stretcher, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a baby evacuation
stretcher in a tensioned and operative configuration.

FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of the baby evacuation
stretcher of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 3 is a top perspective view of the baby evacuation
stretcher of FIG. 1 in a flat and relaxed configuration with
the dashed securement straps of FIG. 1 removed.

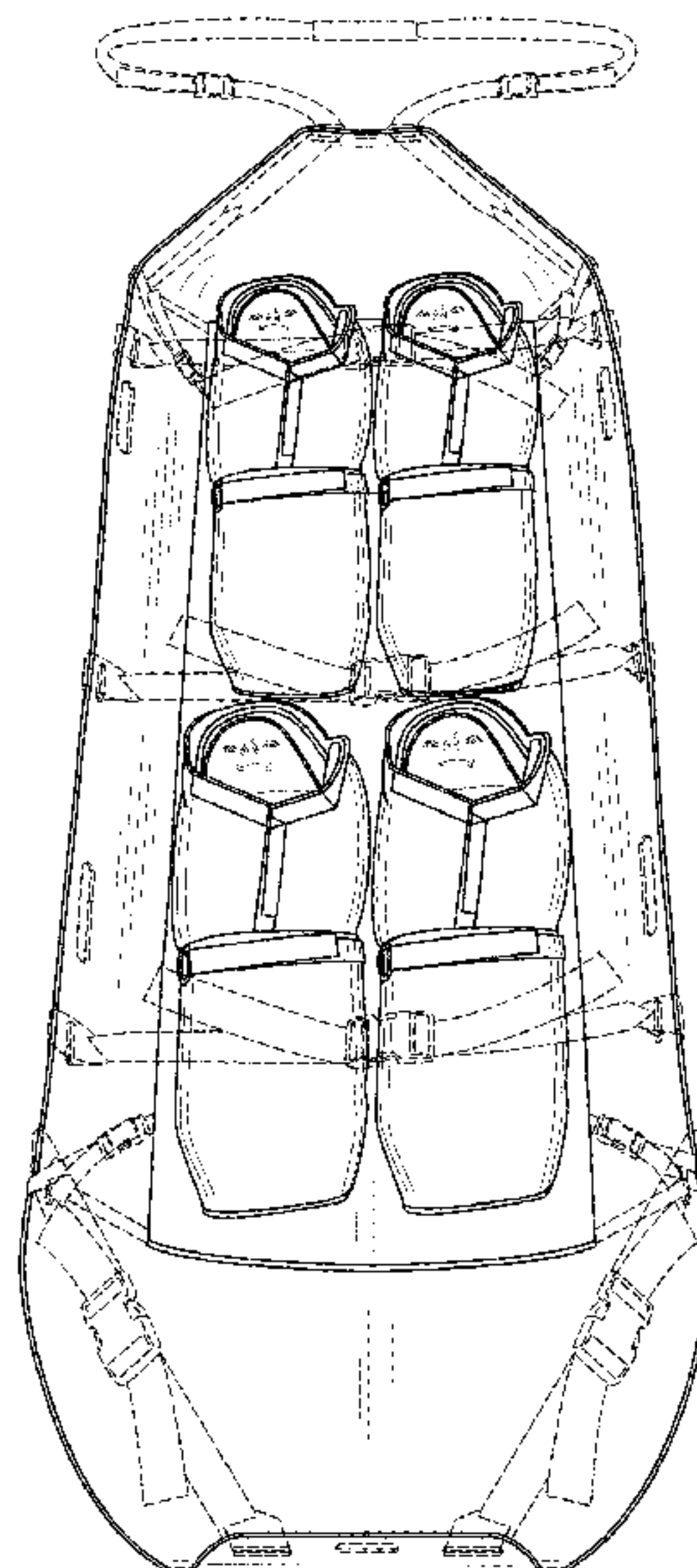
In FIGS. 1-3, the dashed lines showing a plurality of babies

