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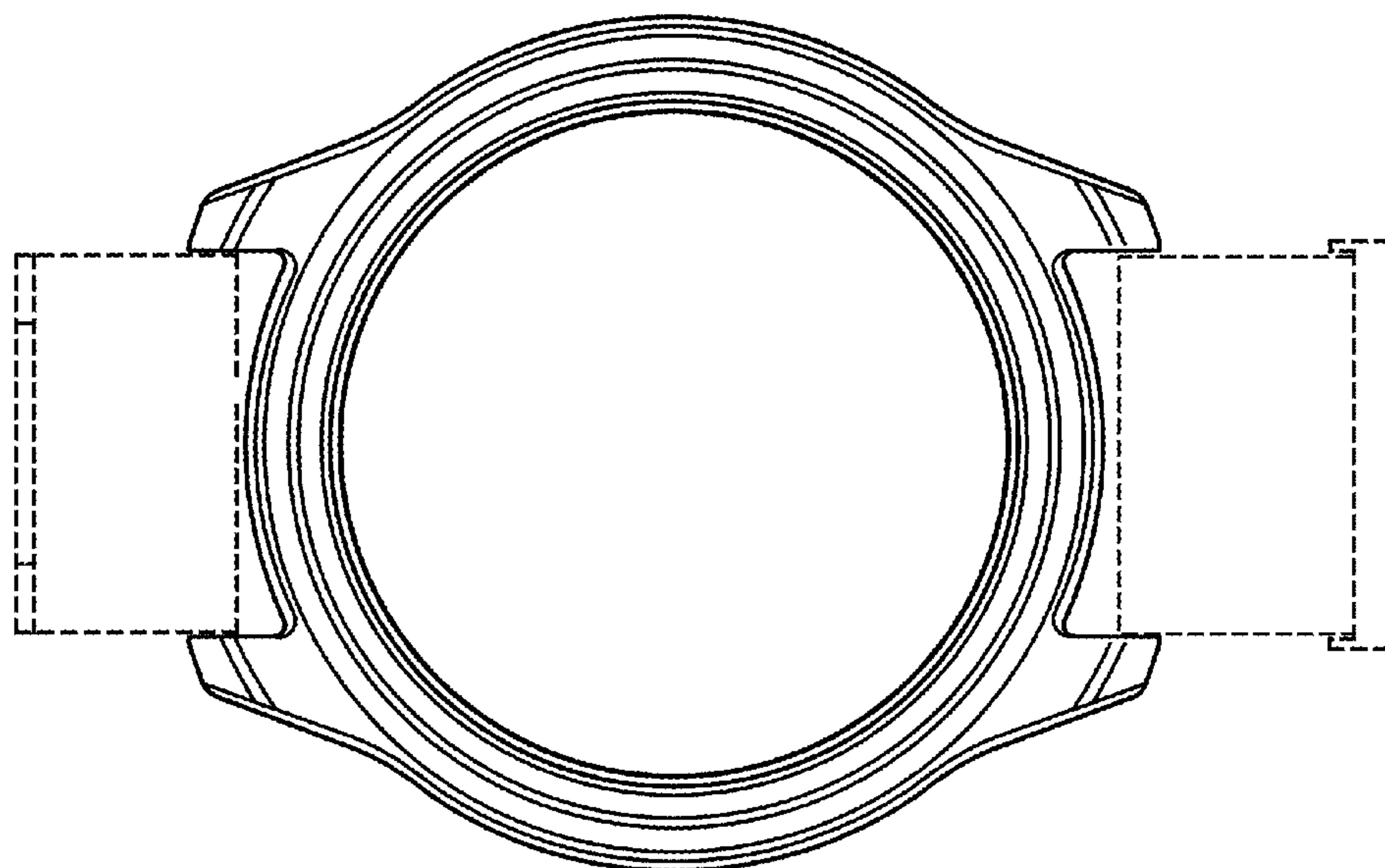
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