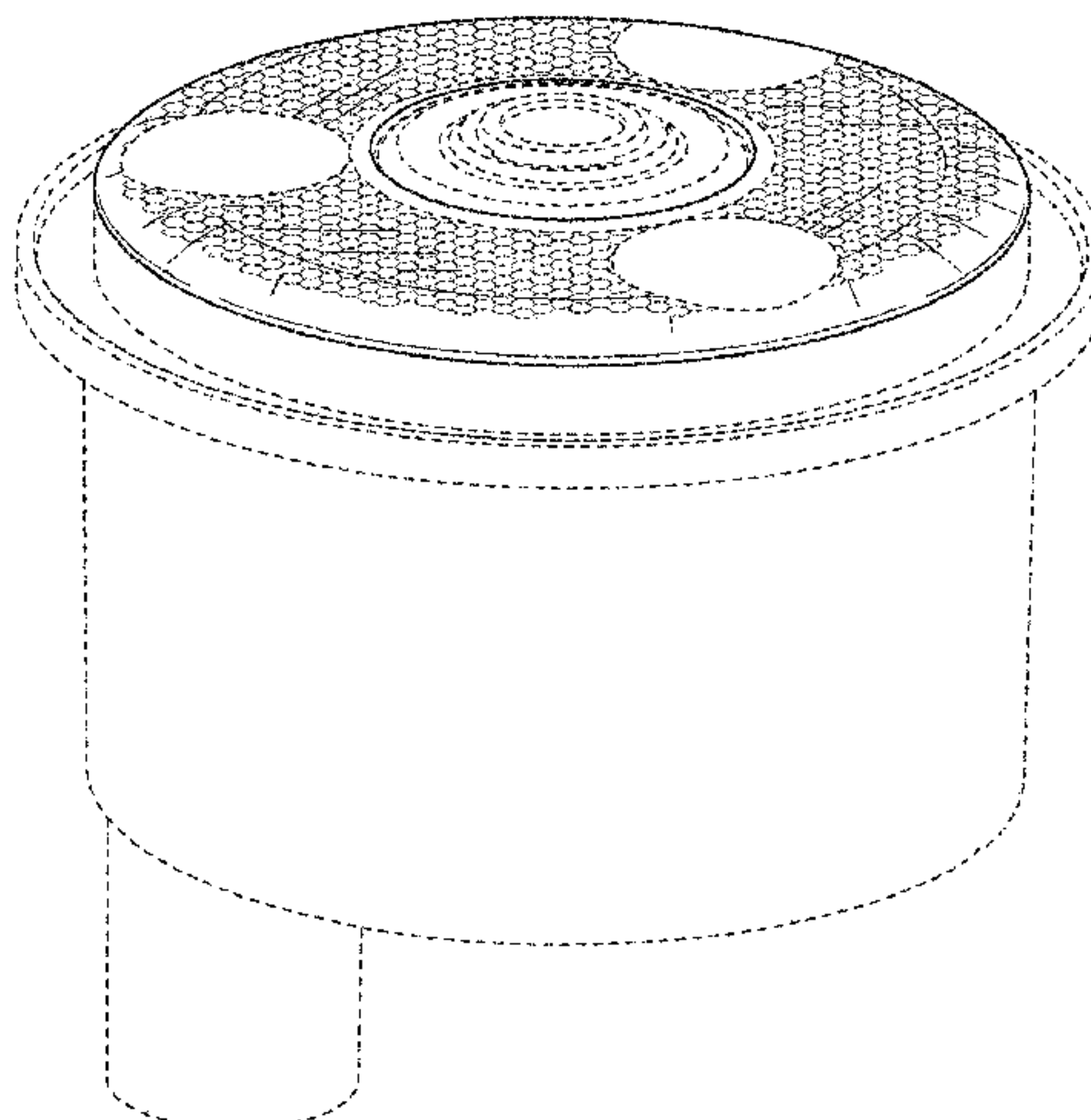
(57) **