The ornamental design for an image display device, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, rear, right-side perspective view of an image display device;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right-side view thereof;

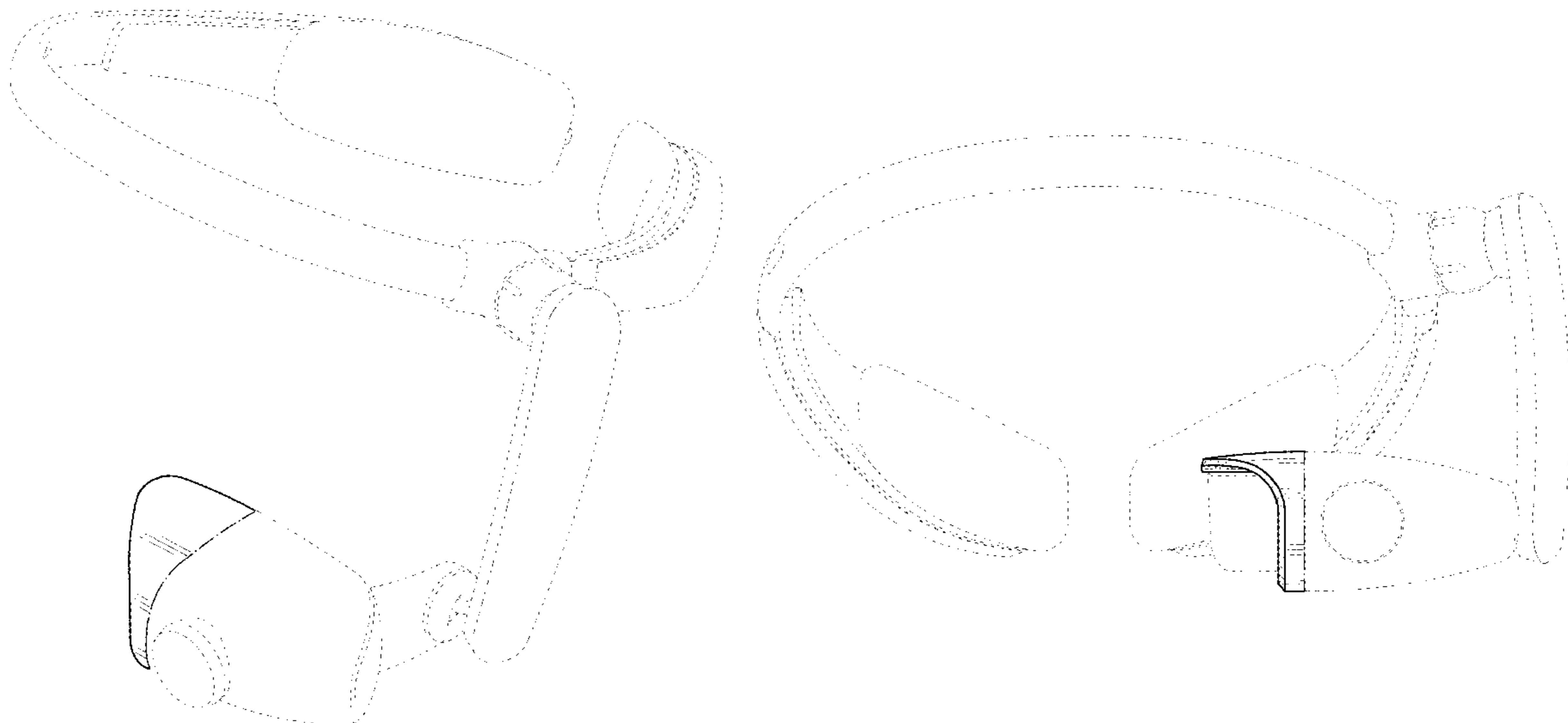
FIG. 5 is a left-side