view, from the bottom right, of the watch;

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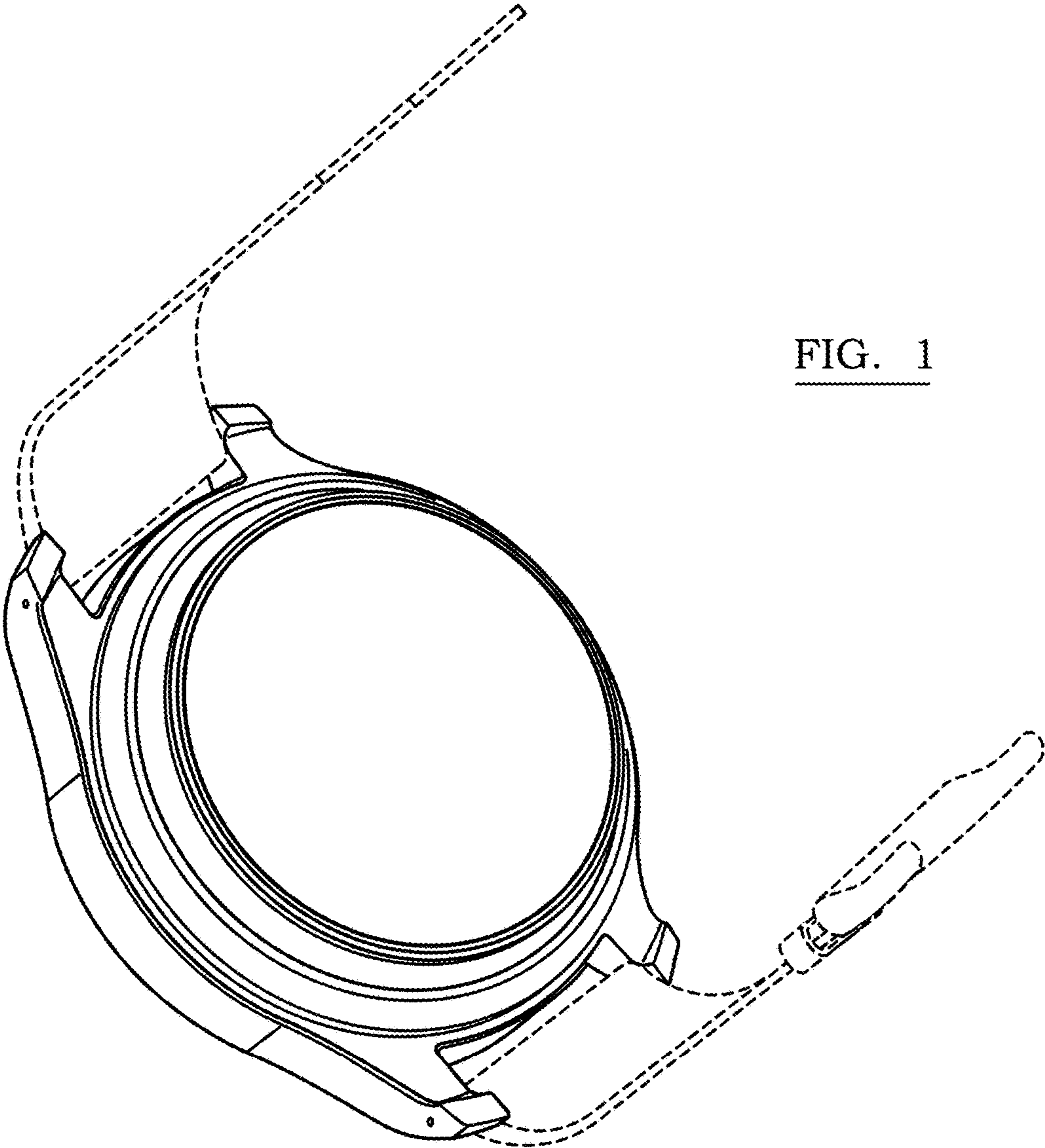

