The diagonal shading represents denim and the stippled shading represents a stretch fabric.

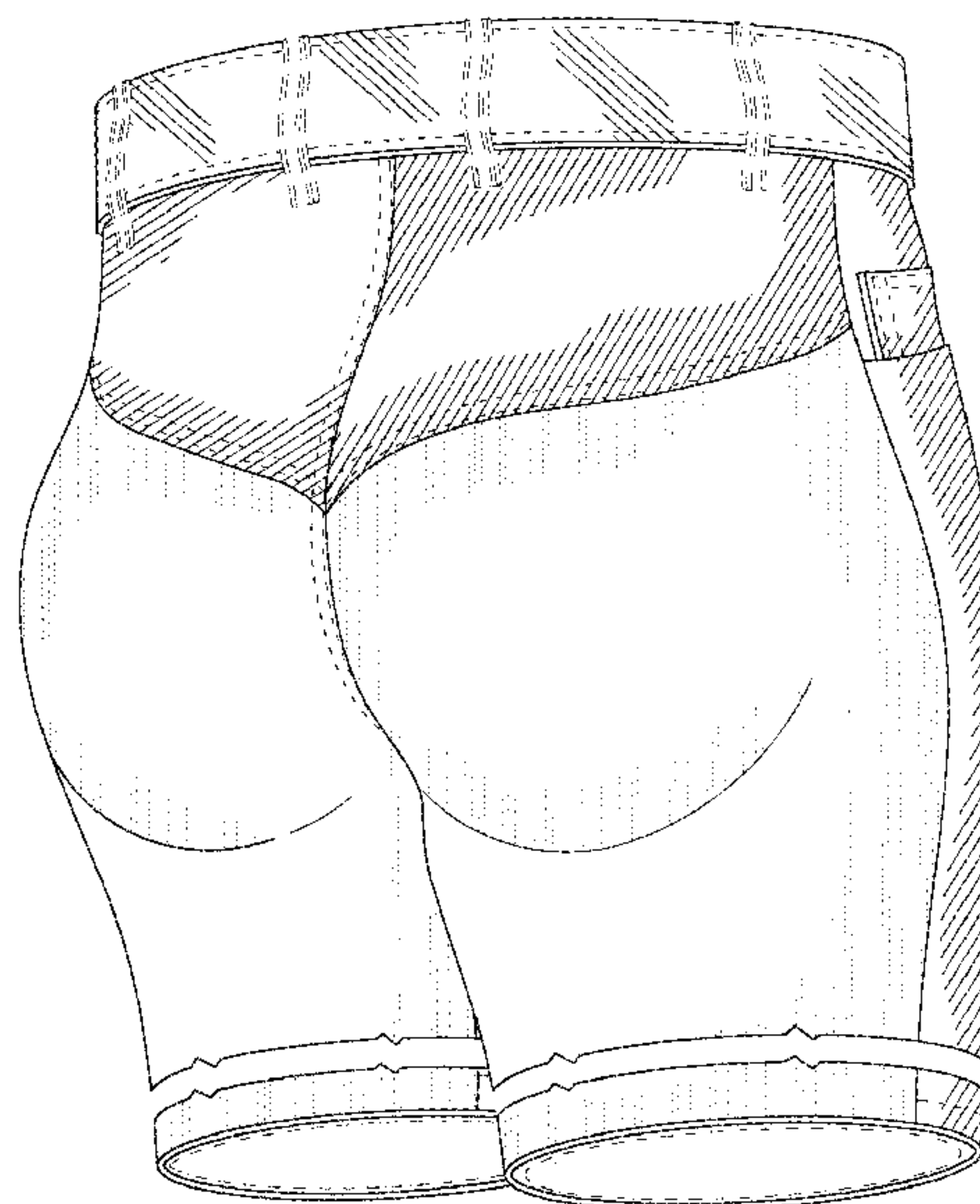
The short dashed lines represent portions of the