view thereof;

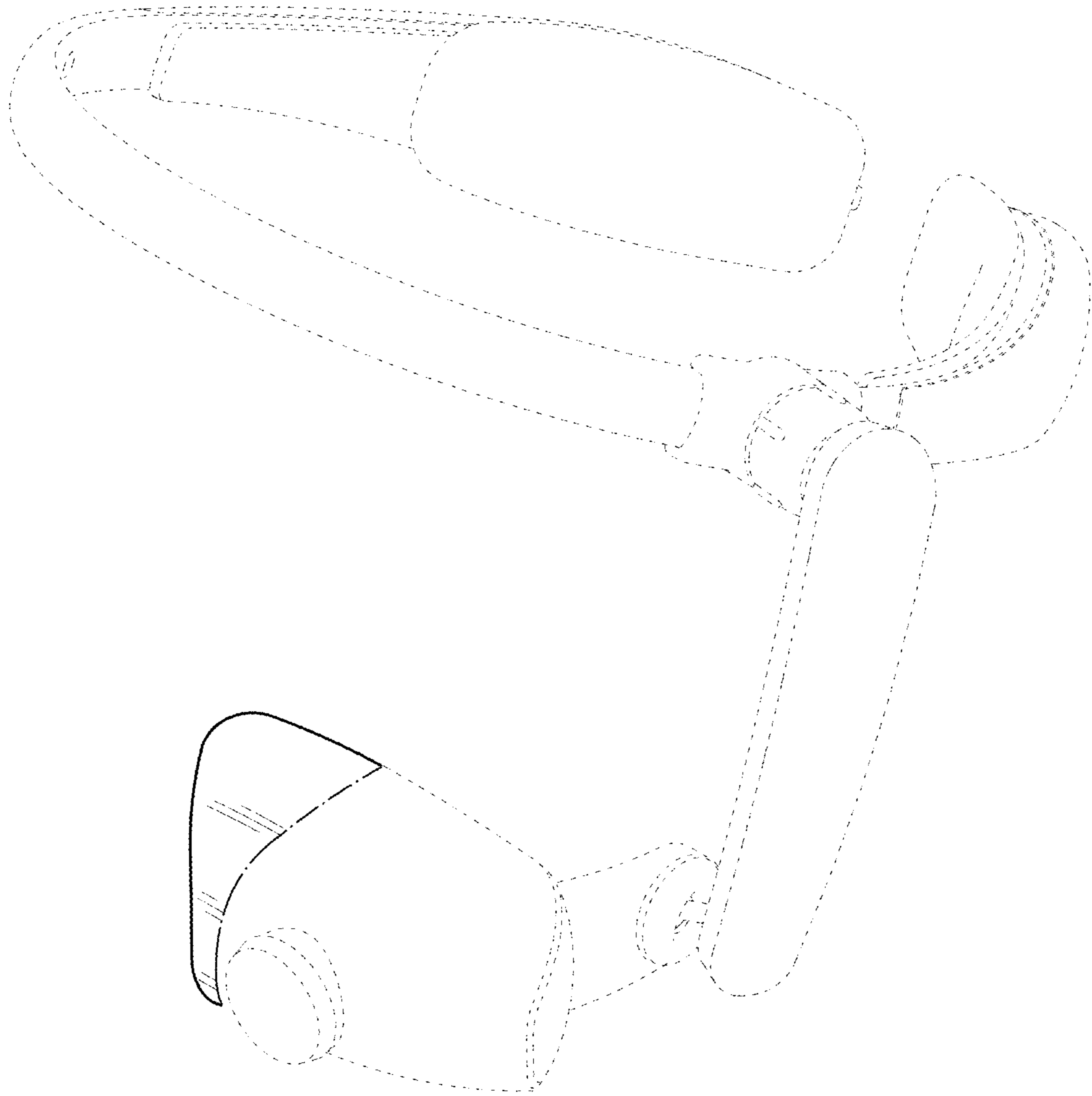

