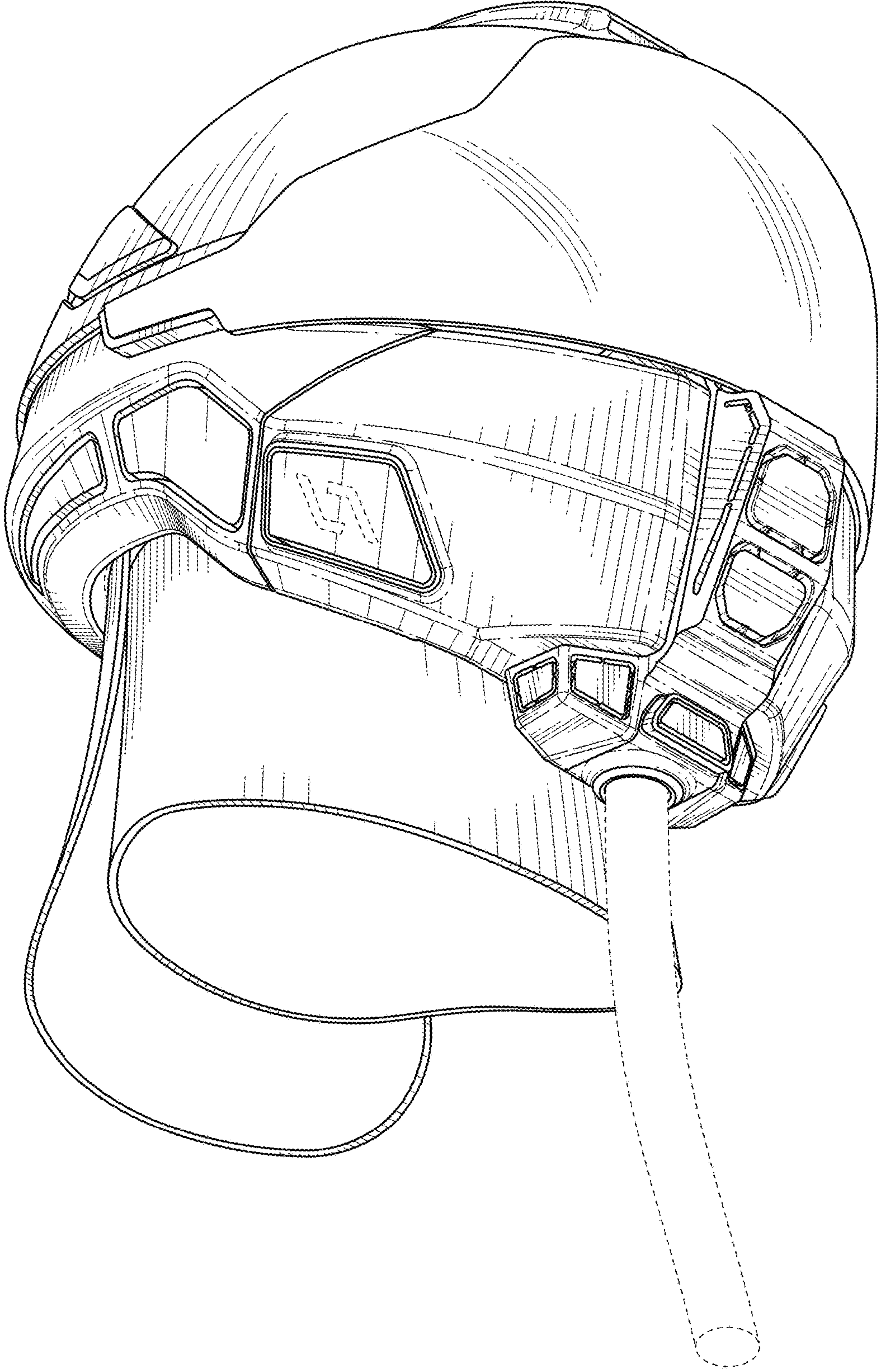

