FIG. 5 is another side elevation view of the splash shield that is opposite the side elevation view shown in FIG. 4.

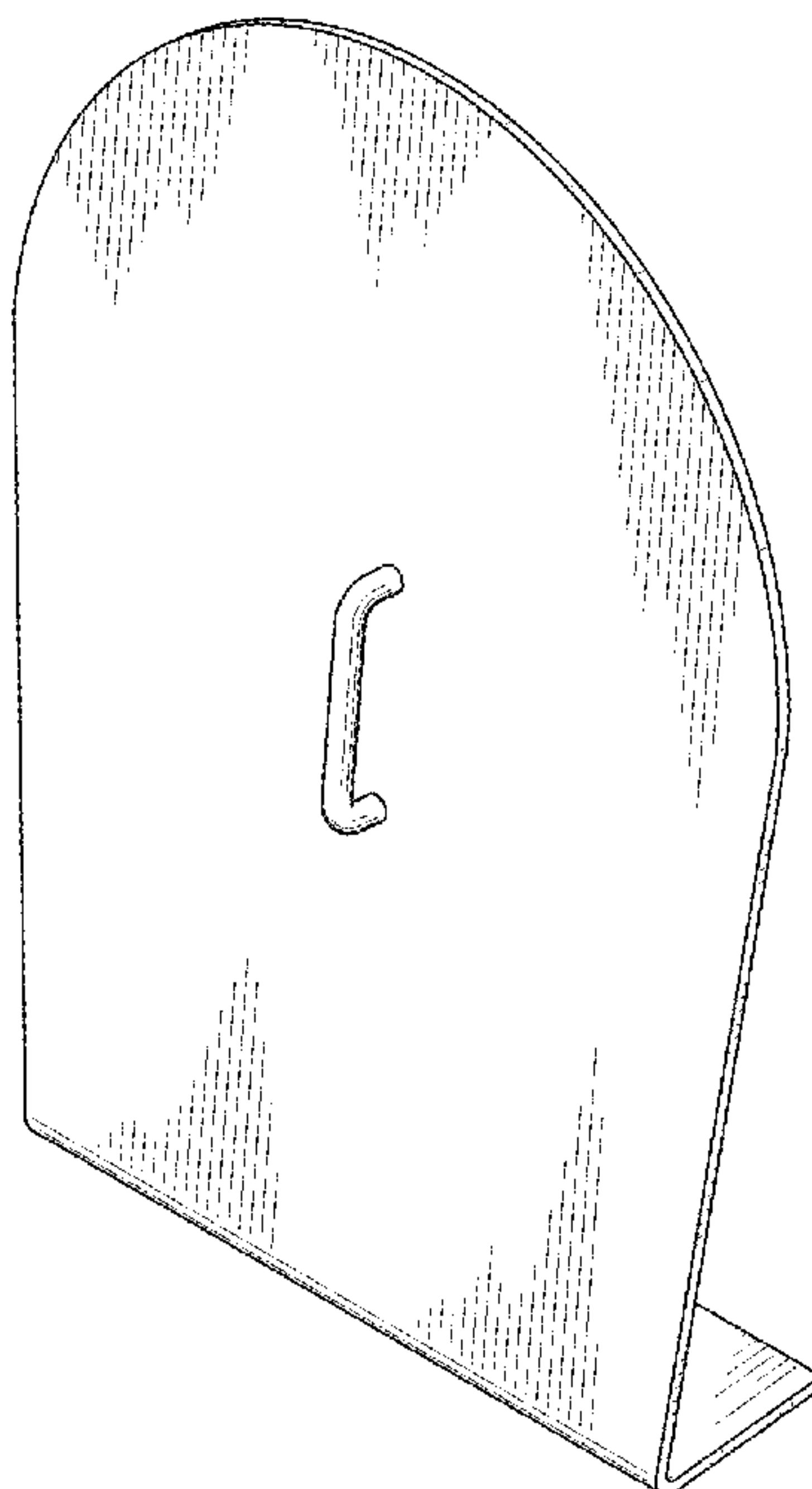
