FIG. 5 is a side view;

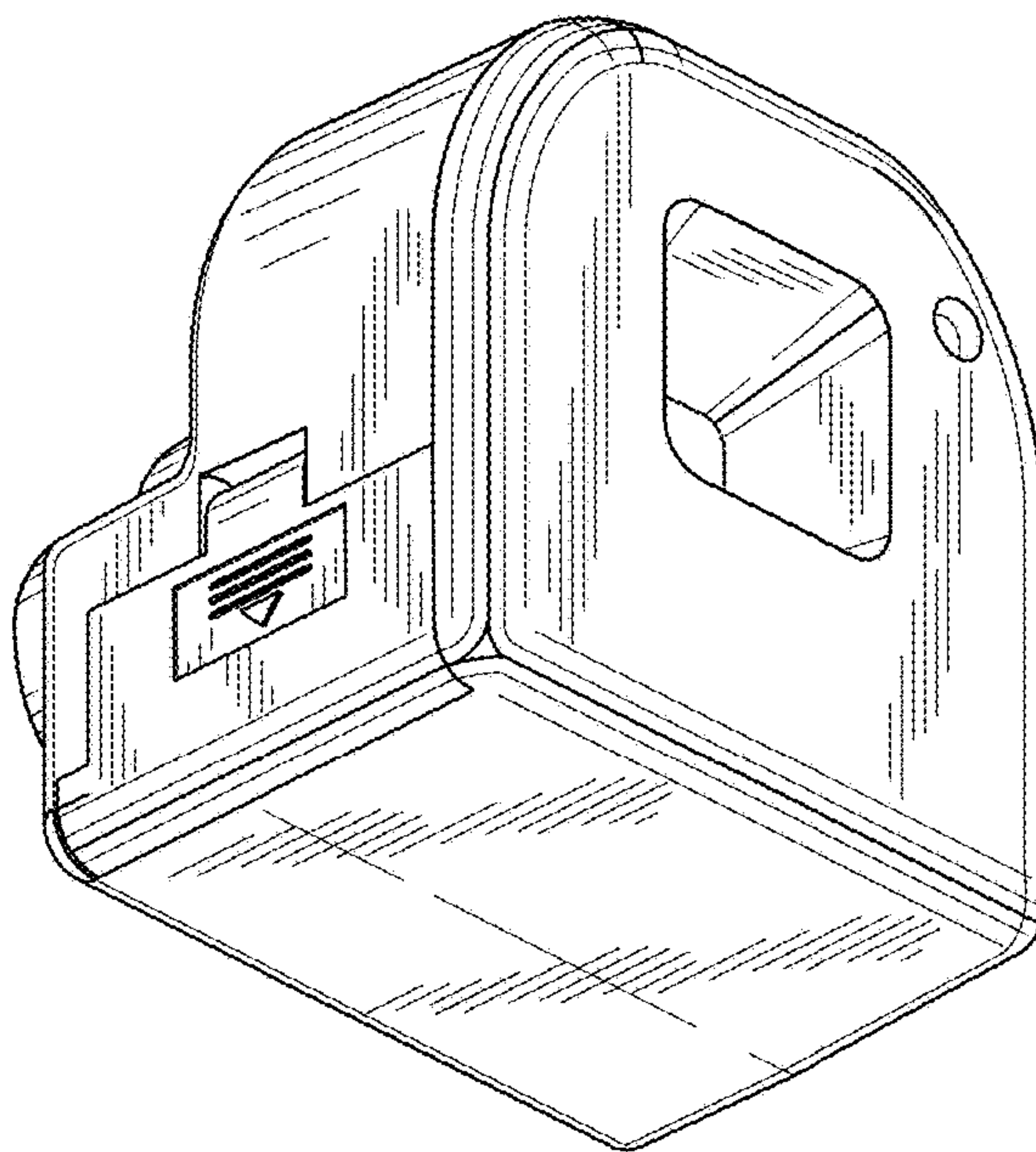
