DESCRIPTION

the right side of FIG. 5;

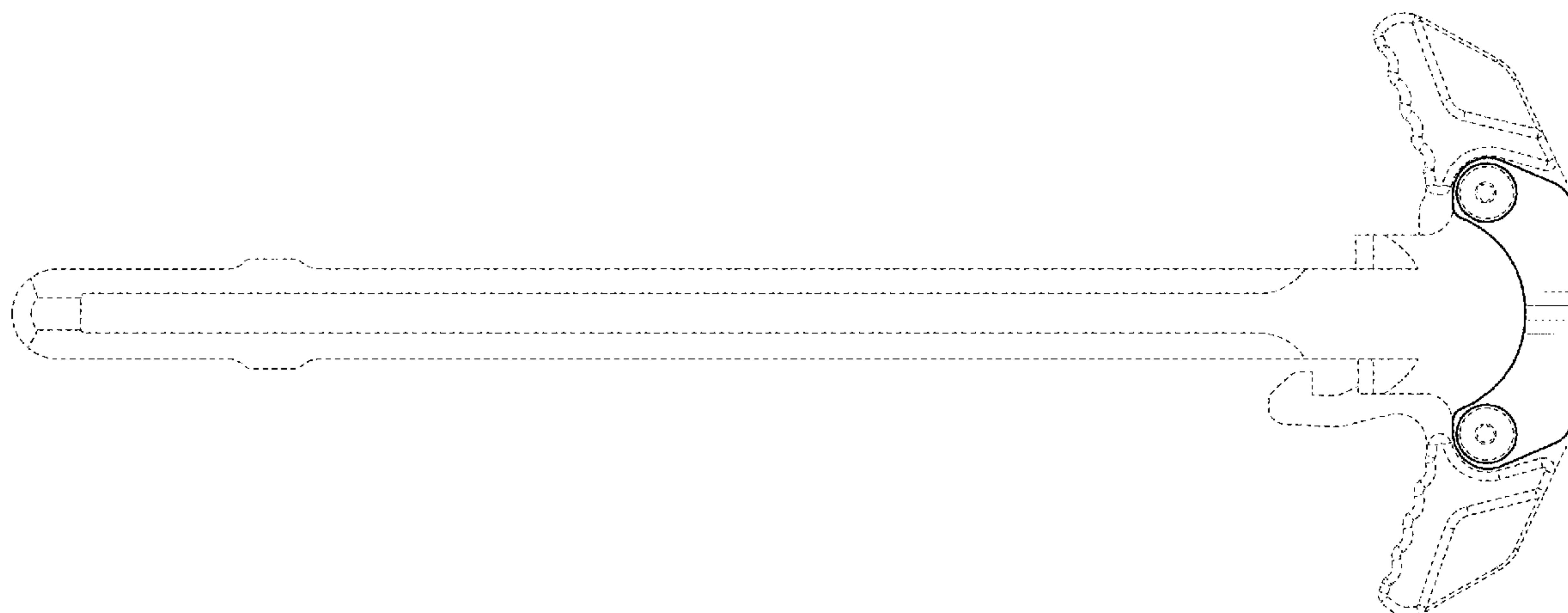