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of our ornamental design for  
a front face for an illuminating water bubbler;

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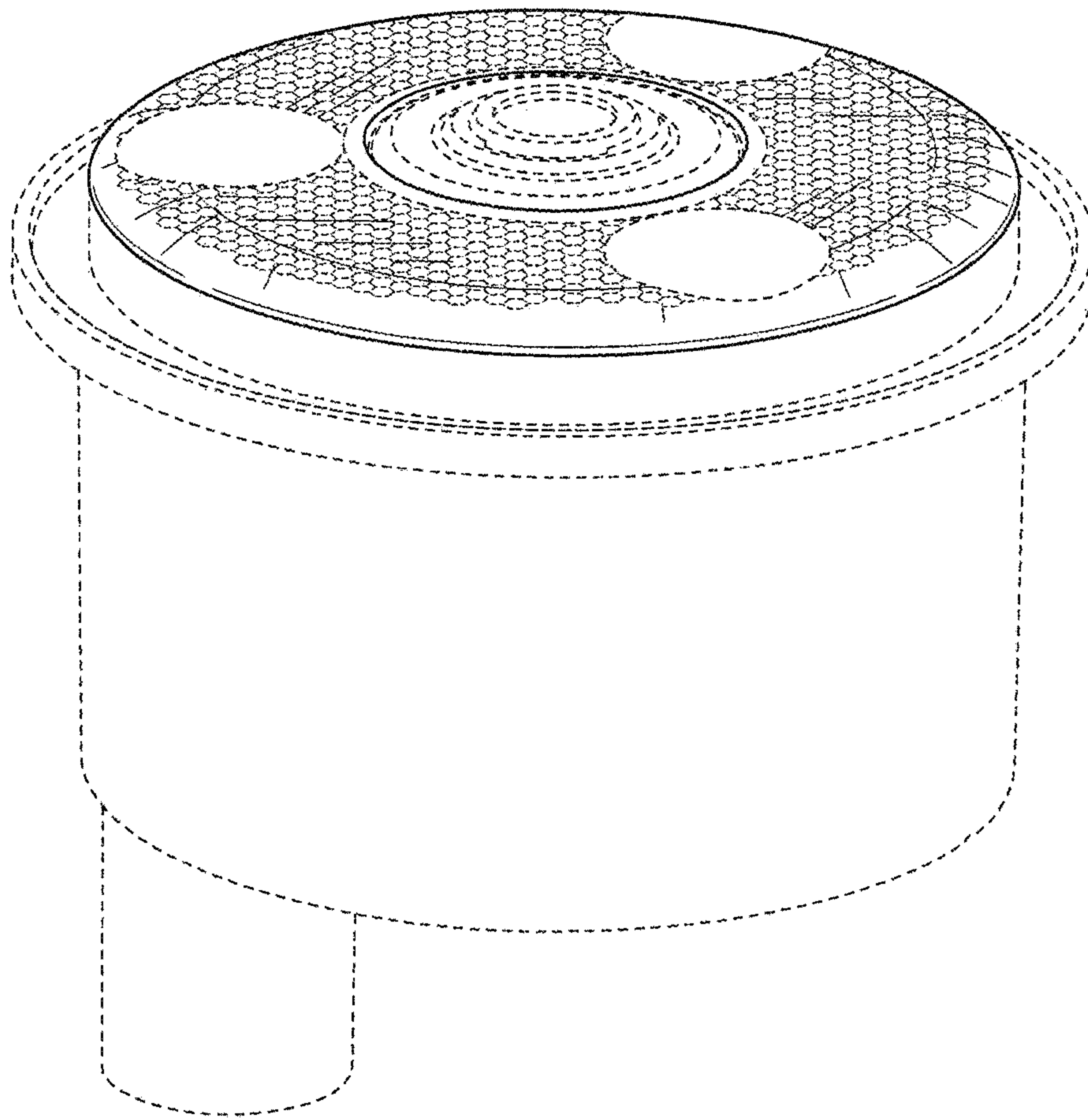