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the splash shield shown in FIG. 1; and,

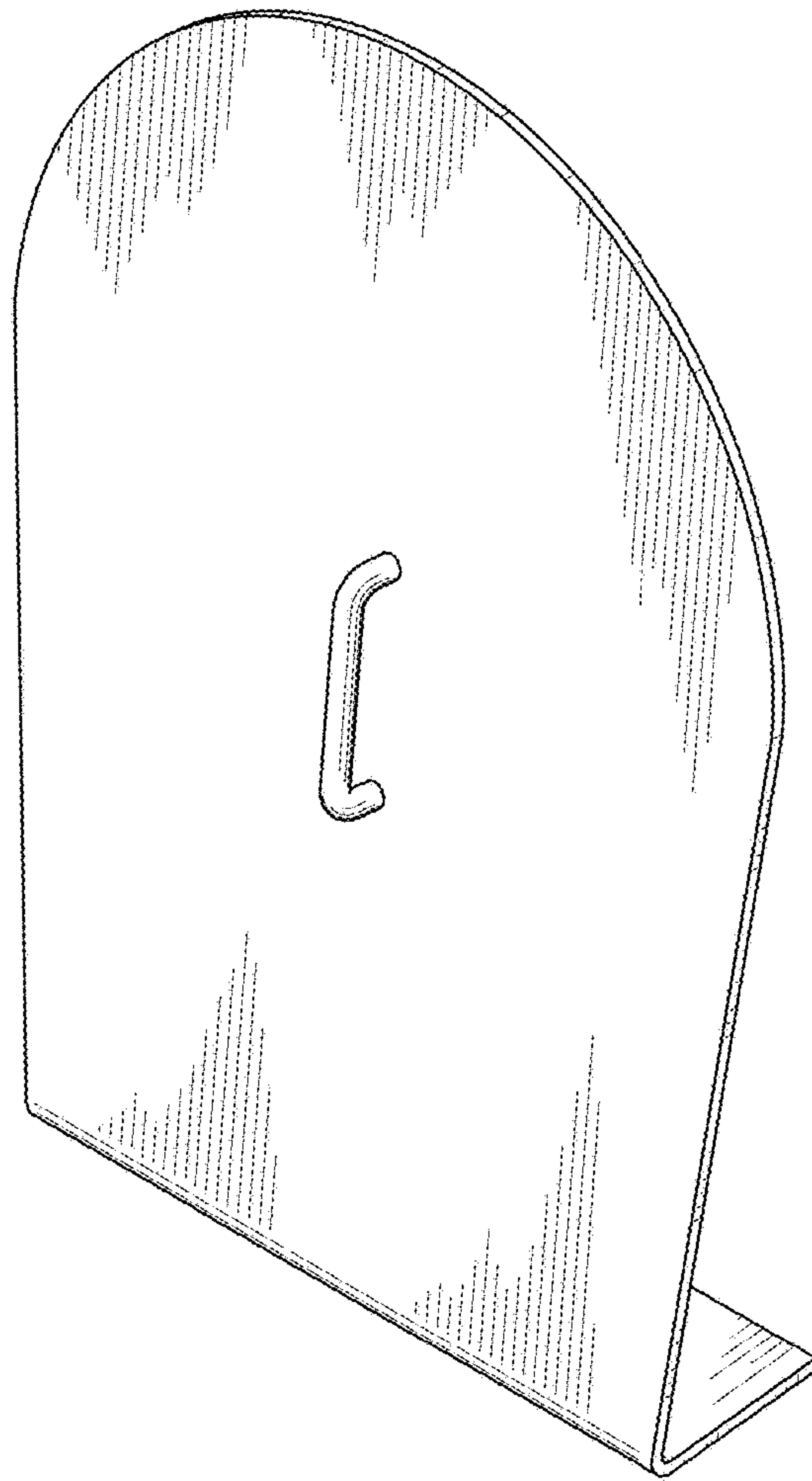

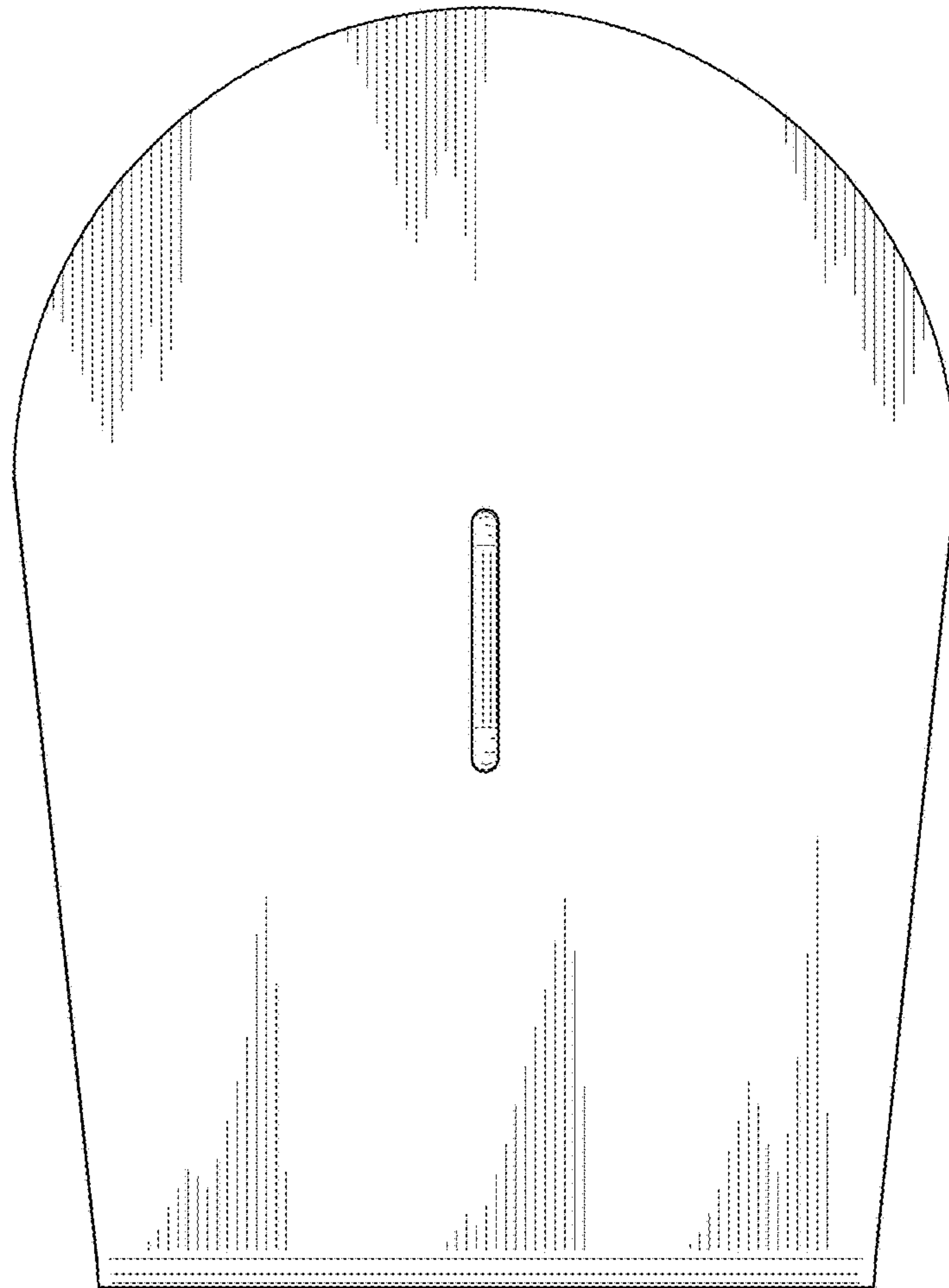

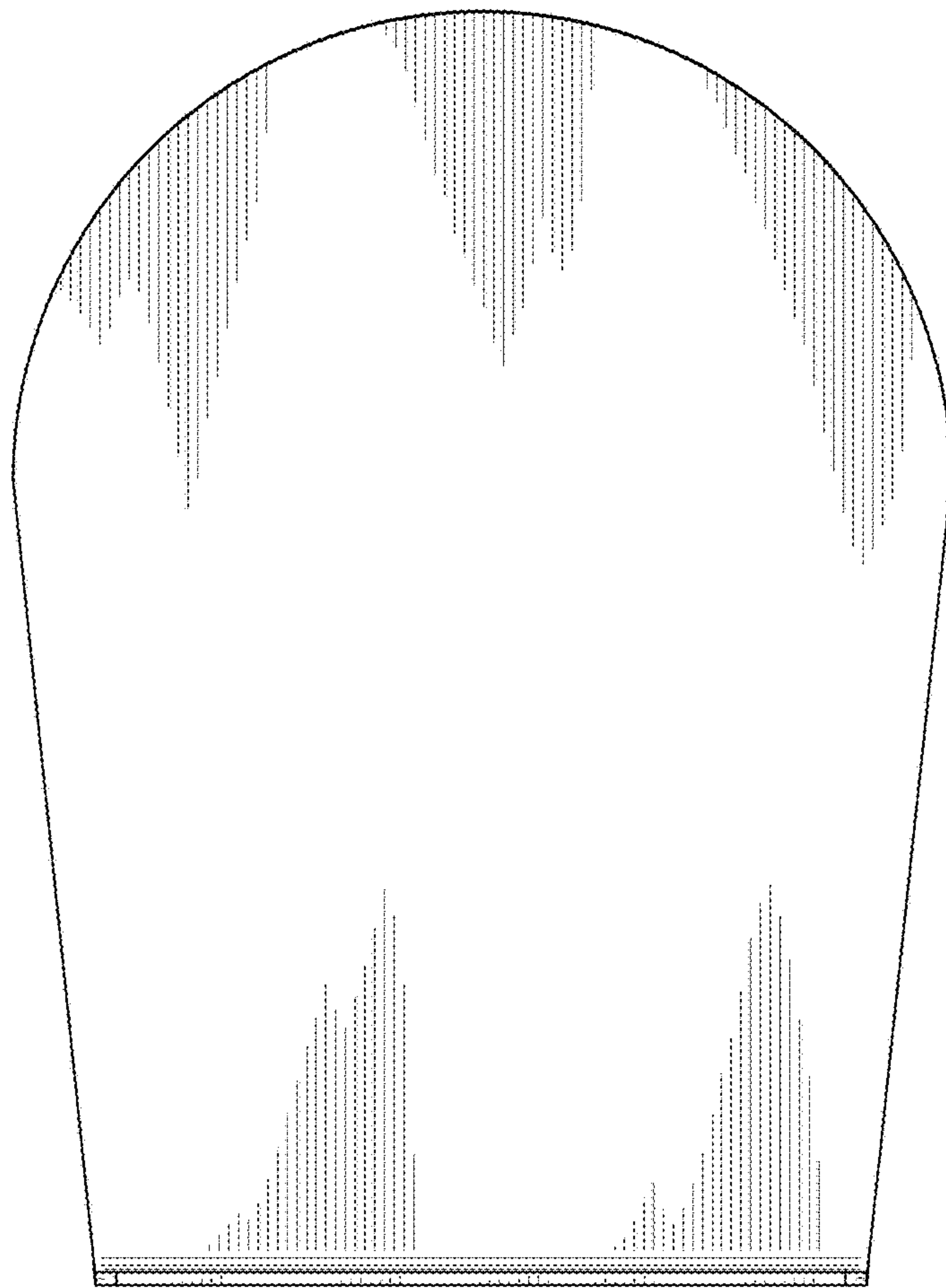