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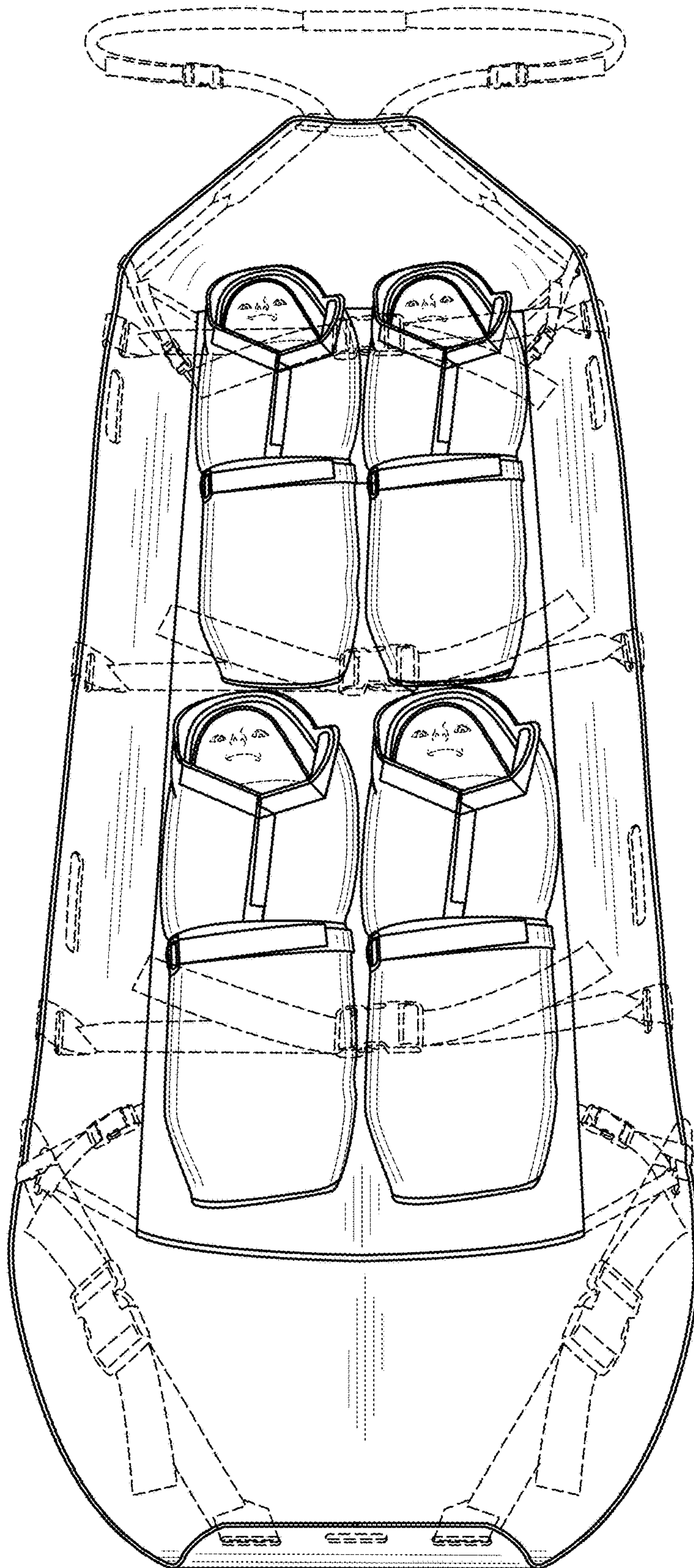