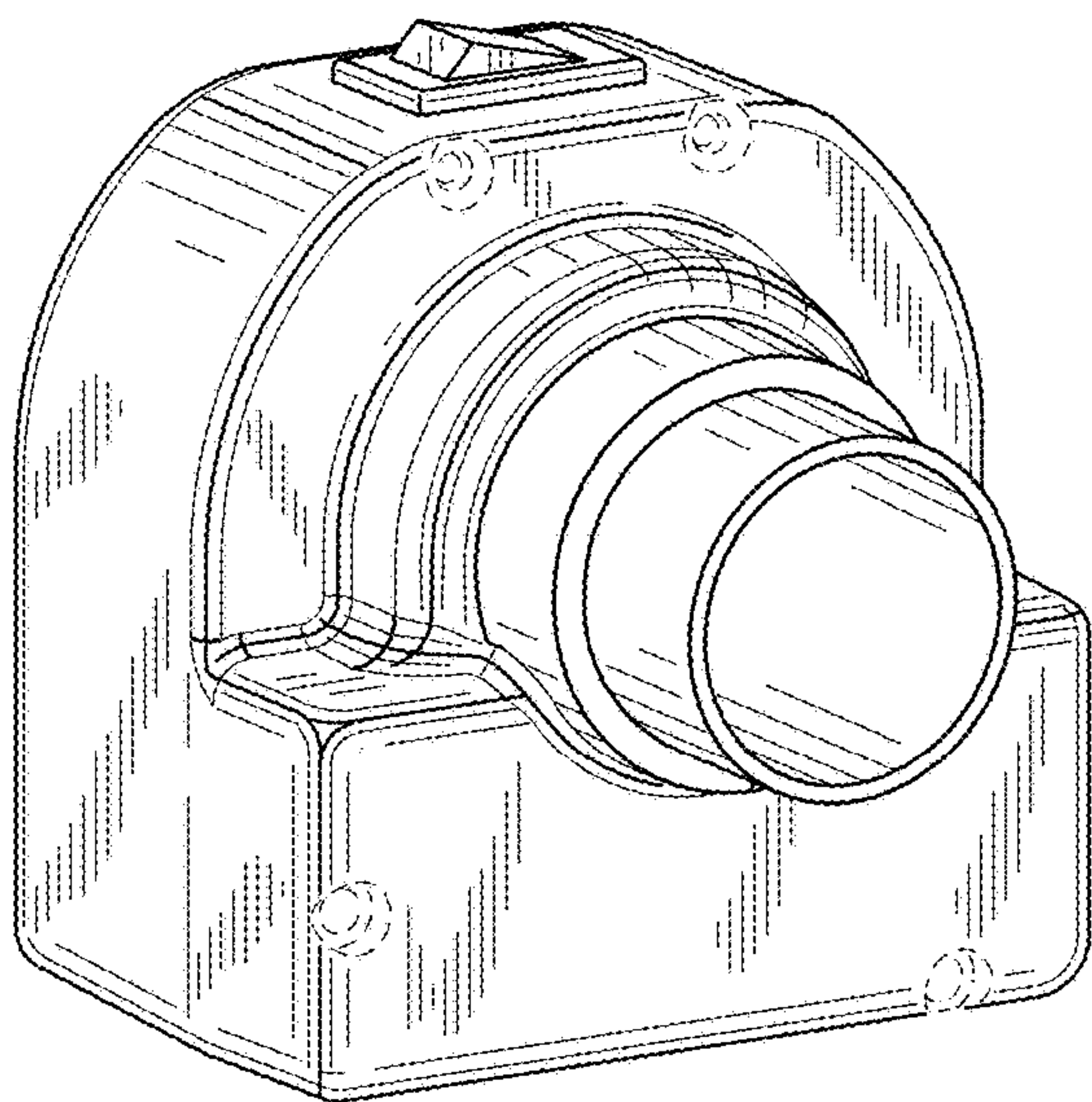
