DESCRIPTION

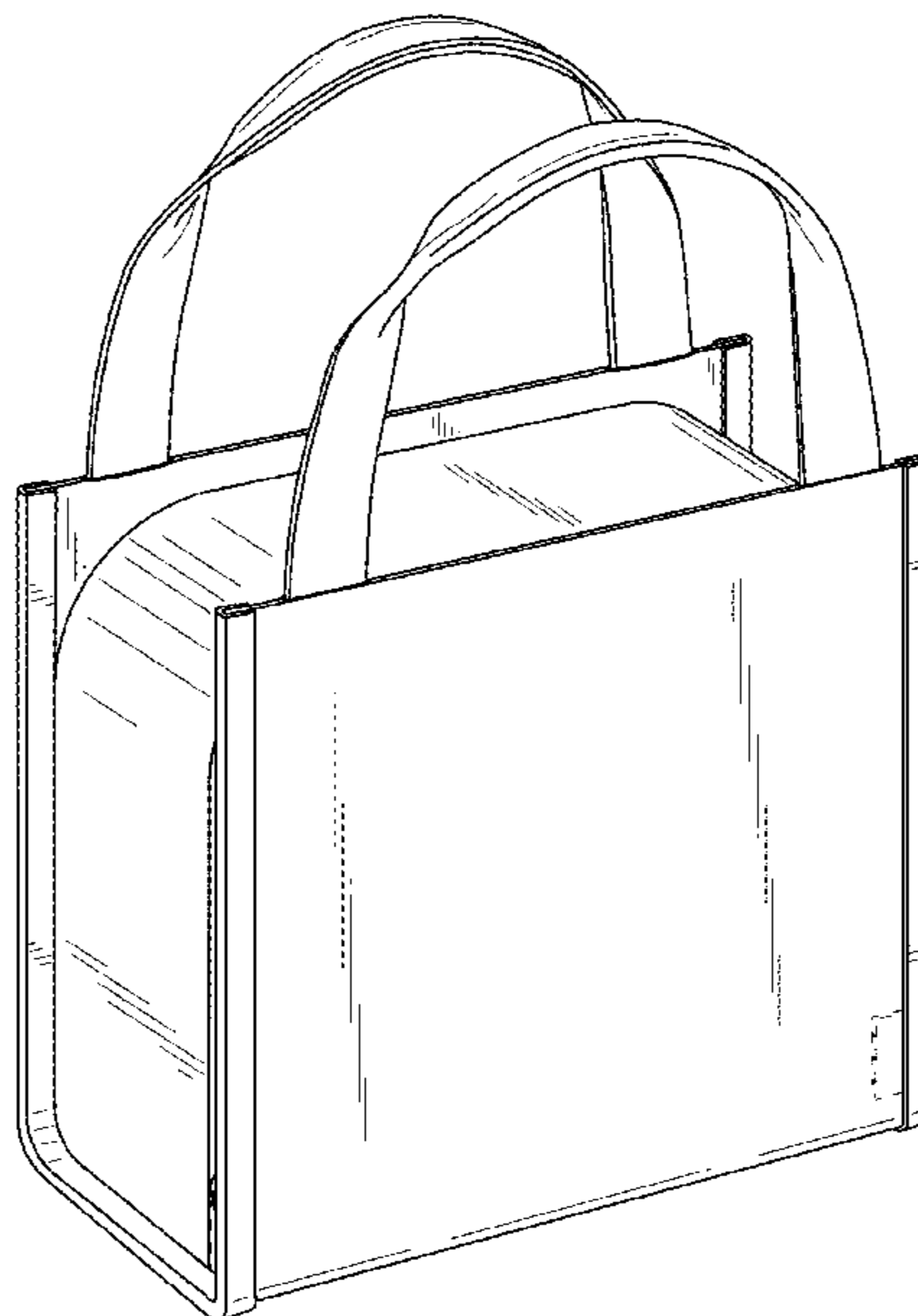