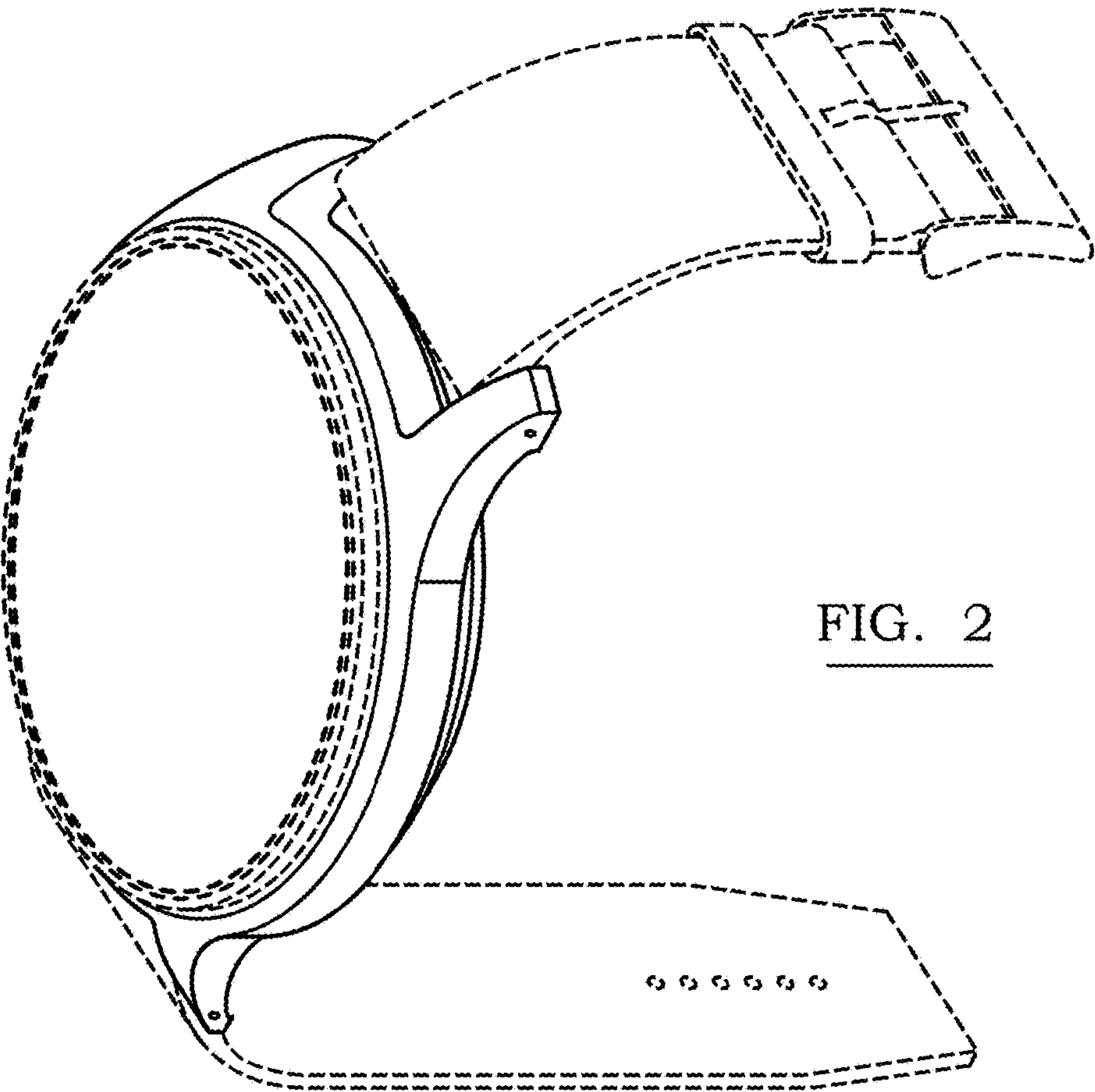

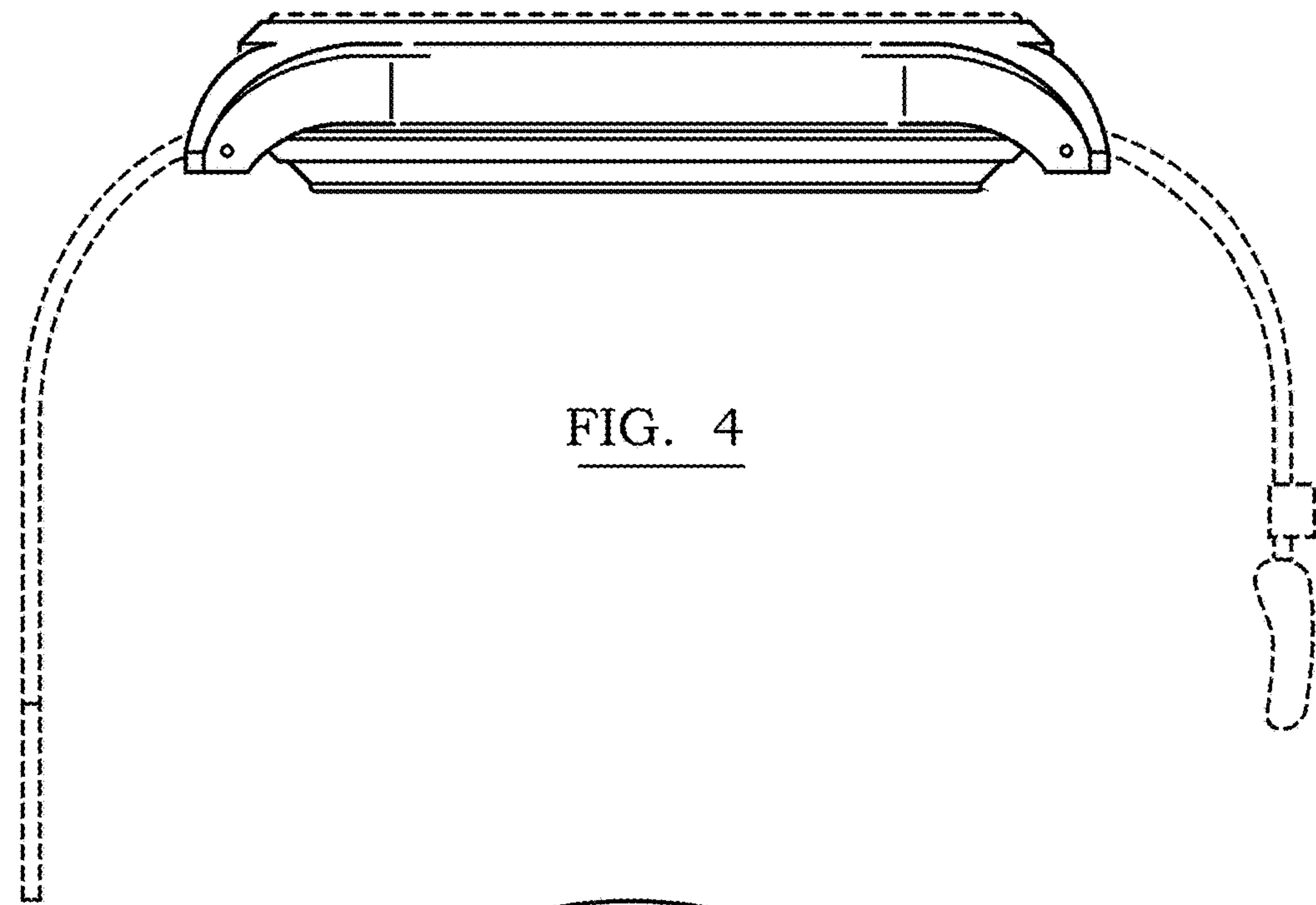

