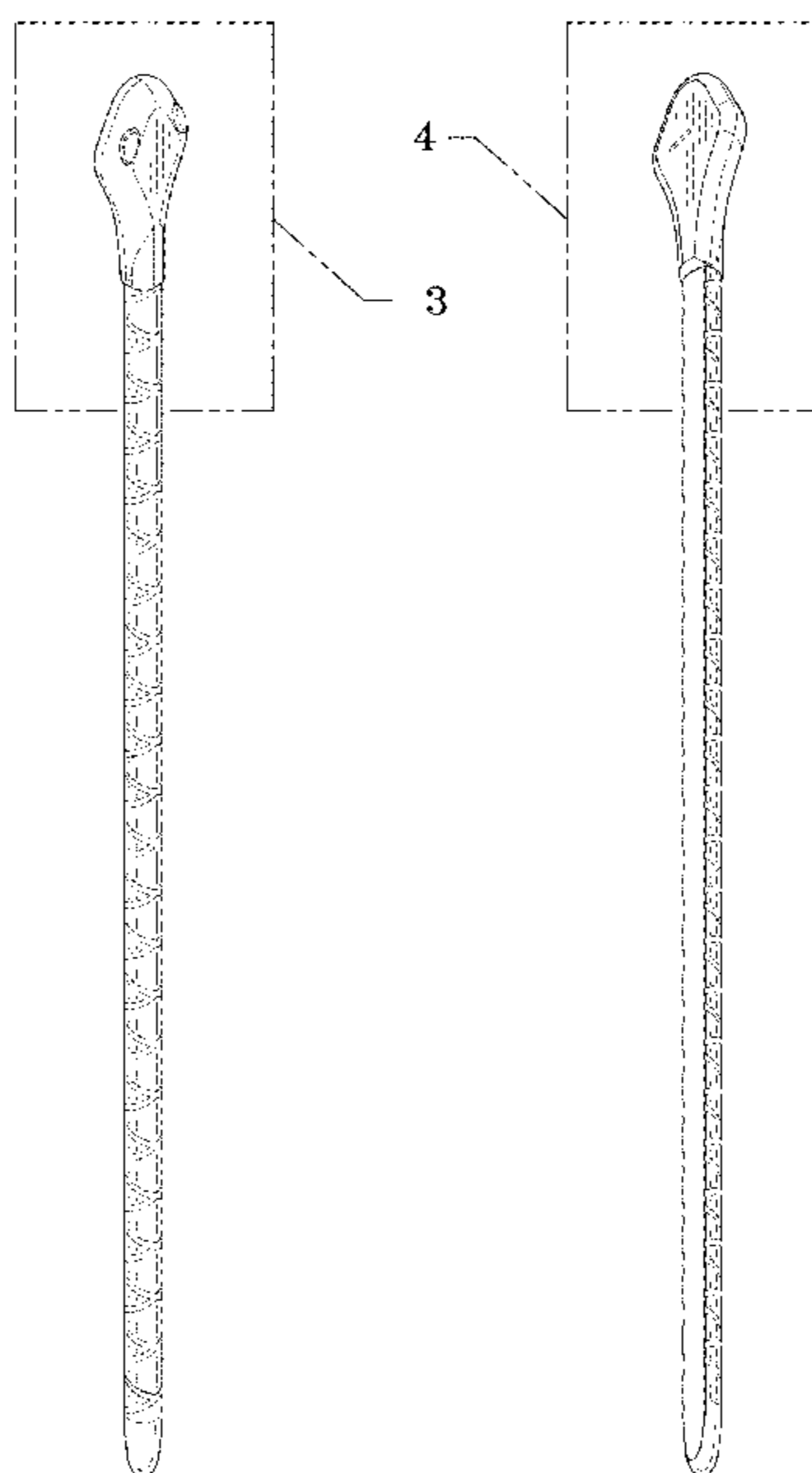
The ornamental design for a jewelry attachment for footwear, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a jewelry attachment for footwear, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an enlarged portion view taken from section labeled 3 in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is an enlarged portion view taken from section labeled 4 in FIG. 2;