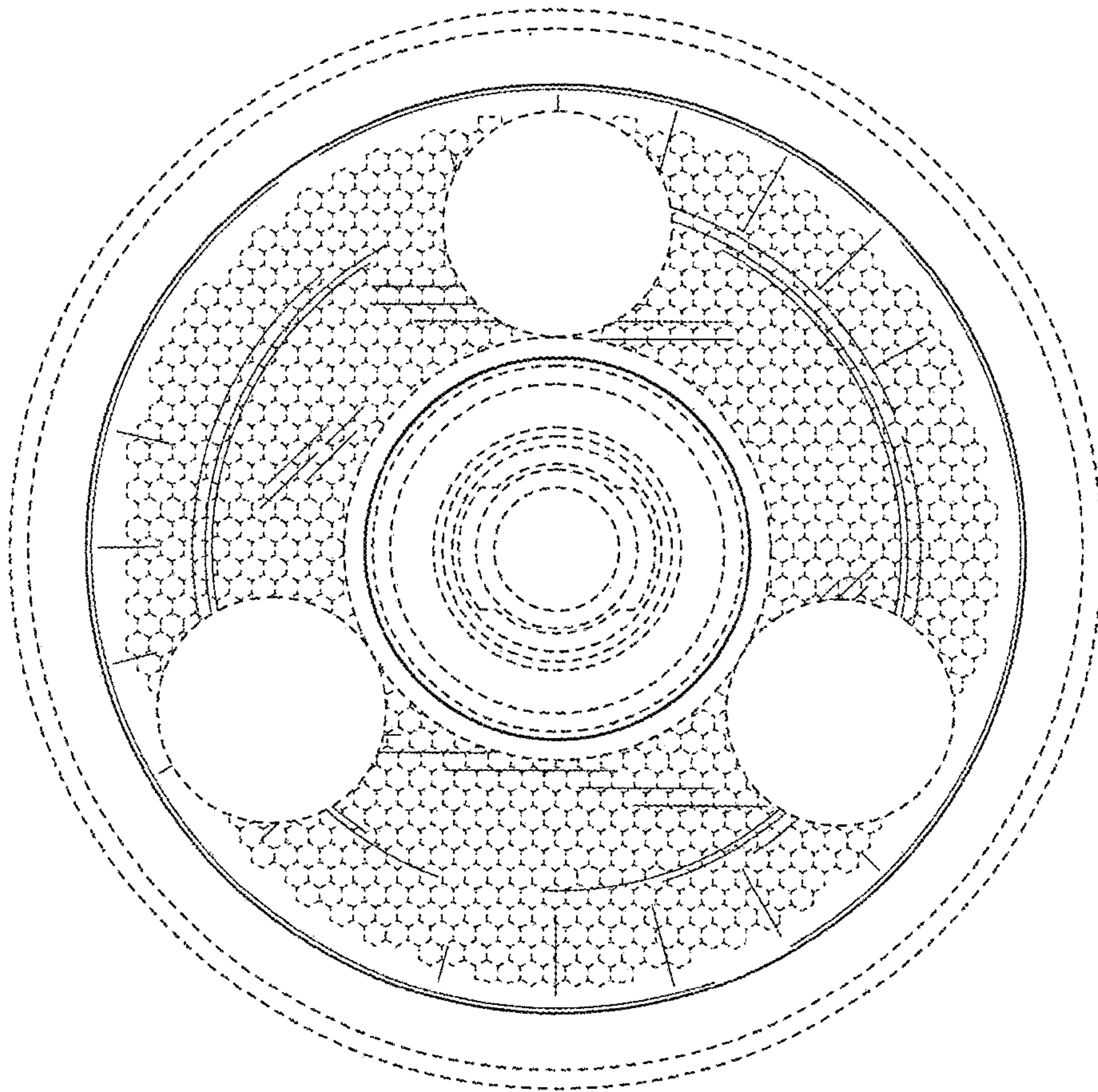

