(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for athletic equipment sandal, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the athletic equipment sandal. FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the athletic equipment sandal illustrated without the environmental structure of the stitching for clarity.

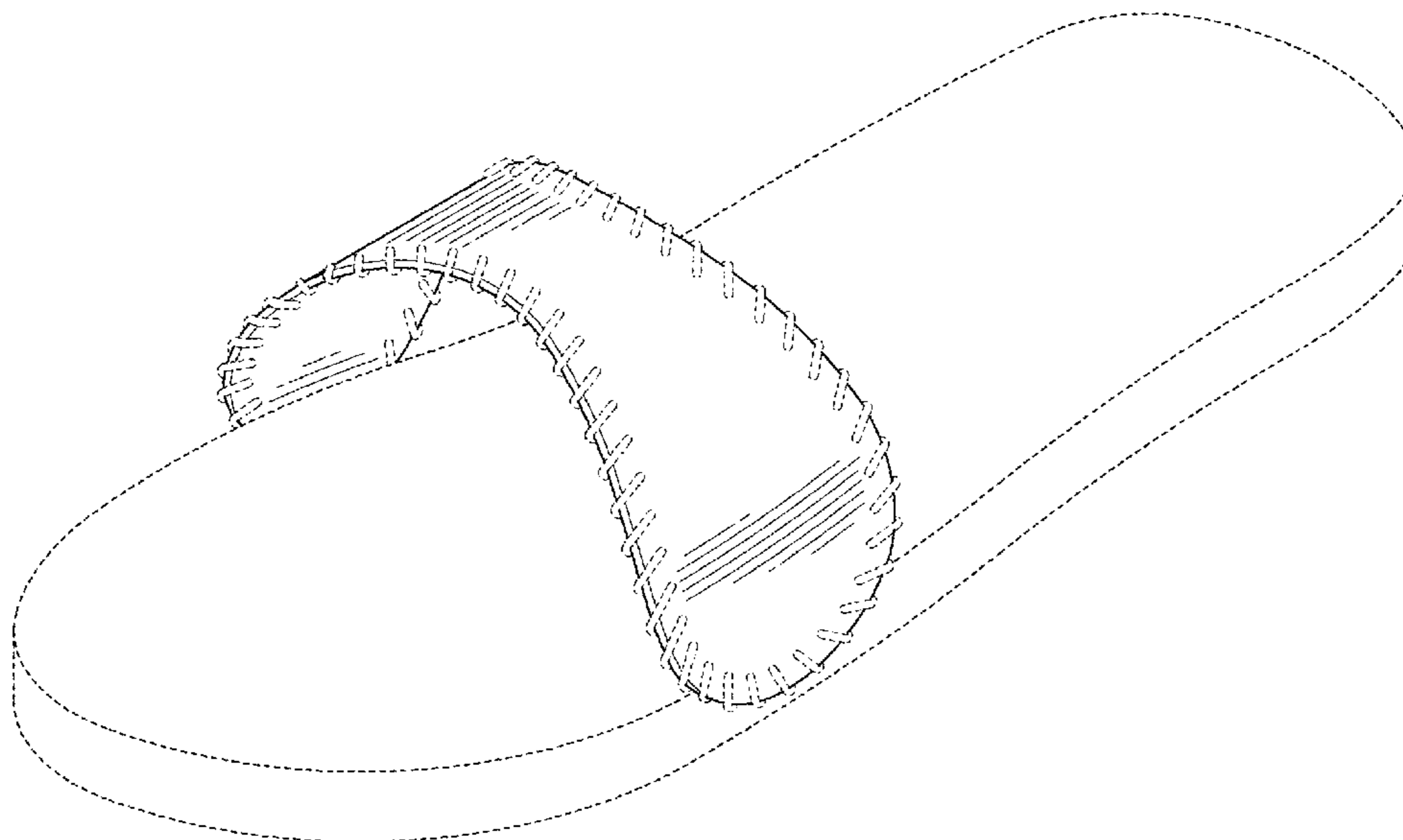
FIG. 3 is a left side view of the athletic equipment sandal illustrated without the environmental structure of the stitching for clarity; and,

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the athletic equipment sandal illustrated without the environmental structure of the stitching for clarity.

The right side view of the athletic equipment sandal is a mirror image of the left side view of the athletic equipment sandal. The bottom of the athletic equipment sandal is unornamented.