FIG. 6 is a second side view;

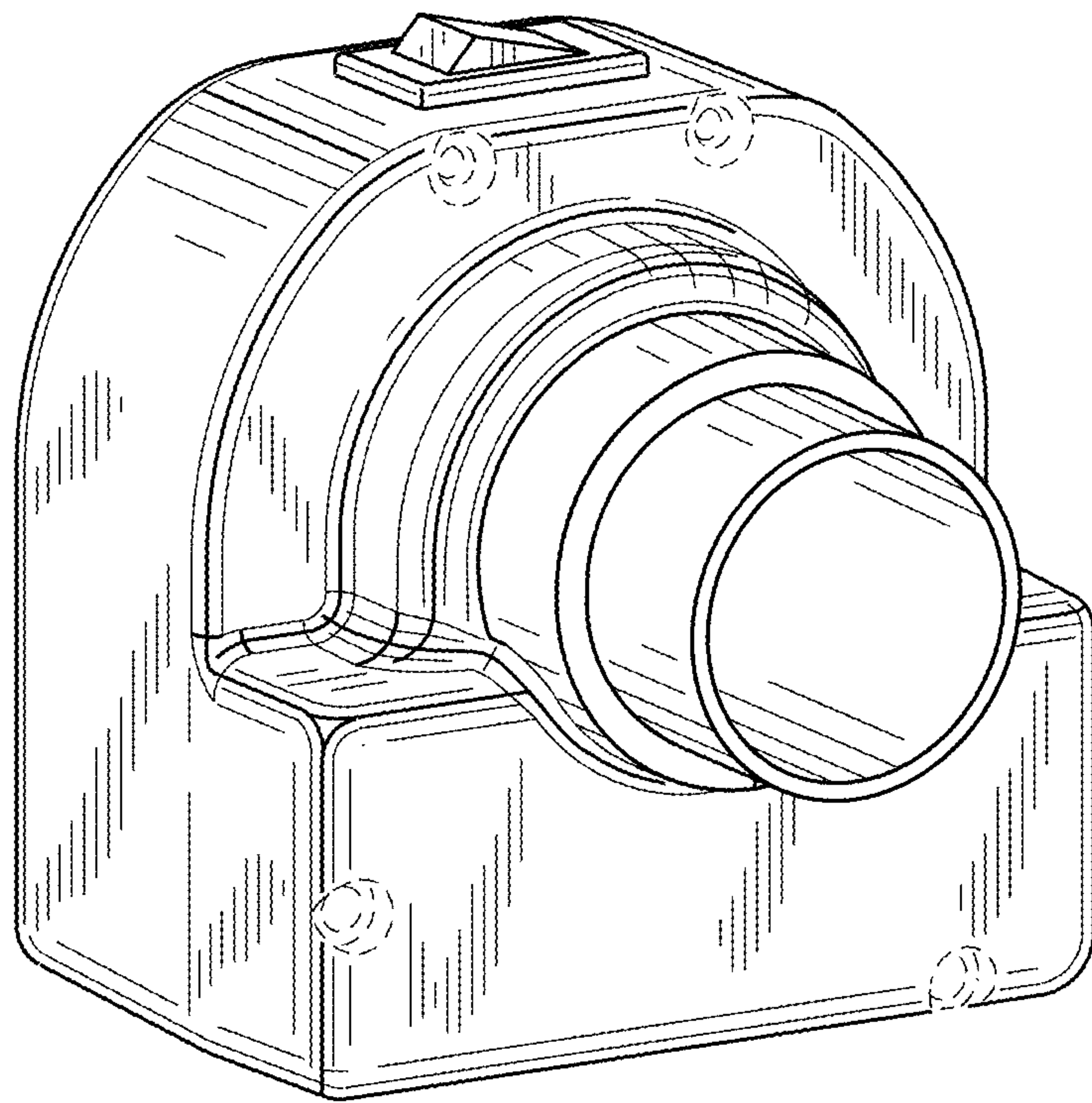