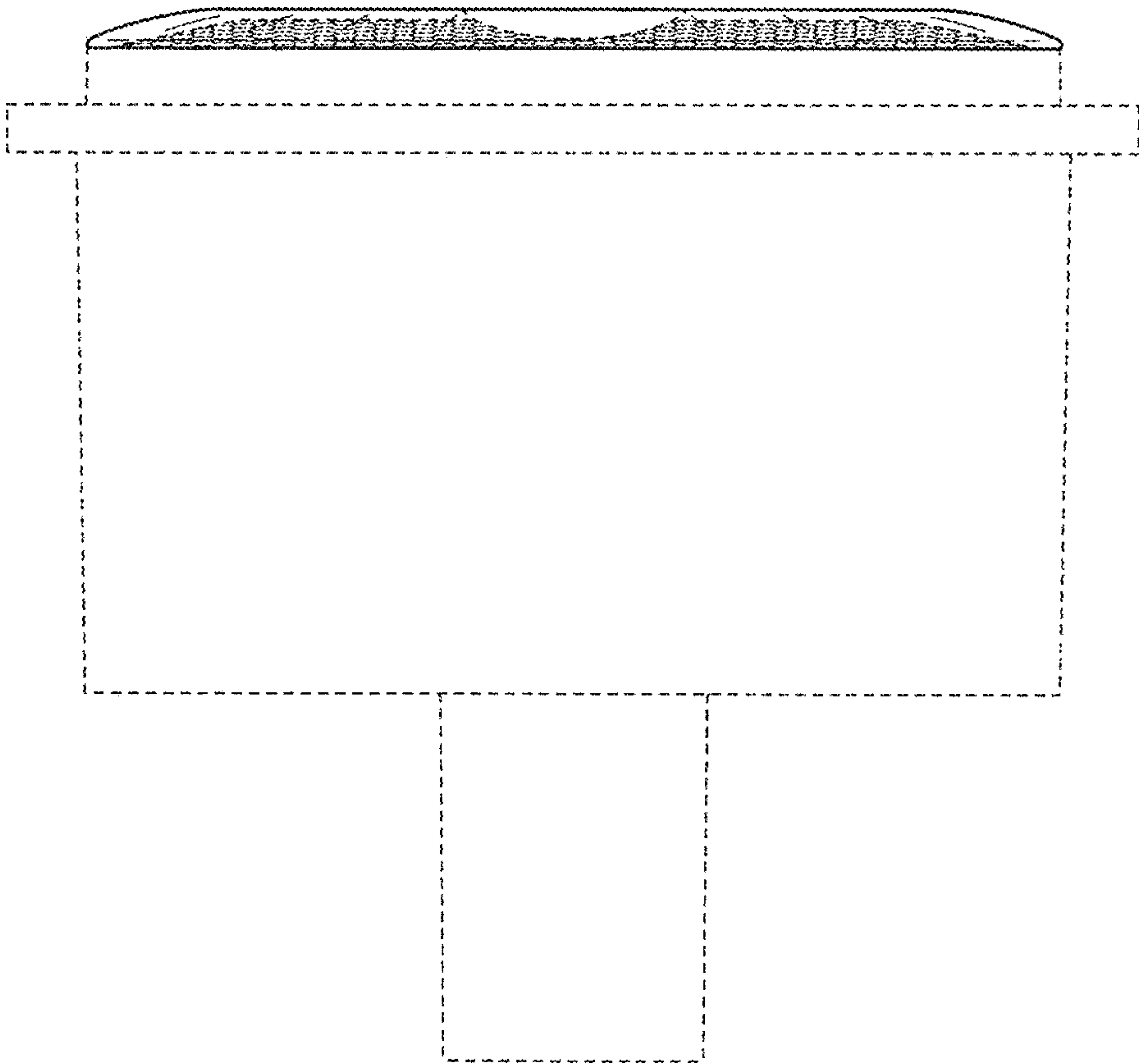

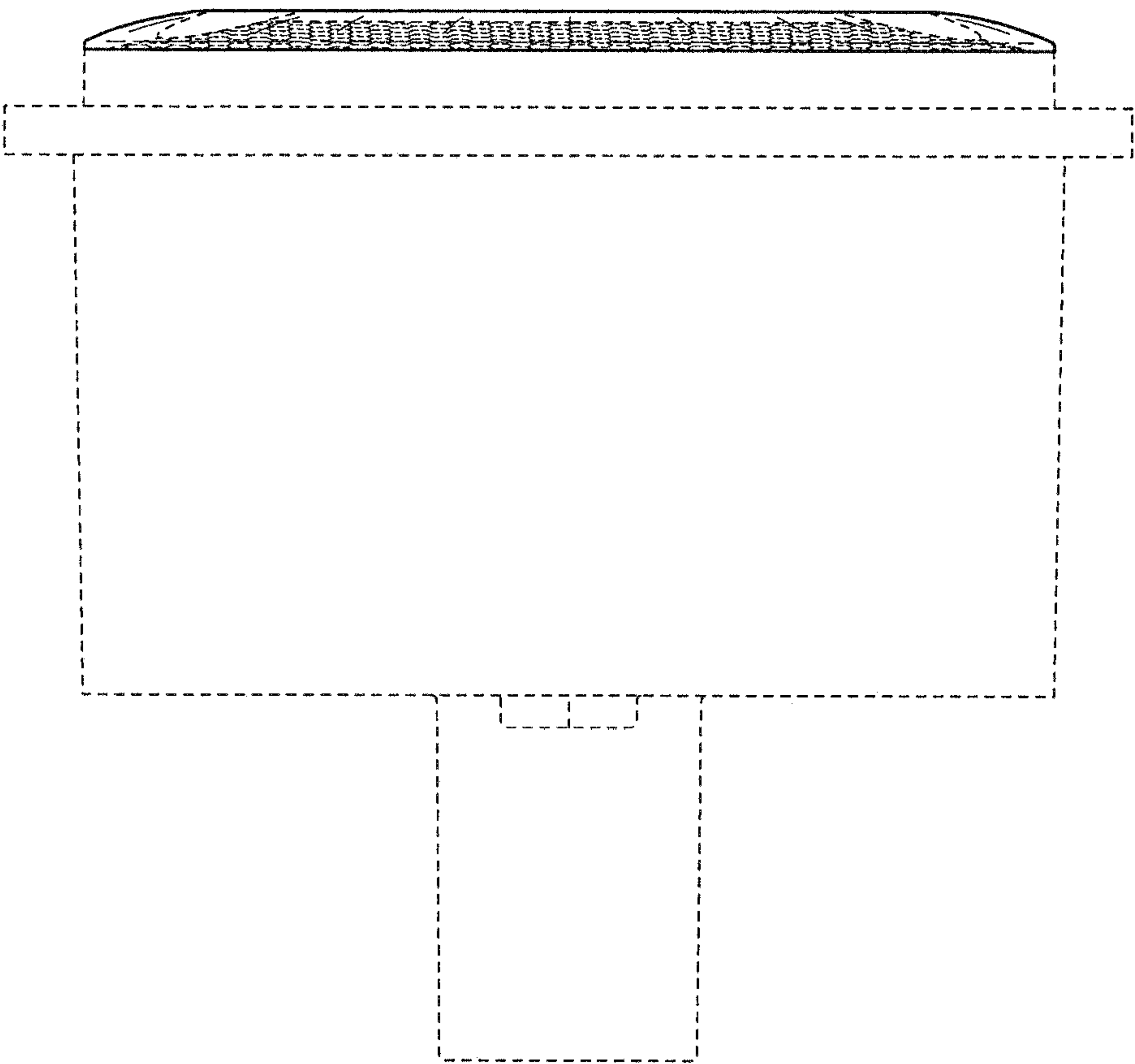