The broken lines in the figures are included to show the environmental structure of the athletic equipment sandal and form no part of the claimed design.

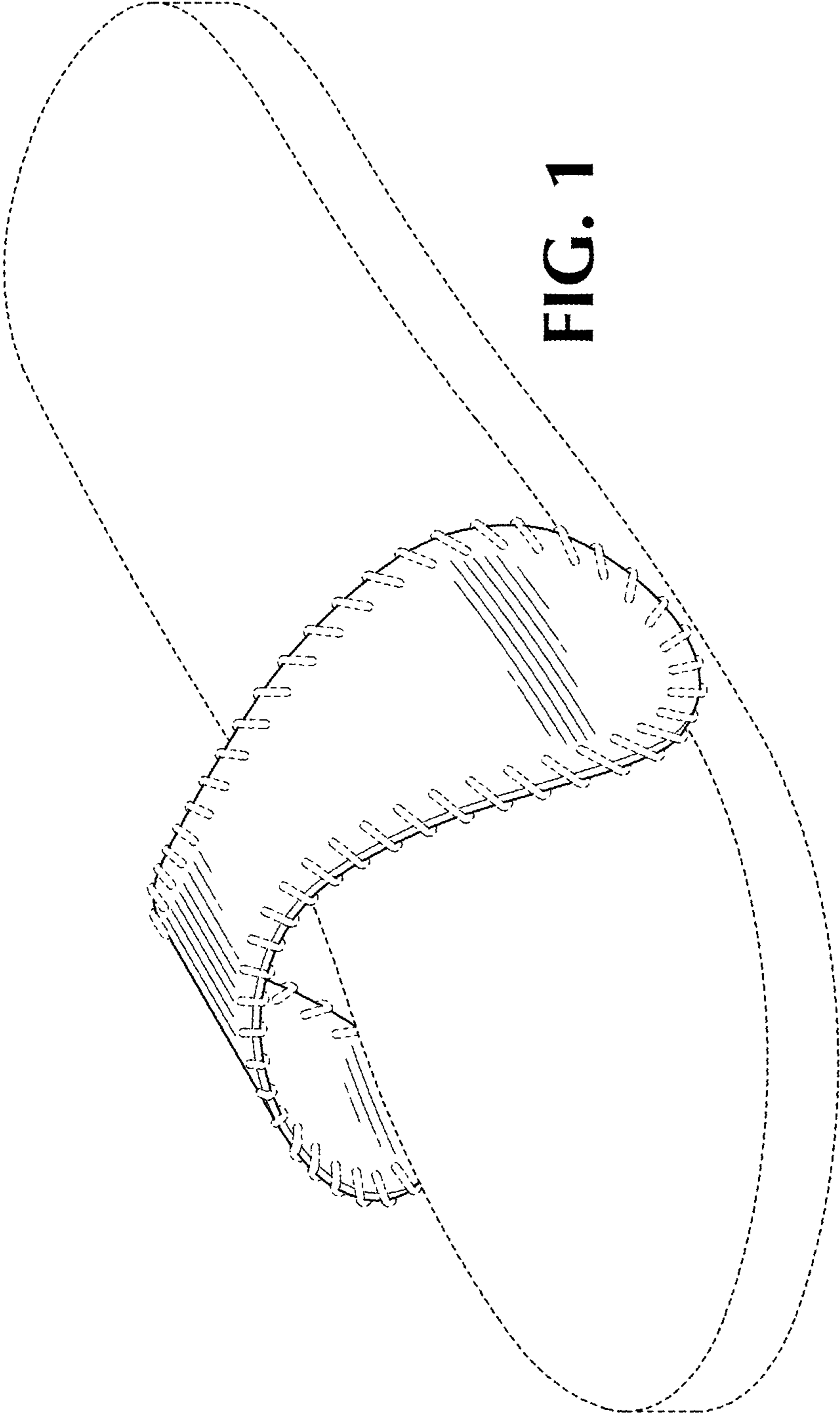