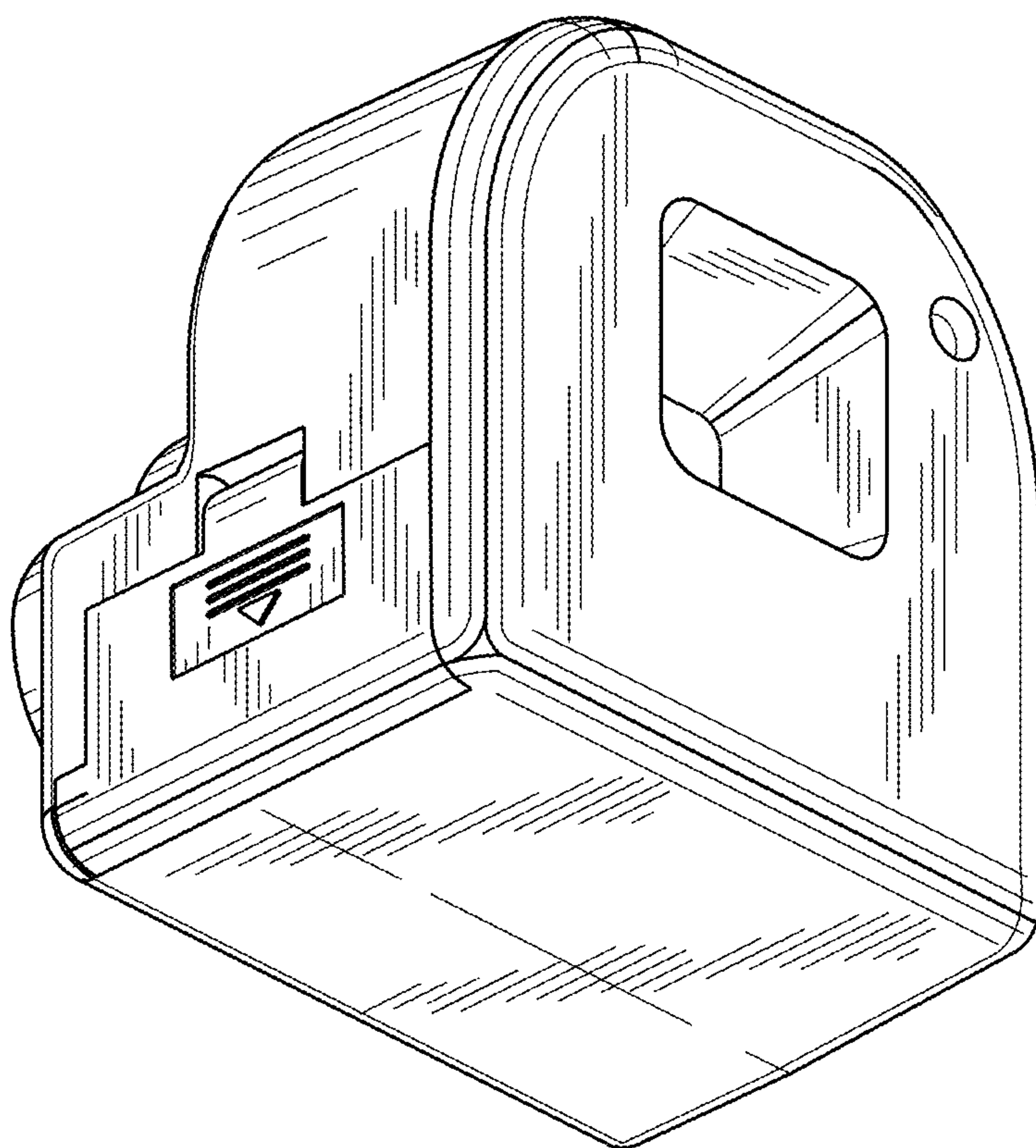

