FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof.

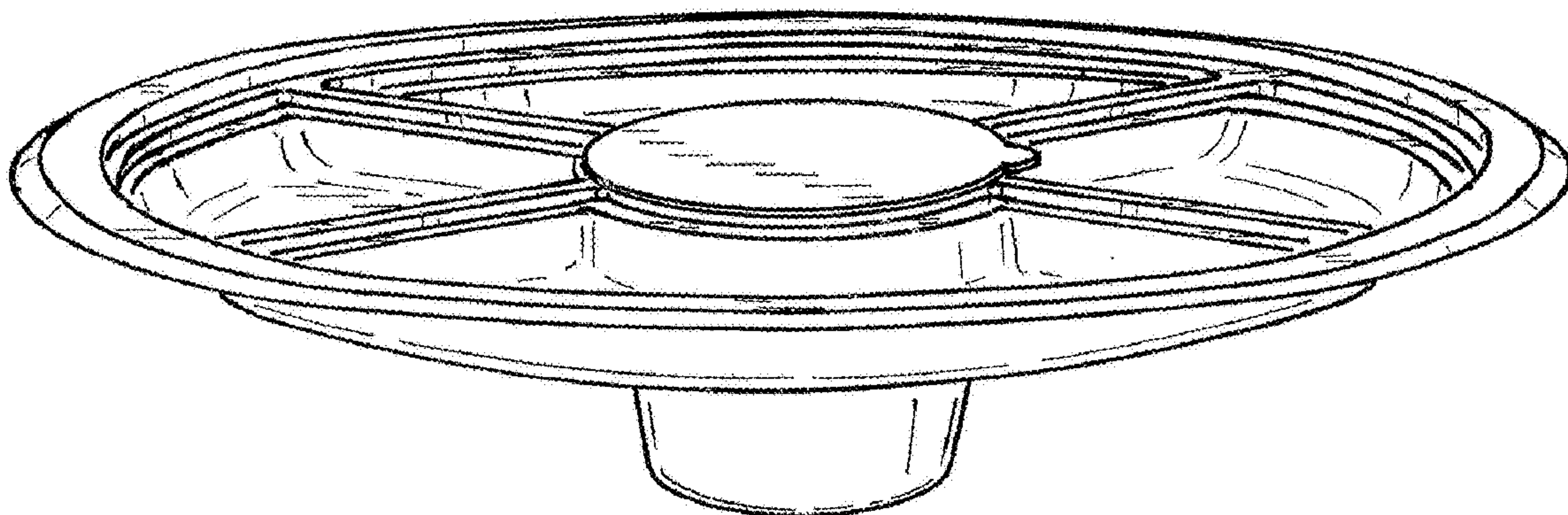