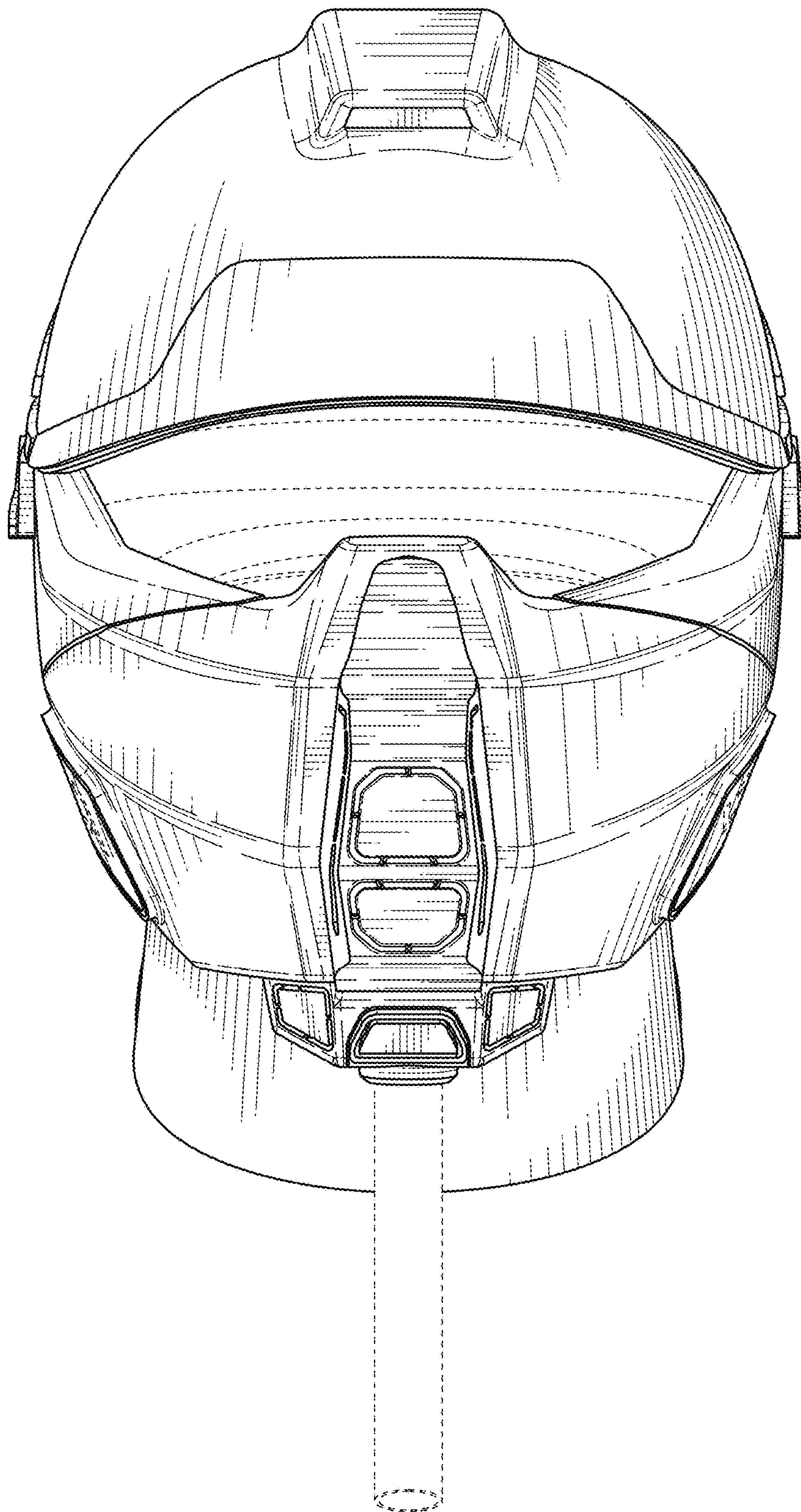

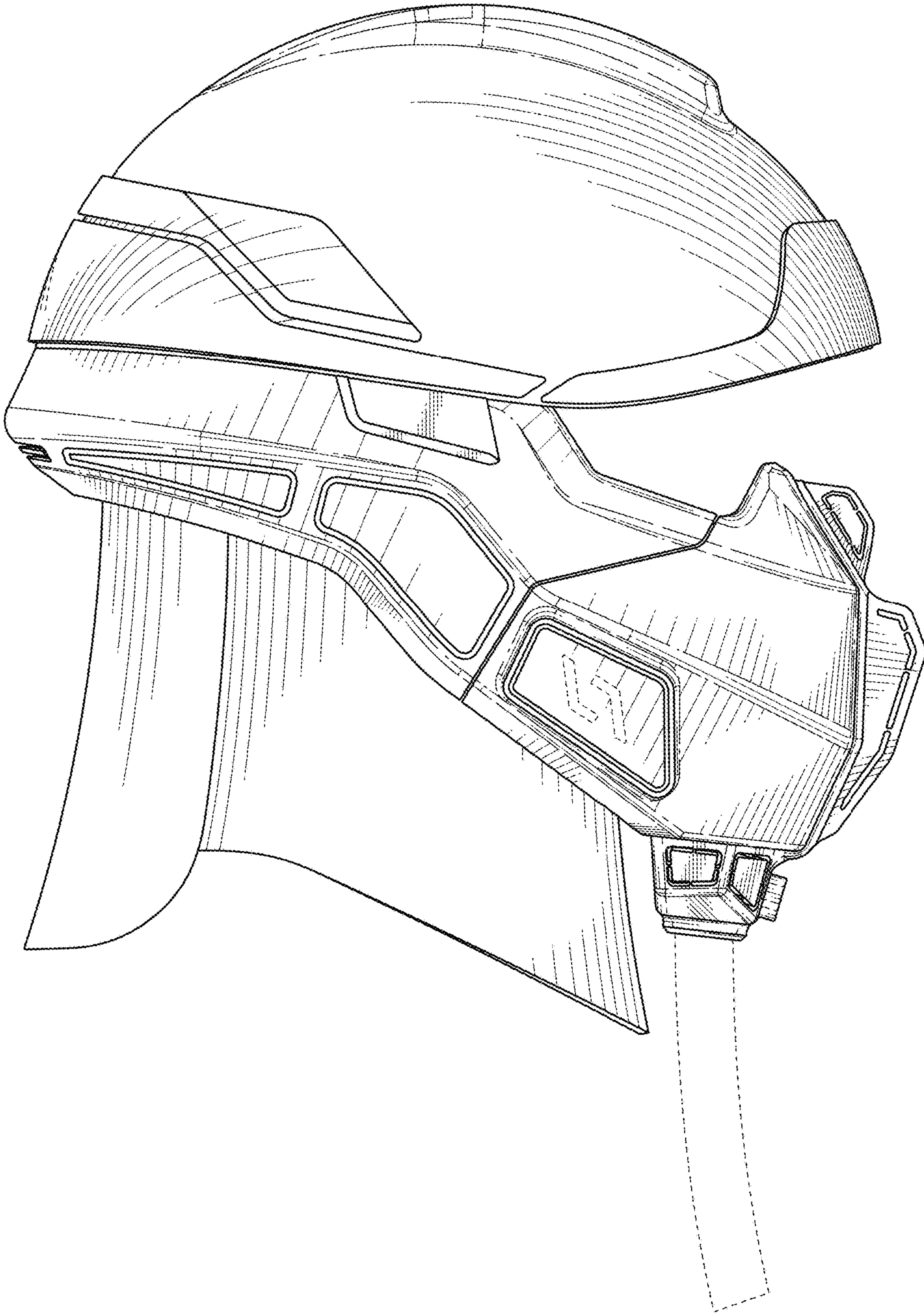