bifurcated garment that form no part of the claimed design.

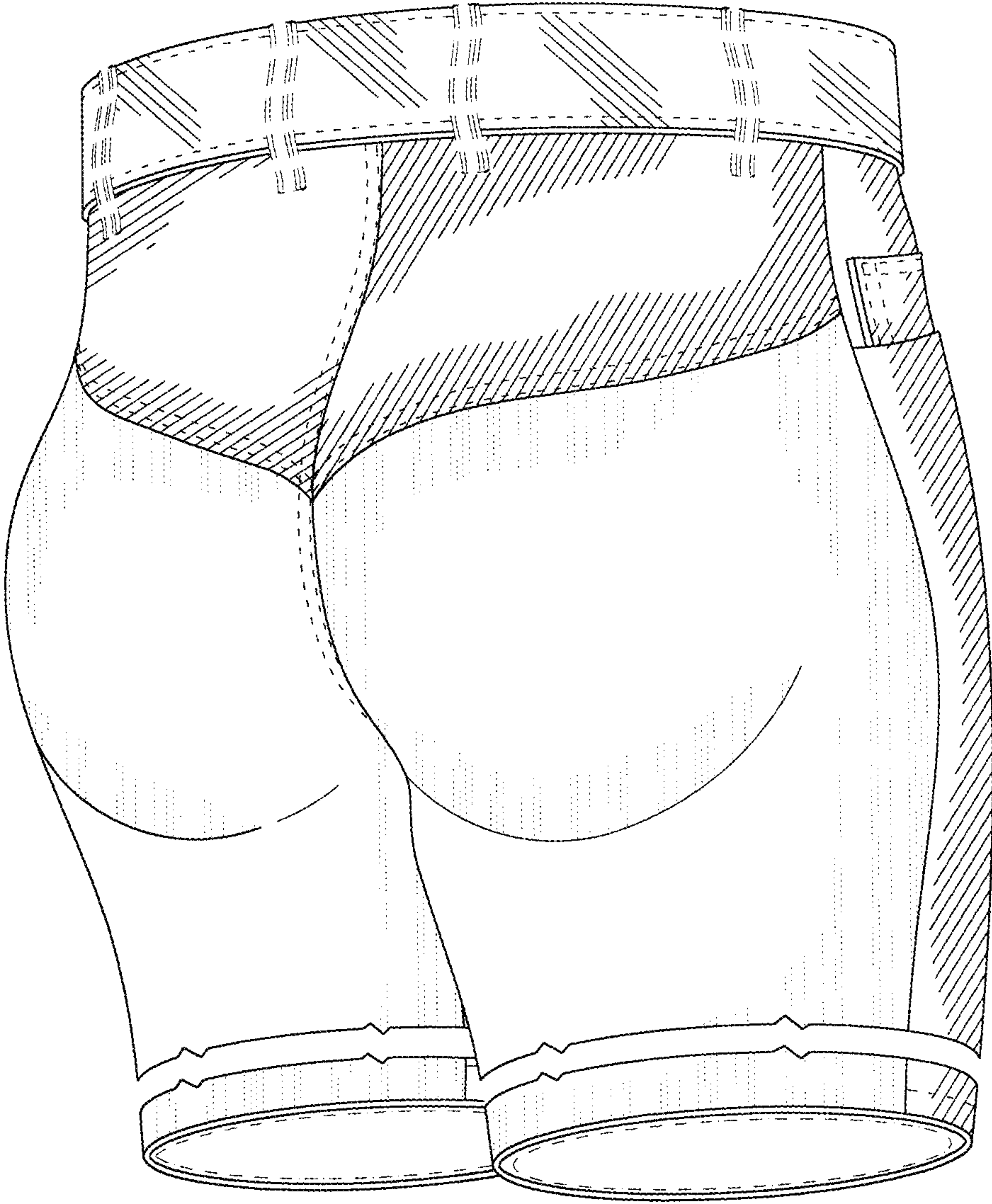