FIG. 7 is a side view of the invention of FIG. 1, as seen from

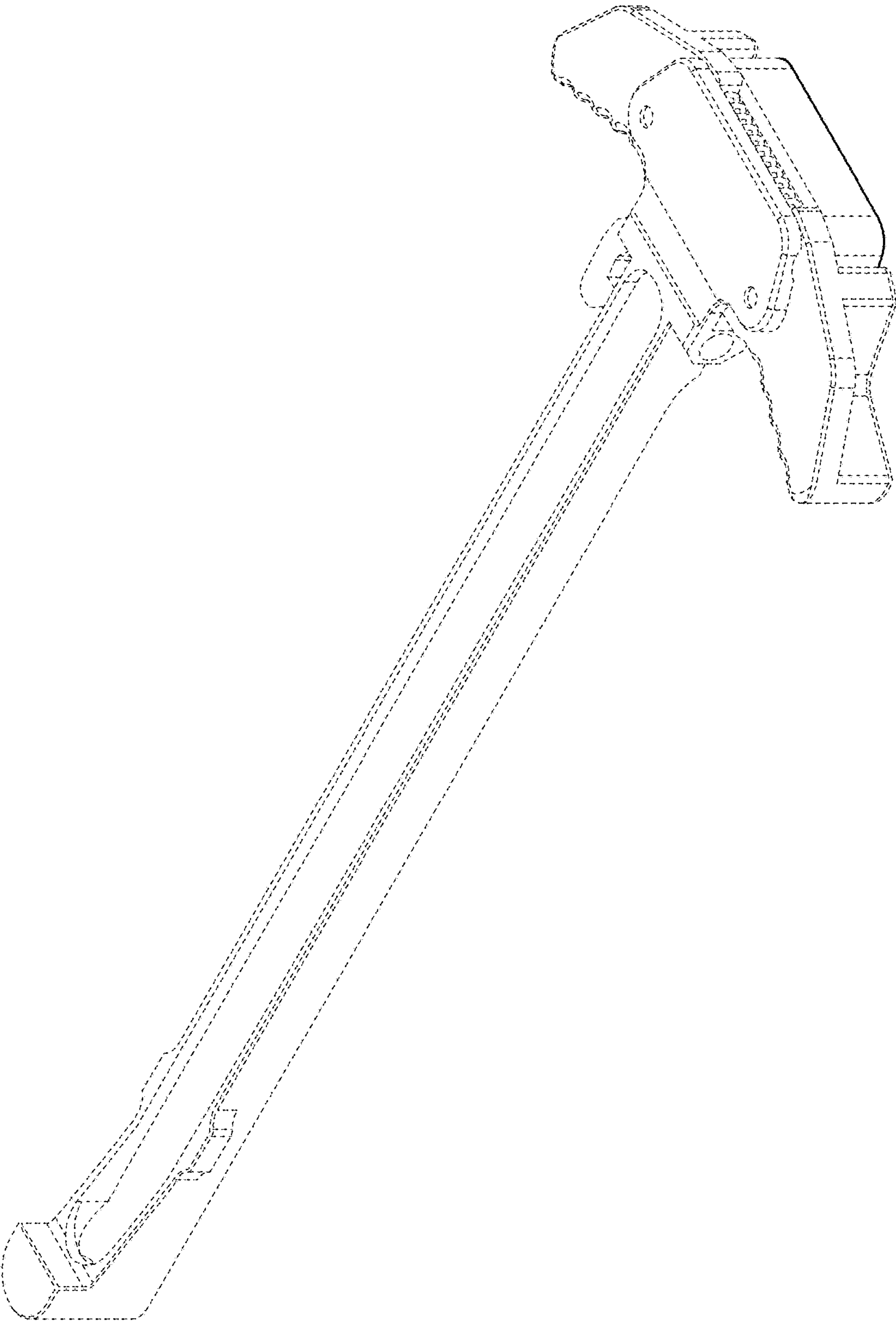

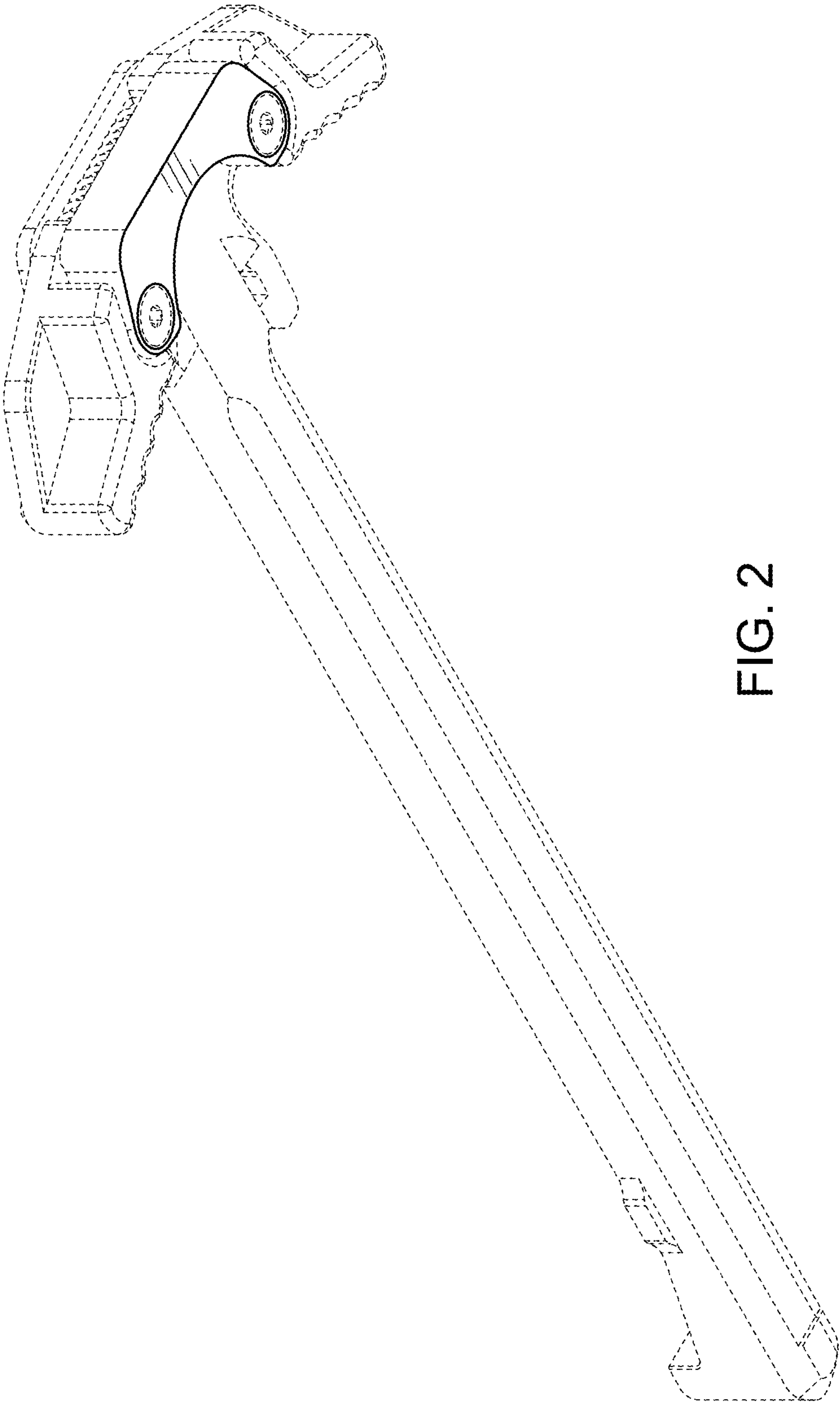