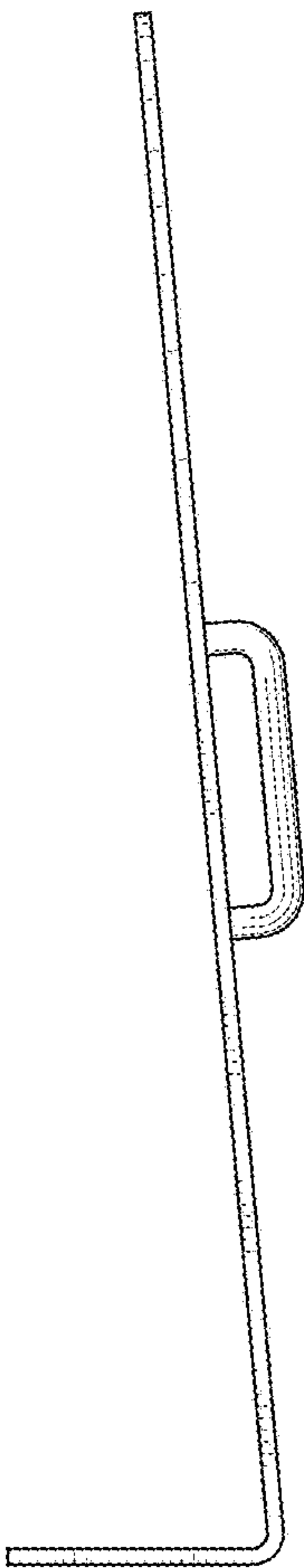

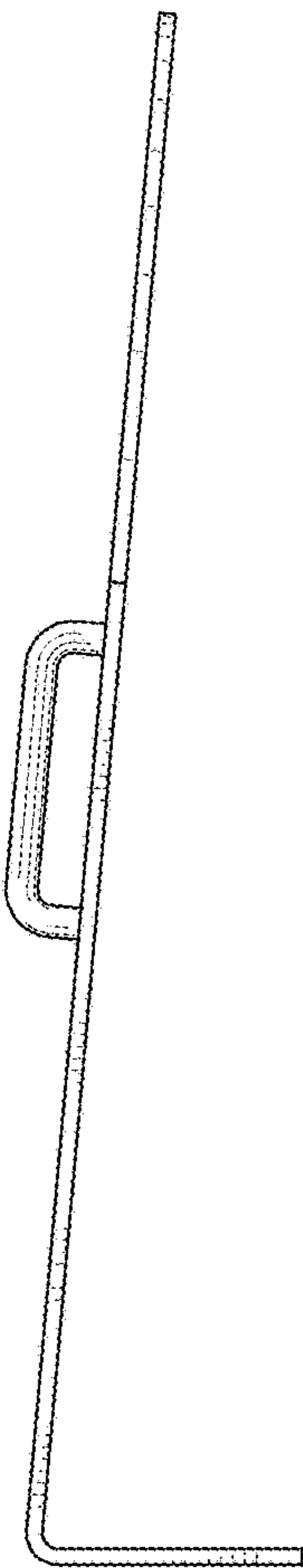