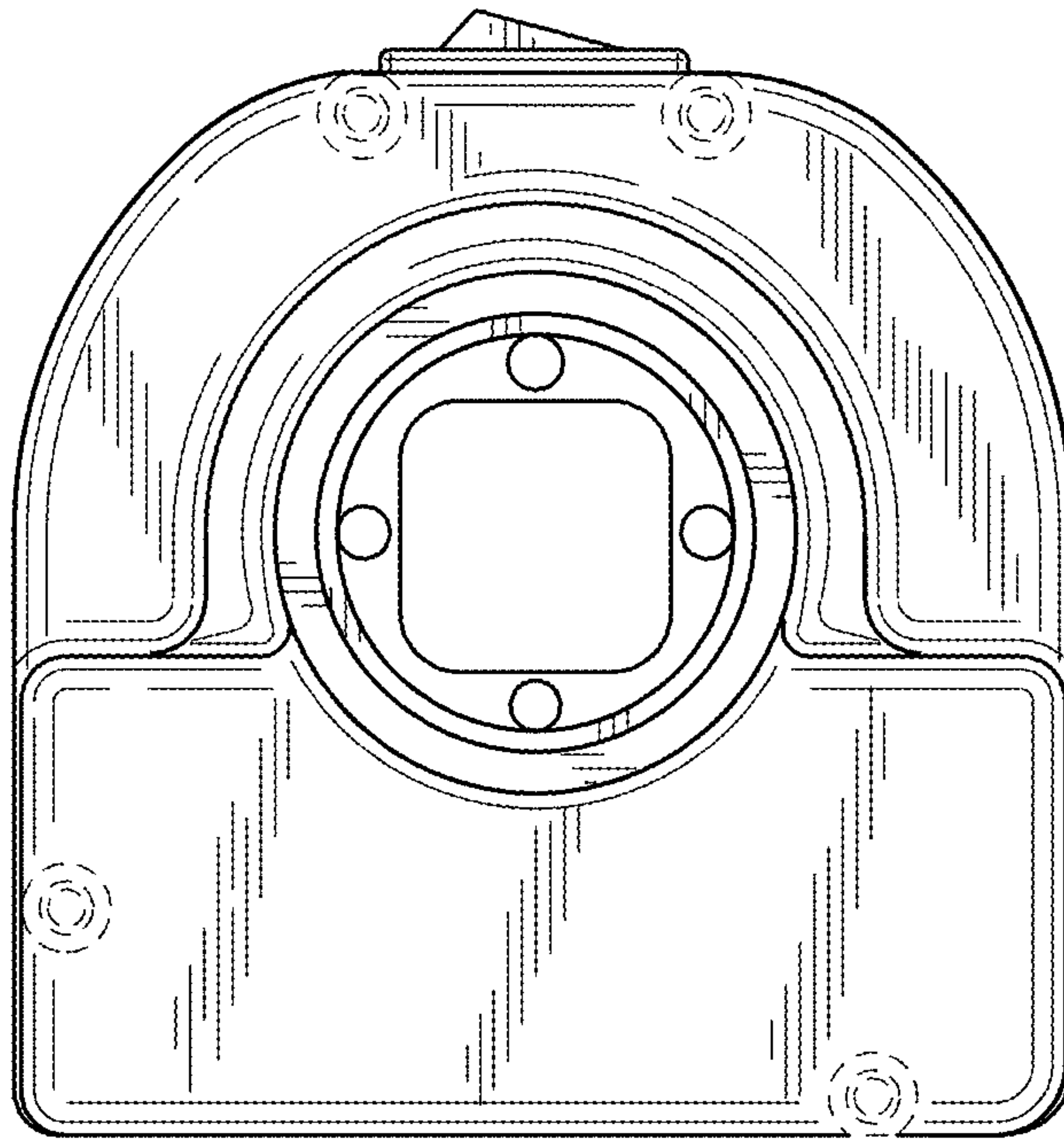