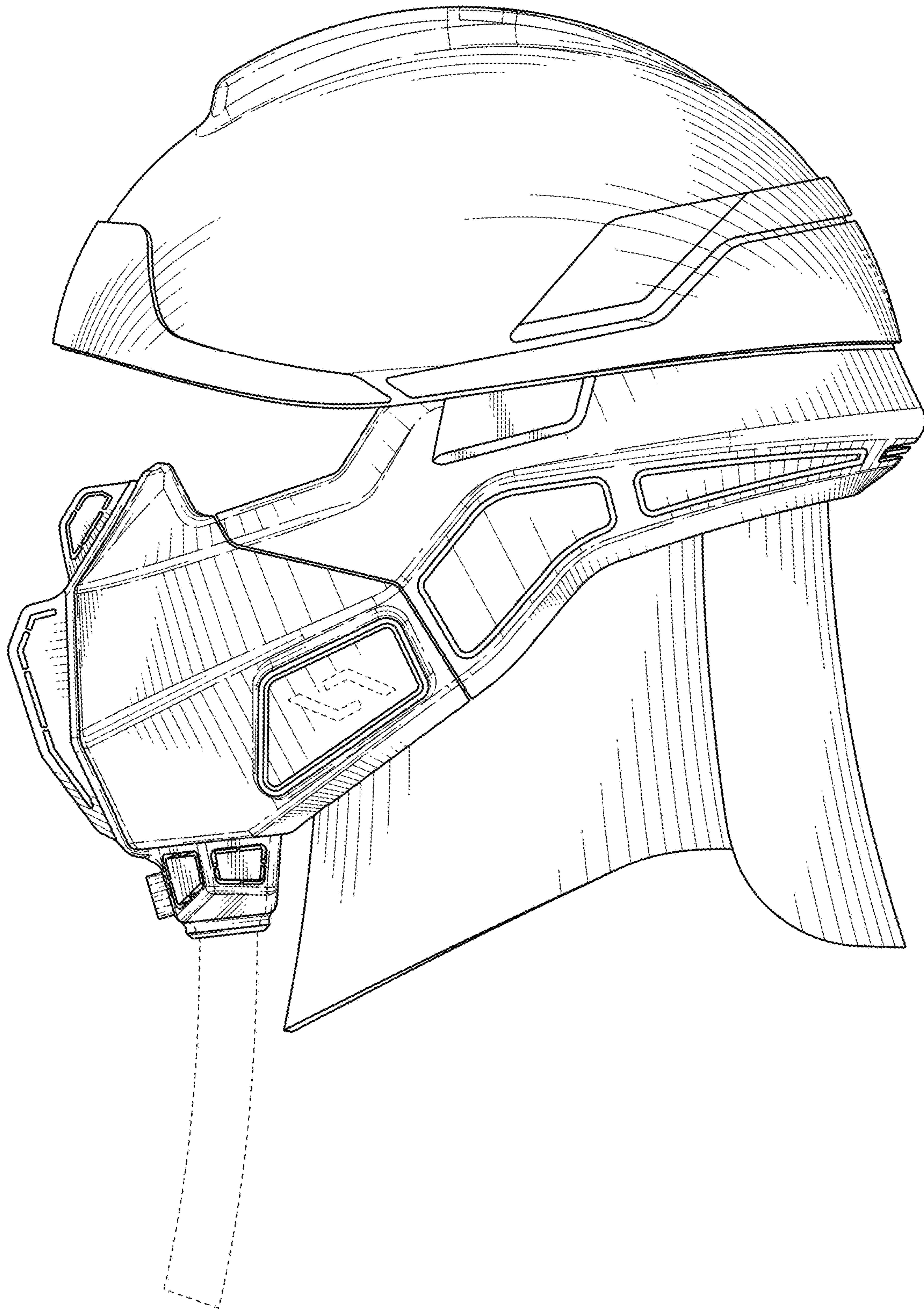

