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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handle for a mason jar, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a handle for a mason jar showing the design;

FIG. 2 is a top perspective view of the handle of FIG. 1 shown in use;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an opposing side elevation view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top elevation view of FIG. 1;

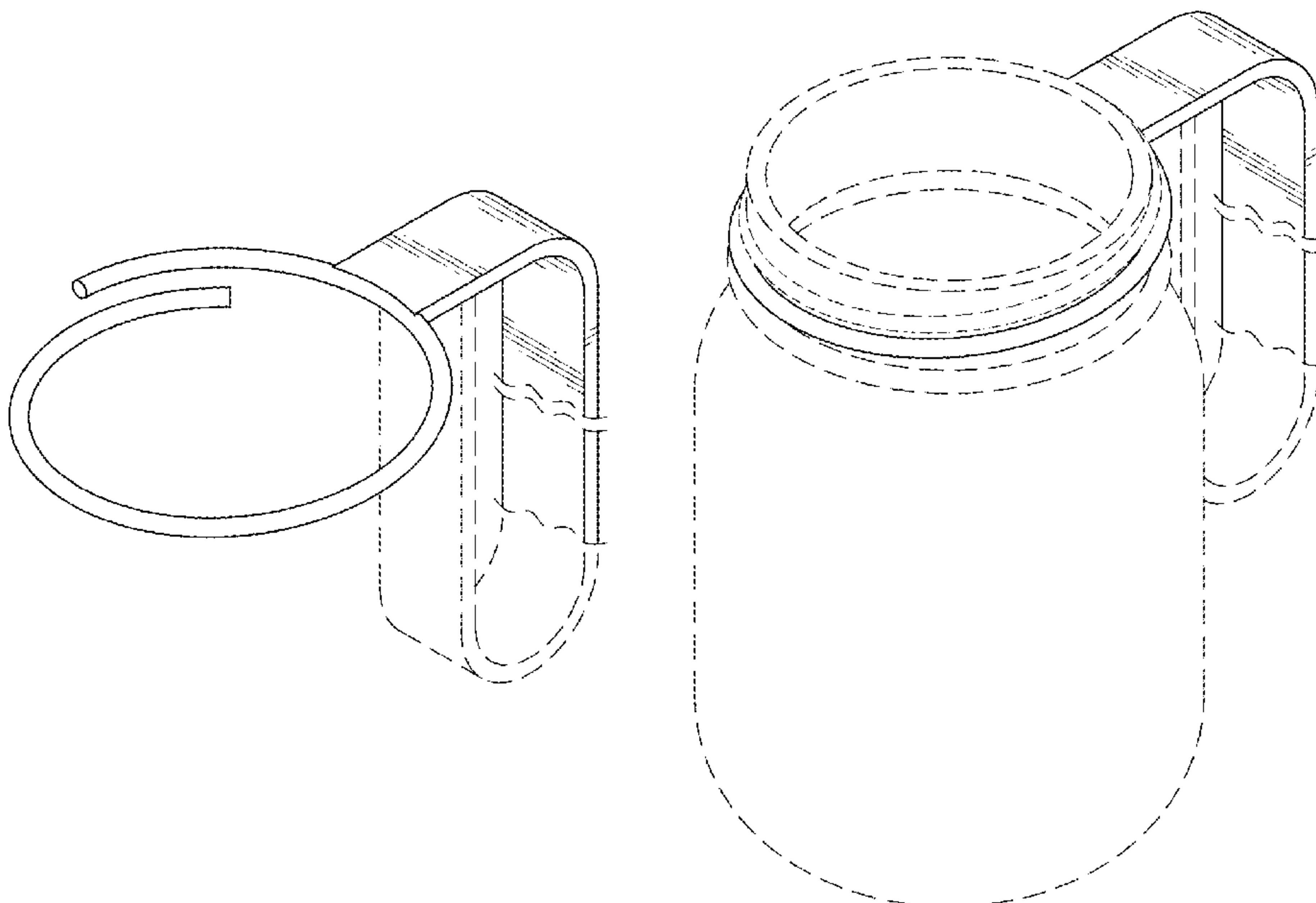
FIG. 6 is a bottom elevation view of FIG. 1;