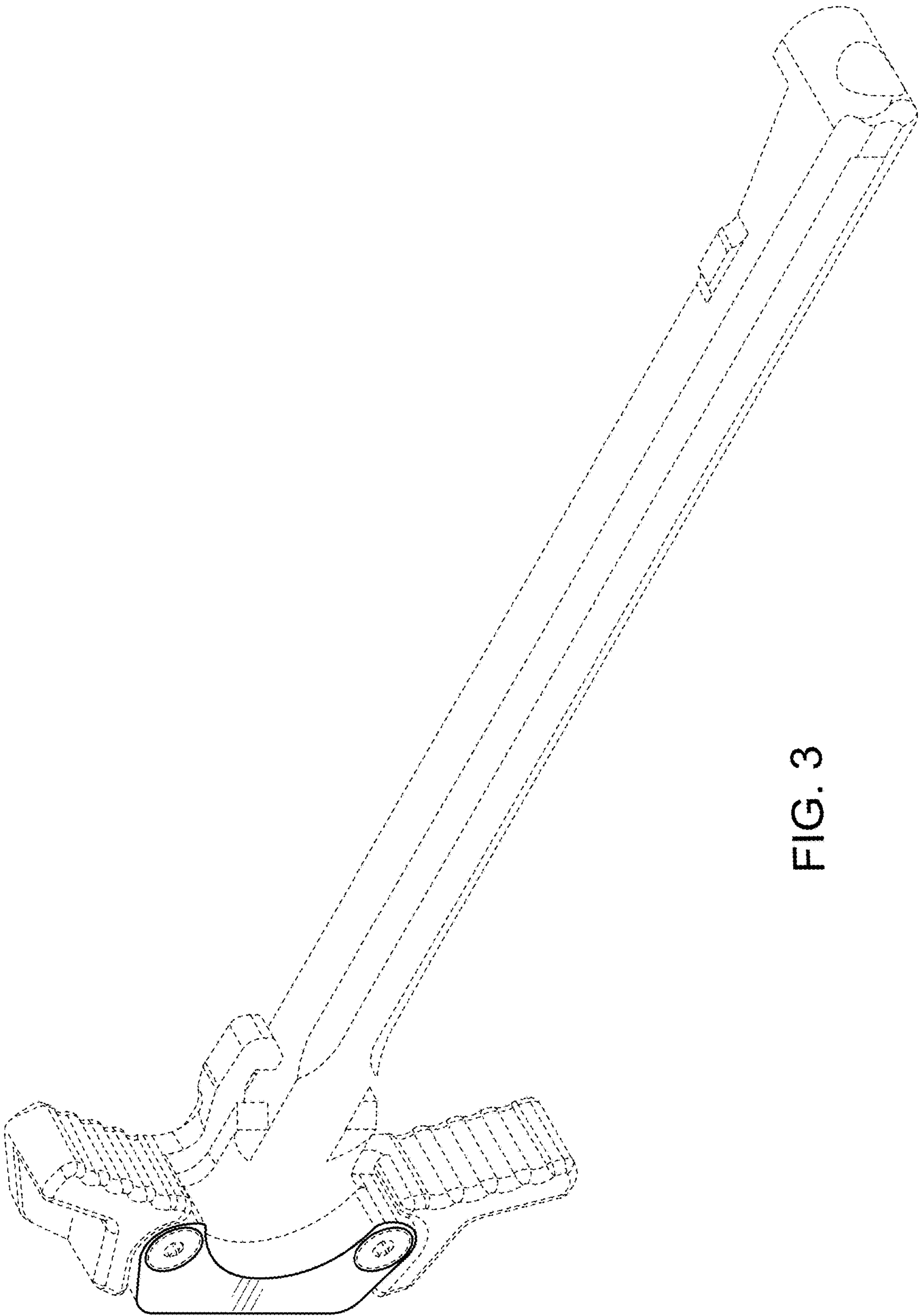

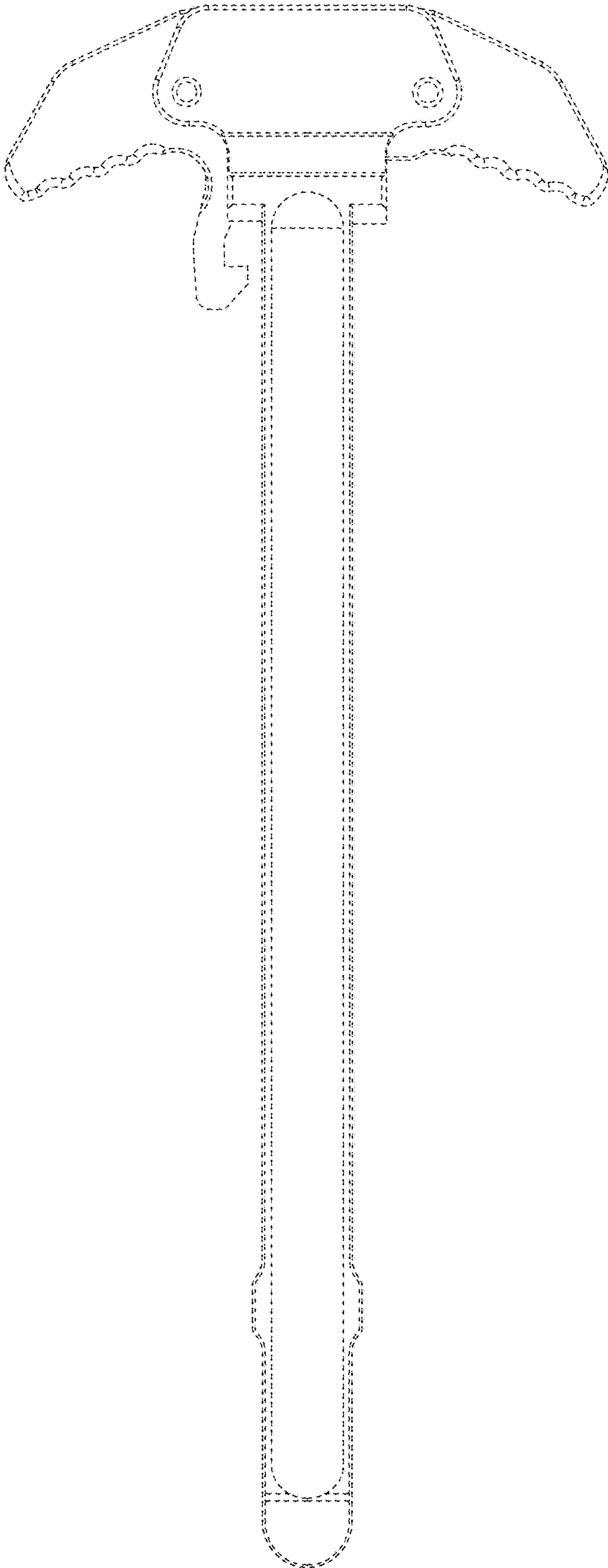