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof. The rear eleva-

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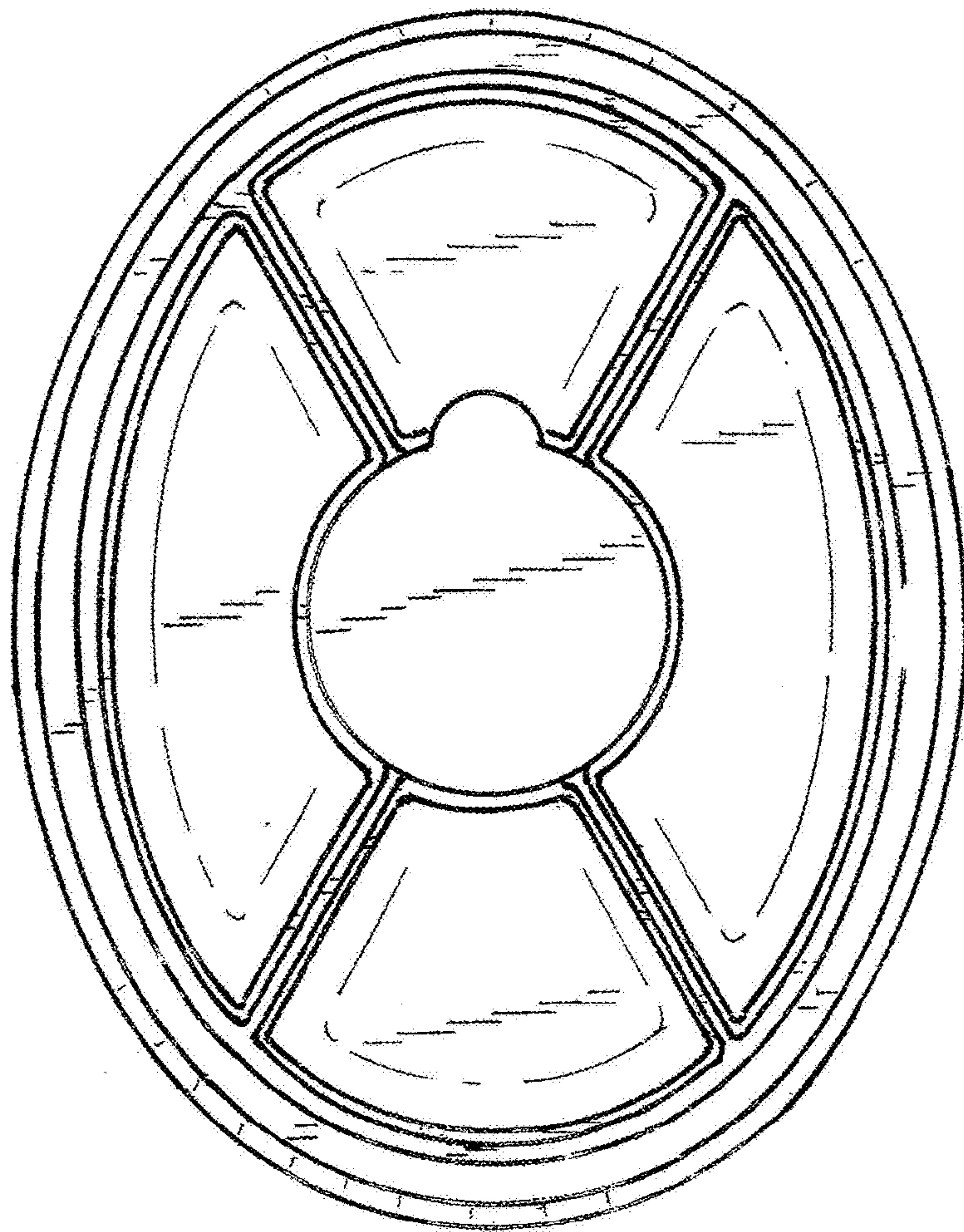

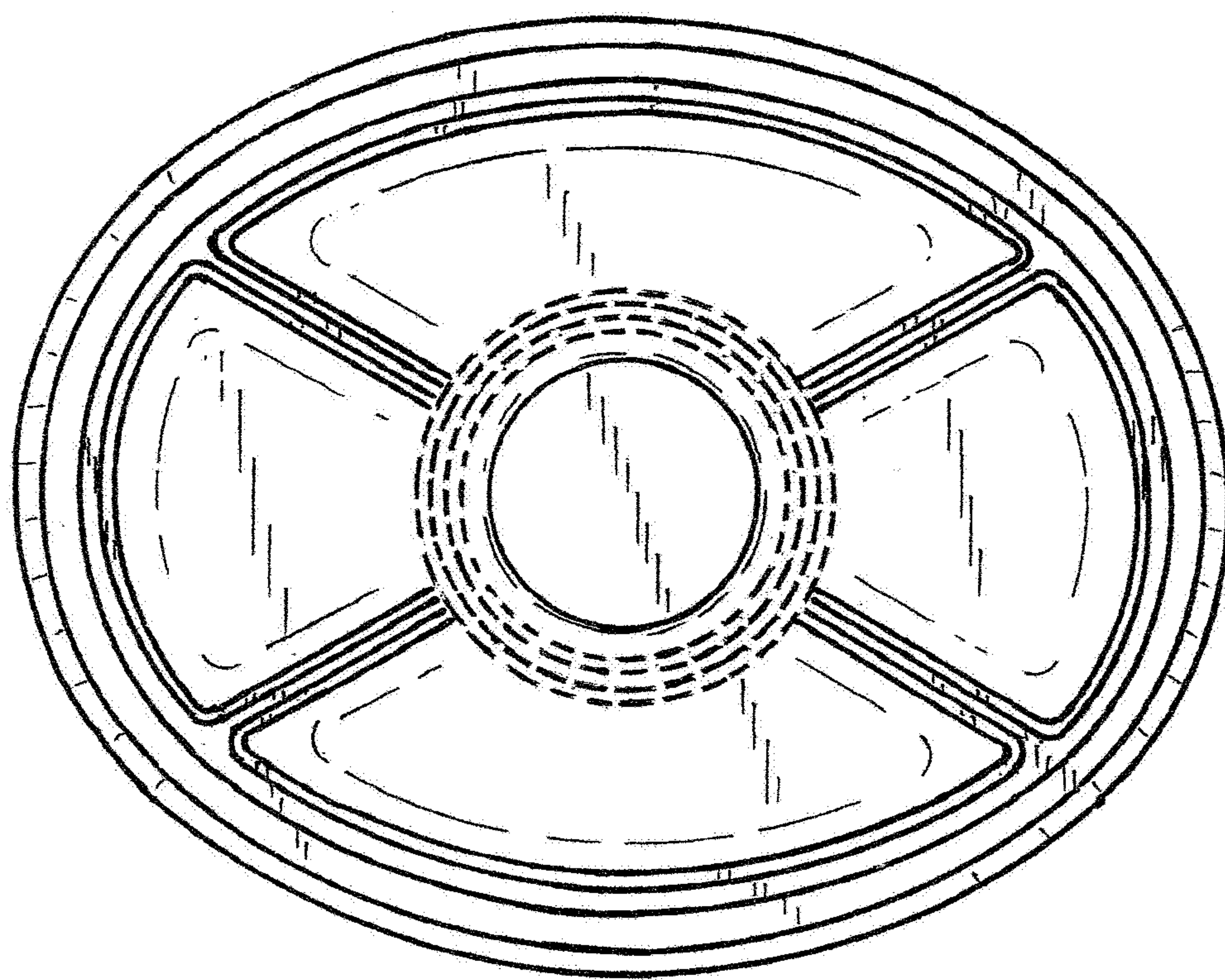
