(57)**CLAIM**

What is claimed is the ornamental design for a fringed bag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view showing the fringed bag. The broken lines on the ring on the front of the bag are shown to define boundaries of potential identifying or decorative features which are not part of the claimed design. The areas within the broken line boundaries are not part of the claimed design.

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the fringed bag of FIG.

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the fringed bag of FIG. 1. The broken lines on the ring on the front of the bag are shown to define boundaries of potential identifying or decorative features which are not part of the claimed design. The areas within the broken line boundaries are not part of the claimed design.

FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of the fringed bag of FIG. 1.


FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view of the fringed bag of FIG.

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the fringed bag of FIG. 1. FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the fringed bag of FIG. 1.

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the fringed bag of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 9 is a front elevation view of the fringed bag of FIG. 1 shown with an accompanying strap. The broken lines on the ring on the front of the bag are shown to define boundaries of potential identifying or decorative features which are not part of the claimed design. The broken lines forming the accompanying strap are shown to provide environmental context for the fringed bag and are not part of the claimed design. The areas within the broken line boundaries are not part of the claimed design.