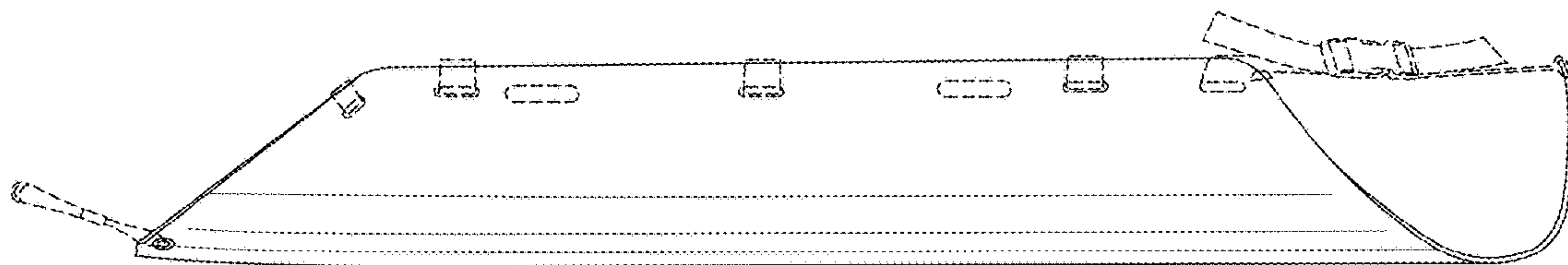

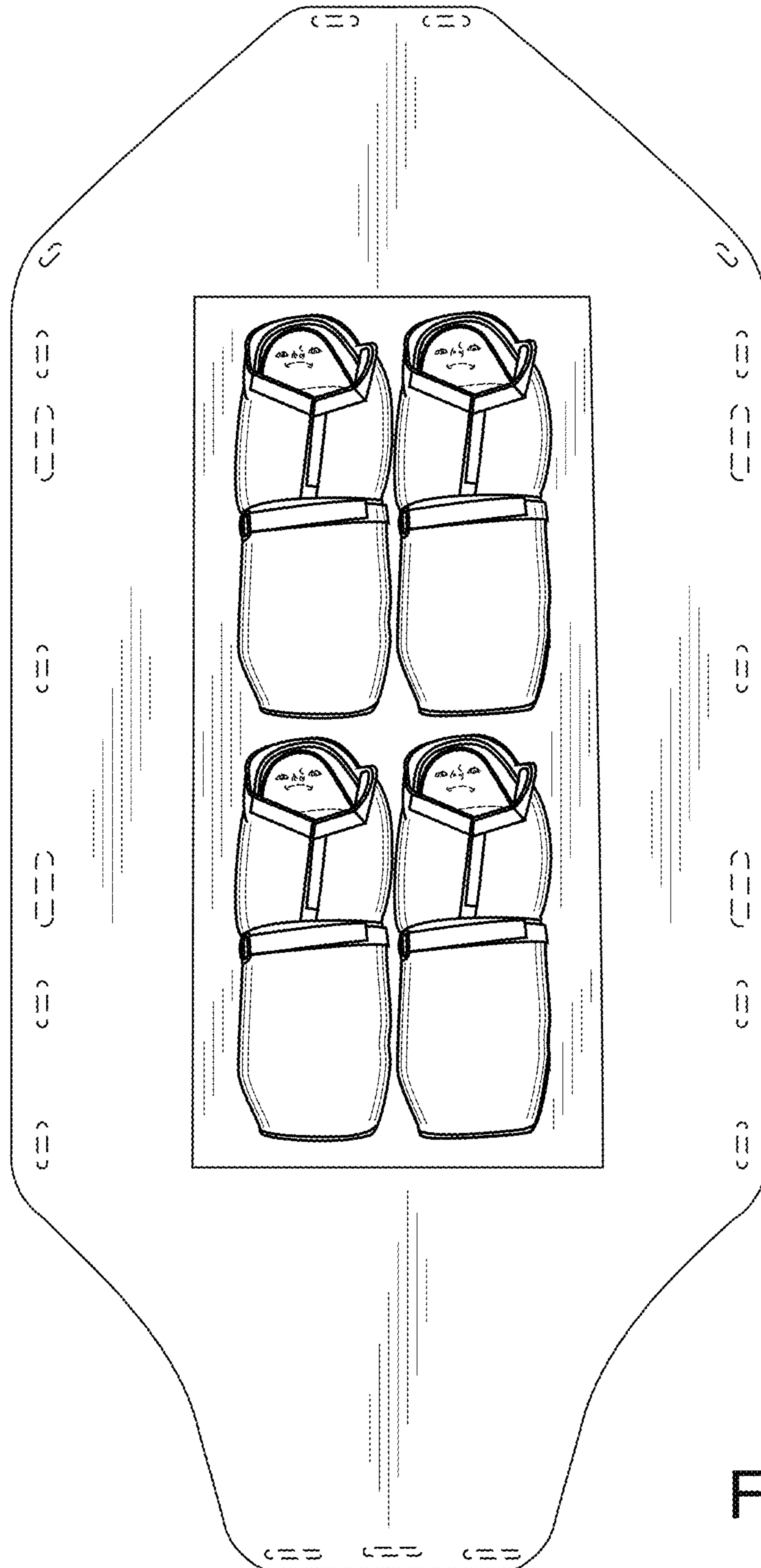