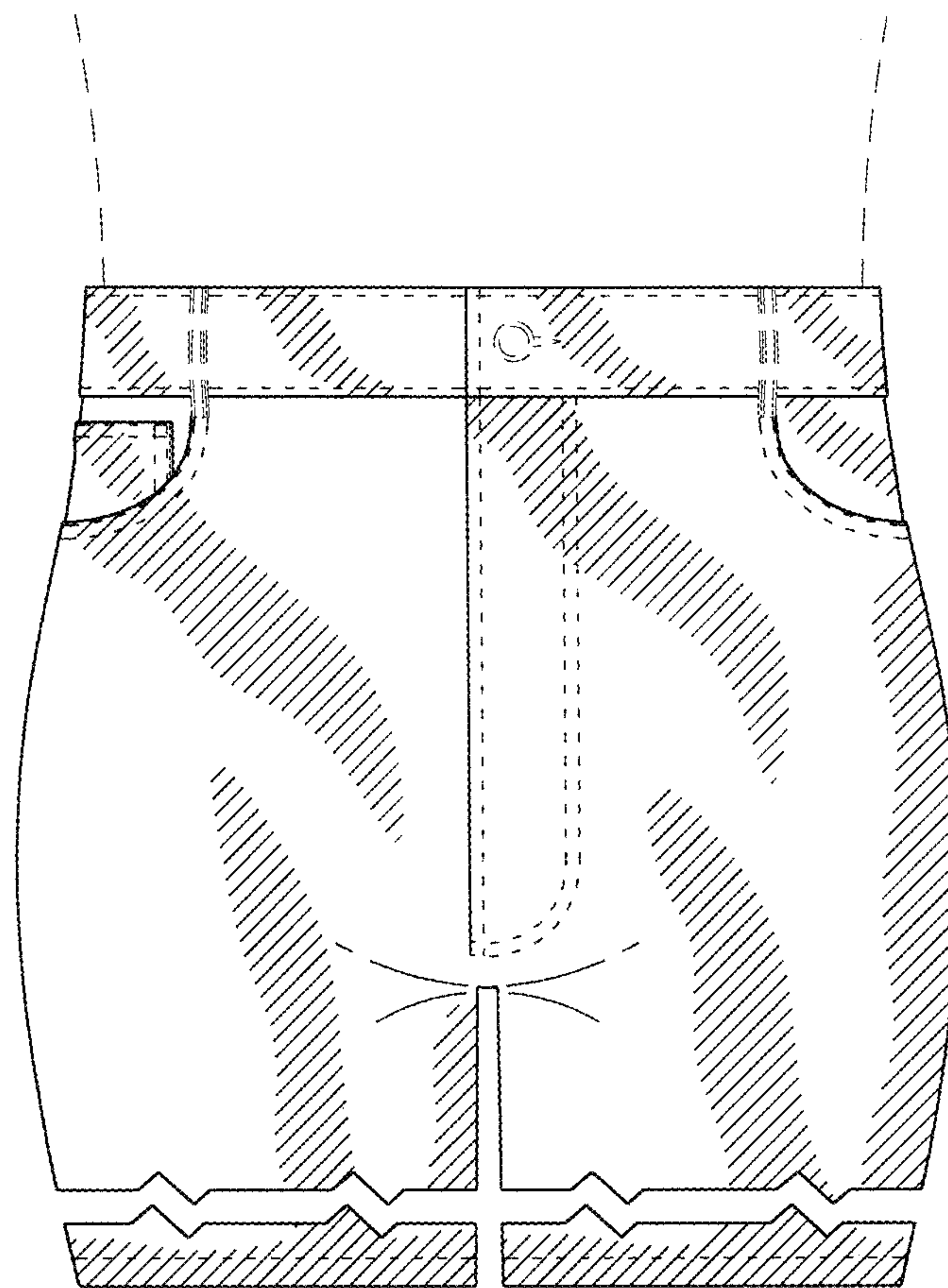

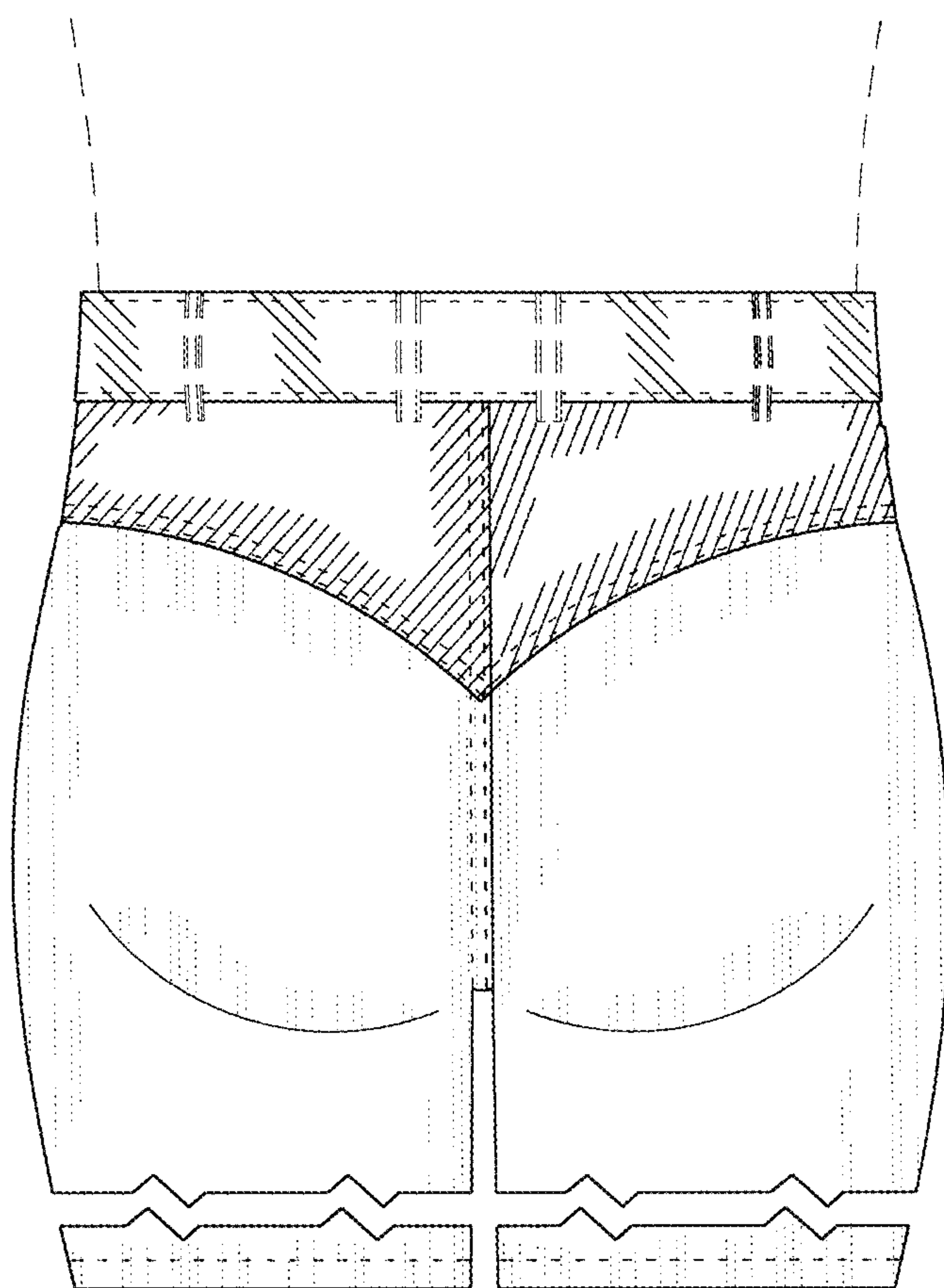