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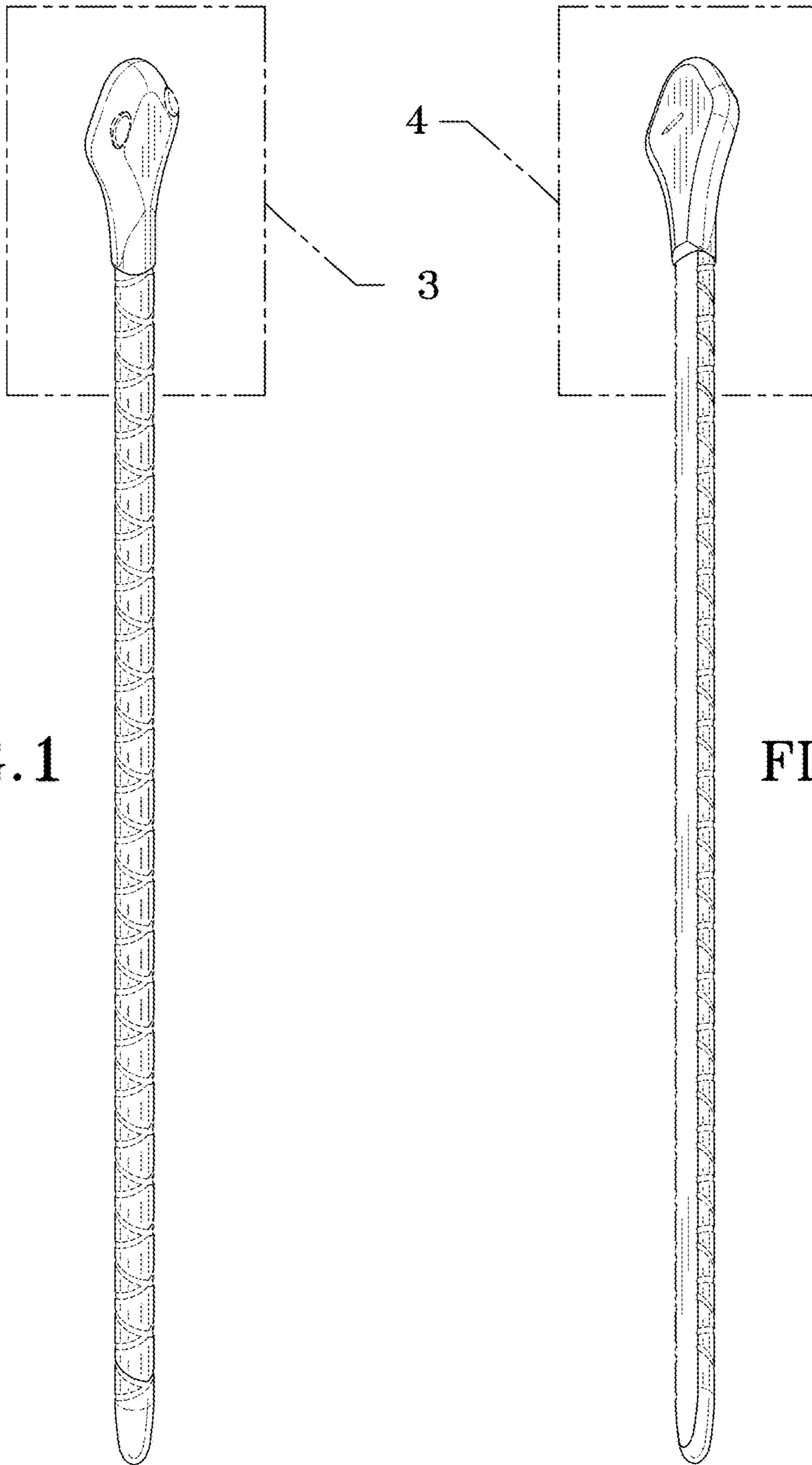