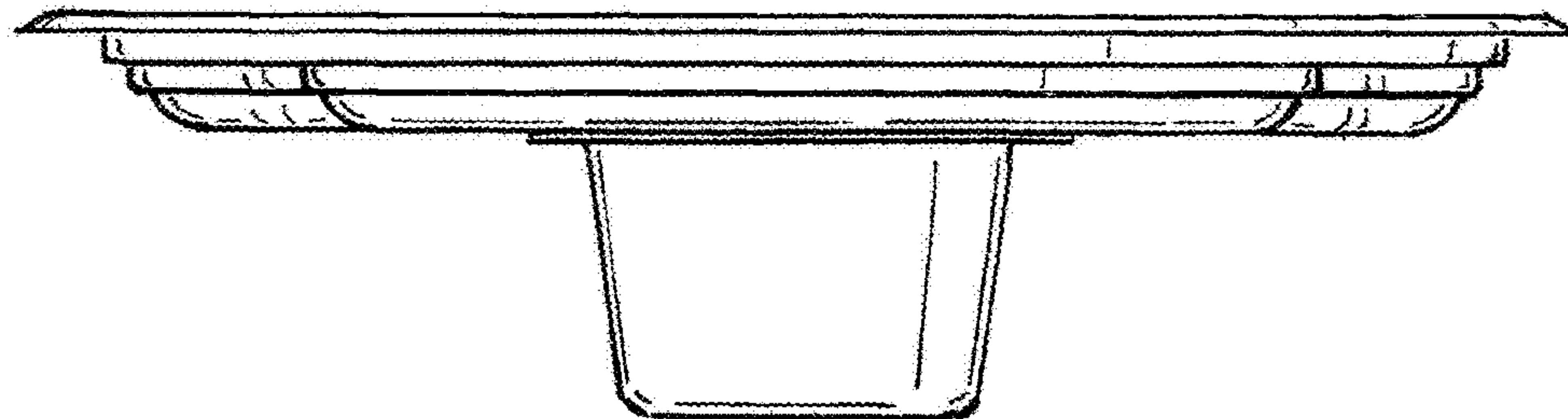

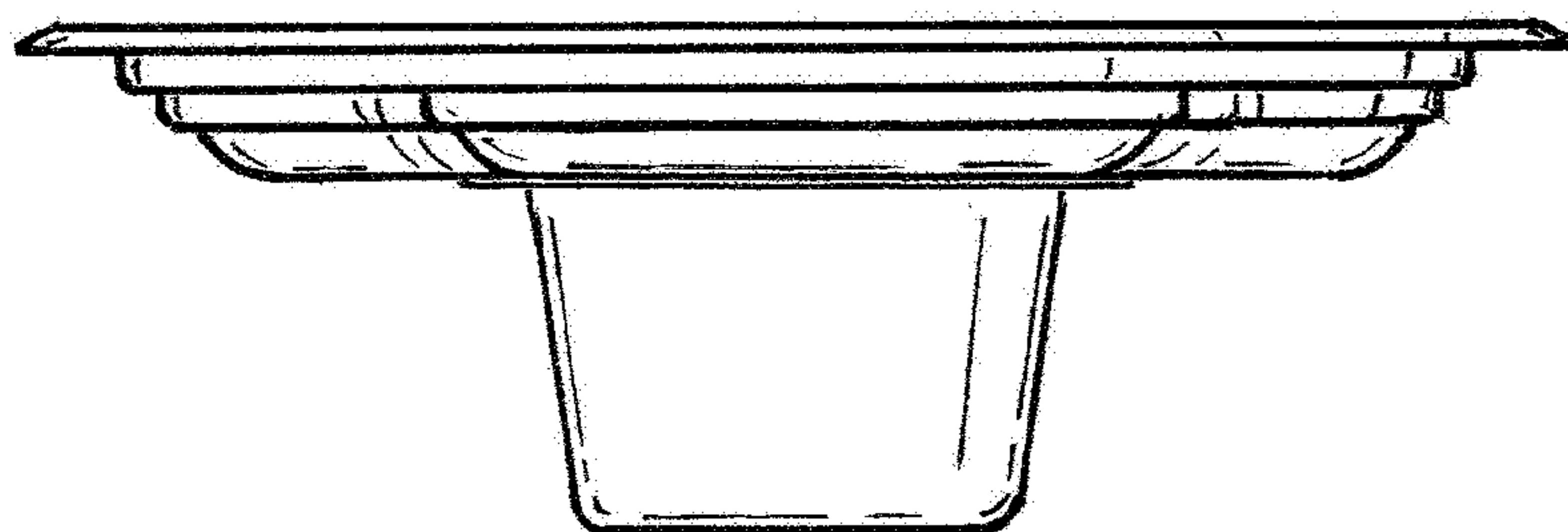

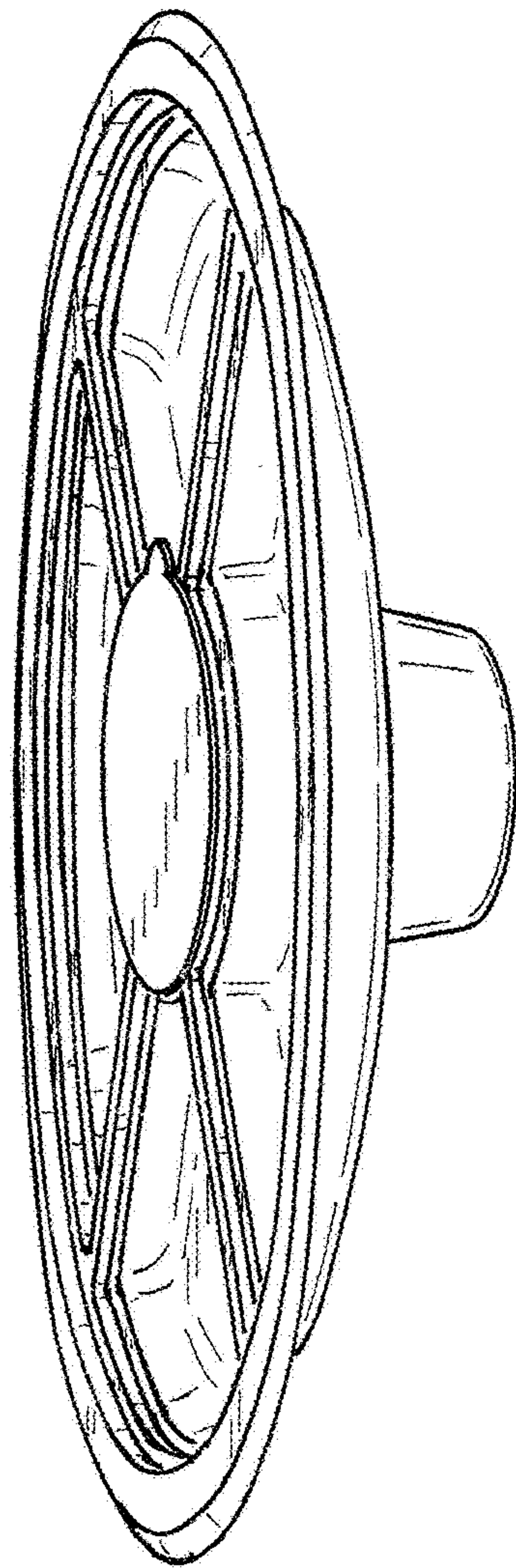