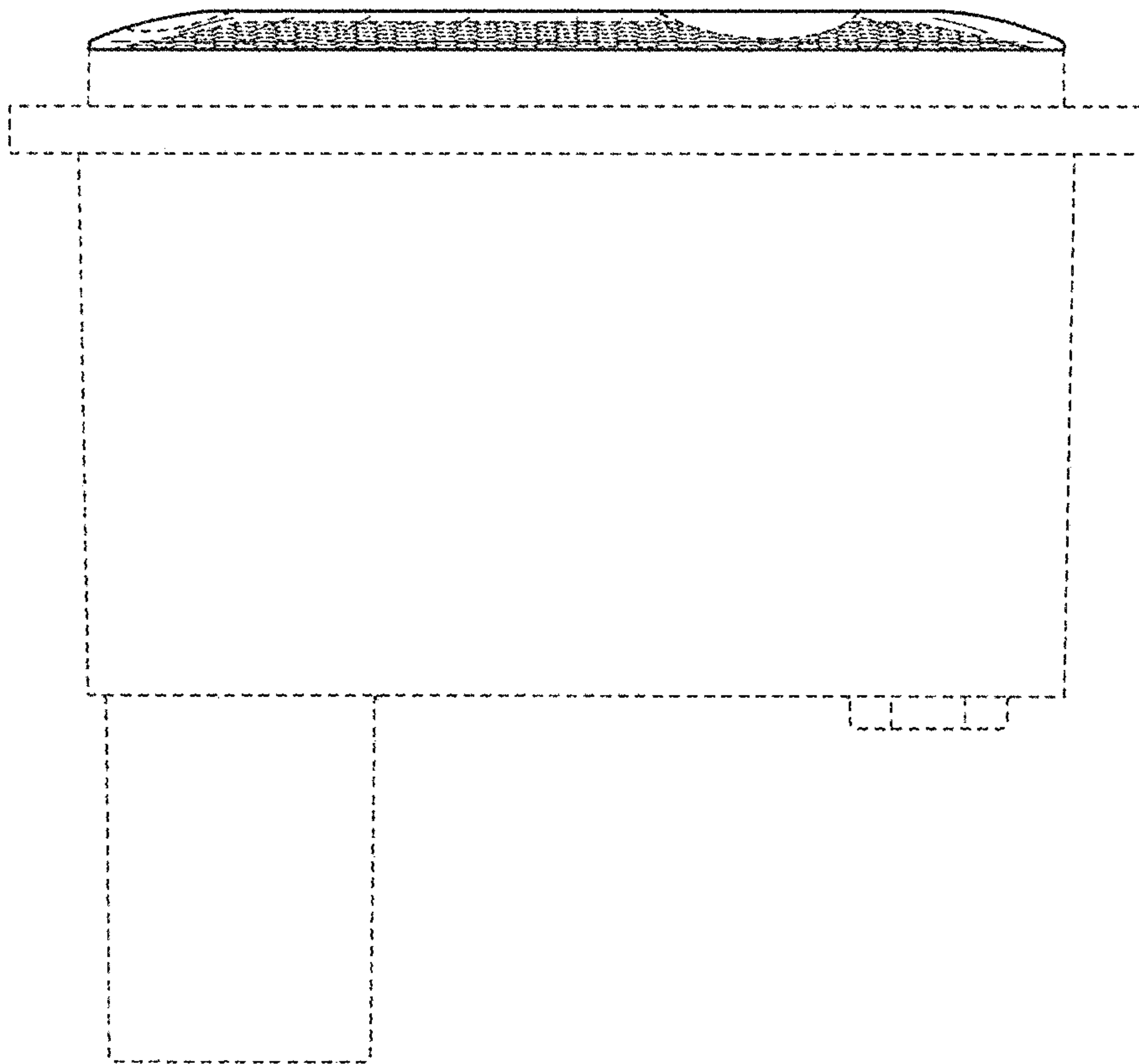