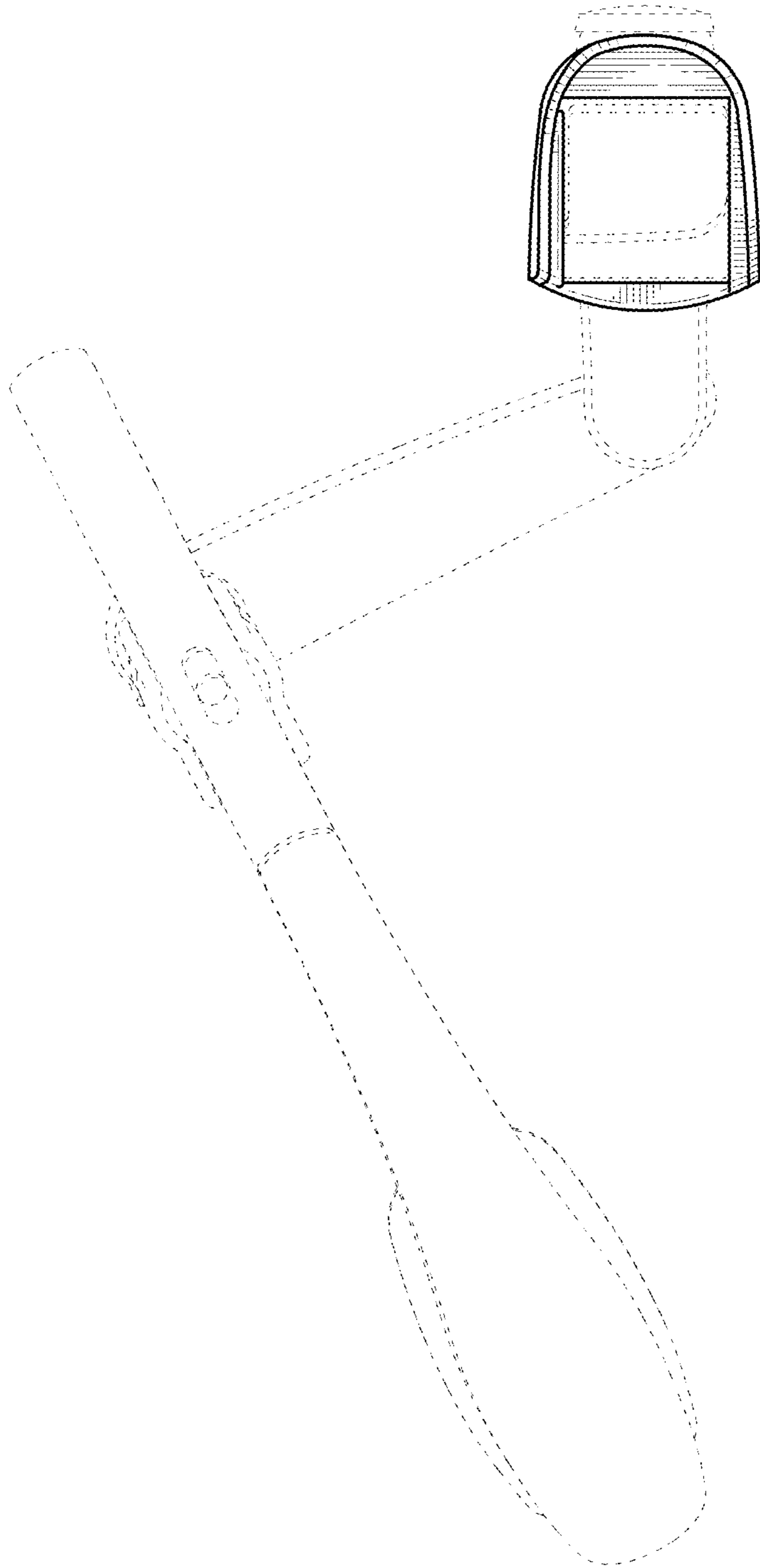

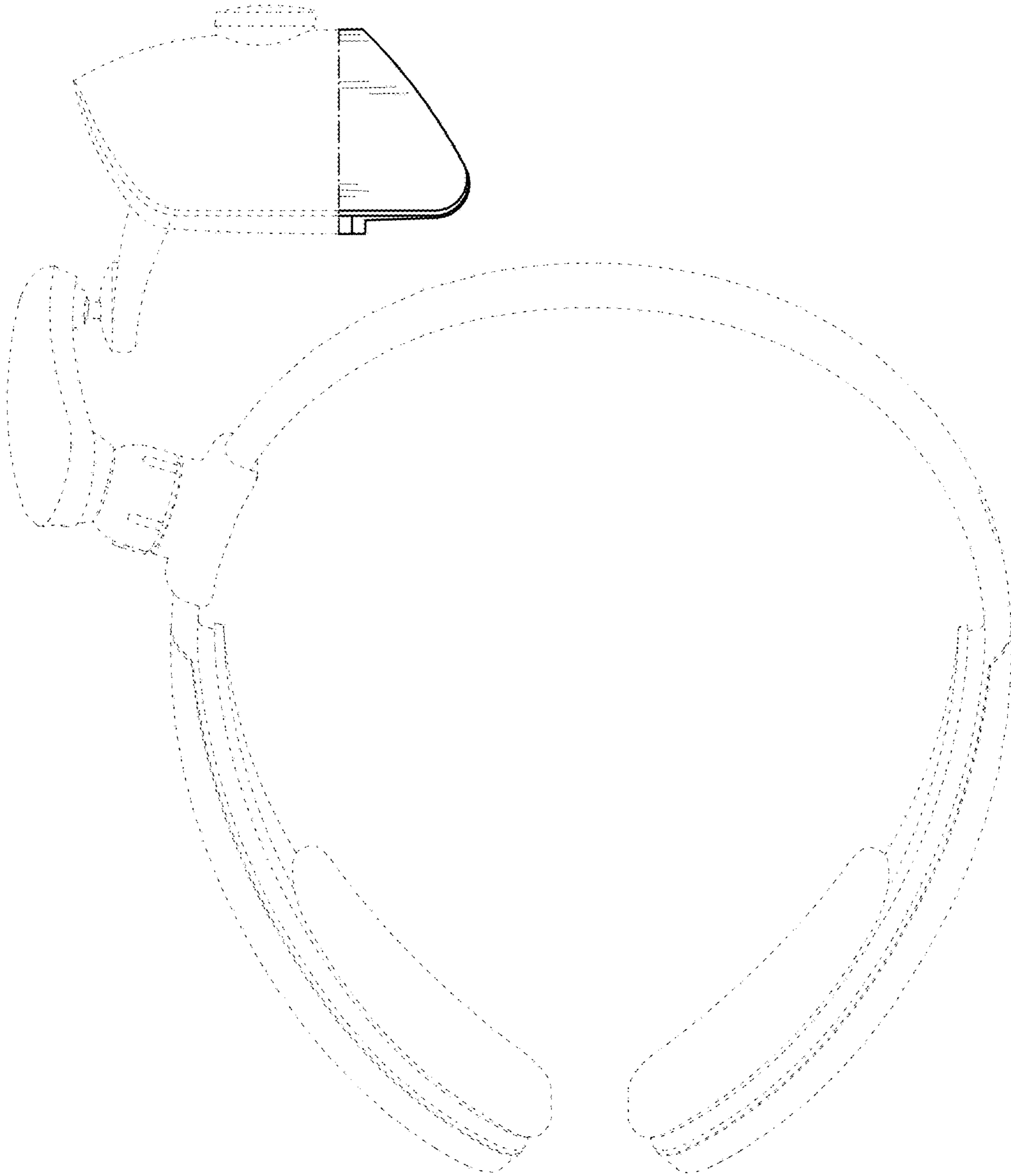