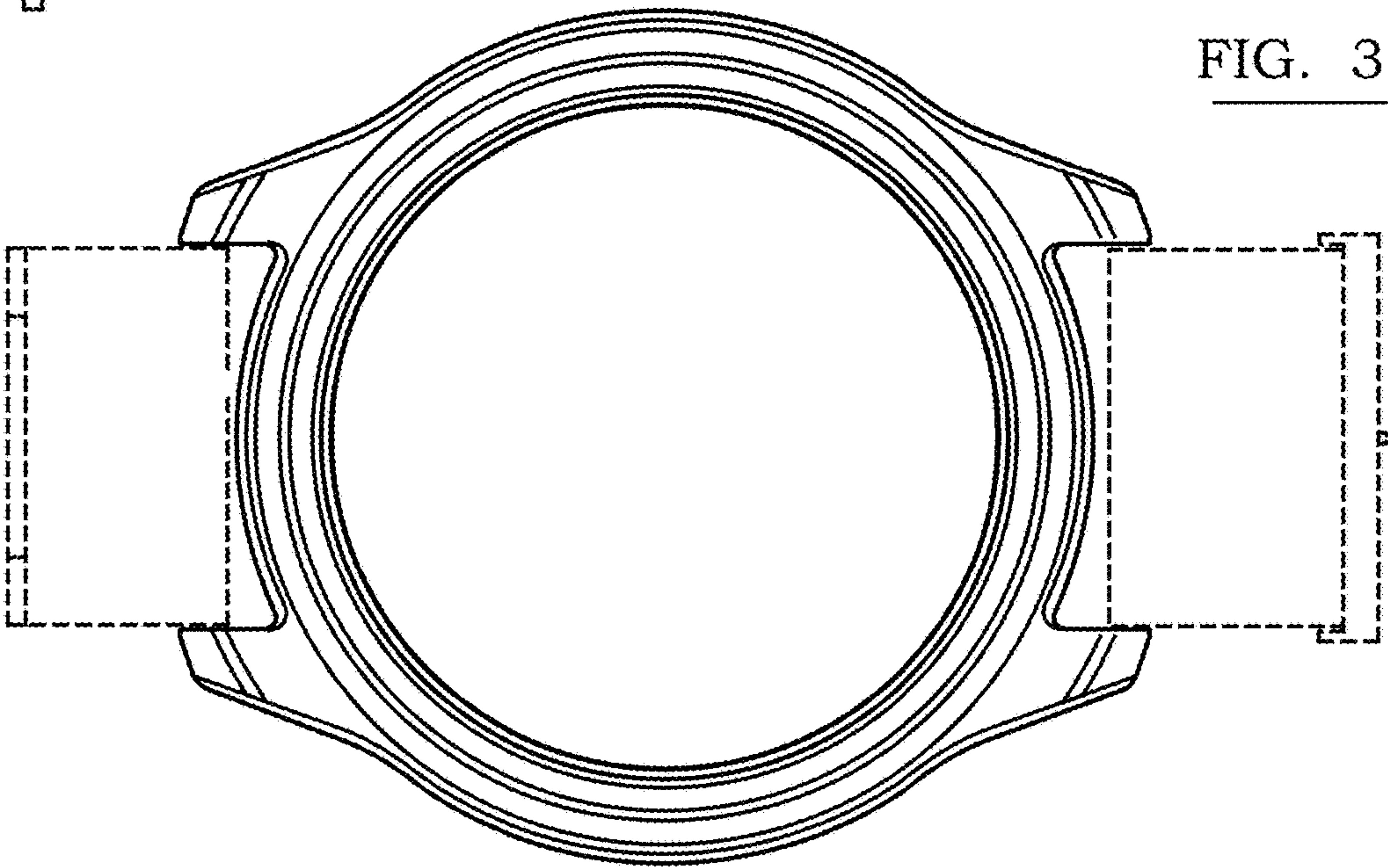

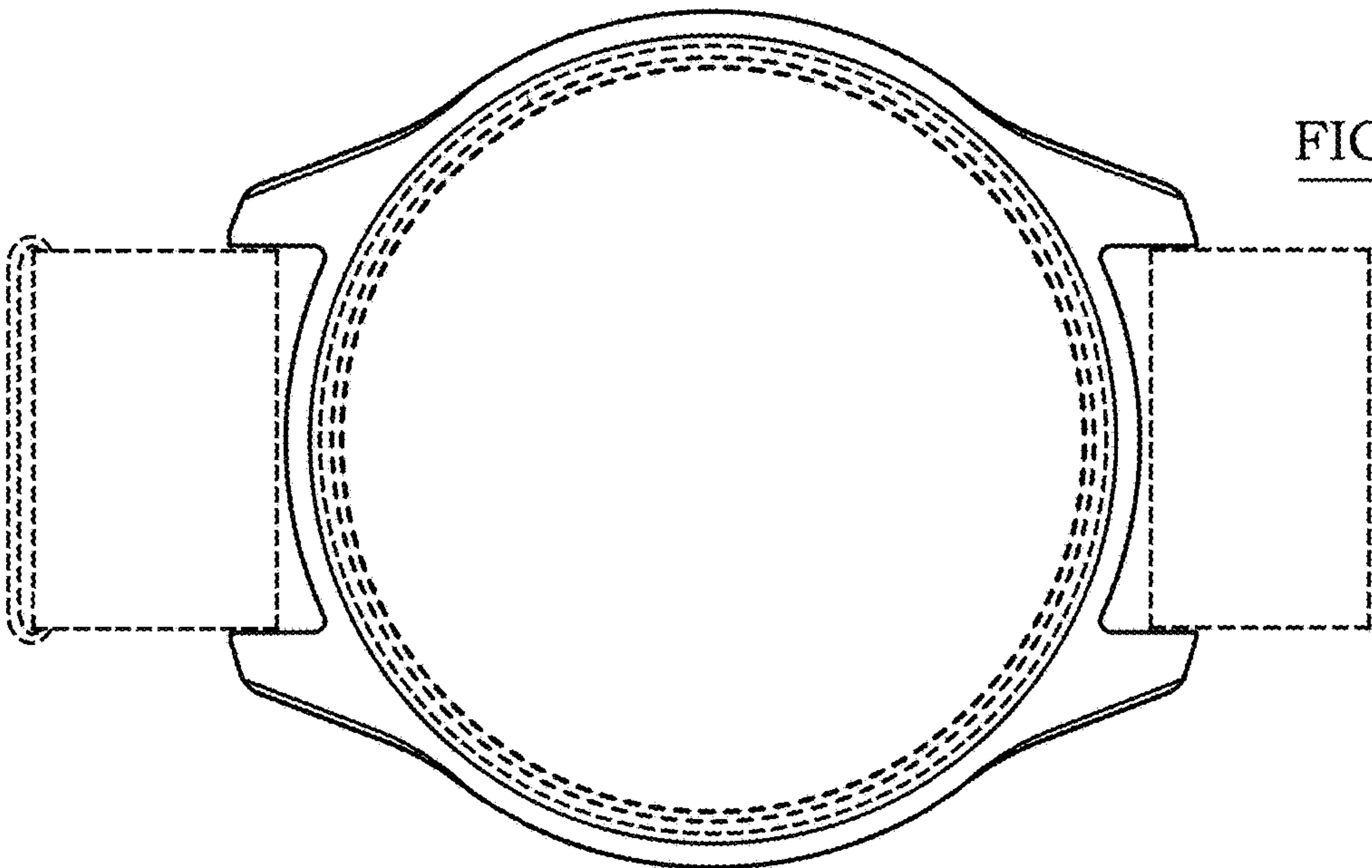