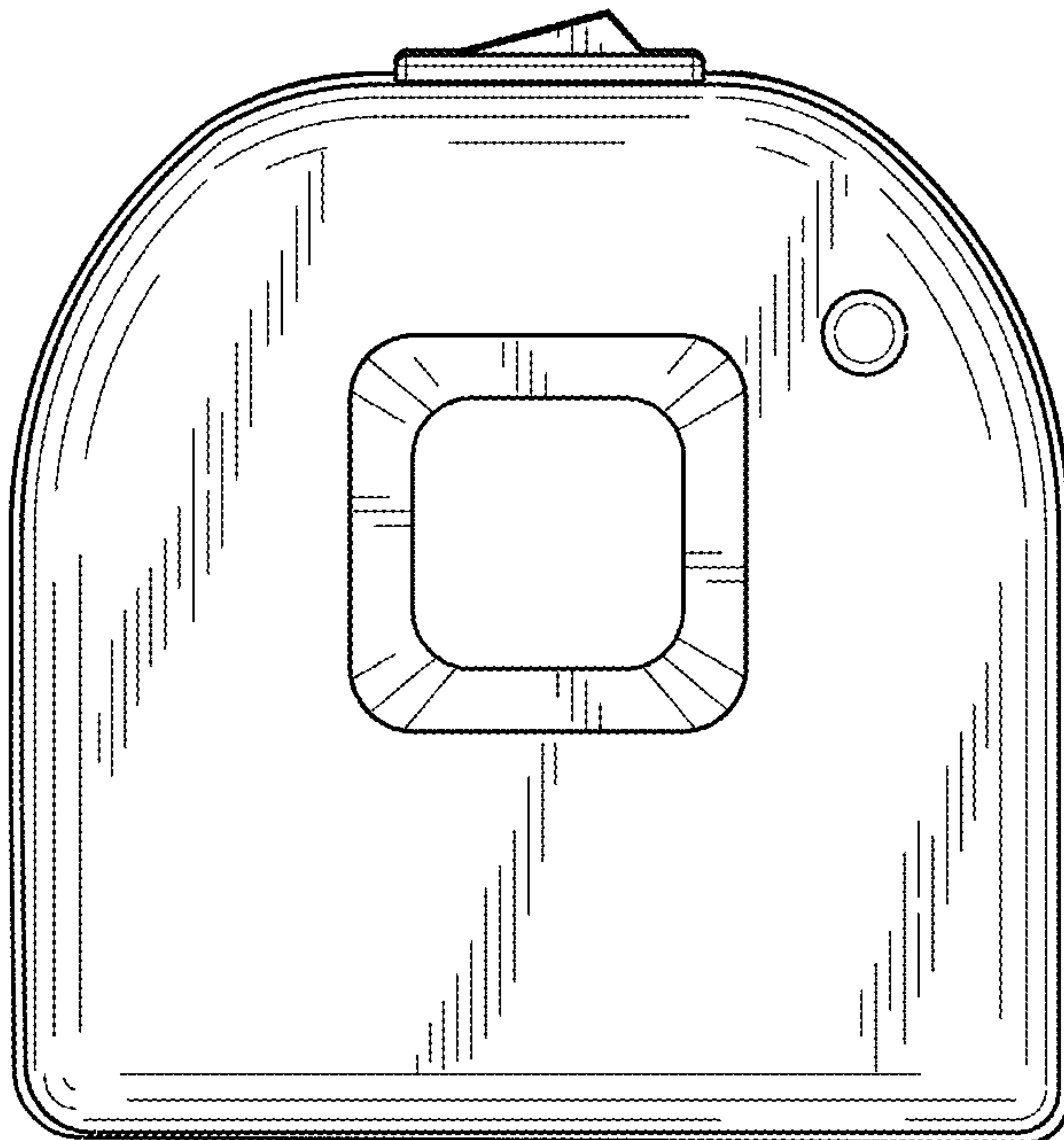