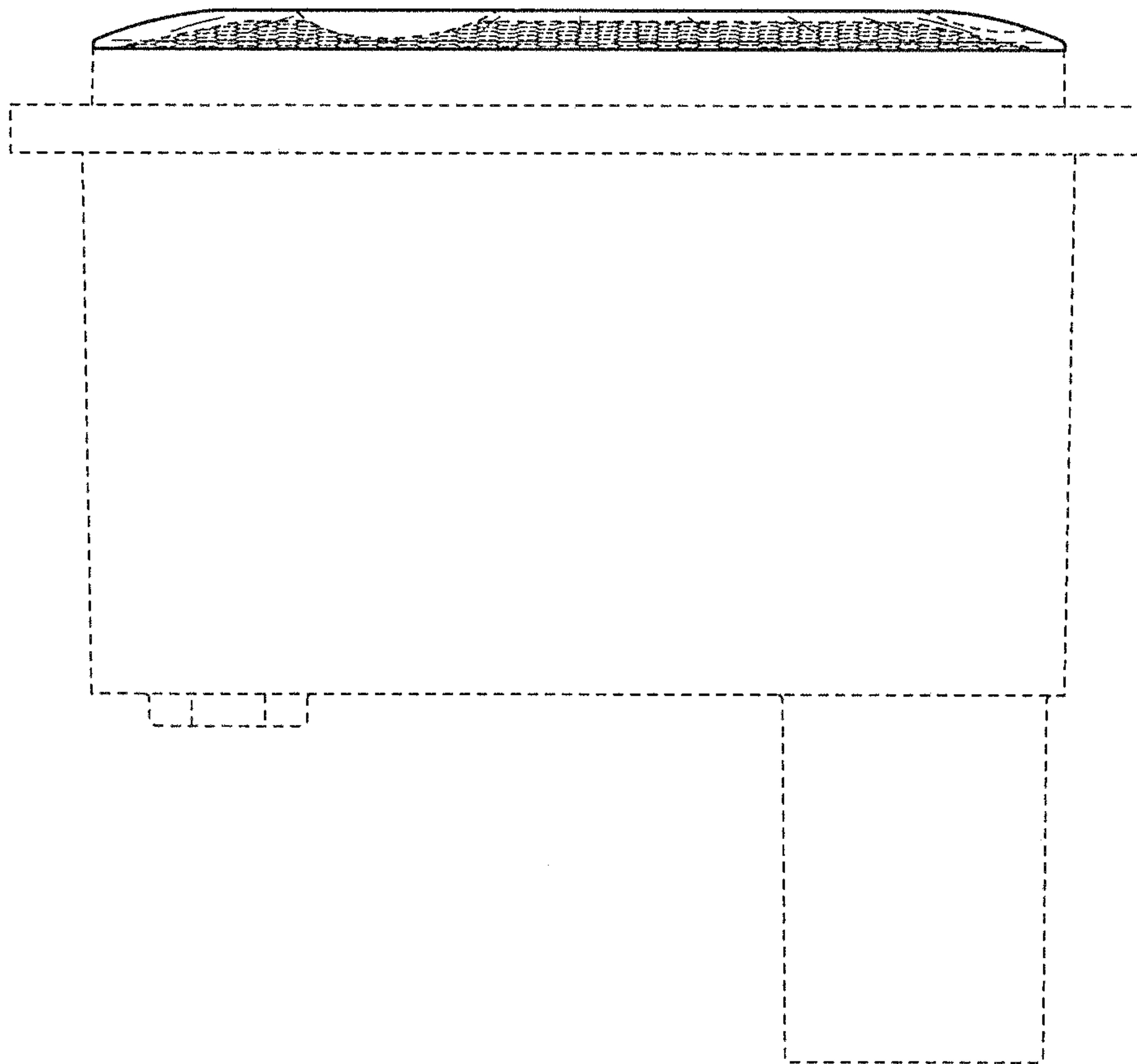

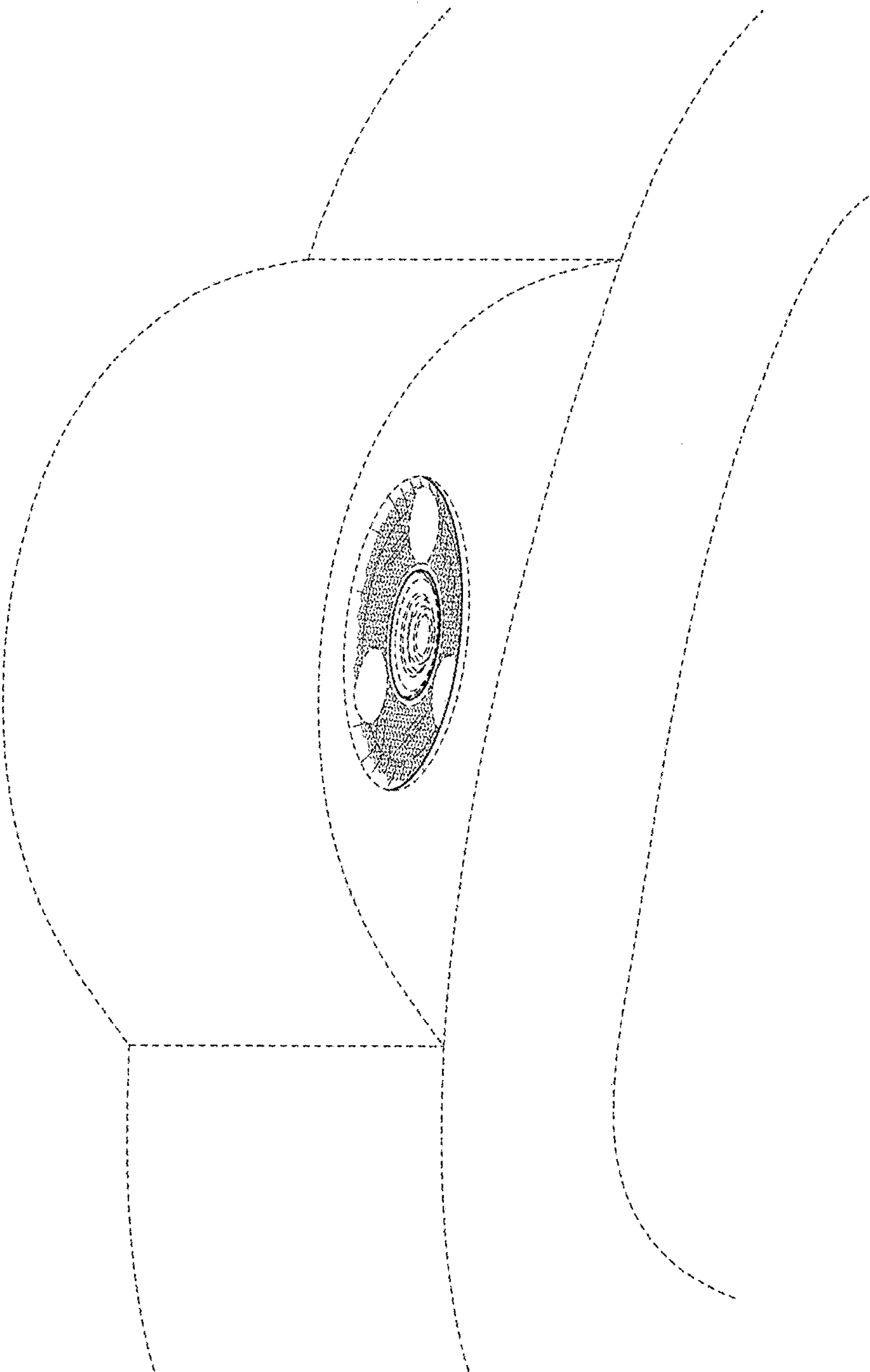