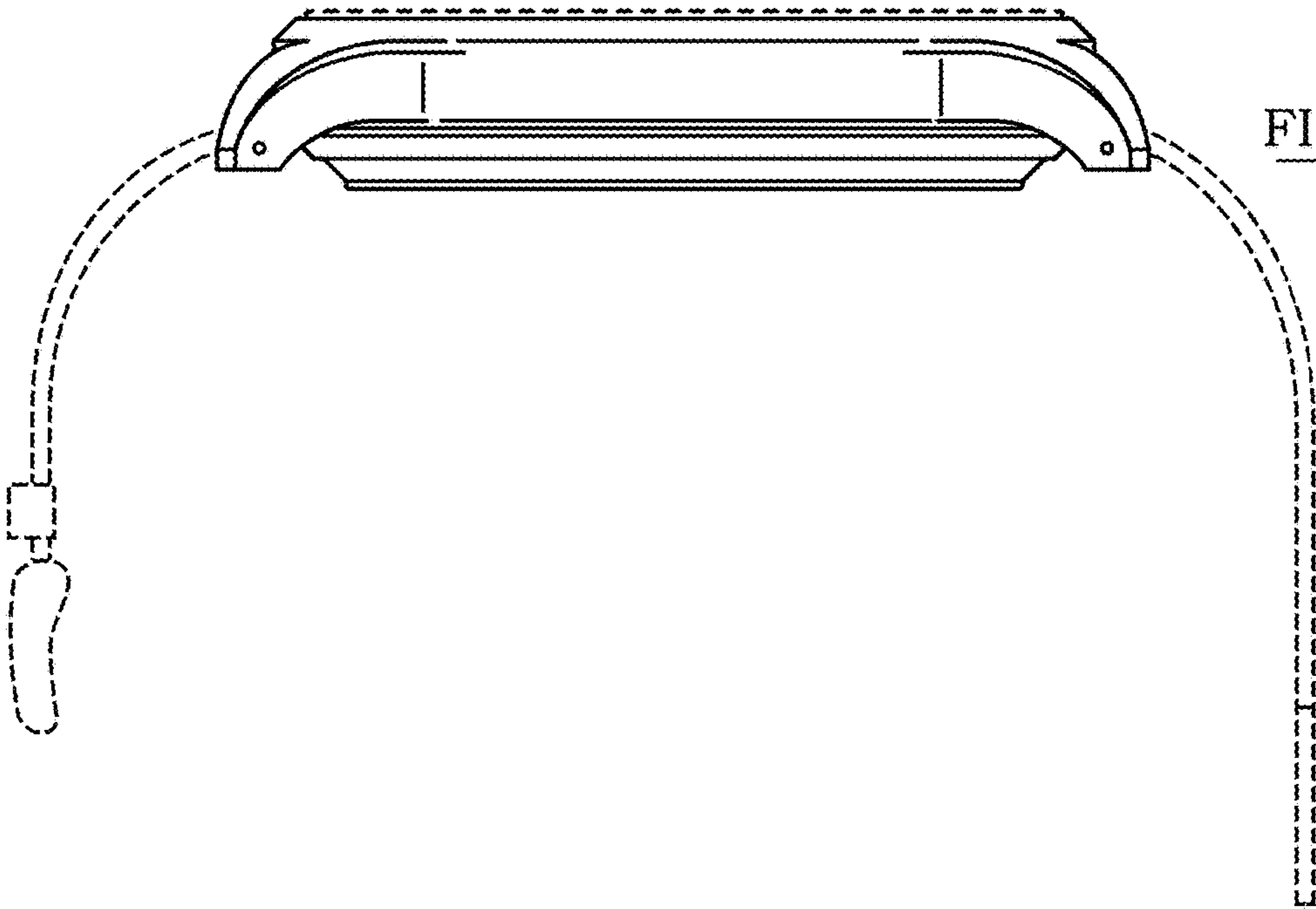