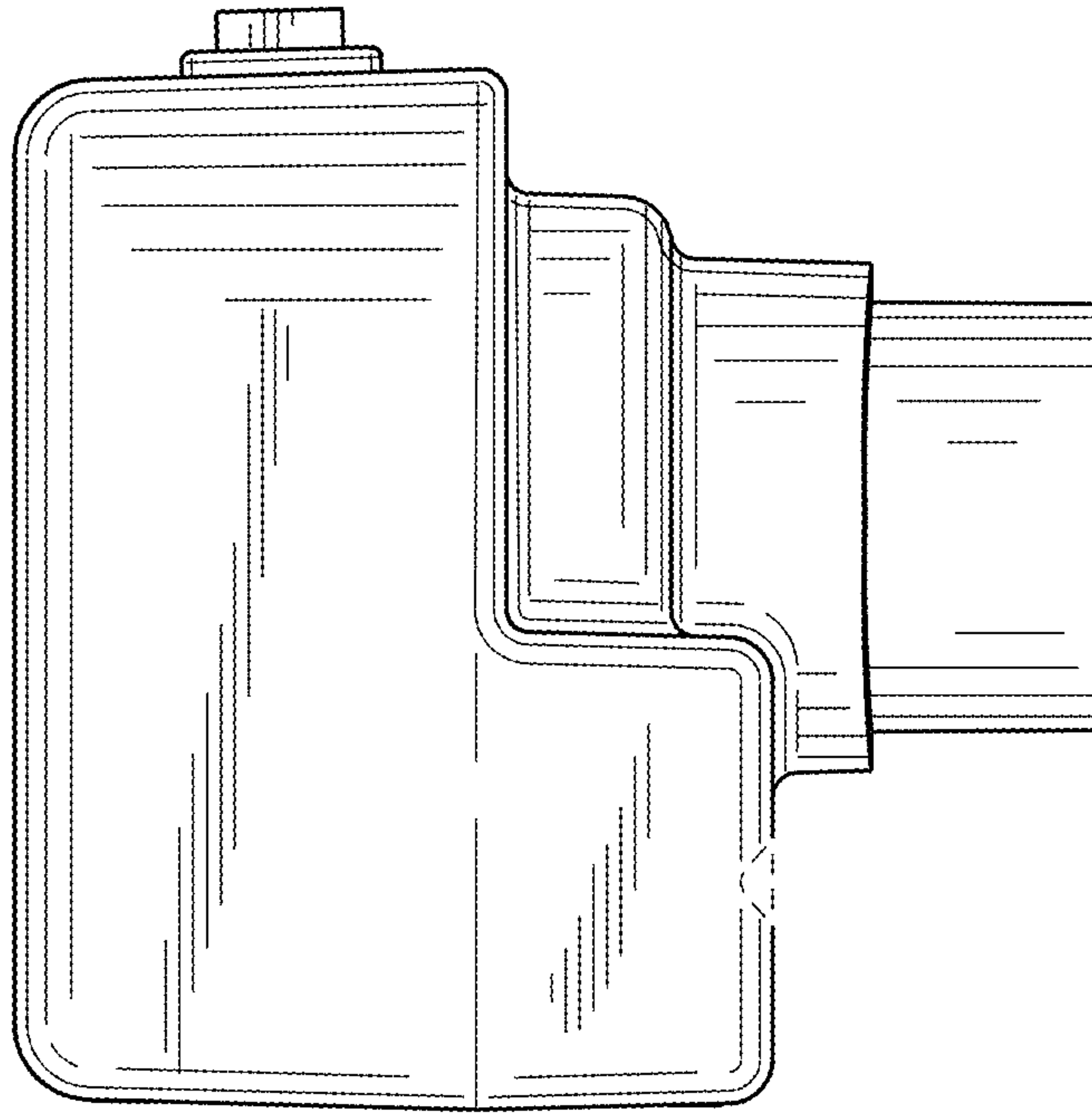

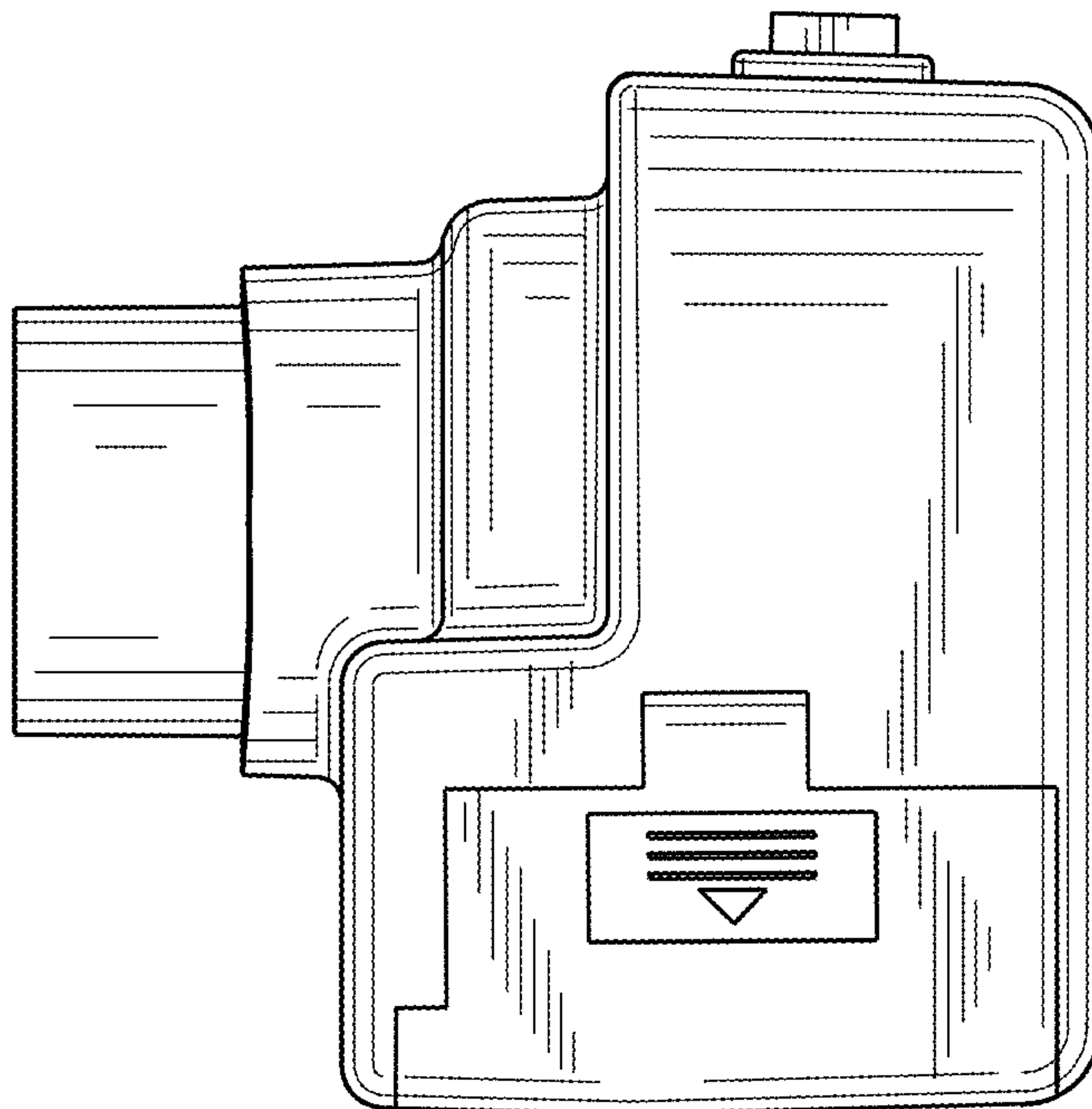