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lunch bag, showing my new design;

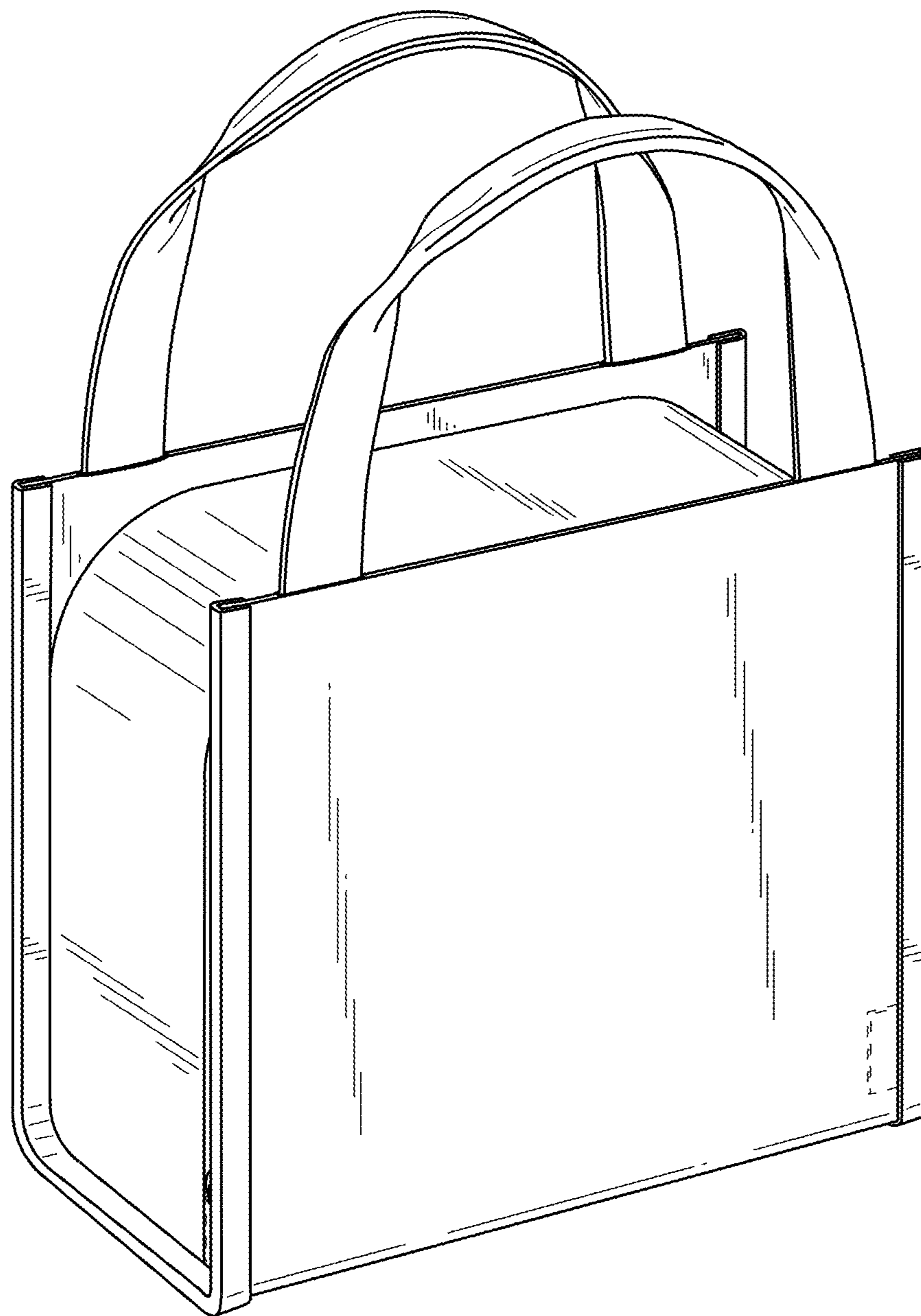