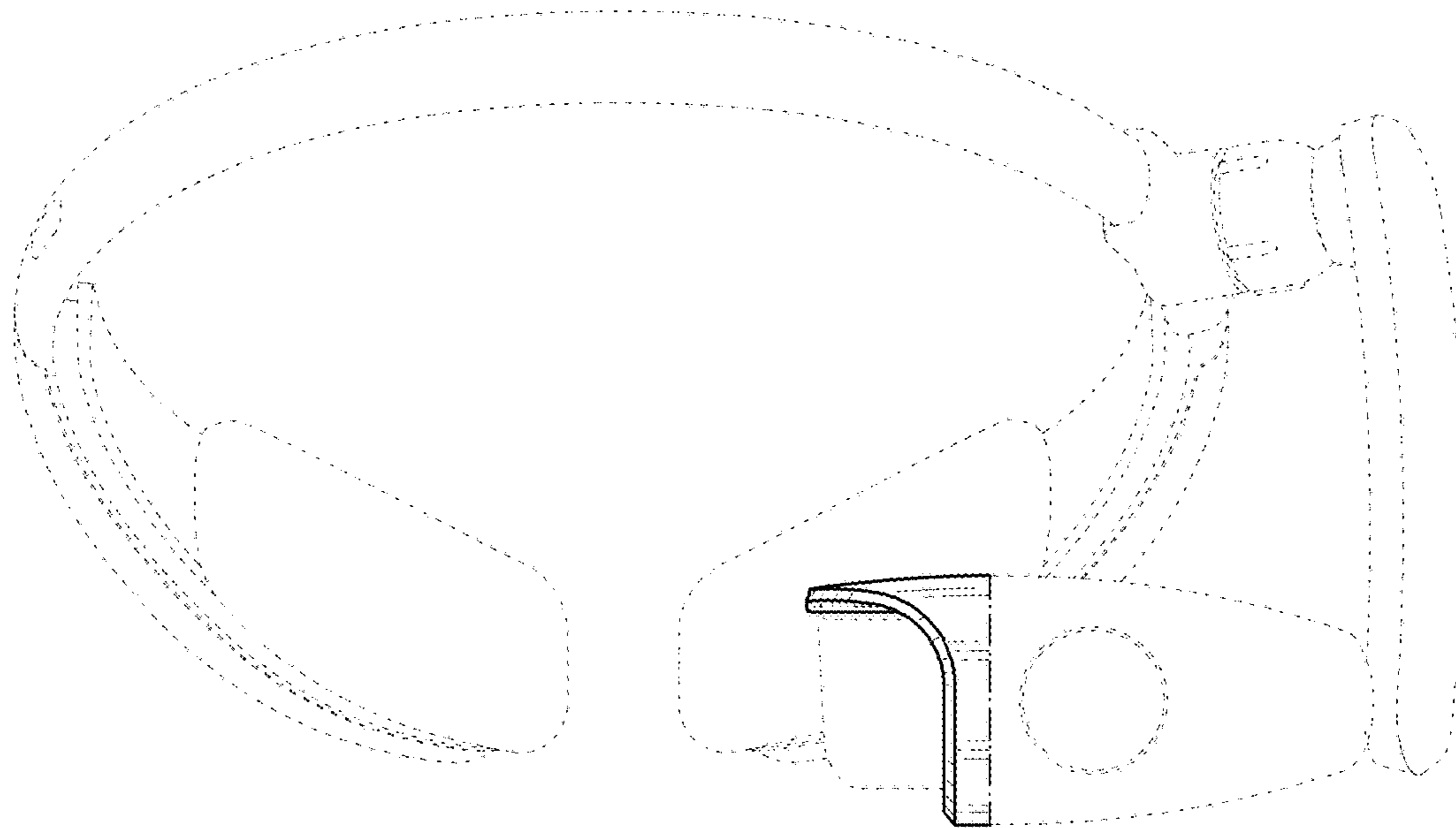

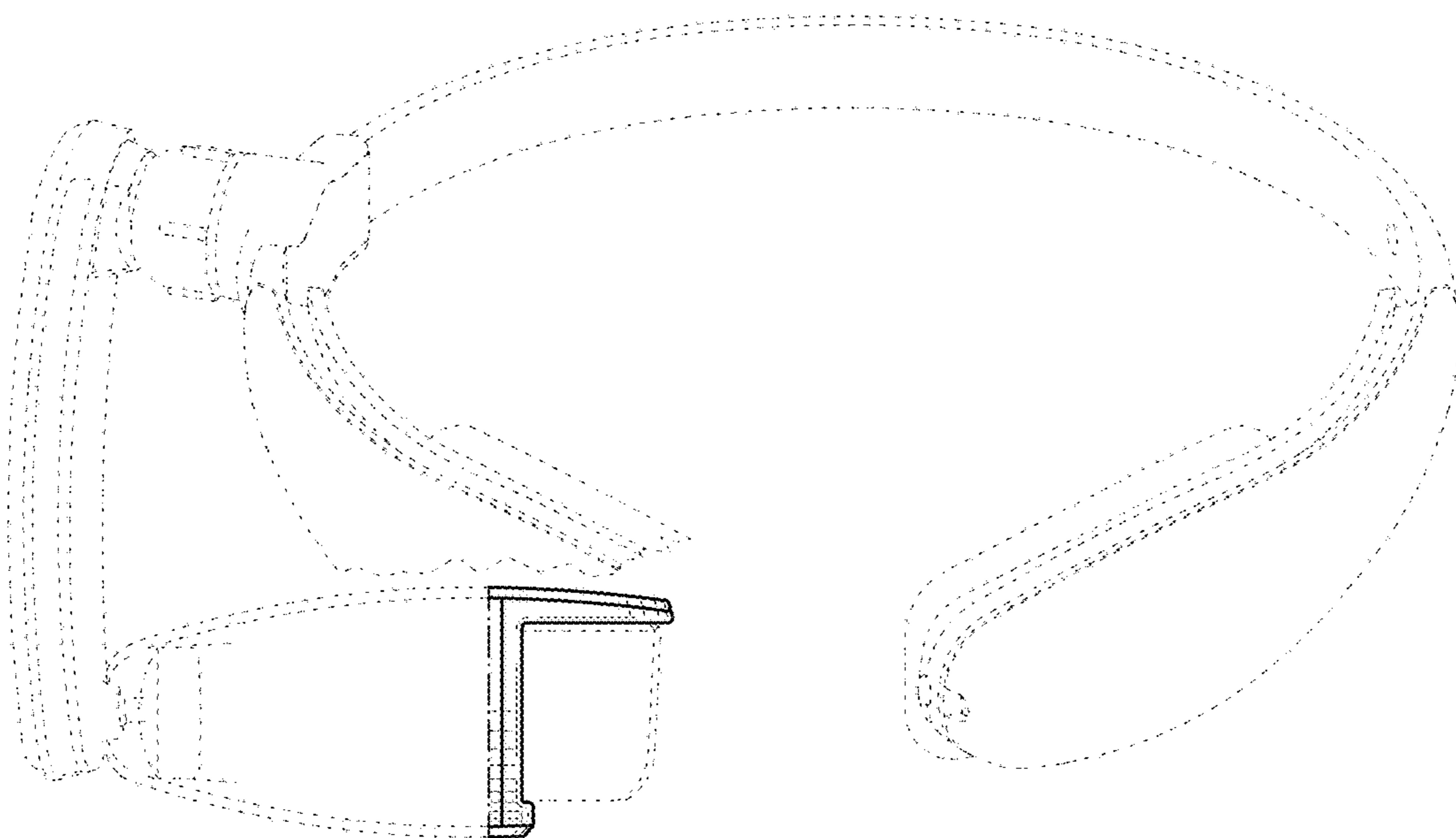