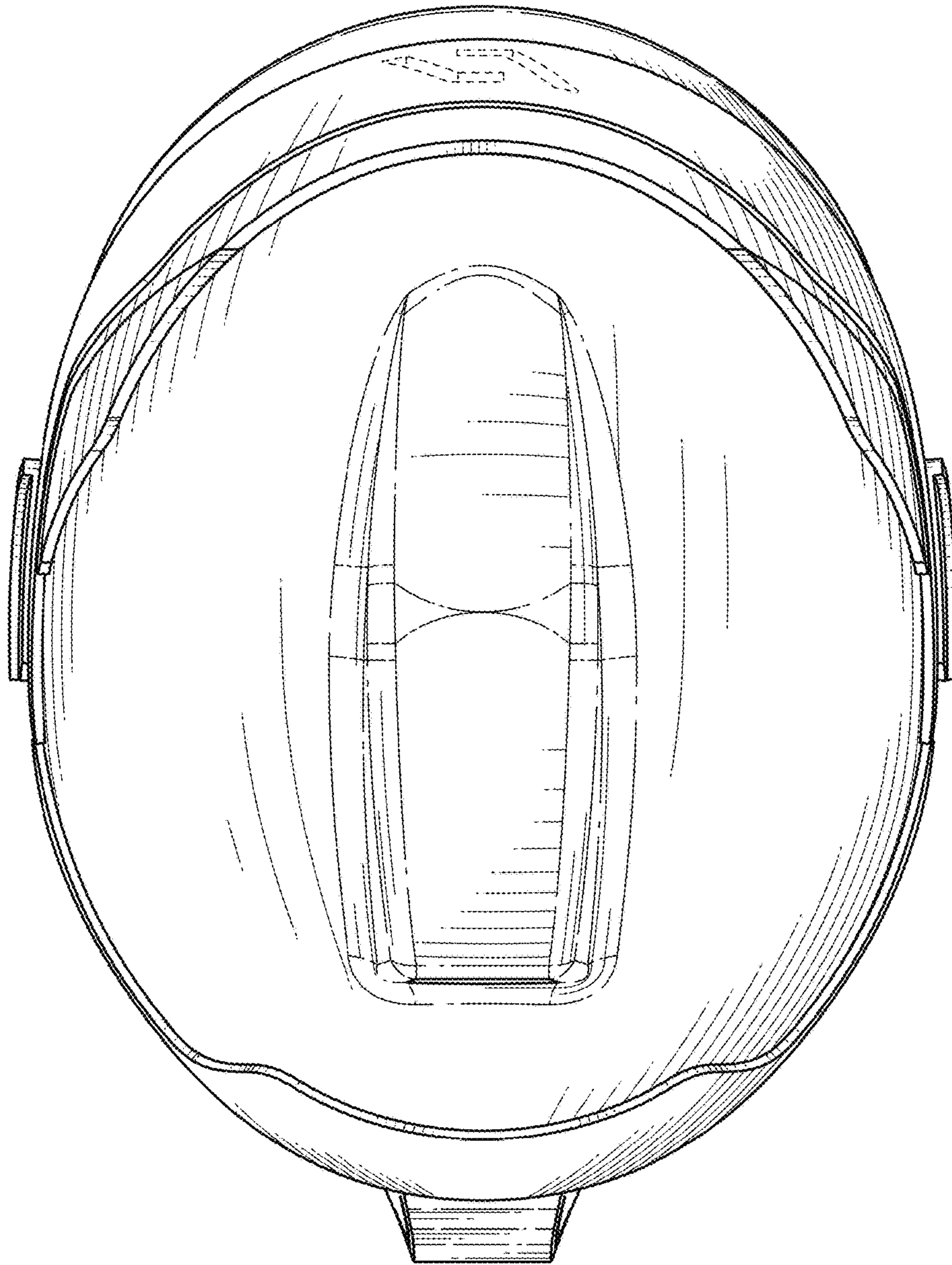