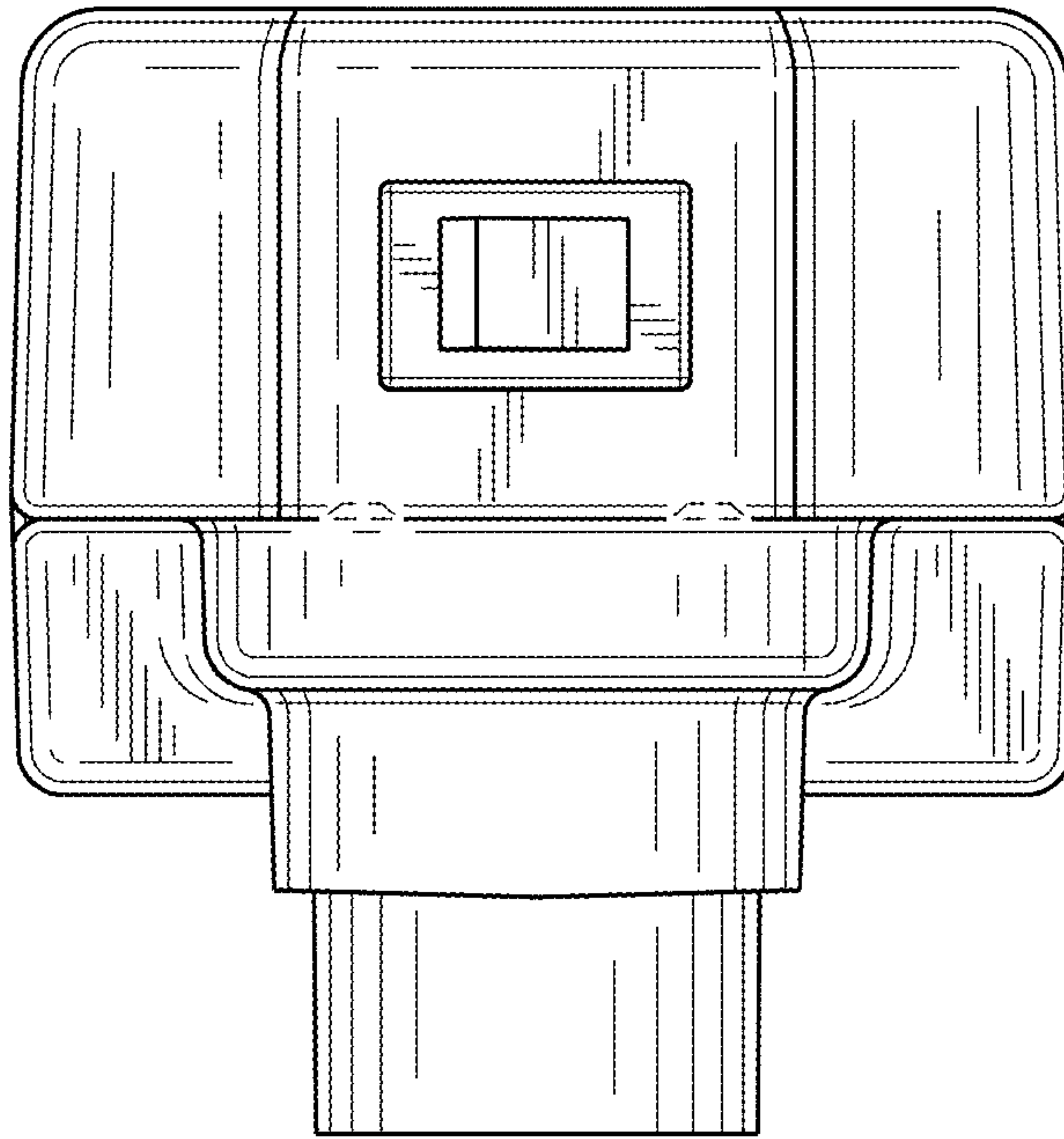