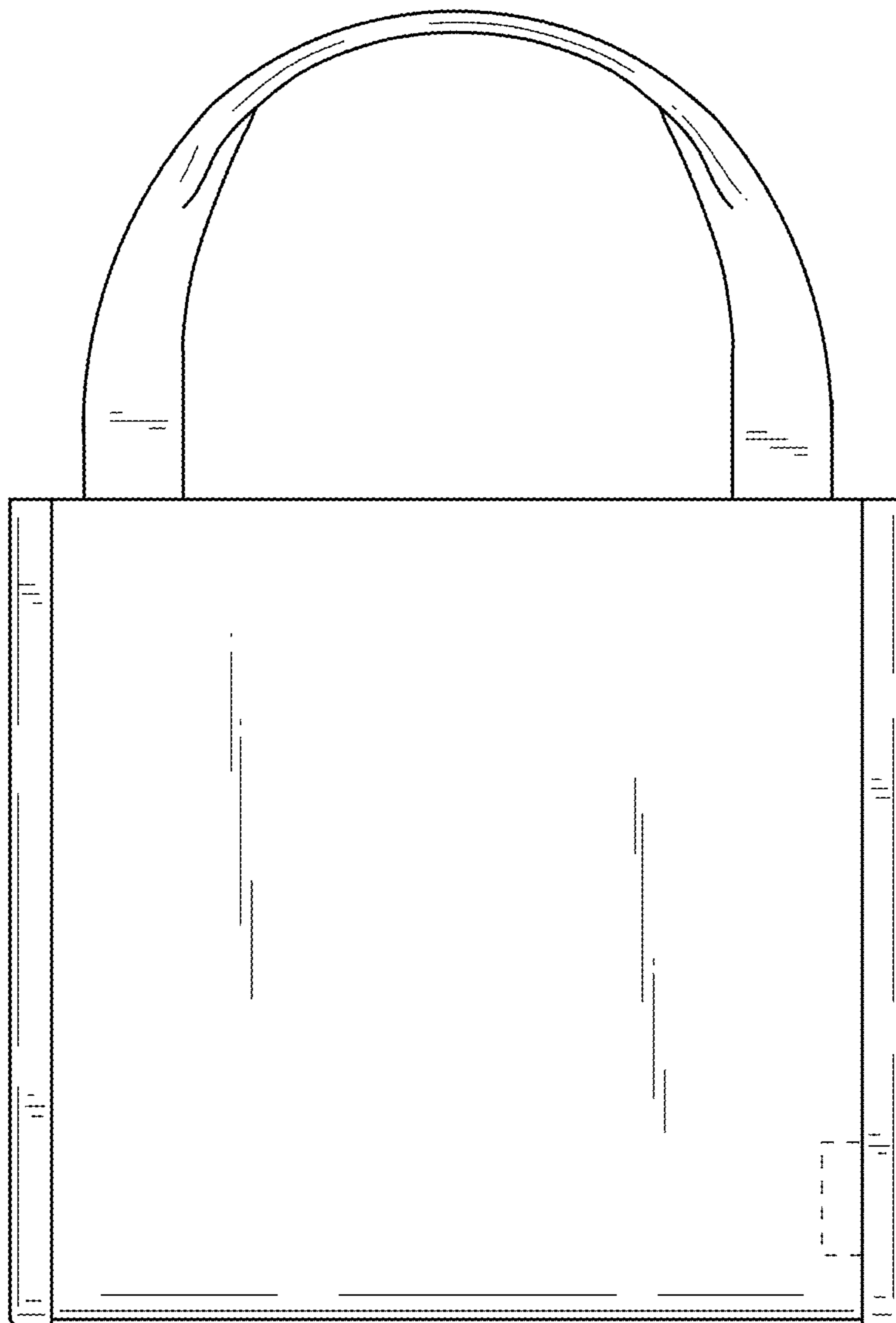

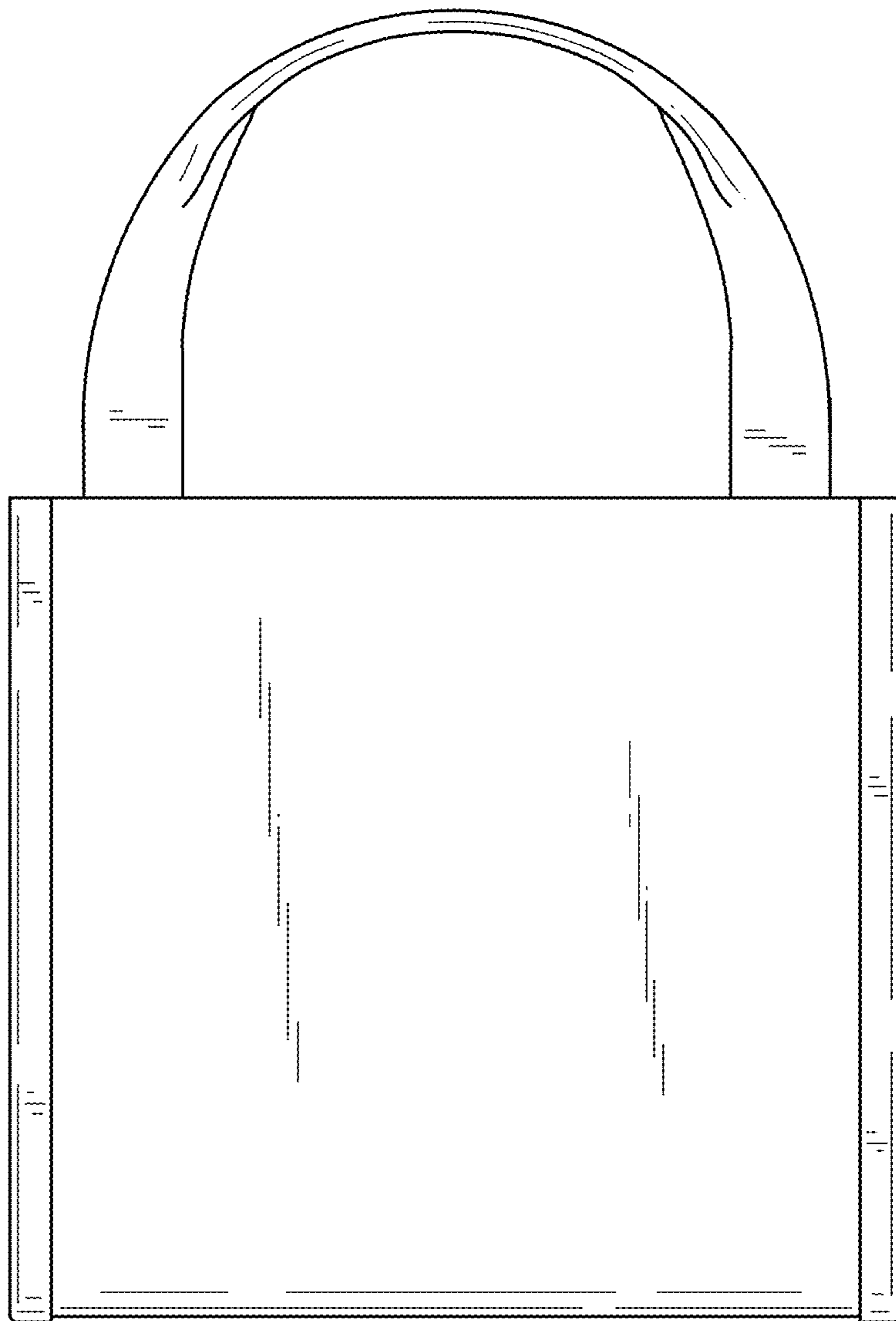