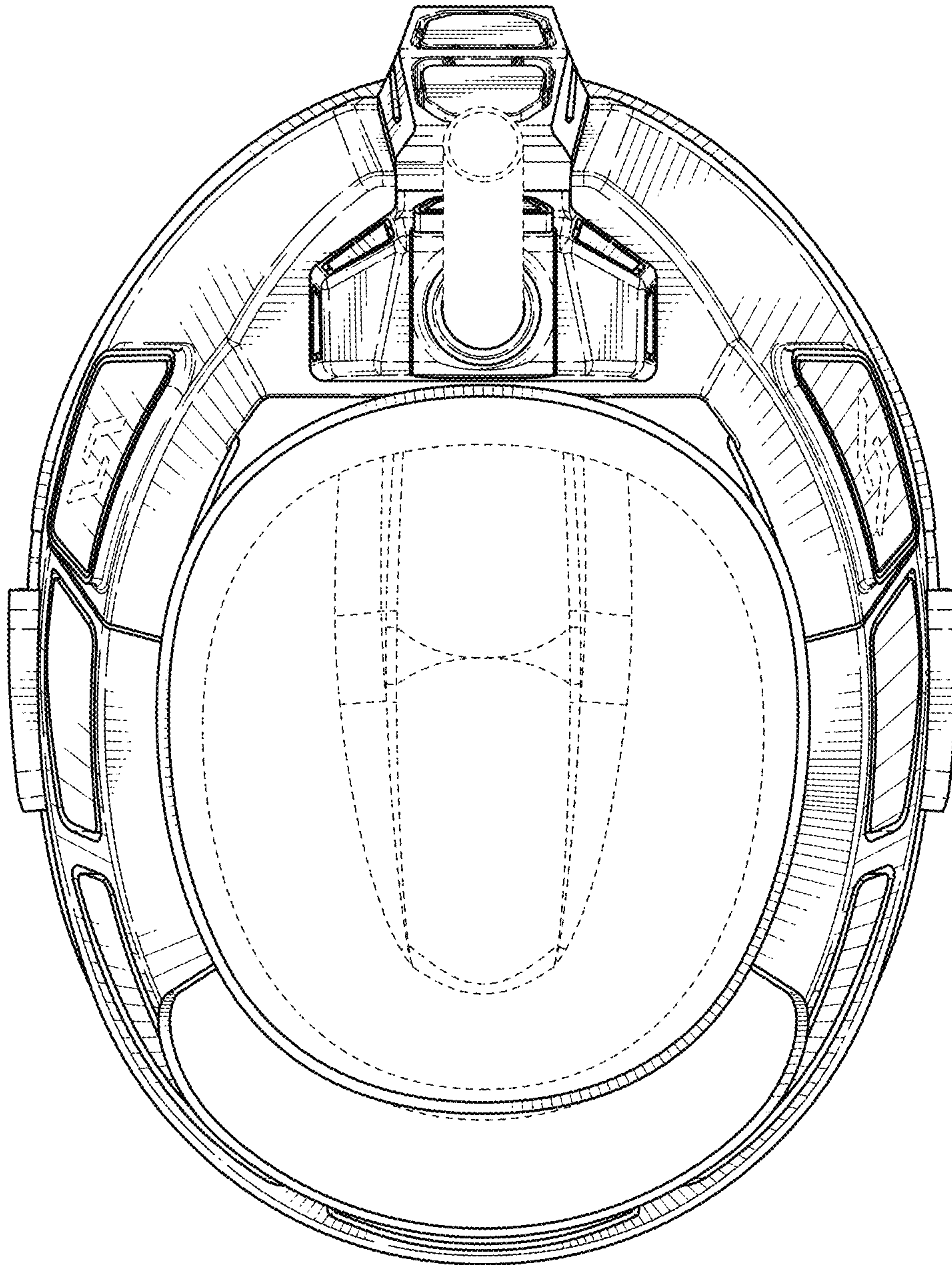

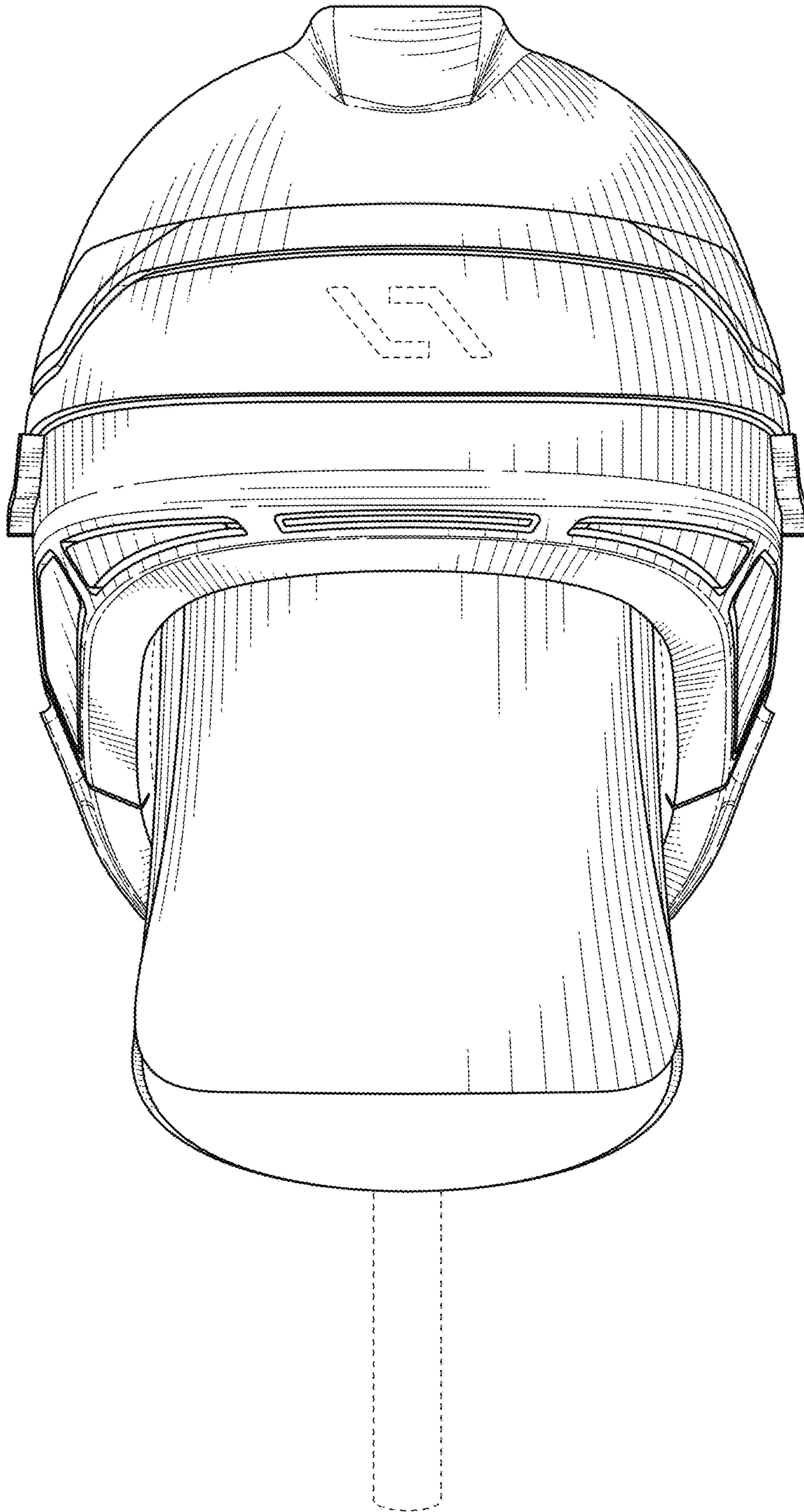