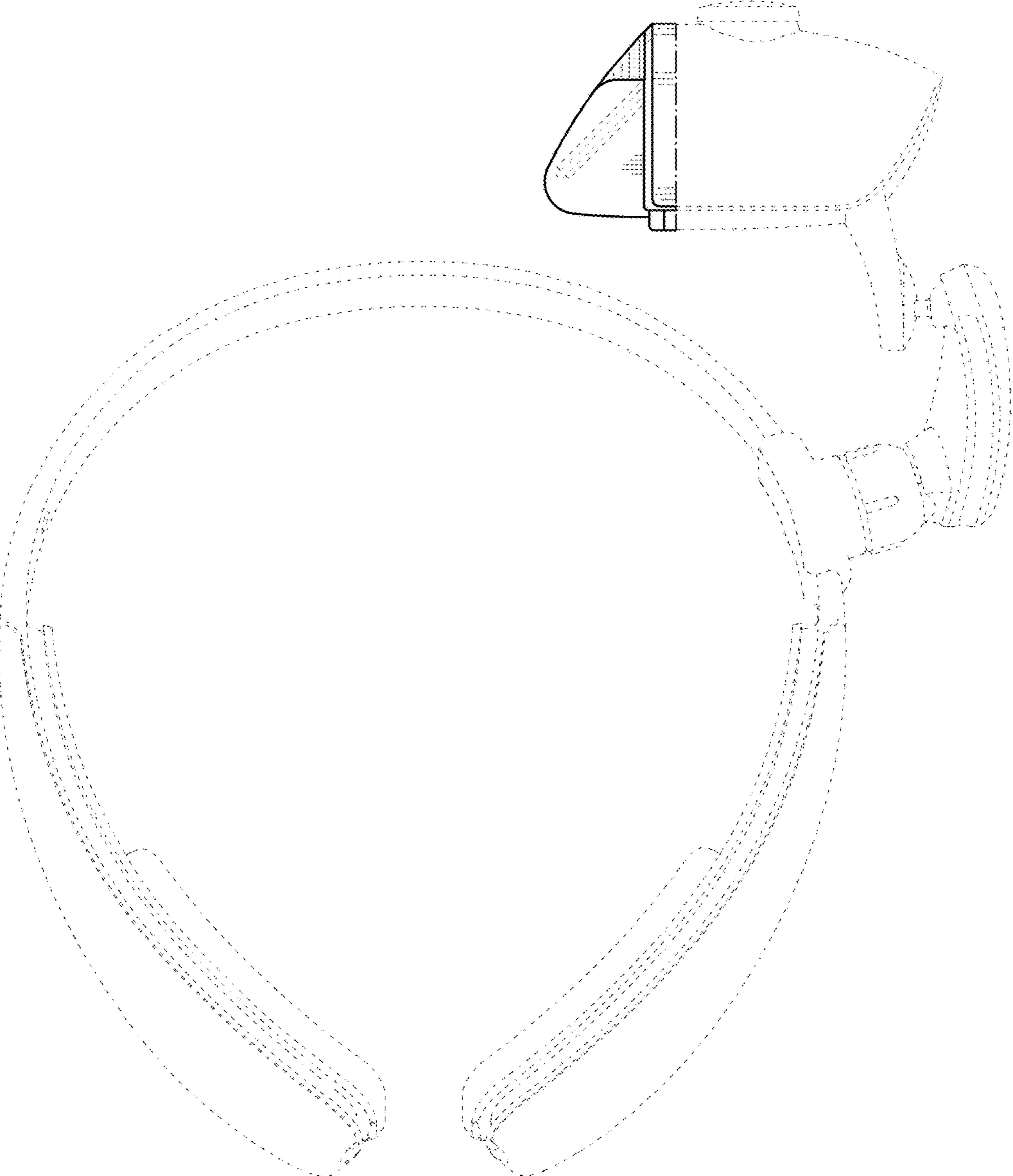

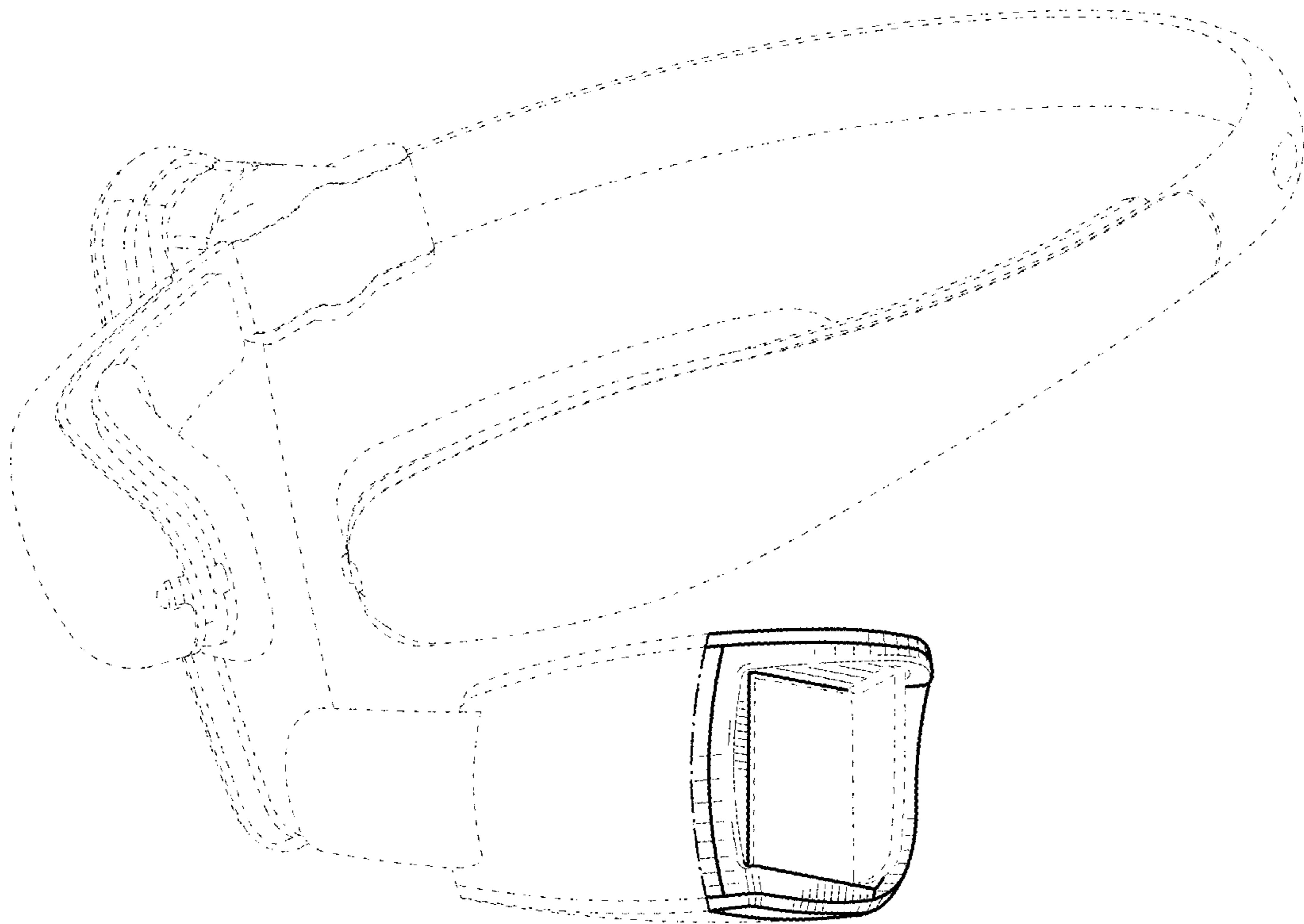