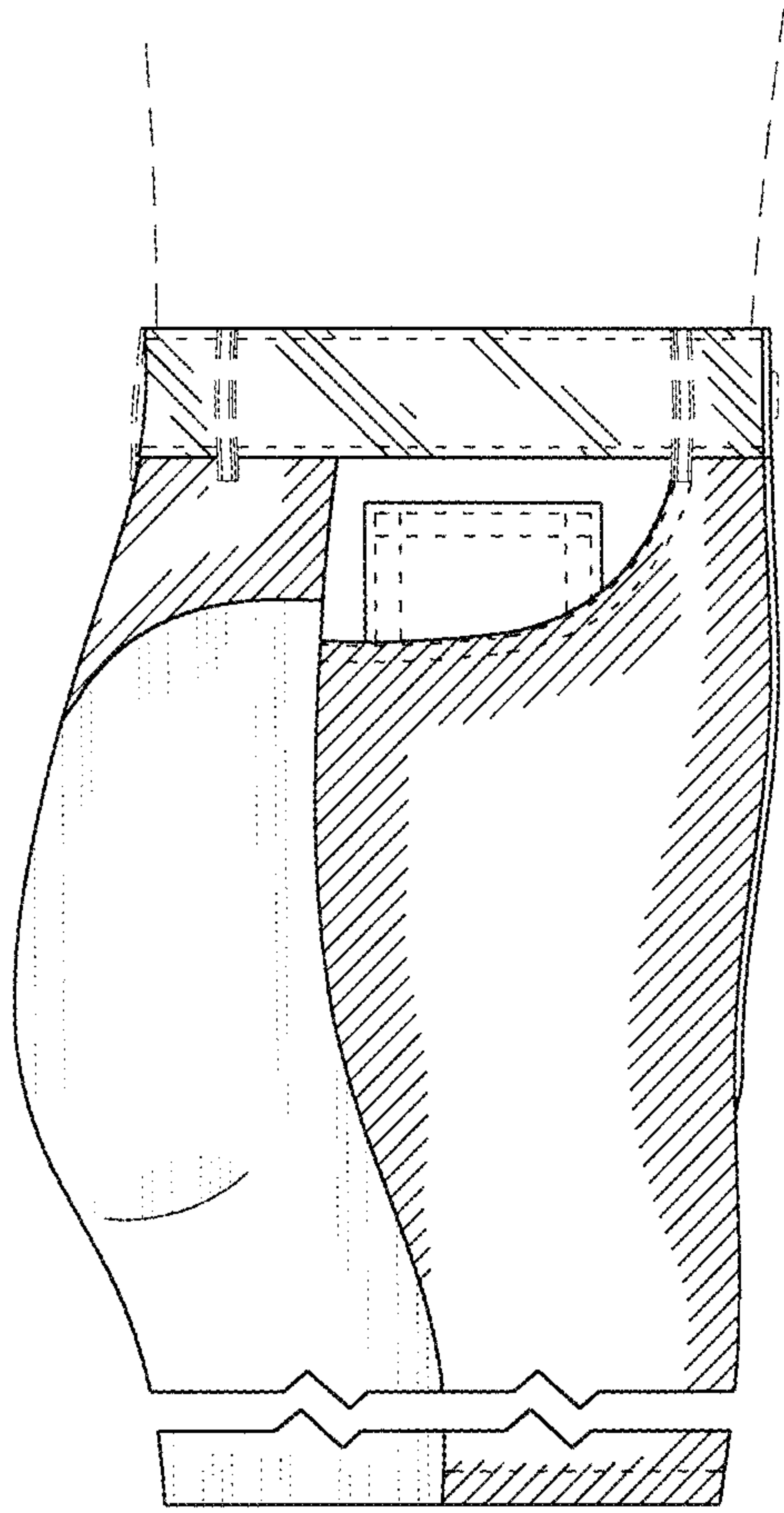

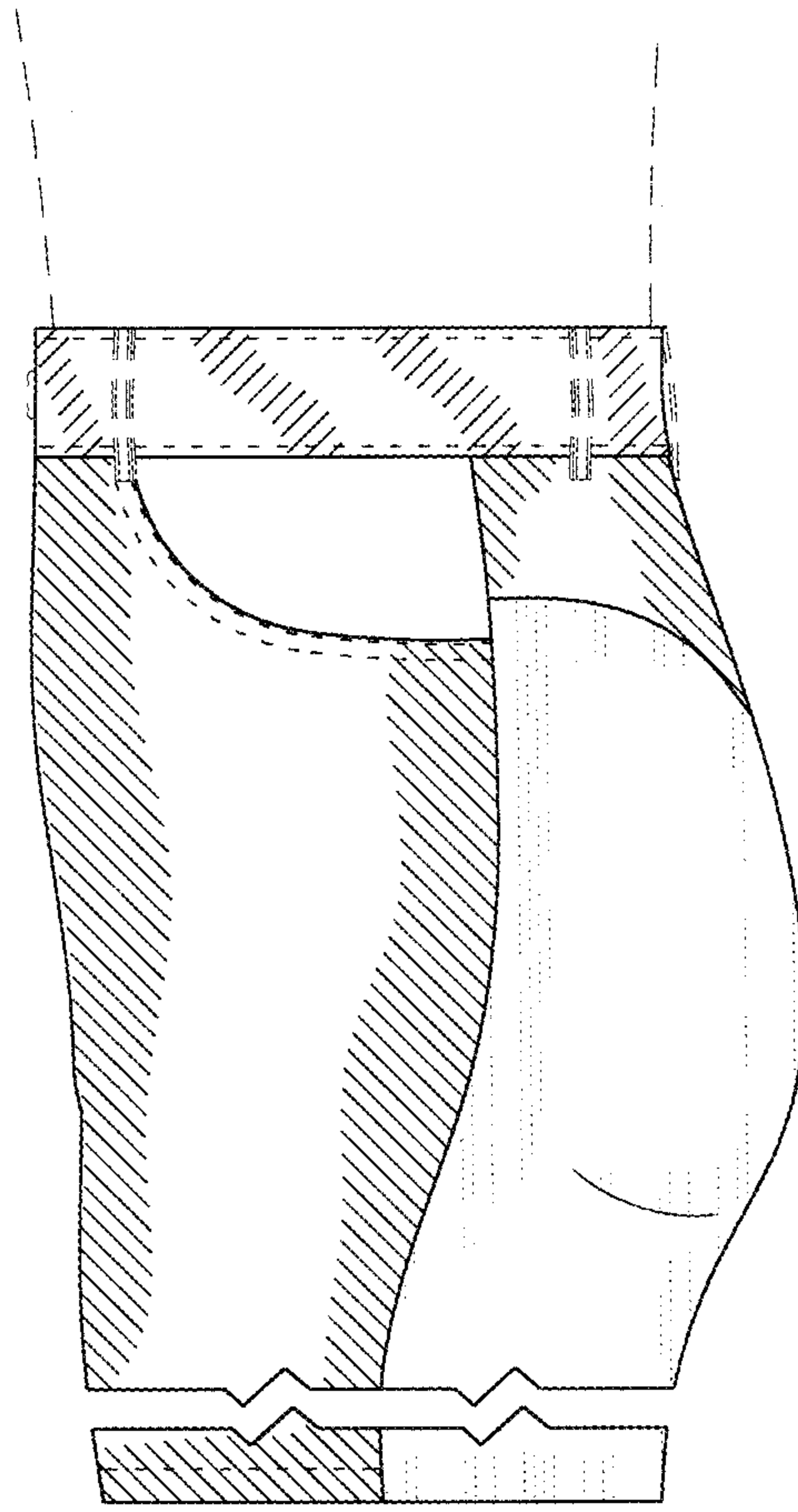