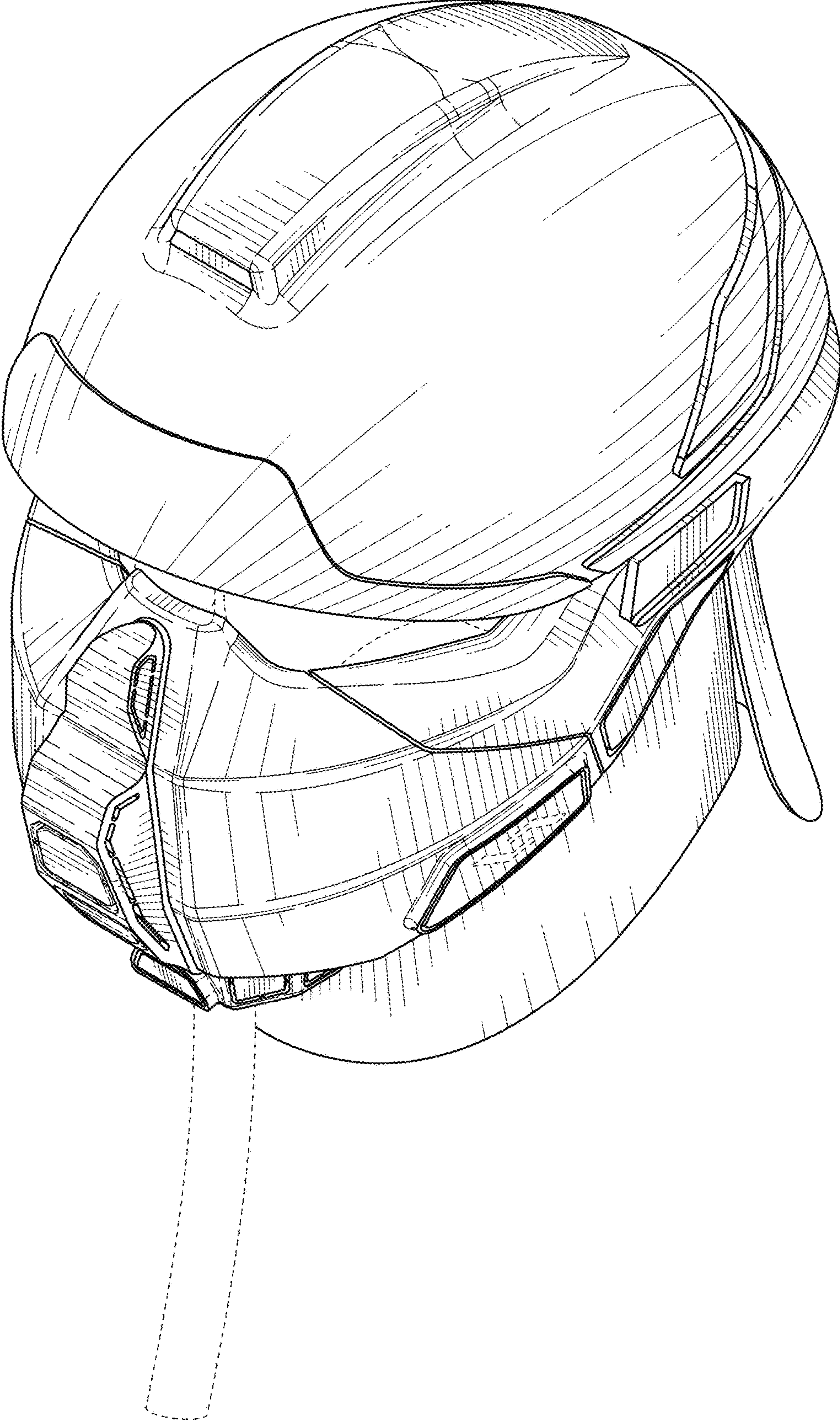