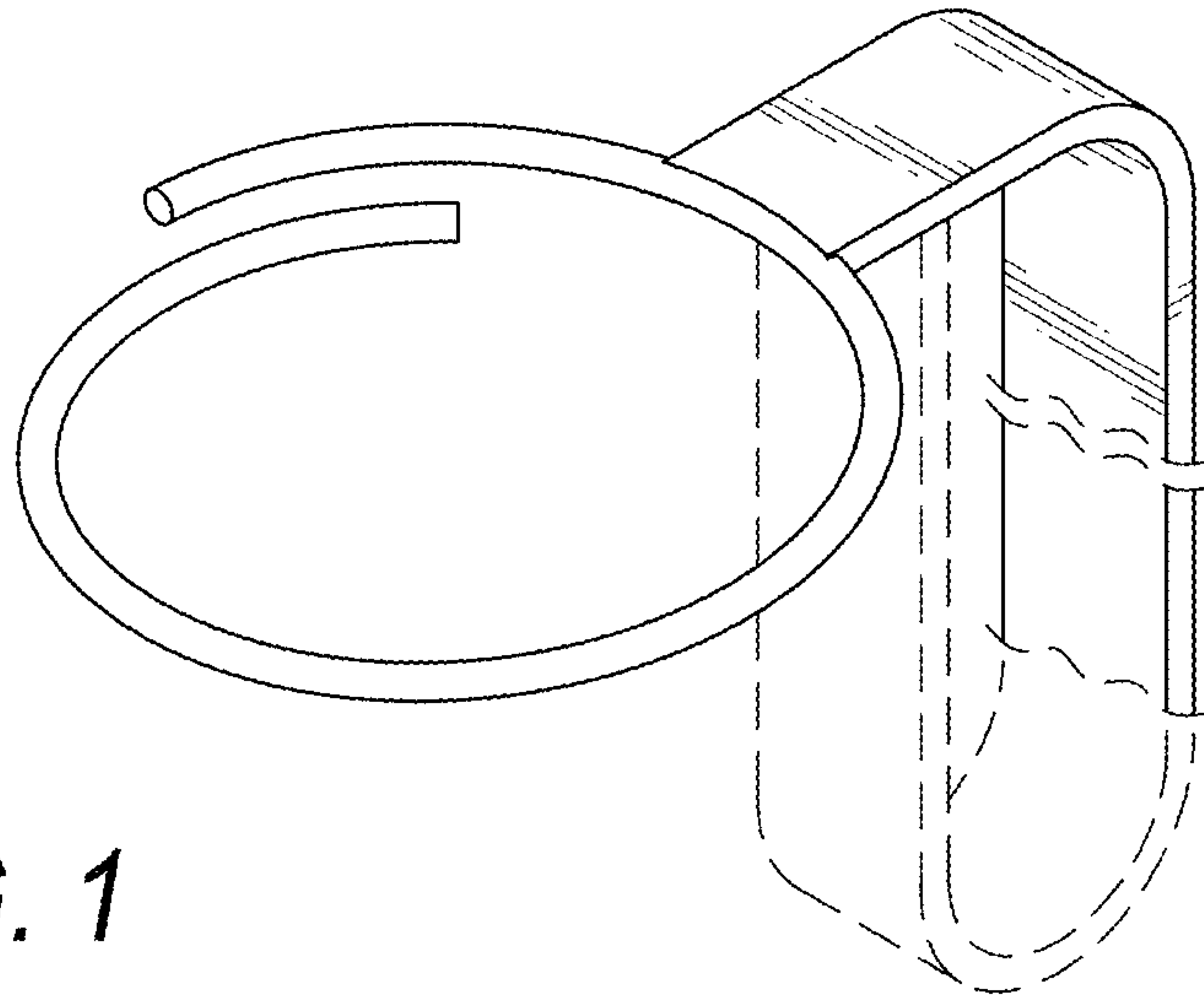

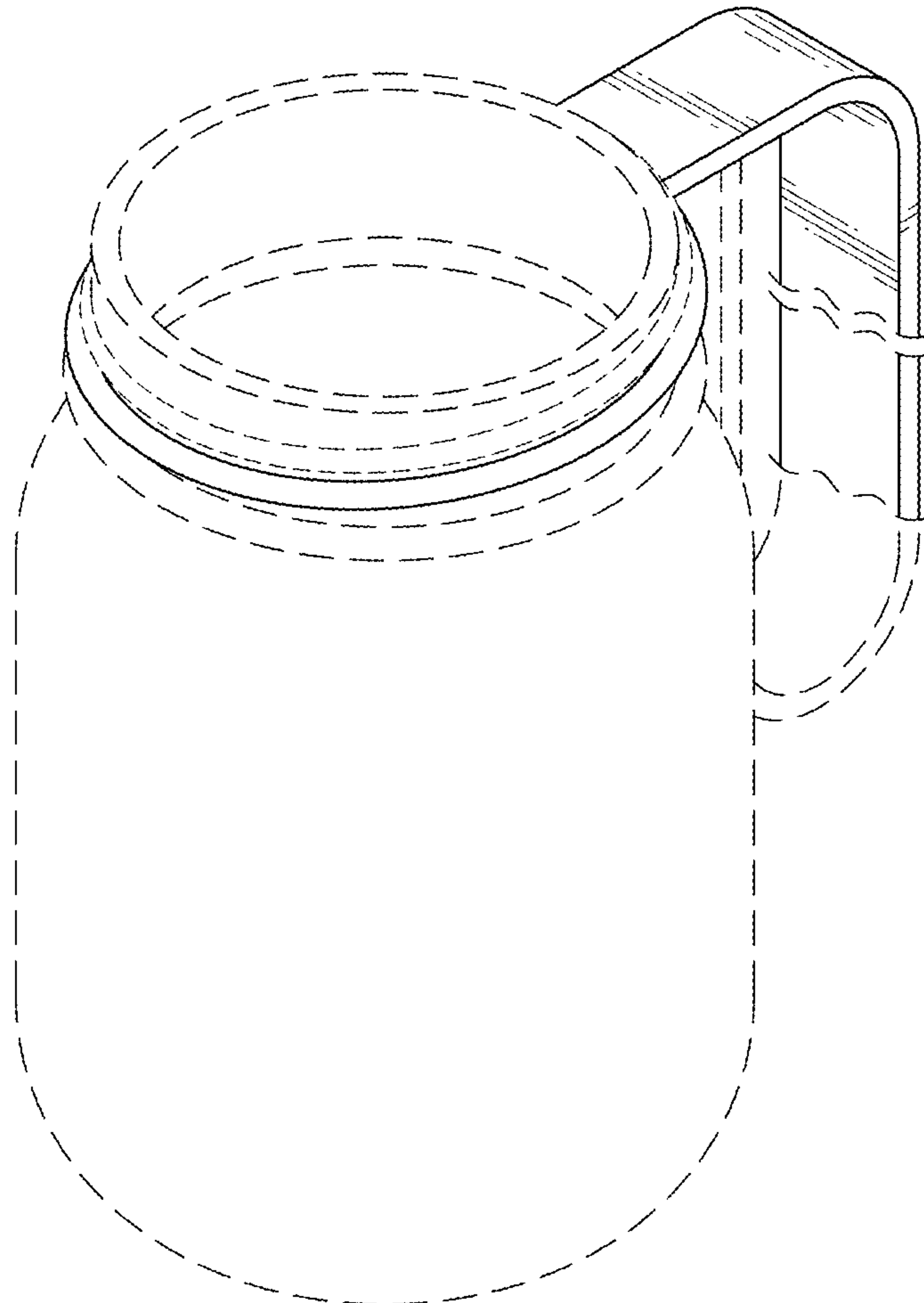

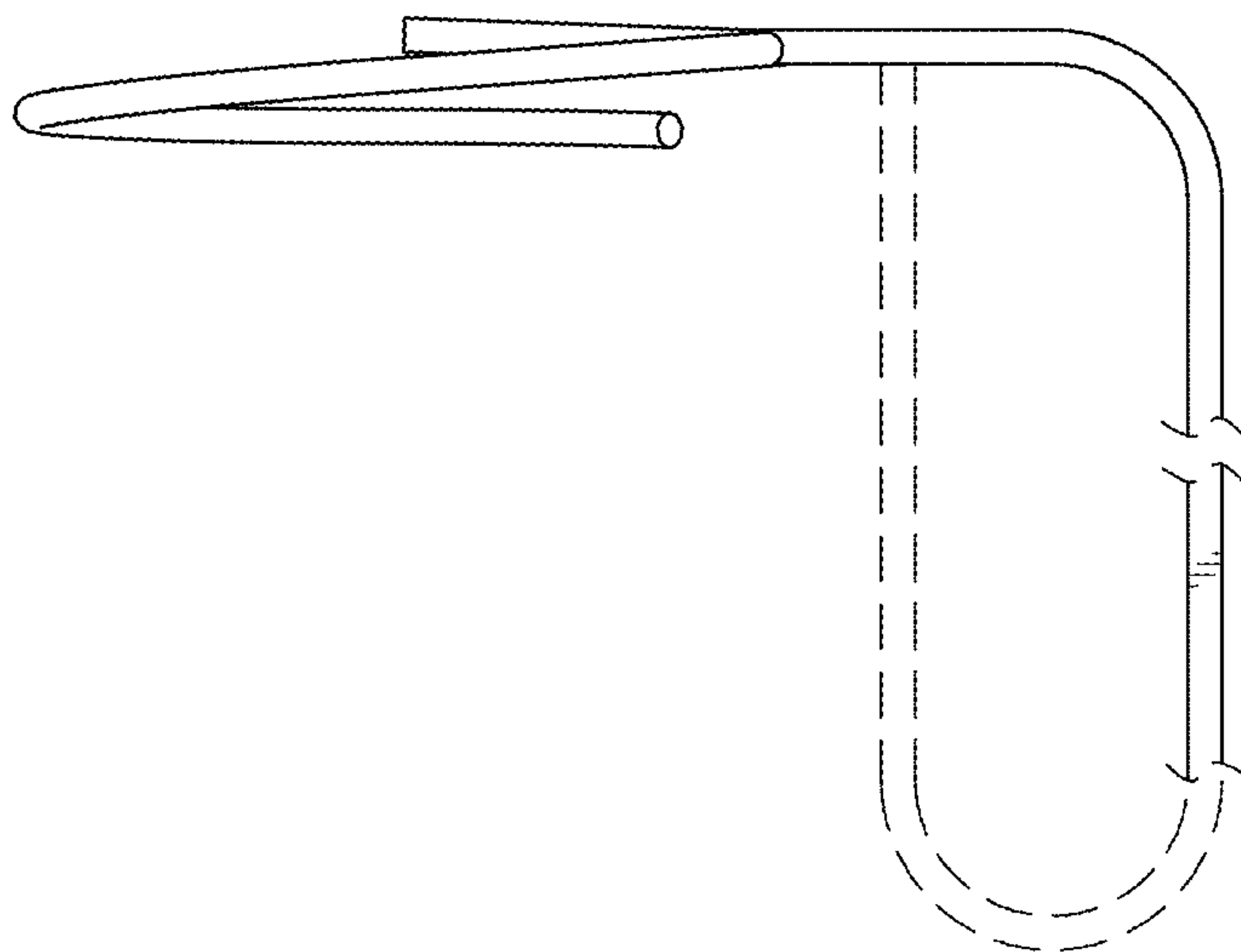