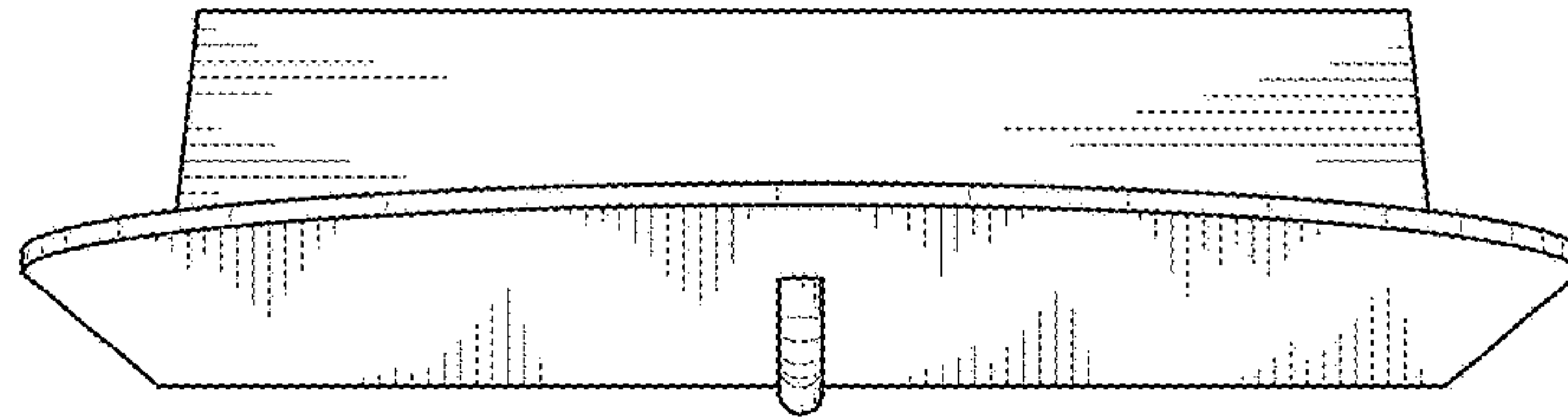

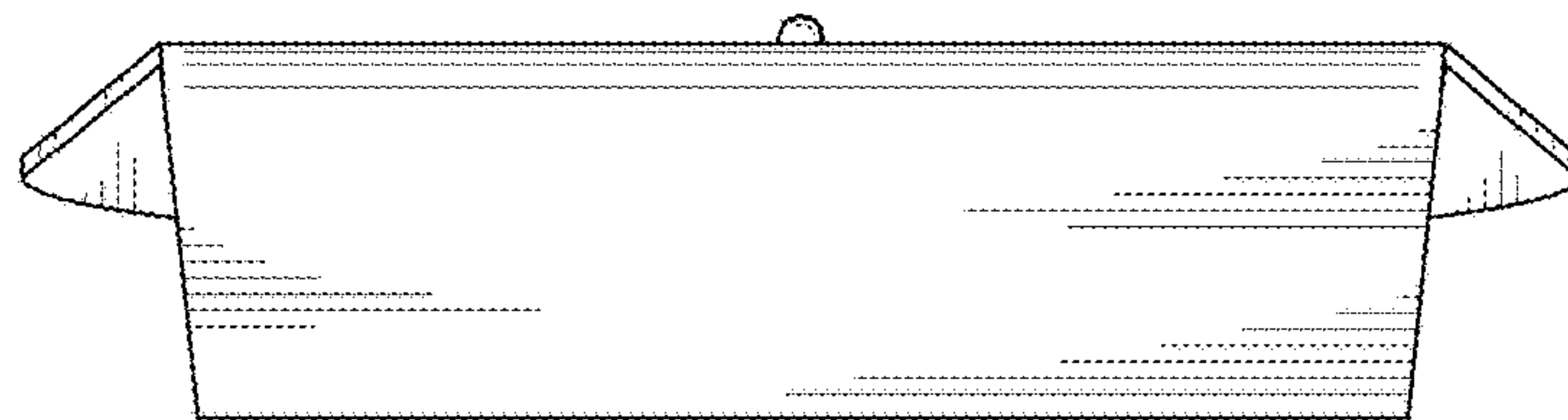