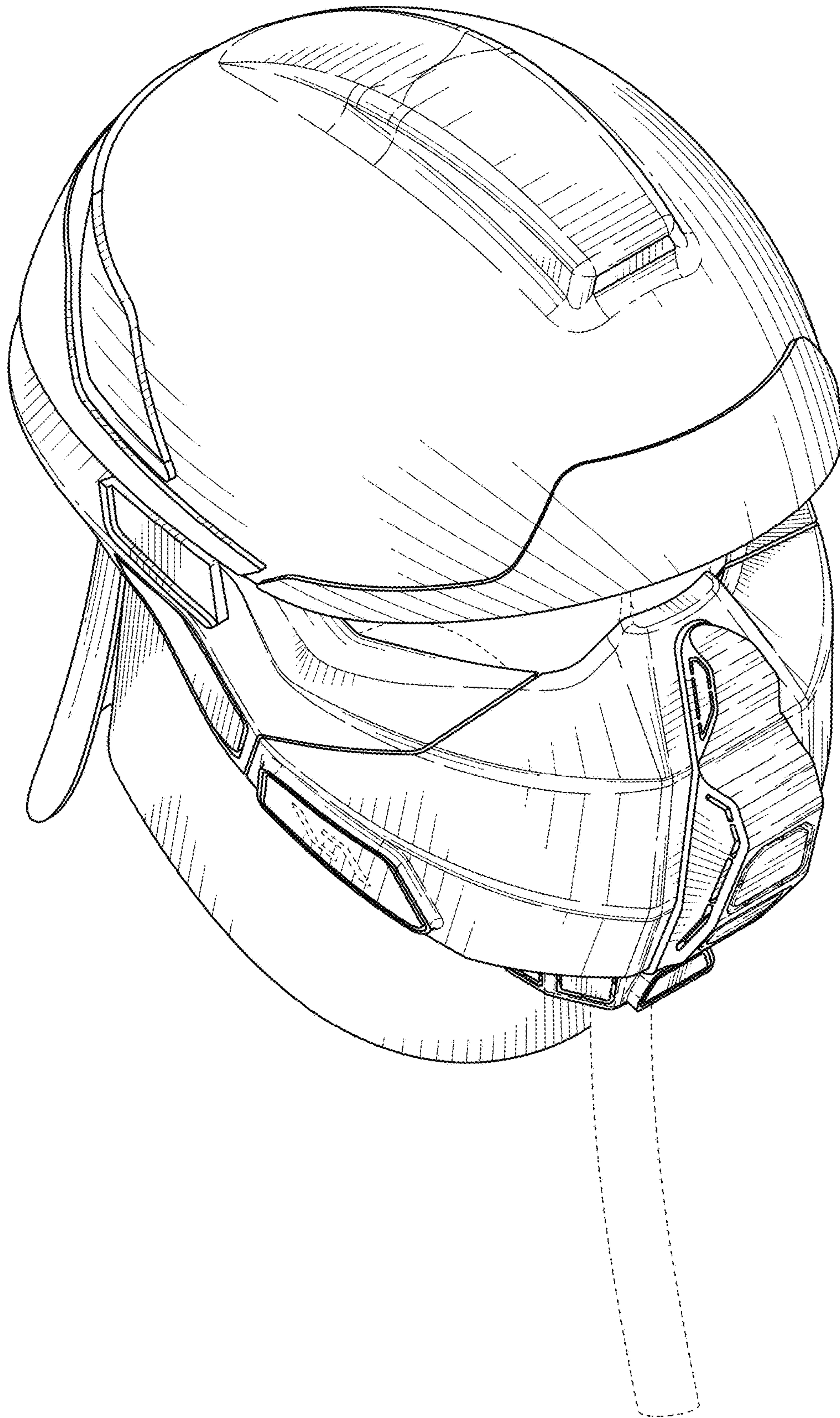

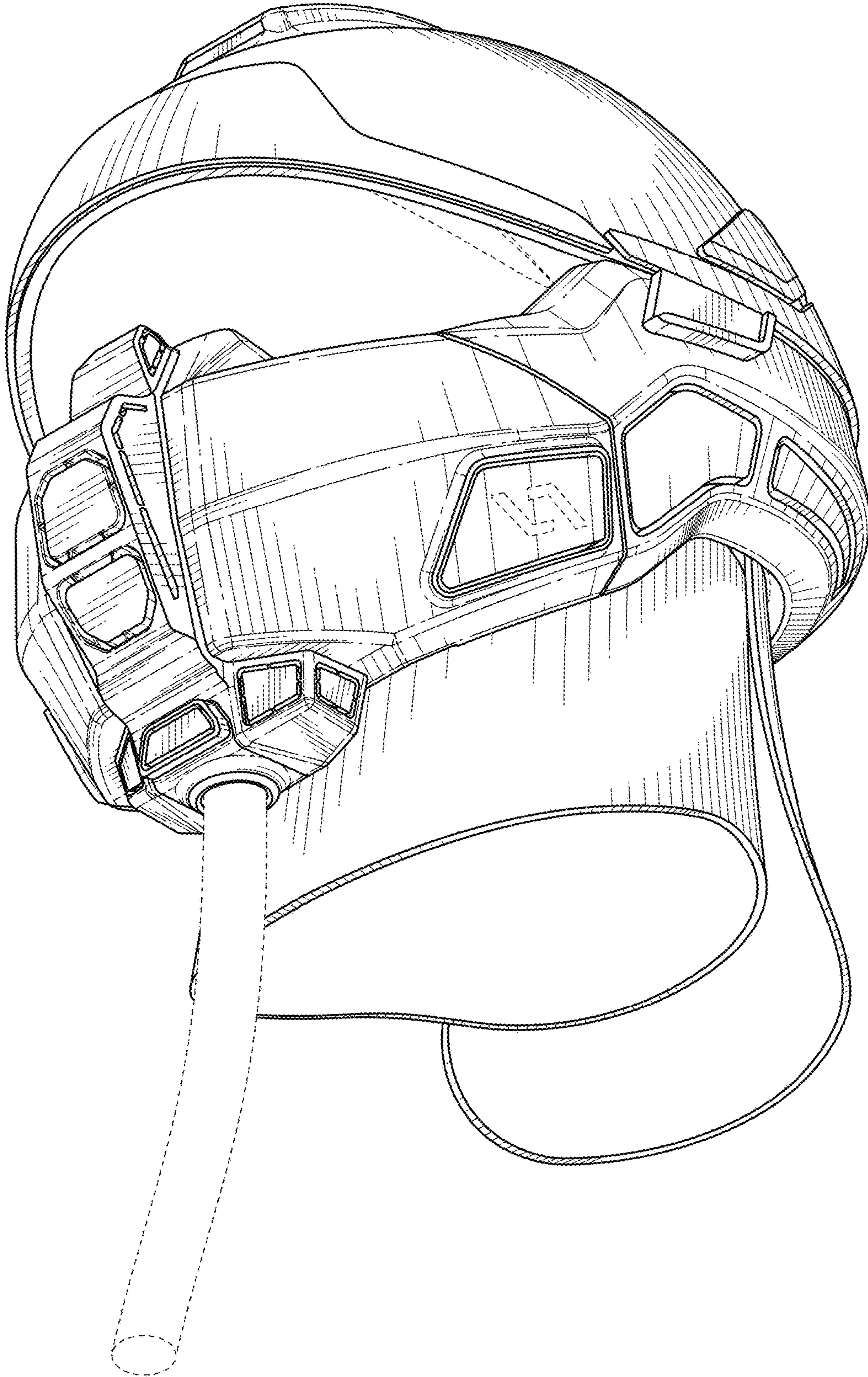