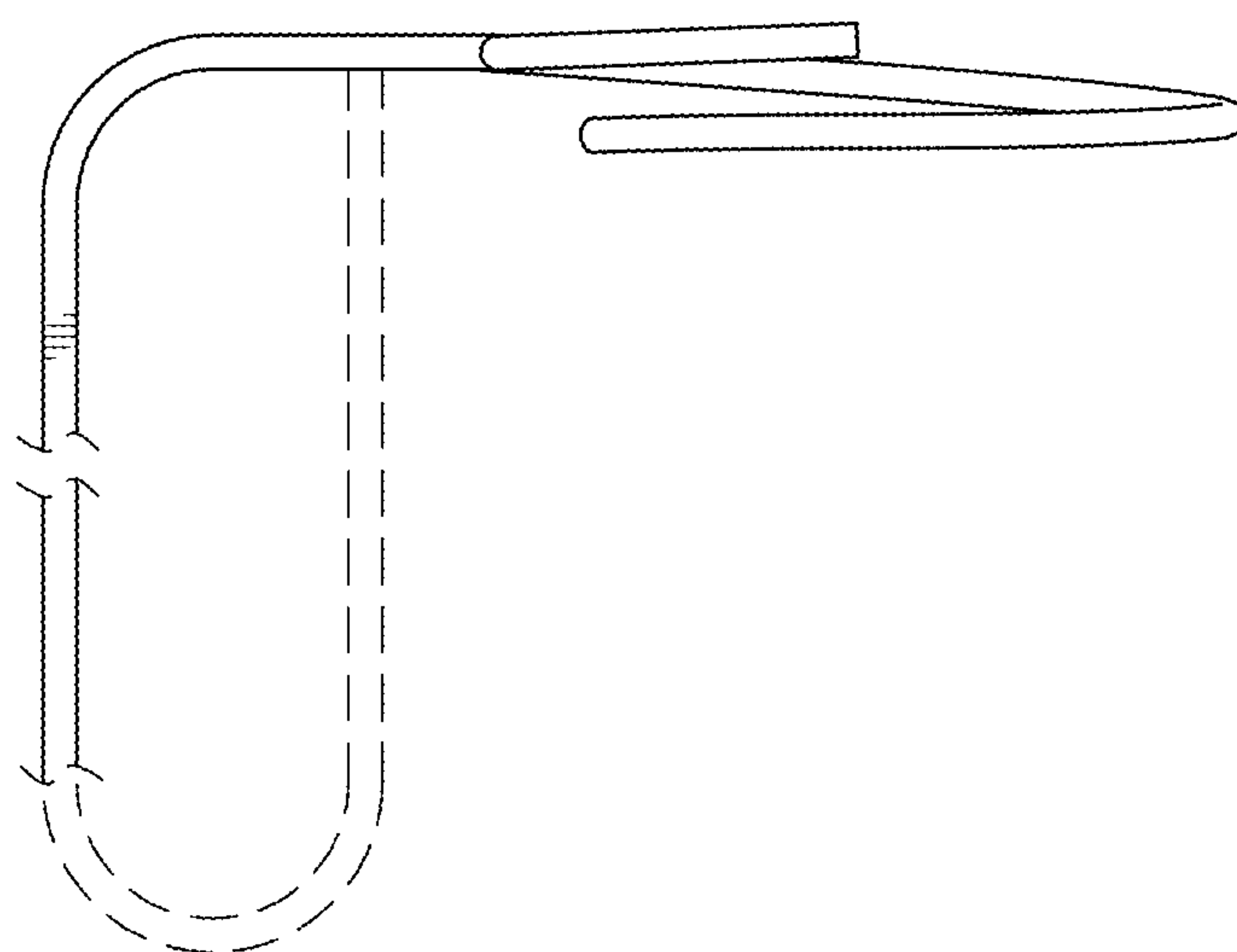

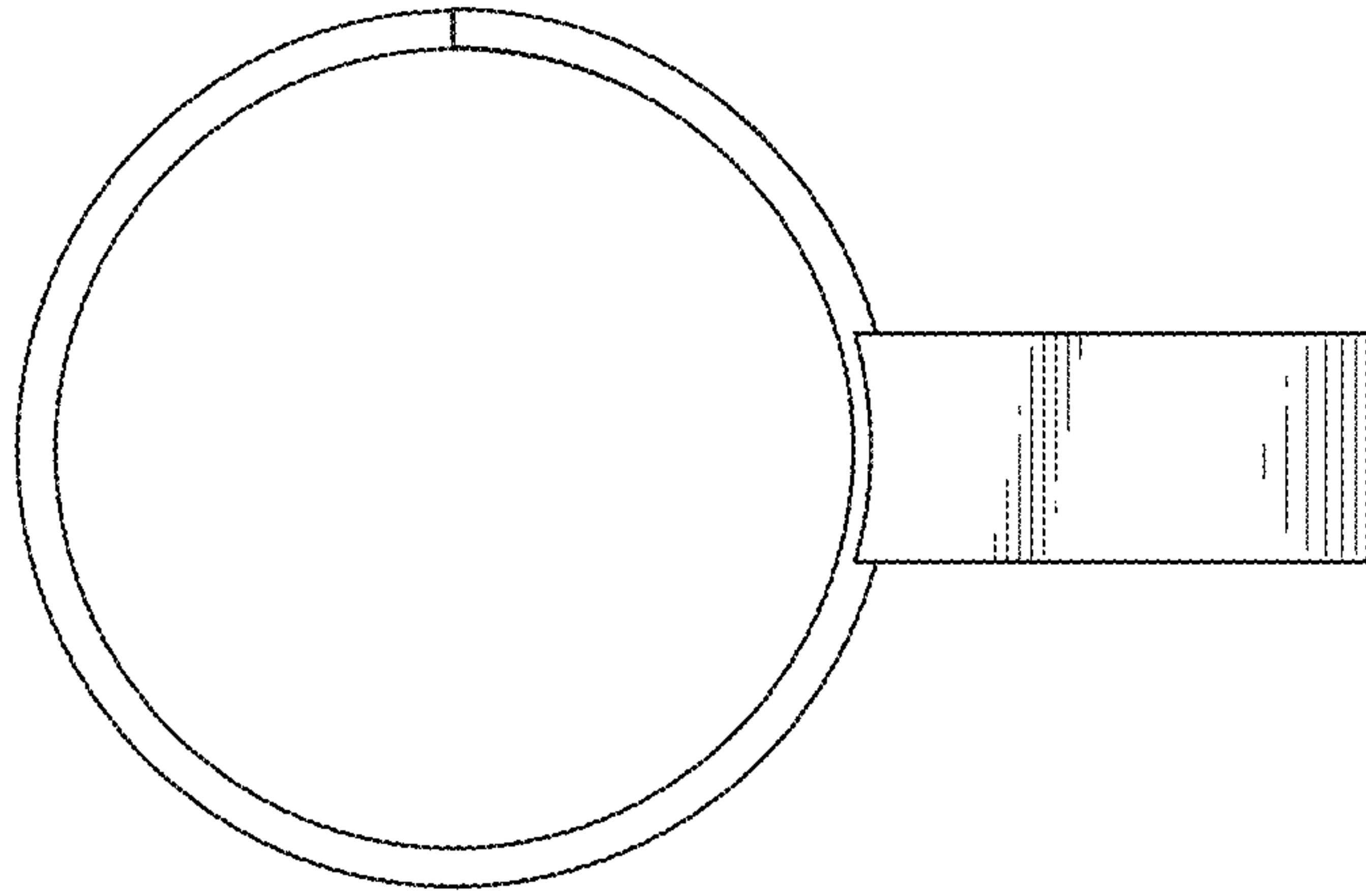