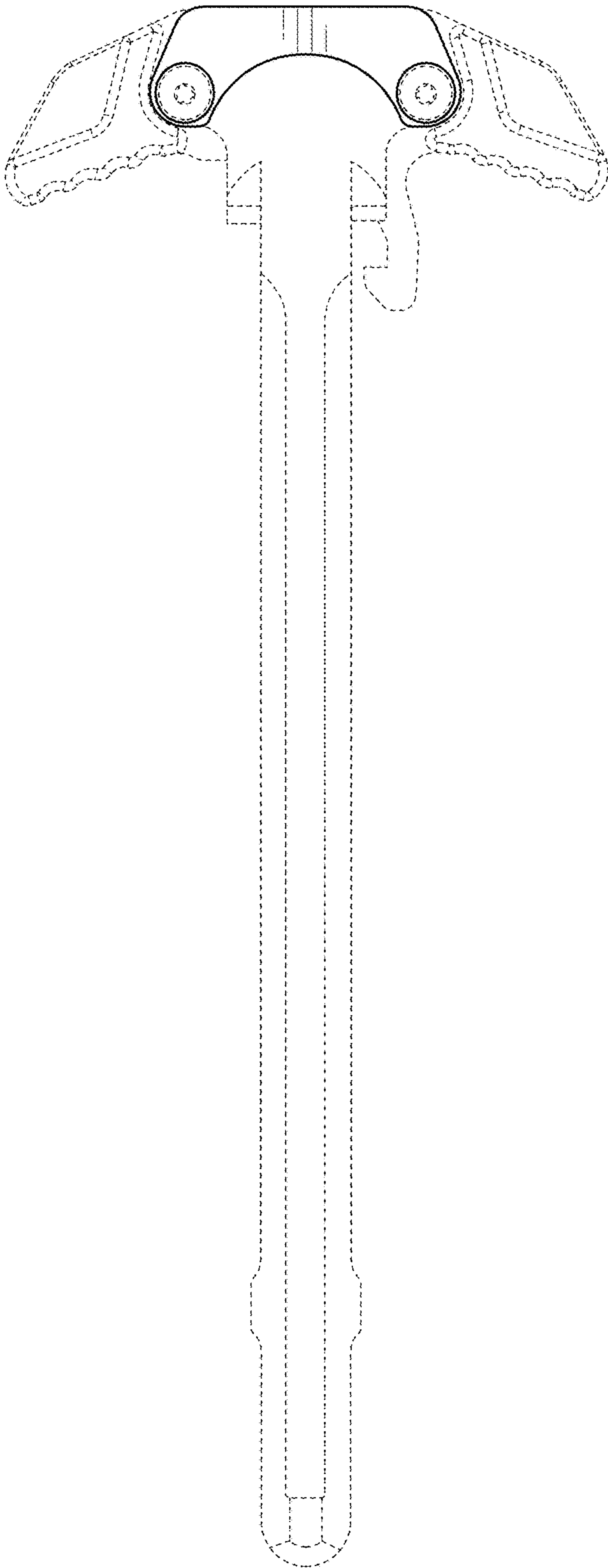

