(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a garment, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front left perspective view of a garment showing my new design in an in-use configuration;

FIG. 2 is a front right perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof;


FIG. 7 is an enlarged view of the right sleeve of the garment of FIG. 1 showing the shaded area in isolation from the environment;

FIG. 8 is an enlarged view of the left sleeve of the garment of FIG. 2 showing the shaded area in isolation from the environment; and,

FIG. 9 is an alternative perspective view of the left sleeve showing FIG. 8.

The broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded area represent unclaimed boundaries of the design. The unshaded regions, demarcated by broken lines, represent unclaimed portions of the garment and form no part of the claimed design. The broken lines showing the remainder of the garment depict environment only and form no part of the claimed design.


