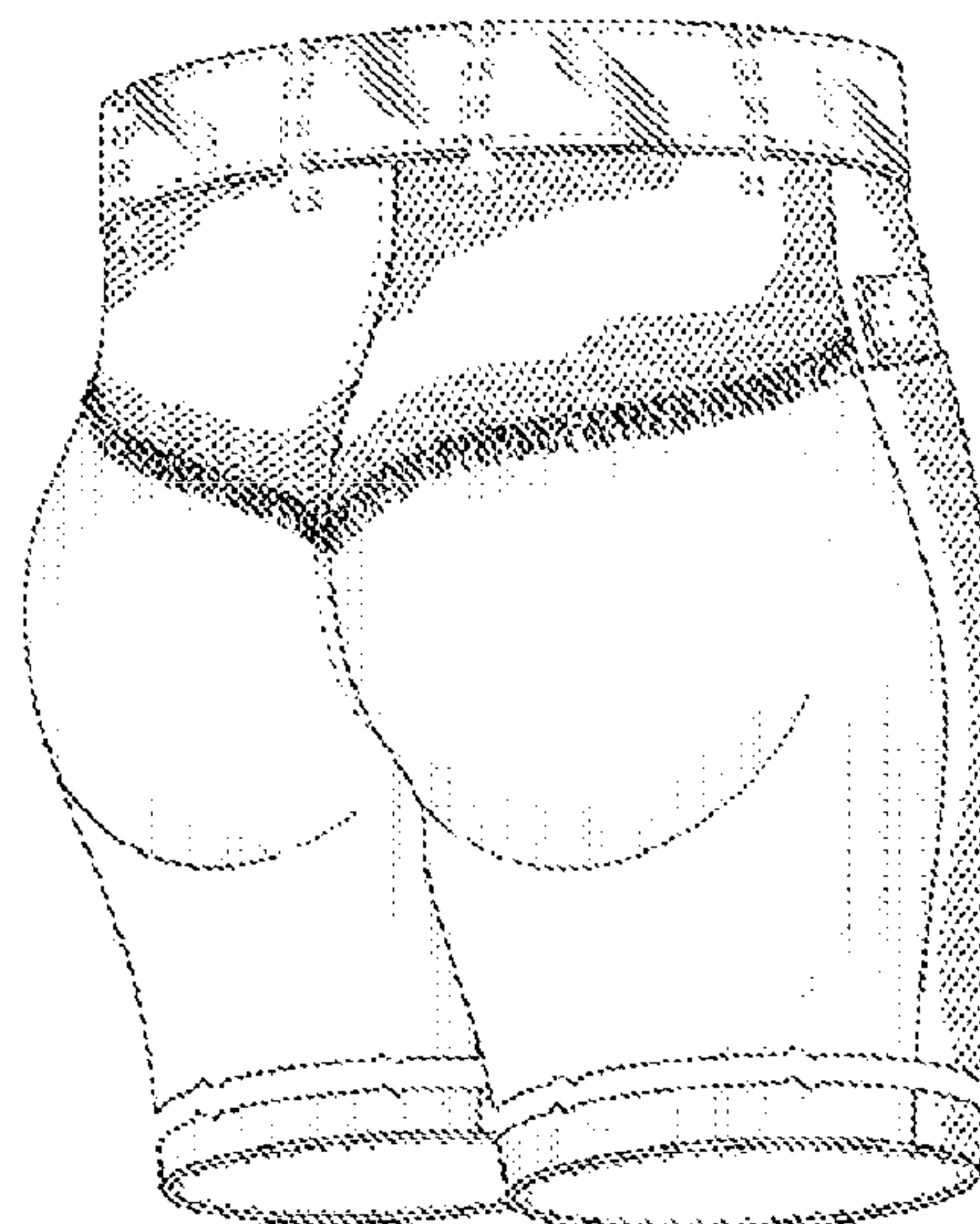
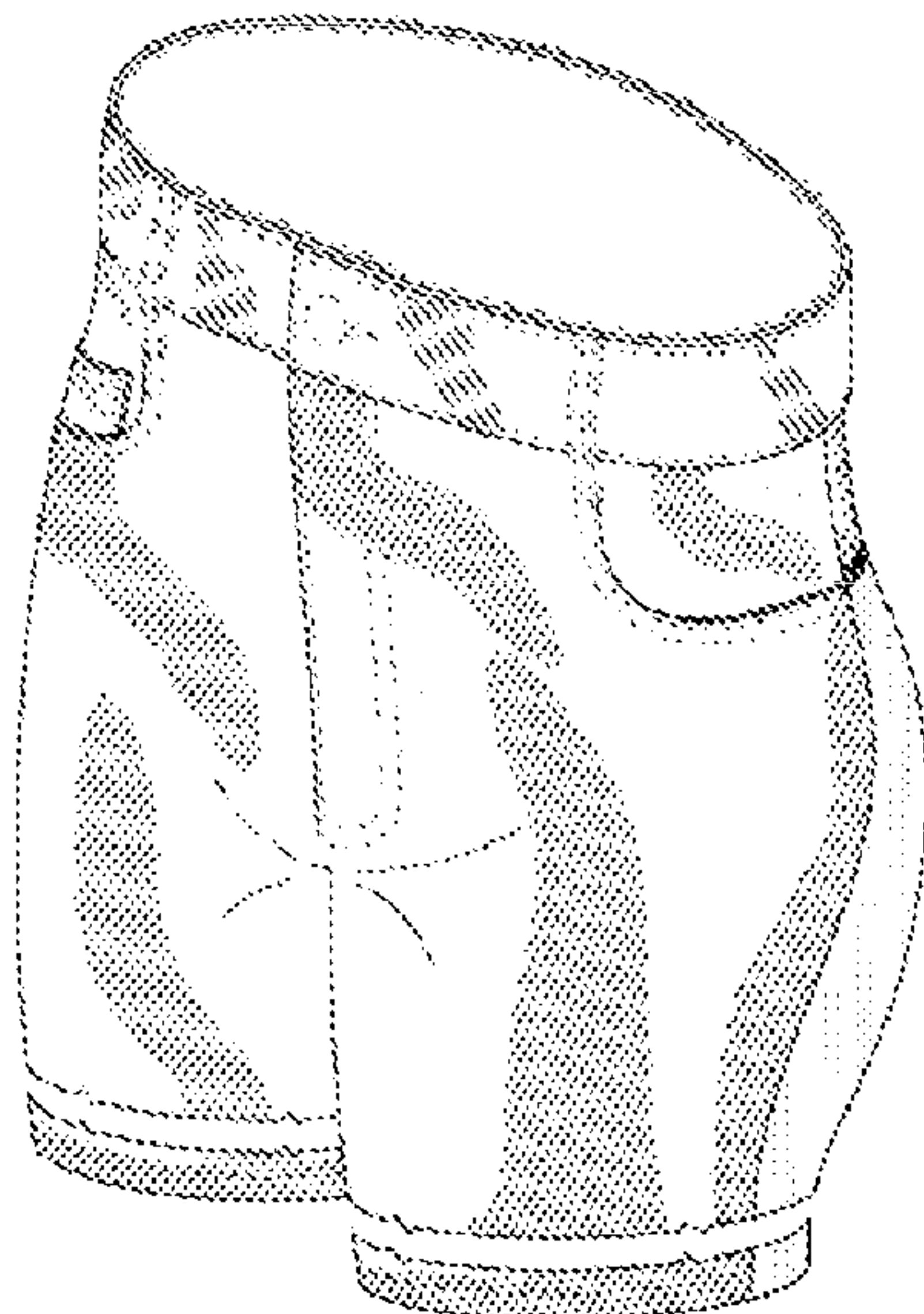

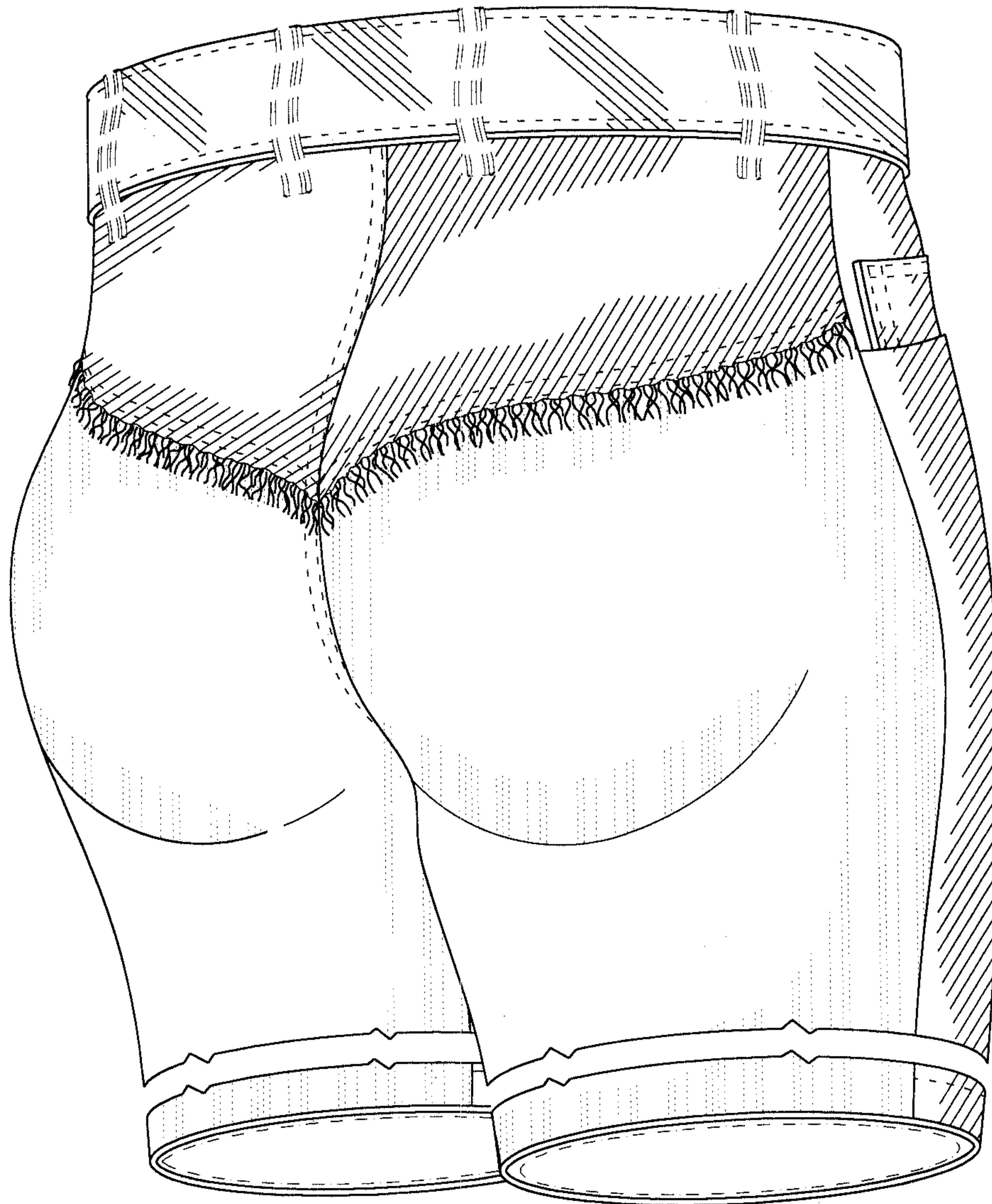