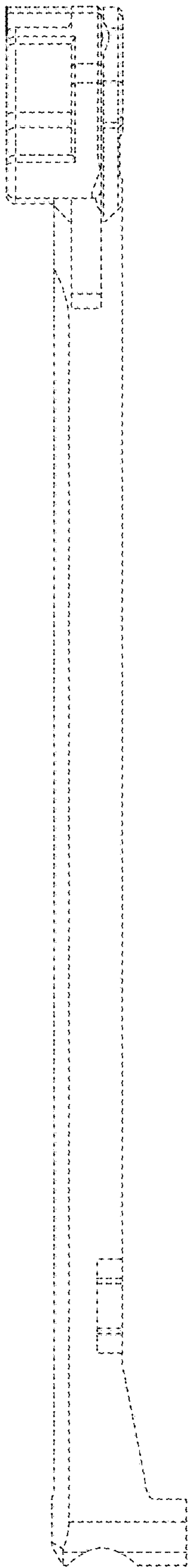

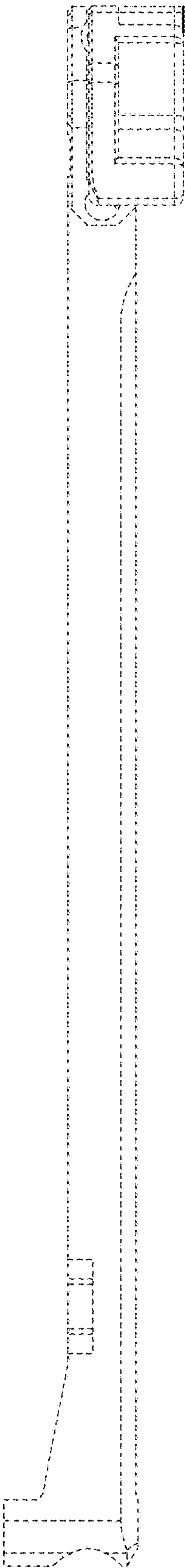

