
#### (57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for headwear, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of headwear, showing our new design, in a first condition of use, the first condition of use having a transparent visor.

- FIG. 2 is a left elevation view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.
- FIG. 3 is a right elevation view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.
- FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.
- FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.
- FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.
- FIG. 7 is a front-right-top perspective view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.
- FIG. 8 is a front-left-top perspective view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.
- FIG. 9 is a front-right-bottom perspective view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.
- FIG. 10 is a front-left-bottom perspective view of the headwear, in the first condition of use.
- FIG. 11 is a front elevation view of headwear, showing our new design, in a second condition of use, the second condition of use having no visor.
- FIG. 12 is a left elevation view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.
- FIG. 13 is a right elevation view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.
- FIG. 14 is a top plan view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.
- FIG. 15 is a bottom plan view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.
- FIG. 16 is a rear elevation view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.
- FIG. 17 is a front-right-top perspective view of the head-wear, in the second condition of use.
- FIG. 18 is a front-left-top perspective view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.
- FIG. 19 is a front-right-bottom perspective view of the headwear, in the second condition of use; and,
- FIG. 20 is a front-left-bottom perspective view of the headwear, in the second condition of use.
- Subject matter shown in broken lines is environmental and forms no part of the claimed design. For example, the interior portions of the bottom plan views in FIGS. 5 and 15 (Continued)



are shown in broken lines and form no part of the claimed design. The shade lines show surface contour and not surface ornamentation.








