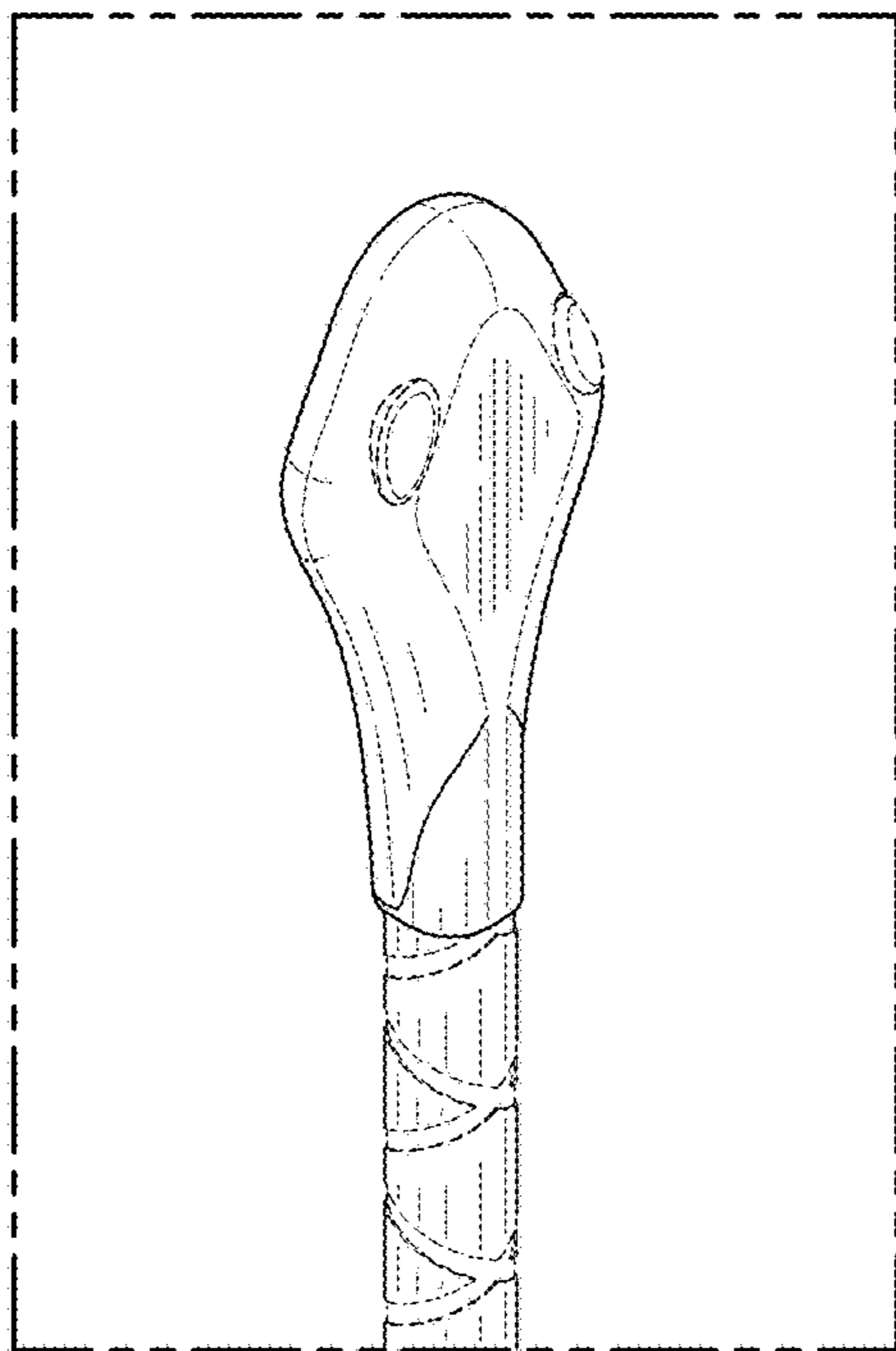

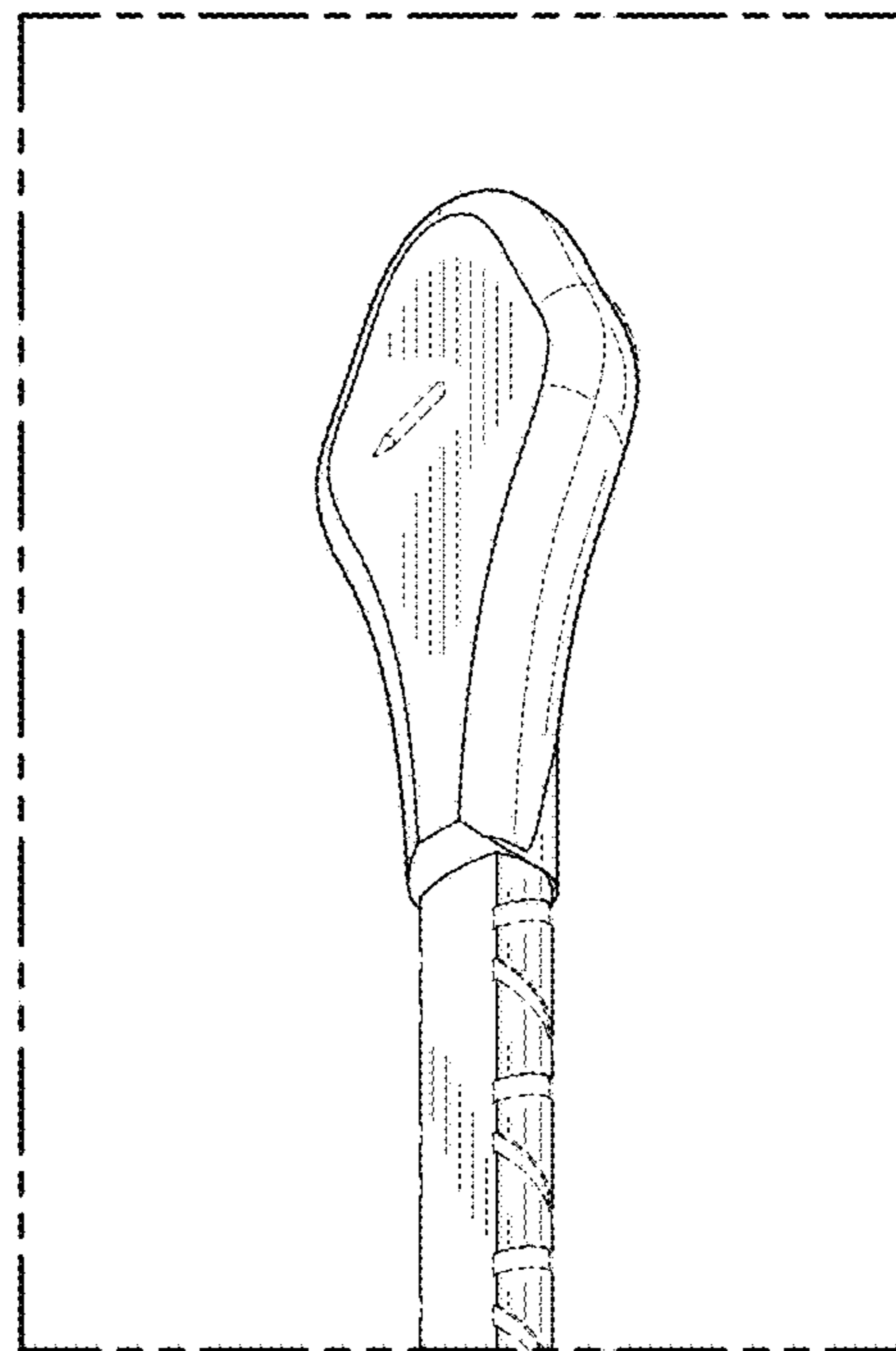

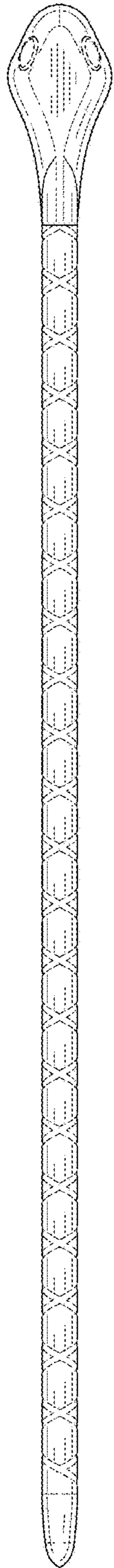