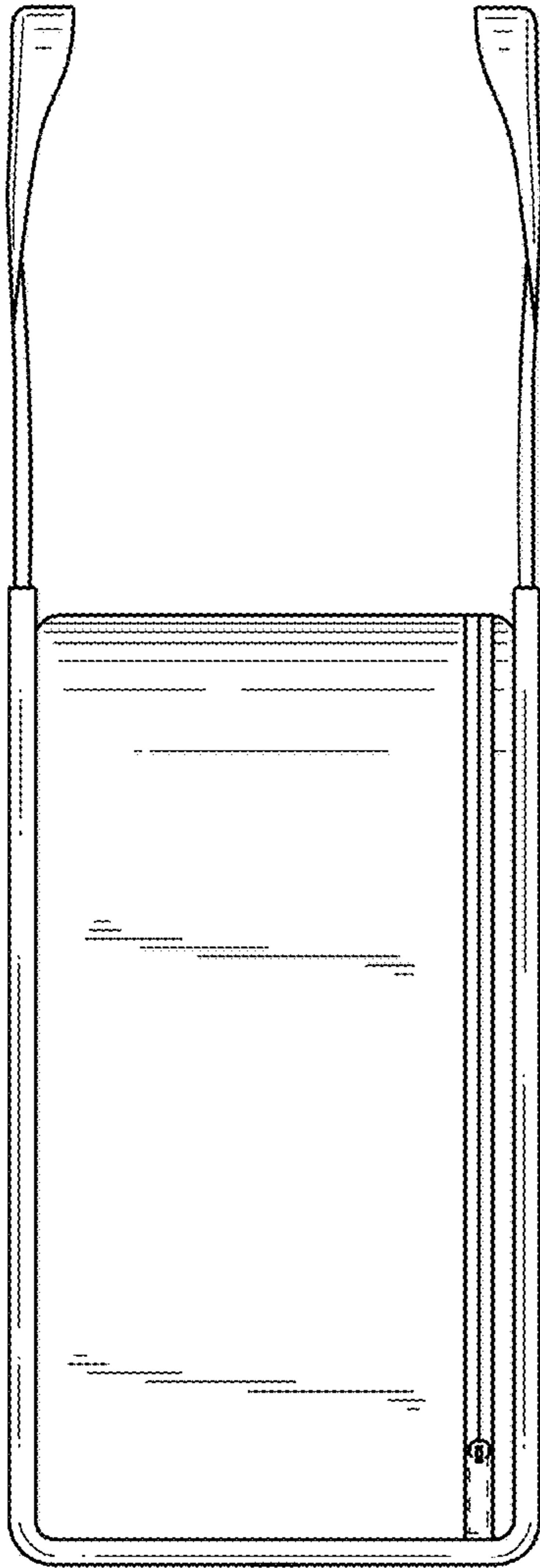