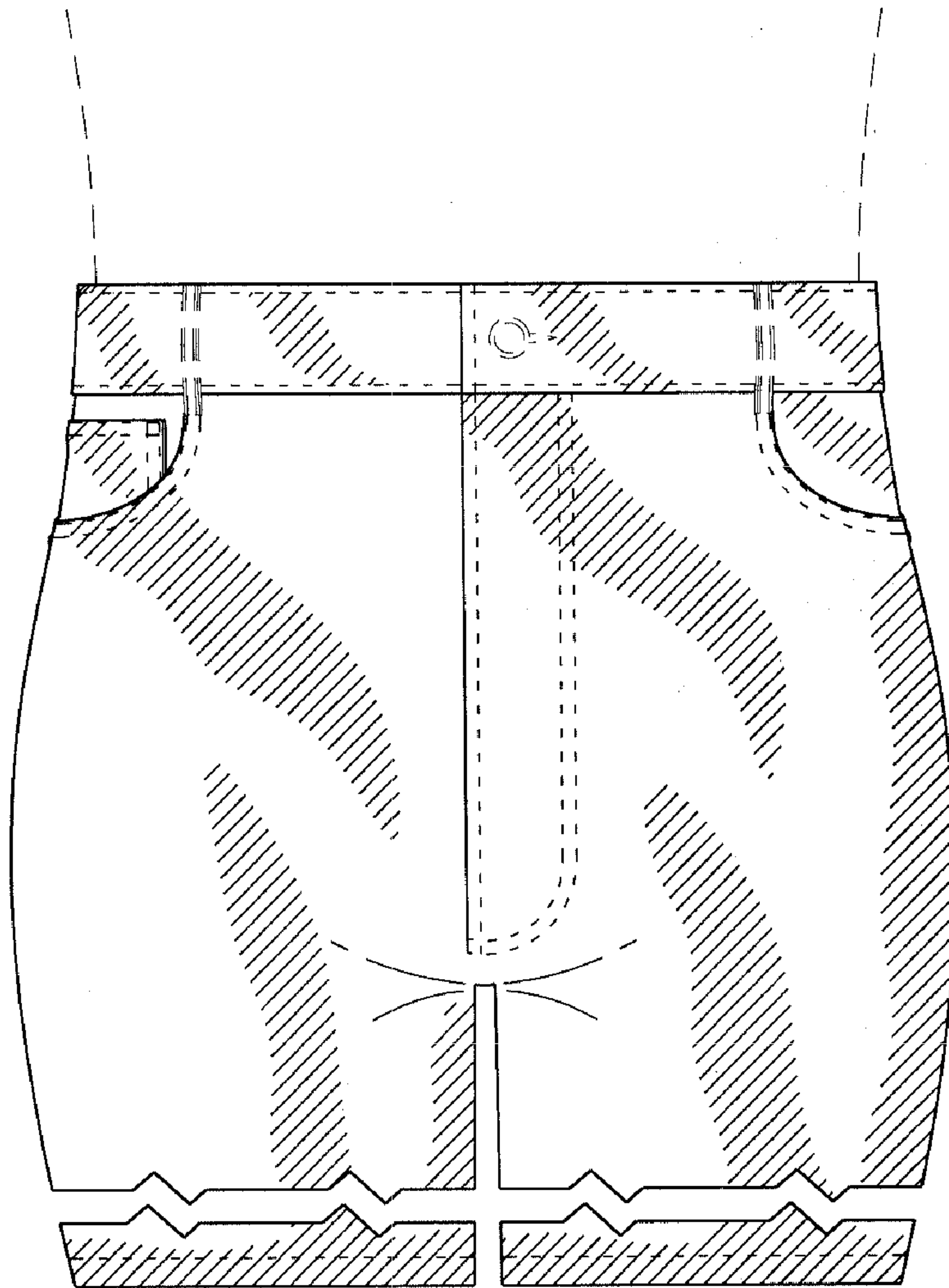

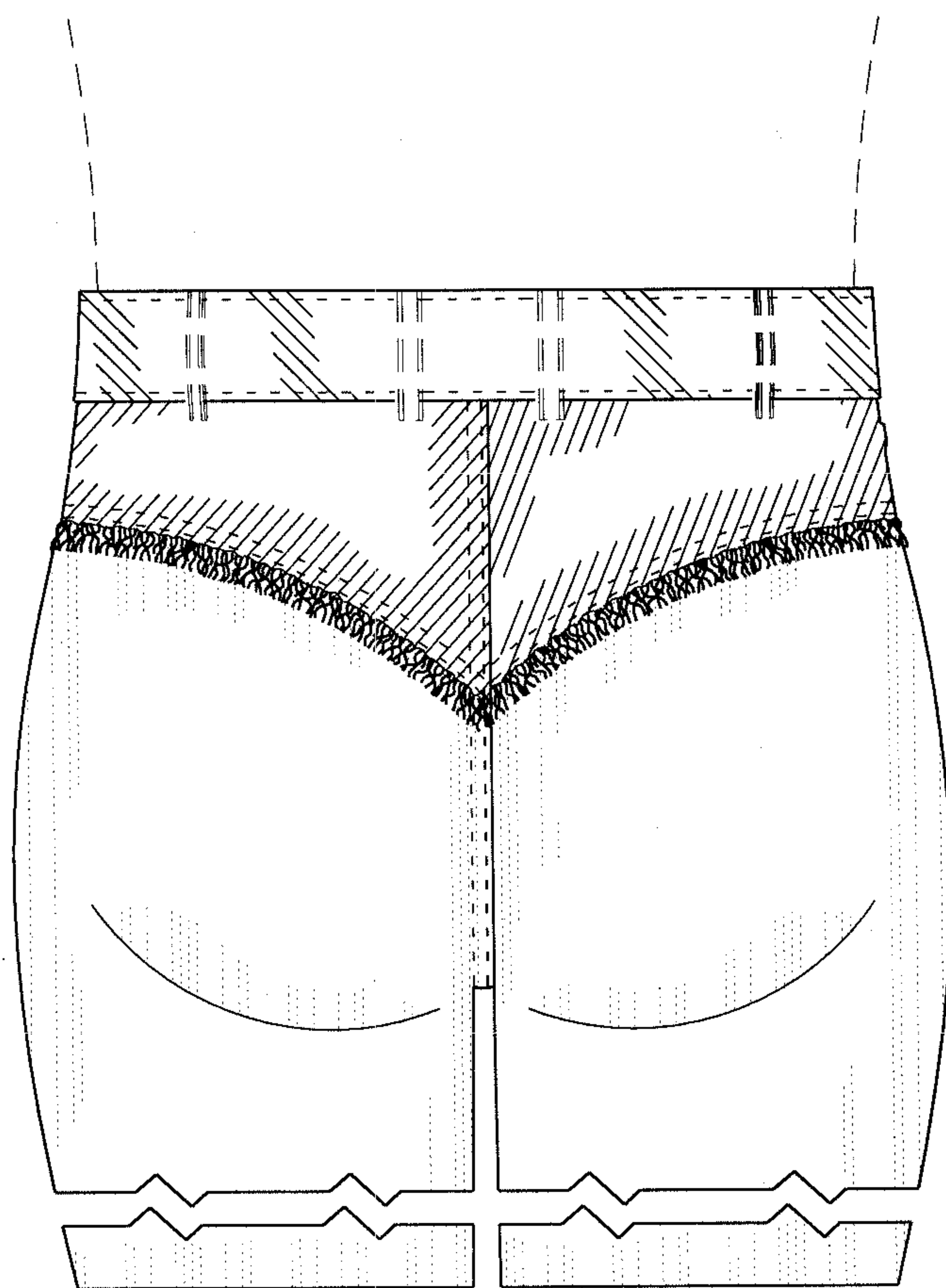