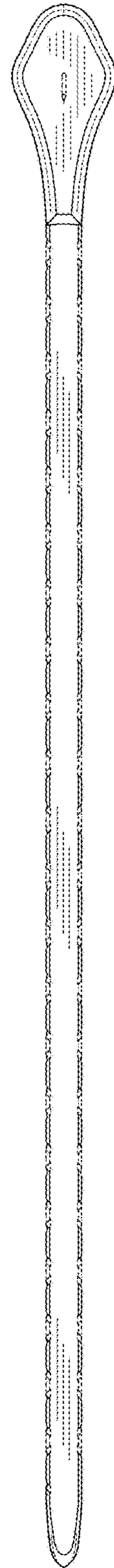

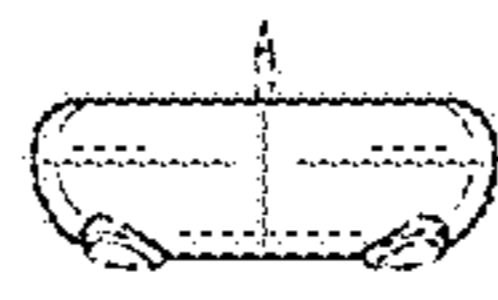

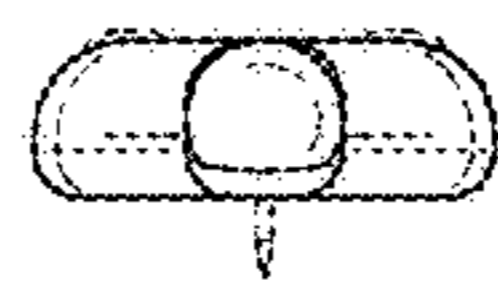

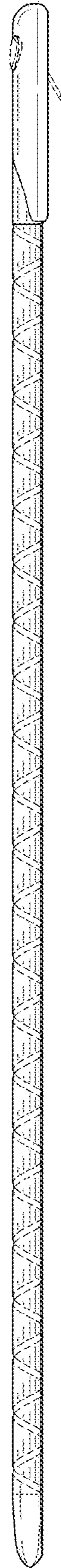

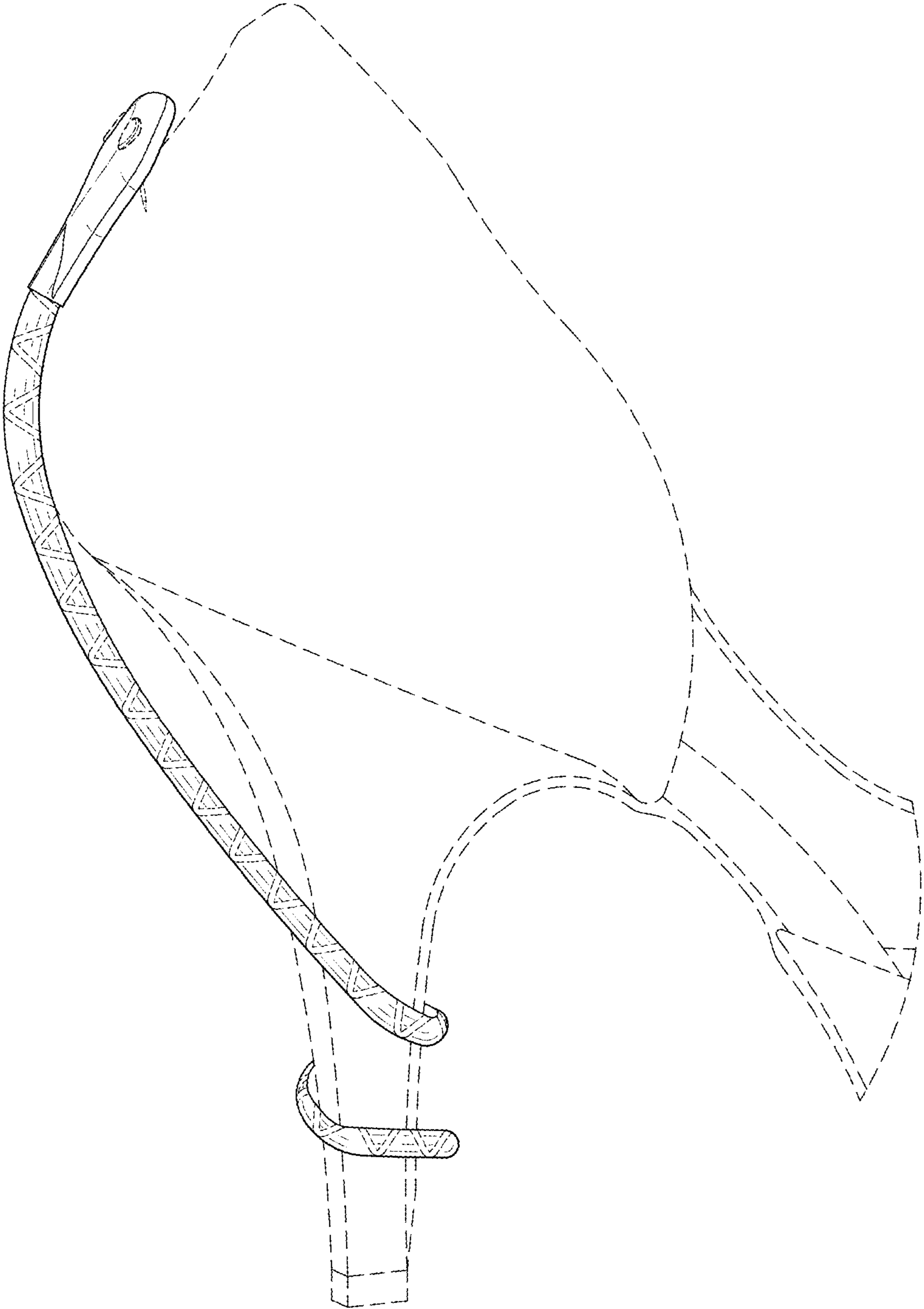