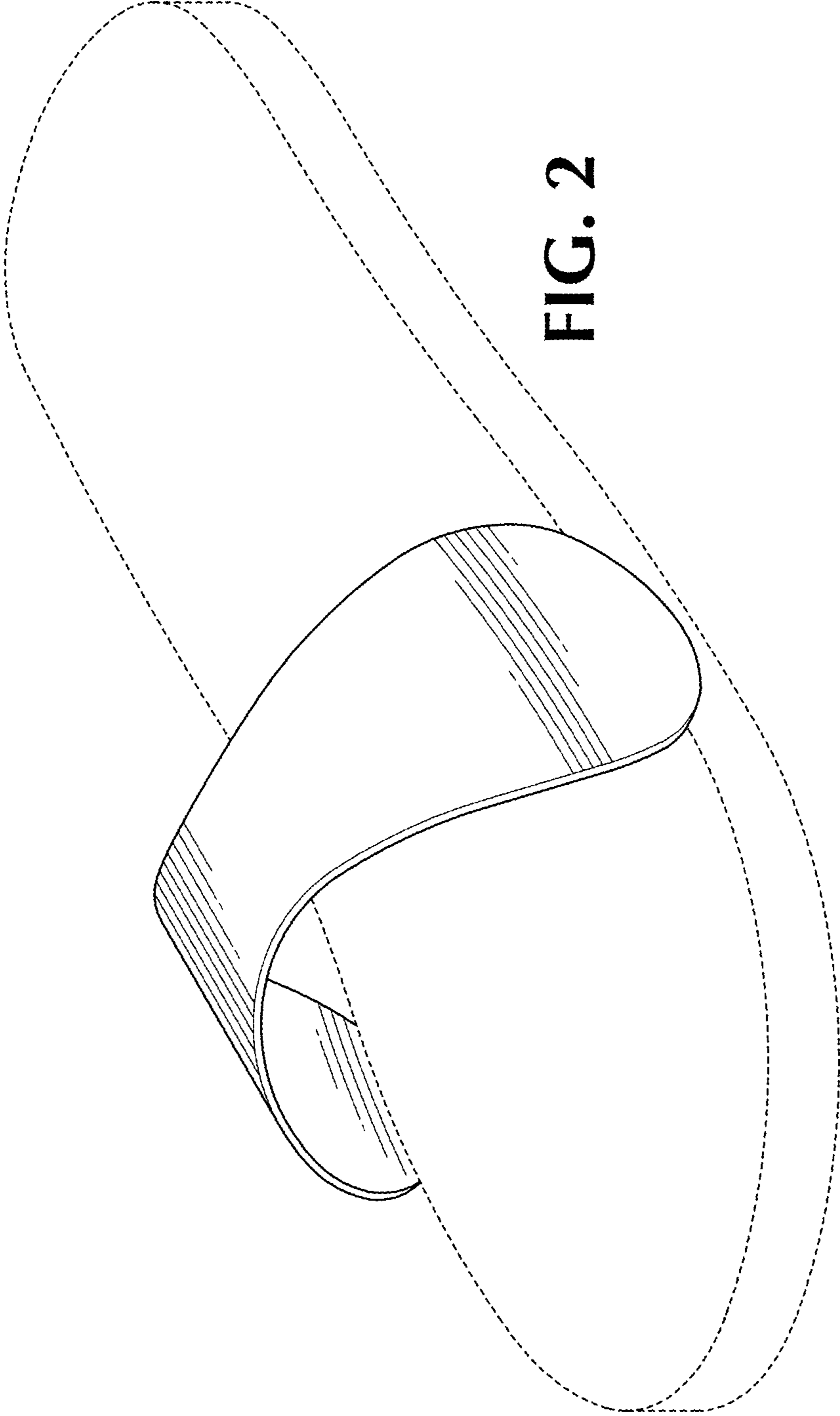

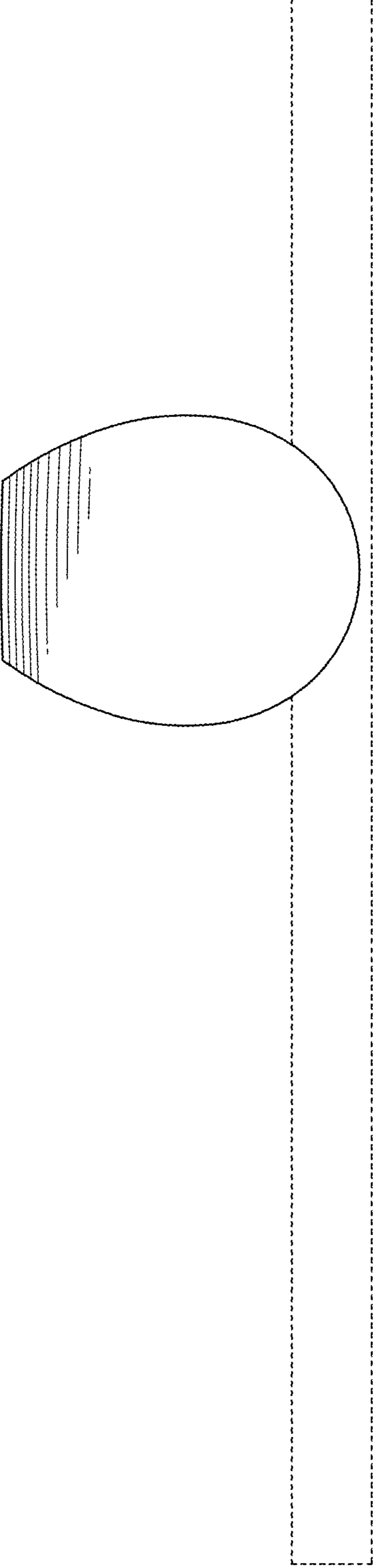
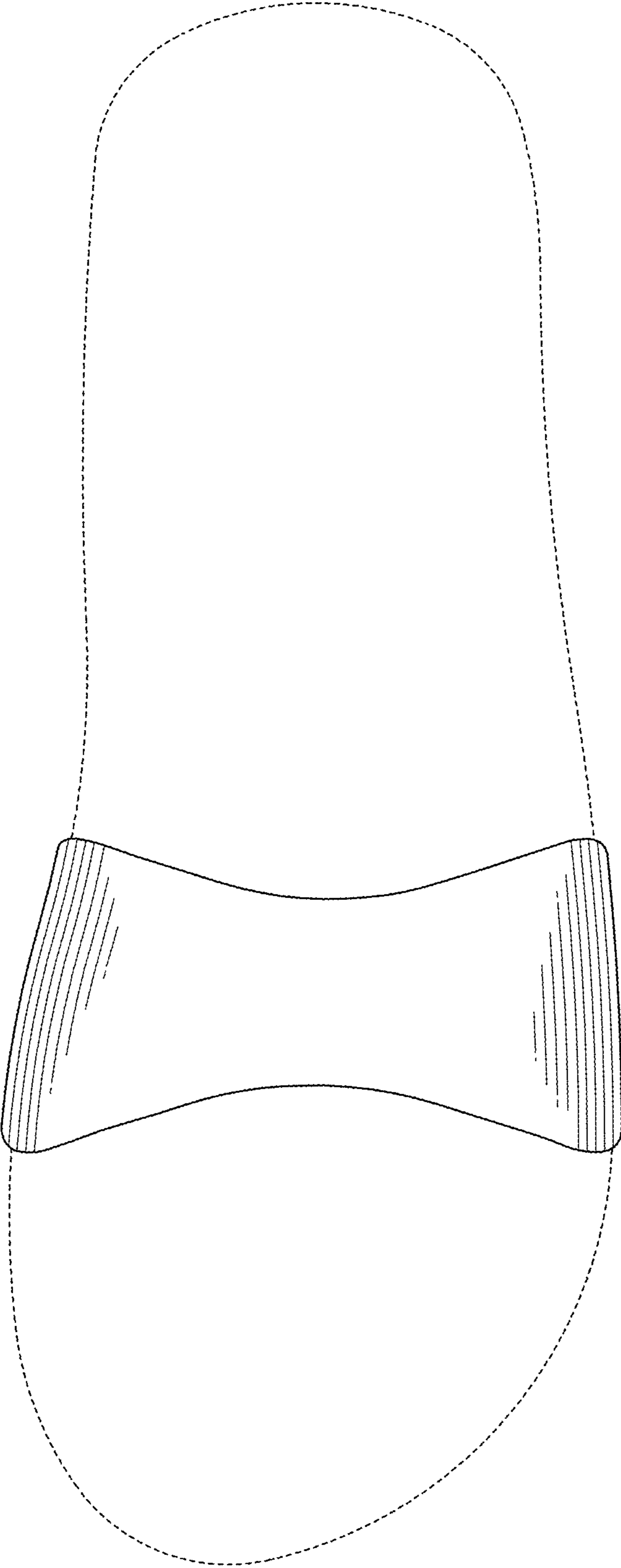