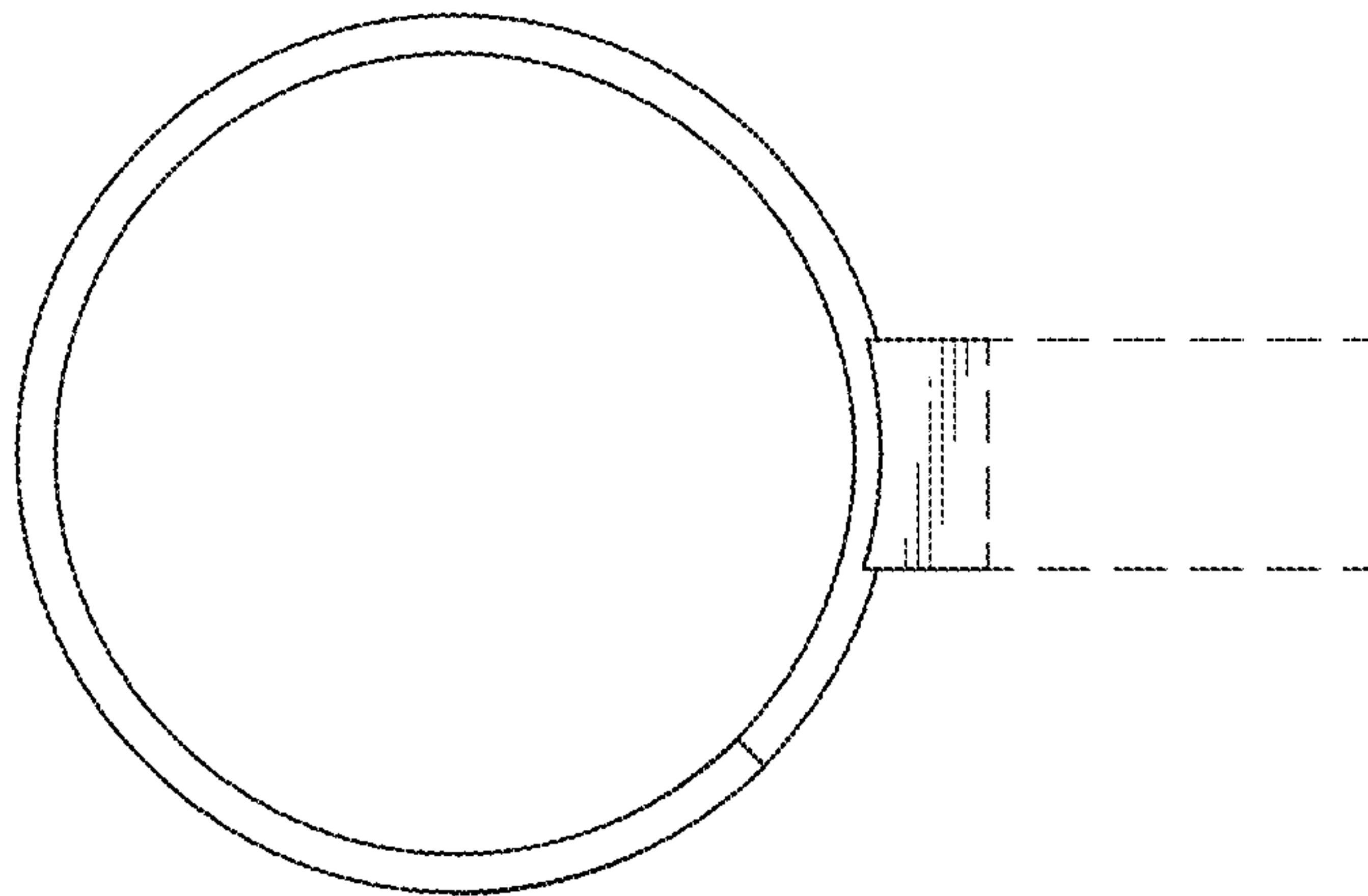

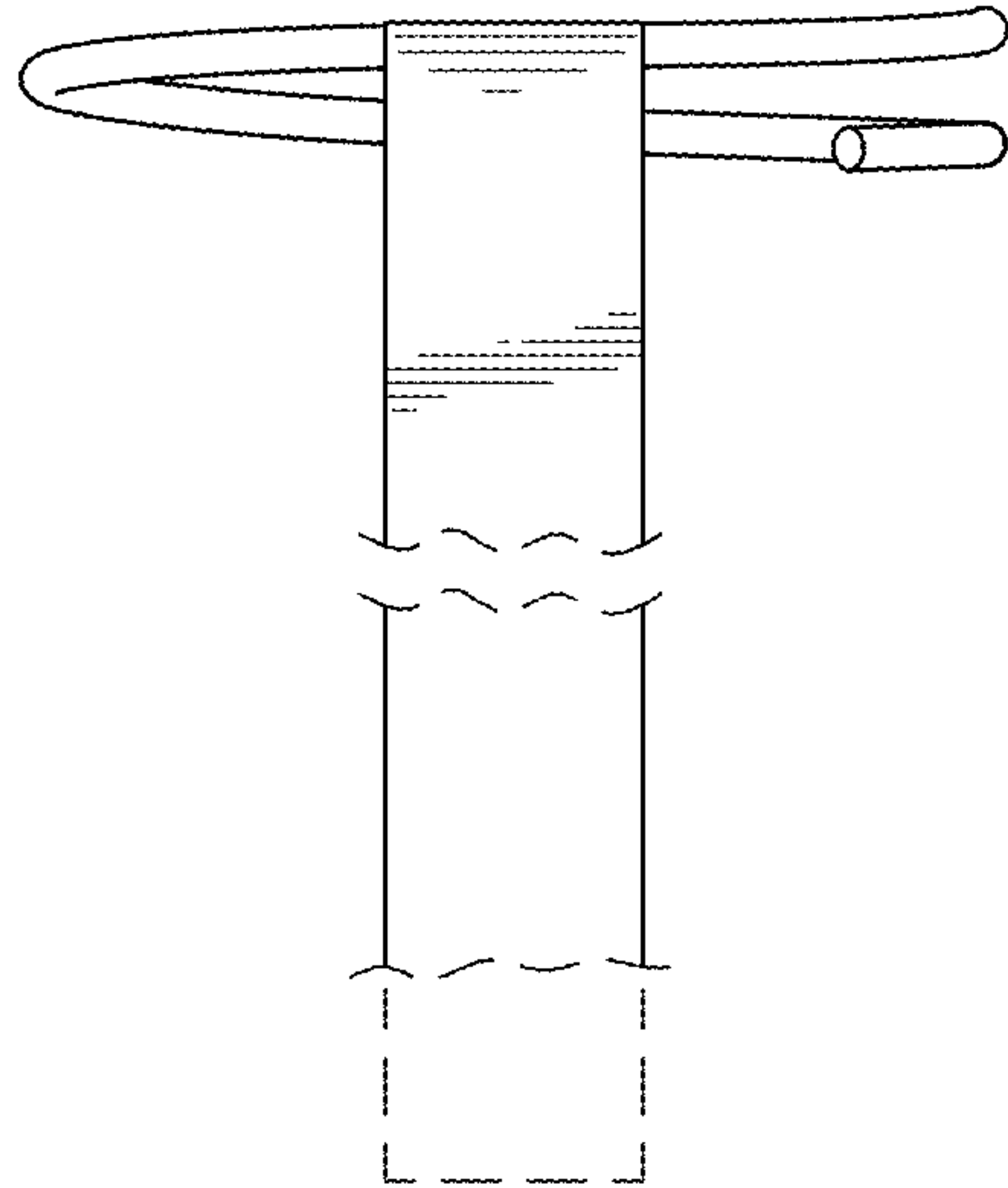

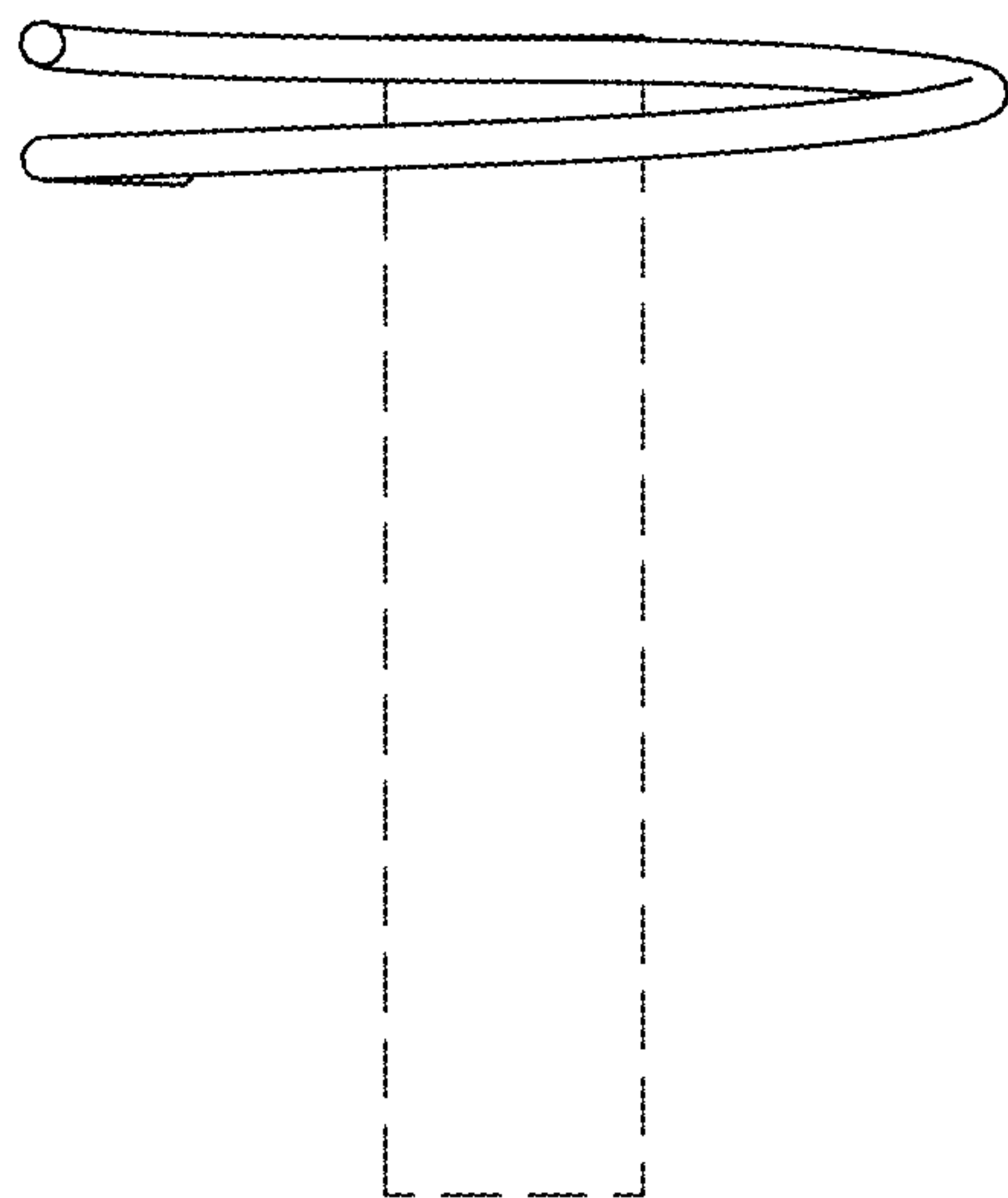