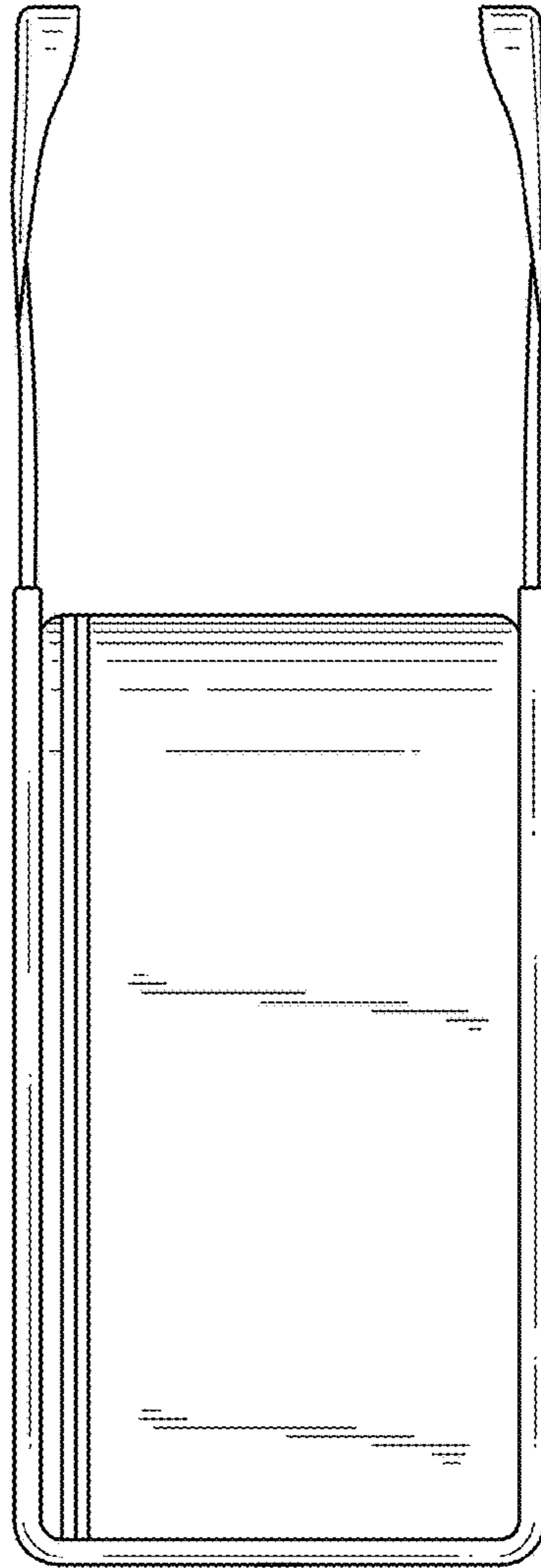

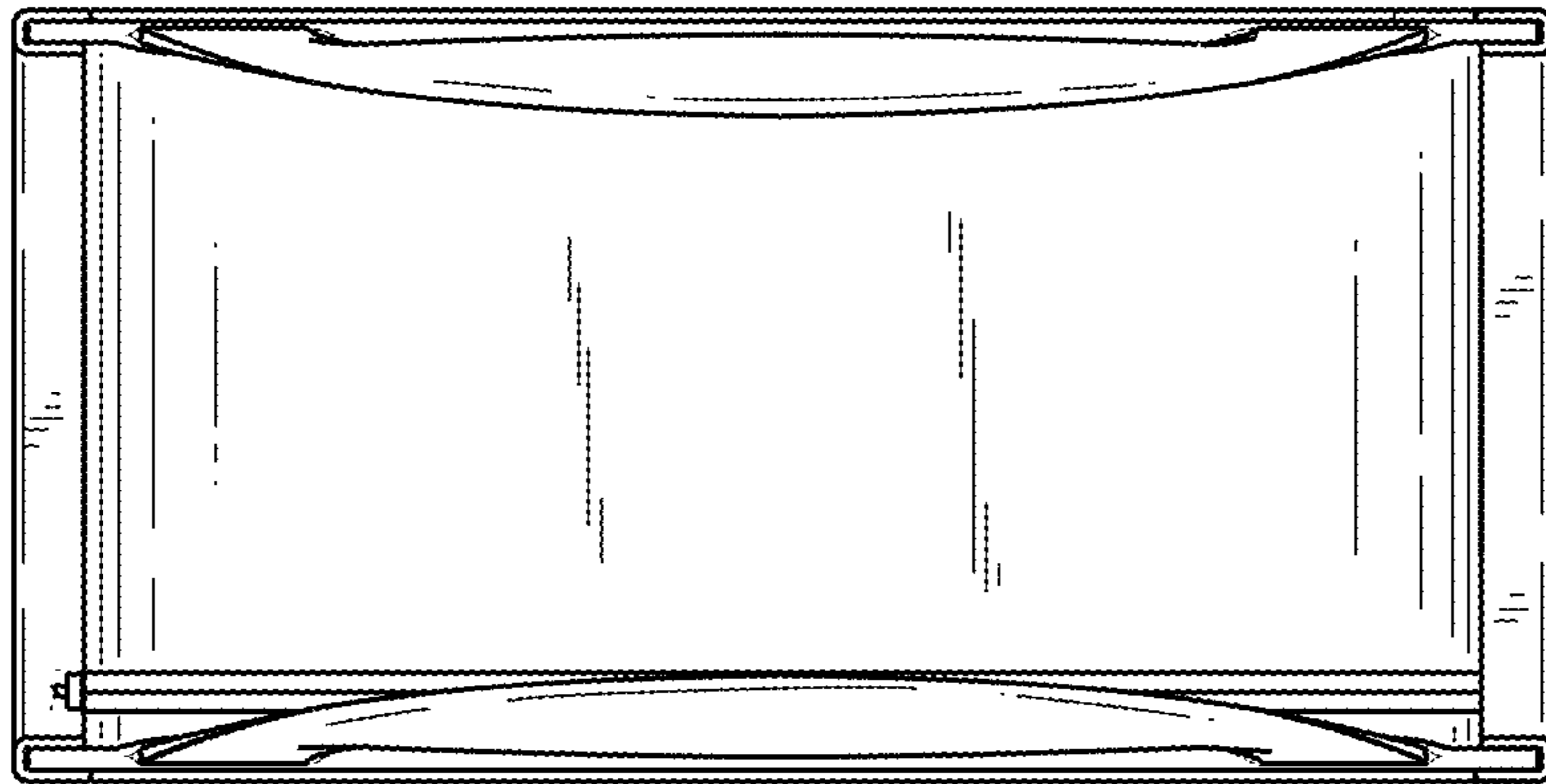