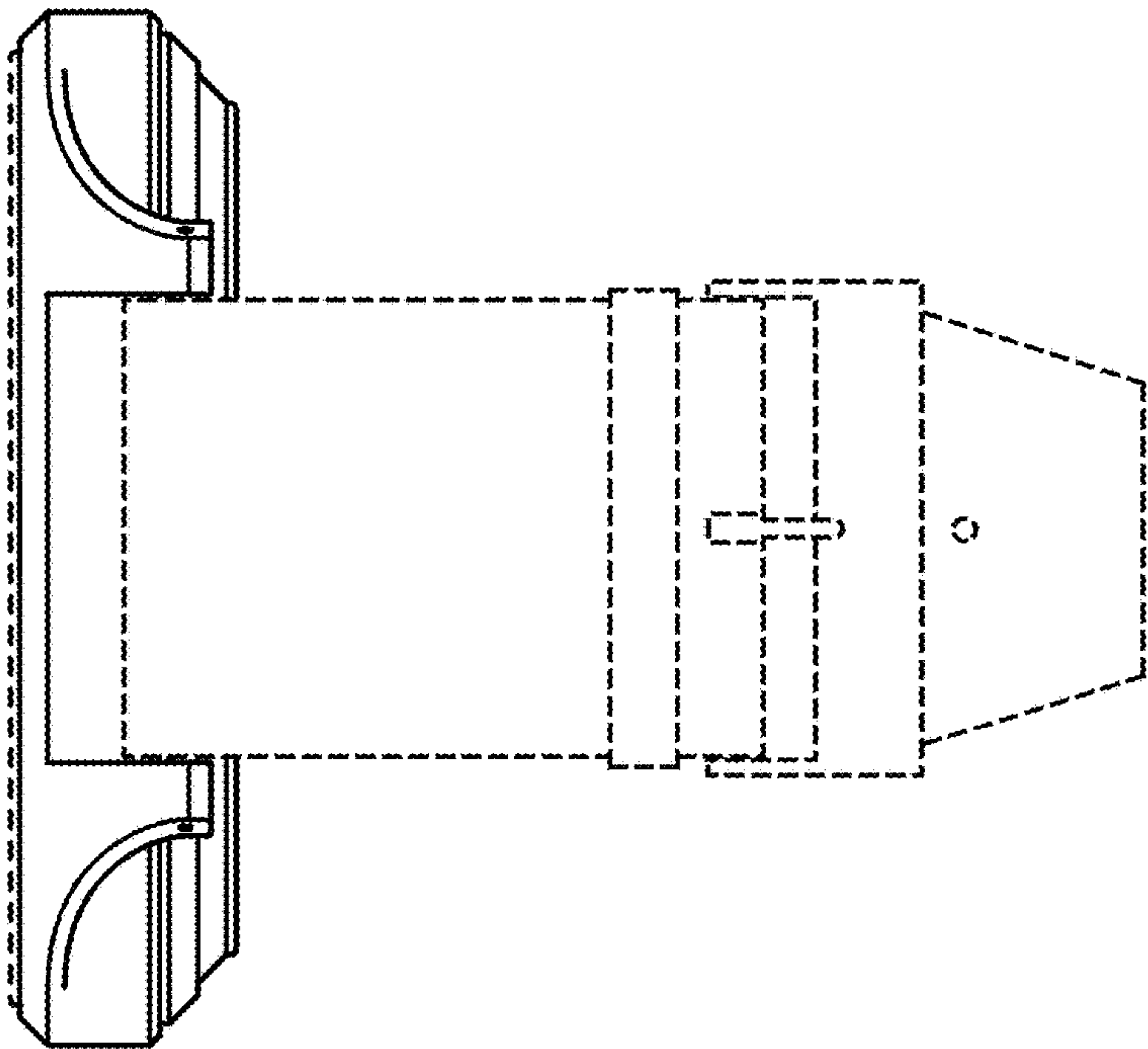

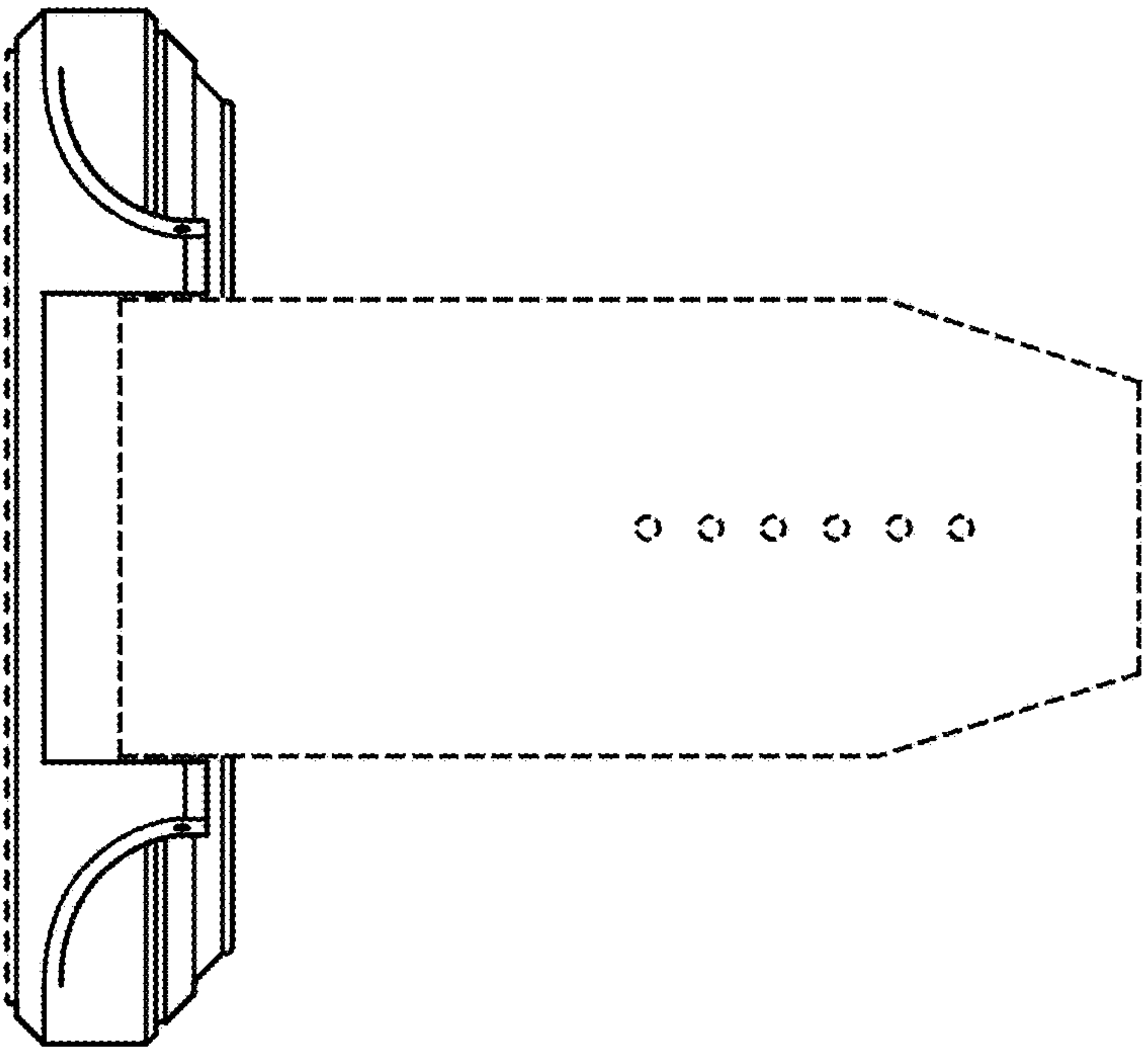