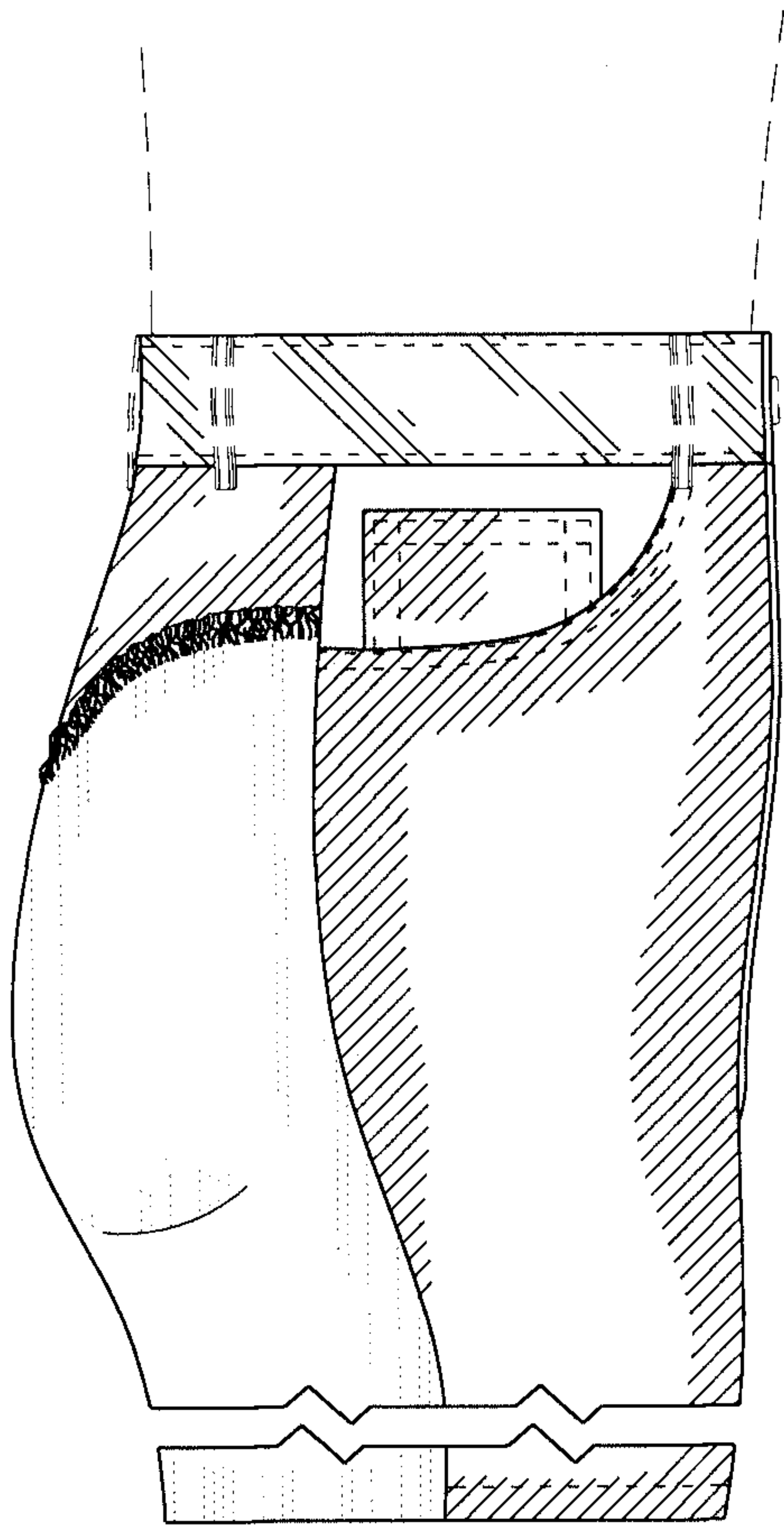

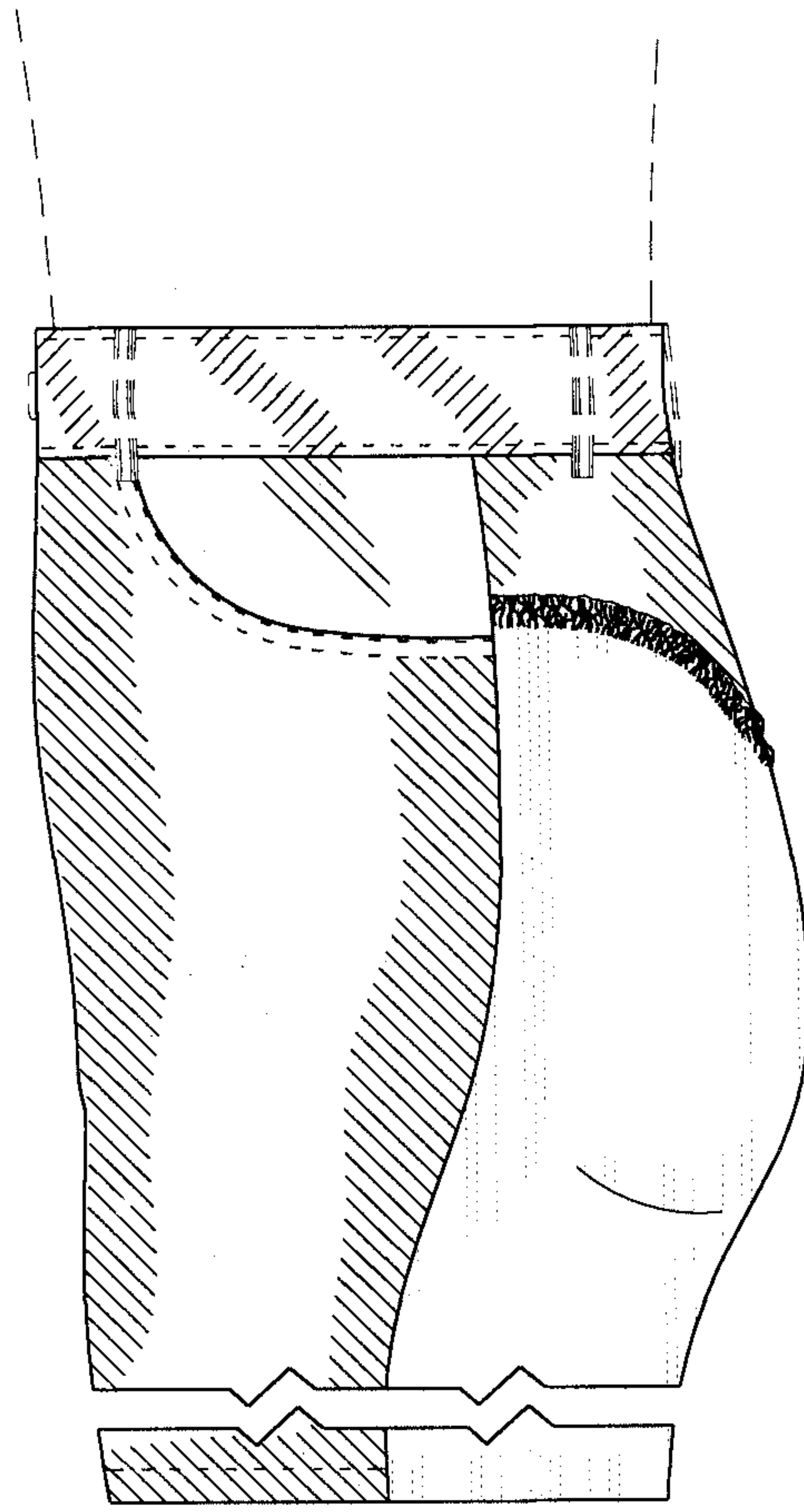