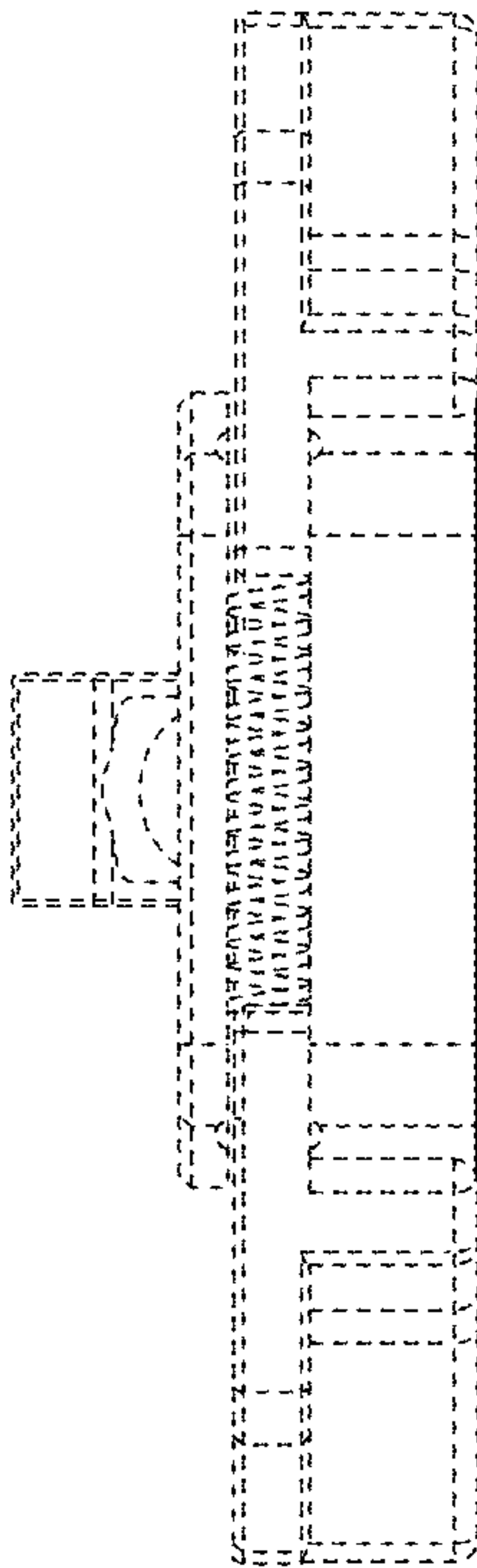

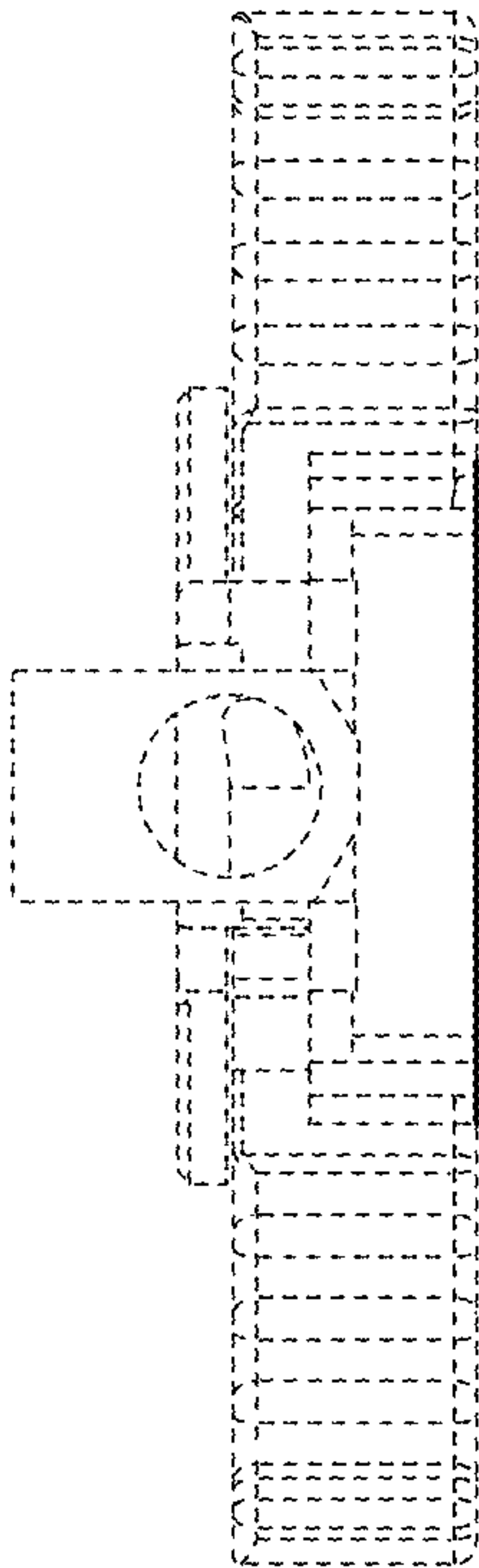