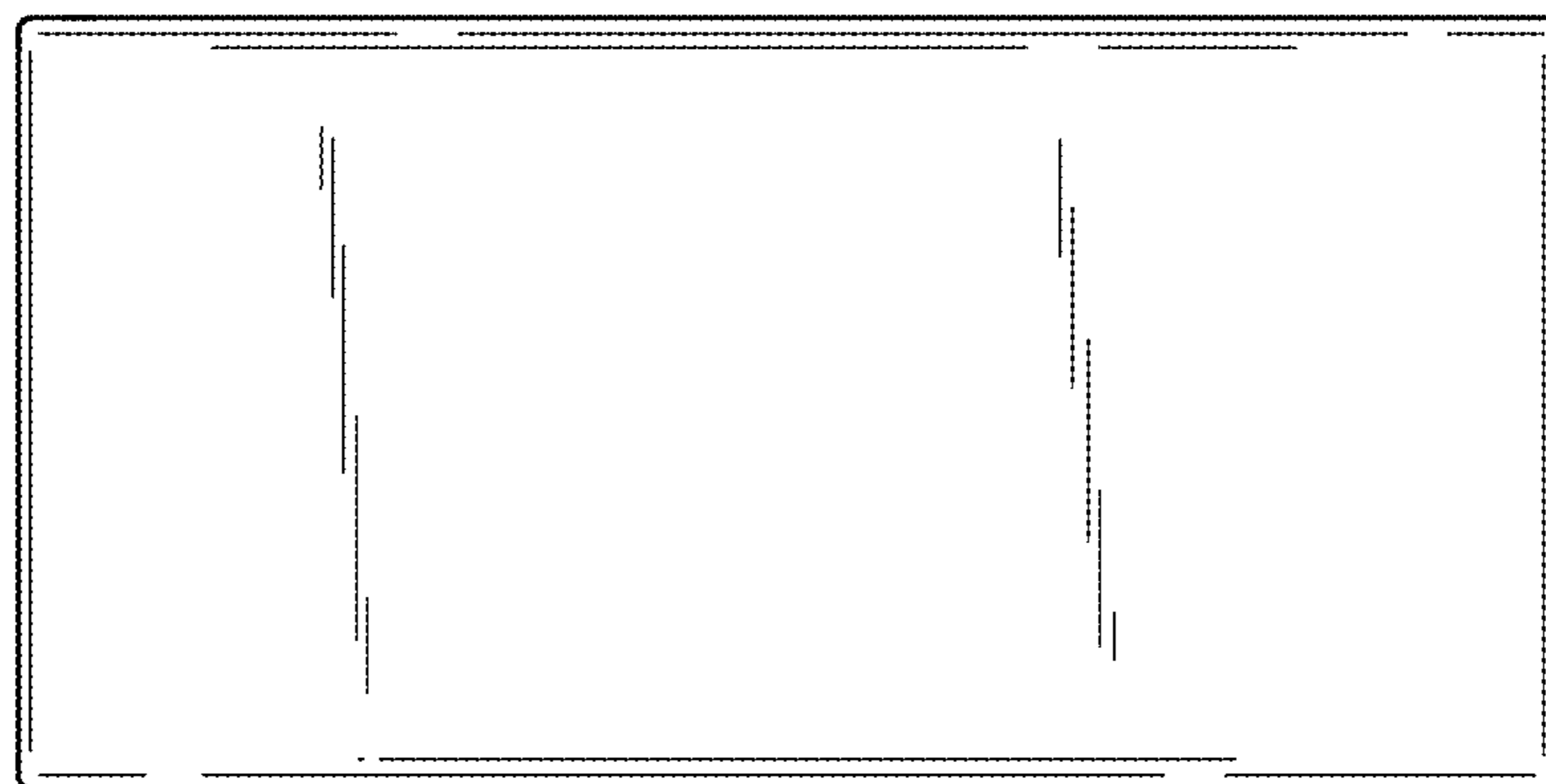