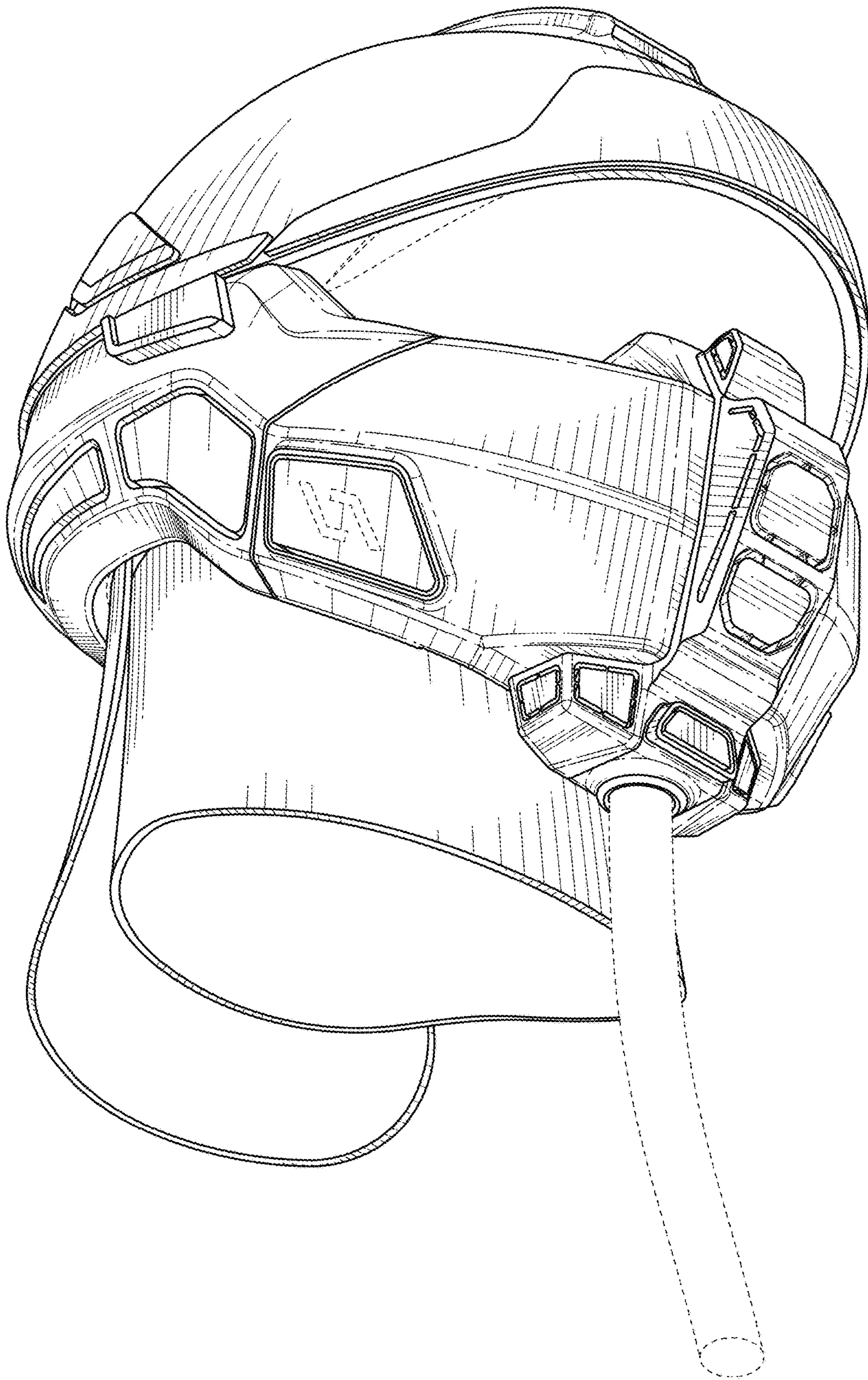
